FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof, shown in a used condition;

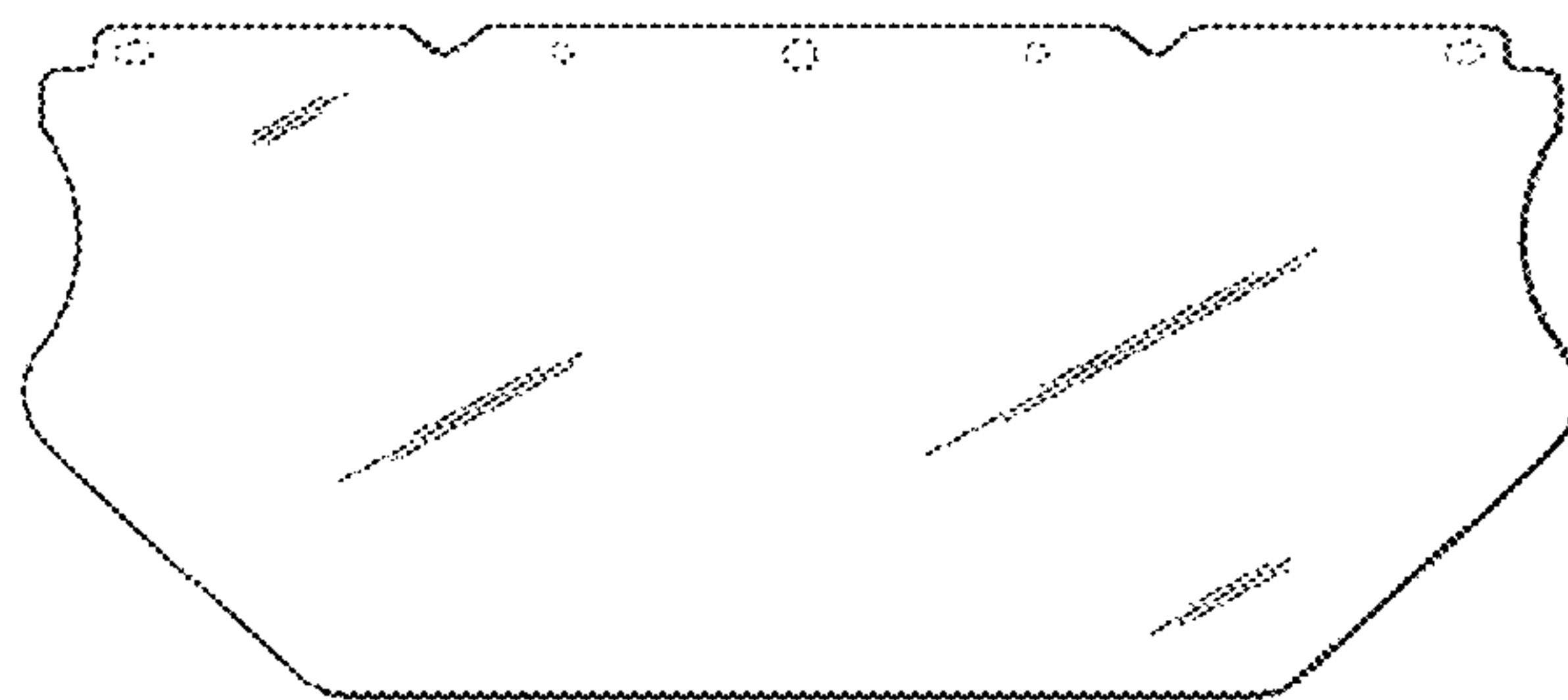
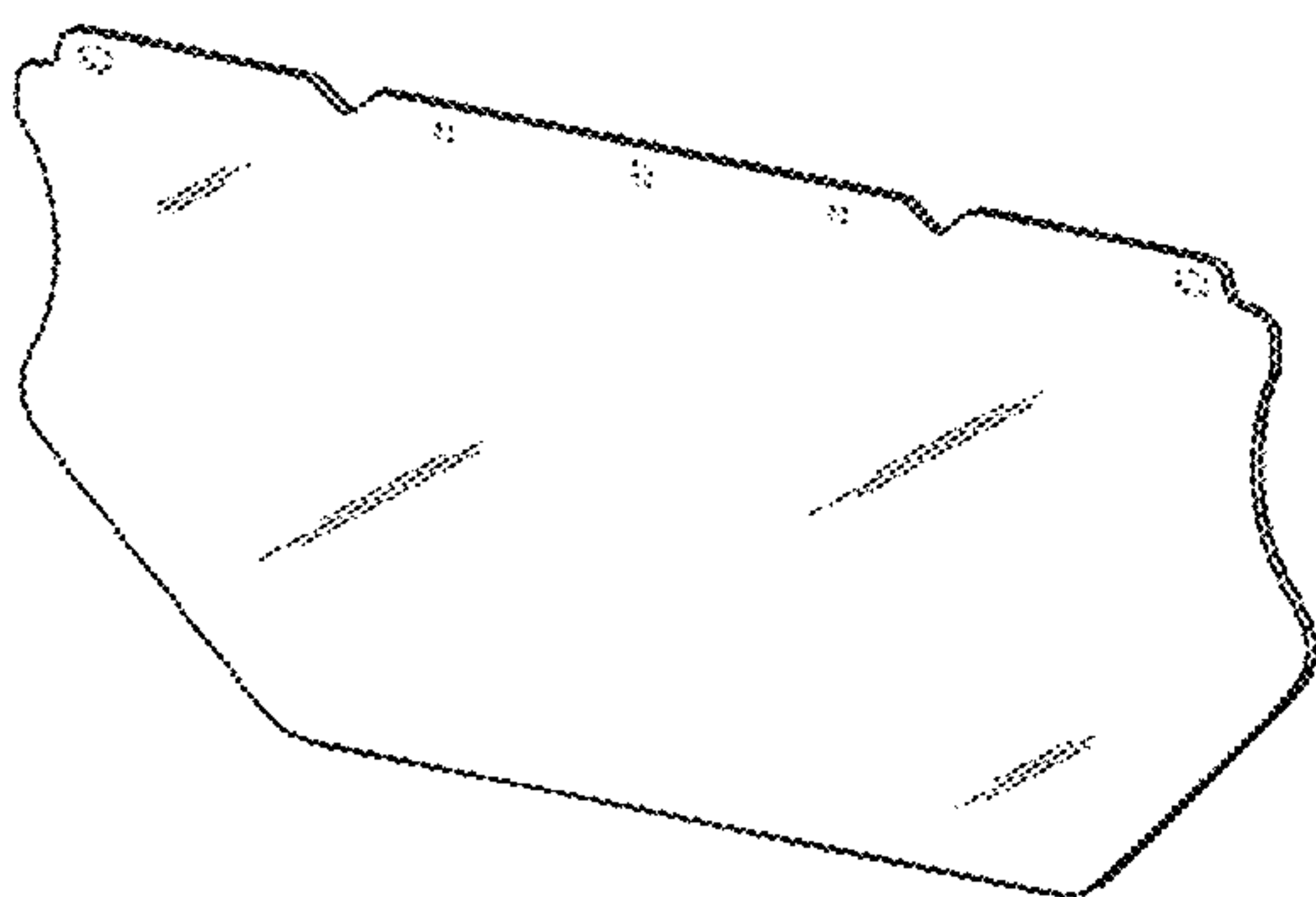
FIG. 10 is a side view thereof, shown in a used condition, the opposite side view is identical;

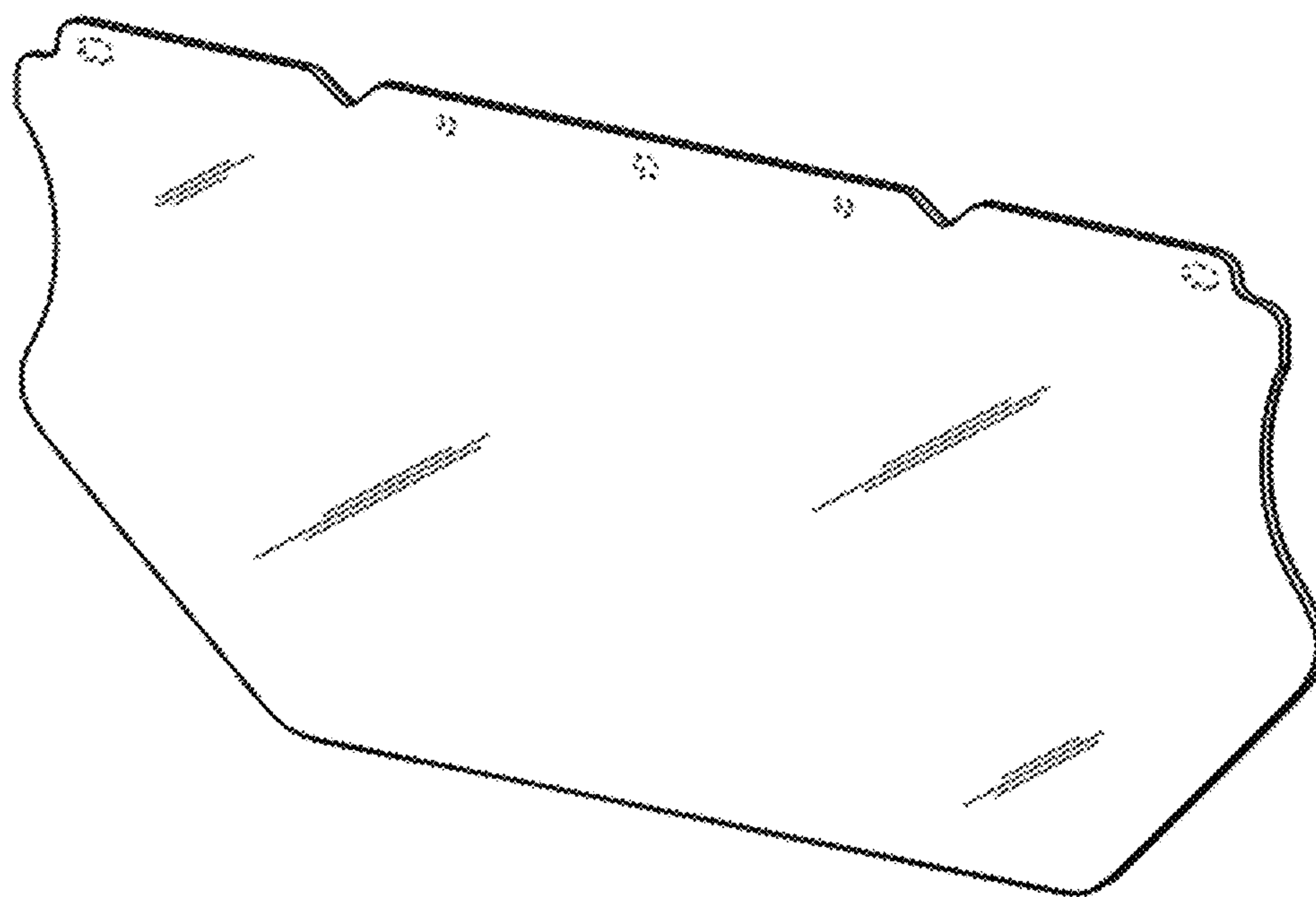

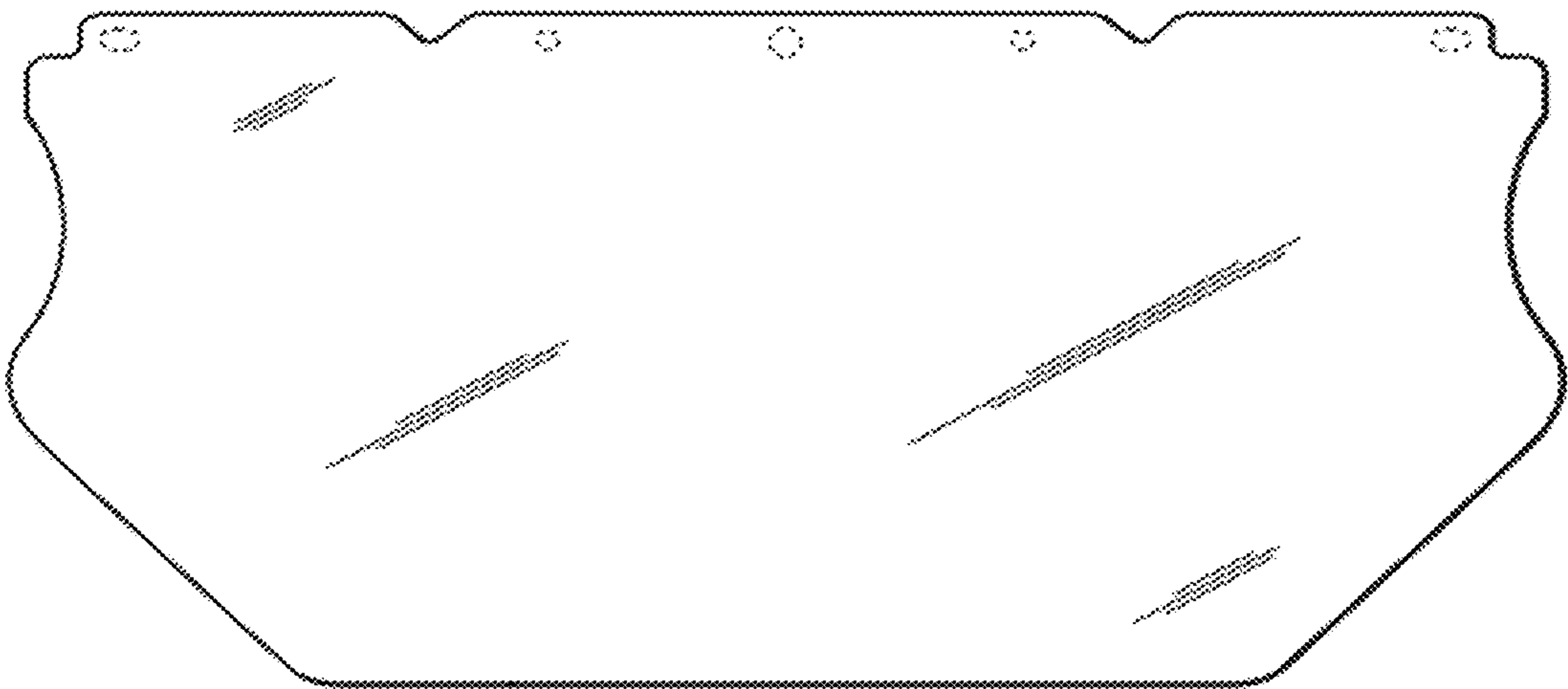

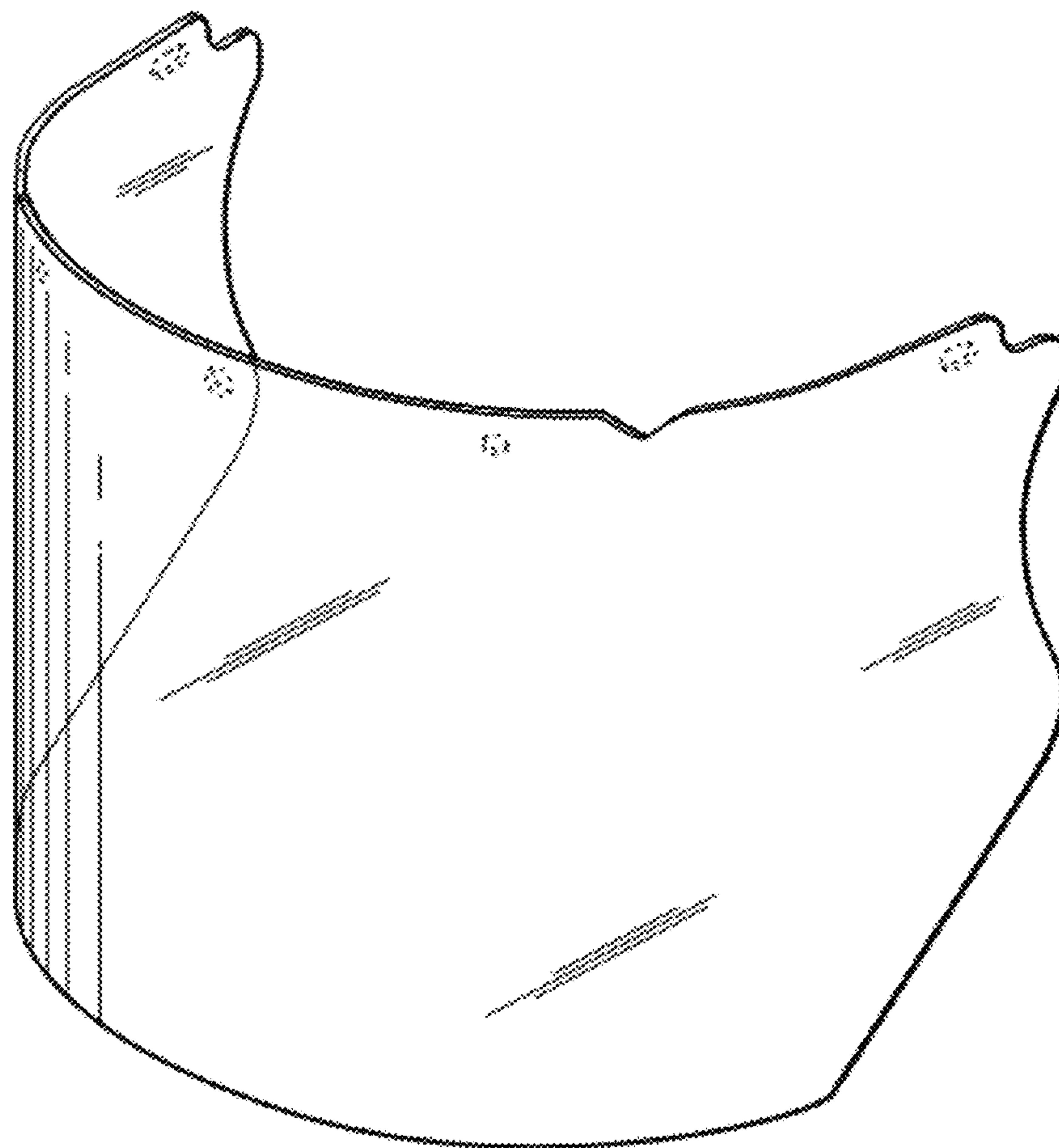

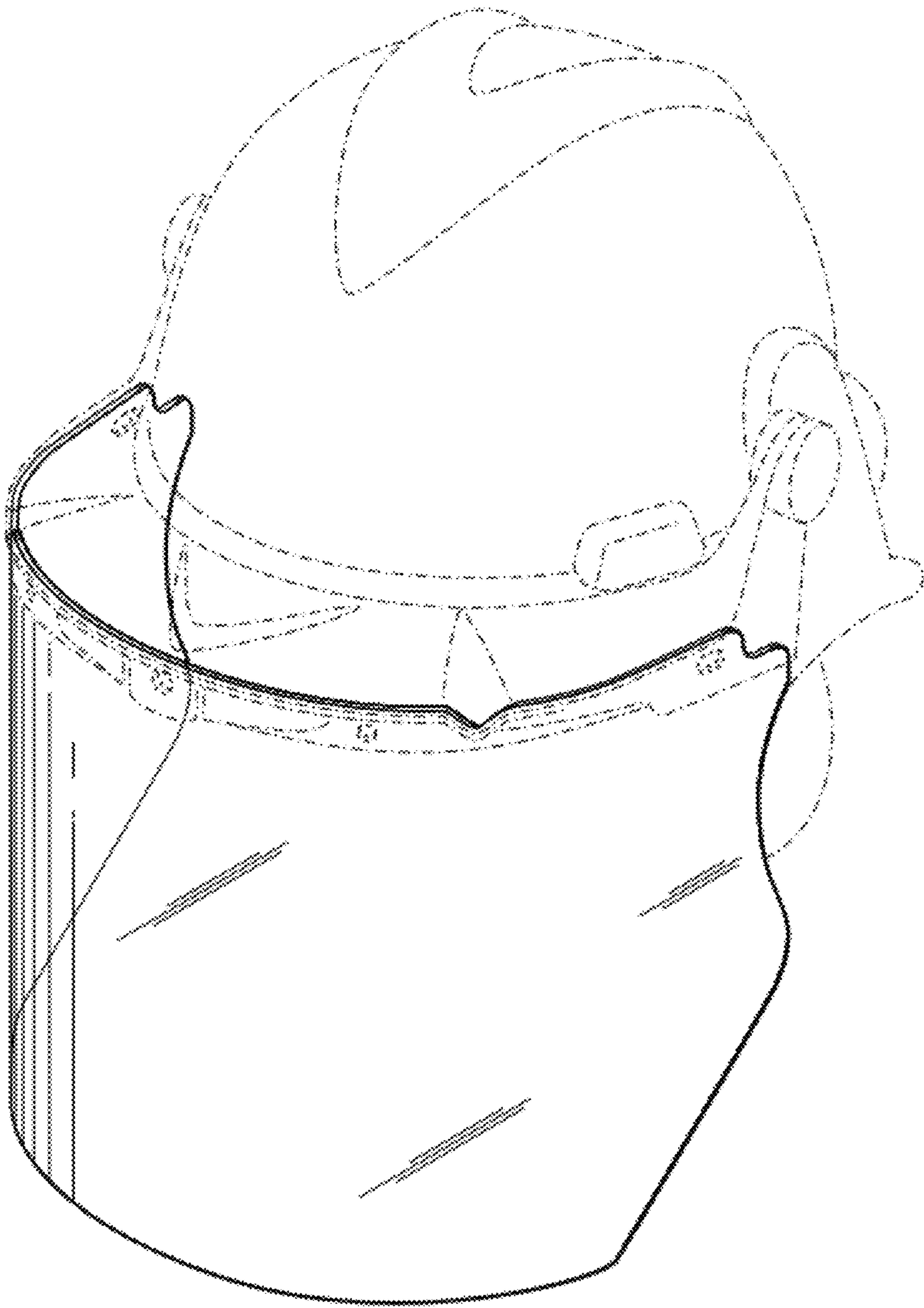

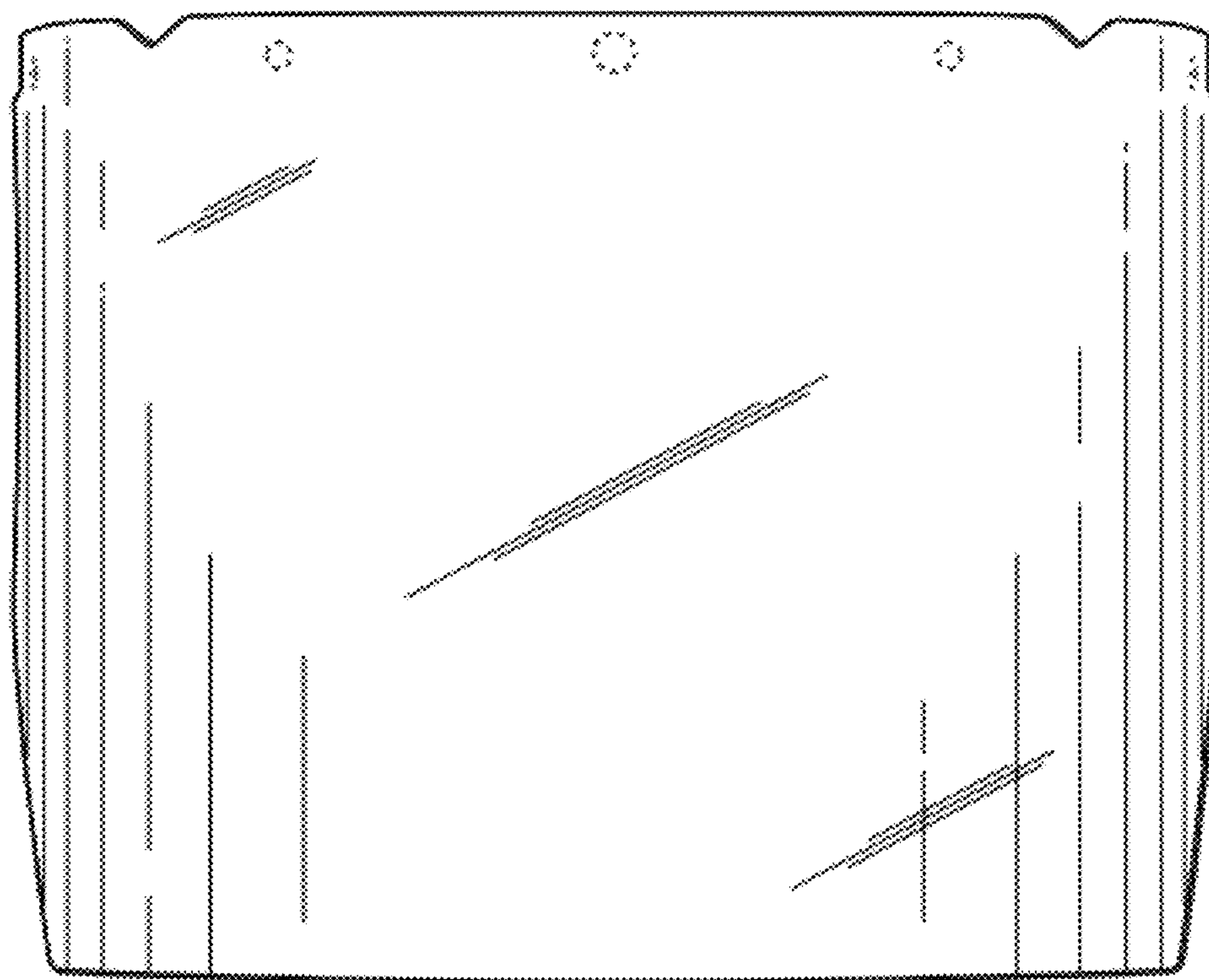

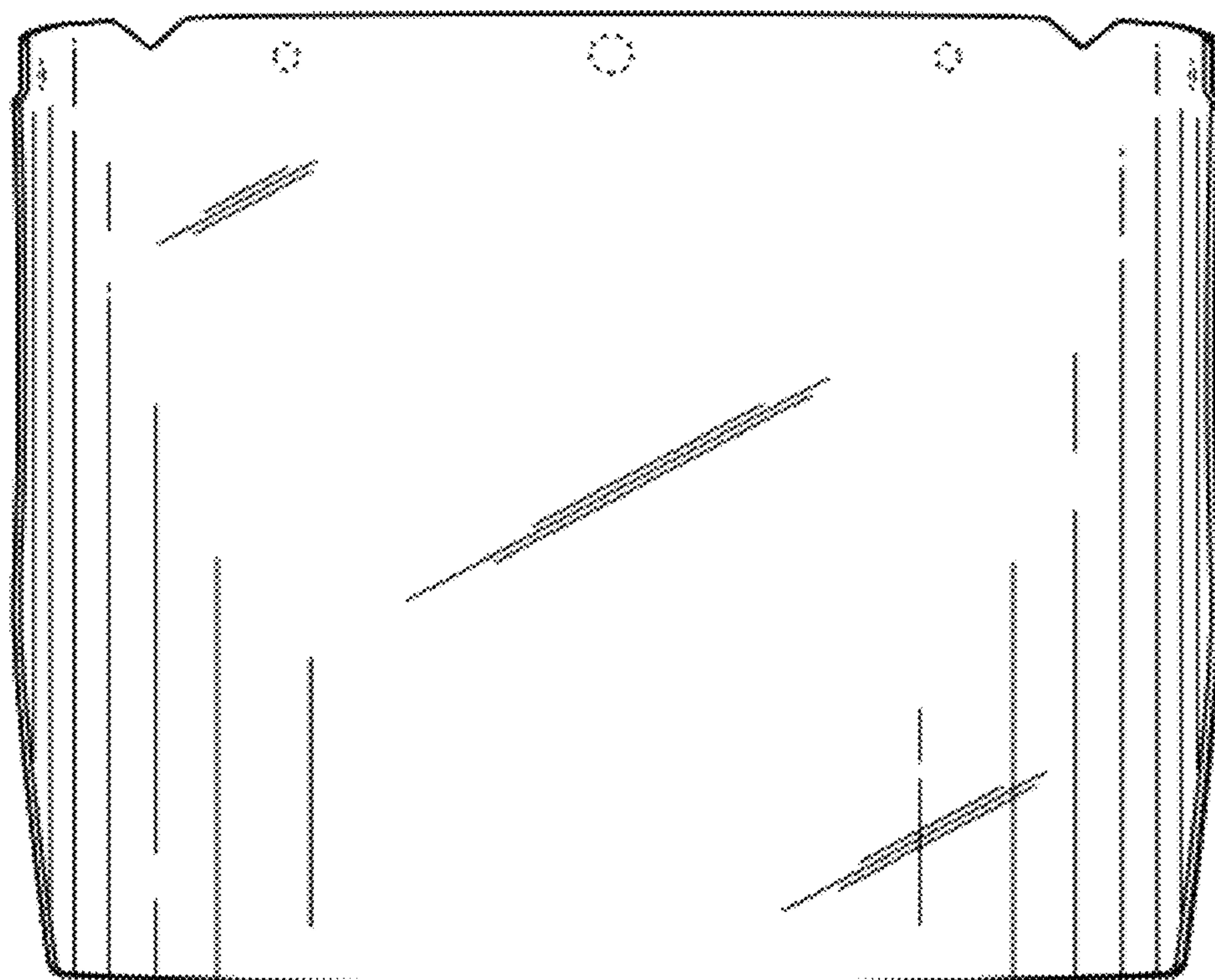

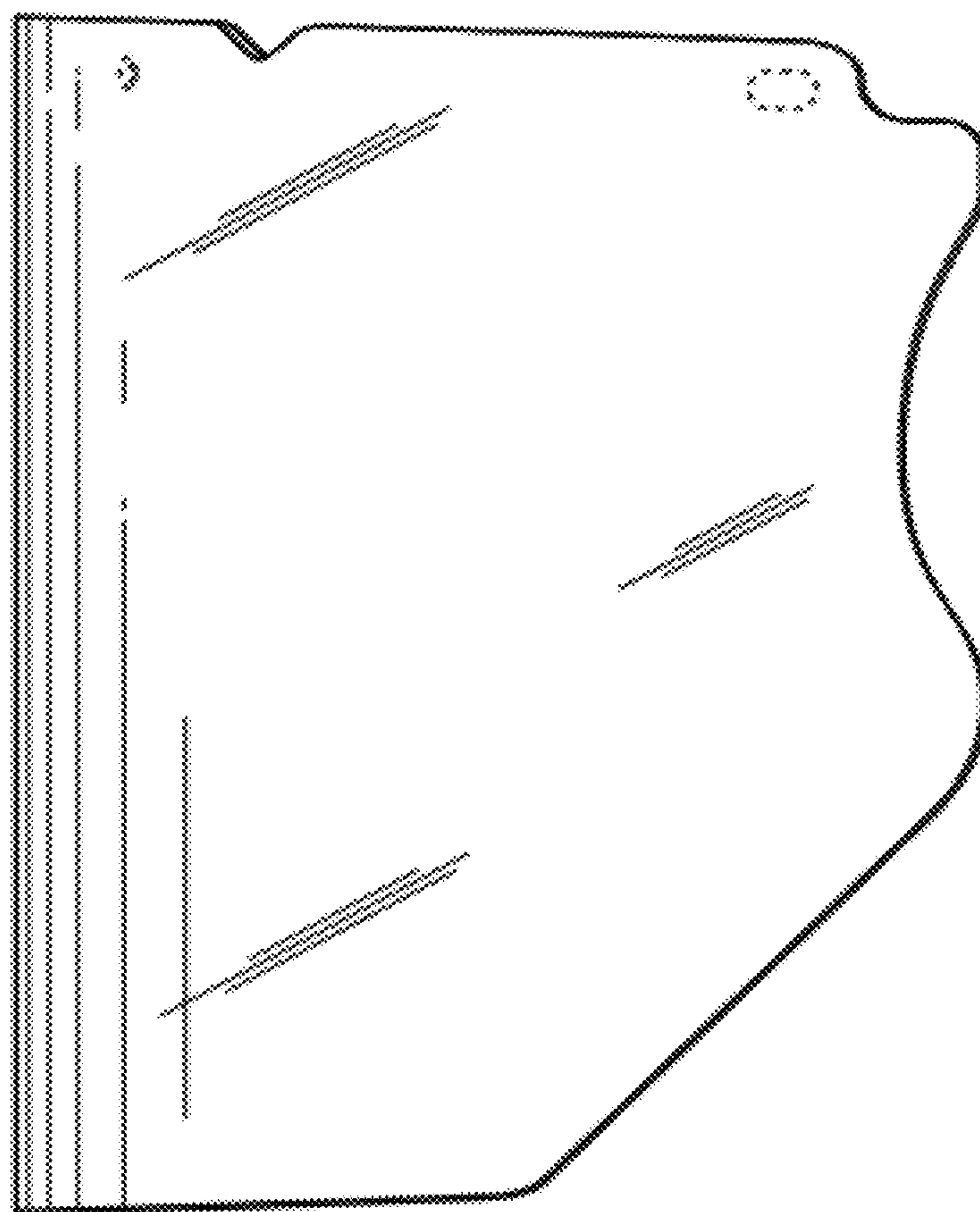

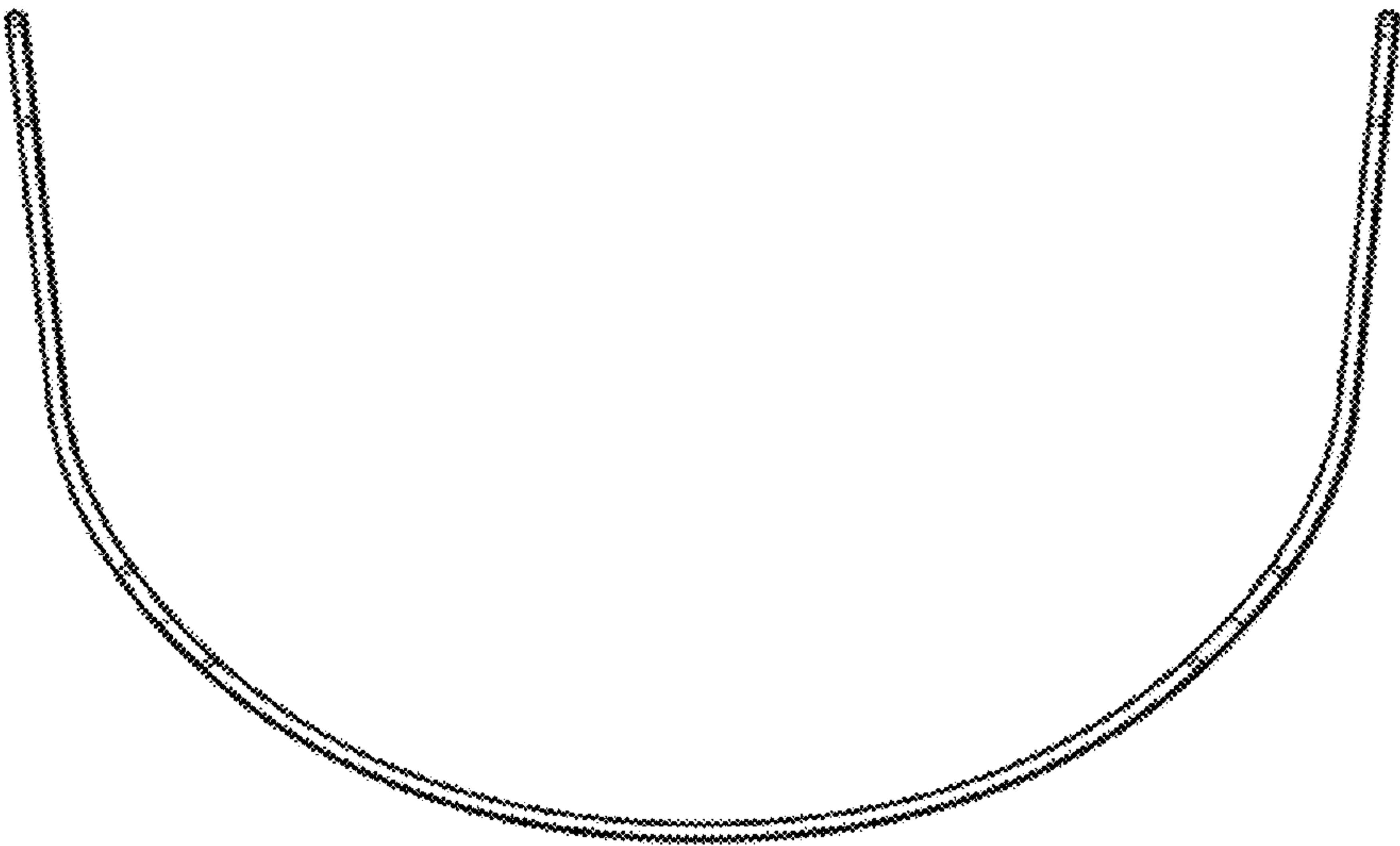

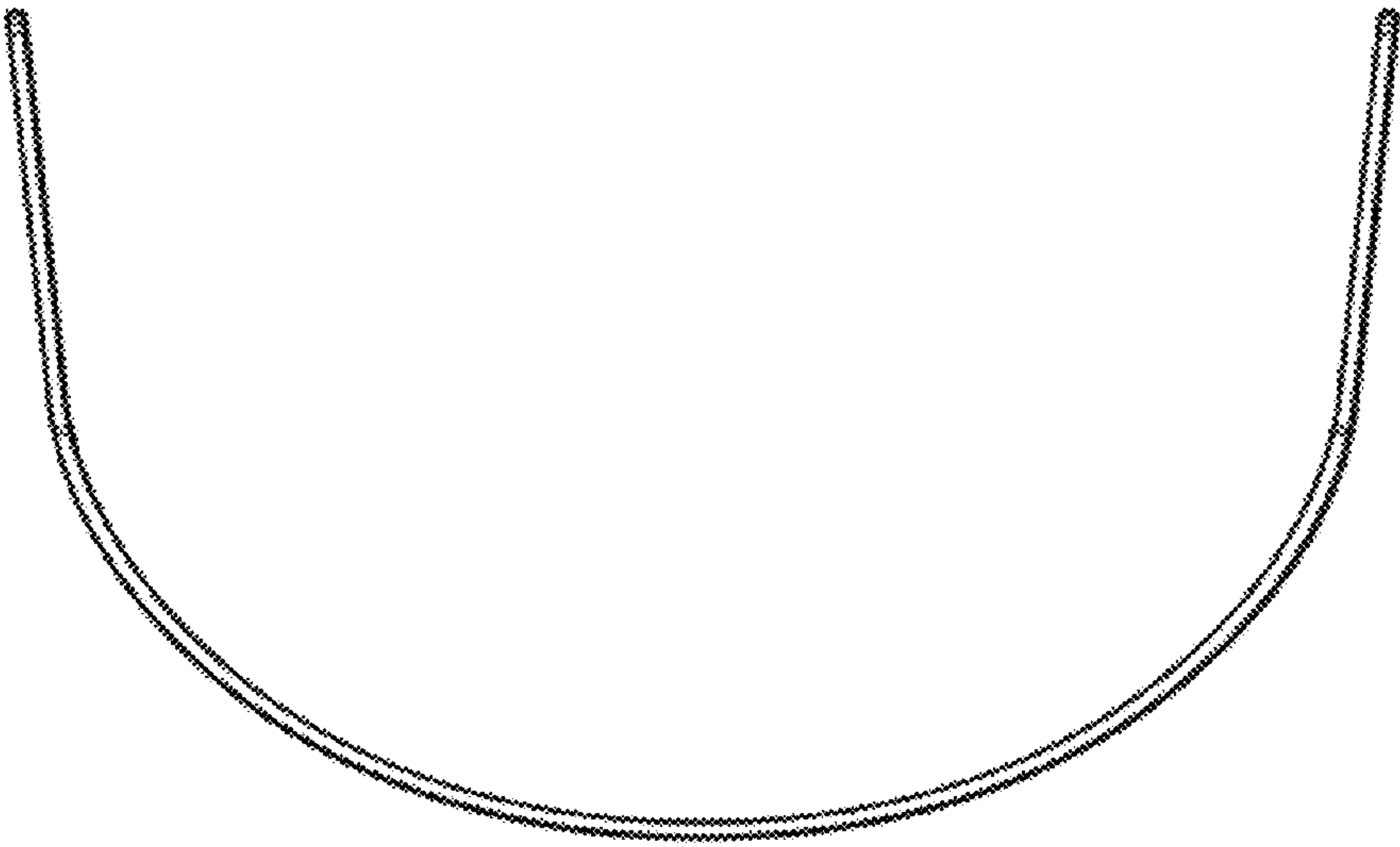
