DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a milling table vise work stop showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, the broken lines form no part of the claimed invention;

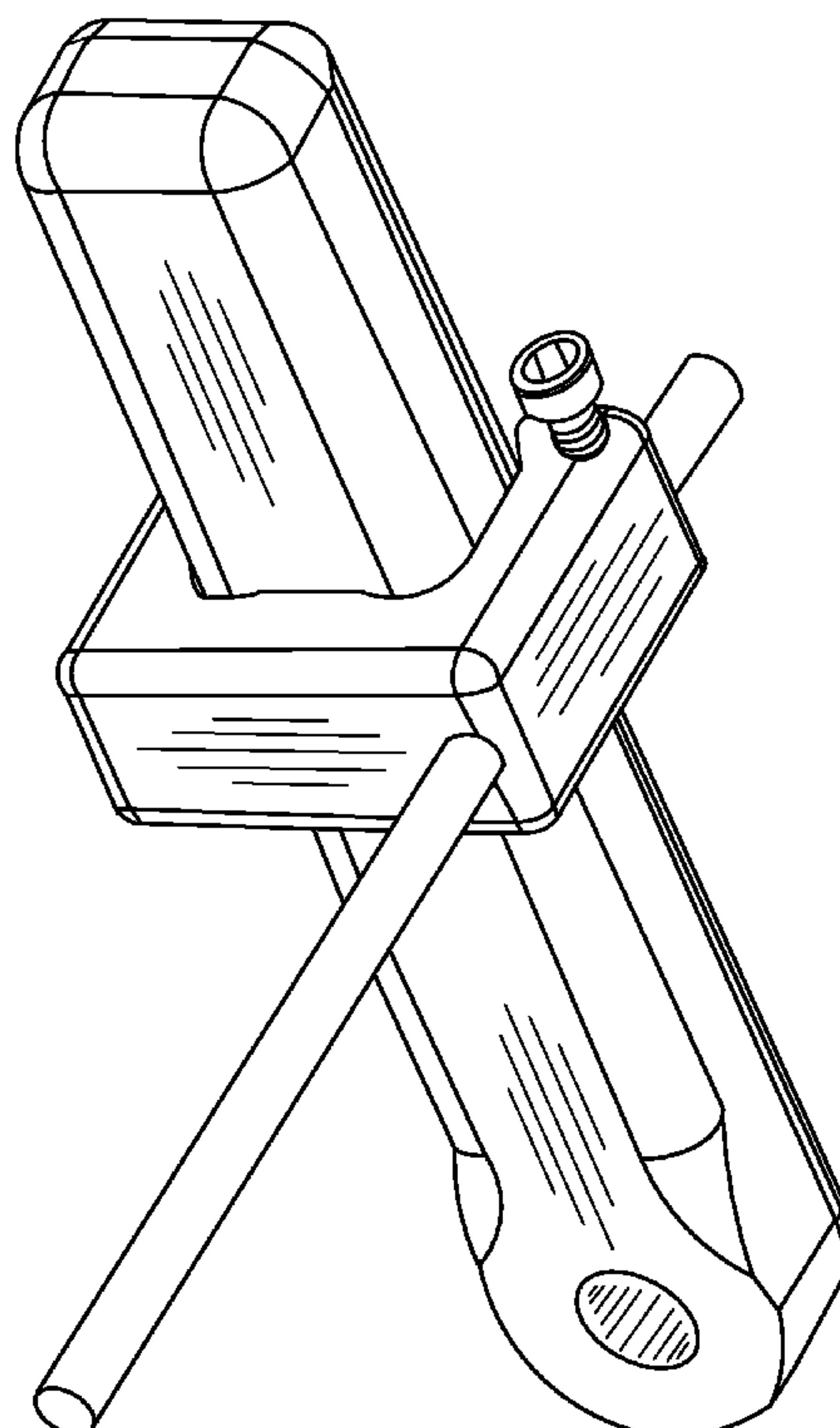
FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof;

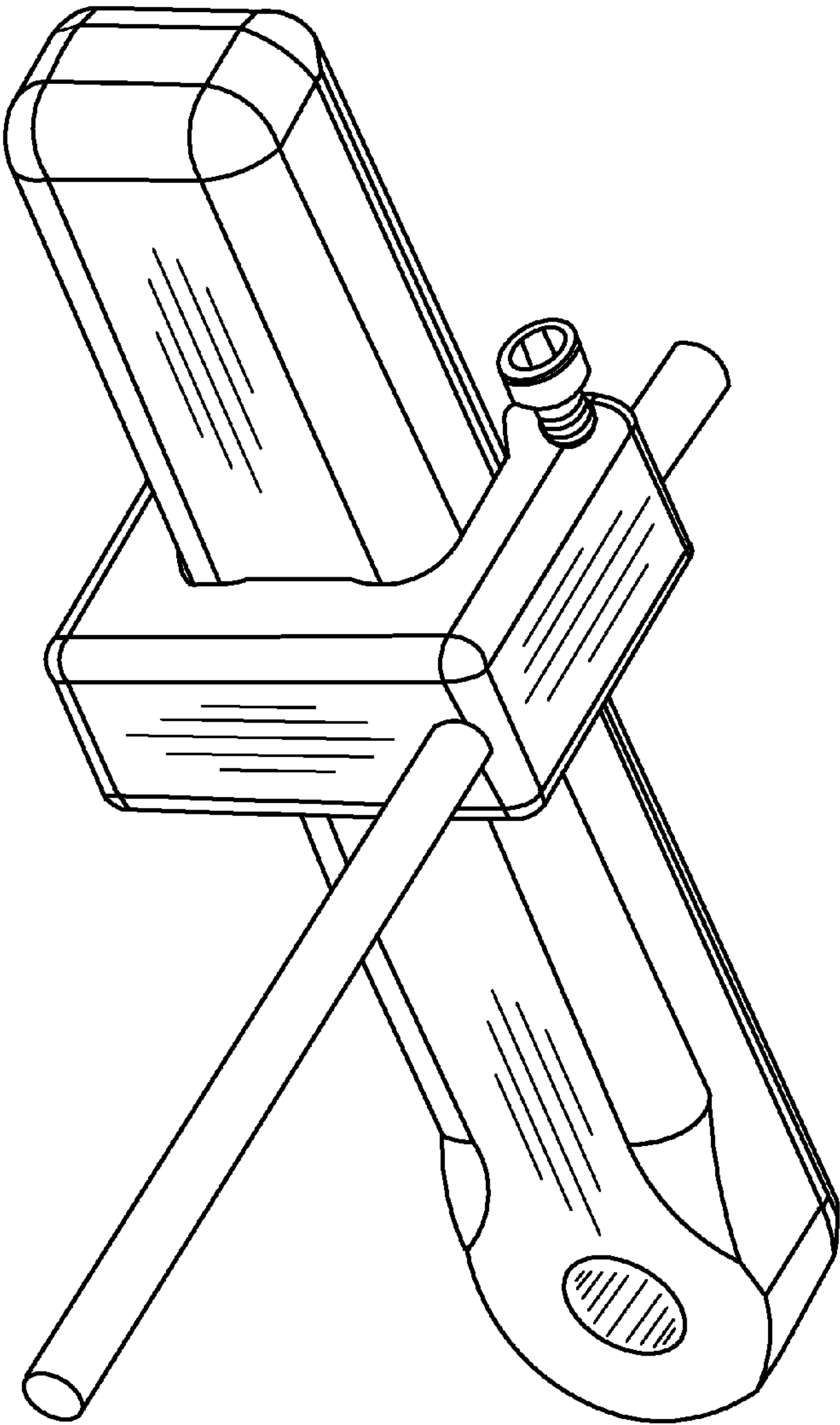

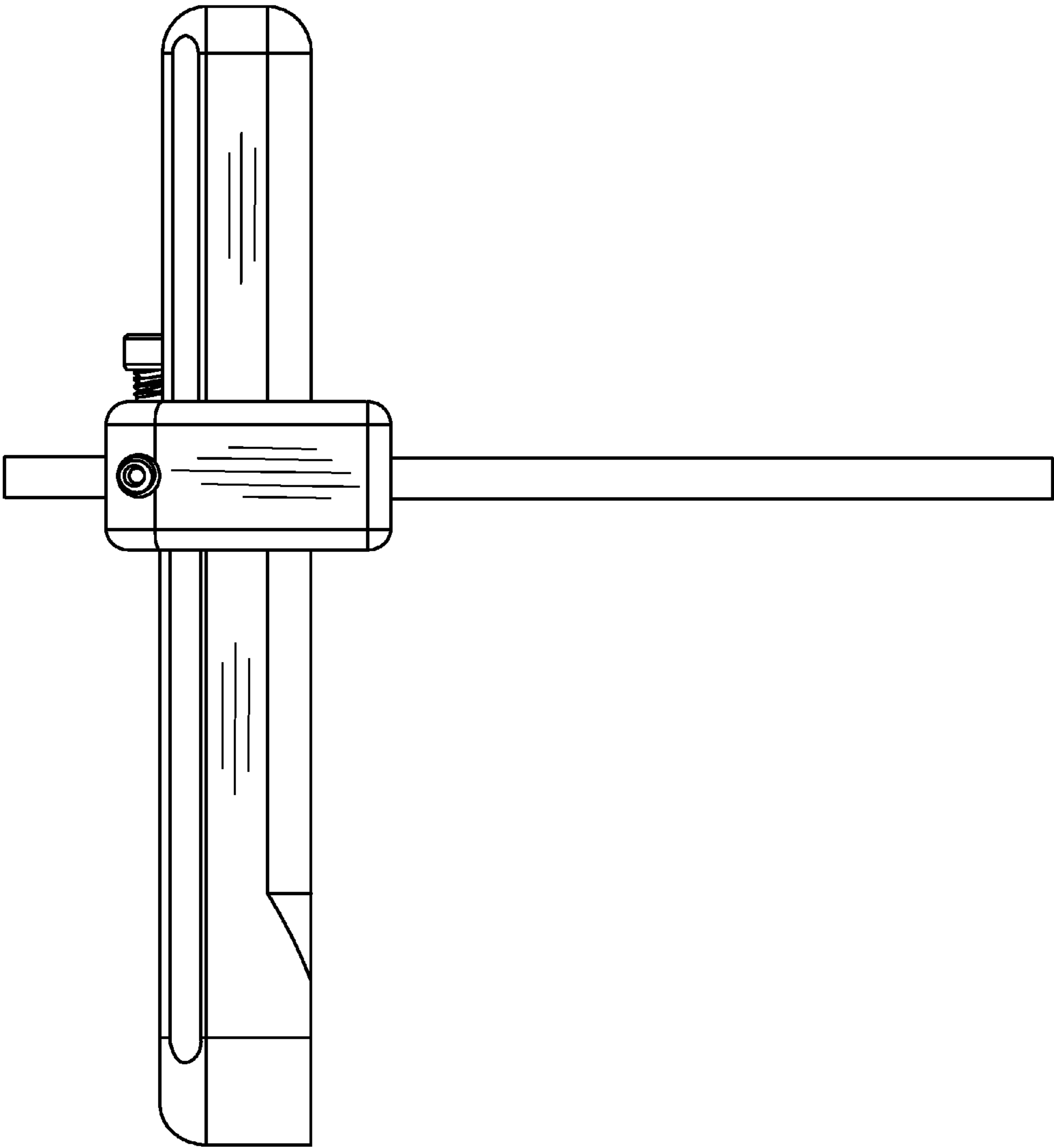

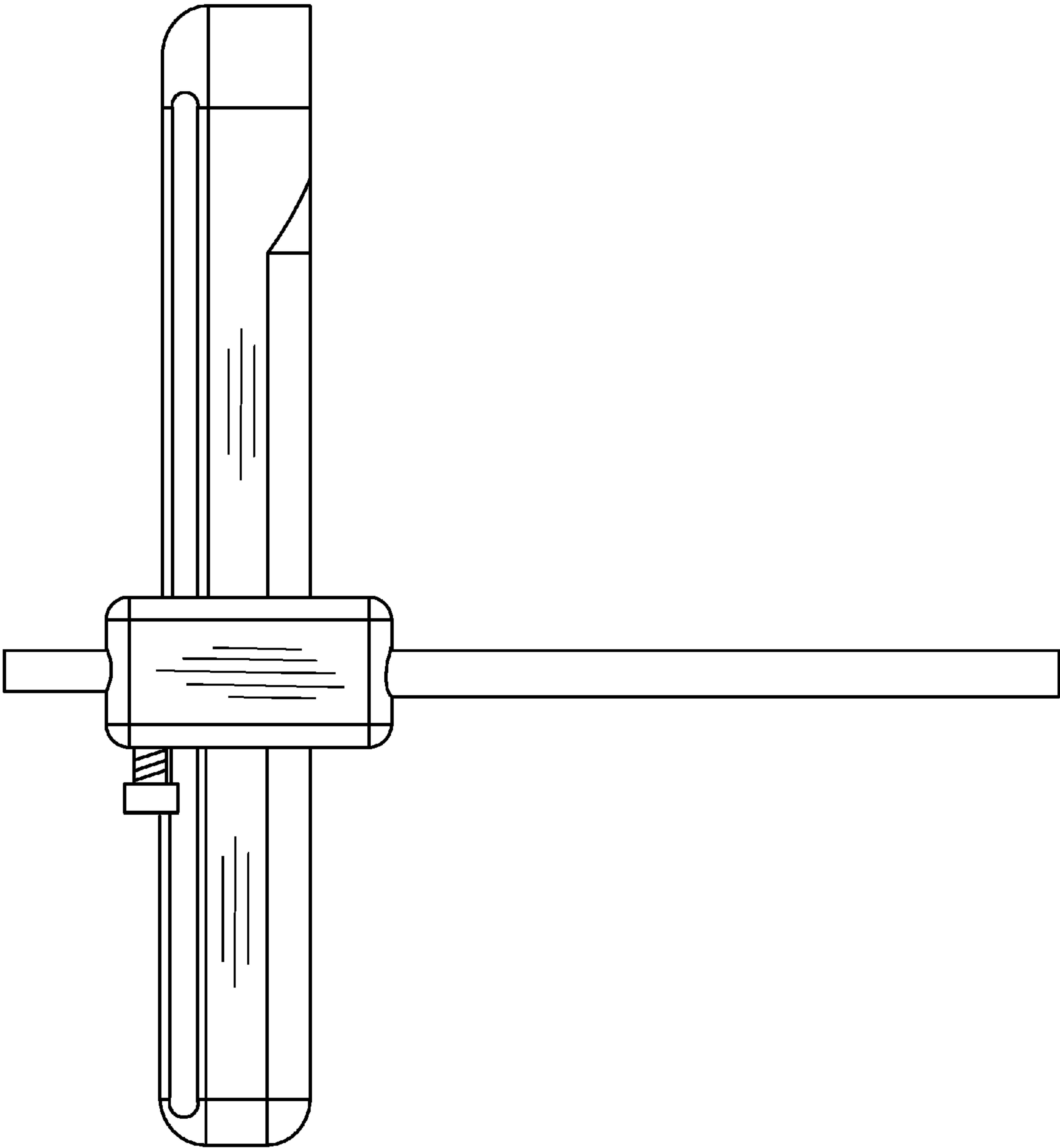

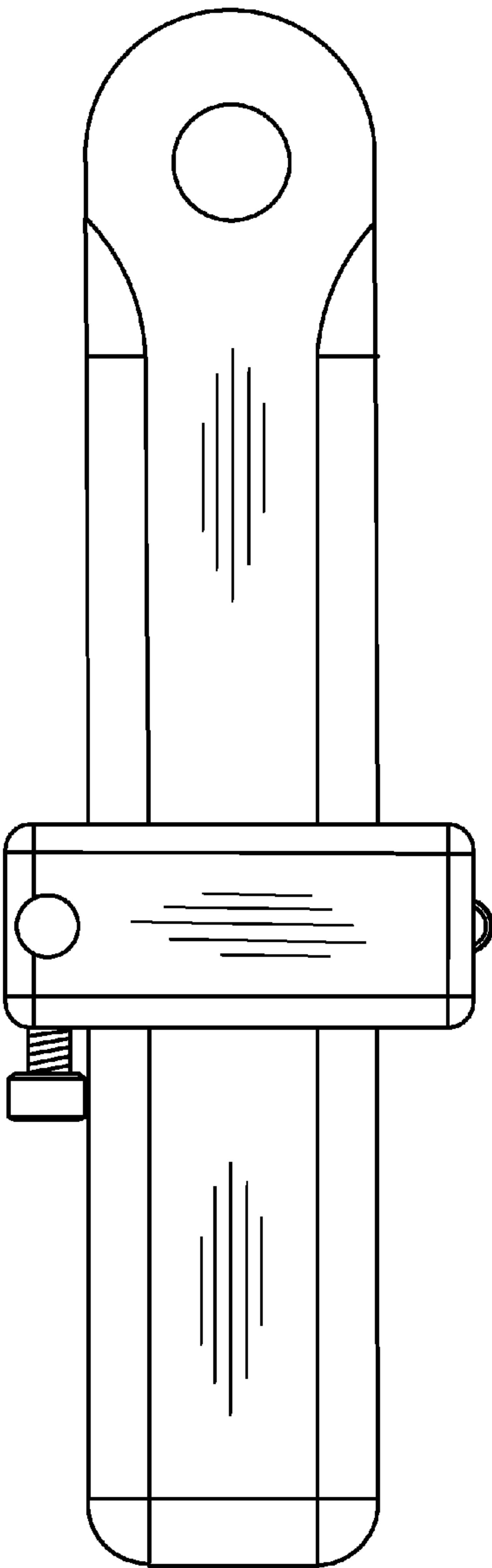

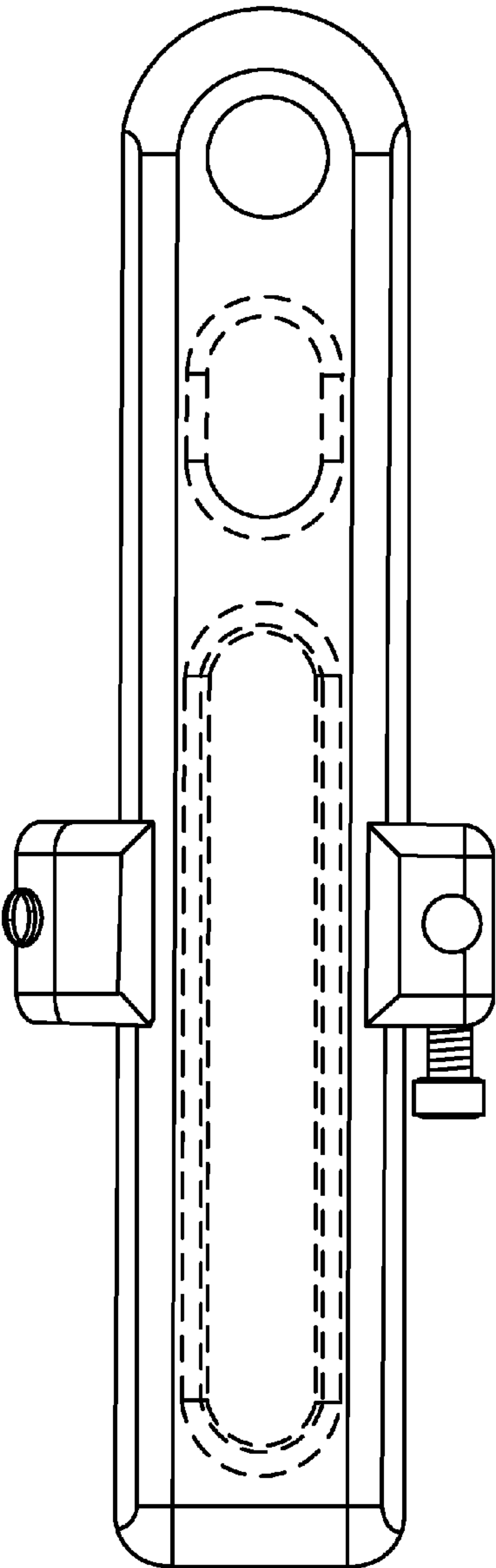

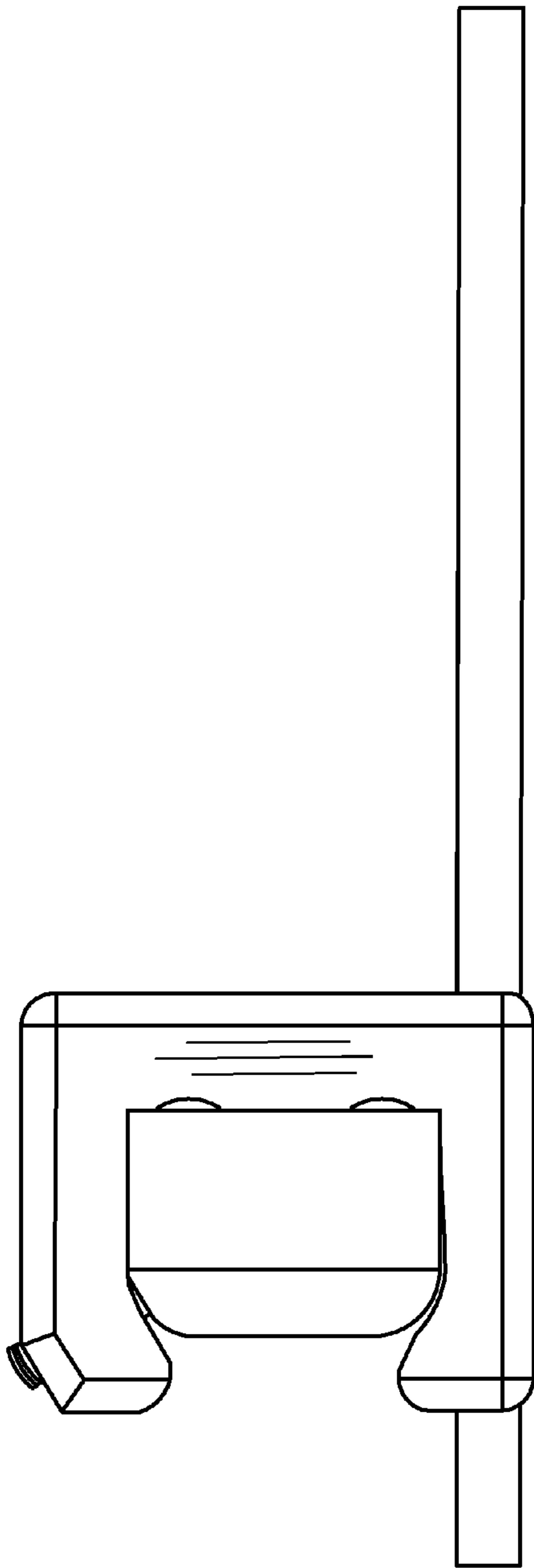

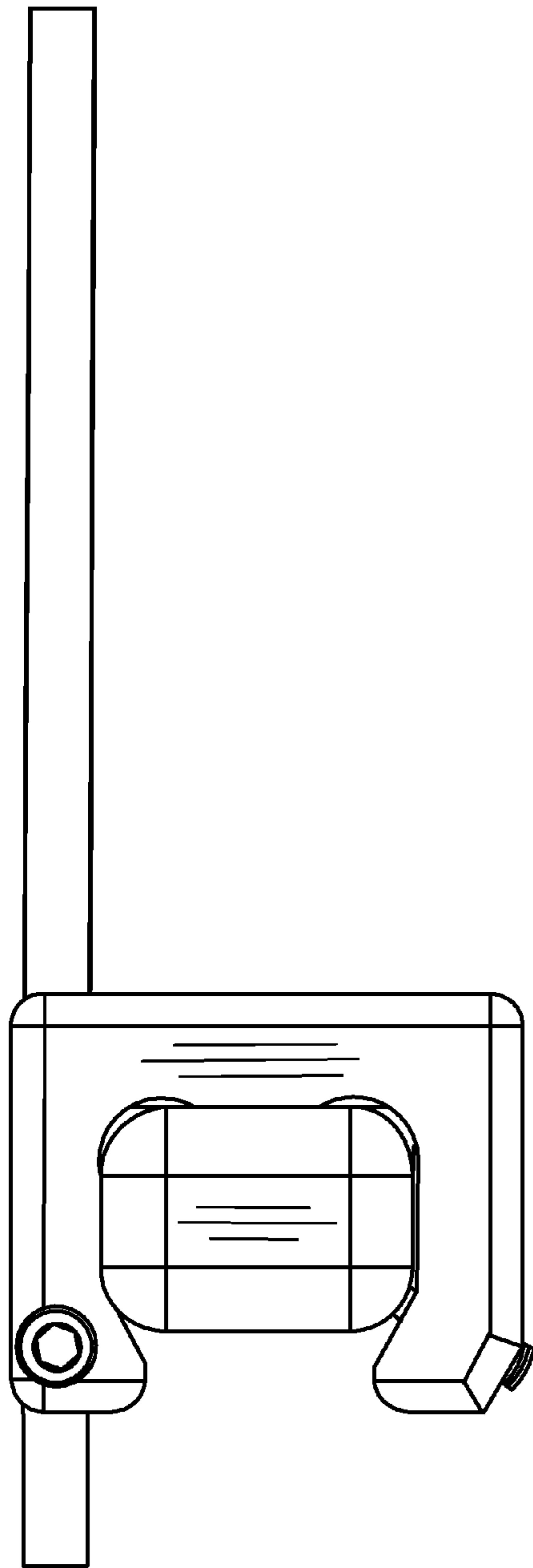

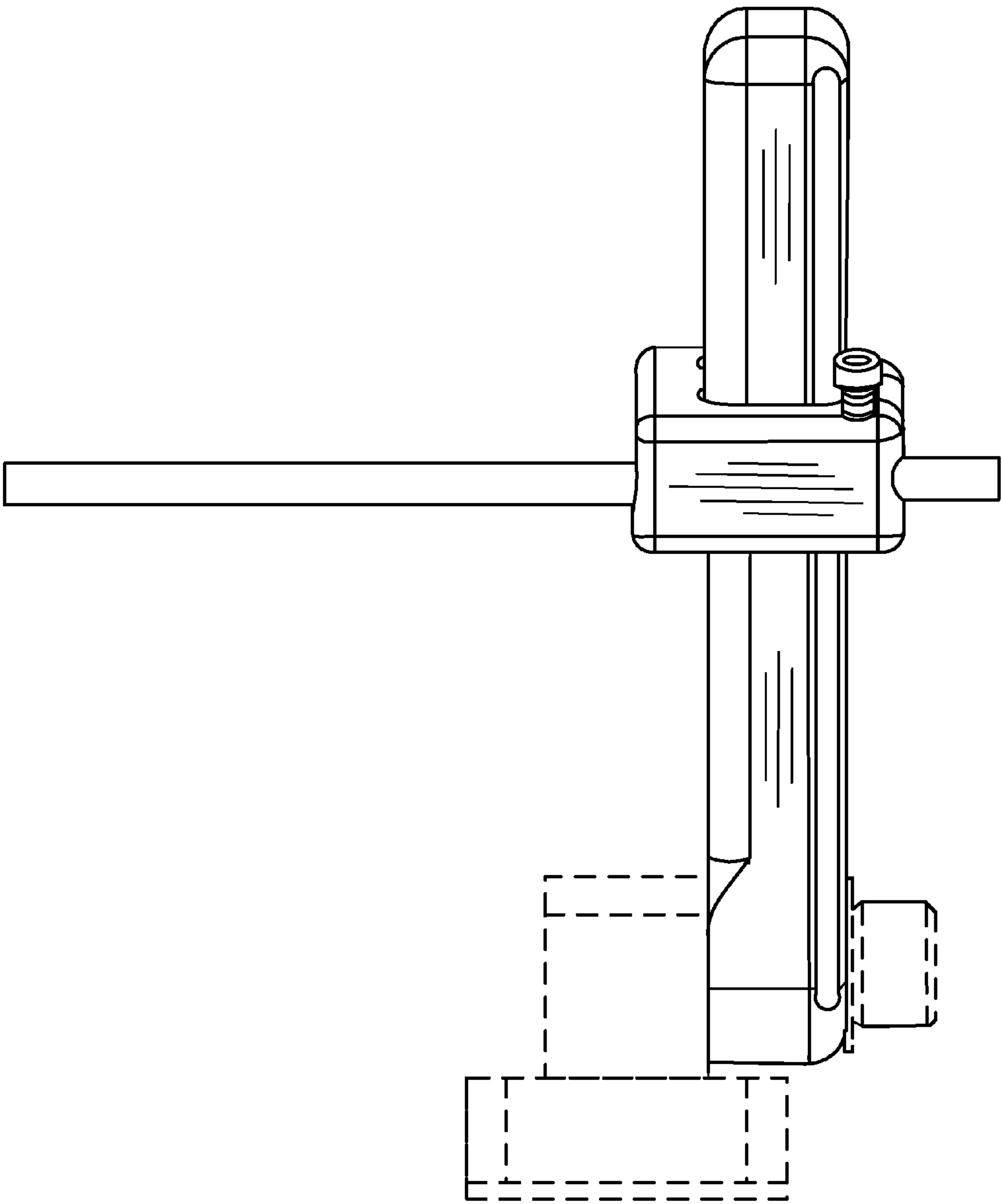

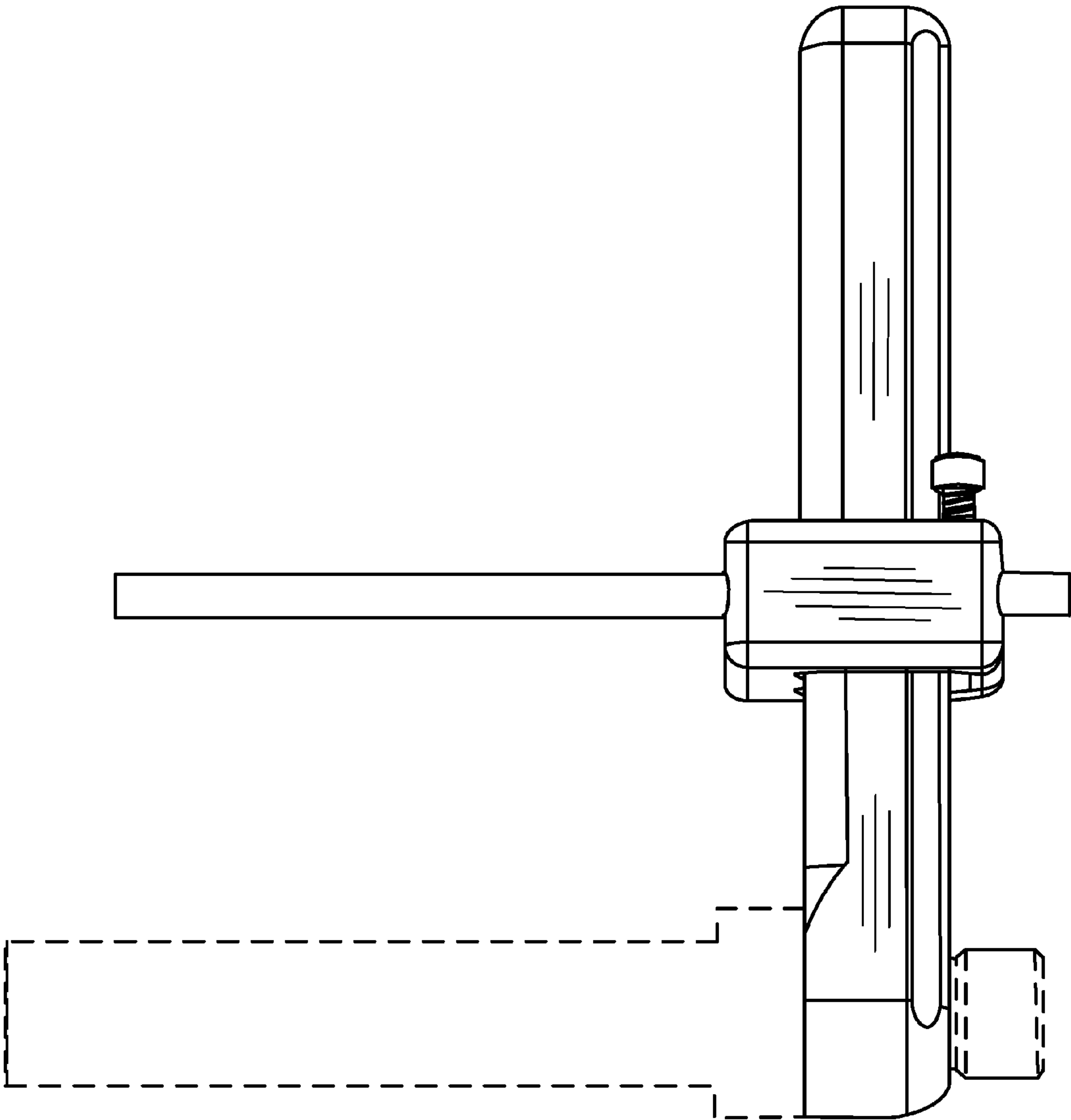
