FIG. 4 shows a right side view of the sofa;

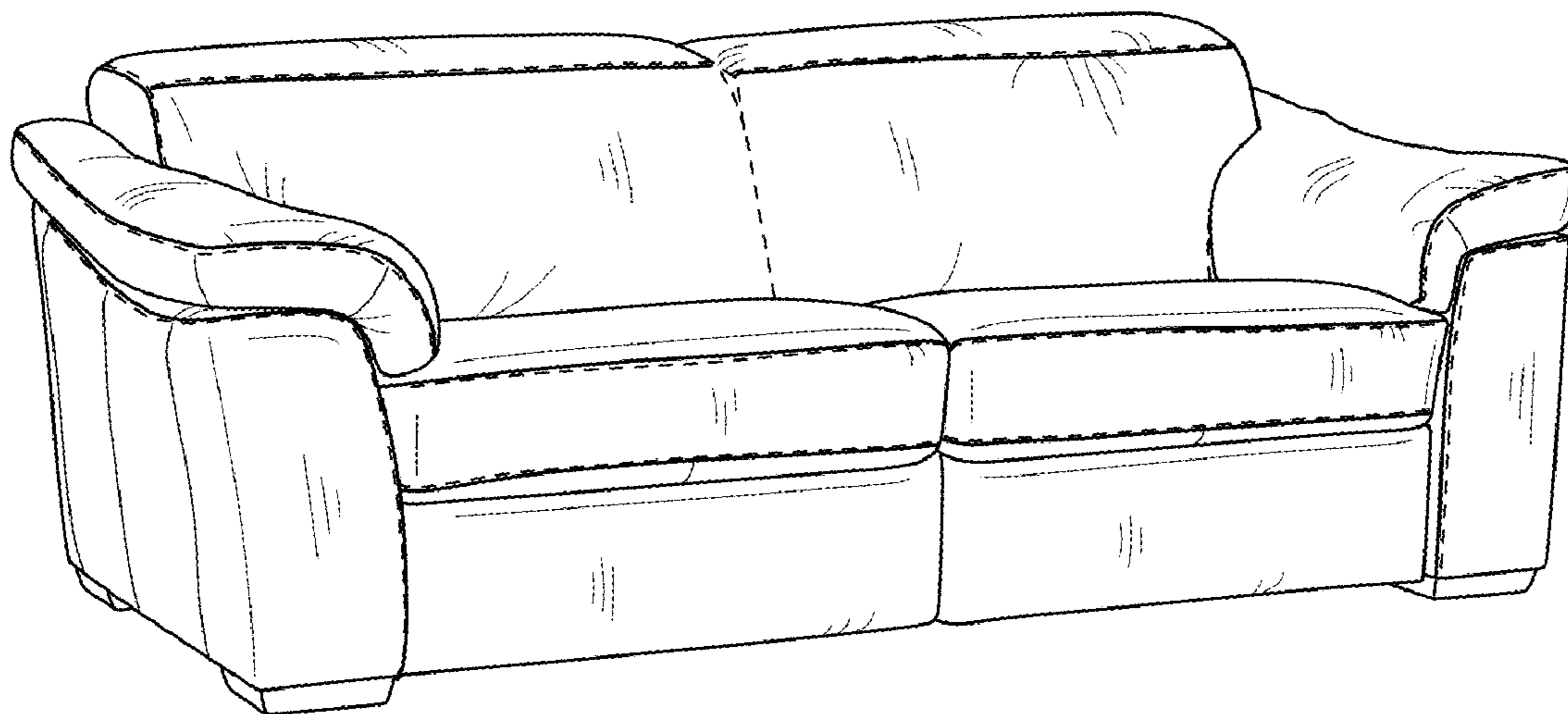
FIG. 5 shows a top view of the sofa;

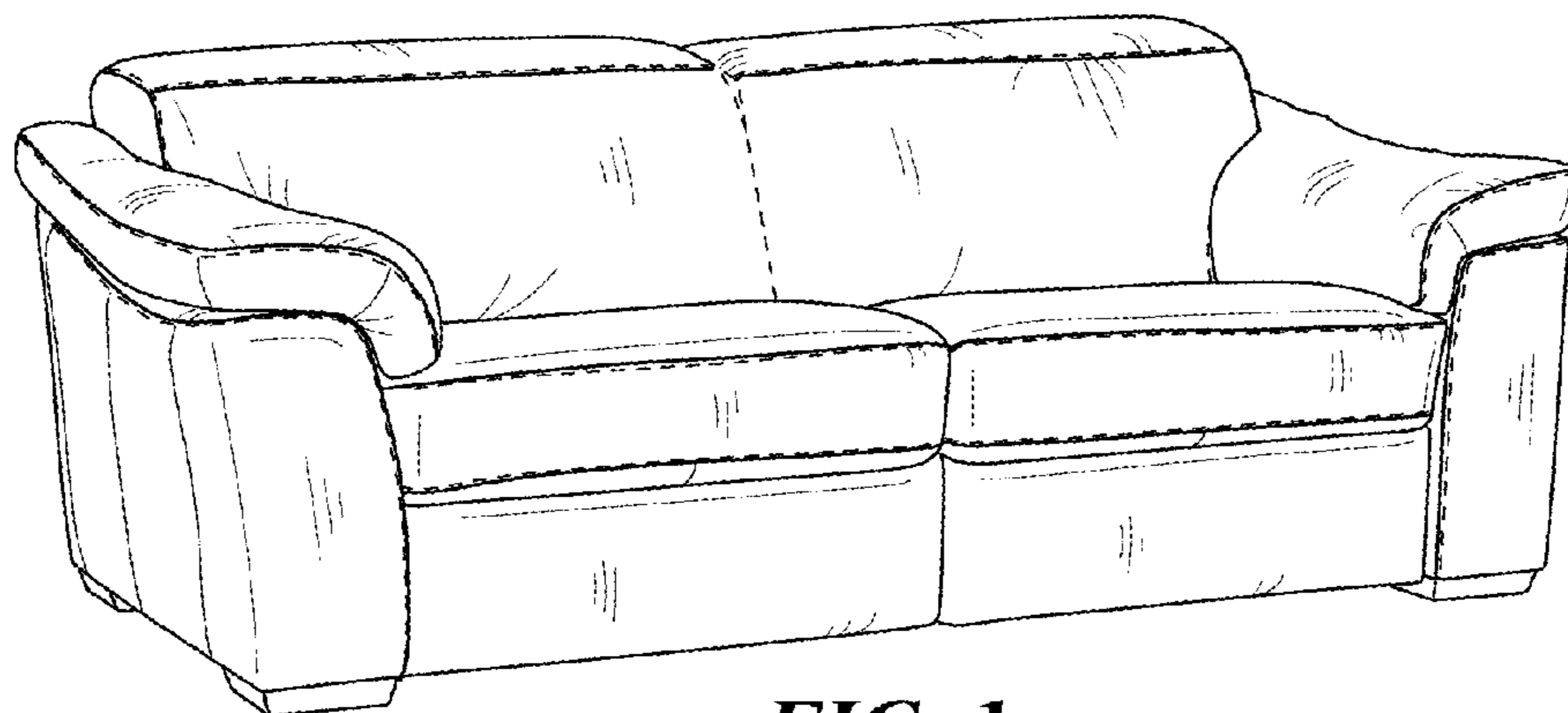

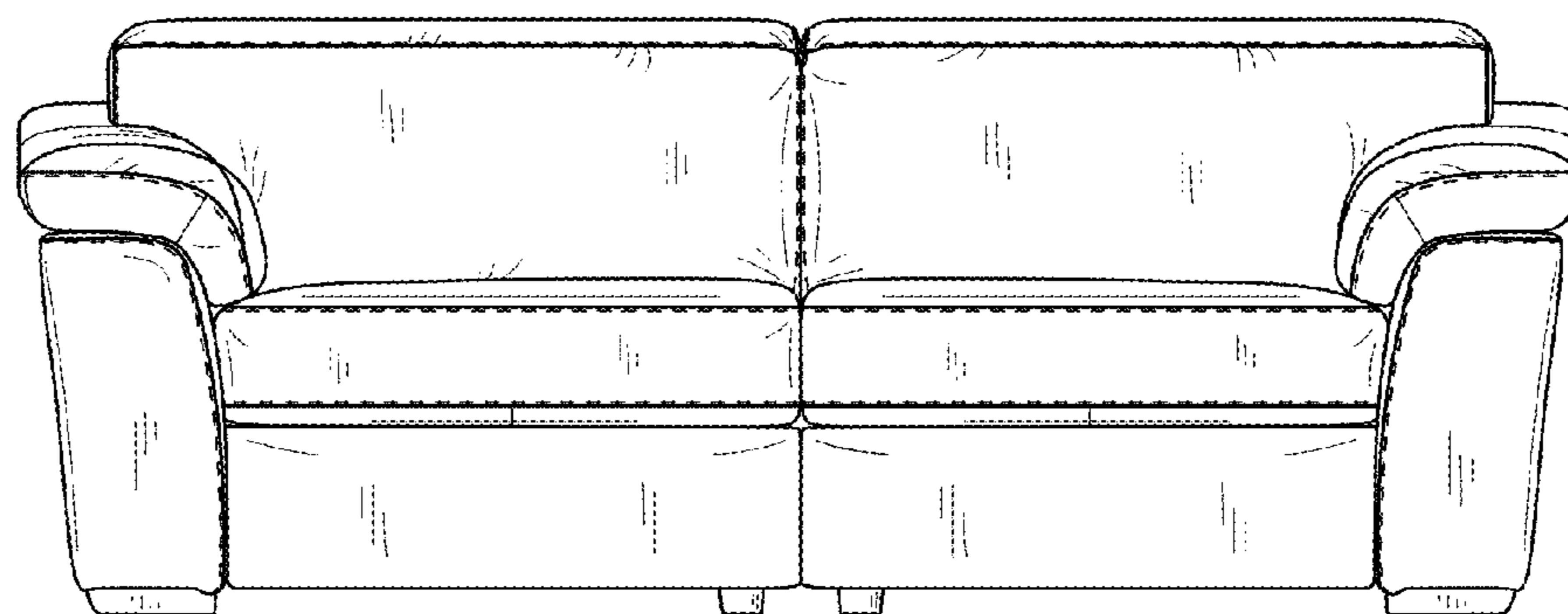

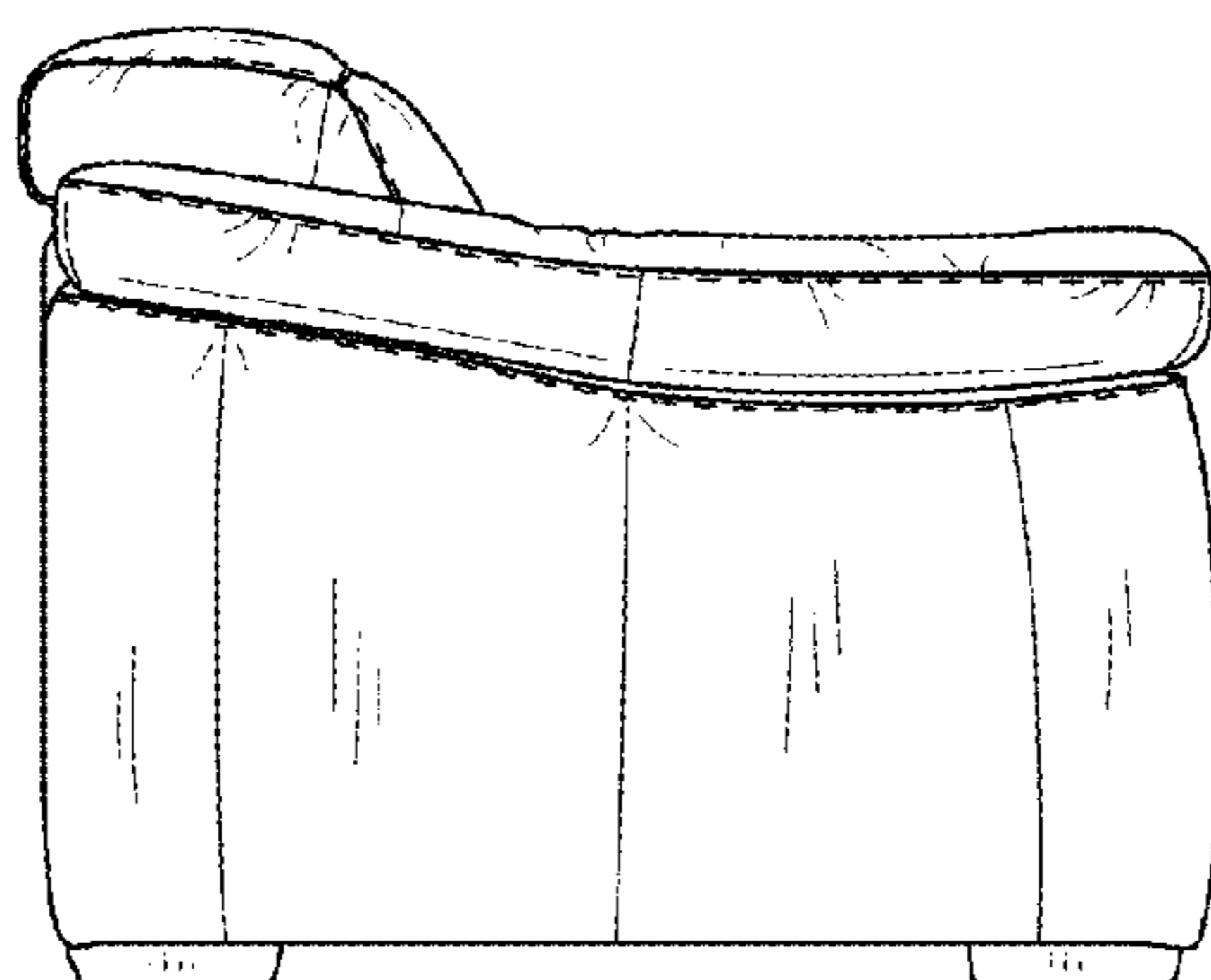

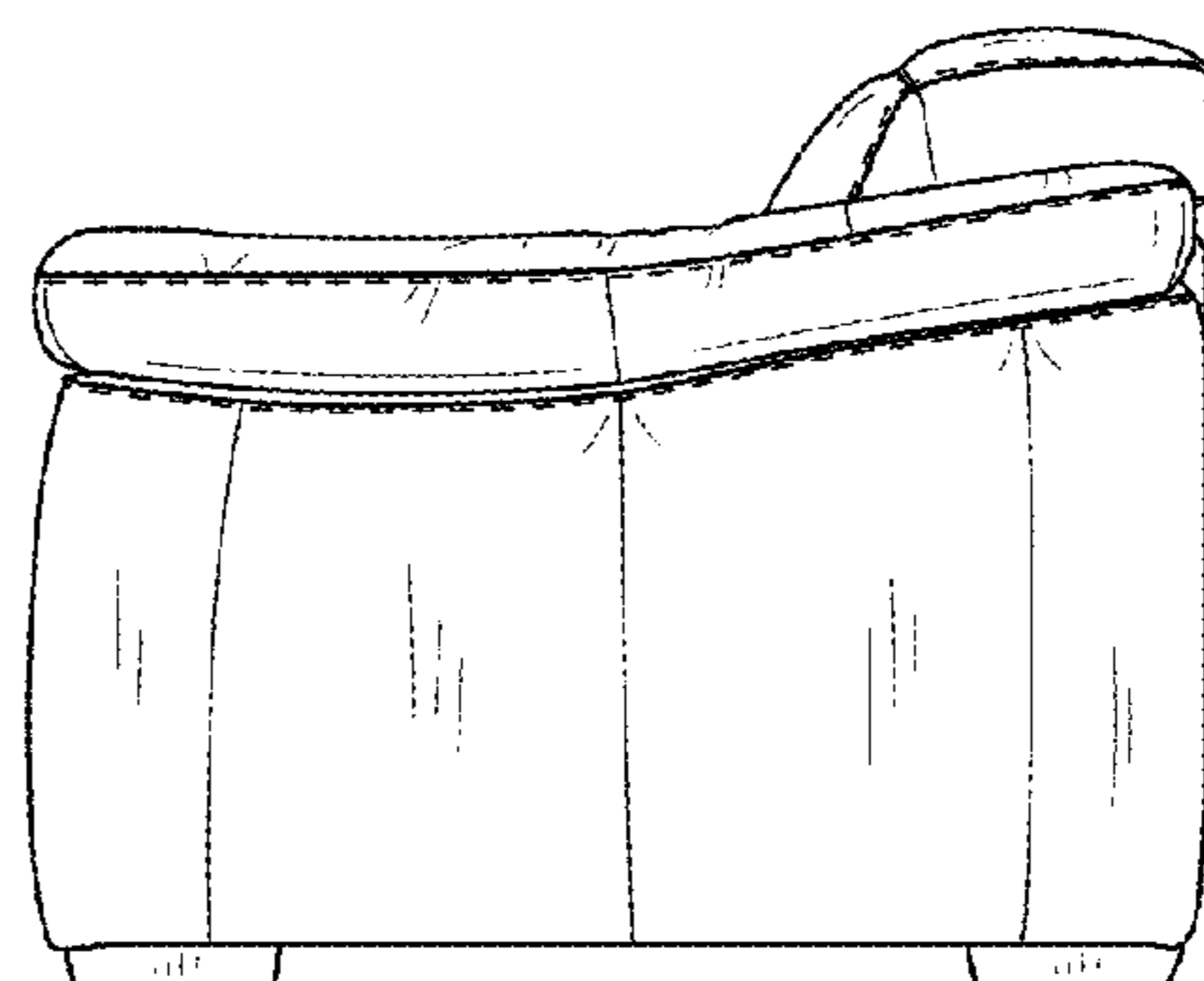

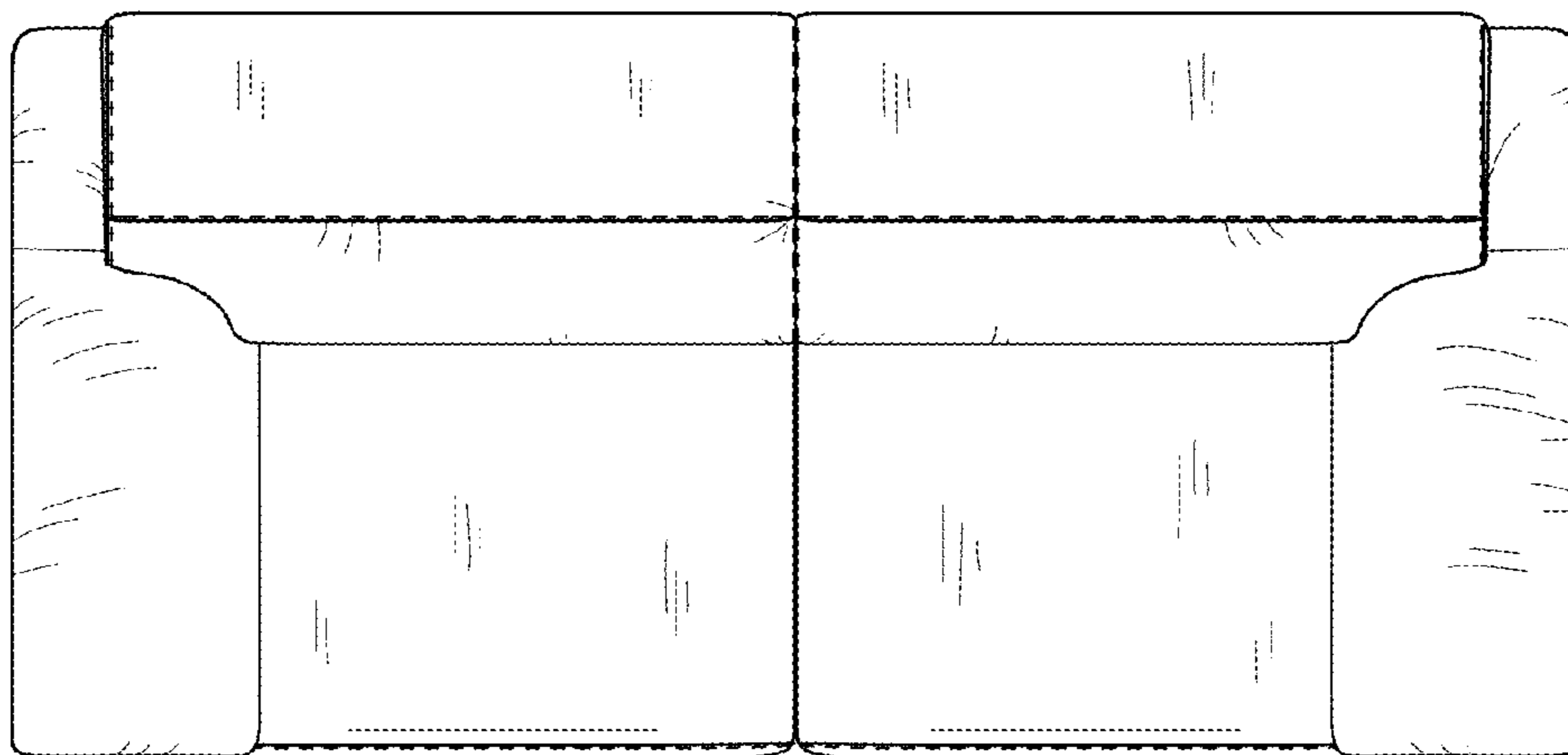

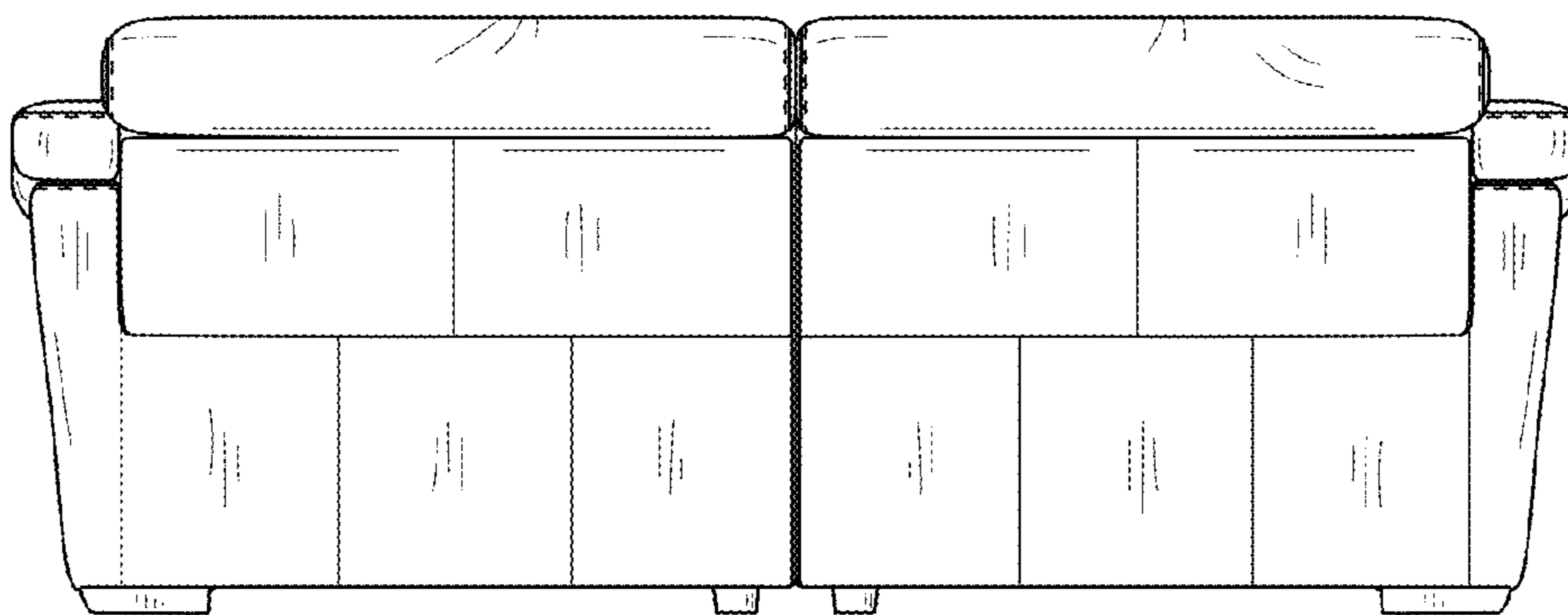

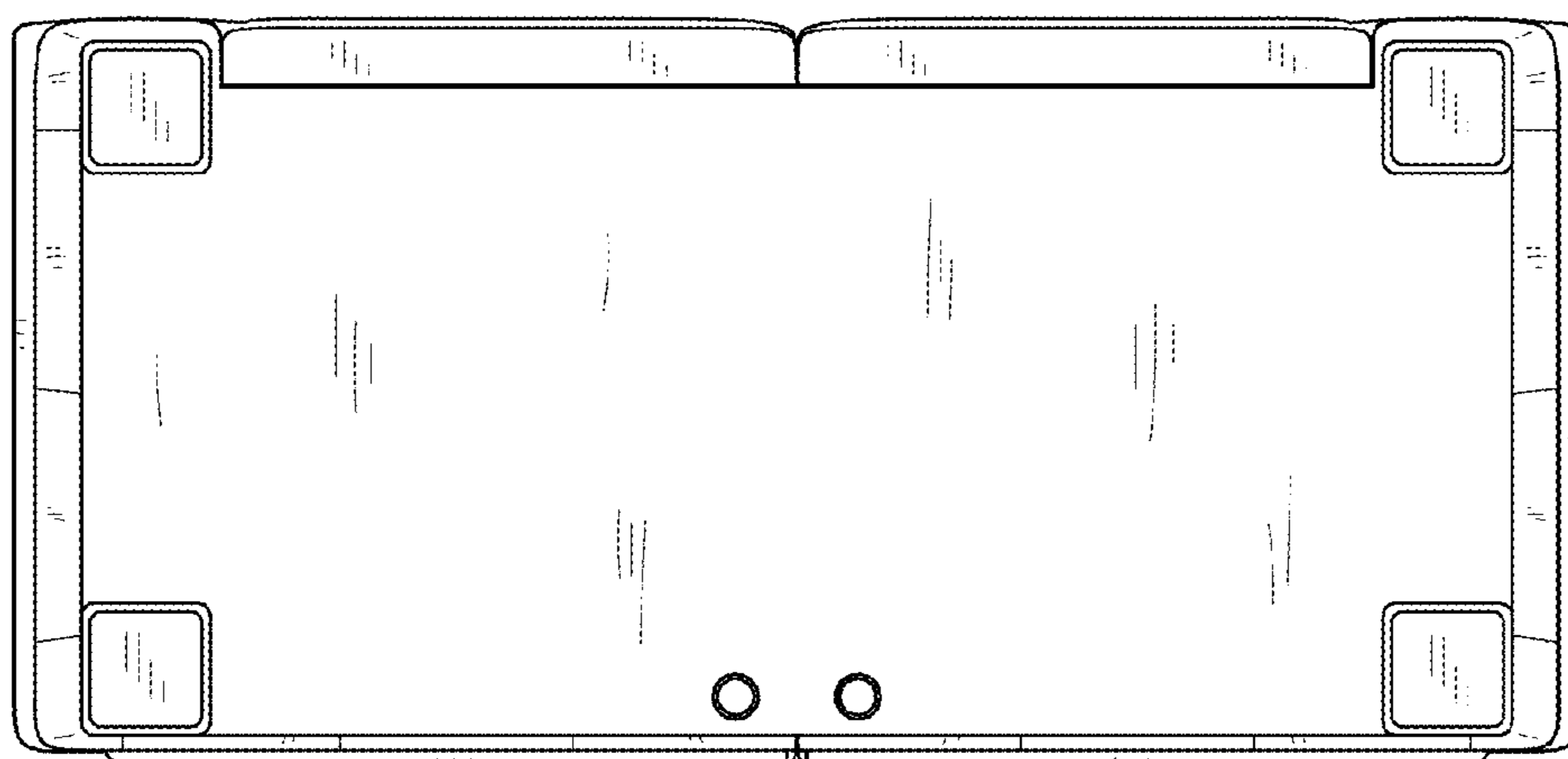
