The ornamental design for a headlamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view embodying the inventive design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary top view thereof, with the front portion shown removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary top view thereof, with the rear portion shown removed for ease of illustration;

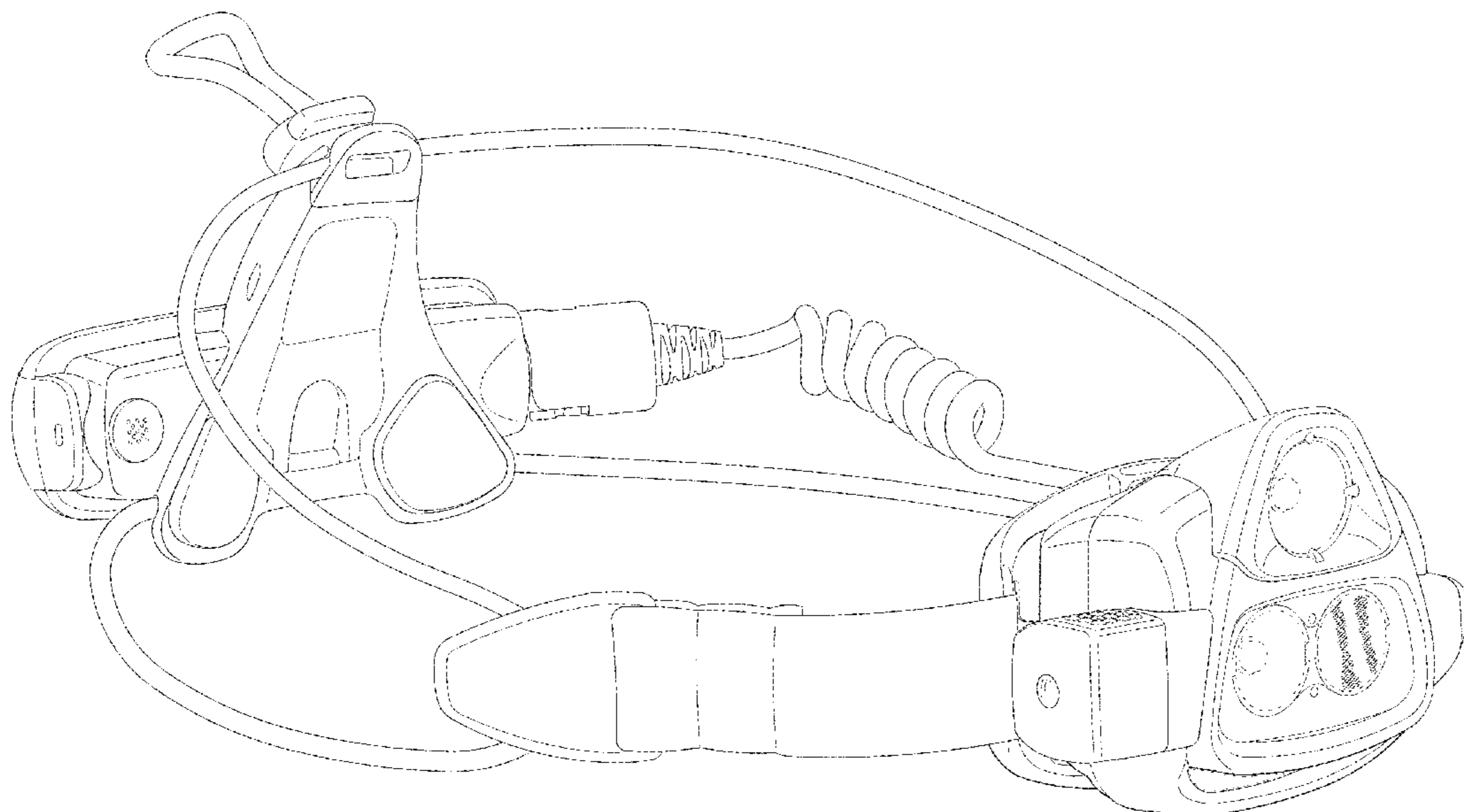
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary broken left-side view thereof, with the center portion removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary broken right-side view thereof, with the center portion removed for ease of illustration;

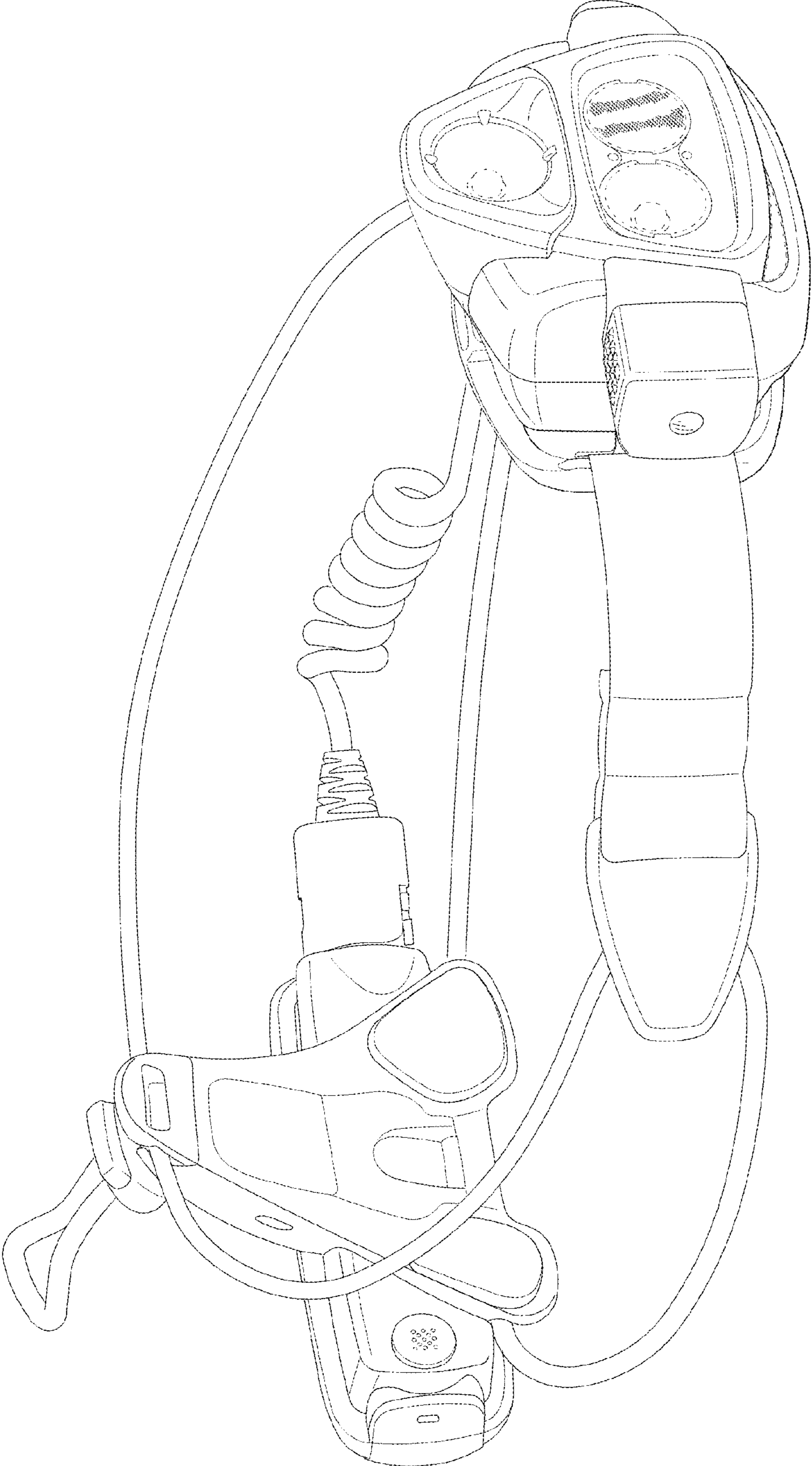

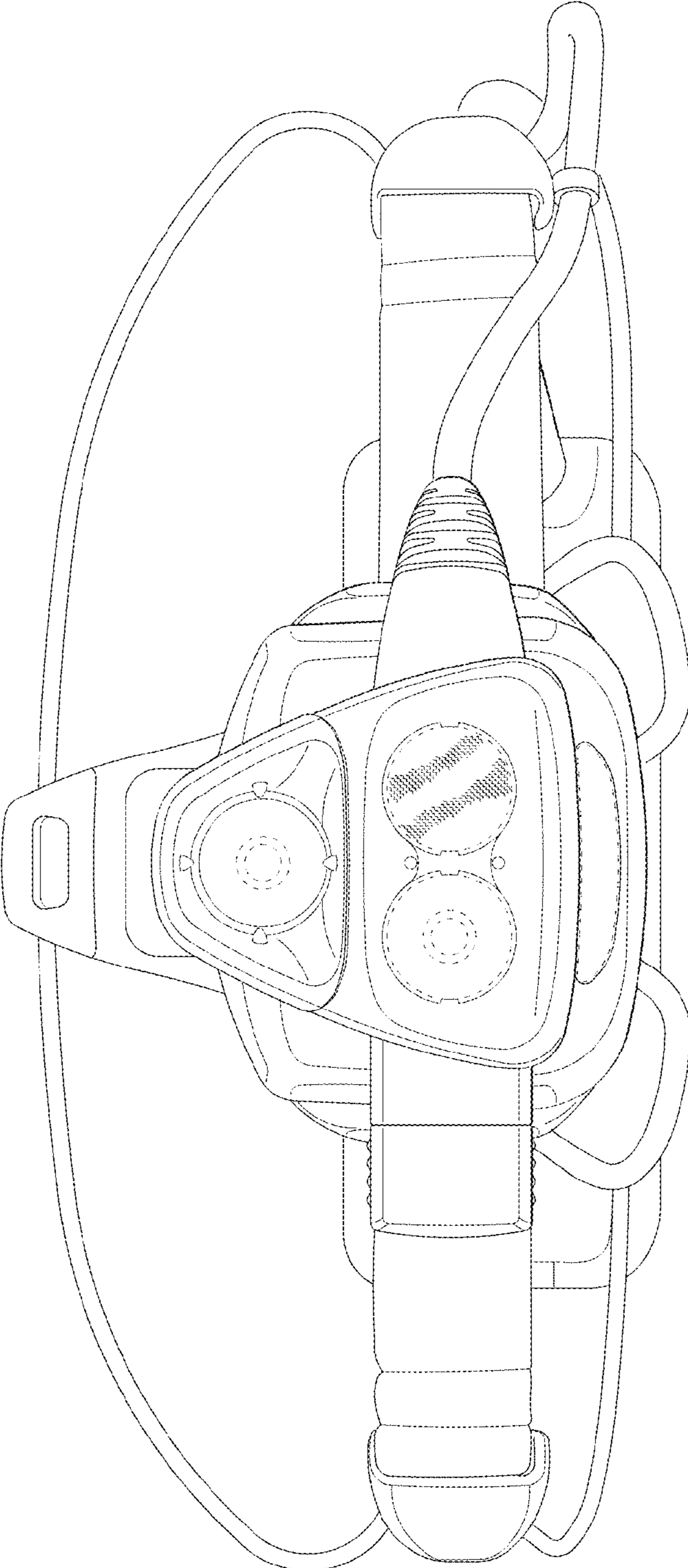

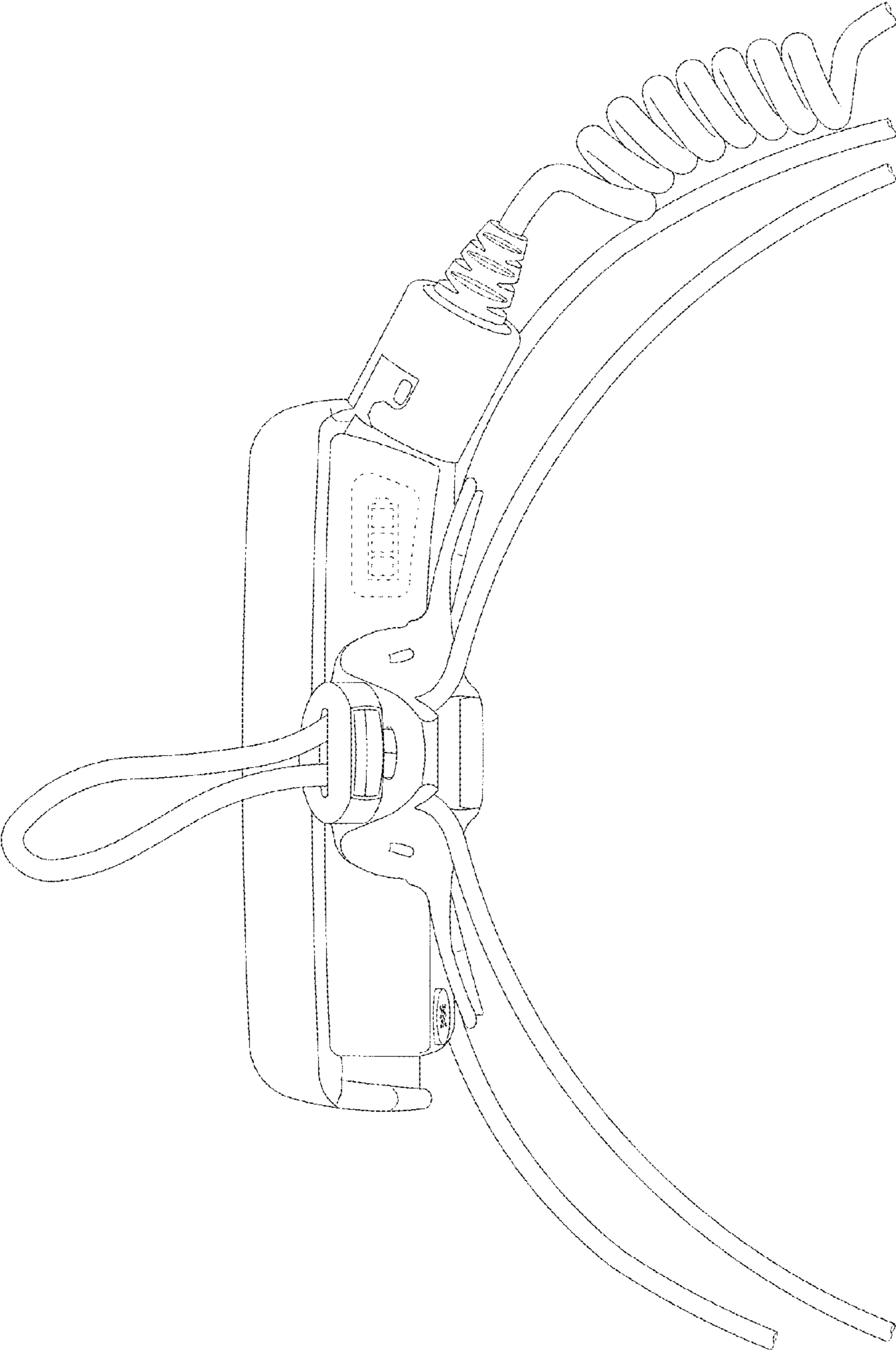

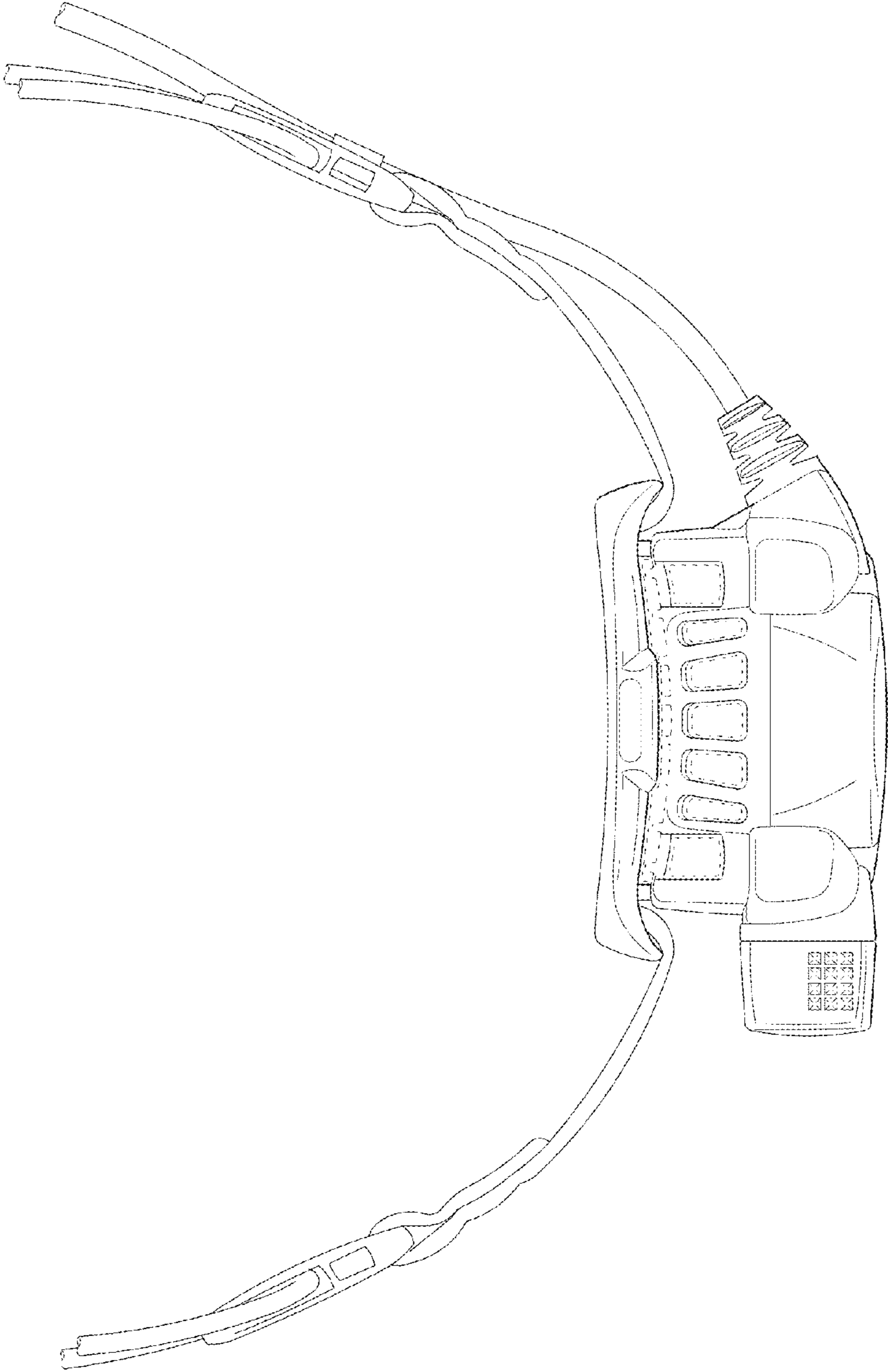

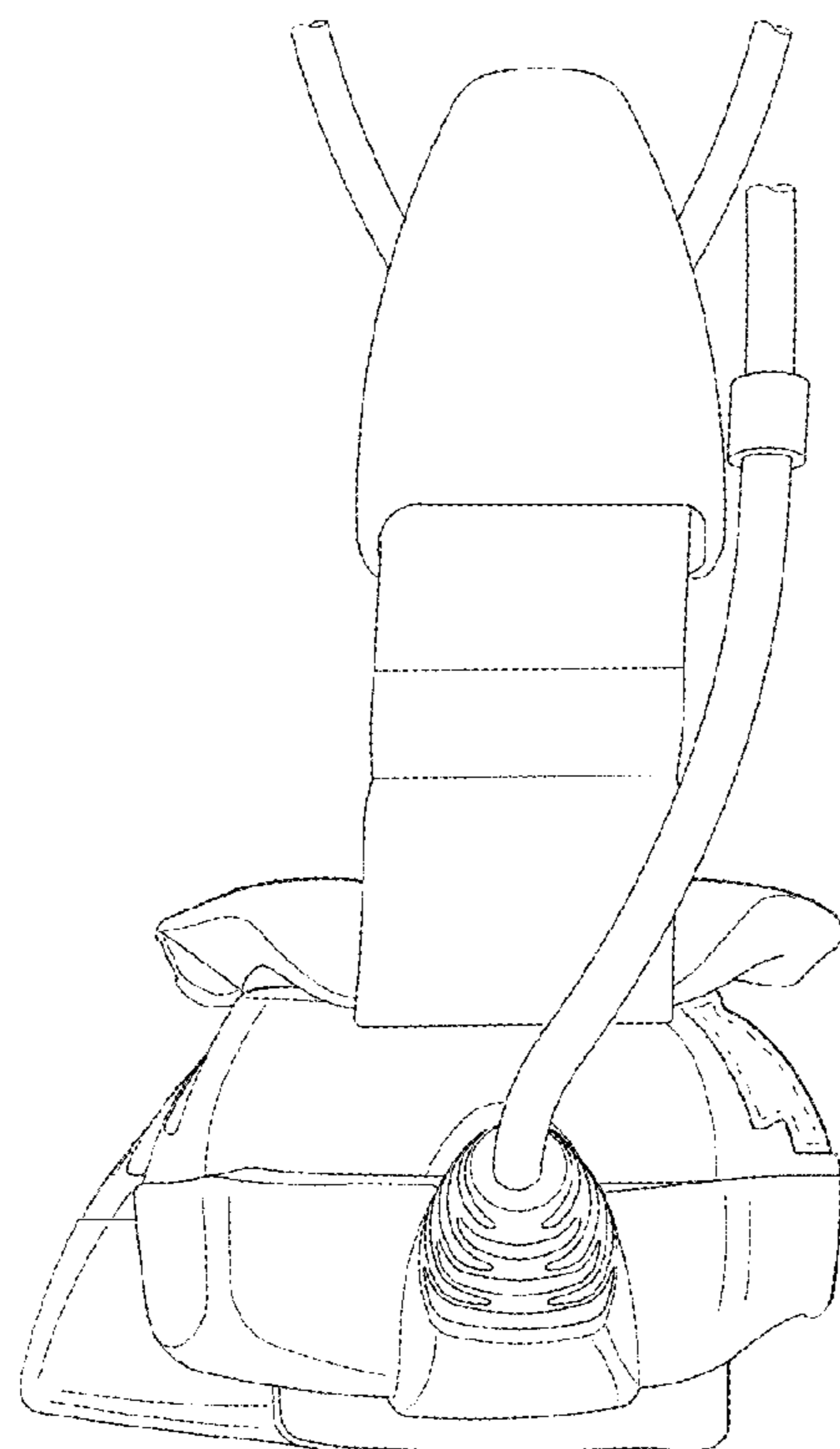
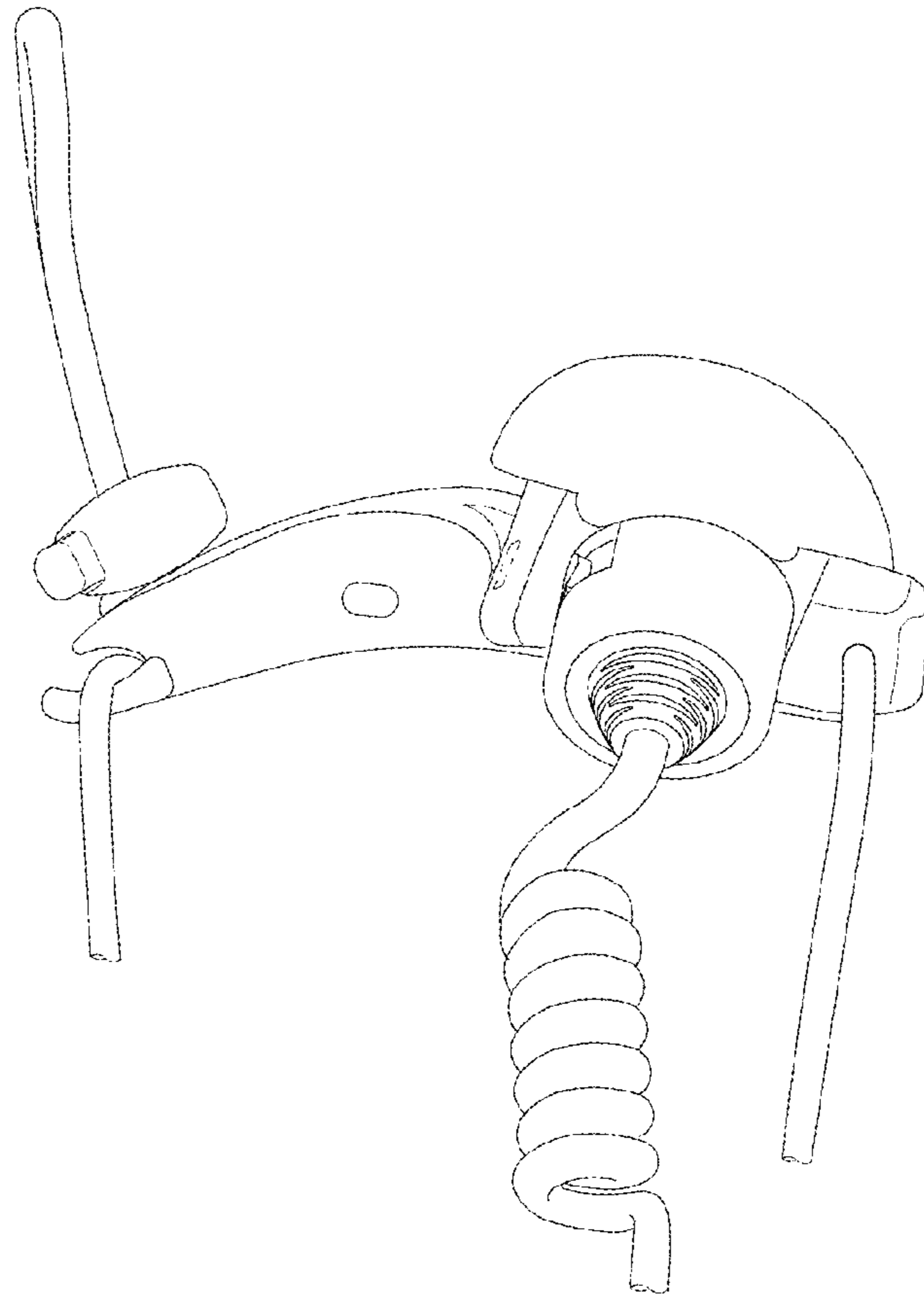

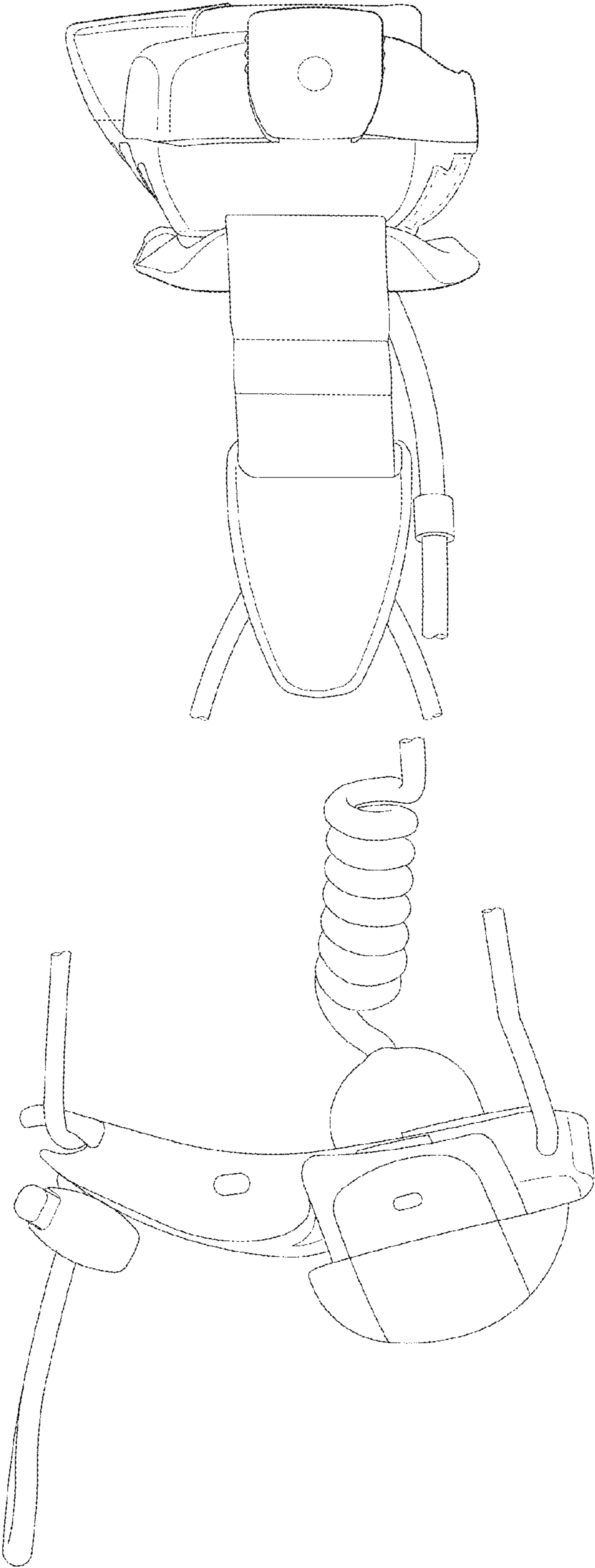

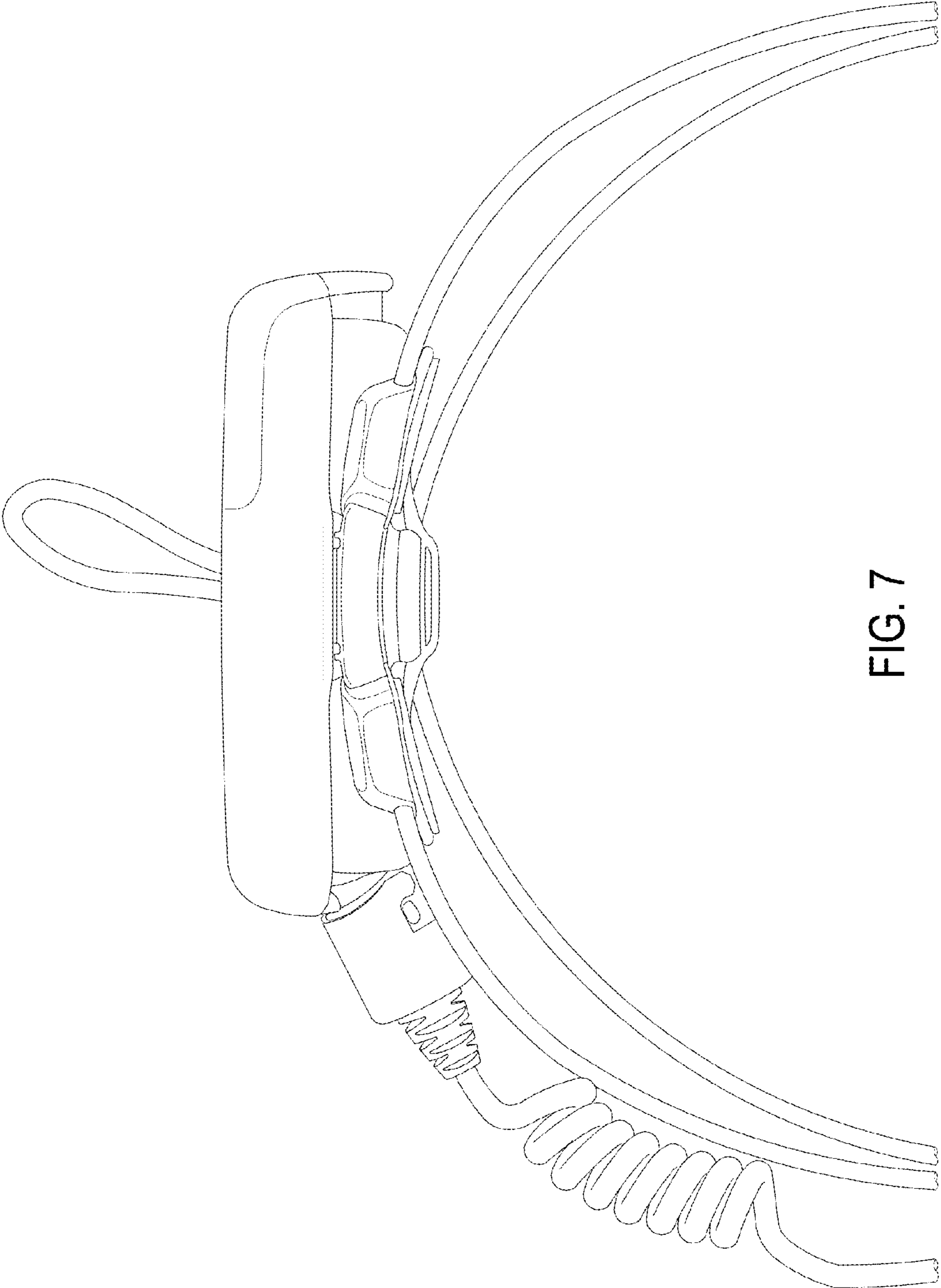

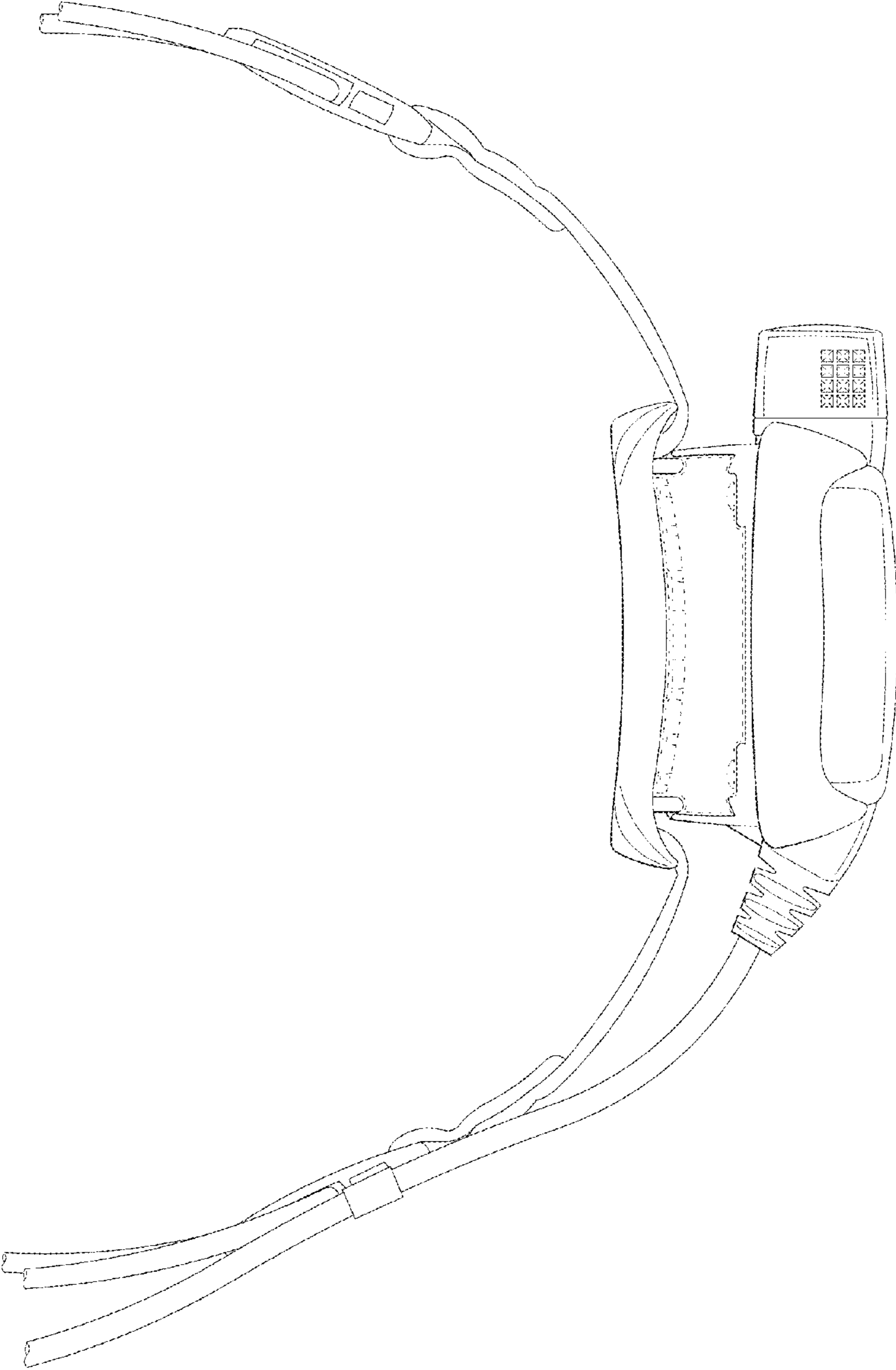
