(57) **CLAIM**

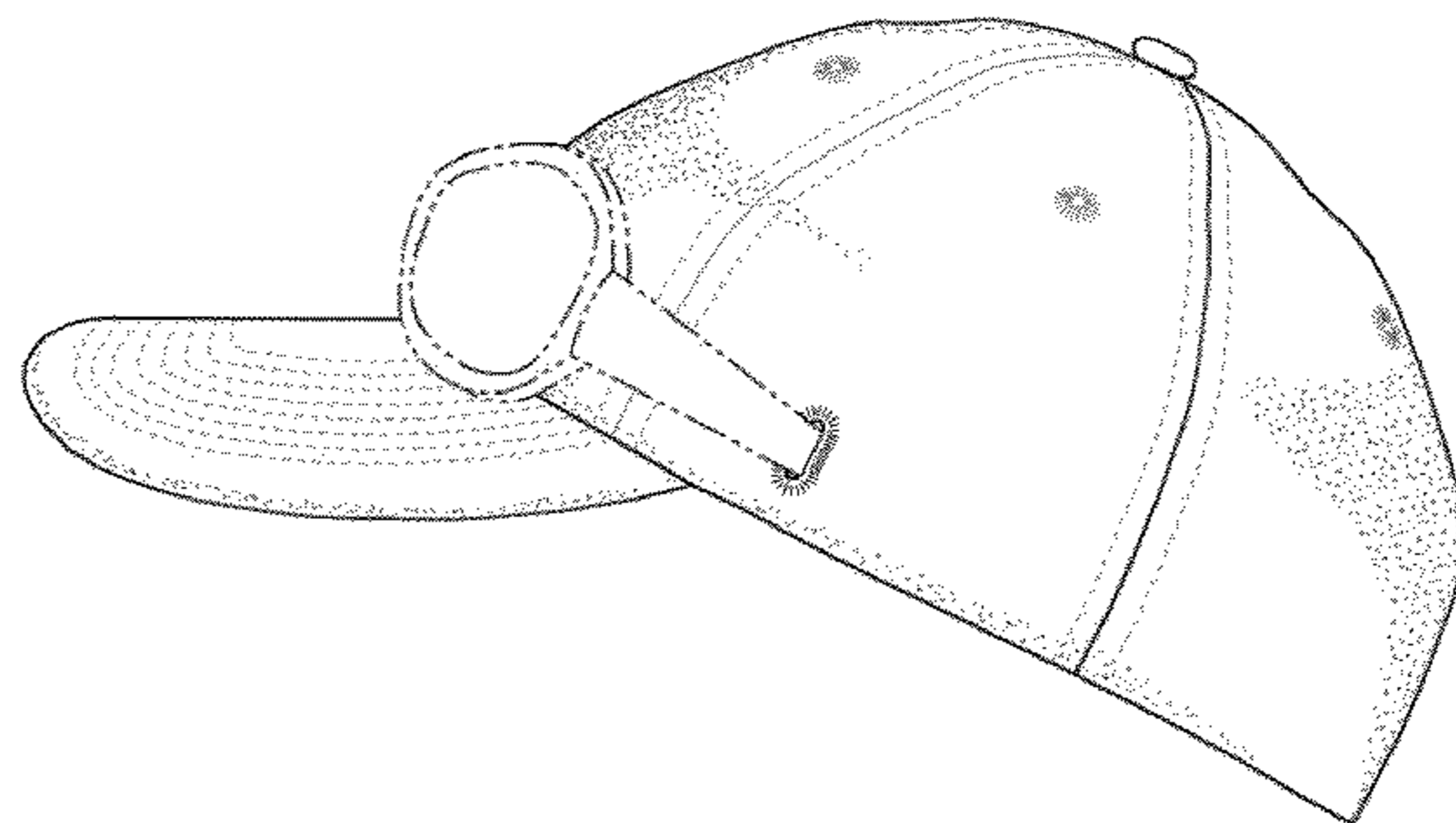
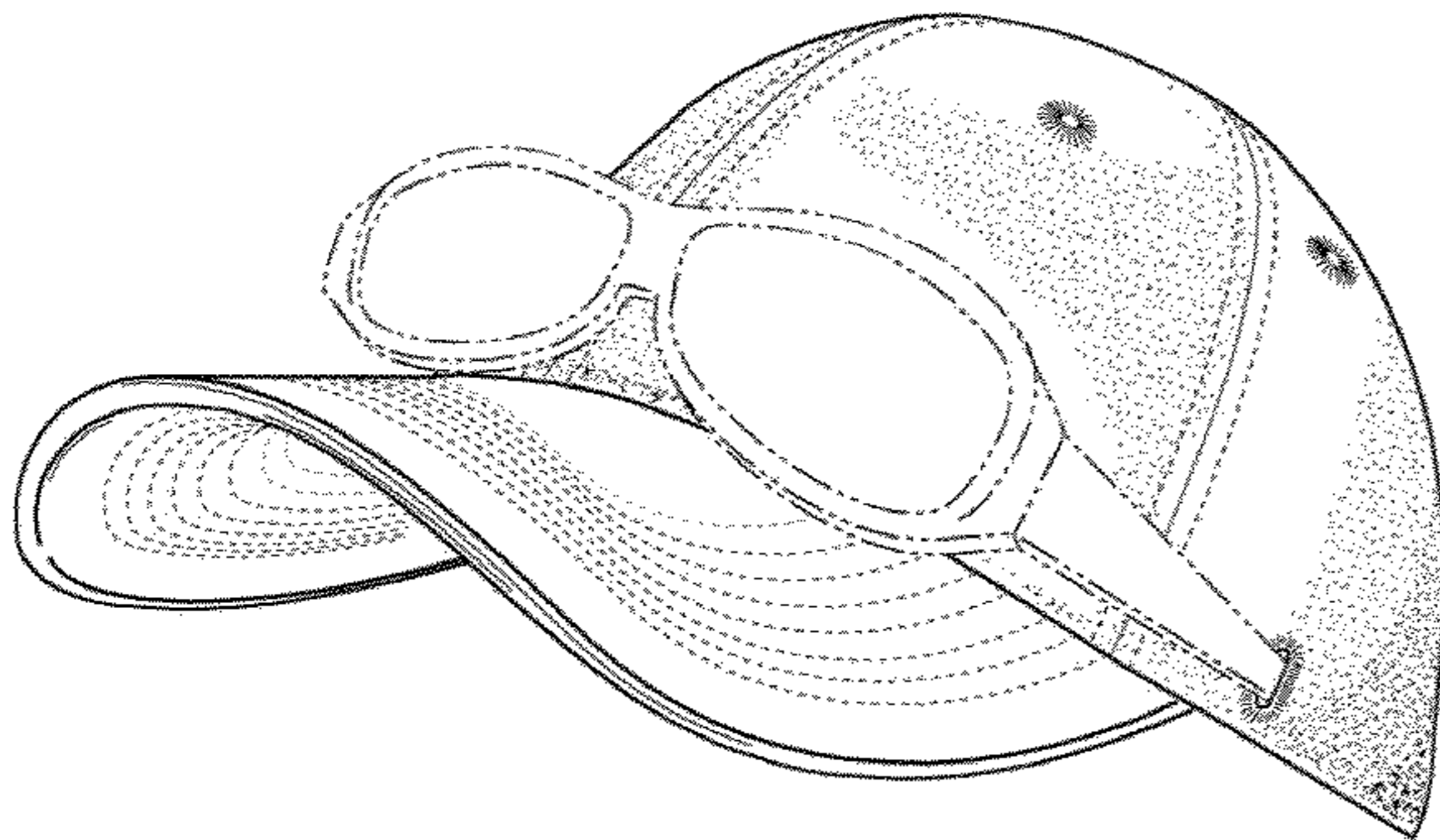
The ornamental design for headwear with sunshade visor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a frontal perspective view of headwear with sunshade visor showing the design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view of the headwear of FIG. 1 showing the design;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the headwear of FIG. 1 showing the design;
FIG. 4 is a front view of the headwear of FIG. 1 showing the design;
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the headwear of FIG. 1 showing the design;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the headwear of FIG. 1 showing the design; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the headwear of FIG. 1 showing the design.

The features shown in broken lines on the surface of the crown and visor of the headwear are lines of stitching and form a part of the claimed design. The sunglasses shown in long-short-short broken lines are environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design. The circular shape shown in long-short-short broken lines in FIGS. 4 and 7 illustrate the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof.

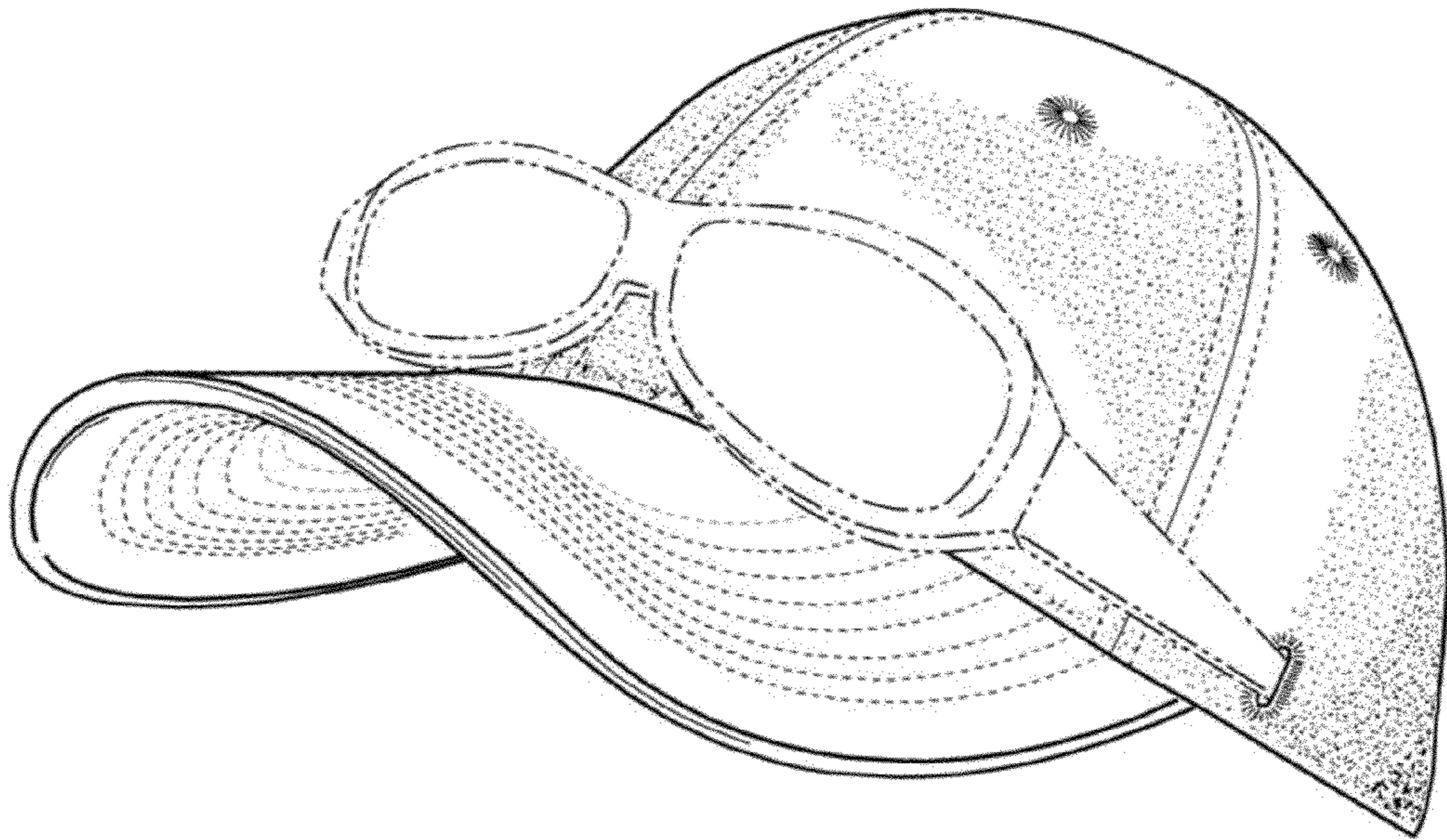

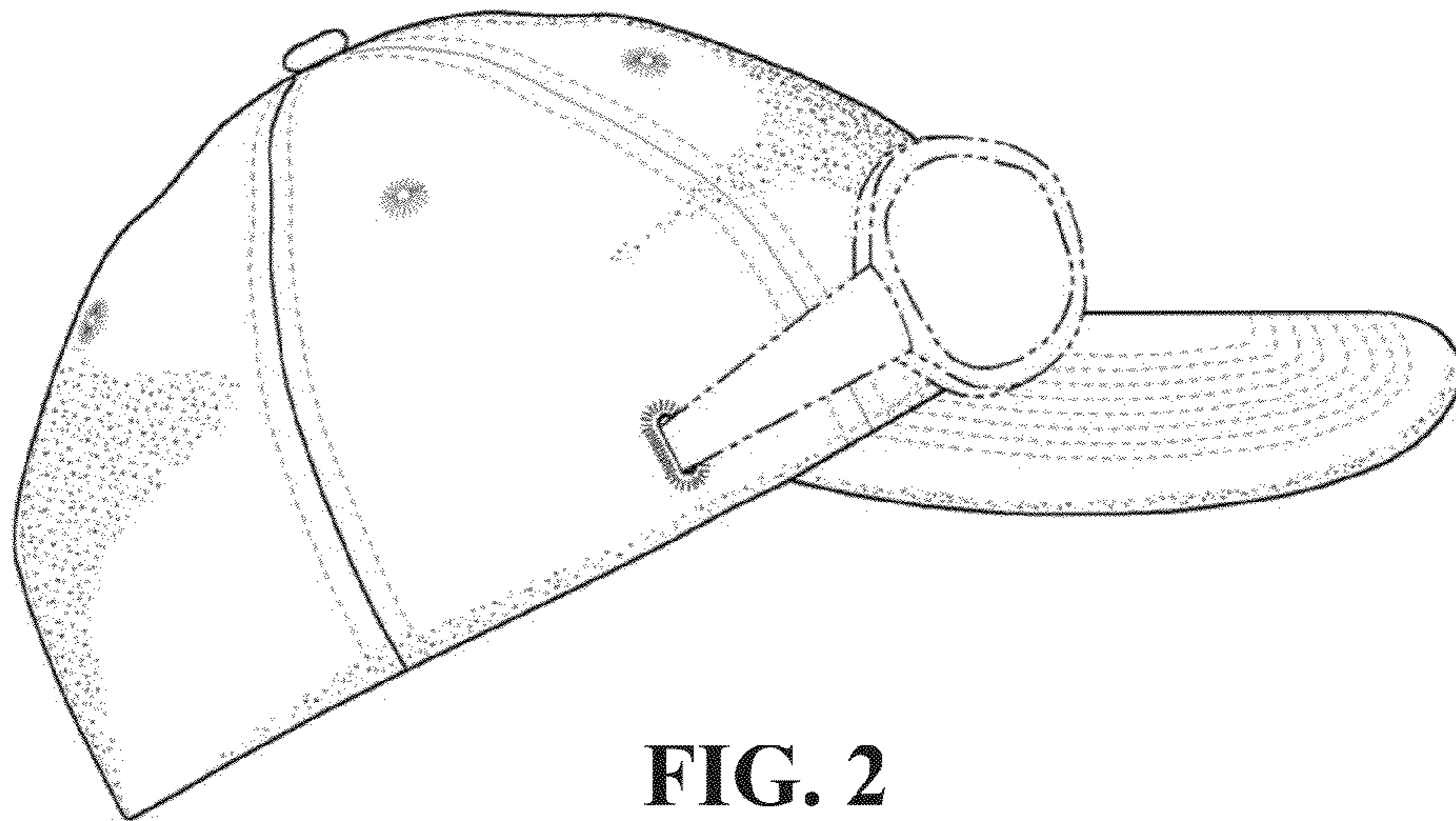

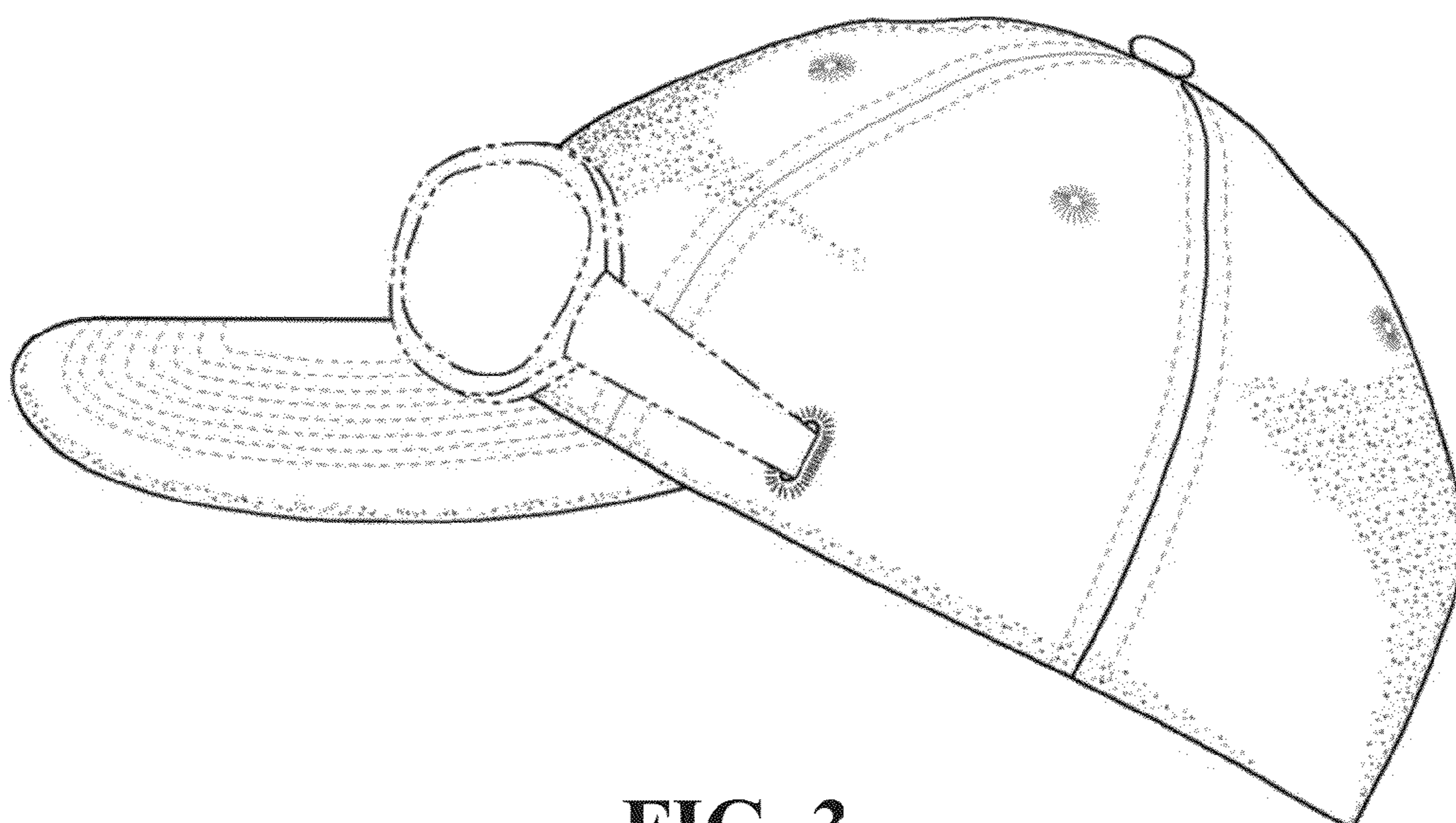

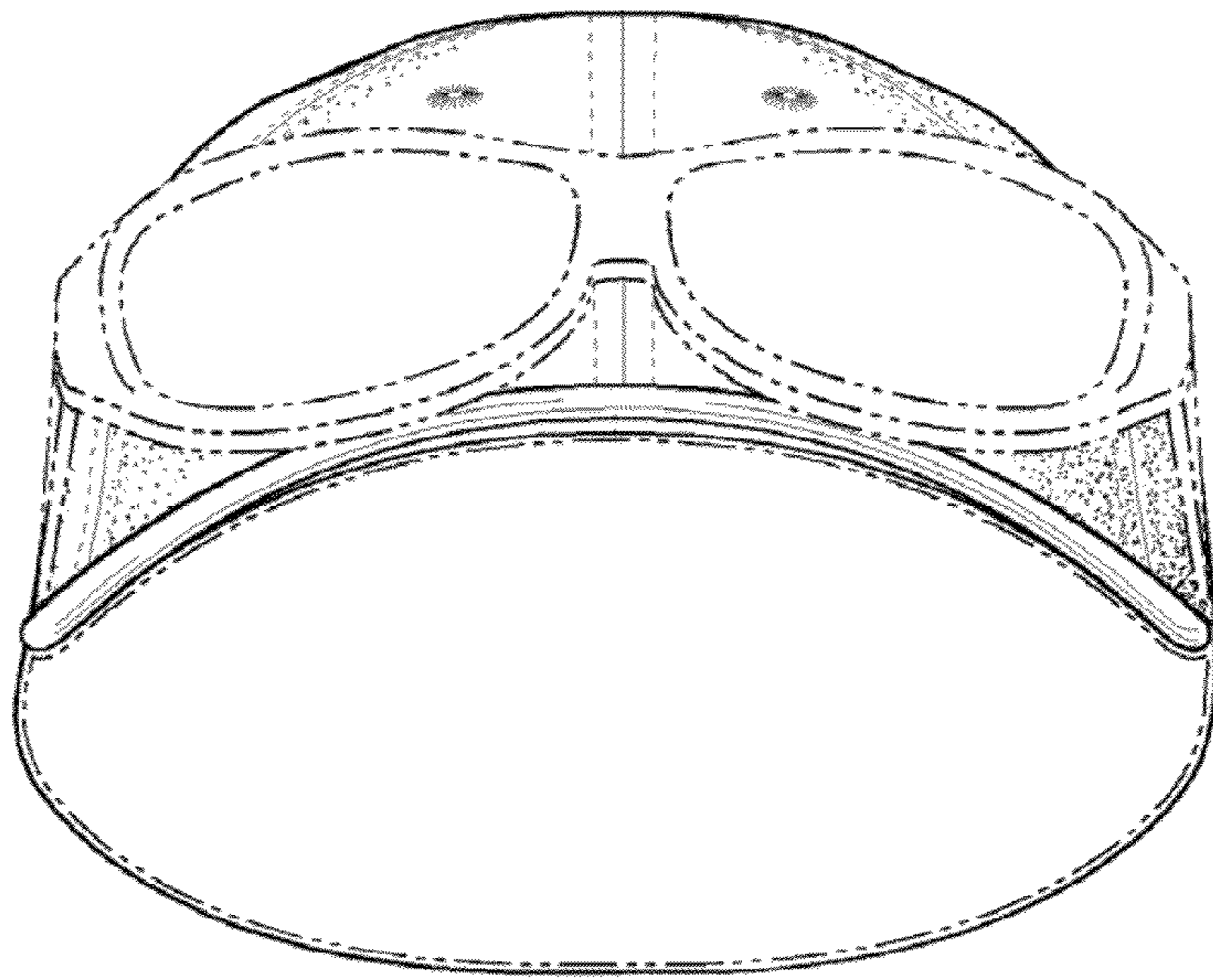

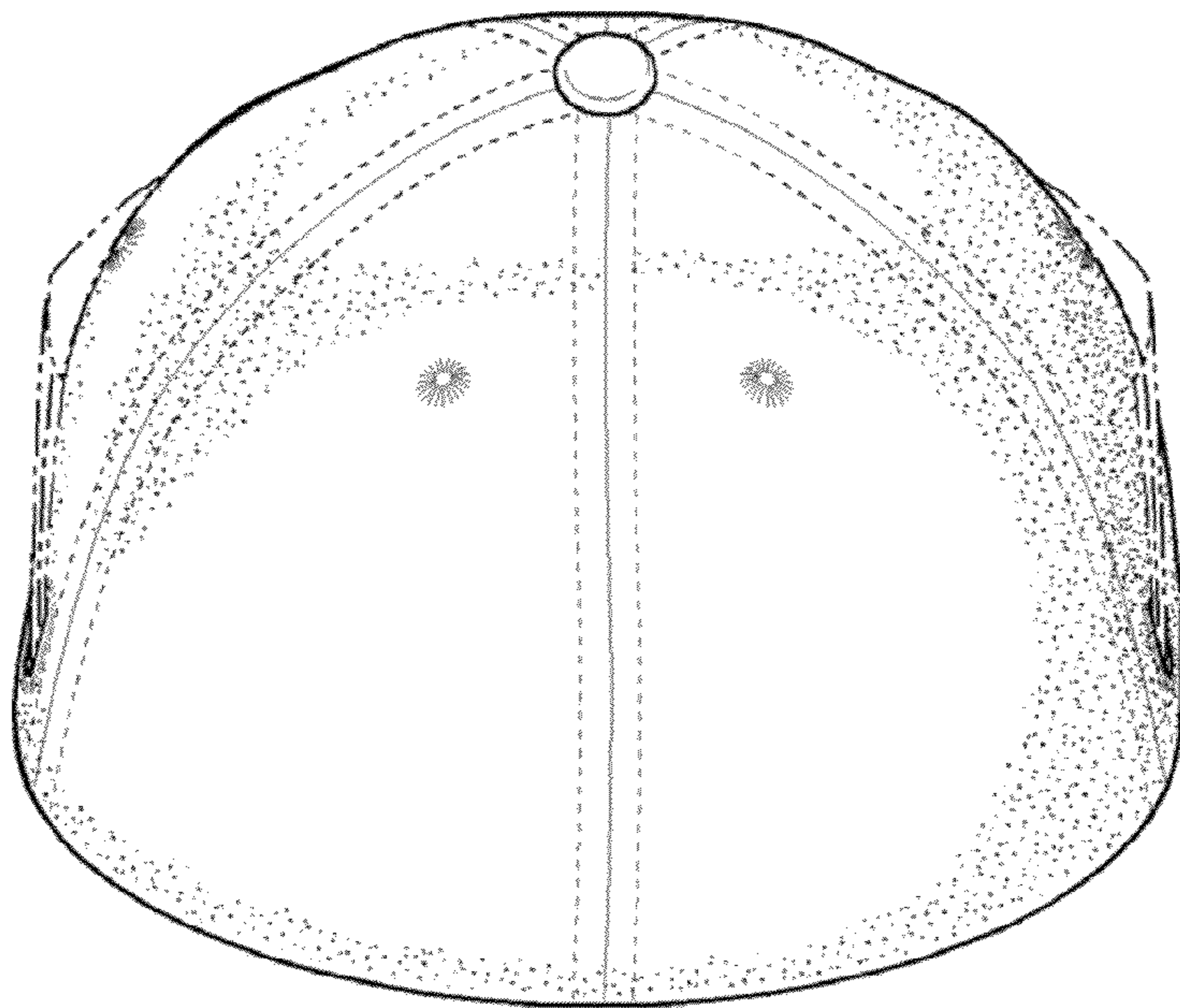

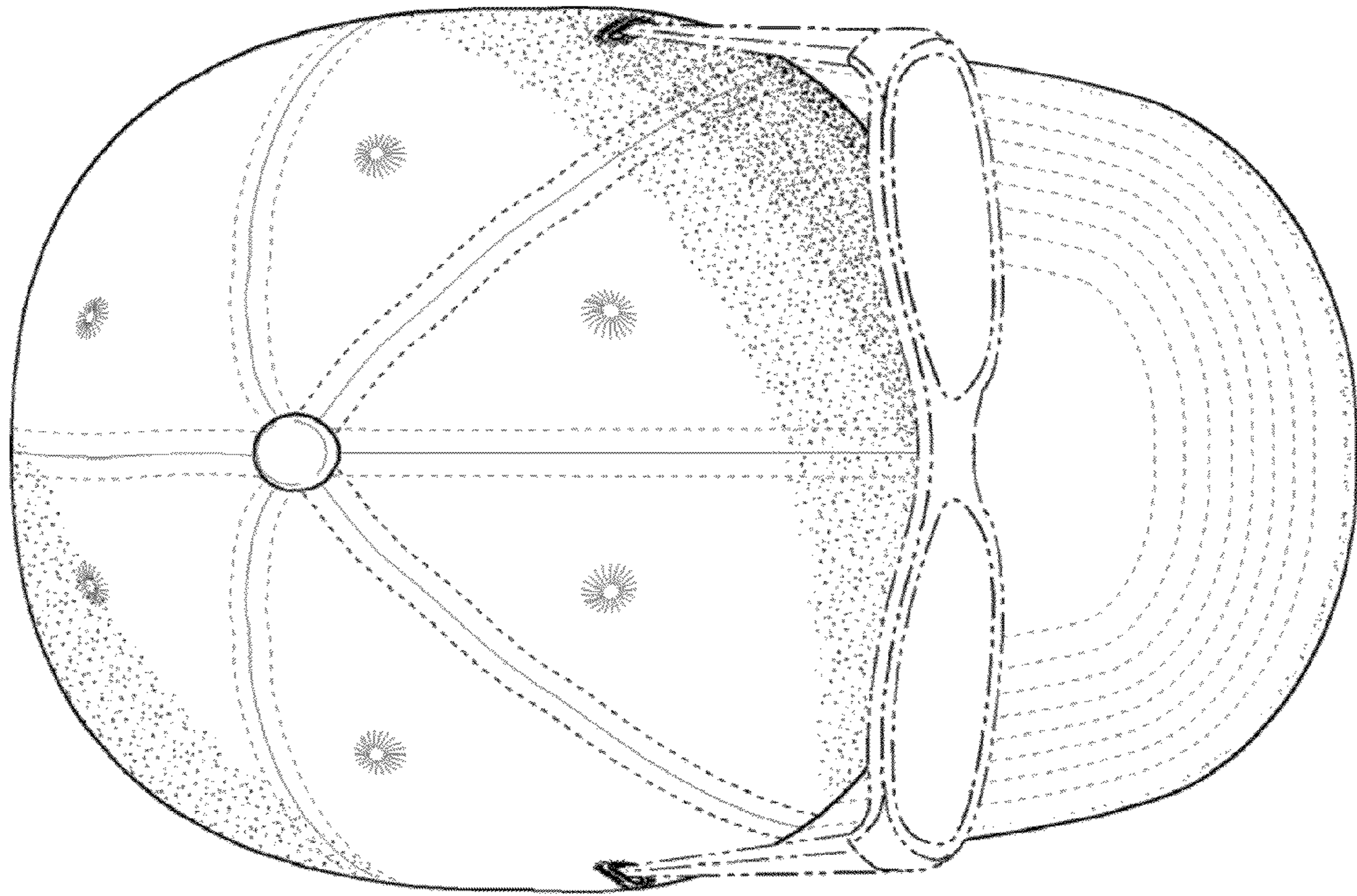

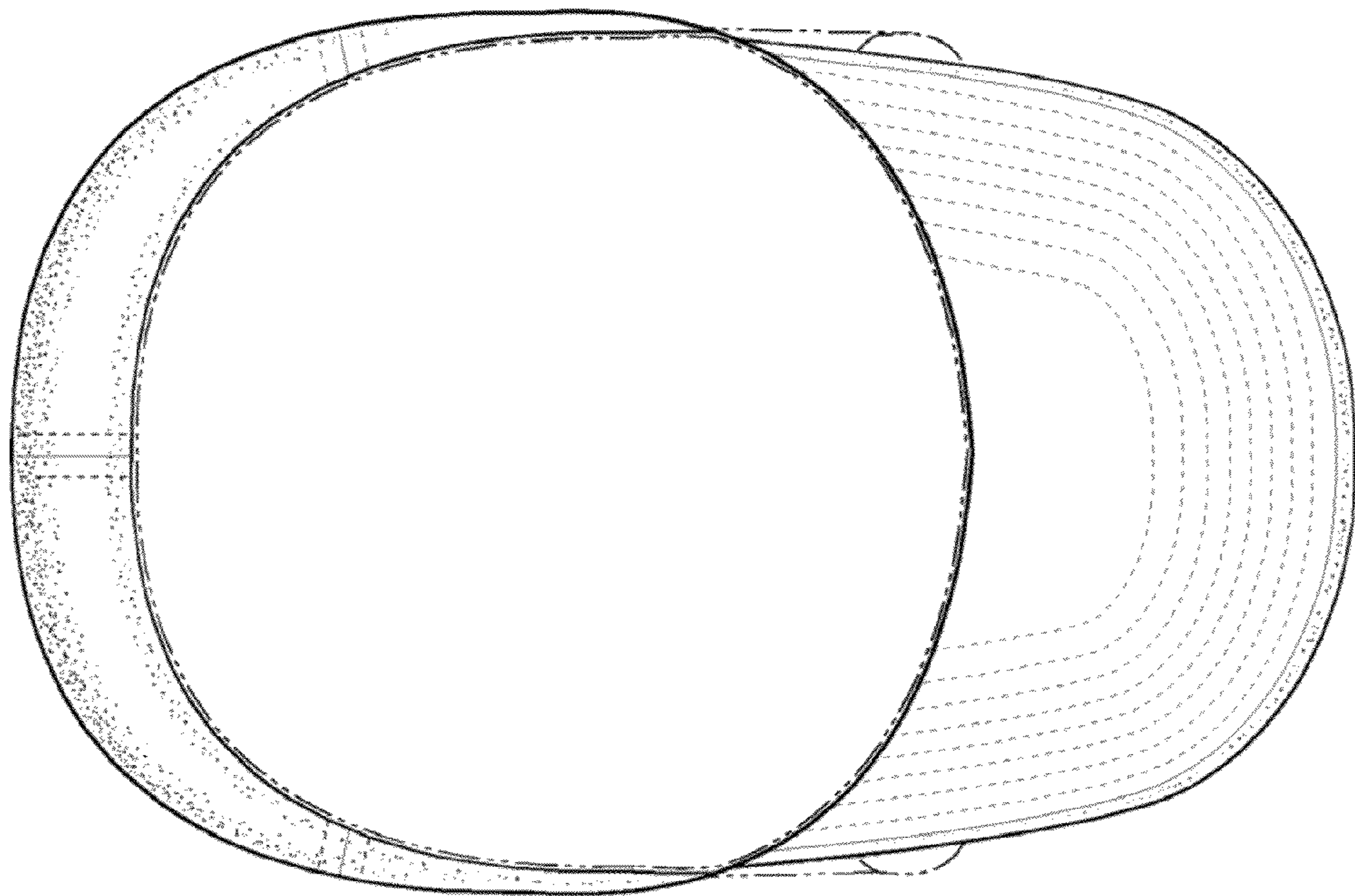
