(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a yoga mat with pattern, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the yoga mat with pattern taken from the front and one side with a detail portion of the design surrounded by dash double dot broken lines and represented in FIG. 2; “dash double dot” lines;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged detail view of the portion of the design numbered 2 from FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

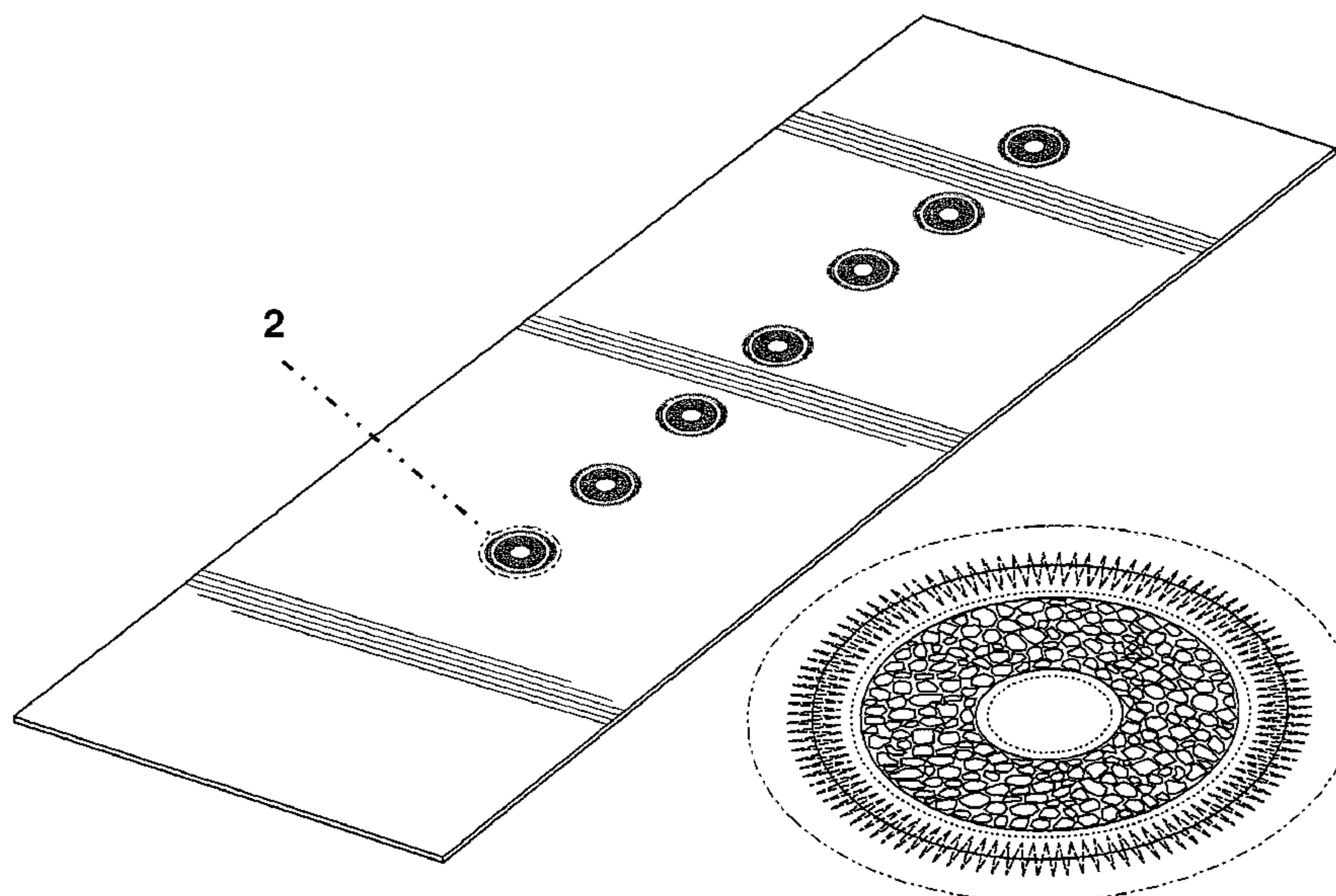
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 9 is an enlarged detail view of the portion of the design numbered “9” from FIG. 8.

The broken lines in the drawing represent portions of the yoga mat with pattern that are not claimed. The dash double dot broken lines represent the boundaries of the details and form no part of the claimed design.

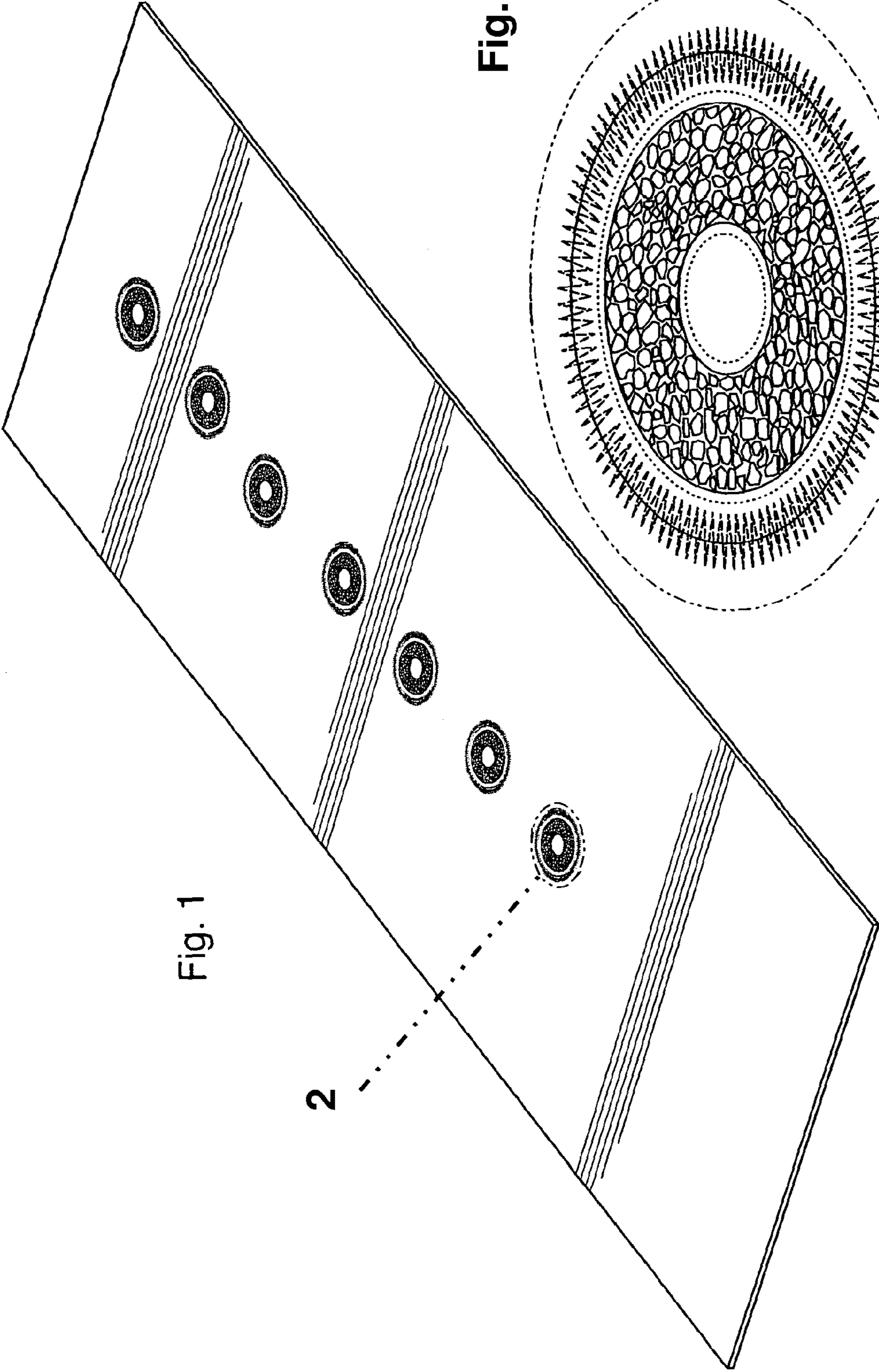

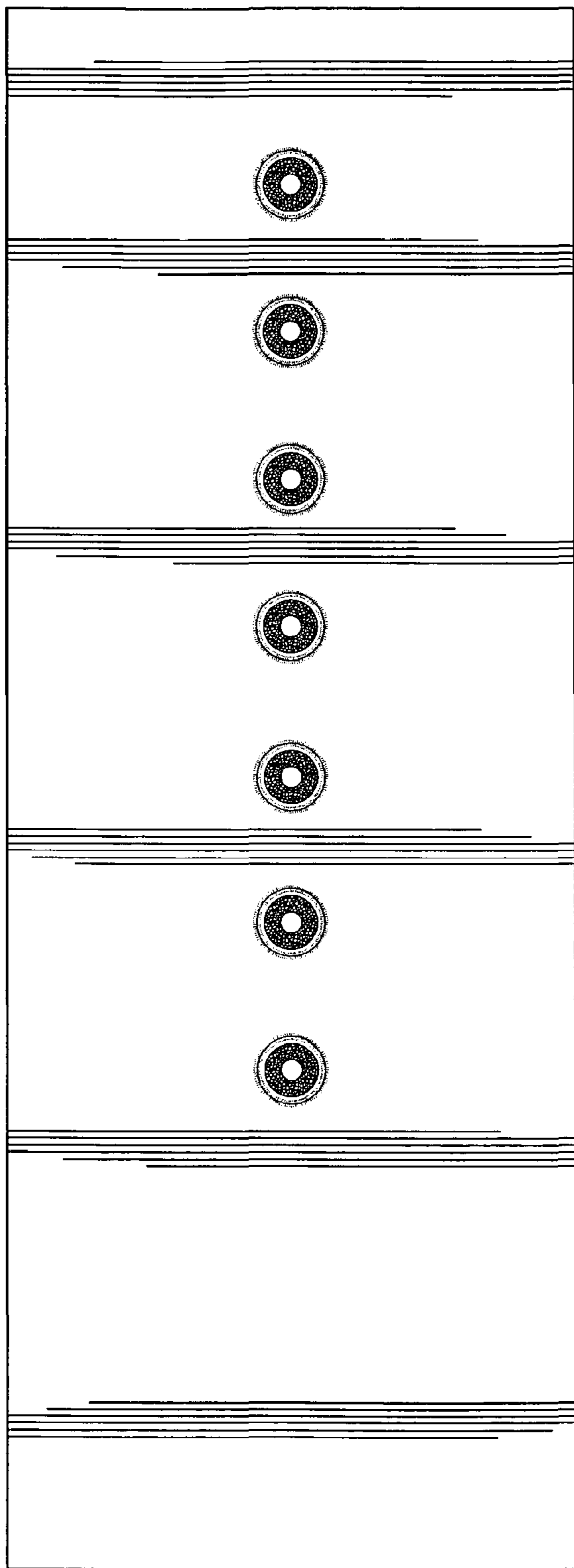

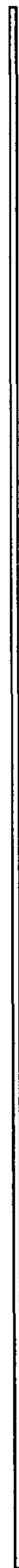

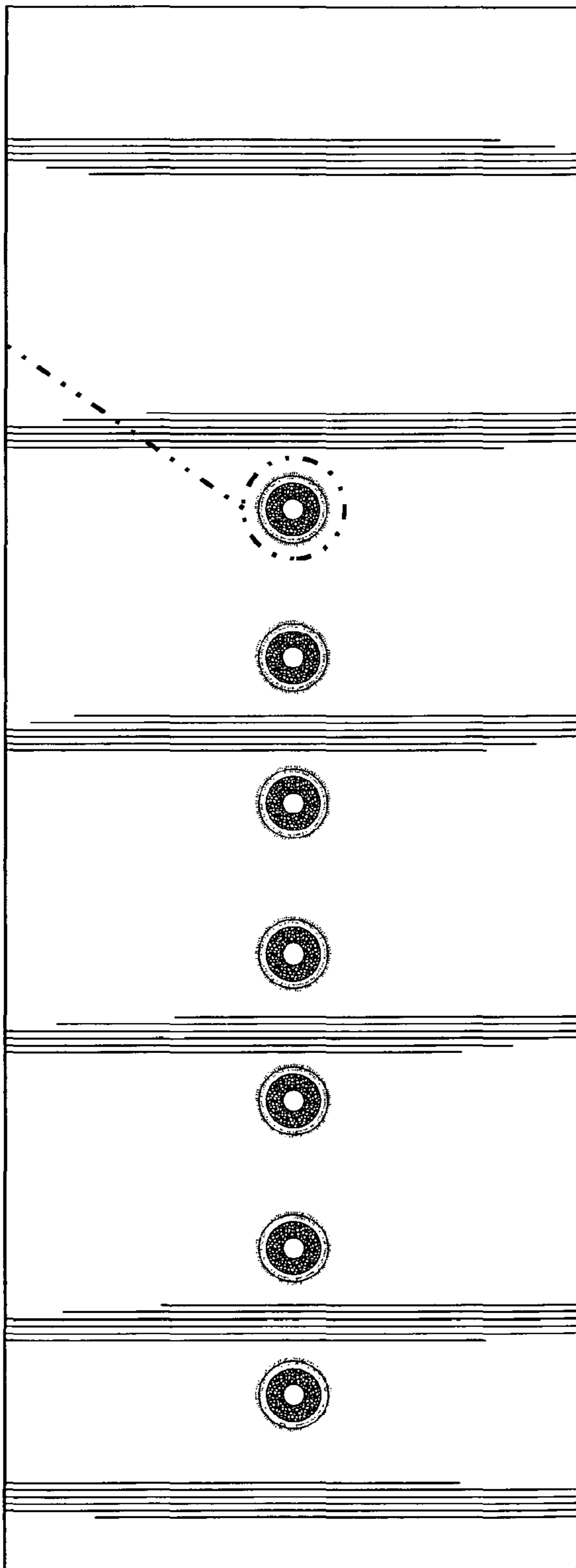

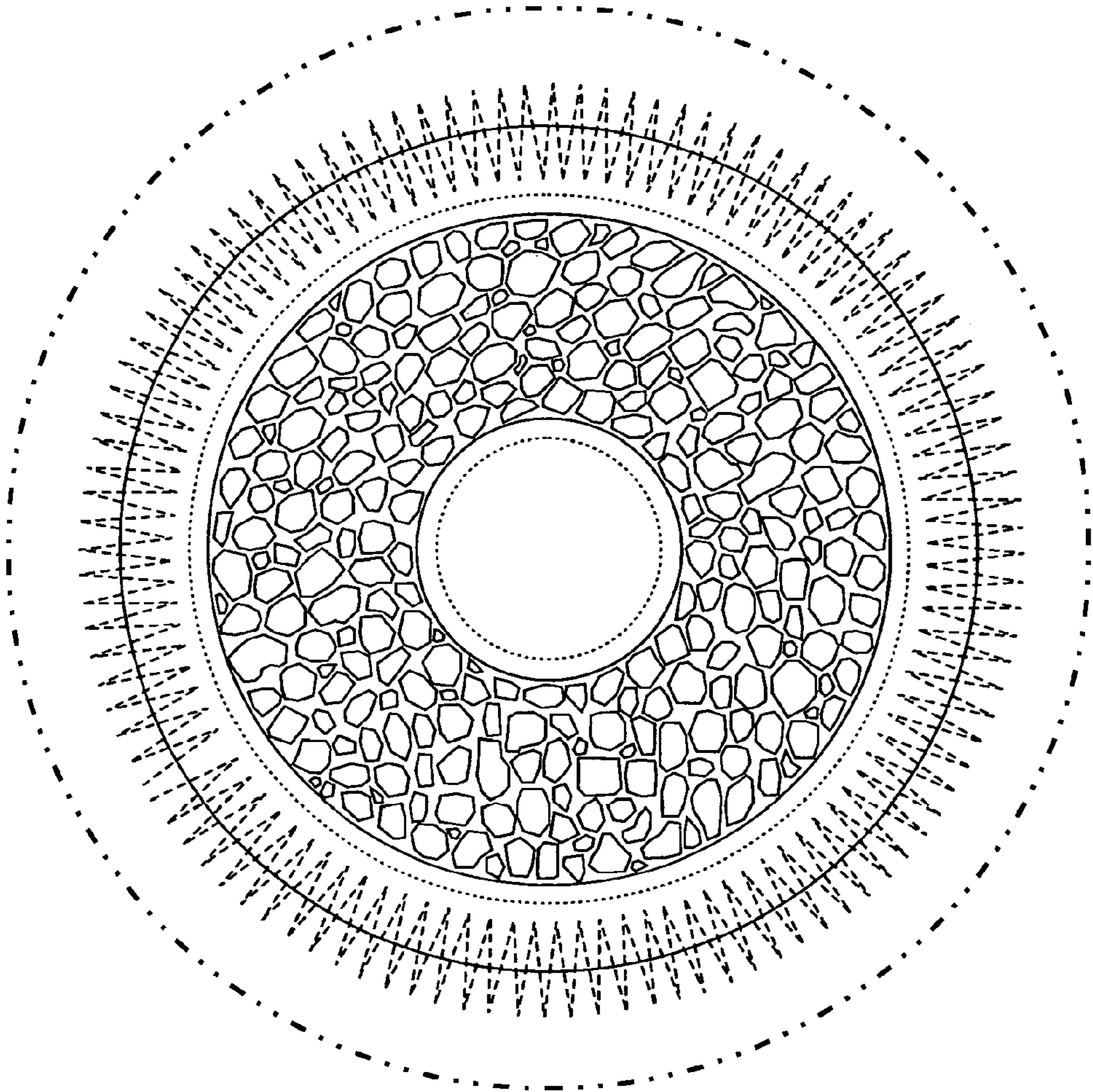
