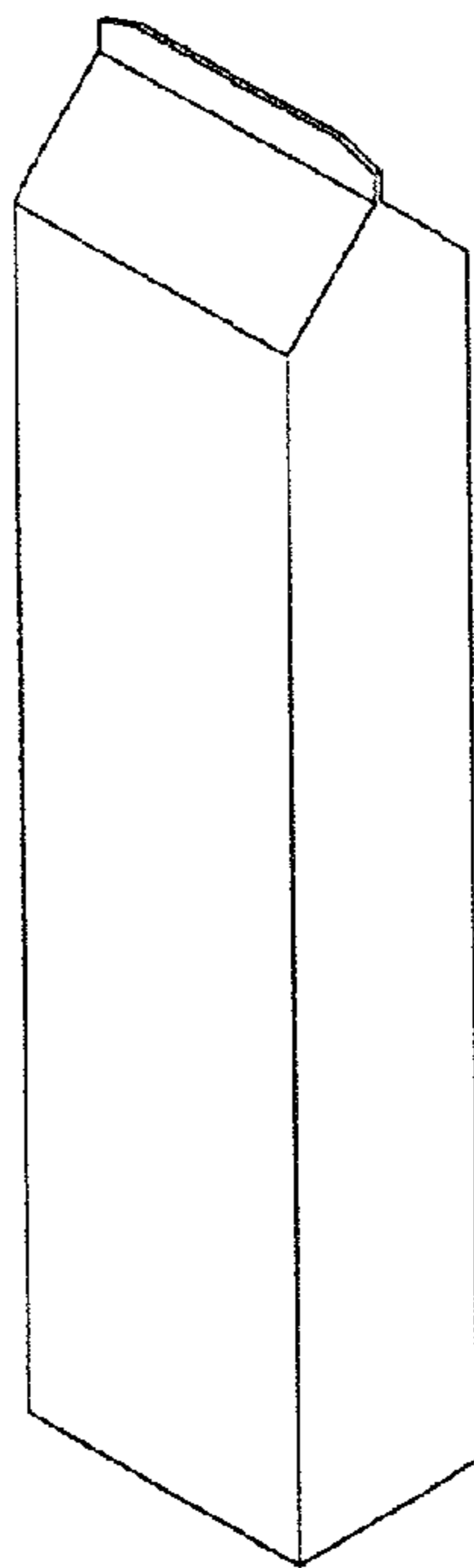
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a patterning tool, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of patterning tool showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is an enlargement at 6-6 of FIG. 2 thereof;  
FIG. 7 is an enlargement at 7-7 of FIG. 3 thereof;  
FIG. 8 is an enlargement of top thereof; and,  
FIG. 9 is a reference perspective view for illustrating the manner of use thereof.

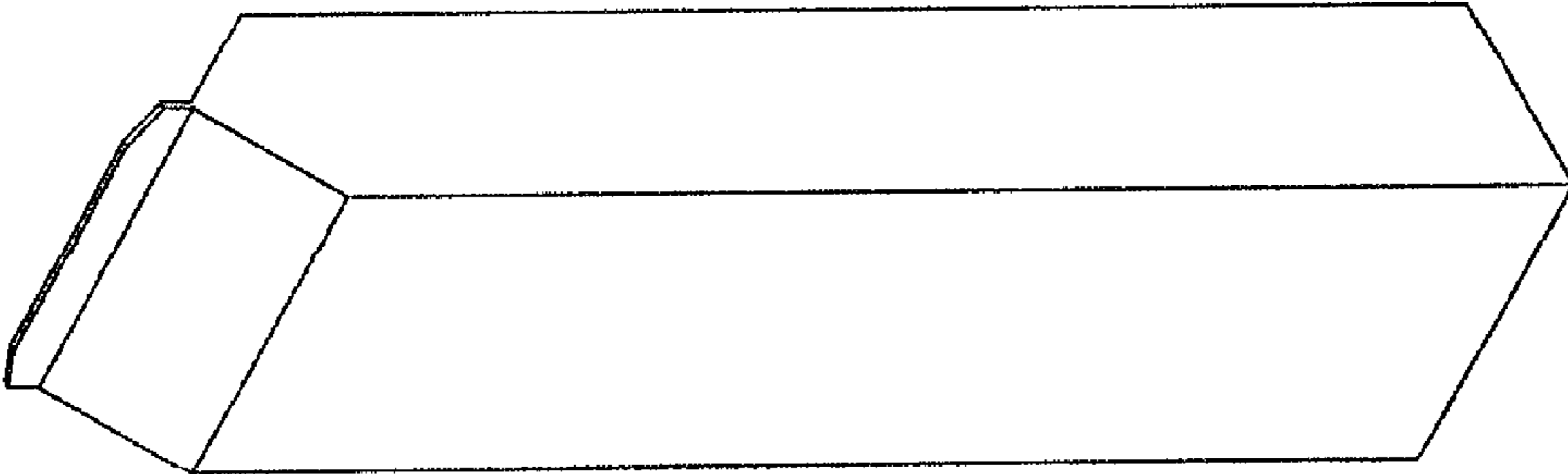

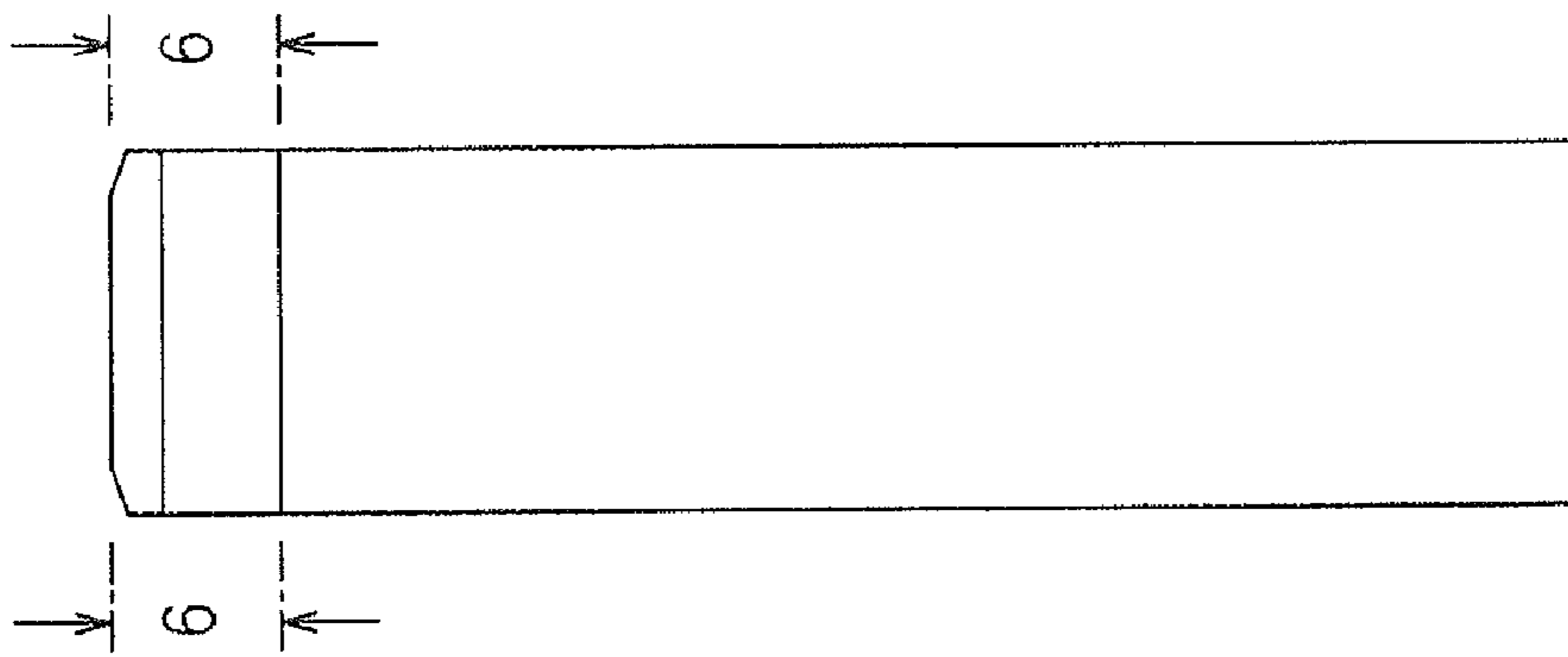

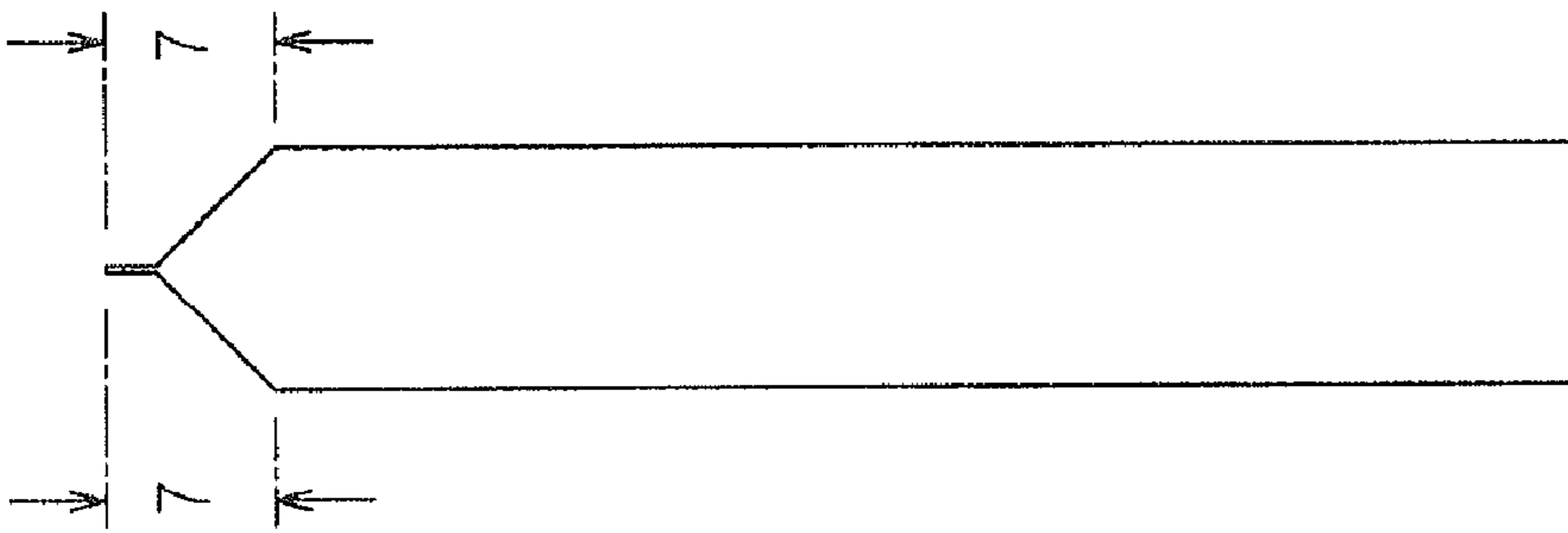

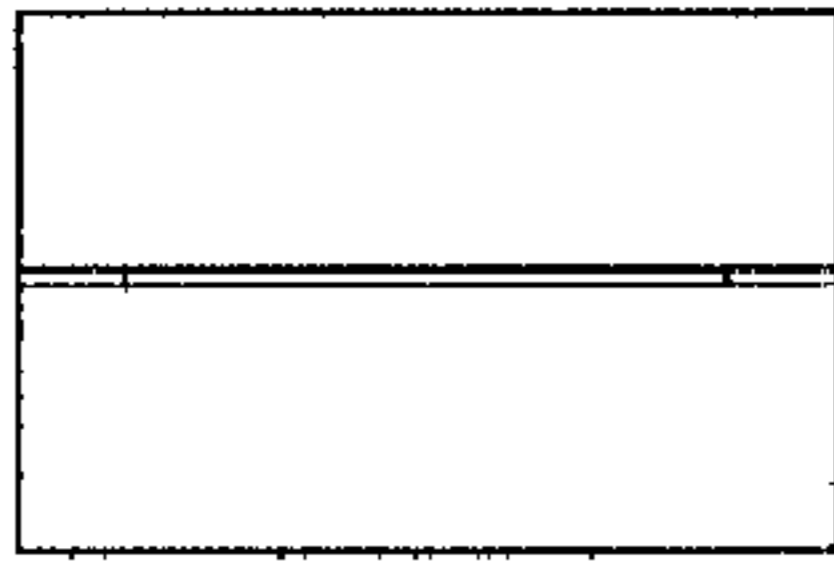

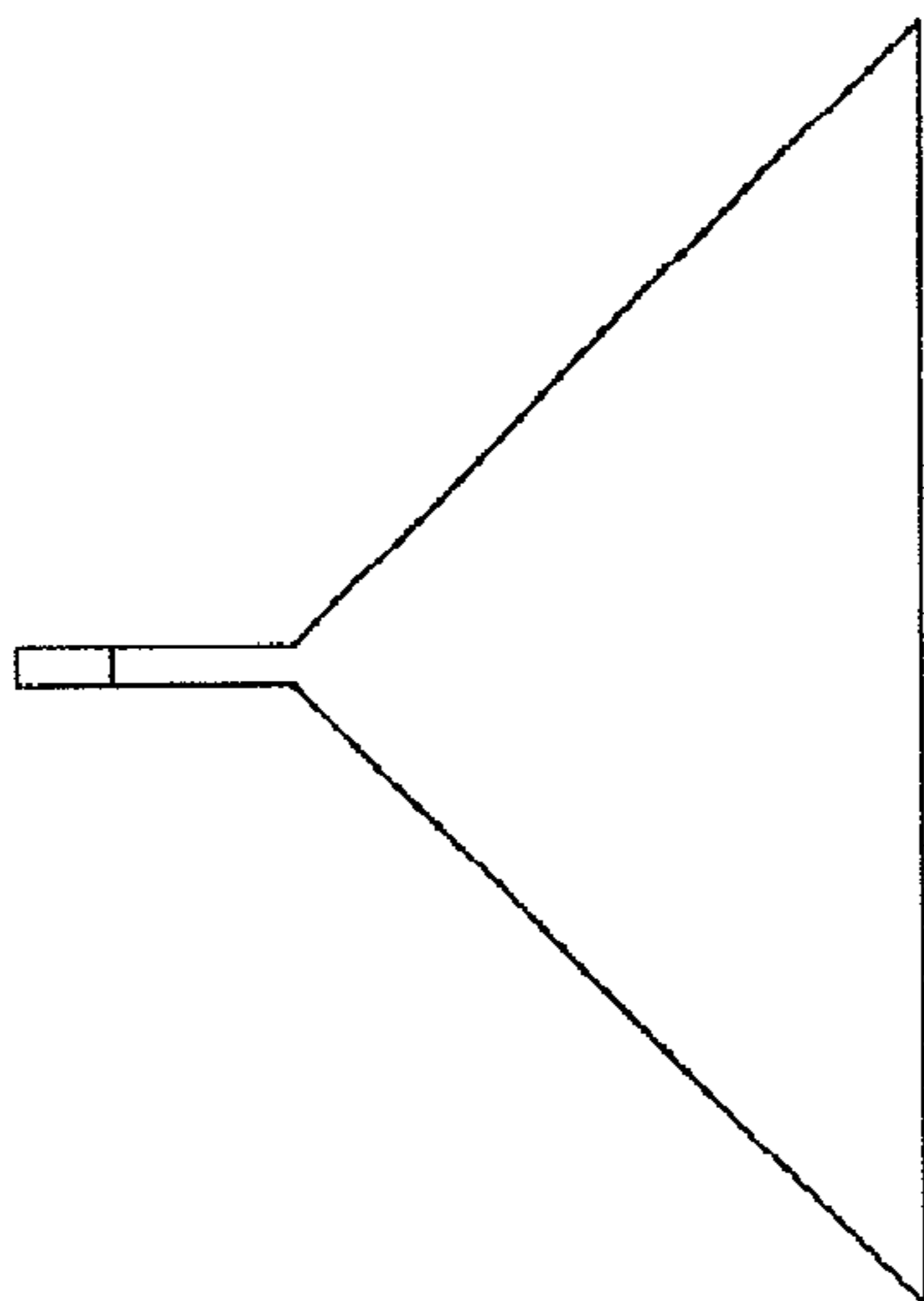

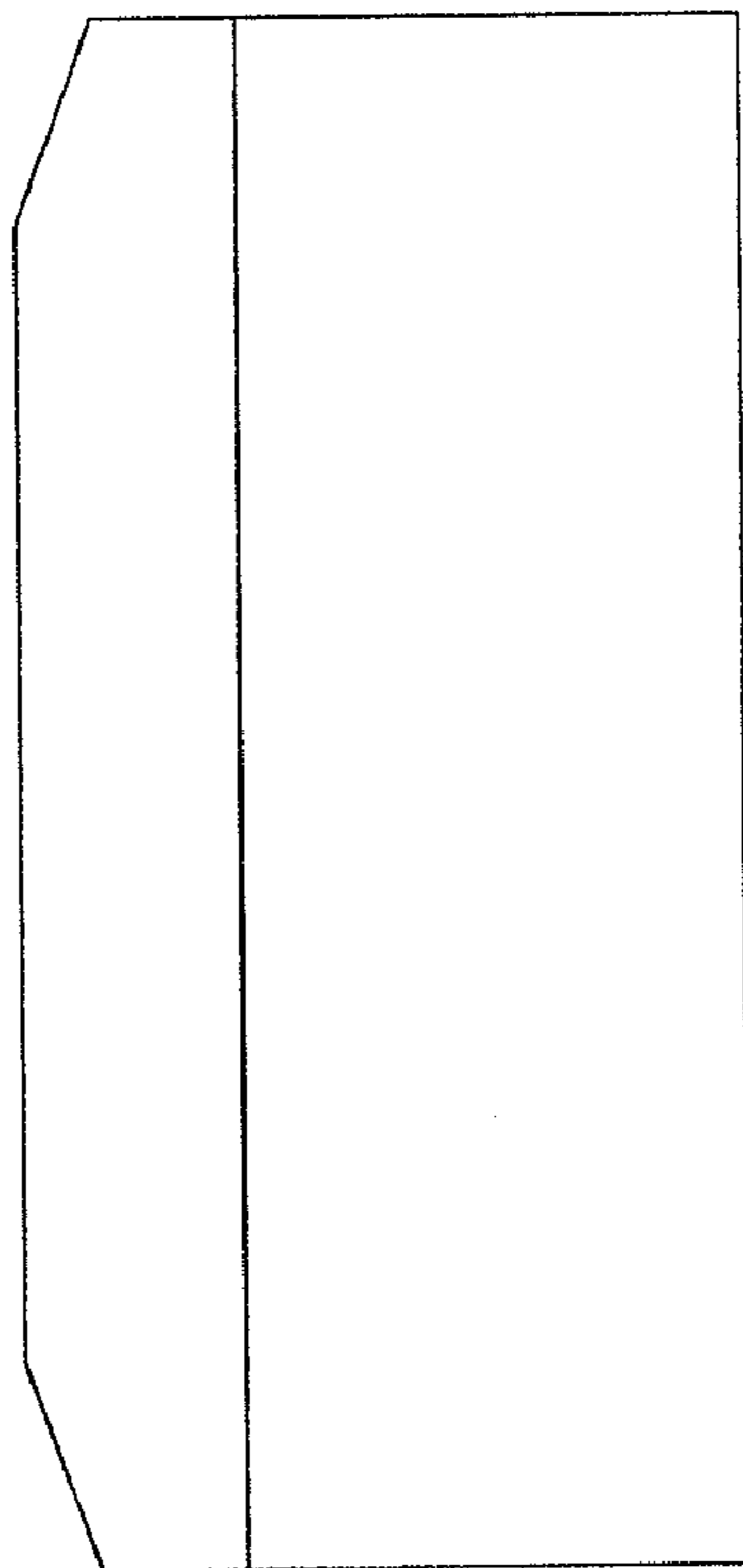

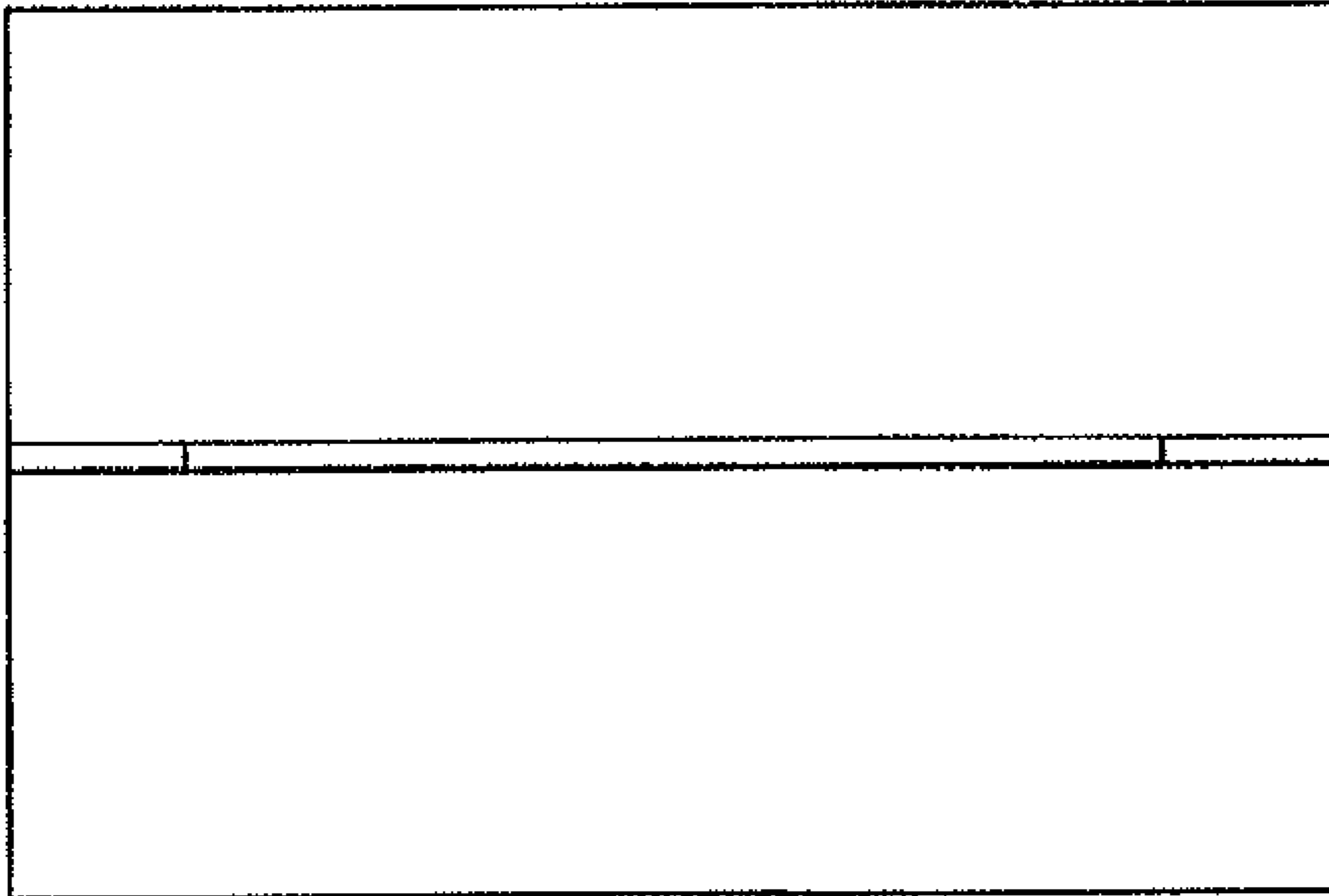

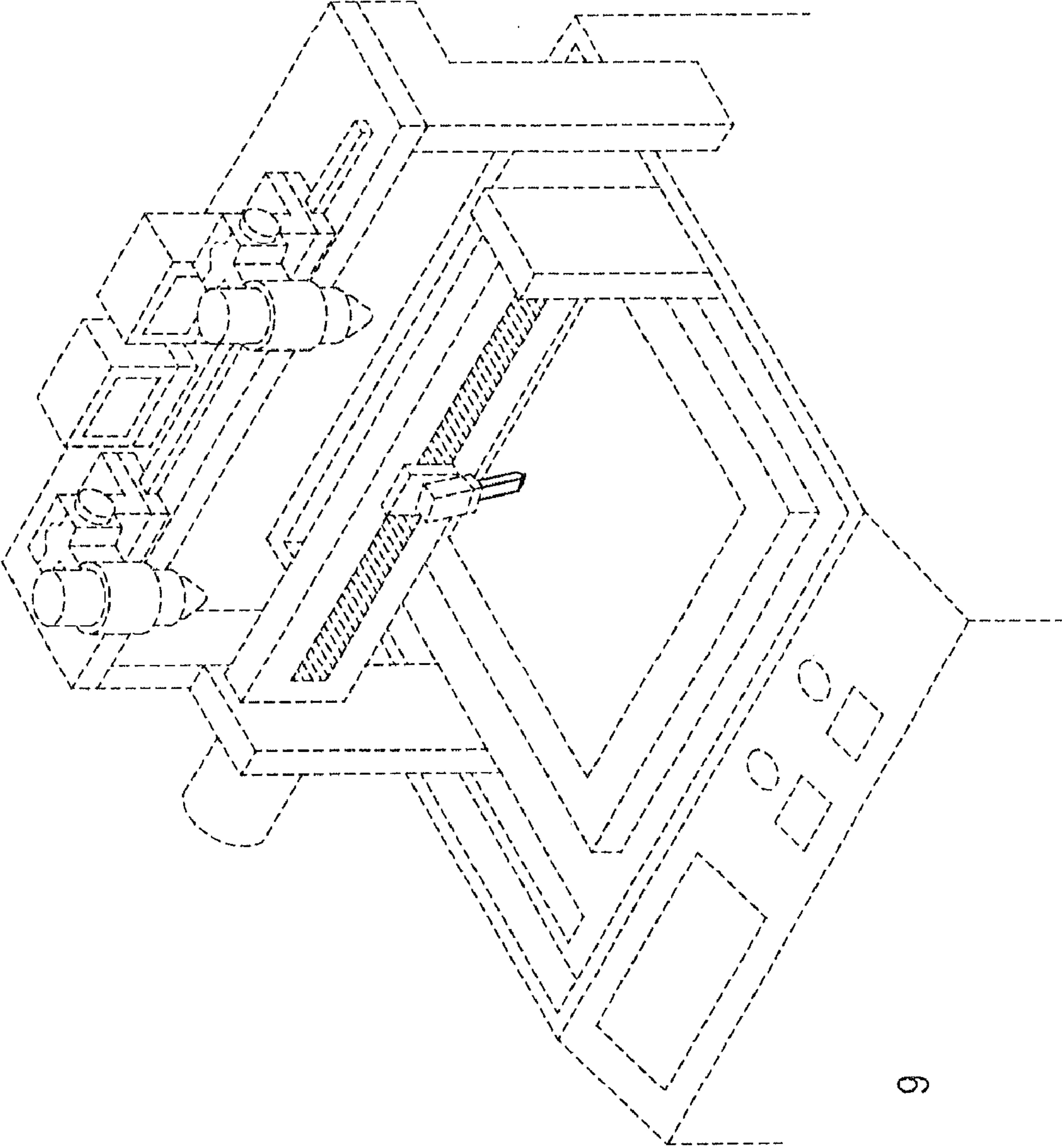
