The ornamental design for a topsheet with visual color for a diaper, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top view of a topsheet with visual color for a diaper showing our new design. The stippling represents an area having a color that contrasts with the color of the area that does not include stippling. The darker stippling represents an area having a teal color, in having a CIE L\*a\*b\* value of about 69, -42, -2 and a Color Space Volume of less than about 10,000. The lighter stippling represents an area having a periwinkle color, in having a CIE L\*a\*b\* value of about 81, 2, -15 and a Color Space Volume of less than about 10,000; and further comprising an area having a white color; and, FIG. 2 is a top view of another embodiment of a topsheet with visual color for a diaper showing our new design. The stippling represents an area having a color that contrasts with the color of the area that does not include stippling. The darker stippling represents an area preferably having a teal color, in having a CIE L\*a\*b\* value of about 69, -42, -2 and a Color Space Volume of less than about 10,000. The lighter stippling represents an area having a periwinkle color, in having a CIE L\*a\*b\* value of about 81, 2, -15 and a Color Space Volume of less than about 10,000.

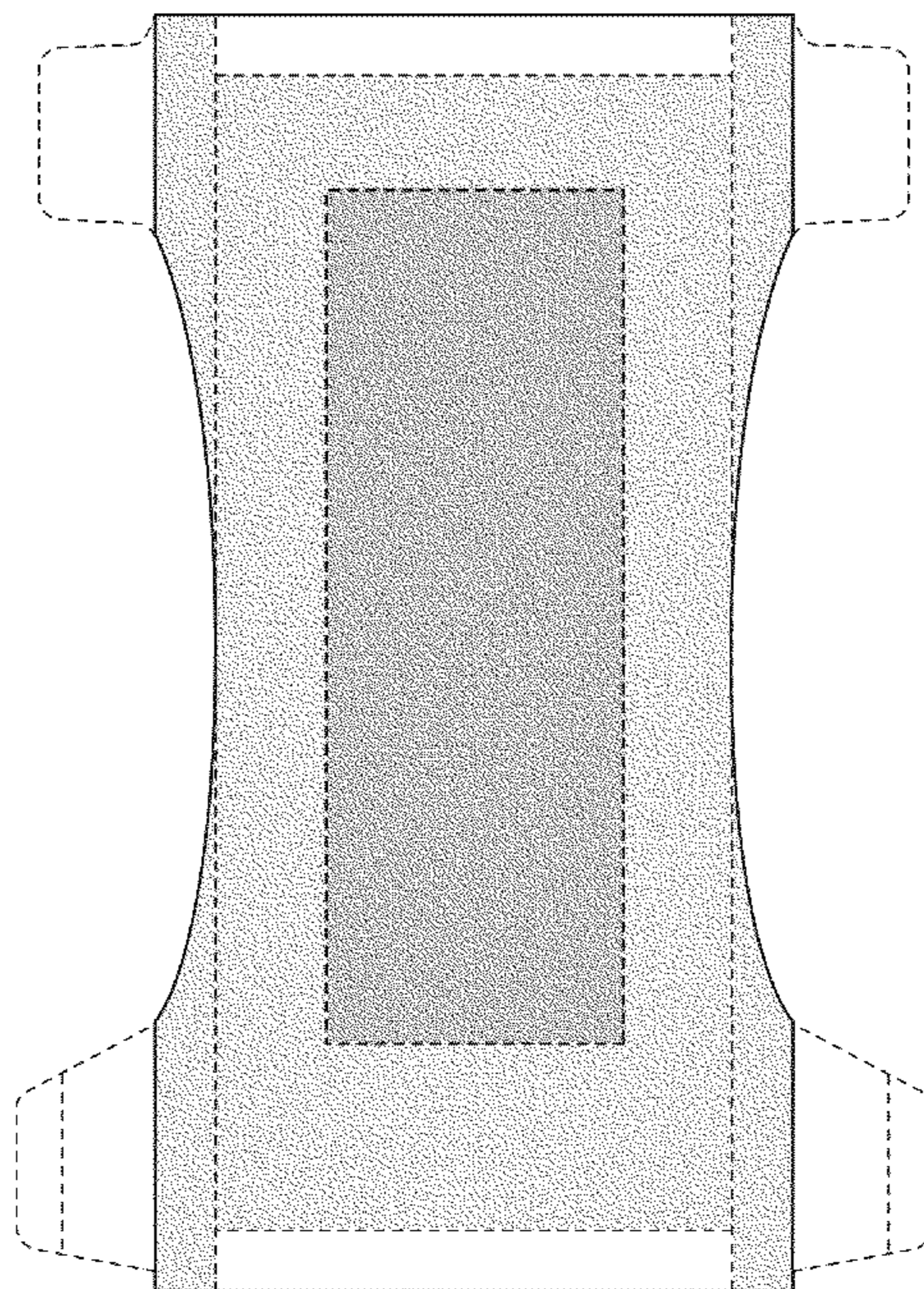

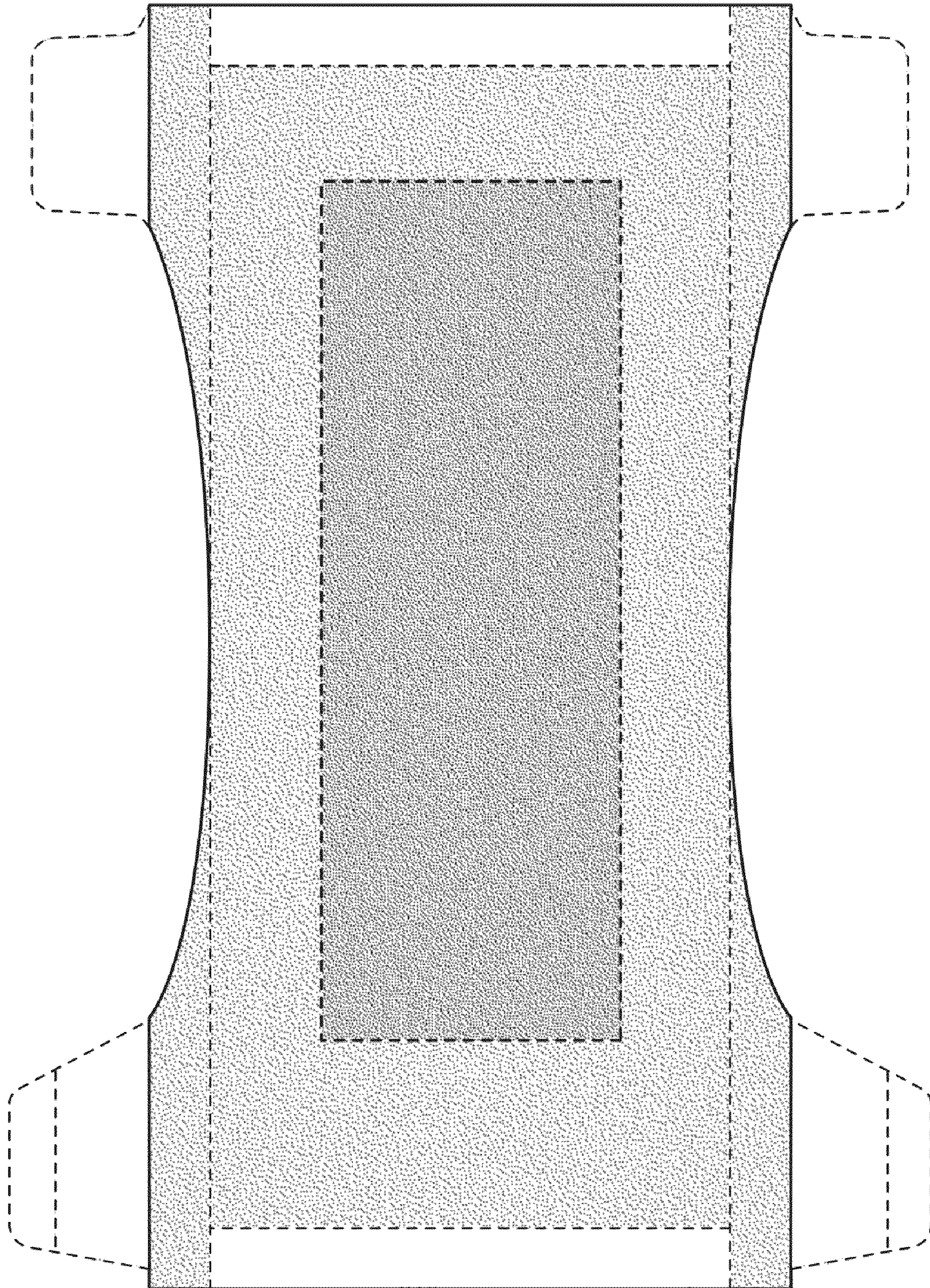

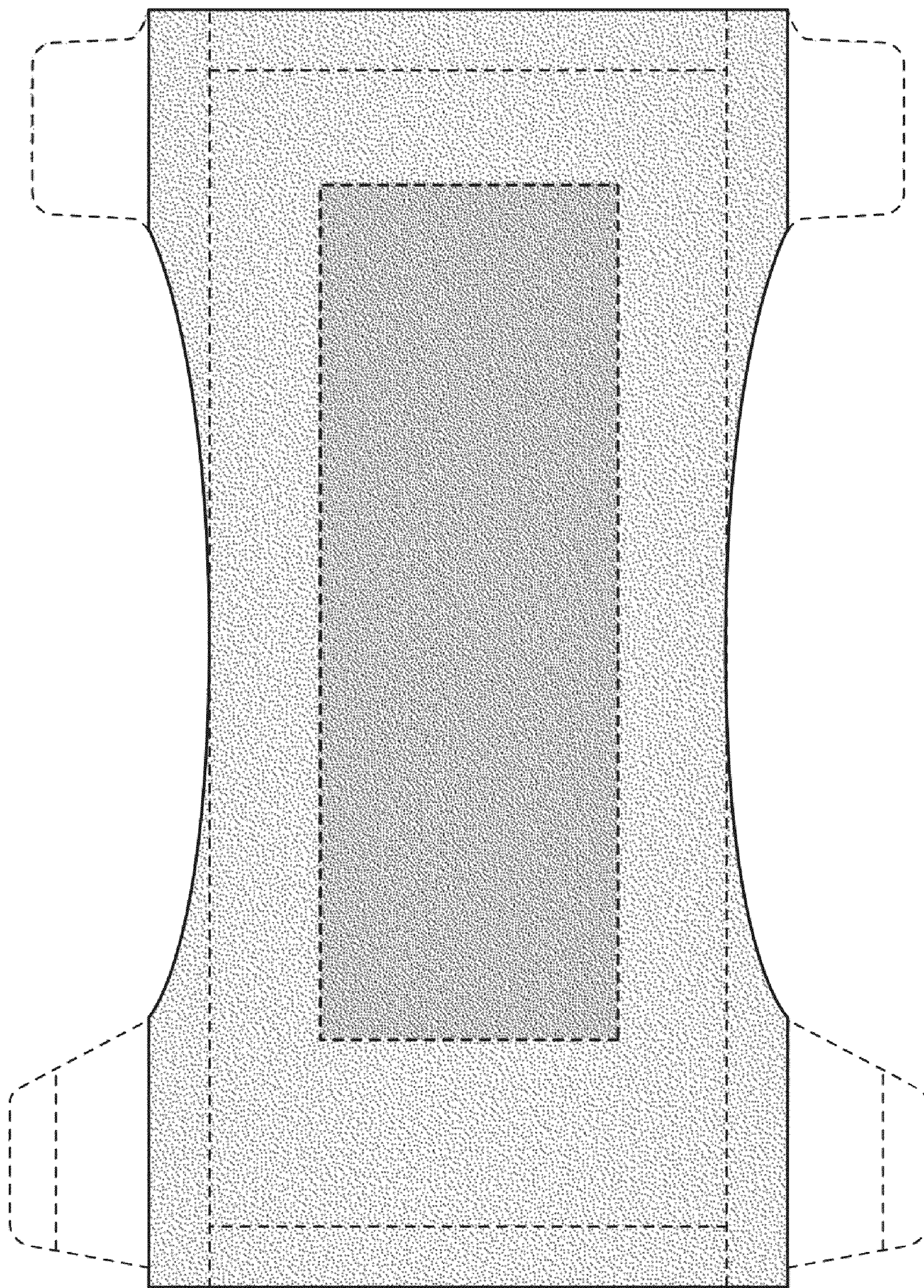
