DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a handle of surgical instrument, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front, top and right side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

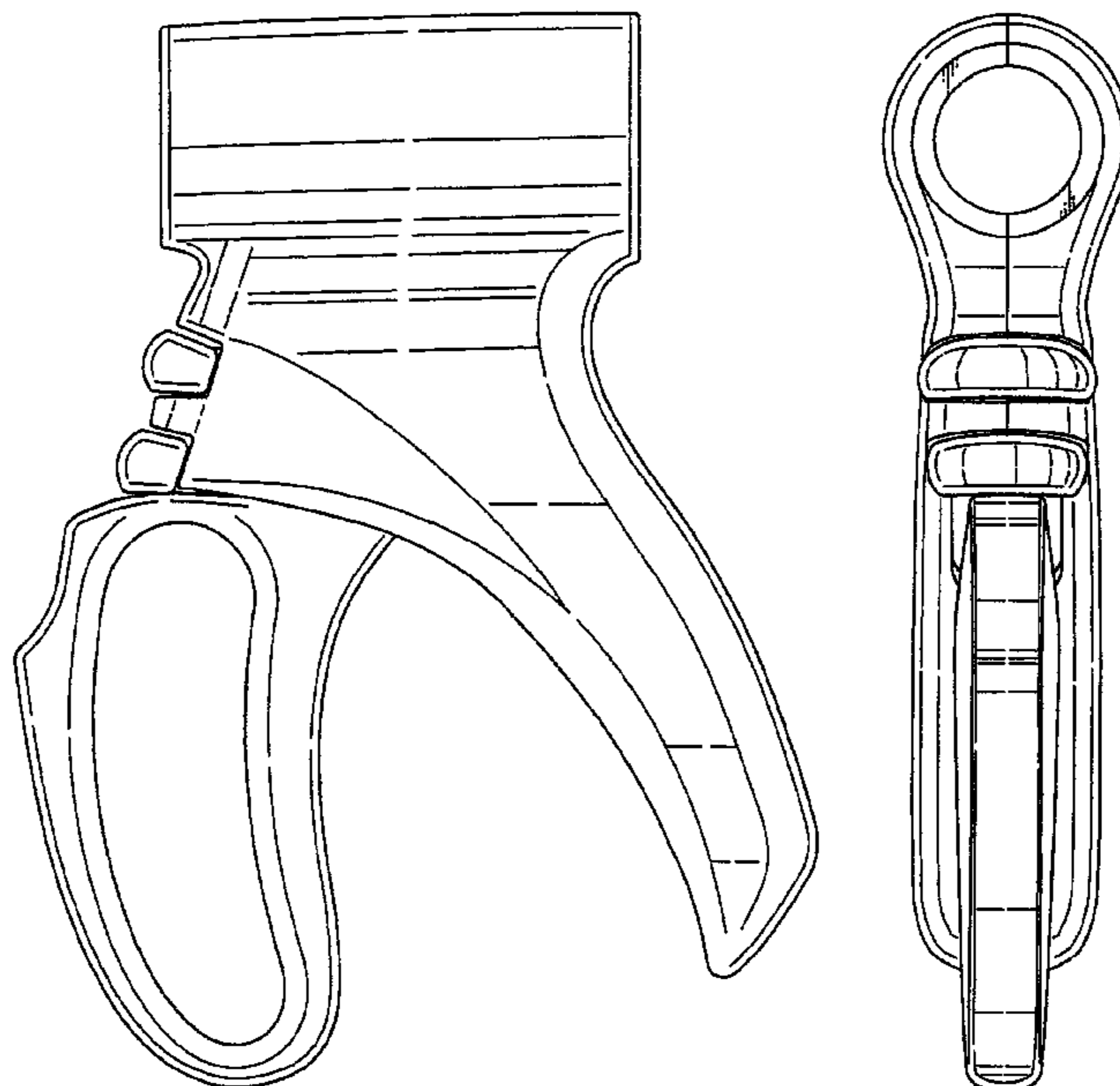
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a cross section view thereof; taken along the line 9-9 in FIG. 5, showing only the housing structure.

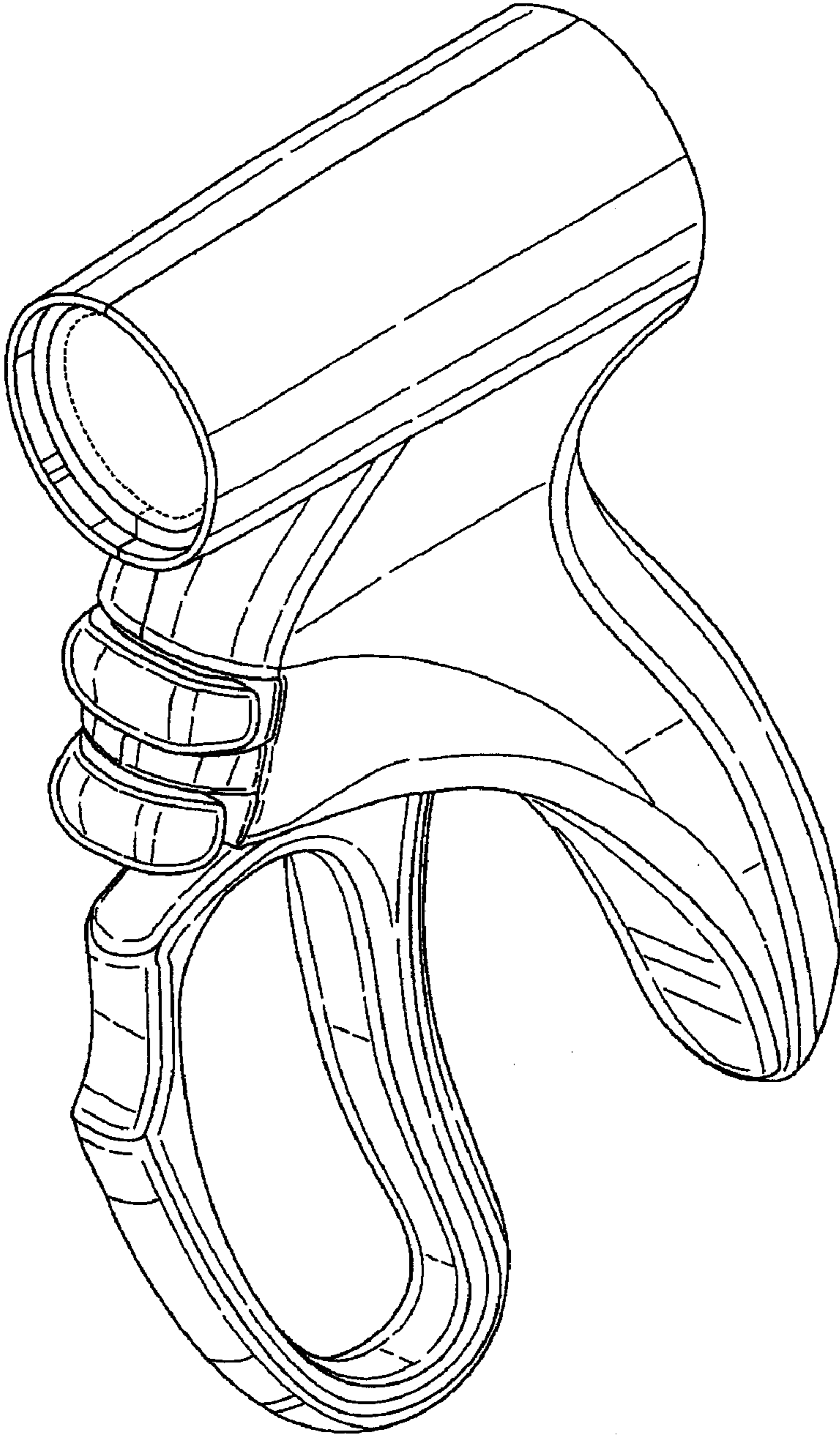

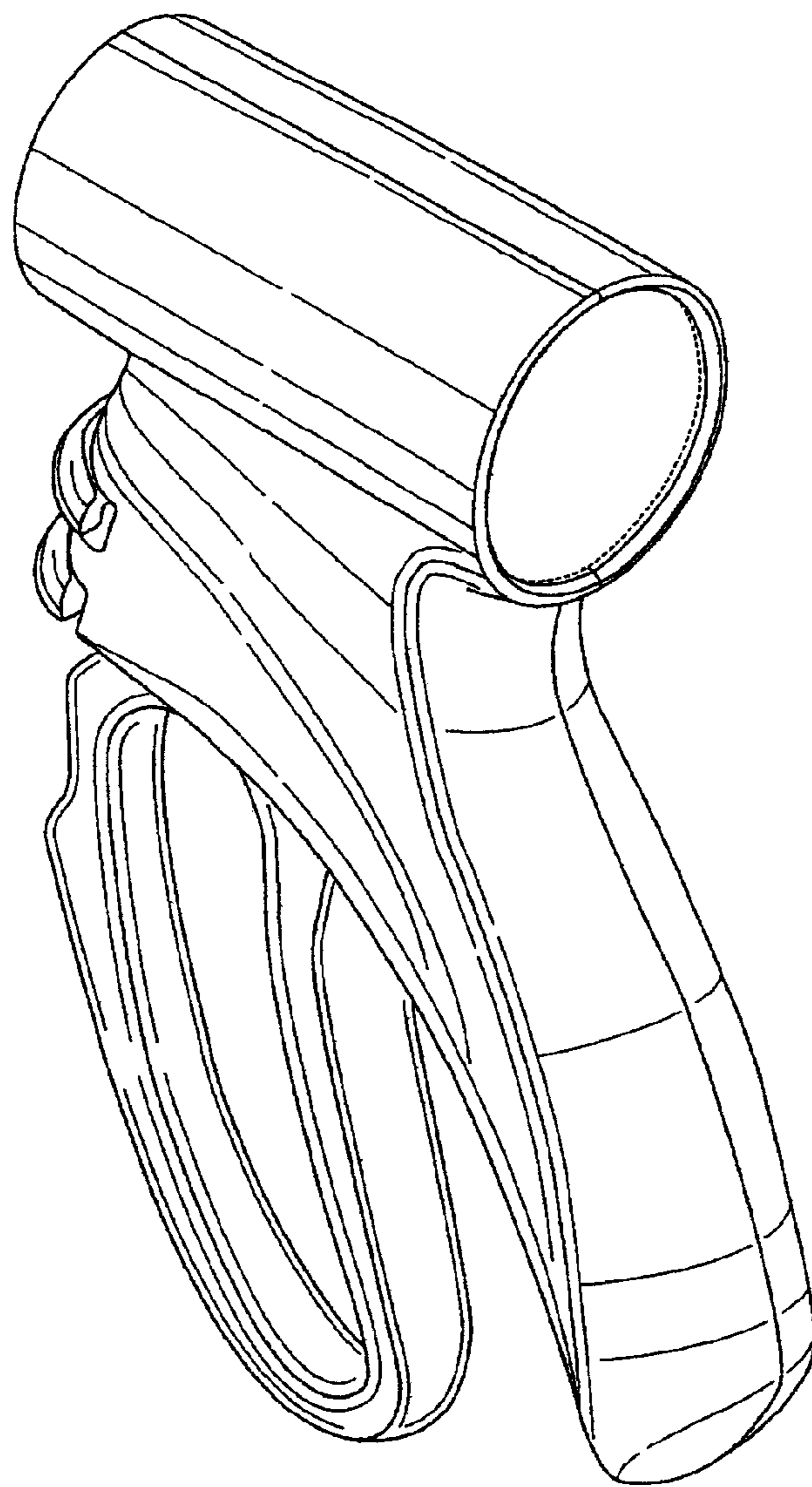

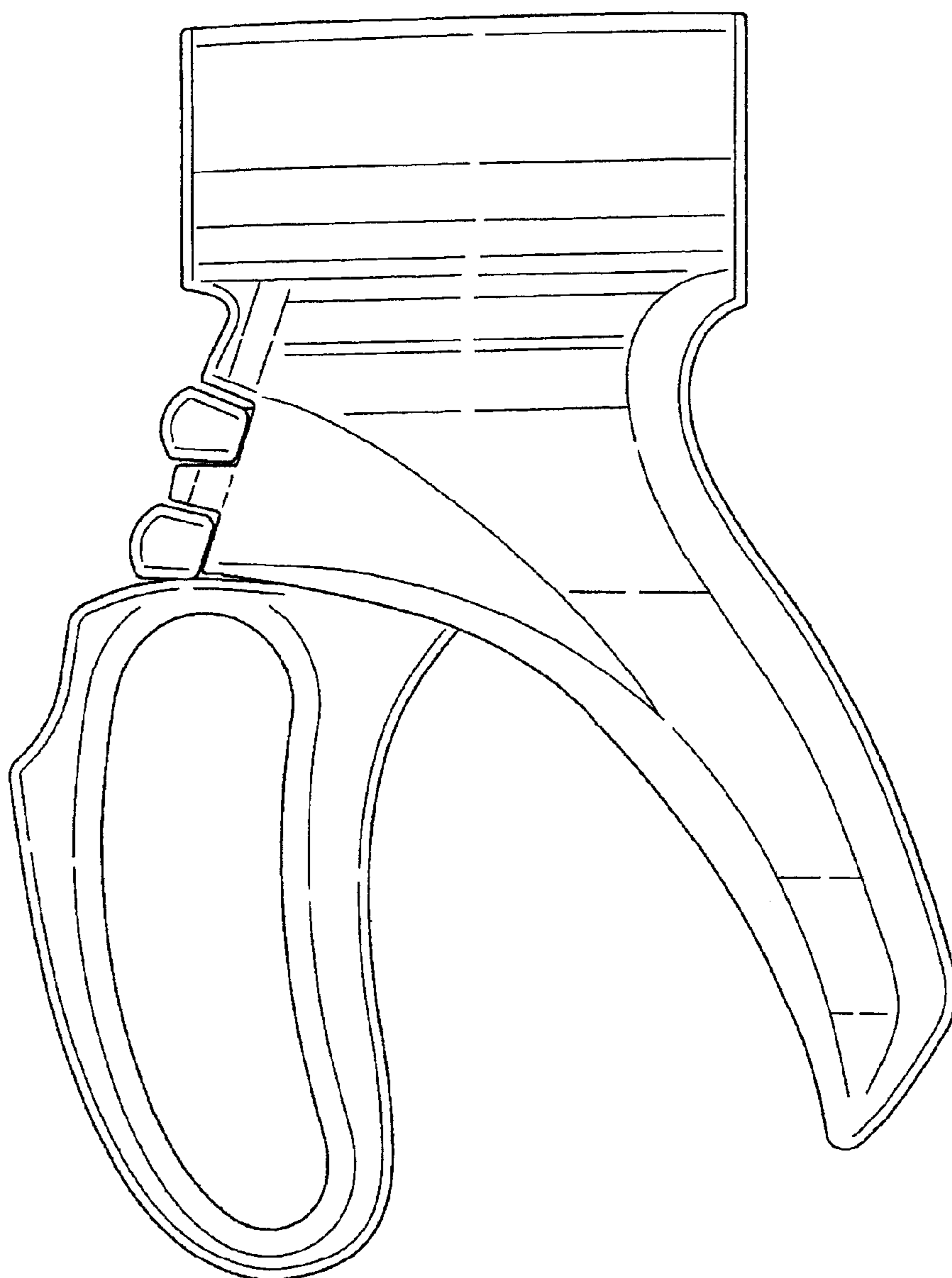

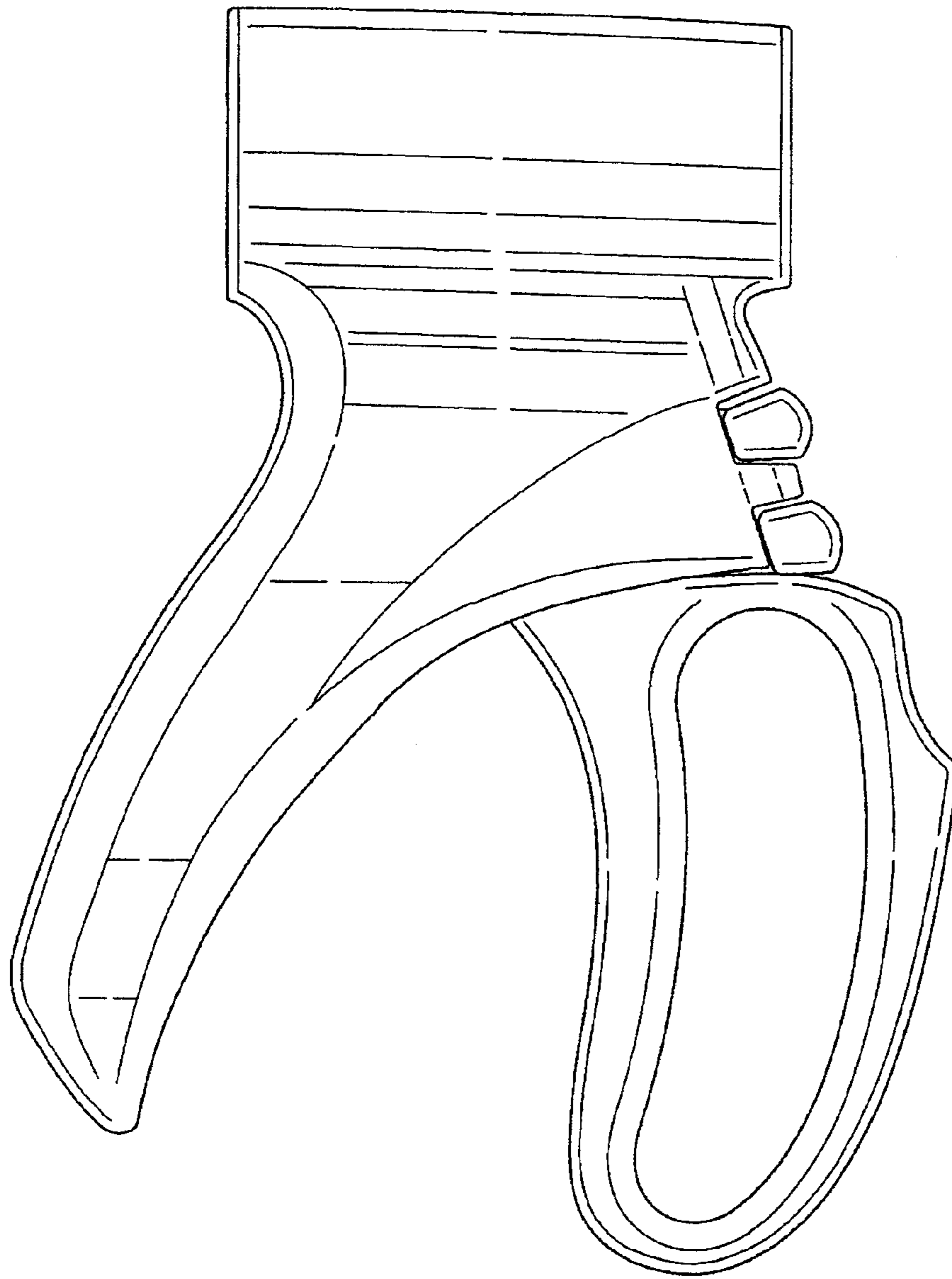

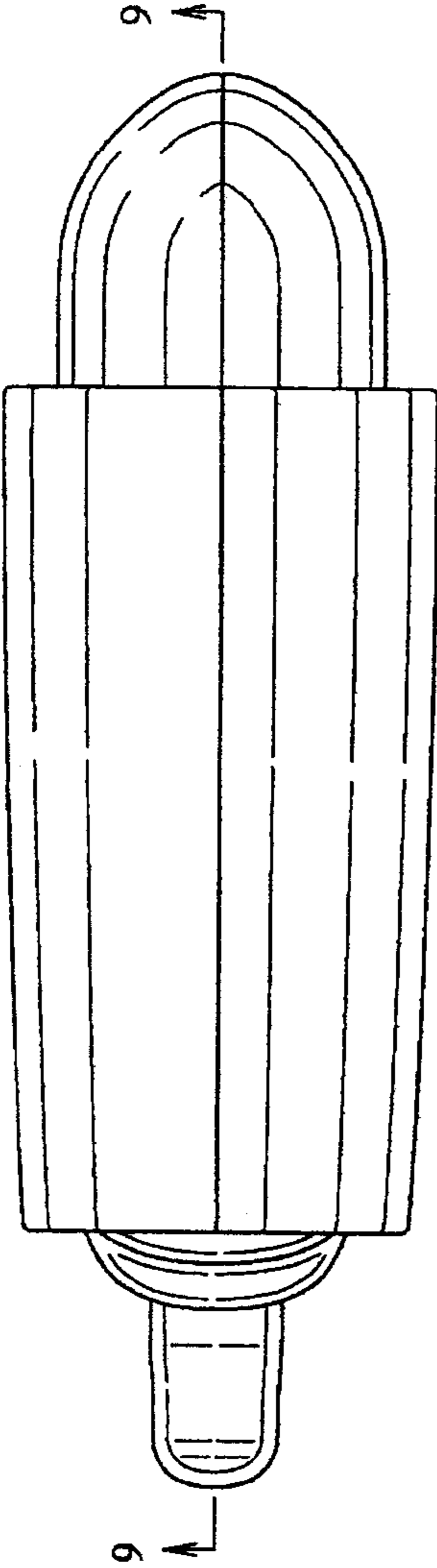

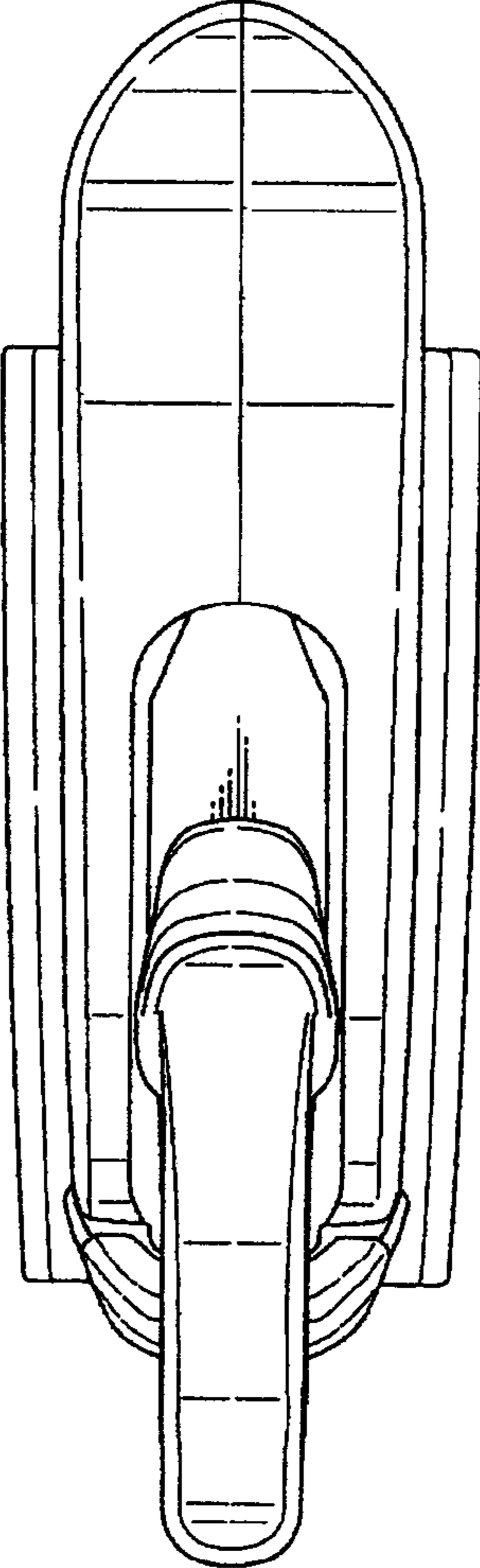

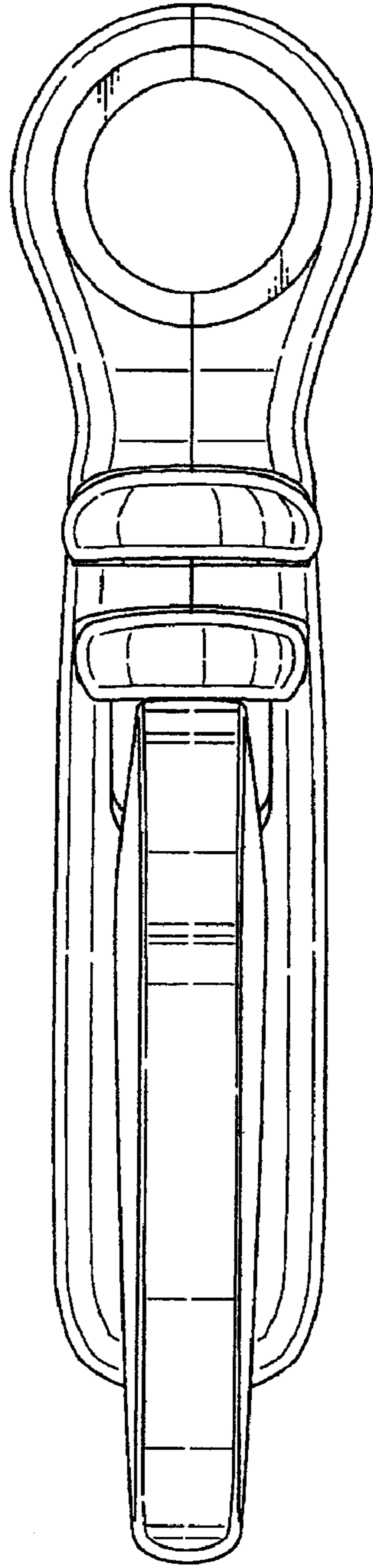

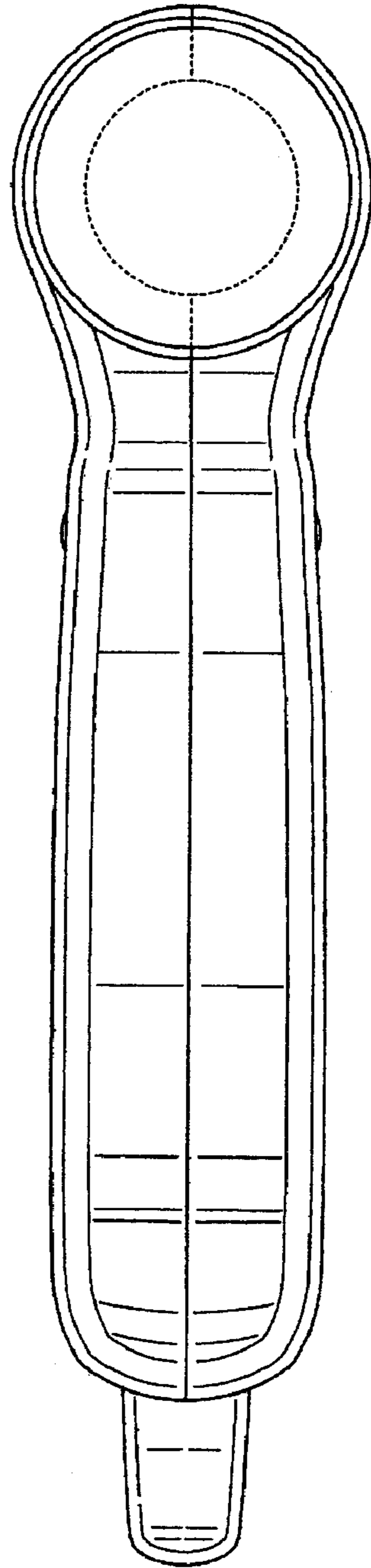

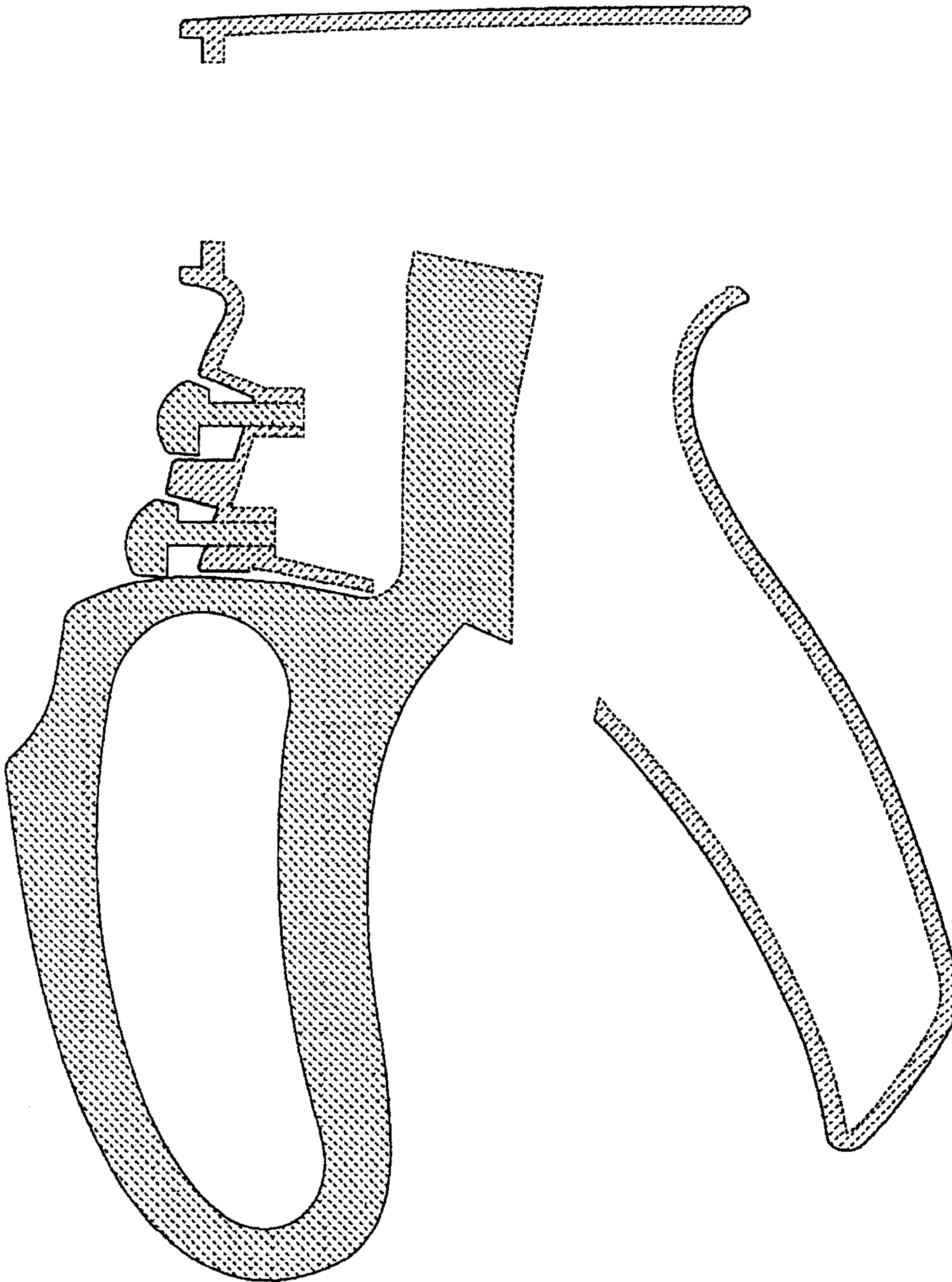
