The ornamental design for a headband, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 provides a front perspective view of an embodiment of a headband in place on the head of an infant.

FIG. 2 provides a side perspective view of an embodiment of a headband in place on the head of an infant.

FIG. 3 provides a right side elevational view of an embodiment of a headband.

FIG. 4 provides a left side elevational view of an embodiment of a headband.

FIG. 5 provides a top elevational view of an embodiment of a headband.

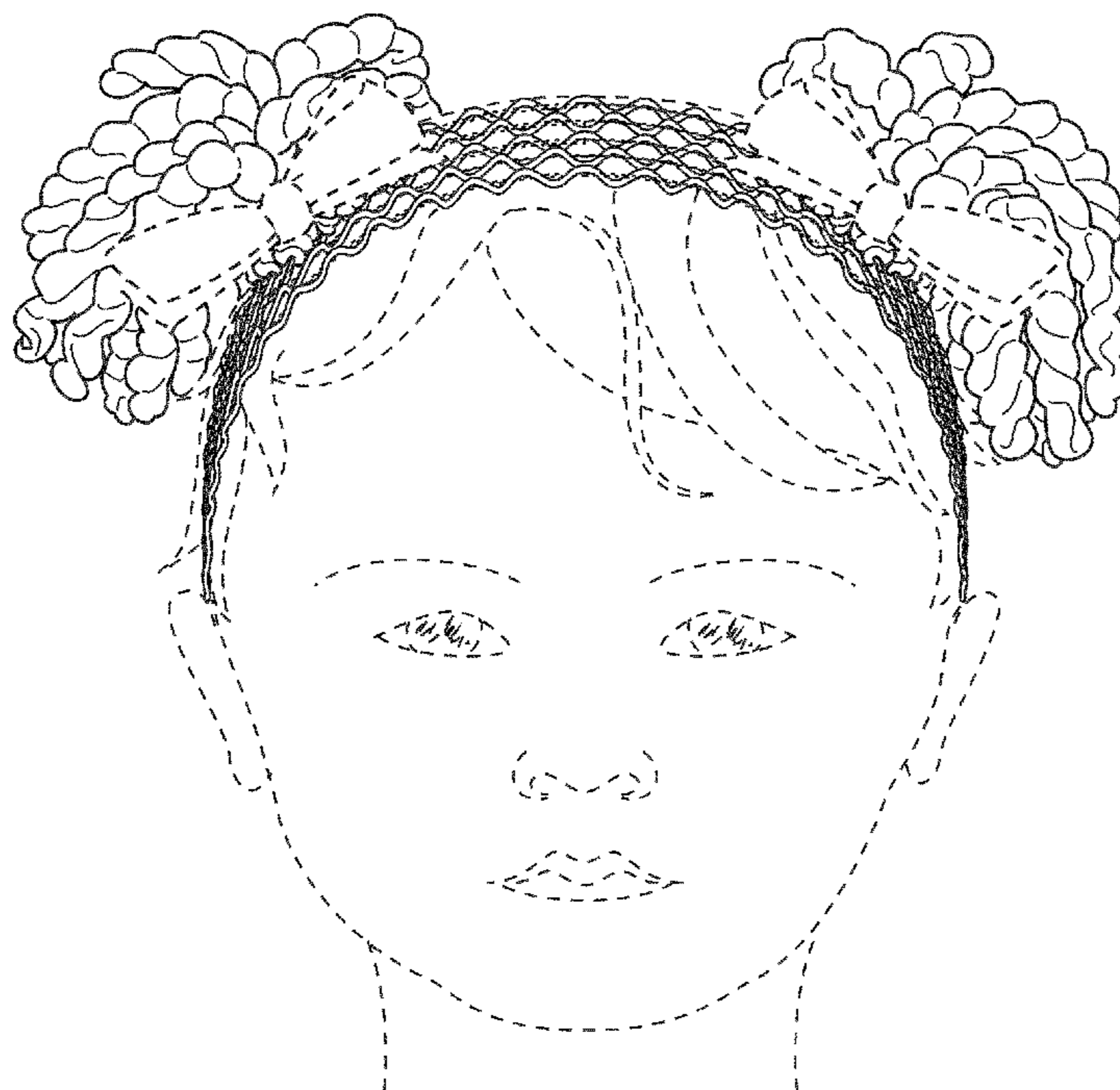
FIG. 6 provides a bottom elevational view of an embodiment of a headband.

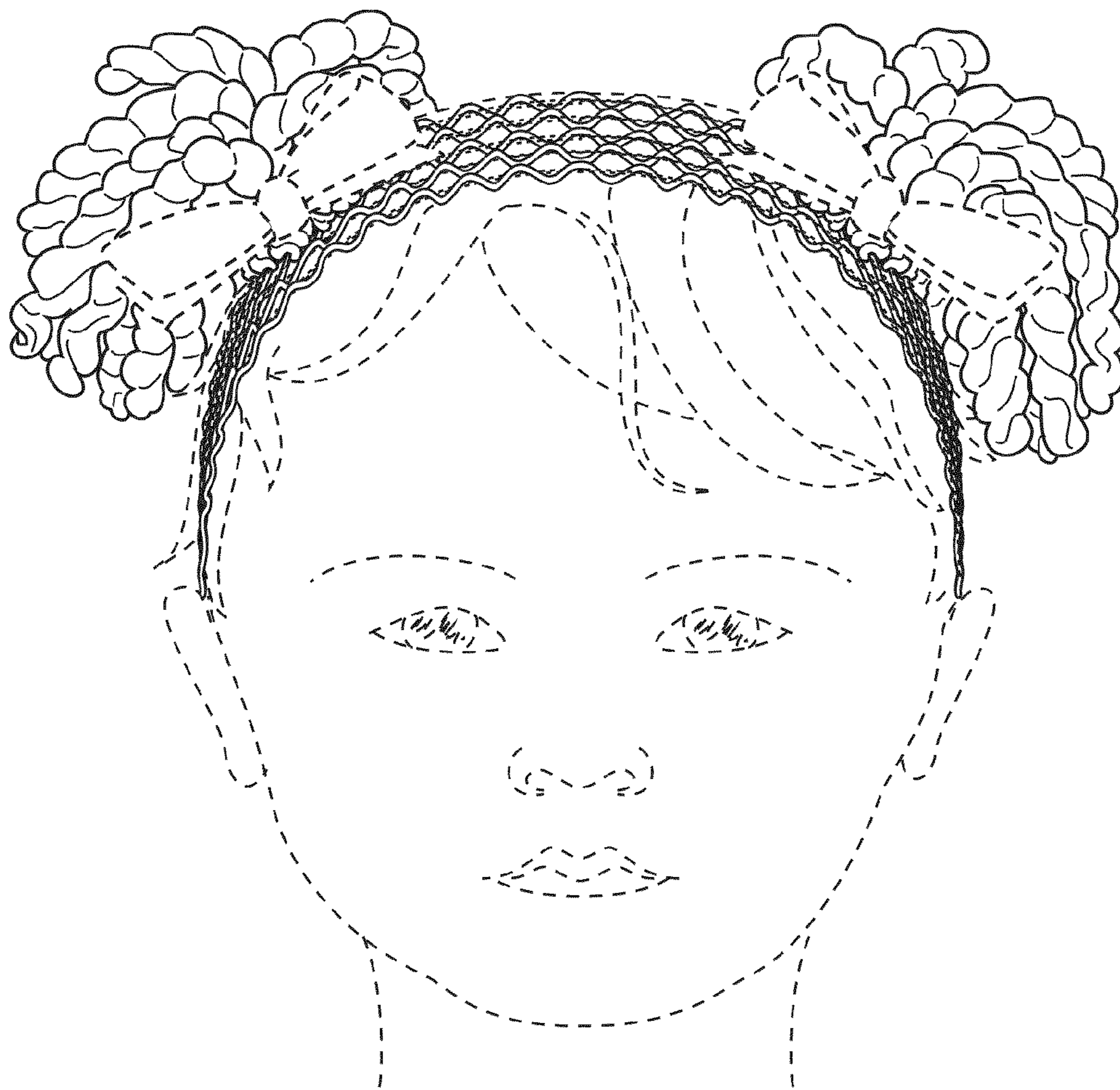

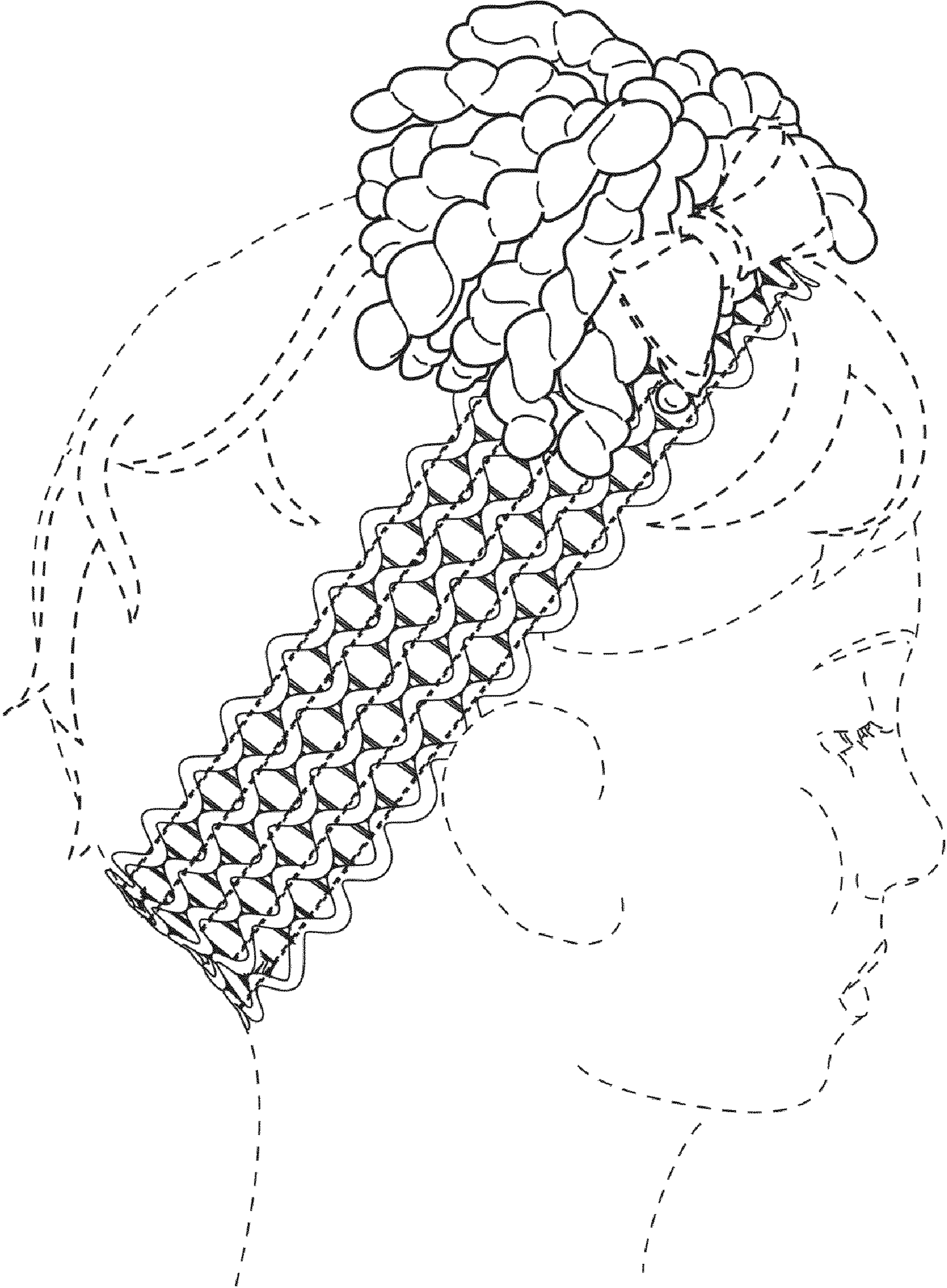

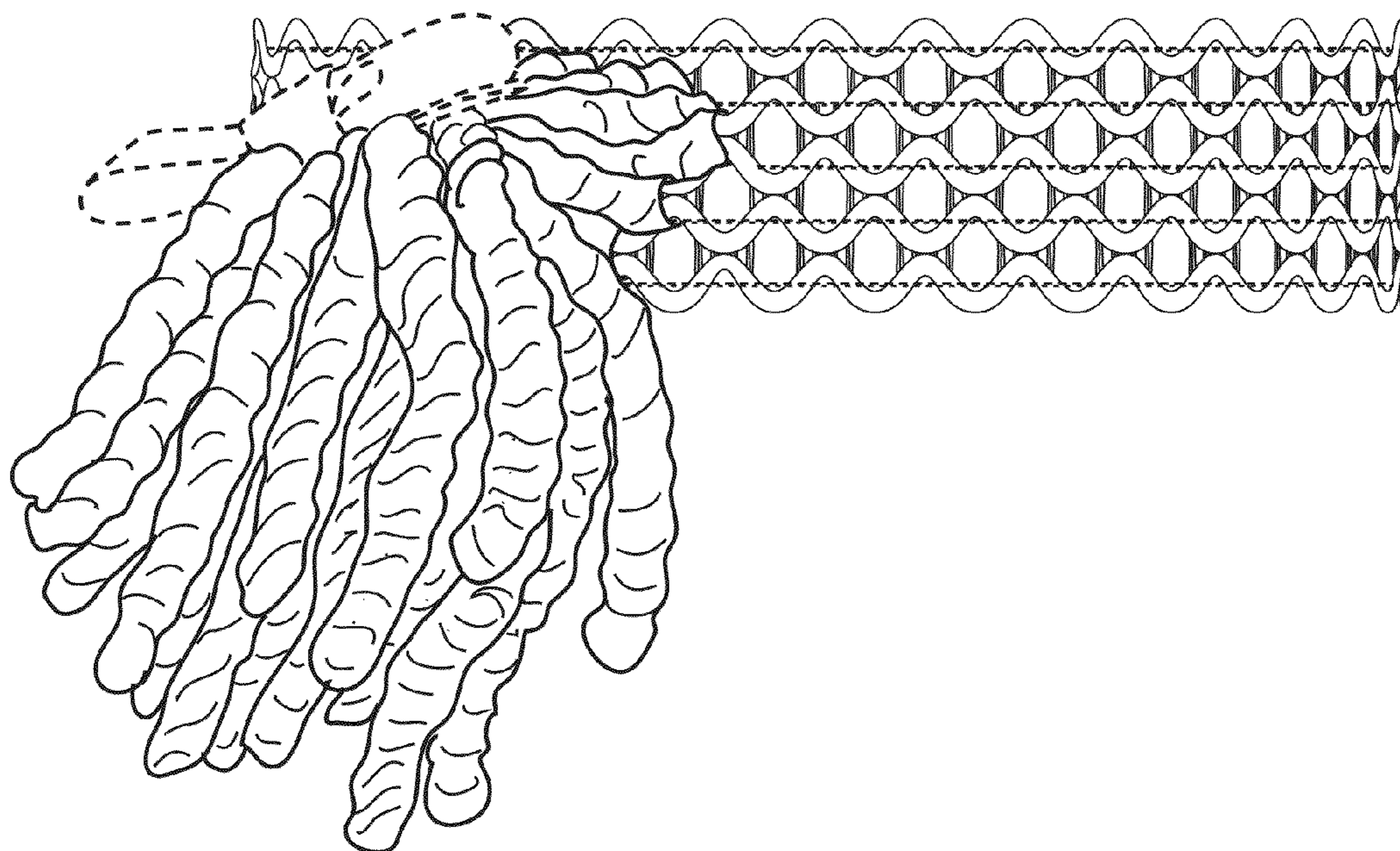

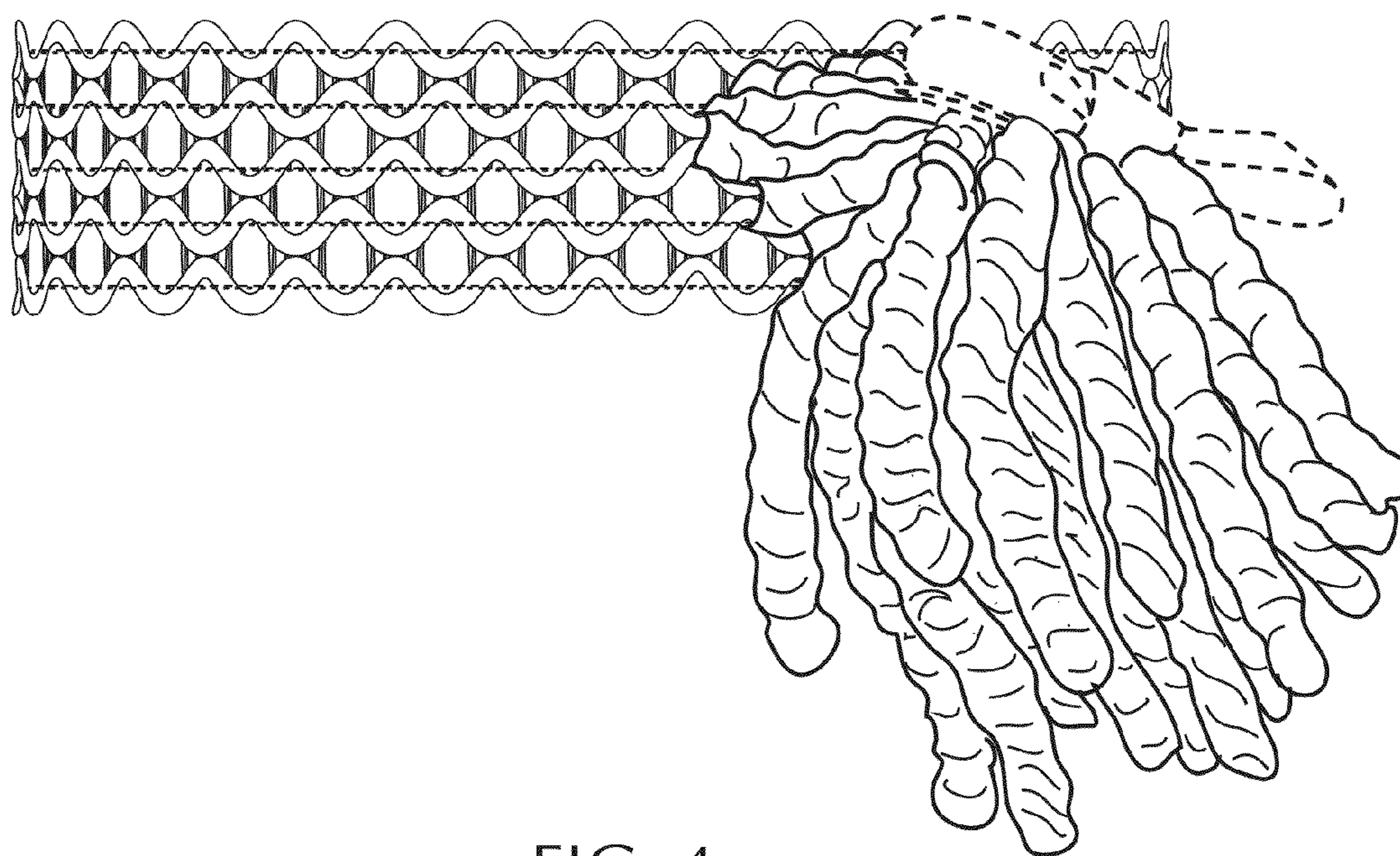

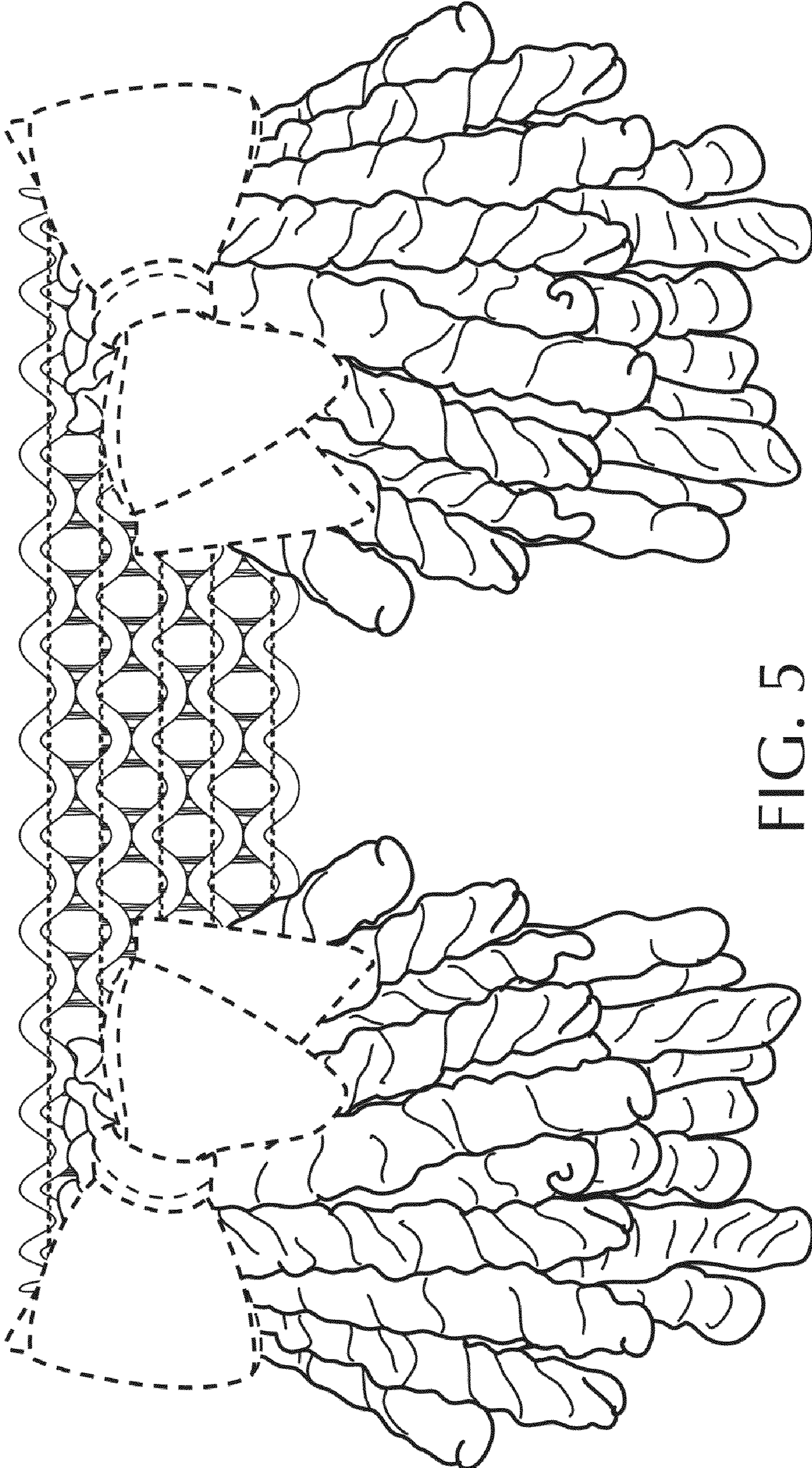

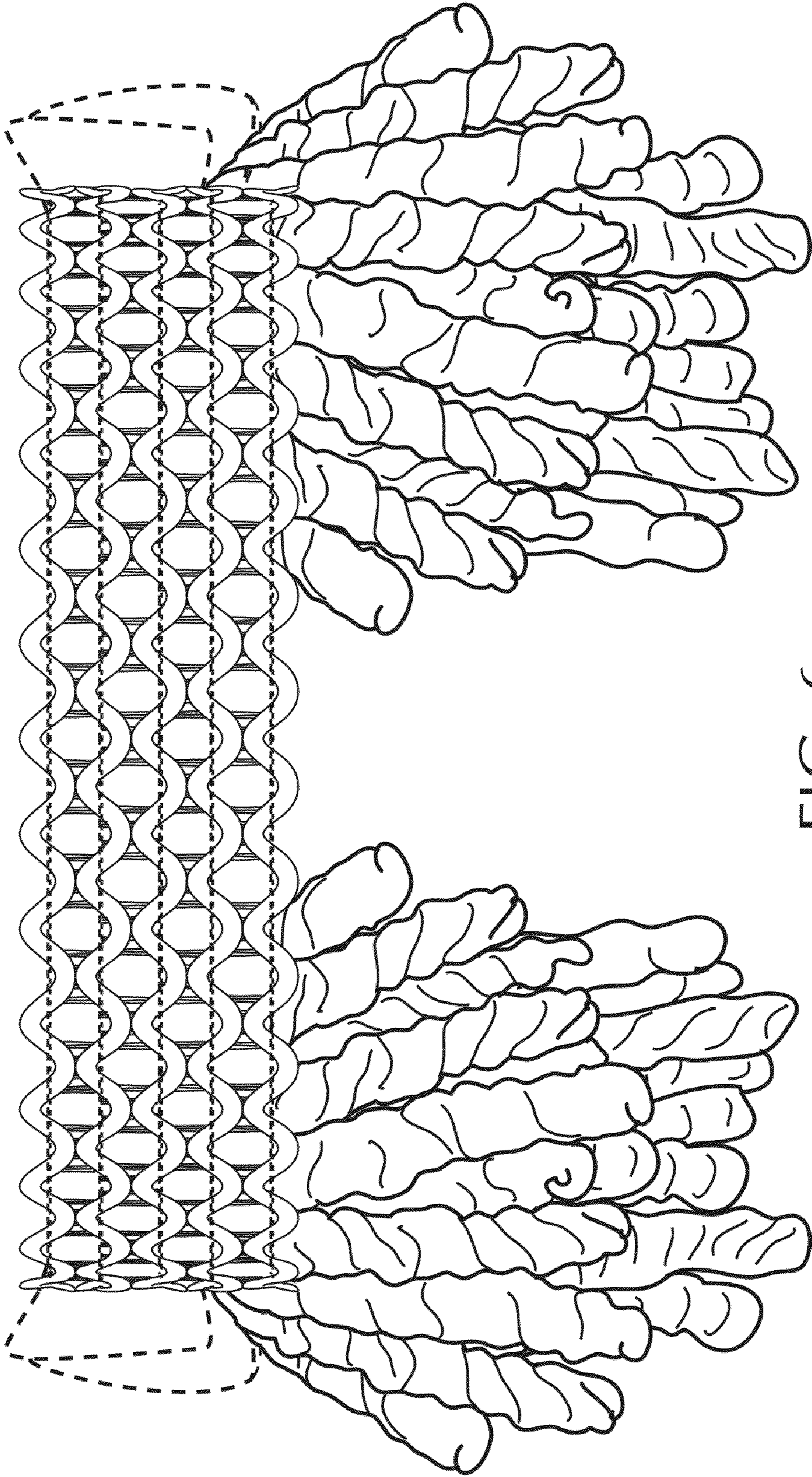

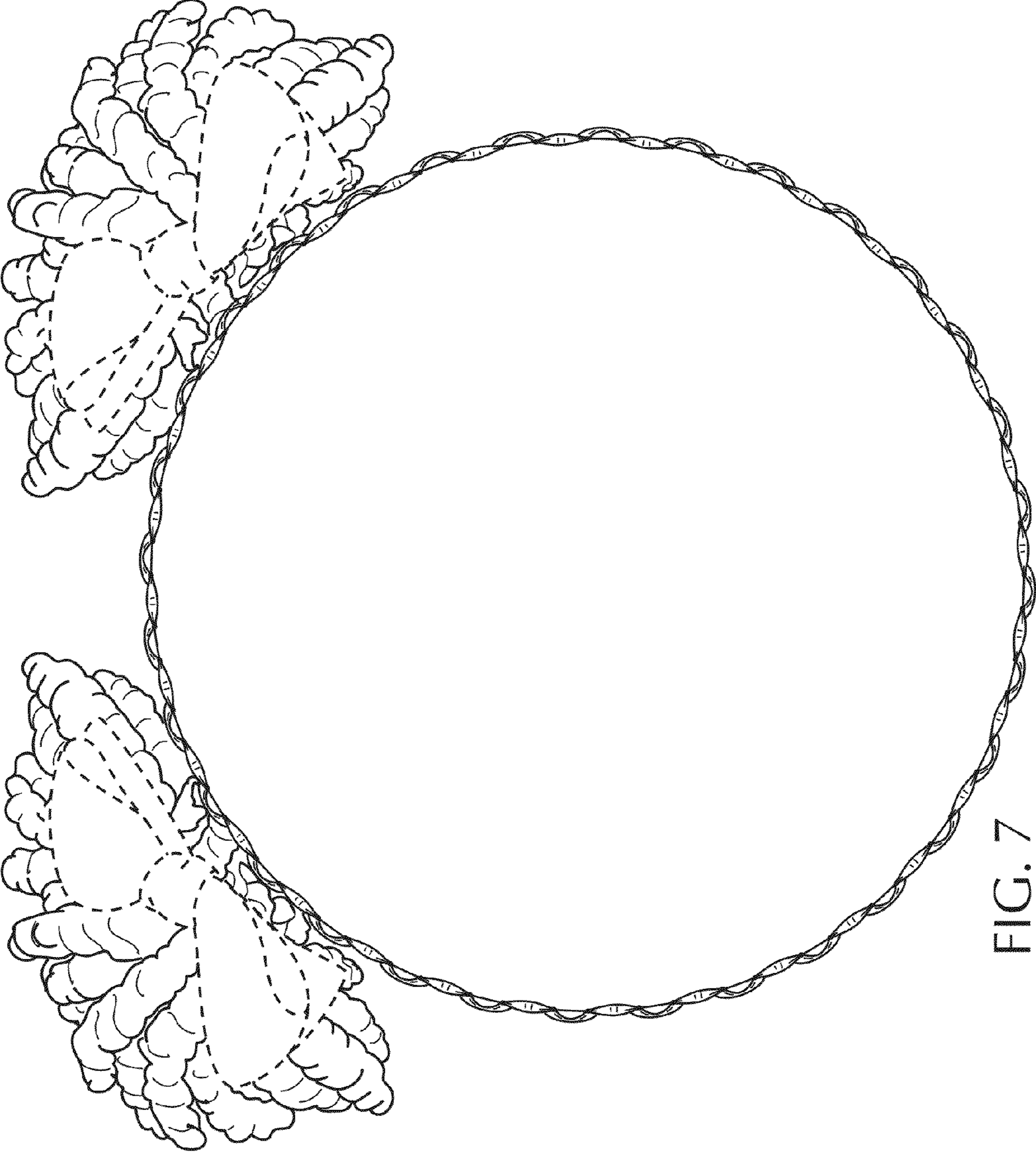

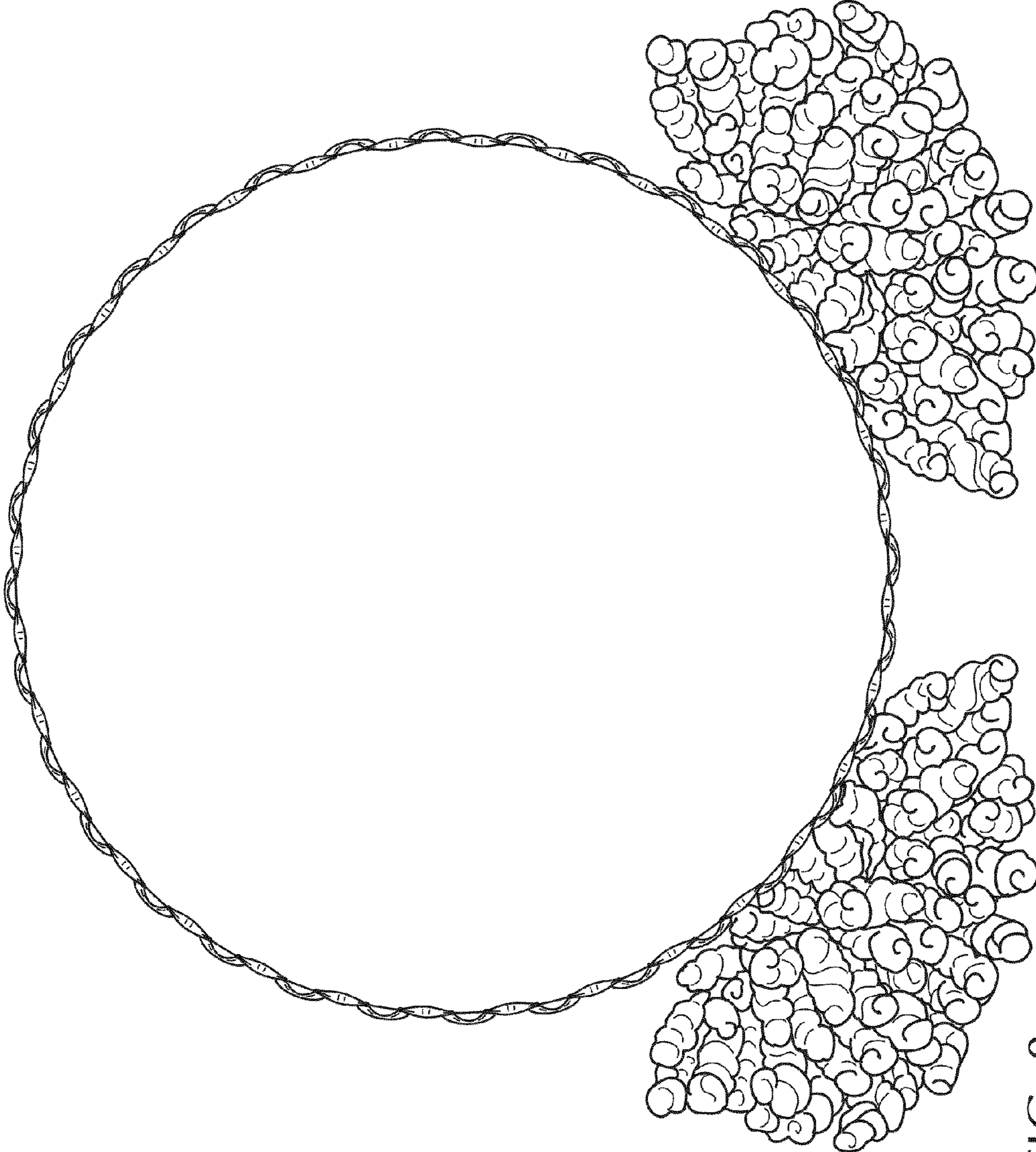
