The ornamental design for stain treatment implements, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the stain treatment implements;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a side view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 1, opposite the side view shown in FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is top view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the stain treatment implements;

FIG. 9 is a front view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a rear view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a side view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 8;

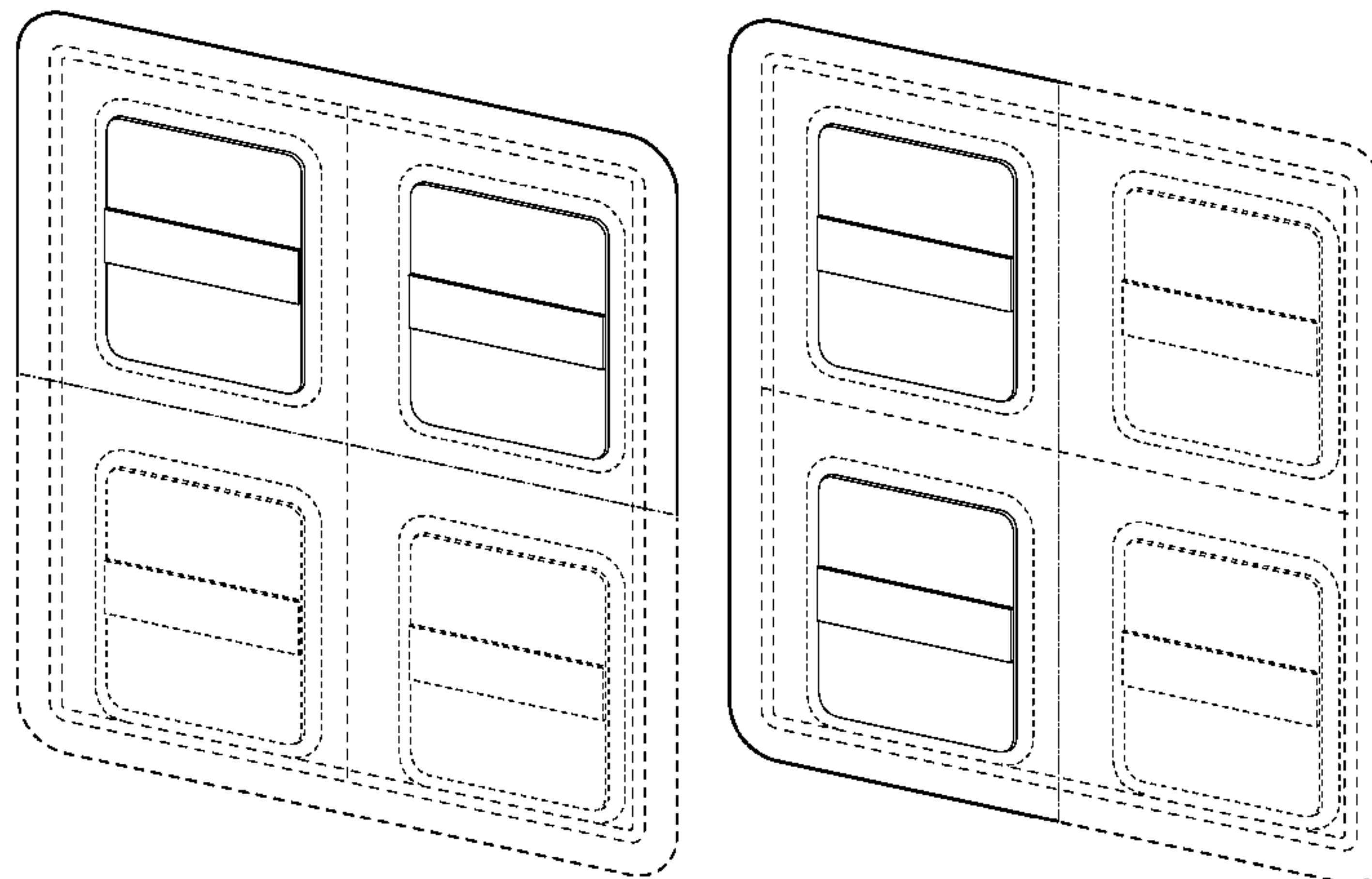
FIG. 12 is a side view of the stain treatment implements of FIG. 8, opposite the side view shown in FIG. 11;

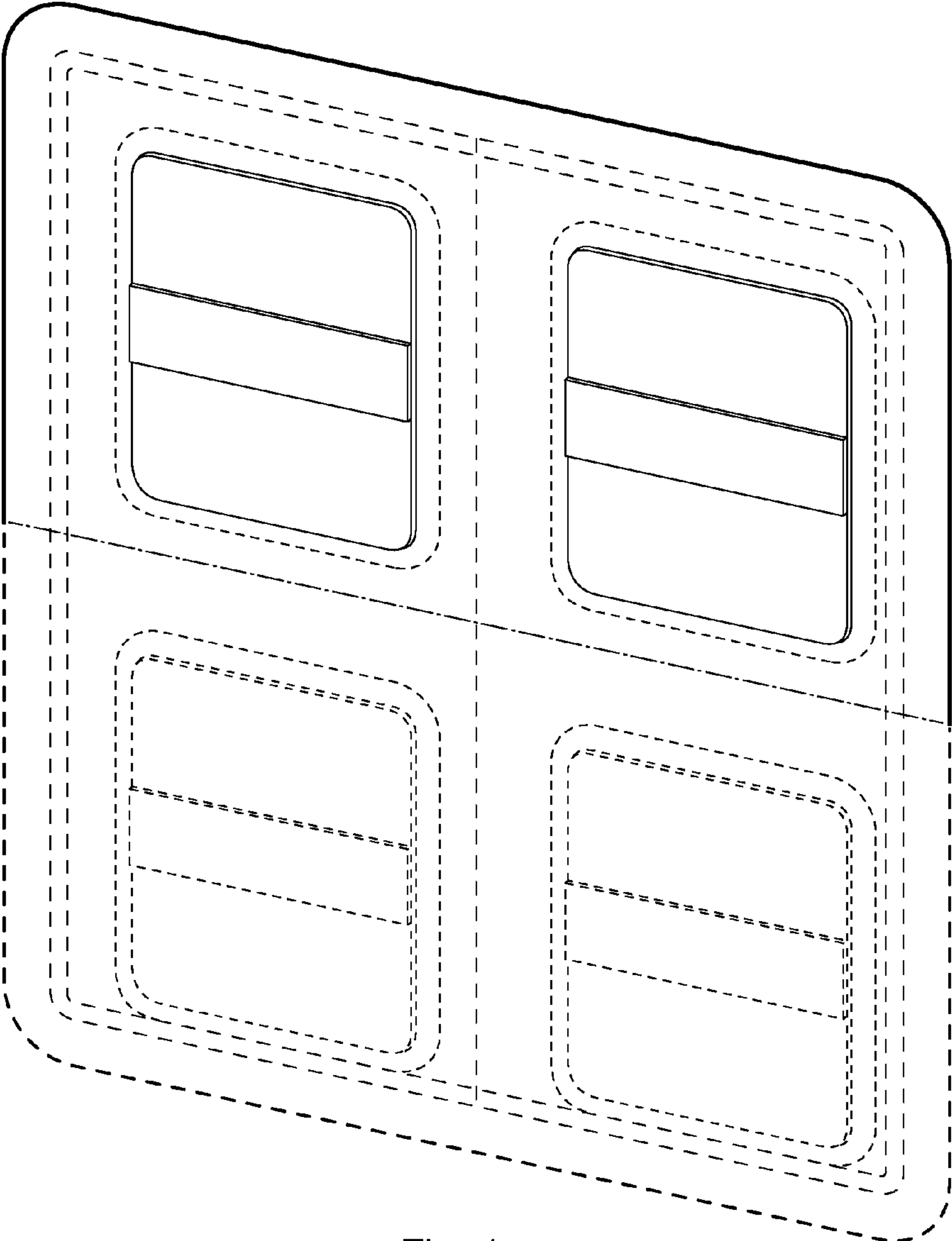

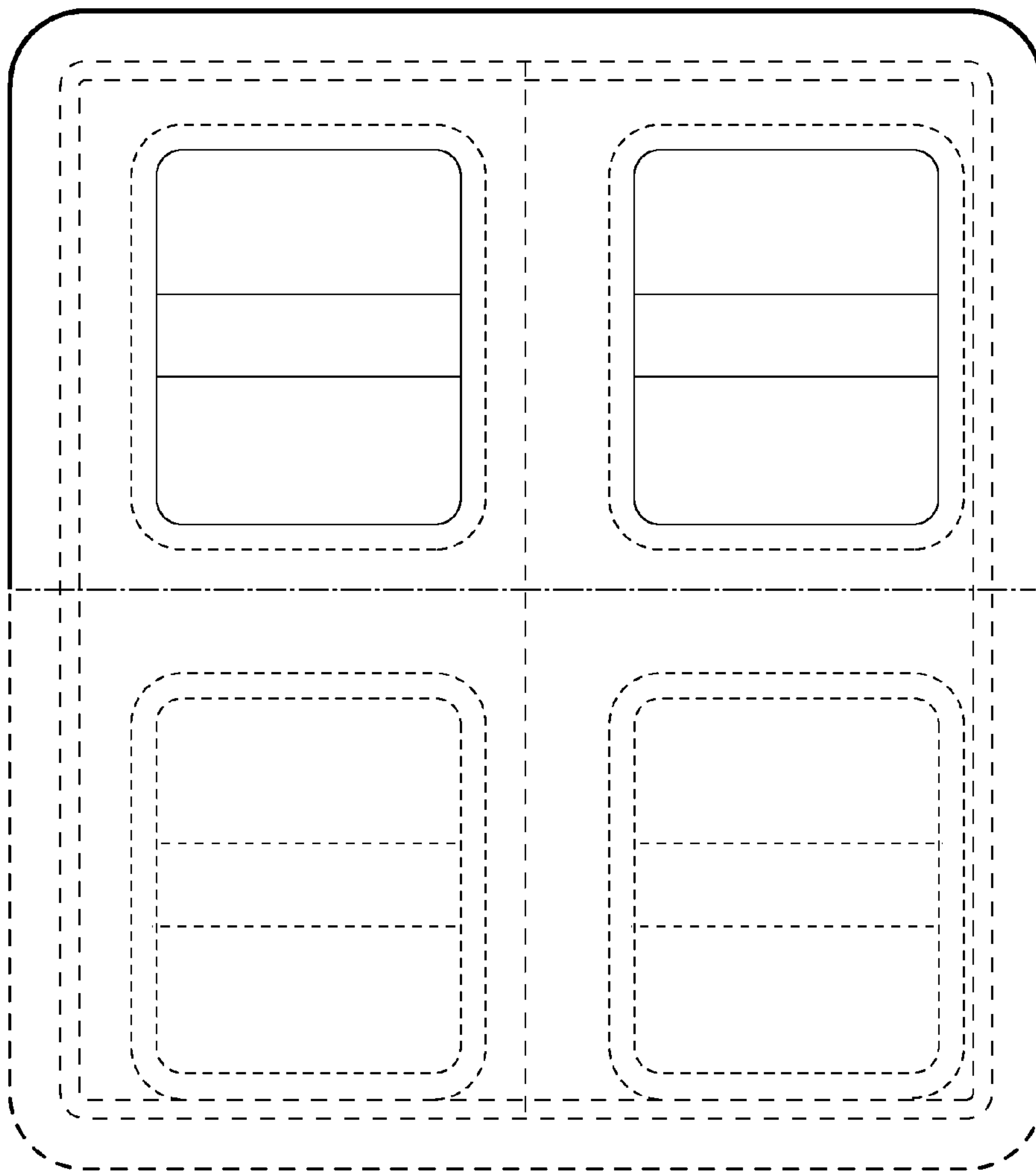

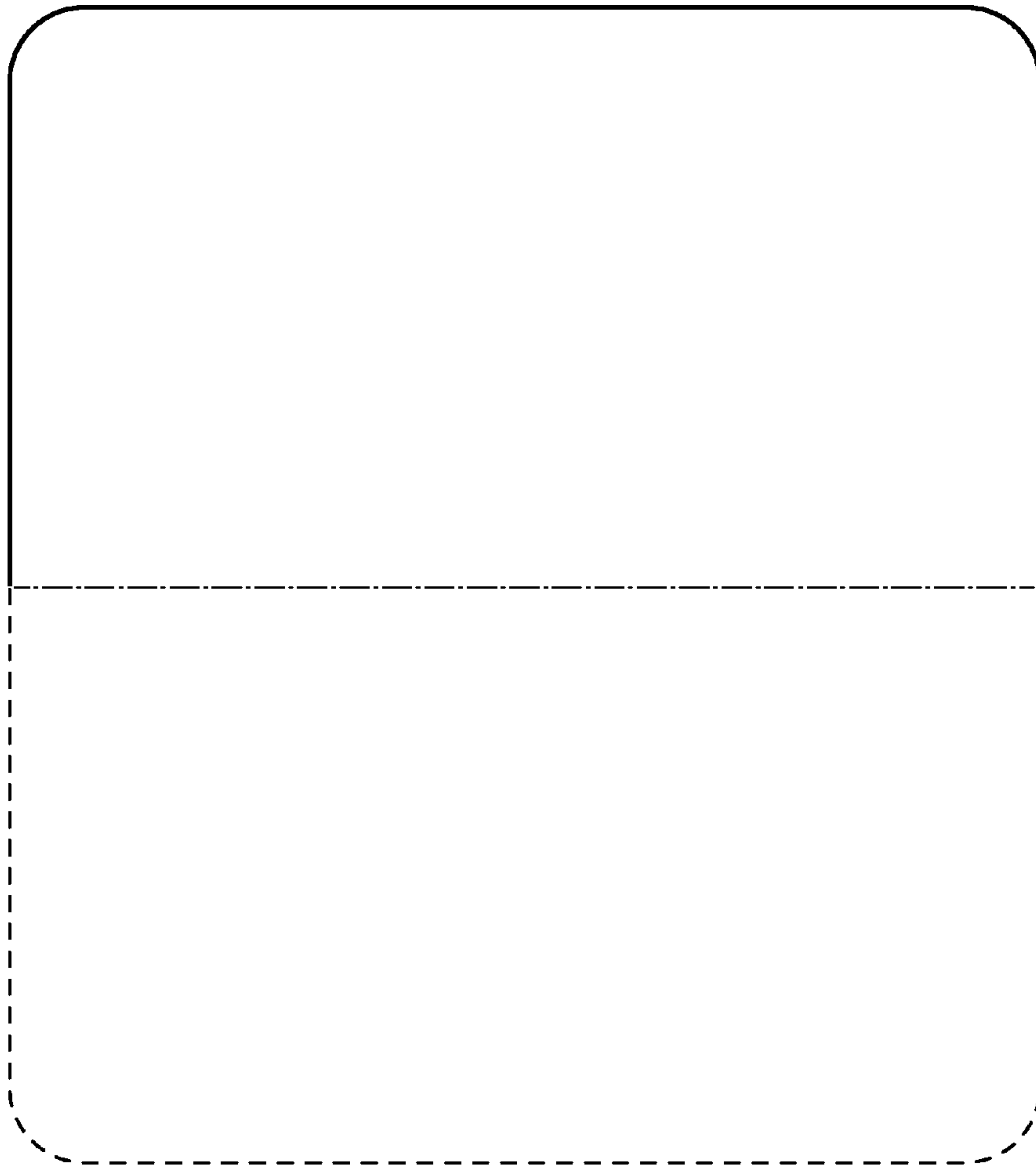

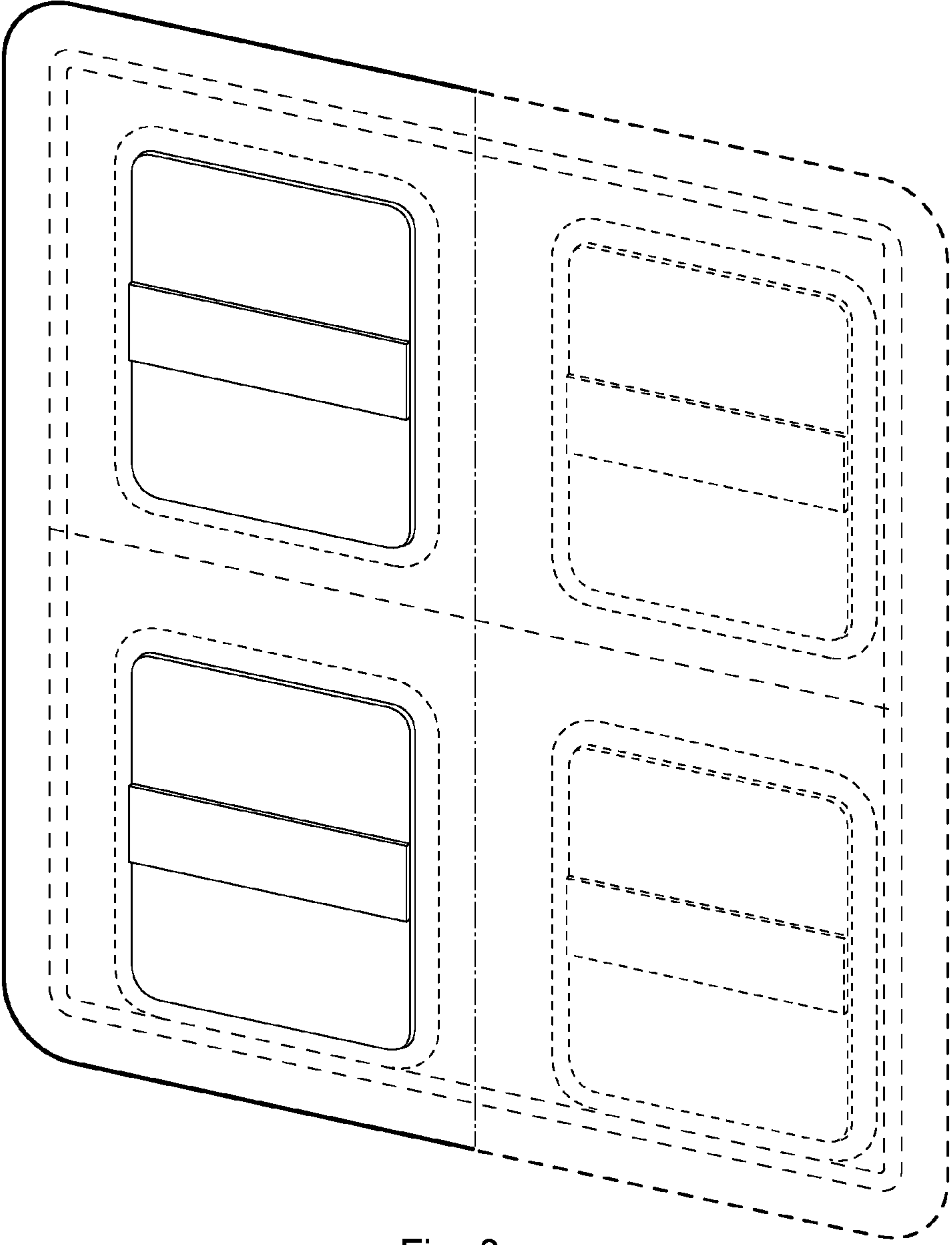

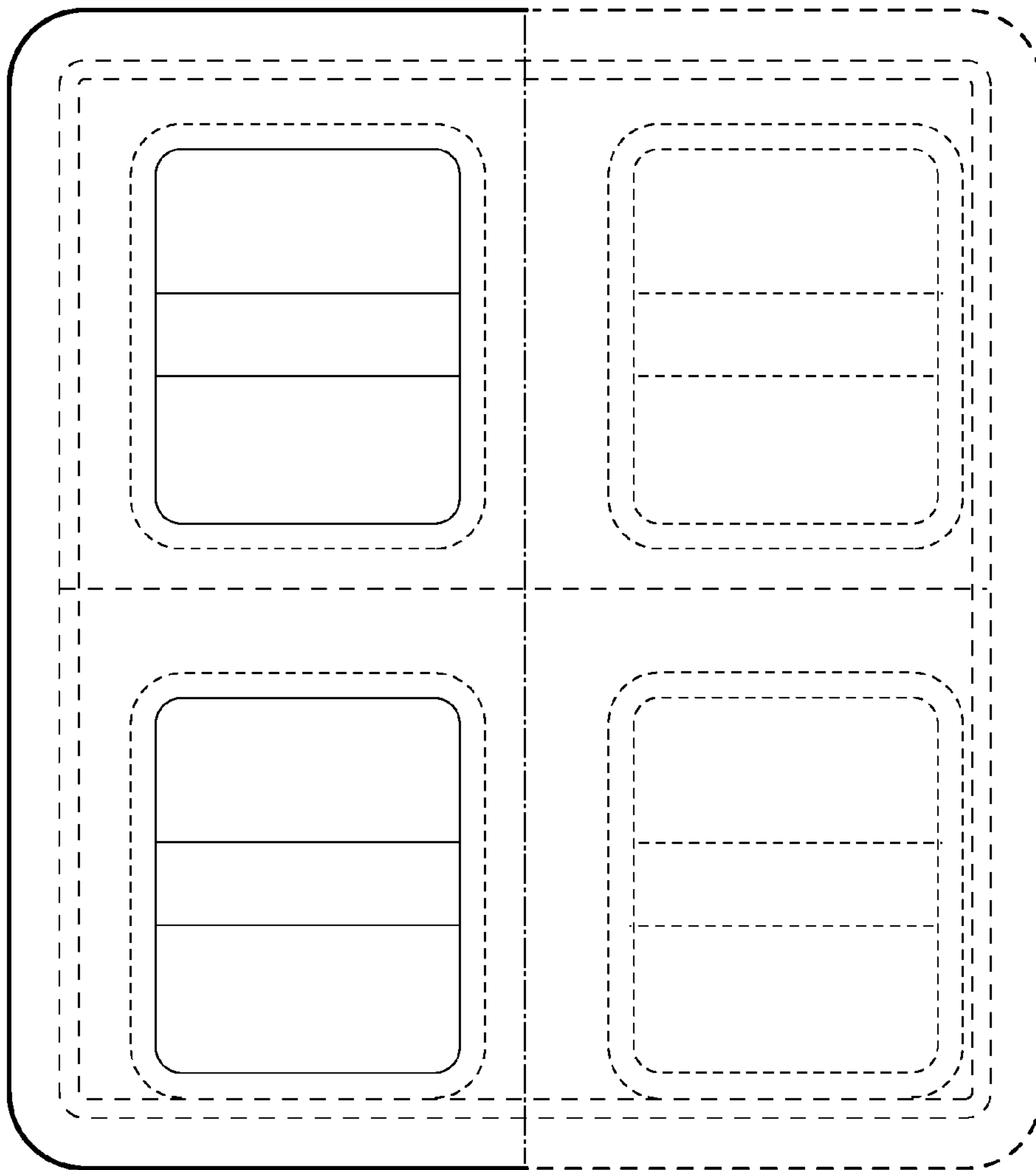

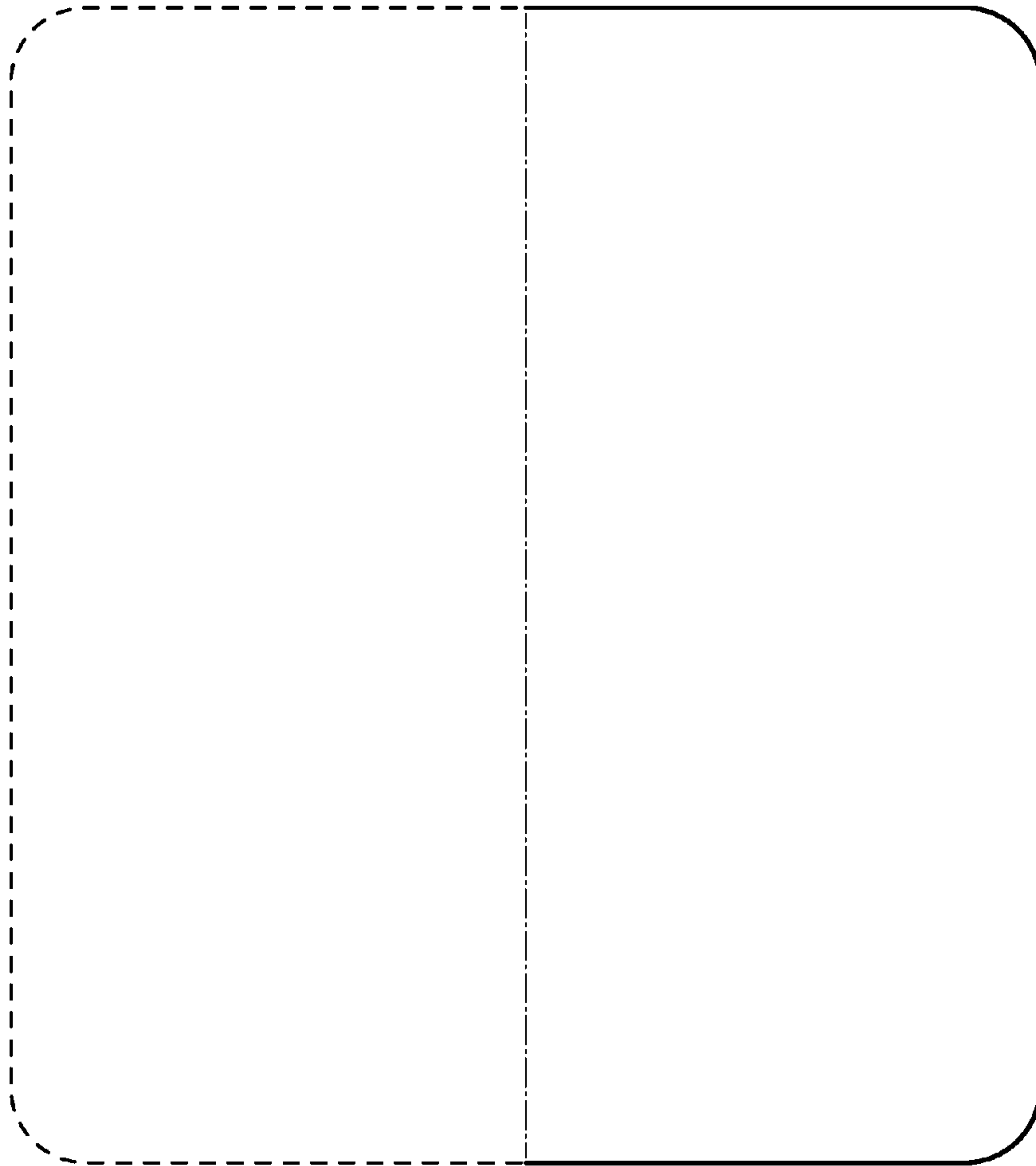

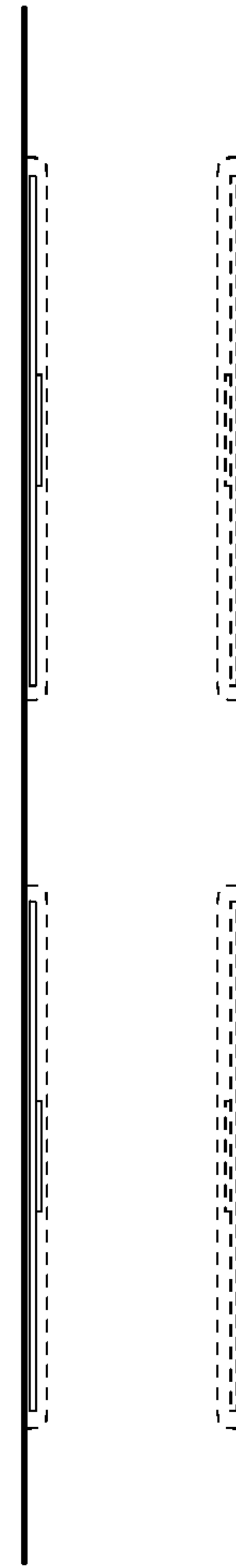


Fig. 11 Fig. 12

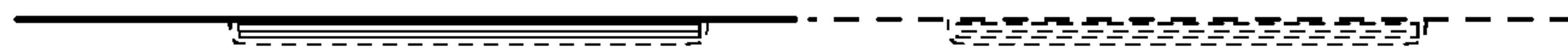
