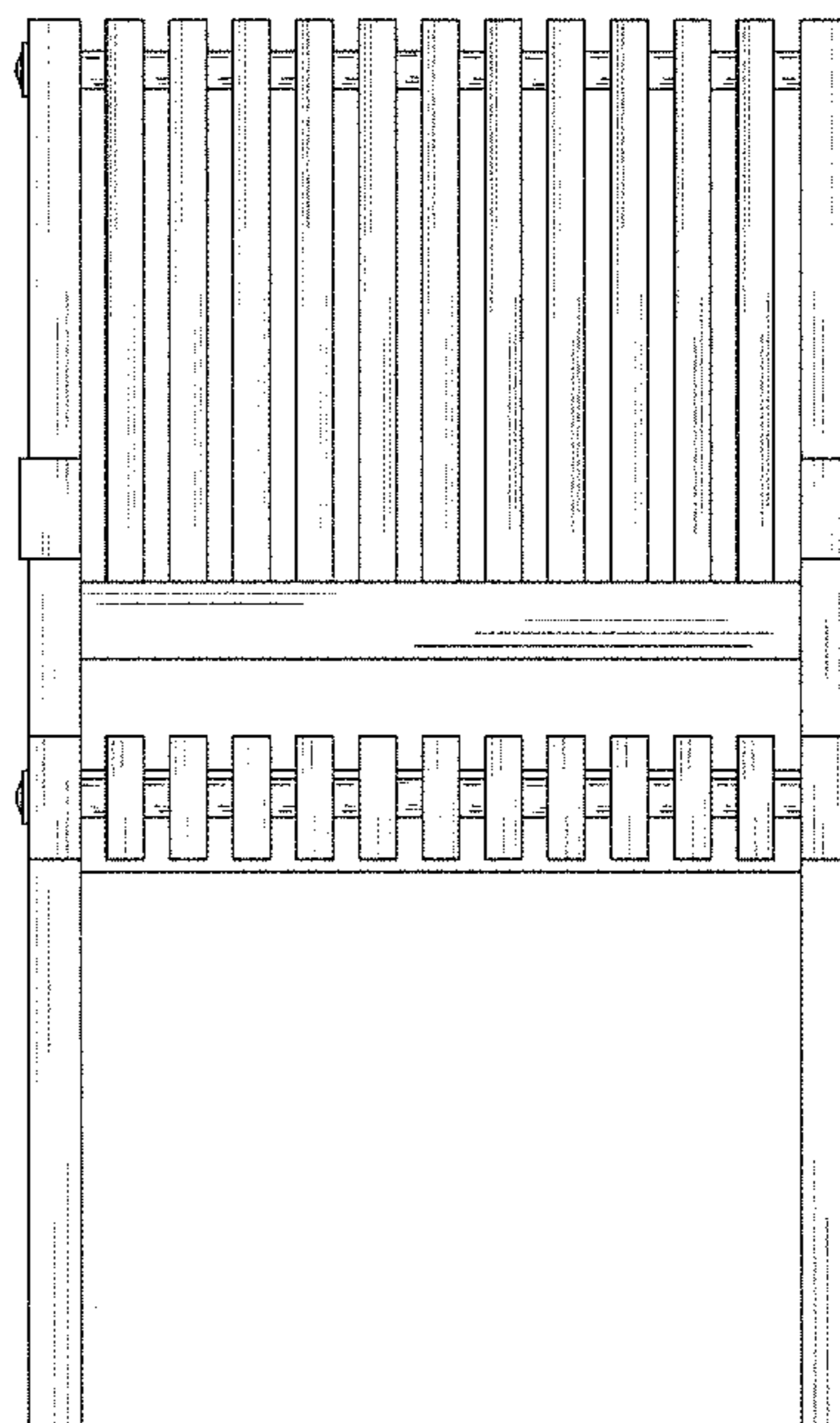
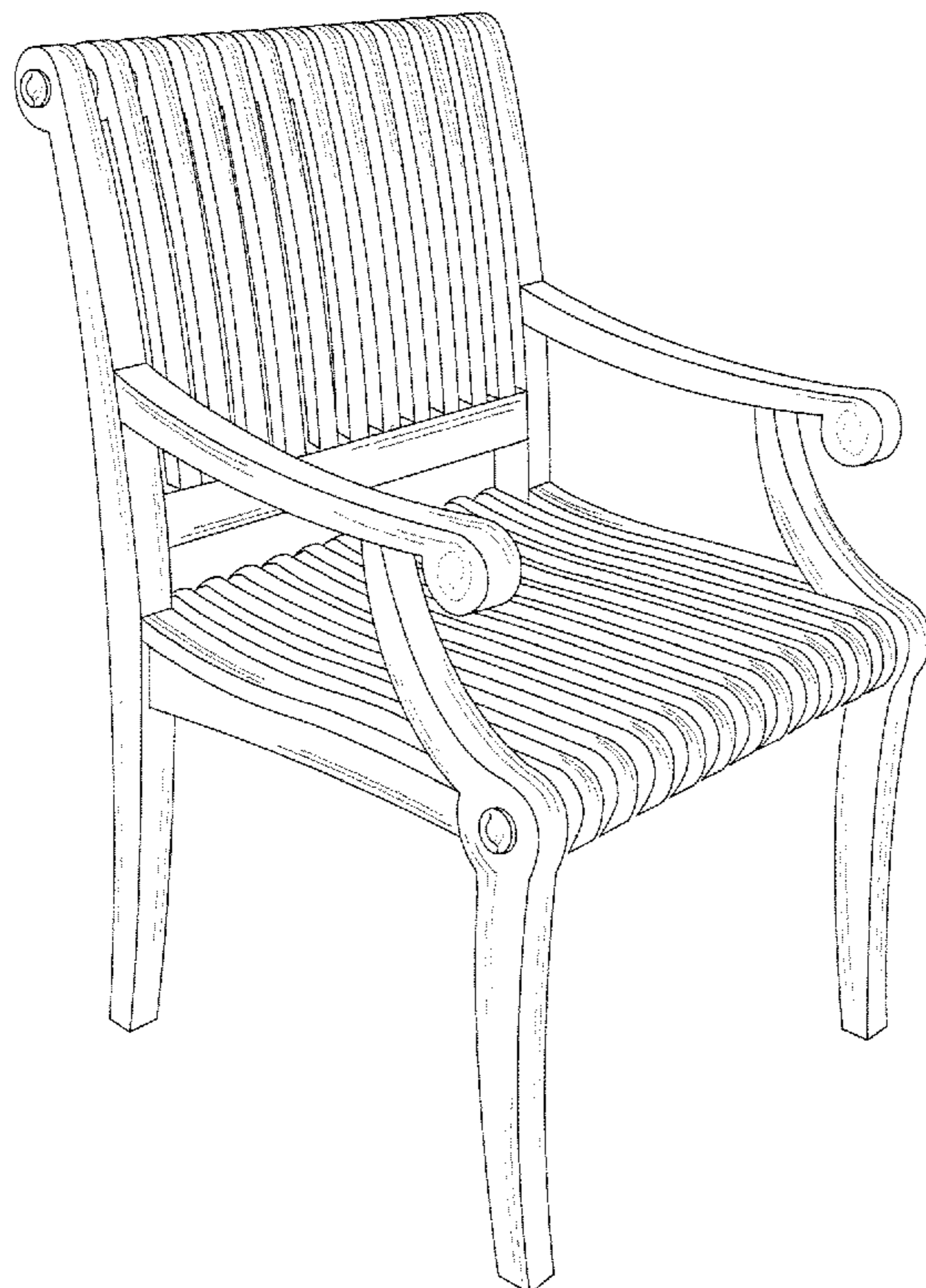
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a frontal perspective view of the armchair showing my new design;

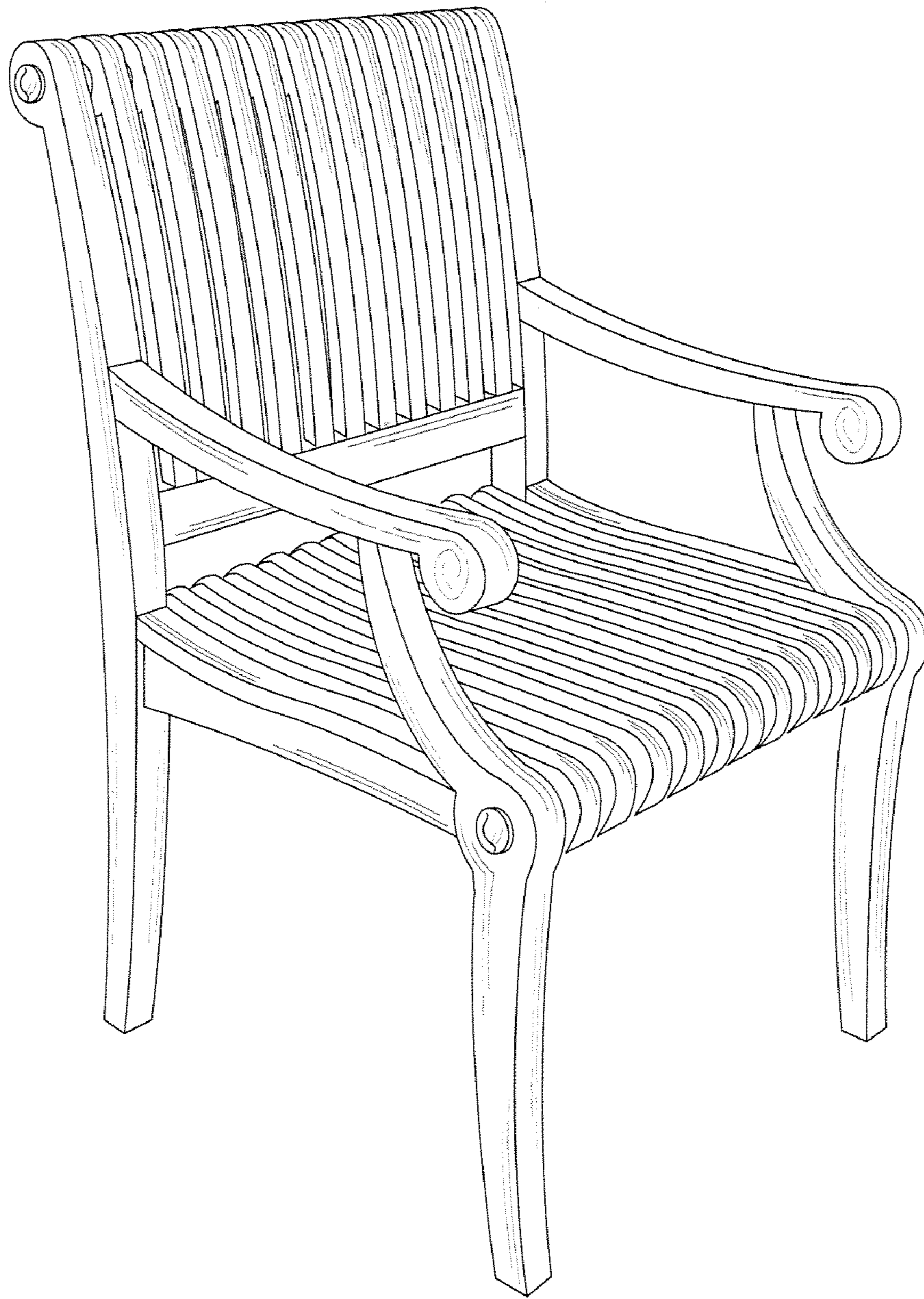

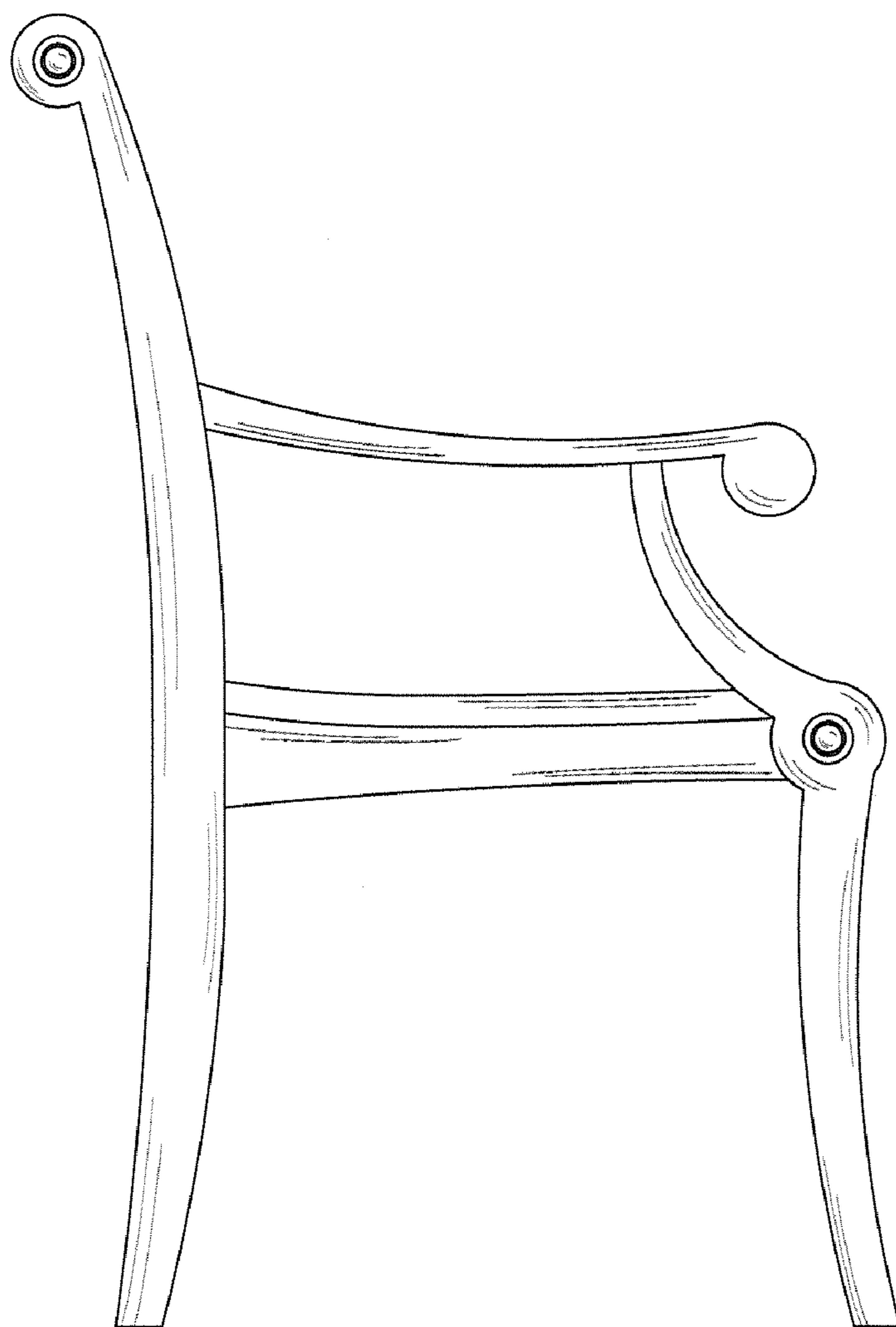

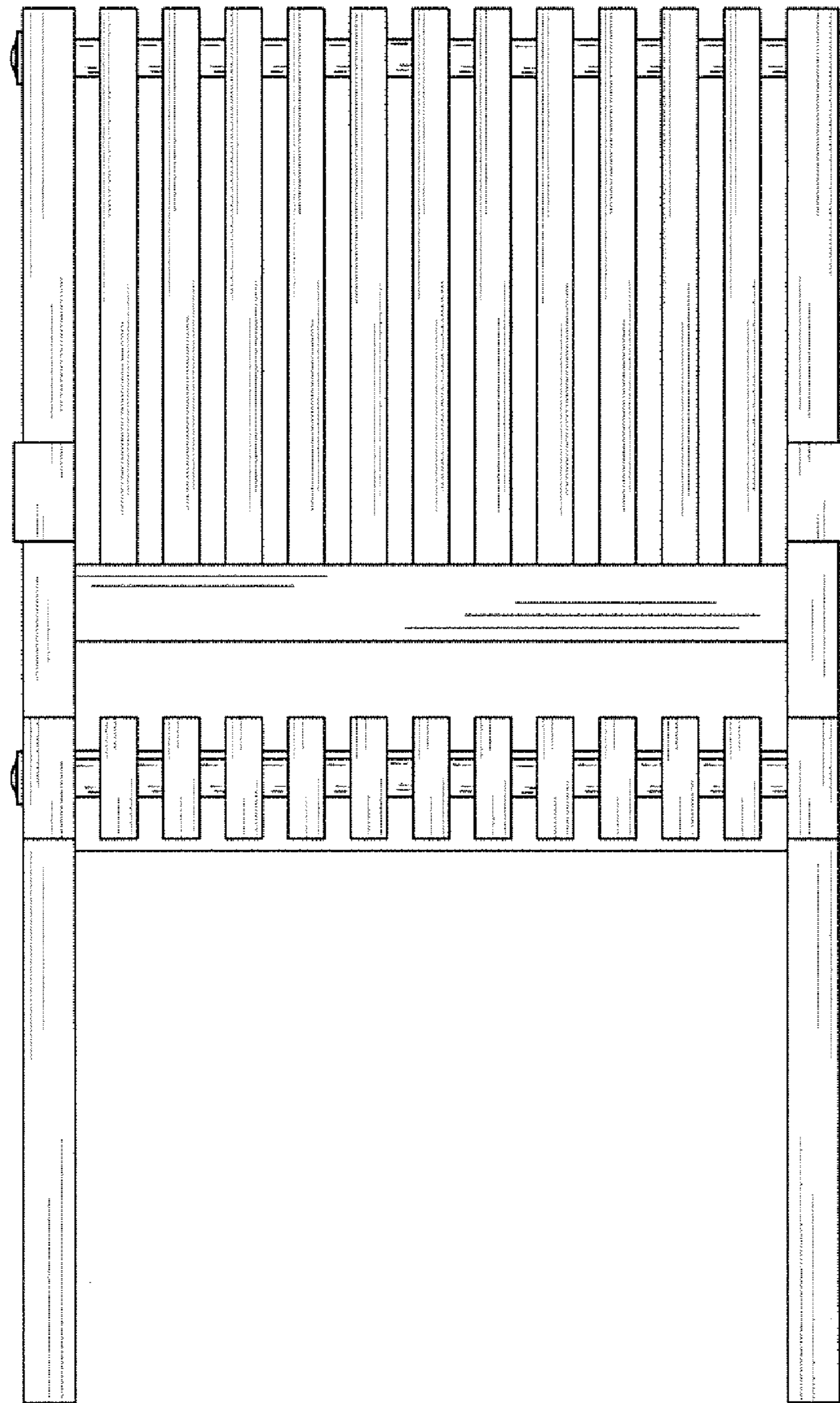

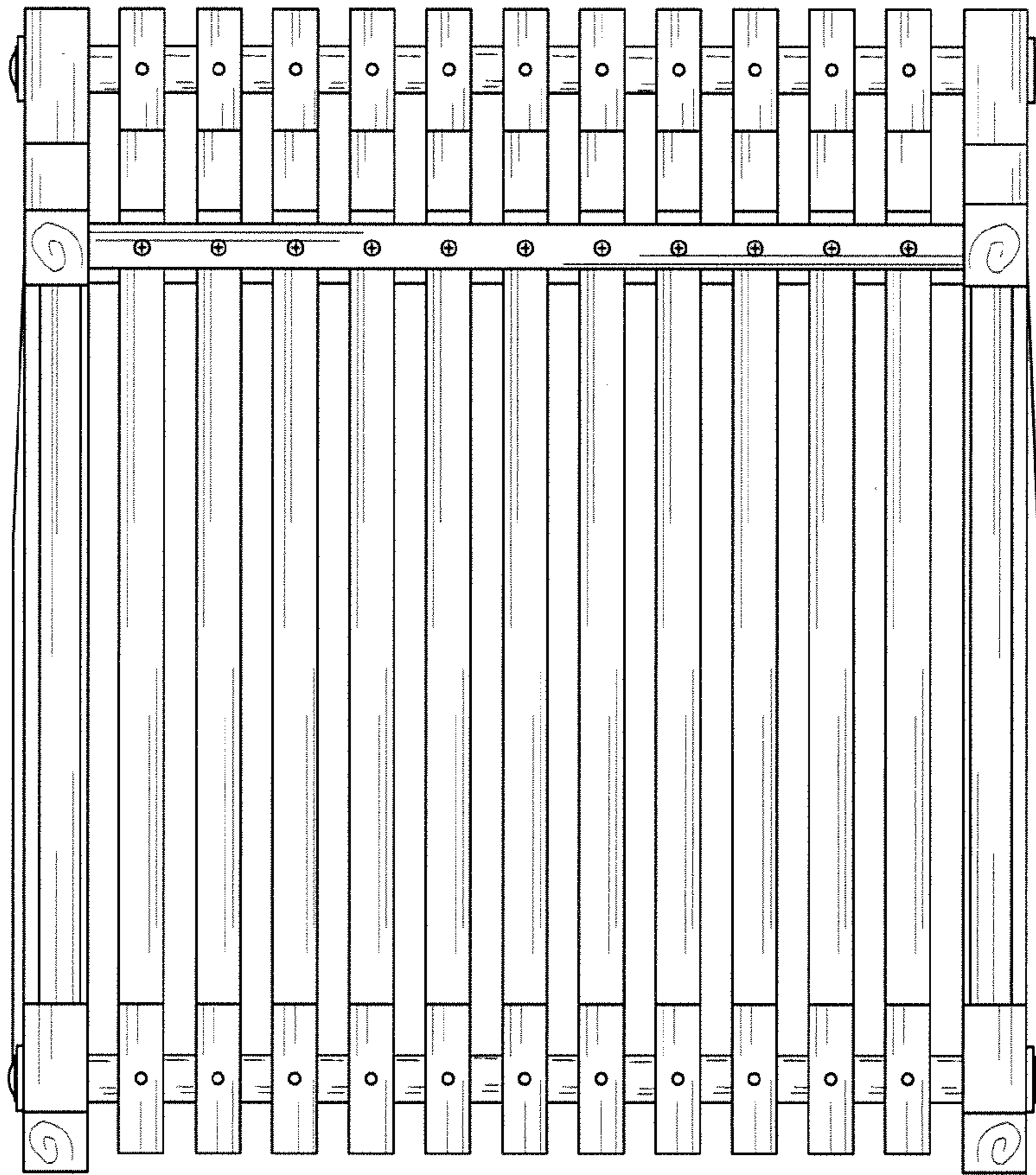

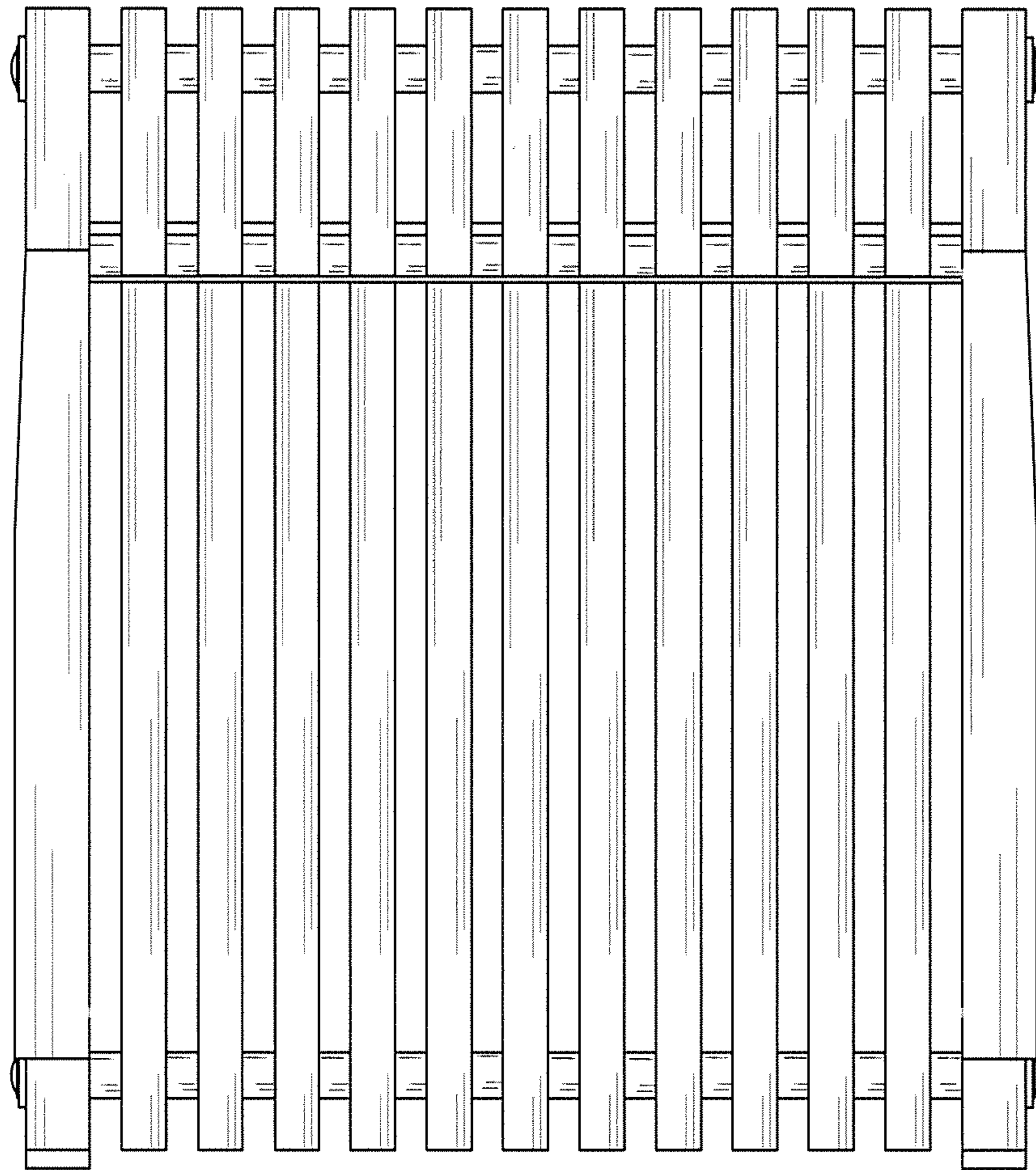

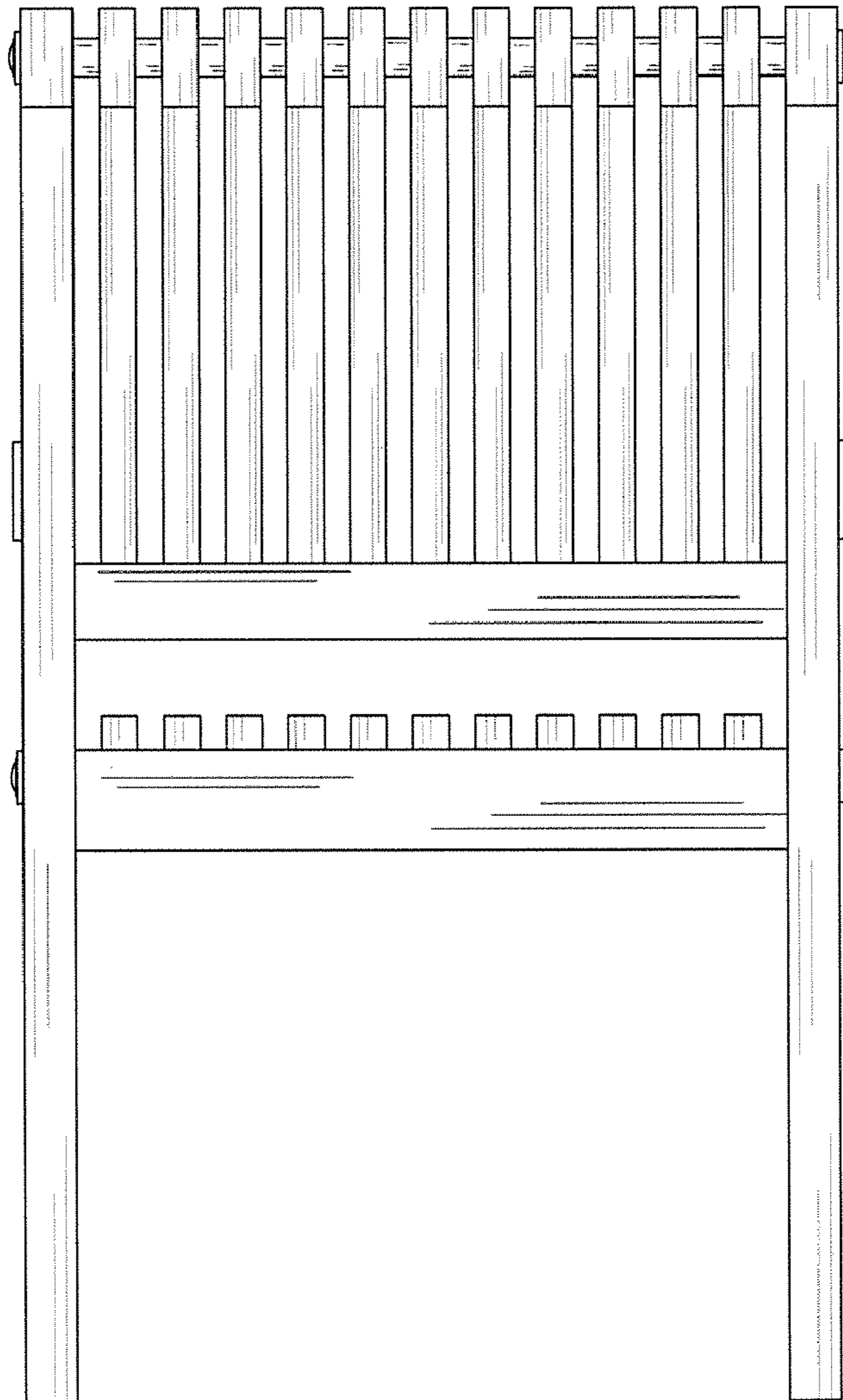
