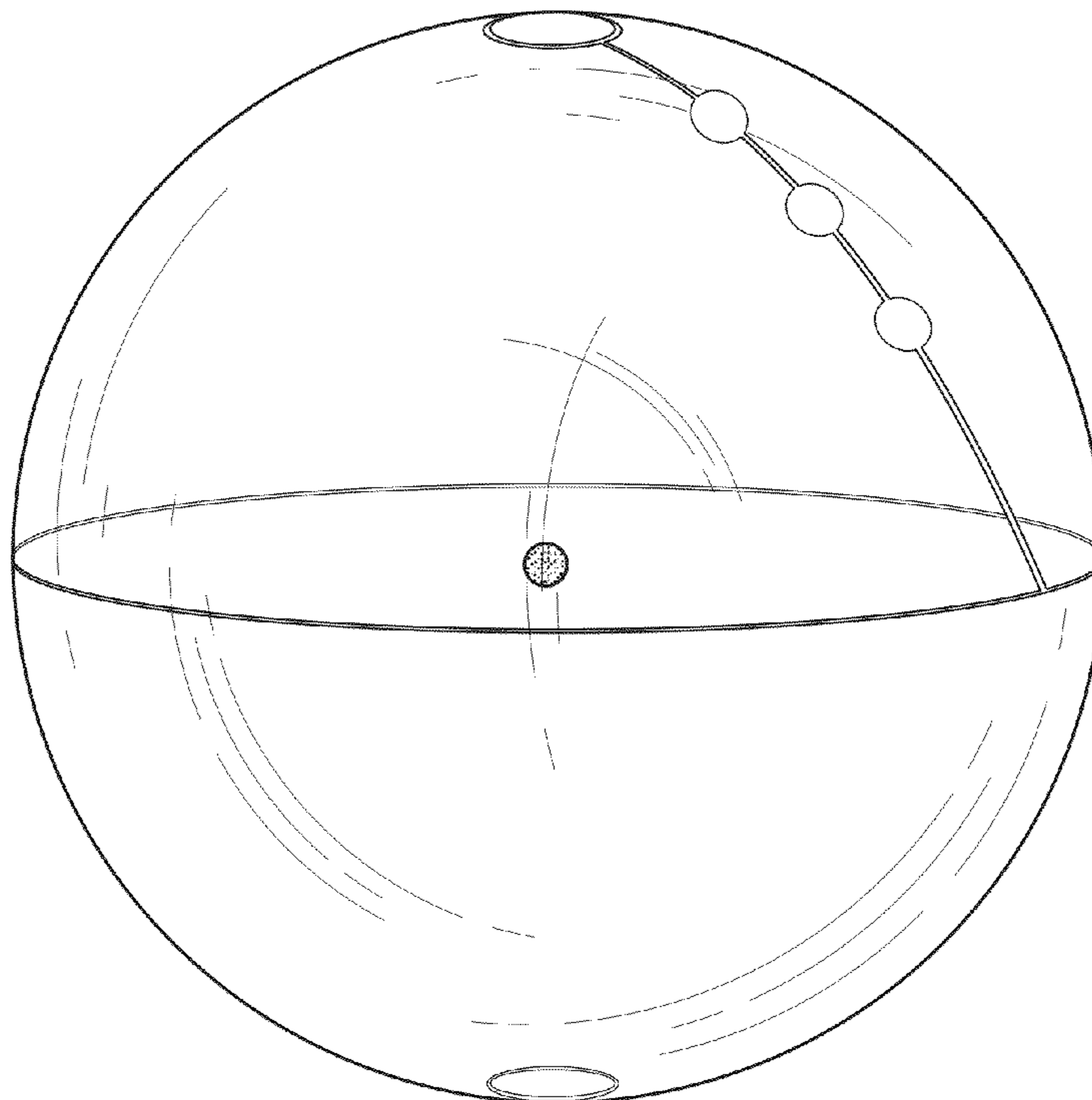
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a transparent billiards training cue ball, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a transparent billiards training cue ball, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
The stippling represents color contrast consonant with the visual appearance shown in the drawings.

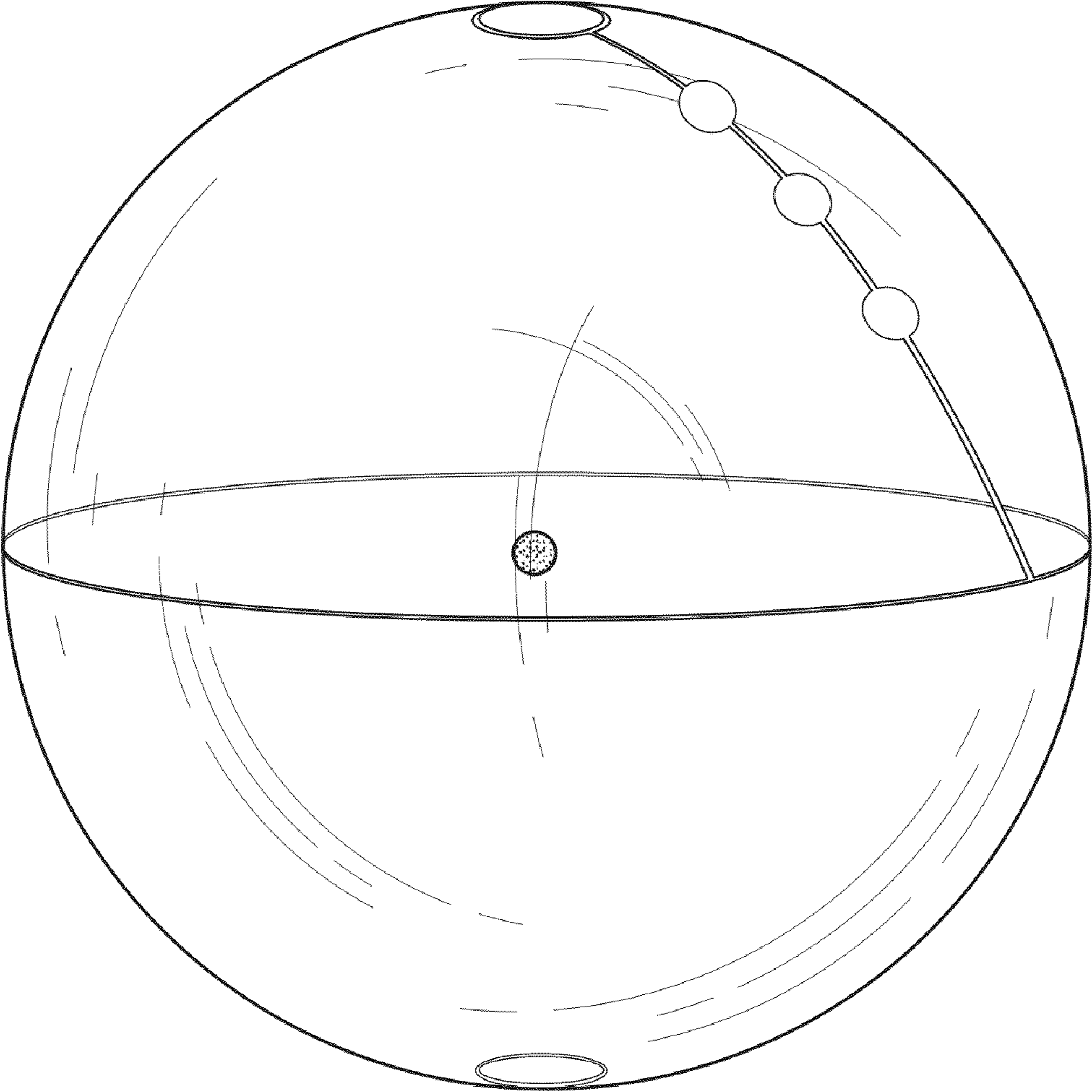

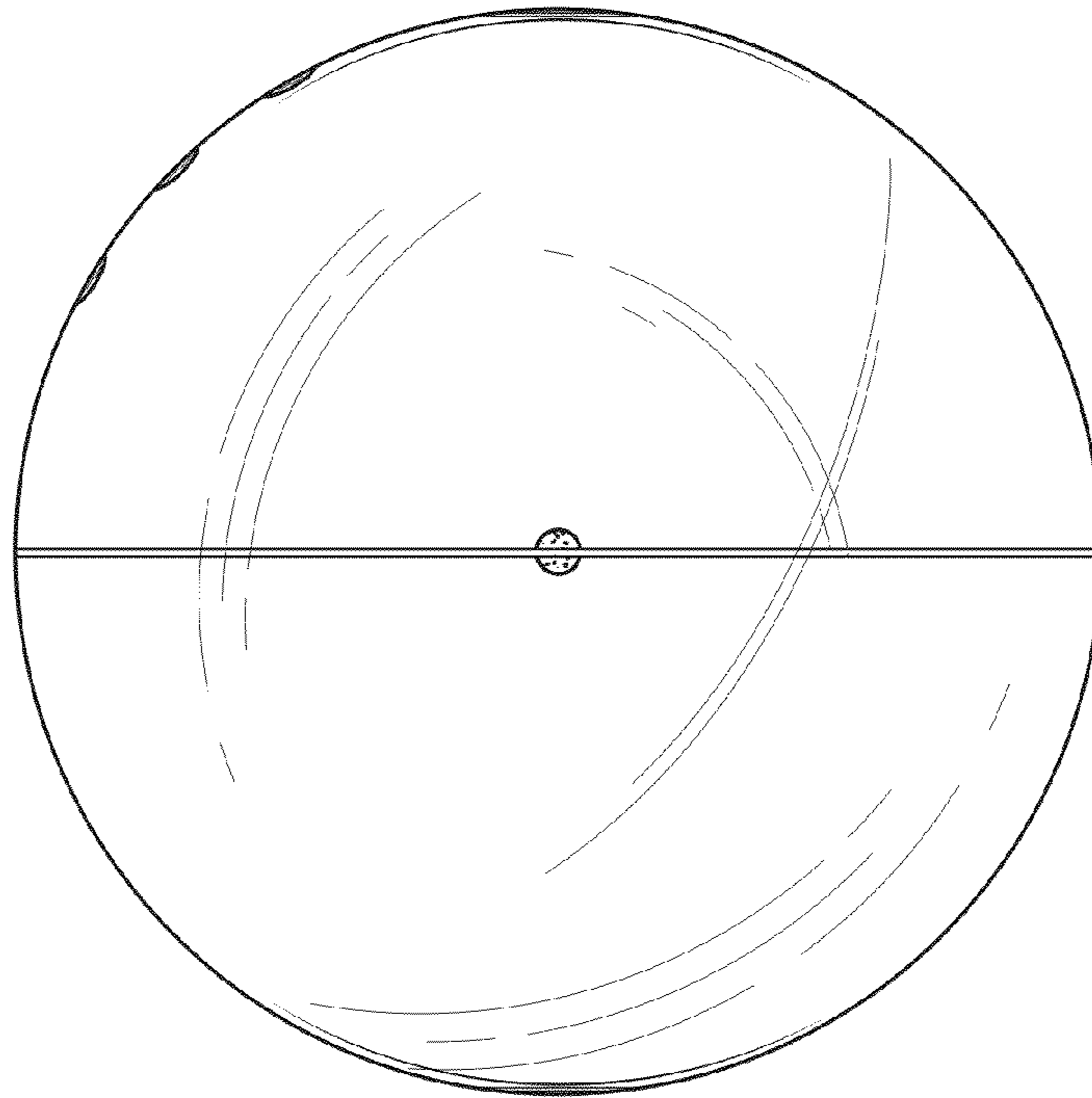

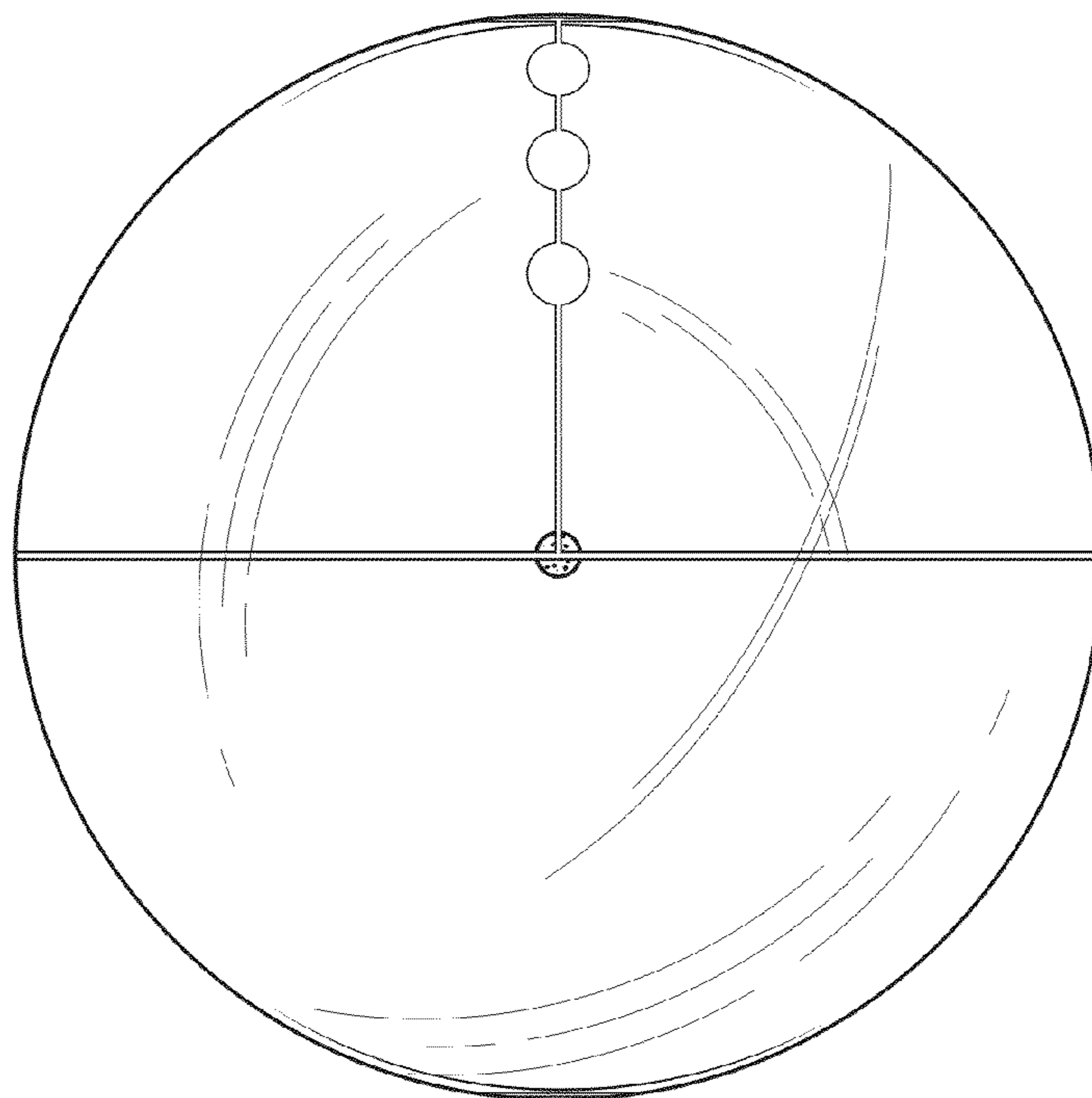

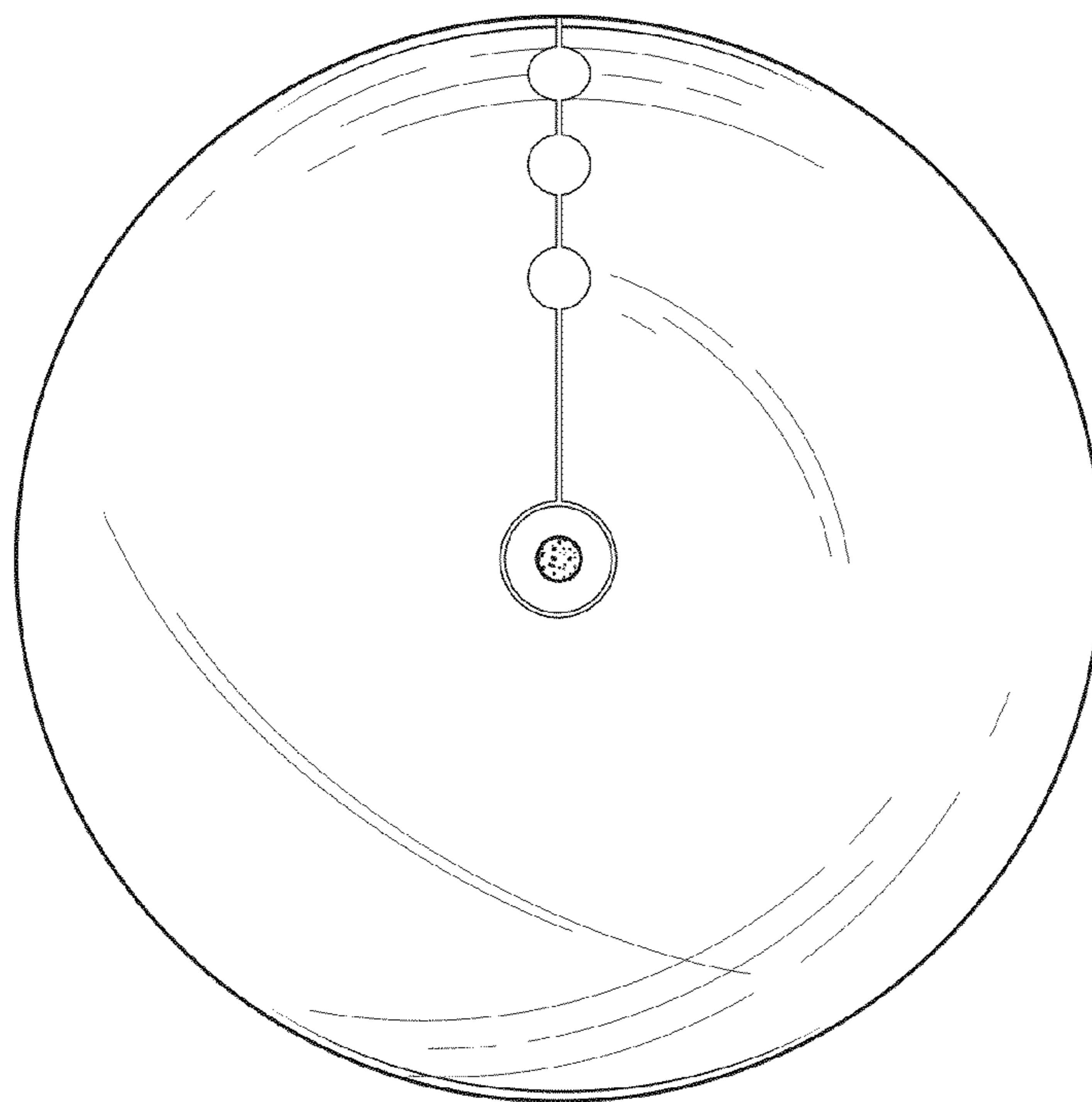

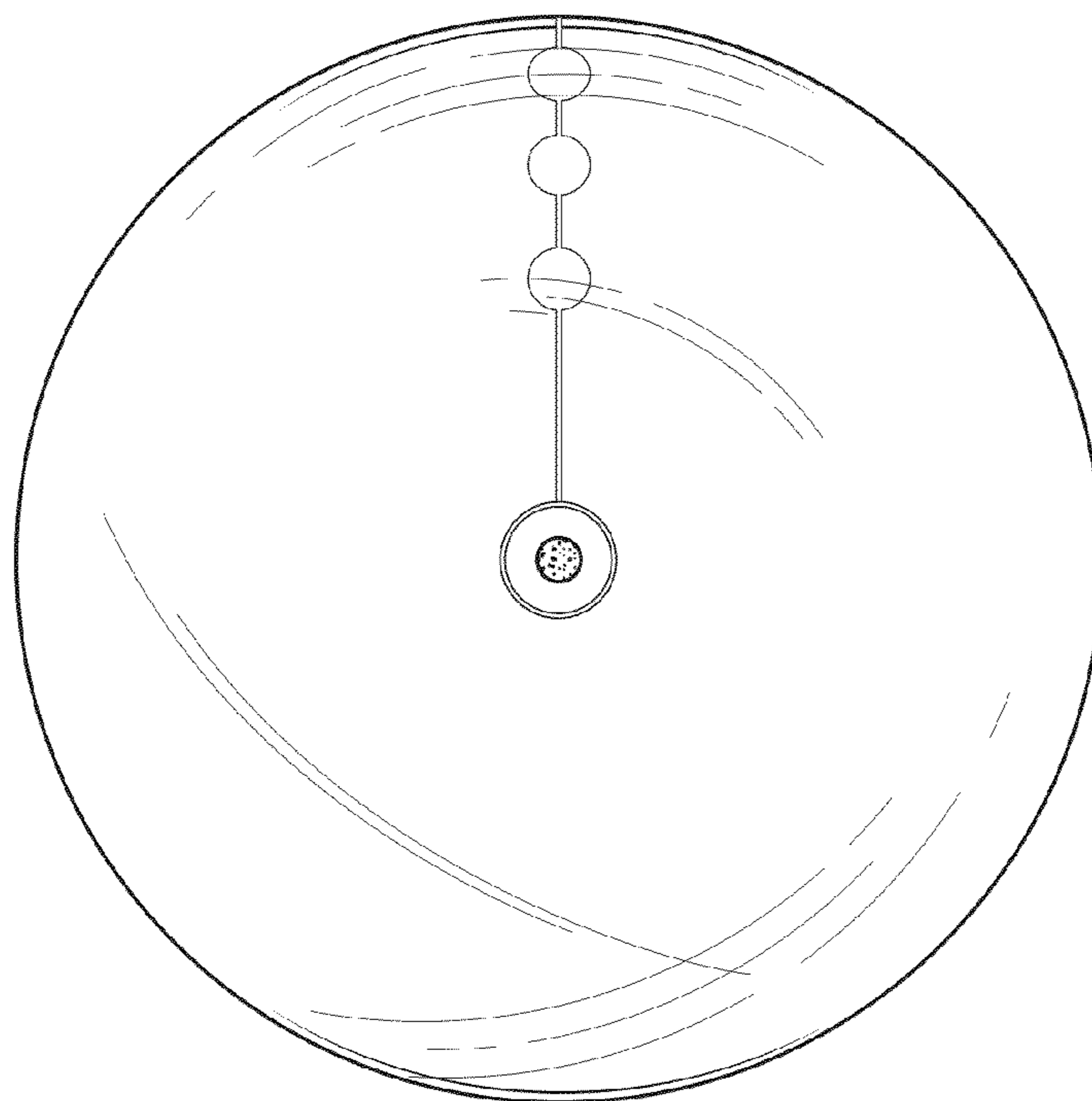
