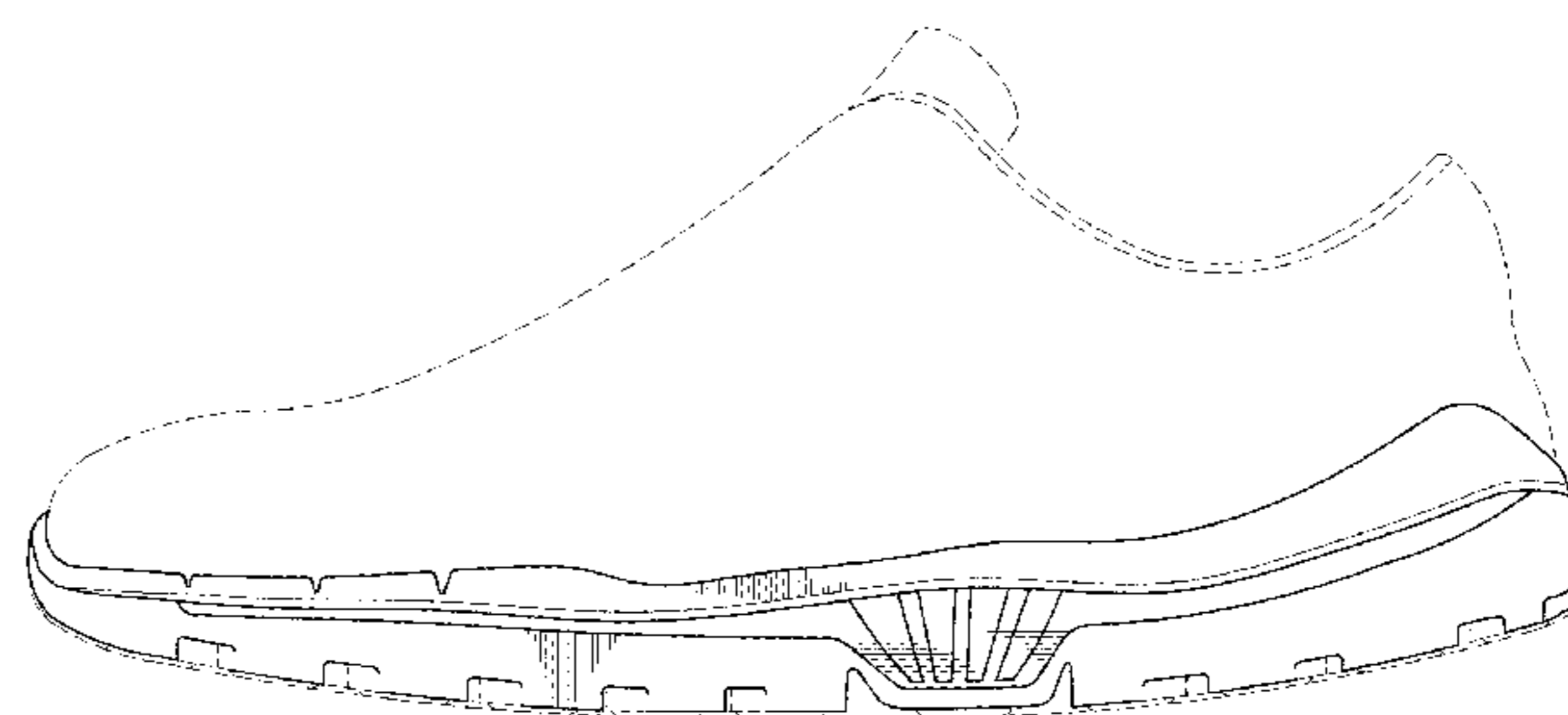
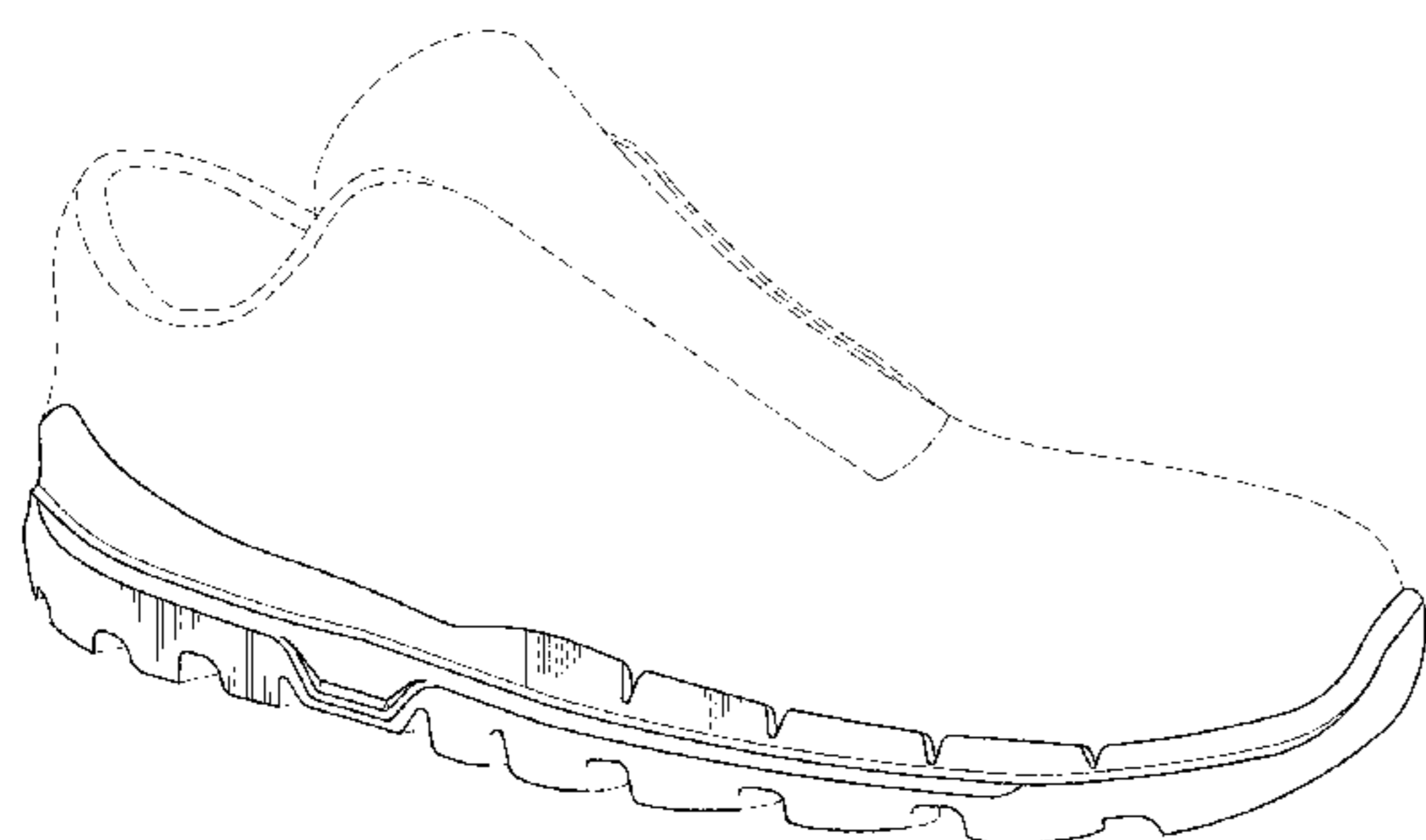
(57) **CLAIM**

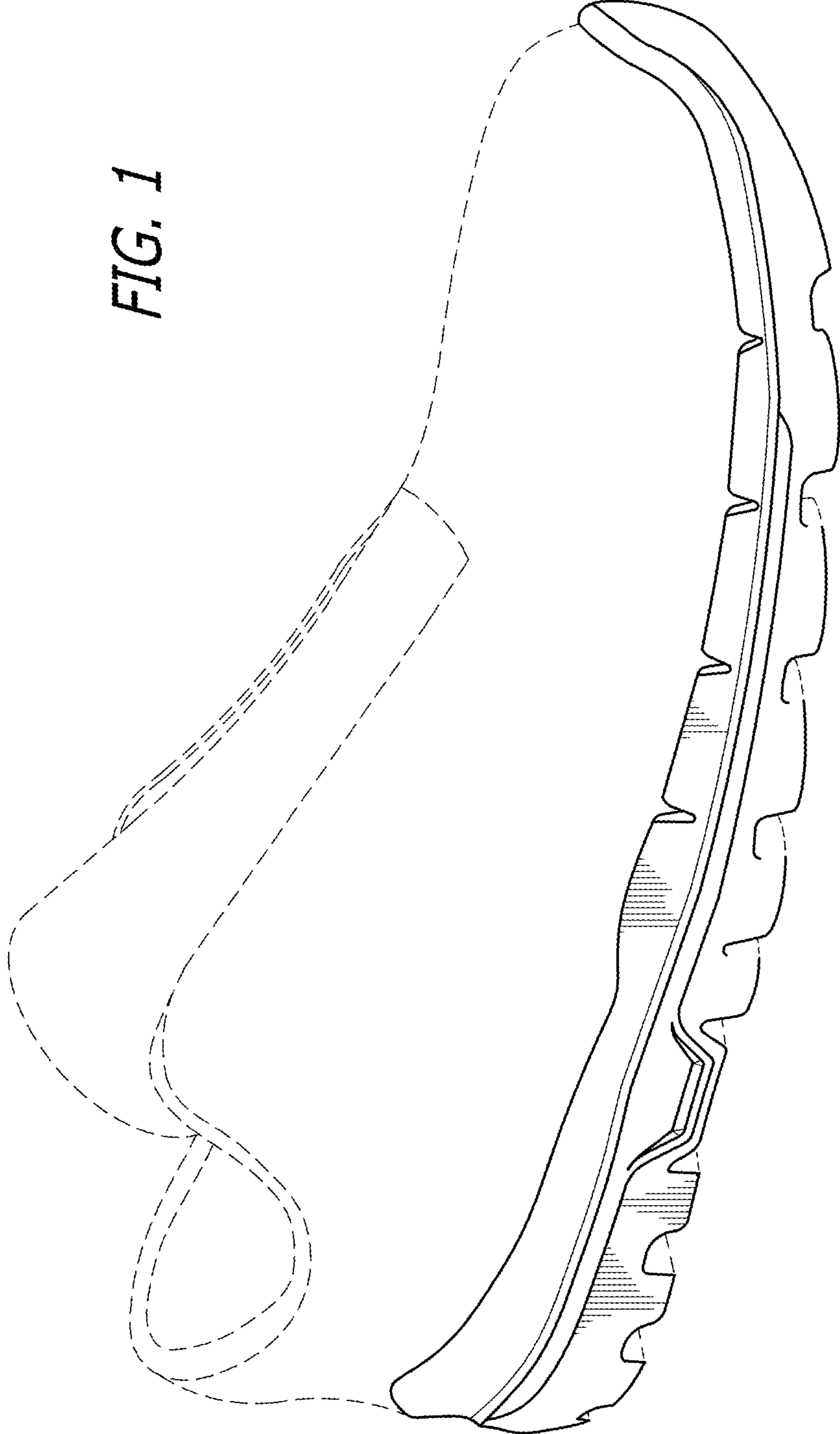
The ornamental design for a shoe outsole and periphery, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe outsole and periphery in accordance with my new design.  
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof; and,

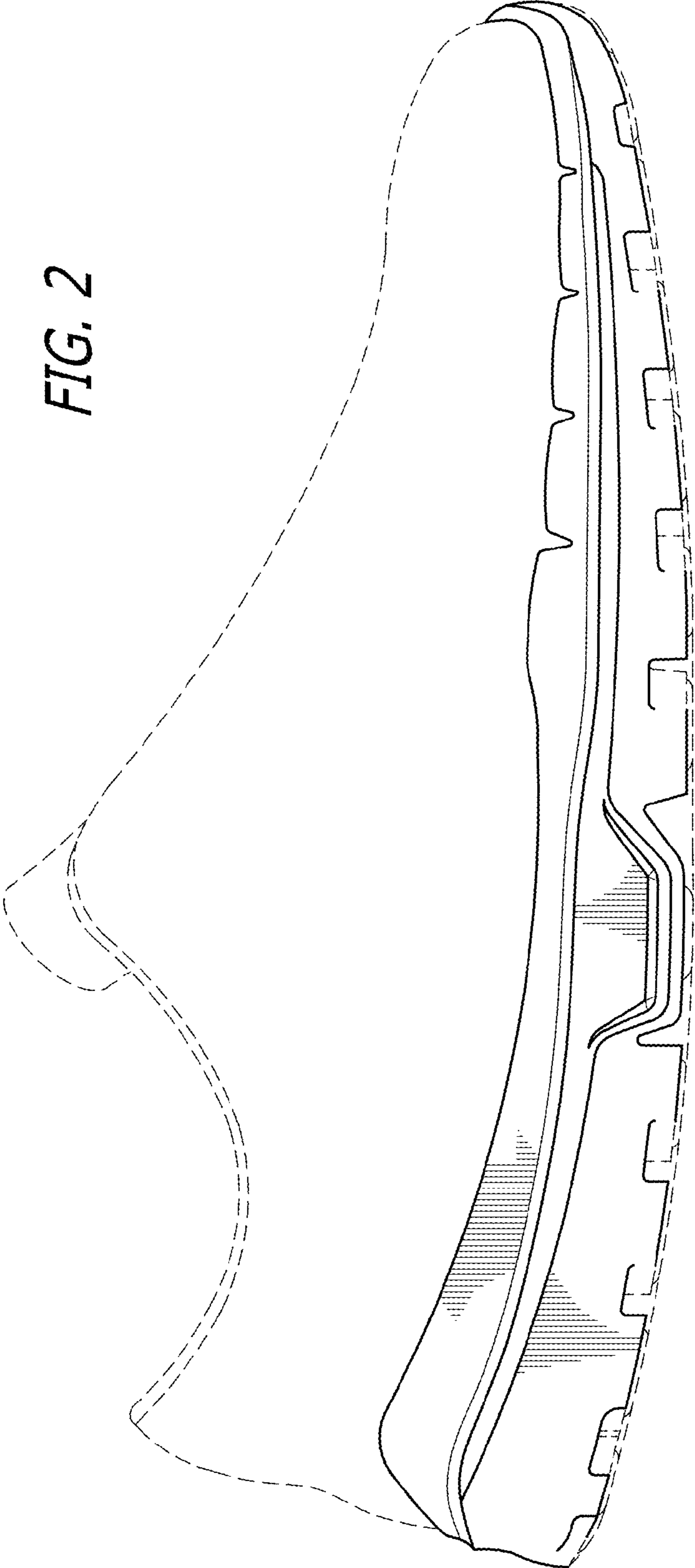

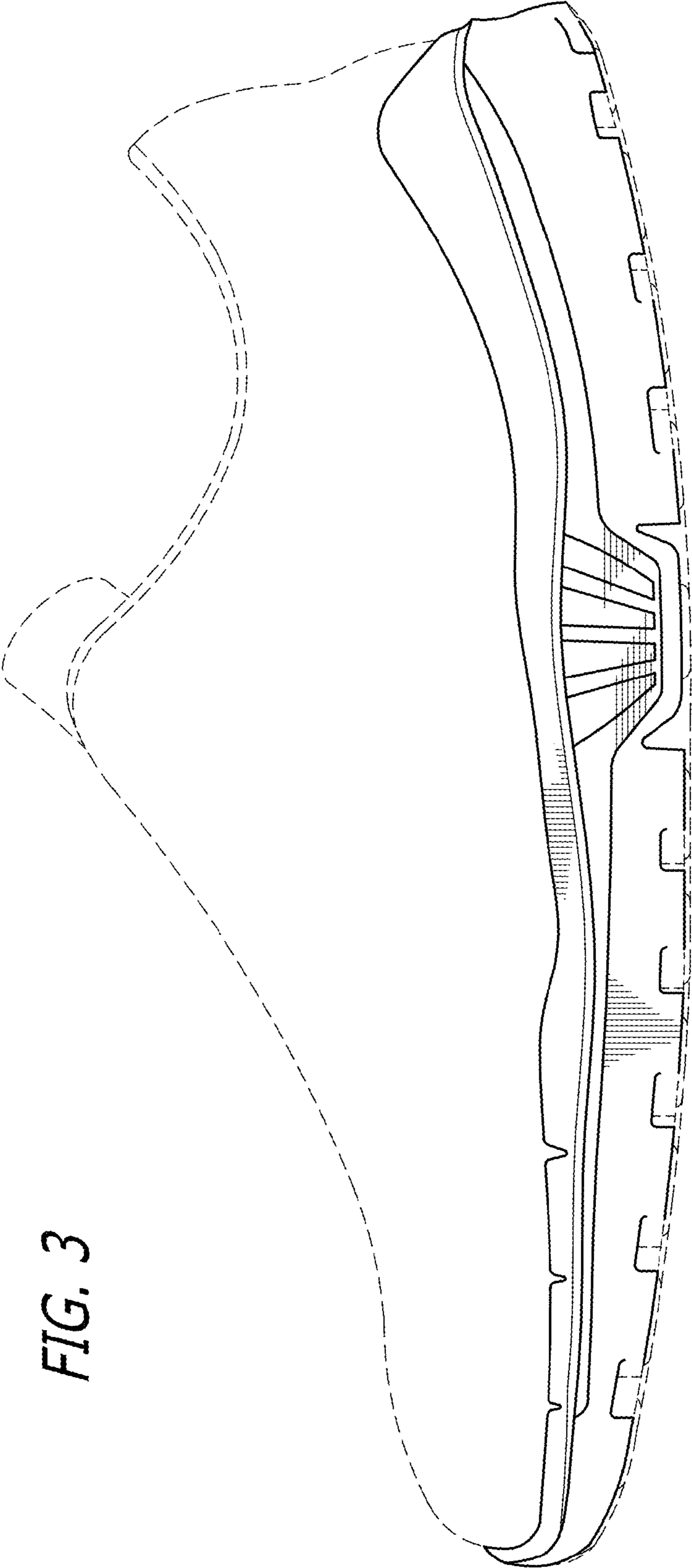

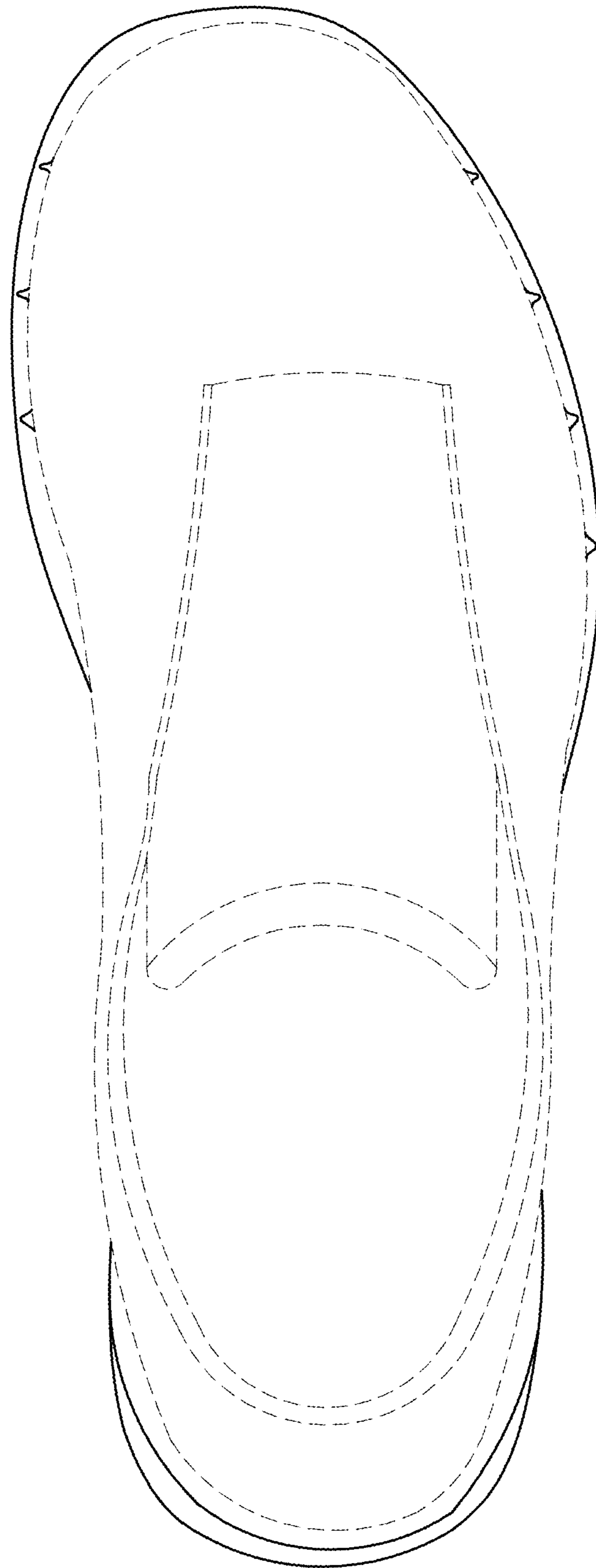

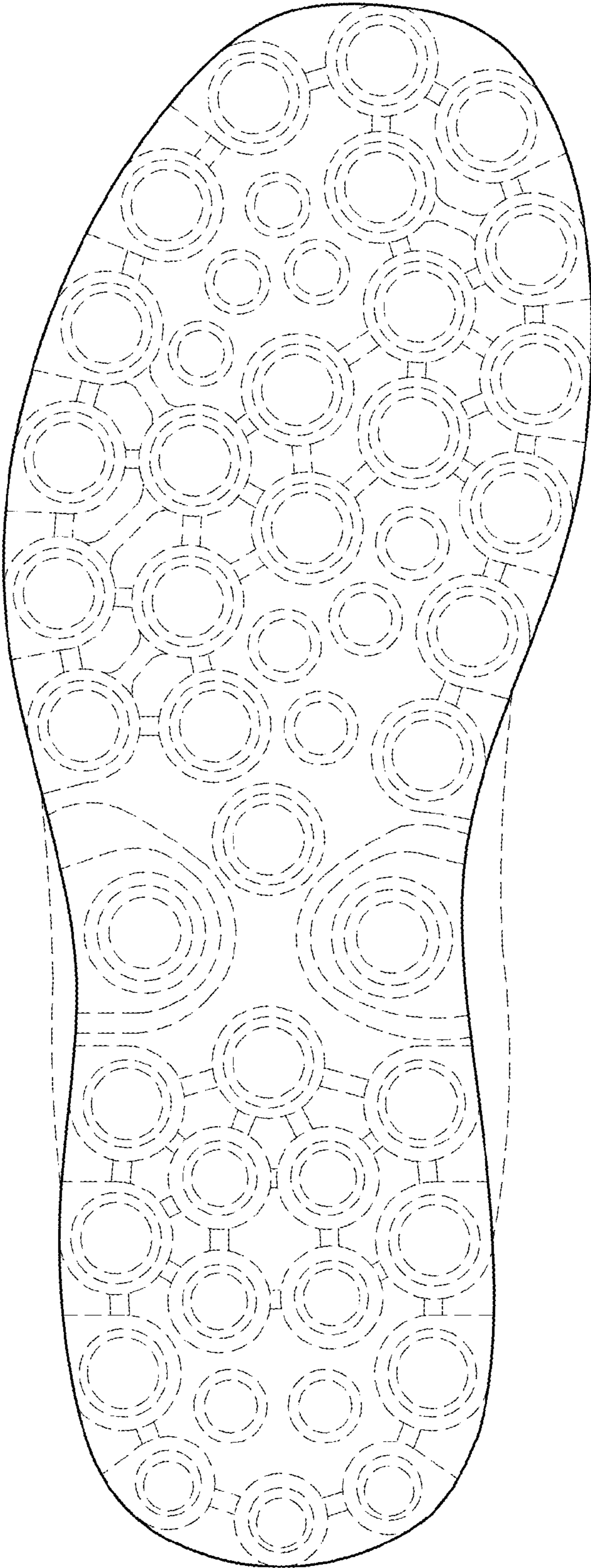

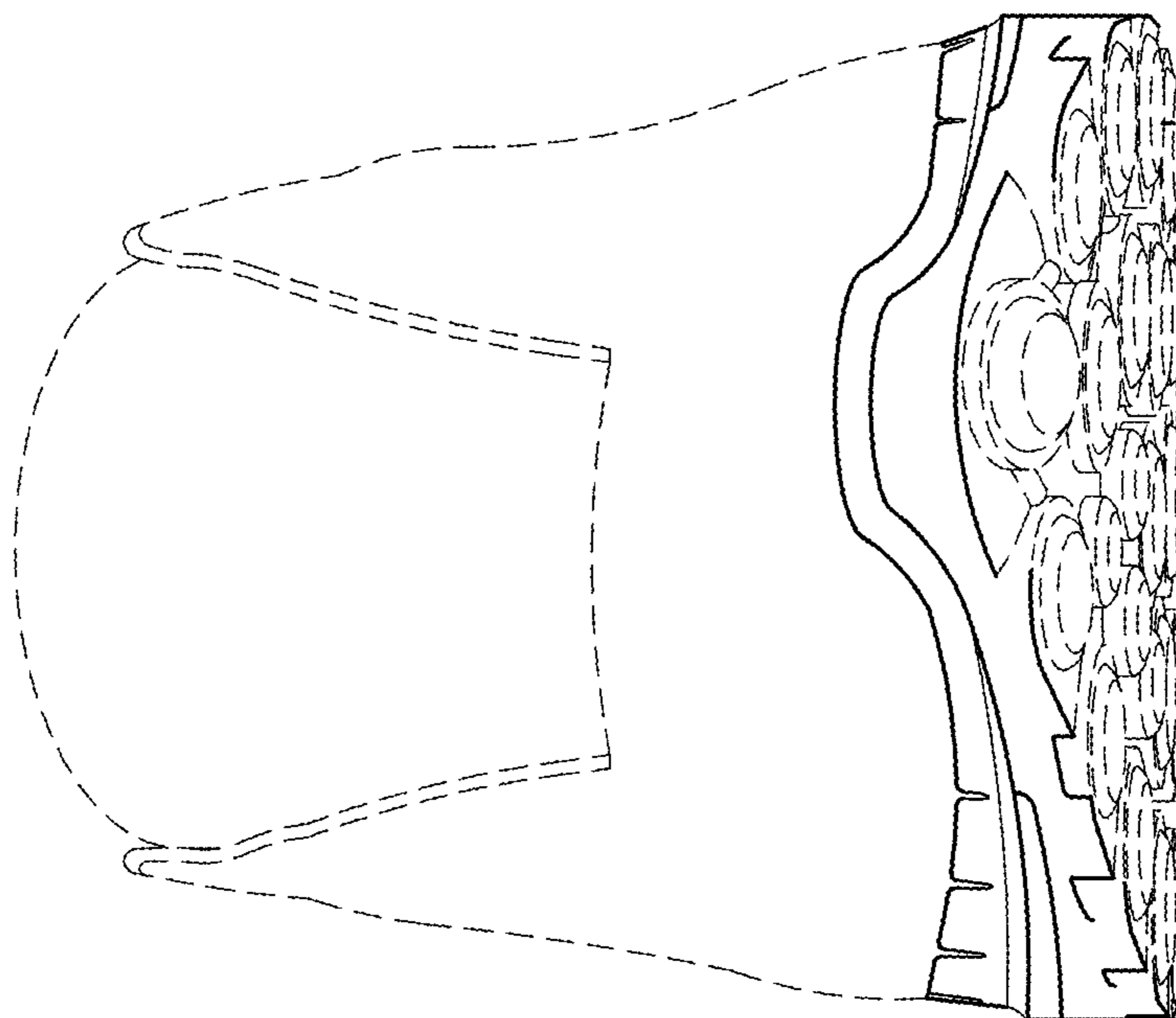
