DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a broom housing assembly, and a bristle assembly shown in phantom;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the broom housing assembly illustrated in FIG. 1, with the bristle assembly shown in phantom;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the broom housing assembly illustrated in FIG. 1, with the bristle assembly shown in phantom;

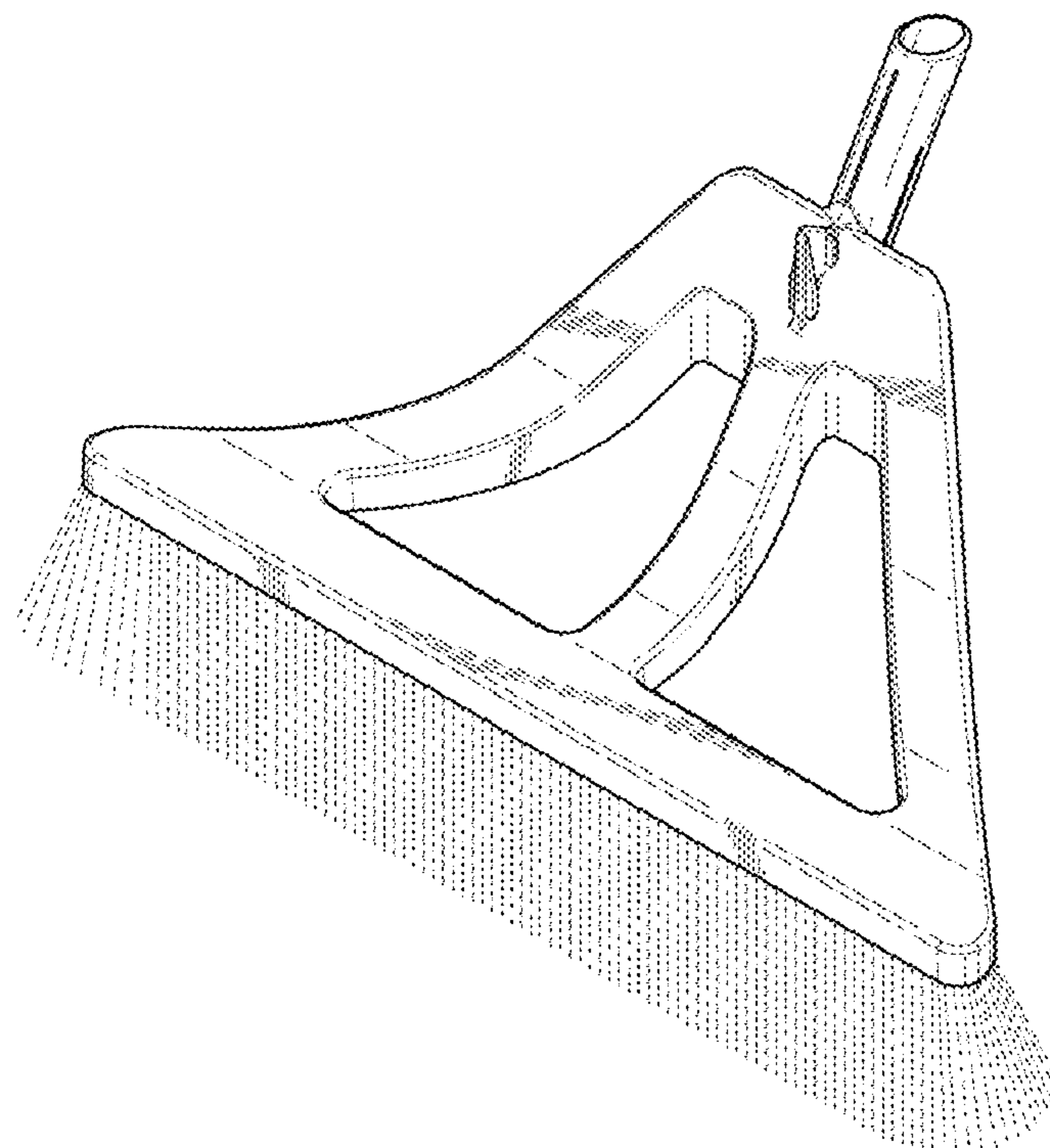
FIG. 4 is a top view of the broom housing assembly illustrated in FIG. 1, with the bristle assembly shown in phantom;

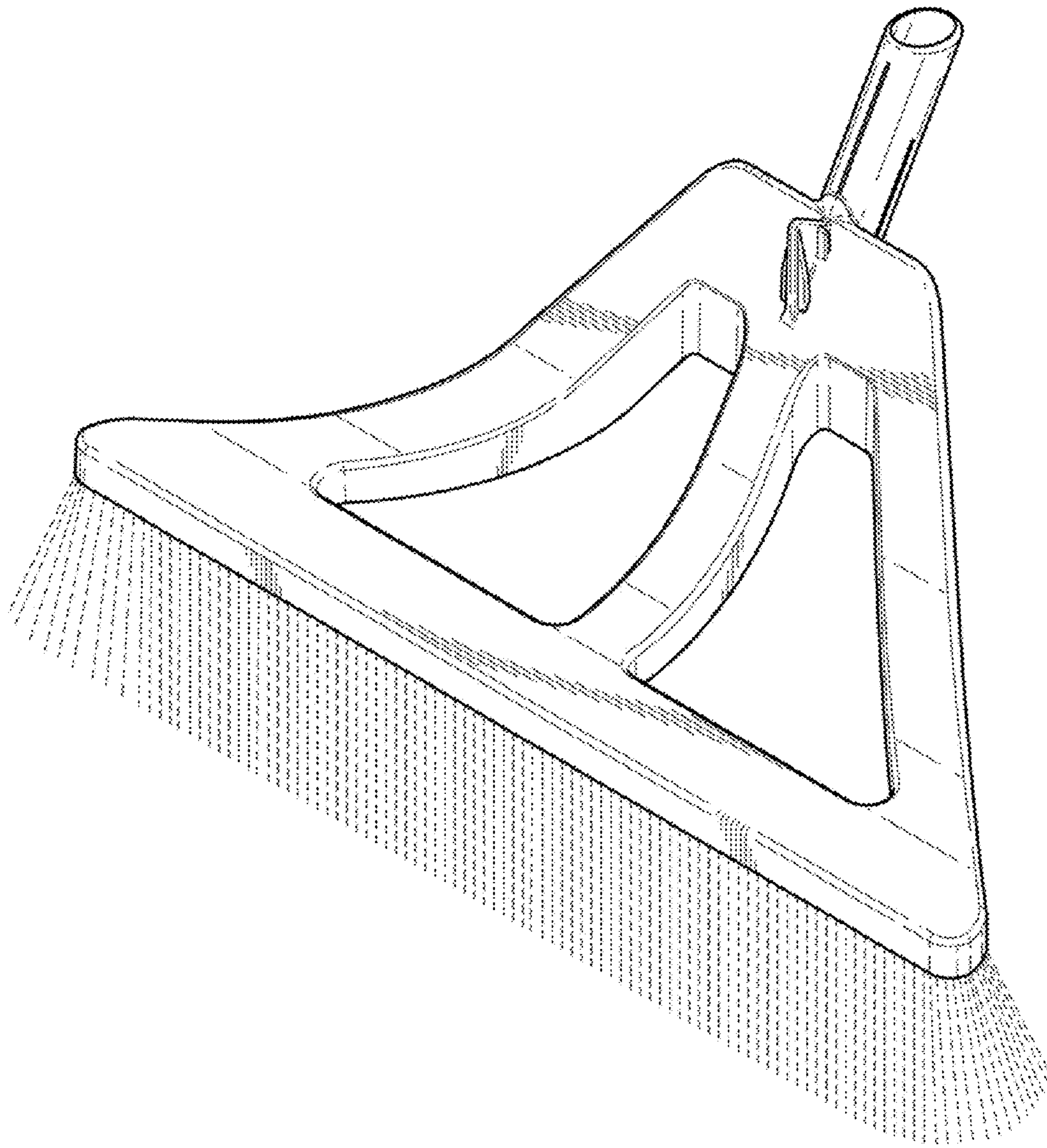

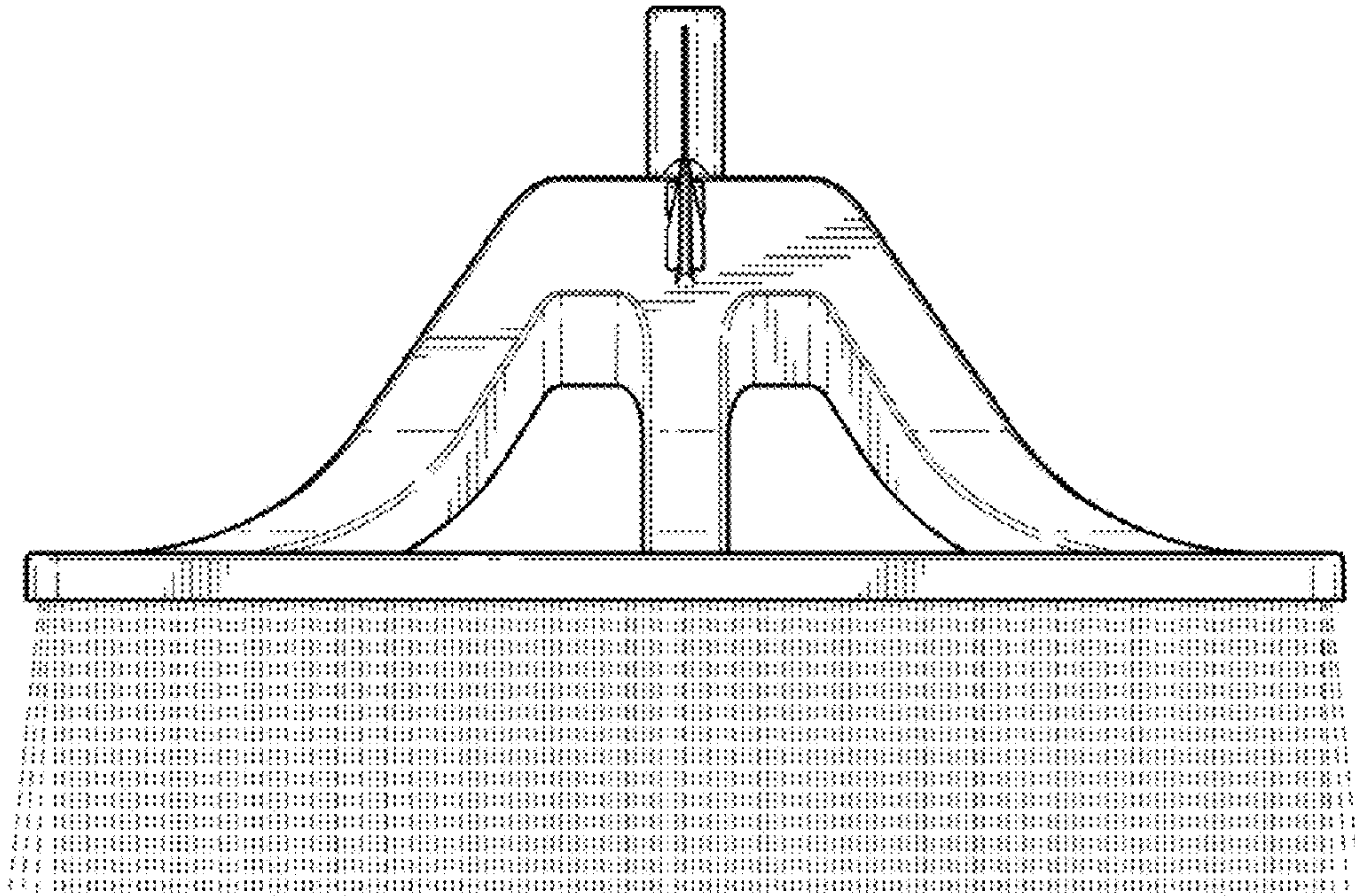

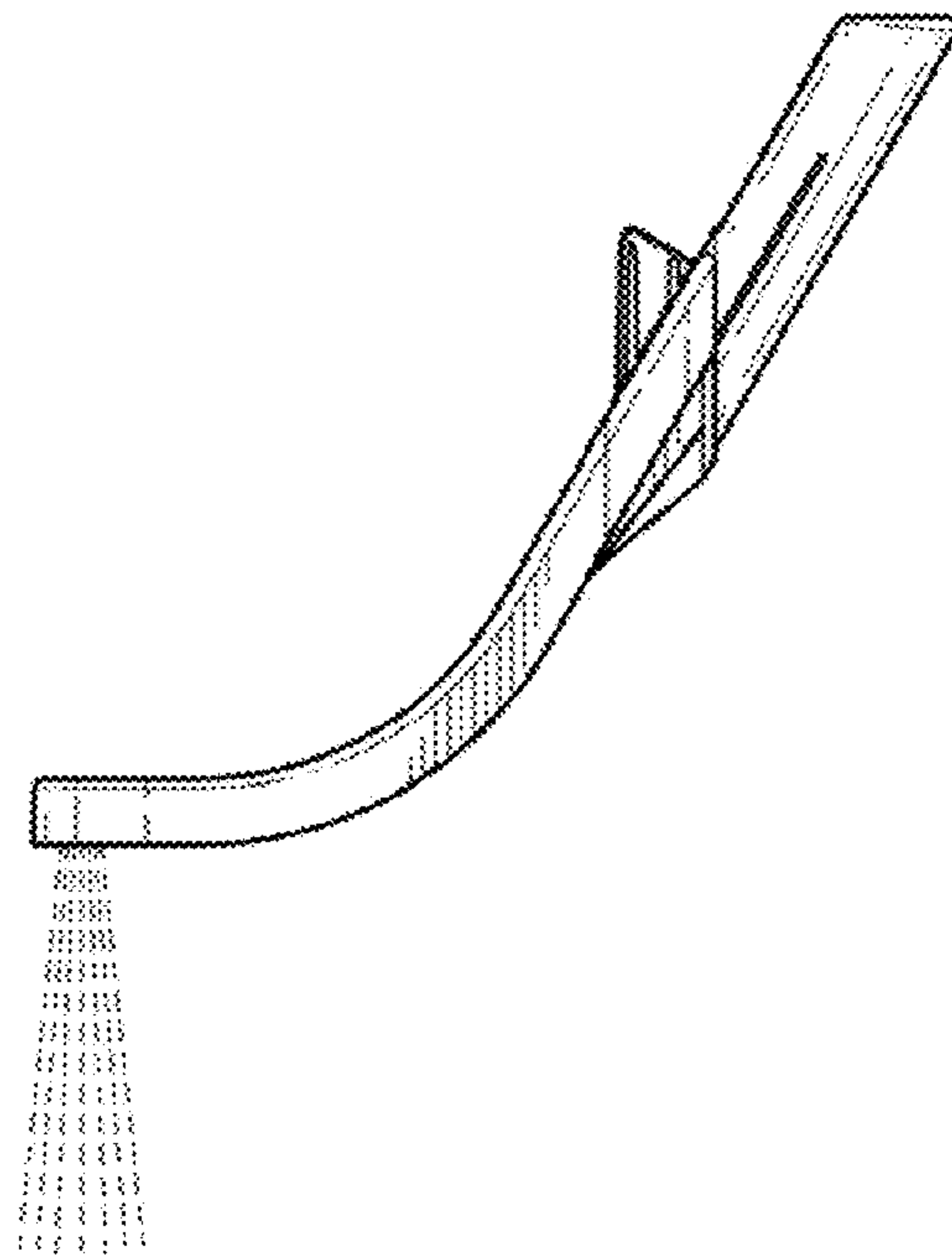

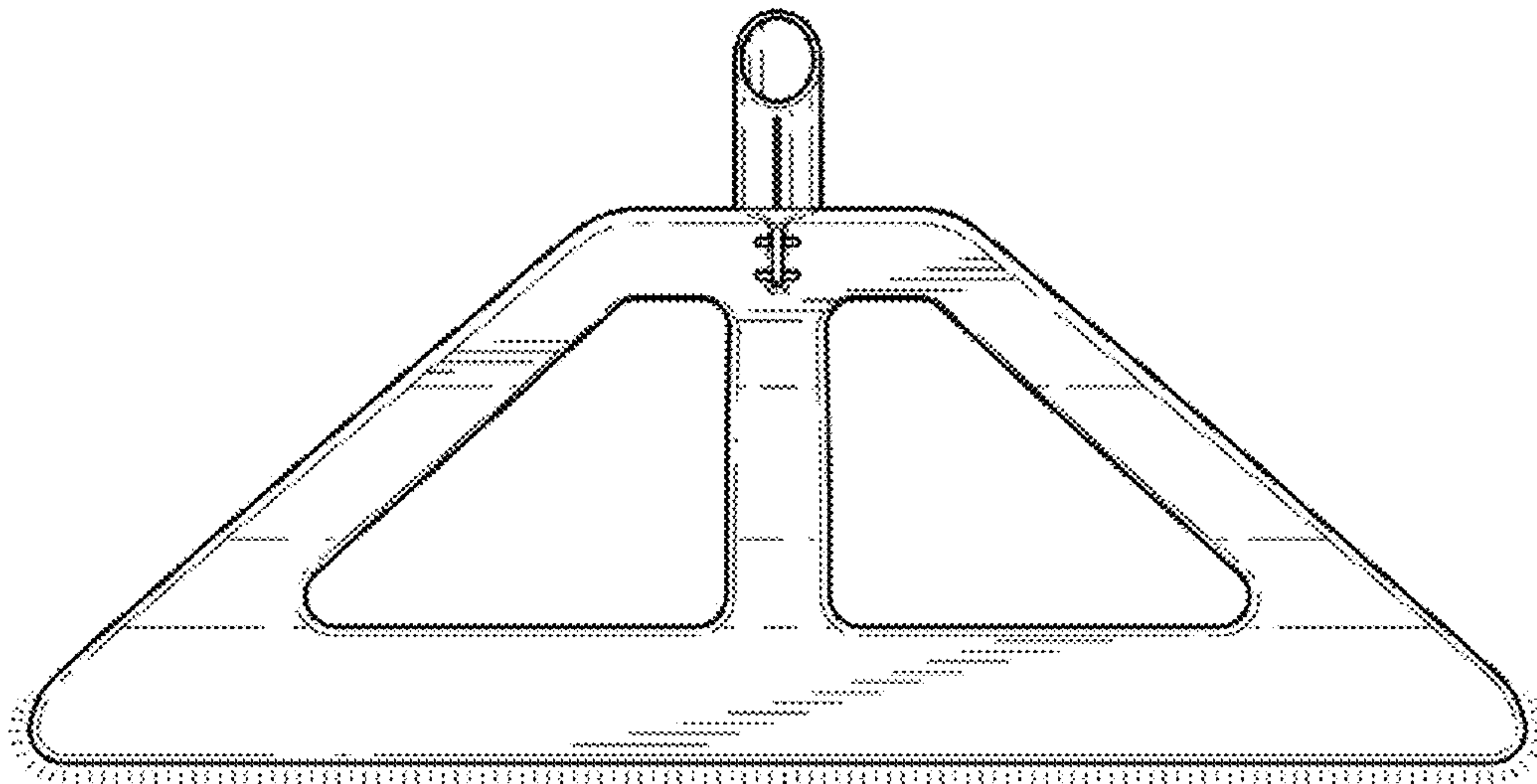

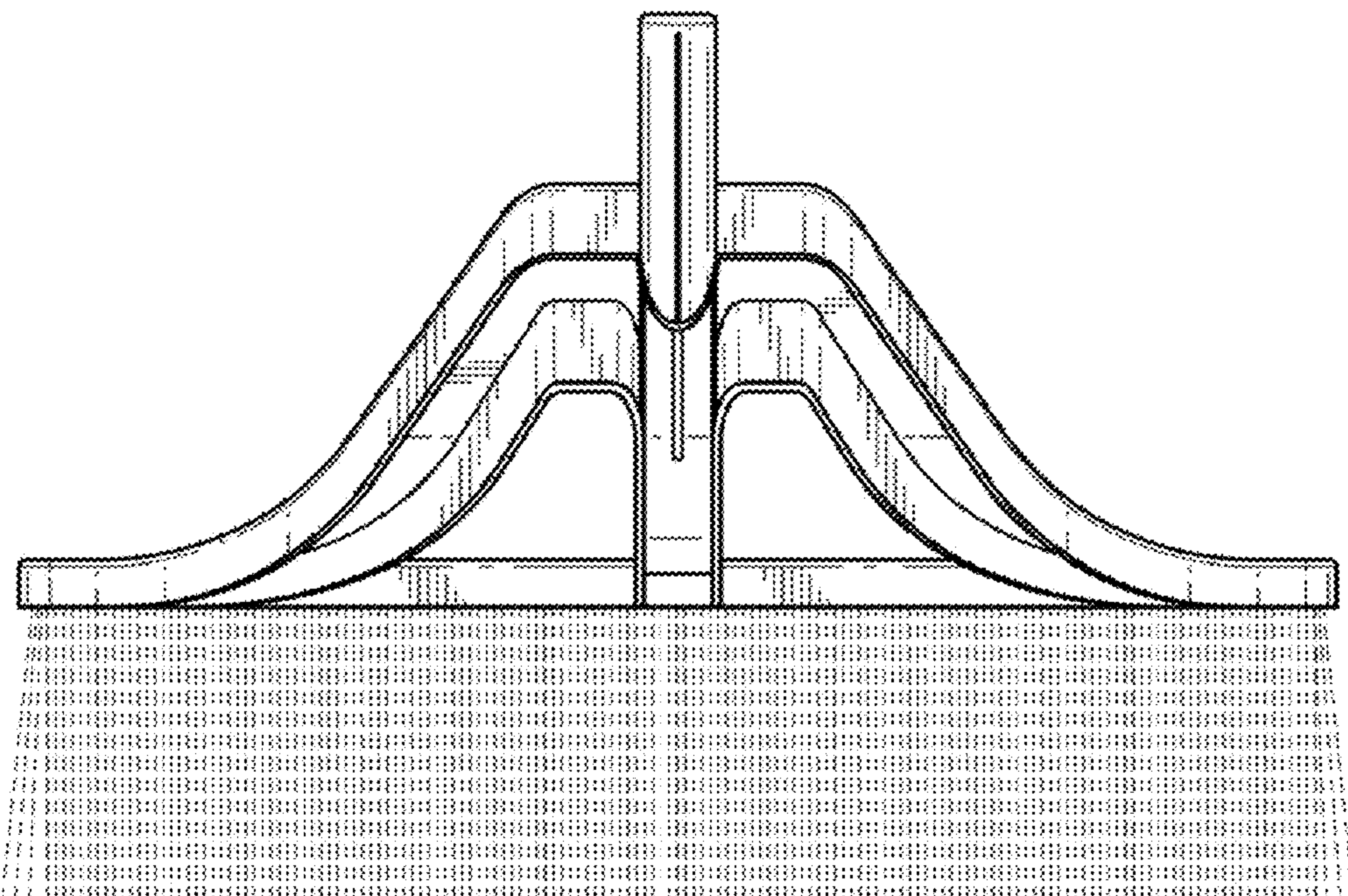

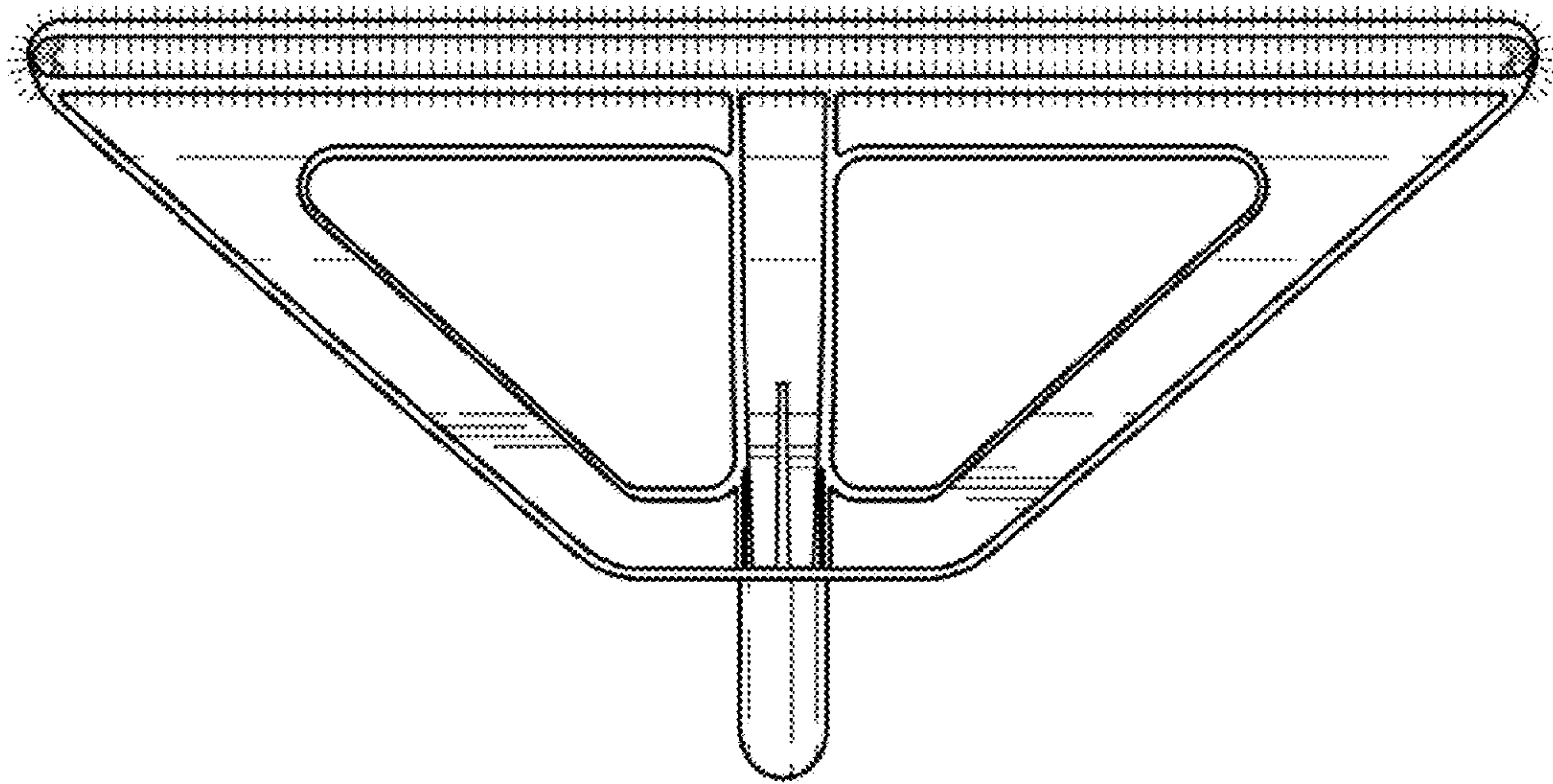
