FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the basket with wearable decoration.

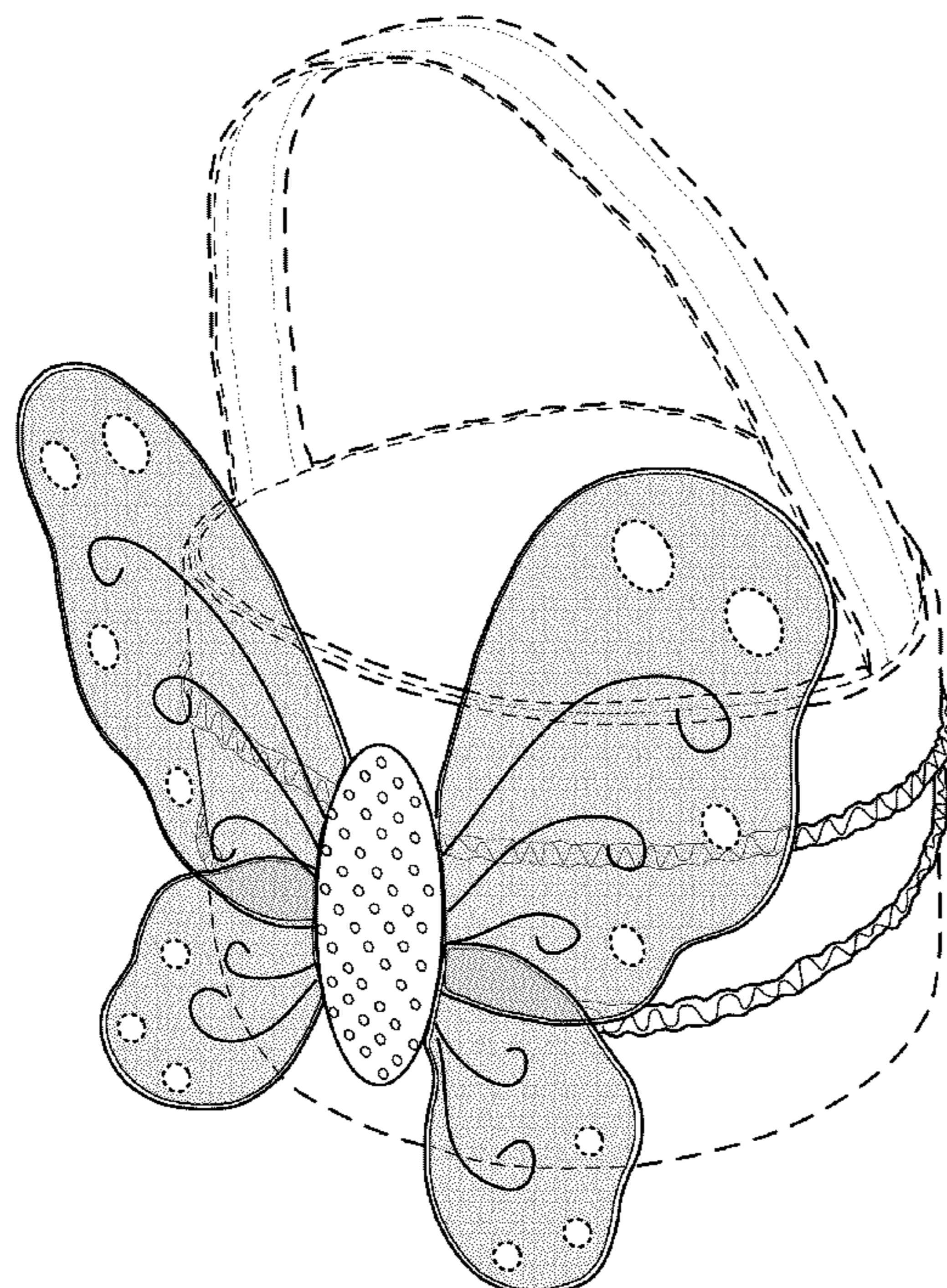
FIG. 5 is a back elevation view of the basket with wearable decoration.

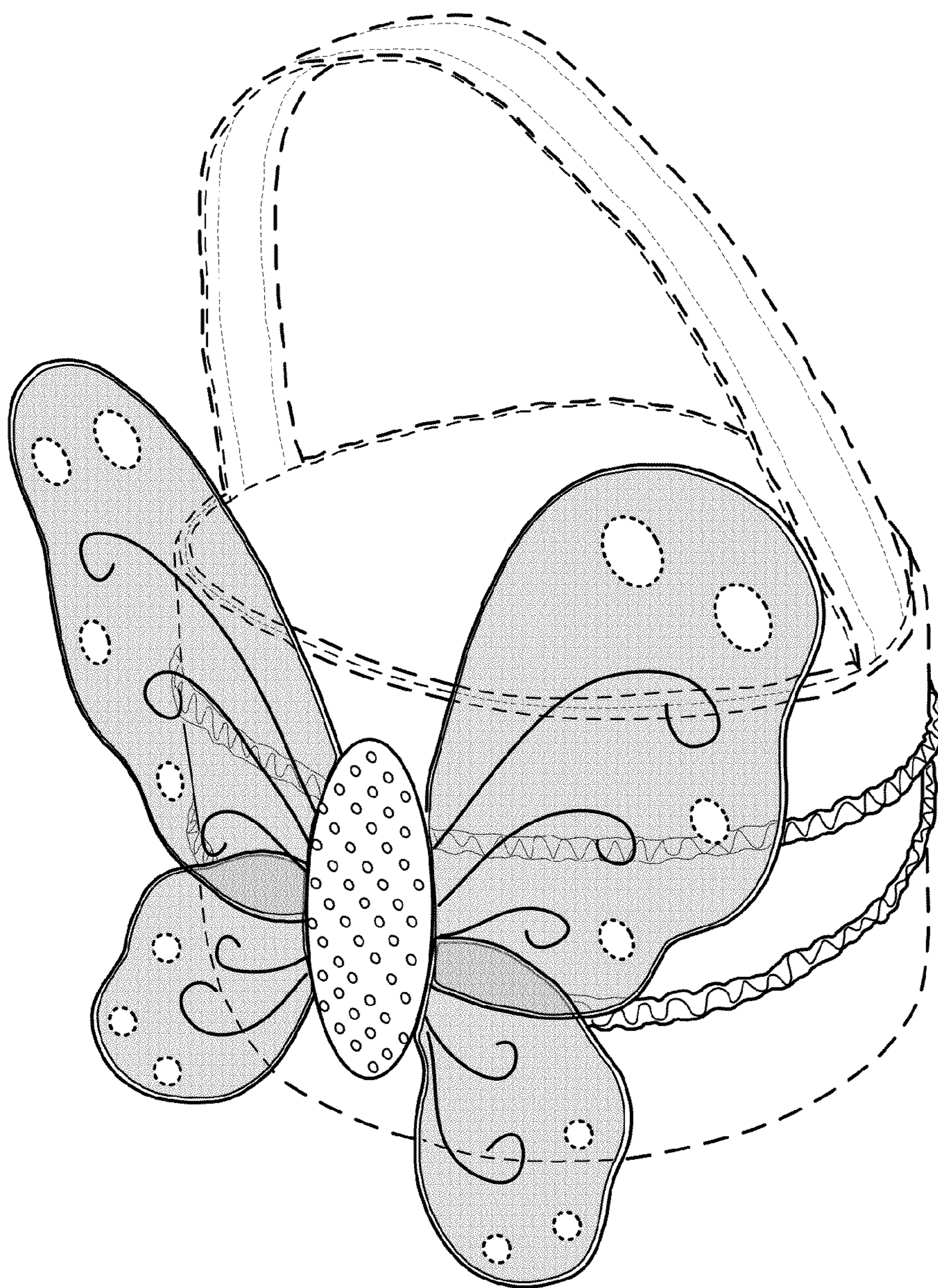
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the basket with wearable decoration; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the basket with wearable decoration.

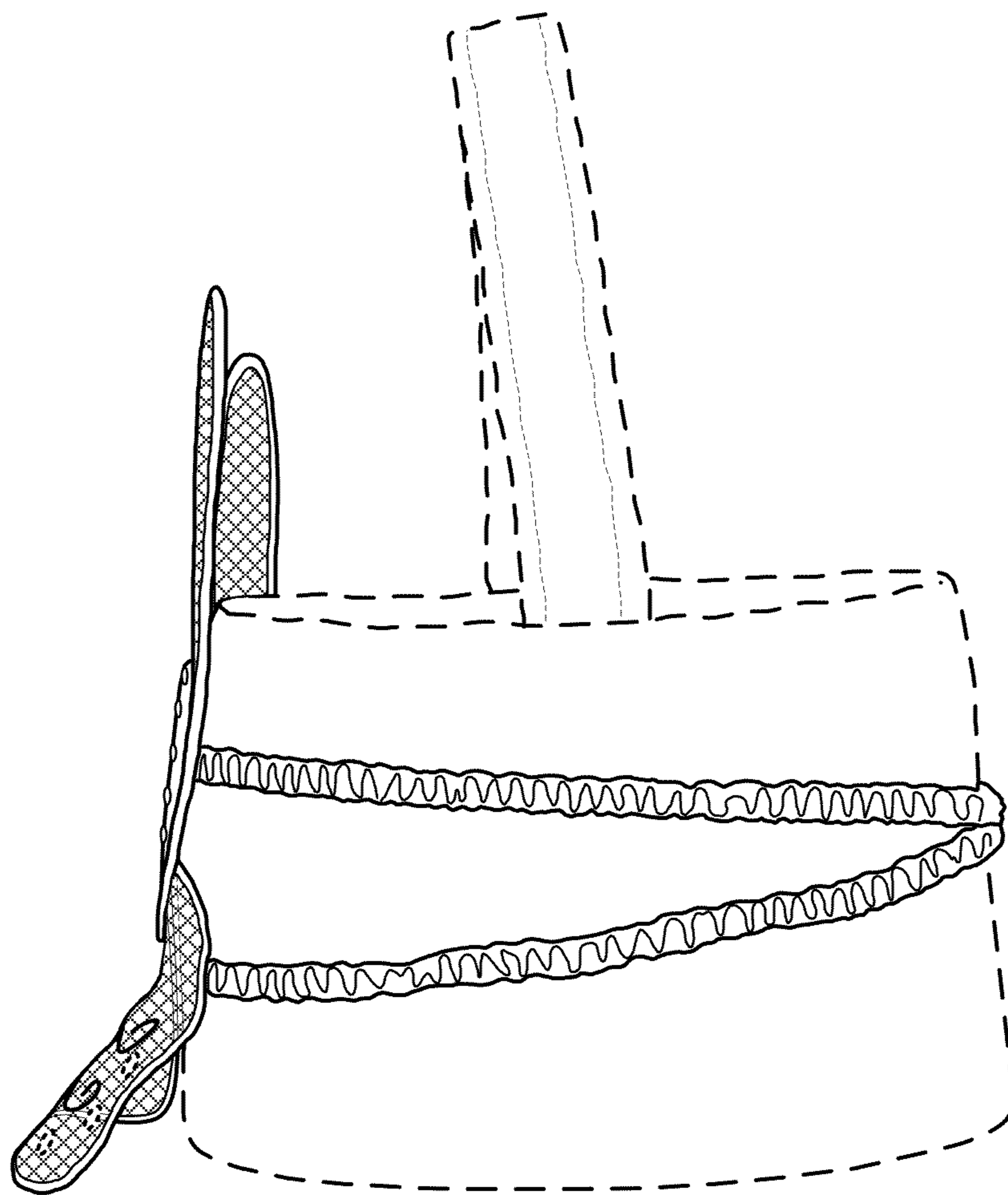

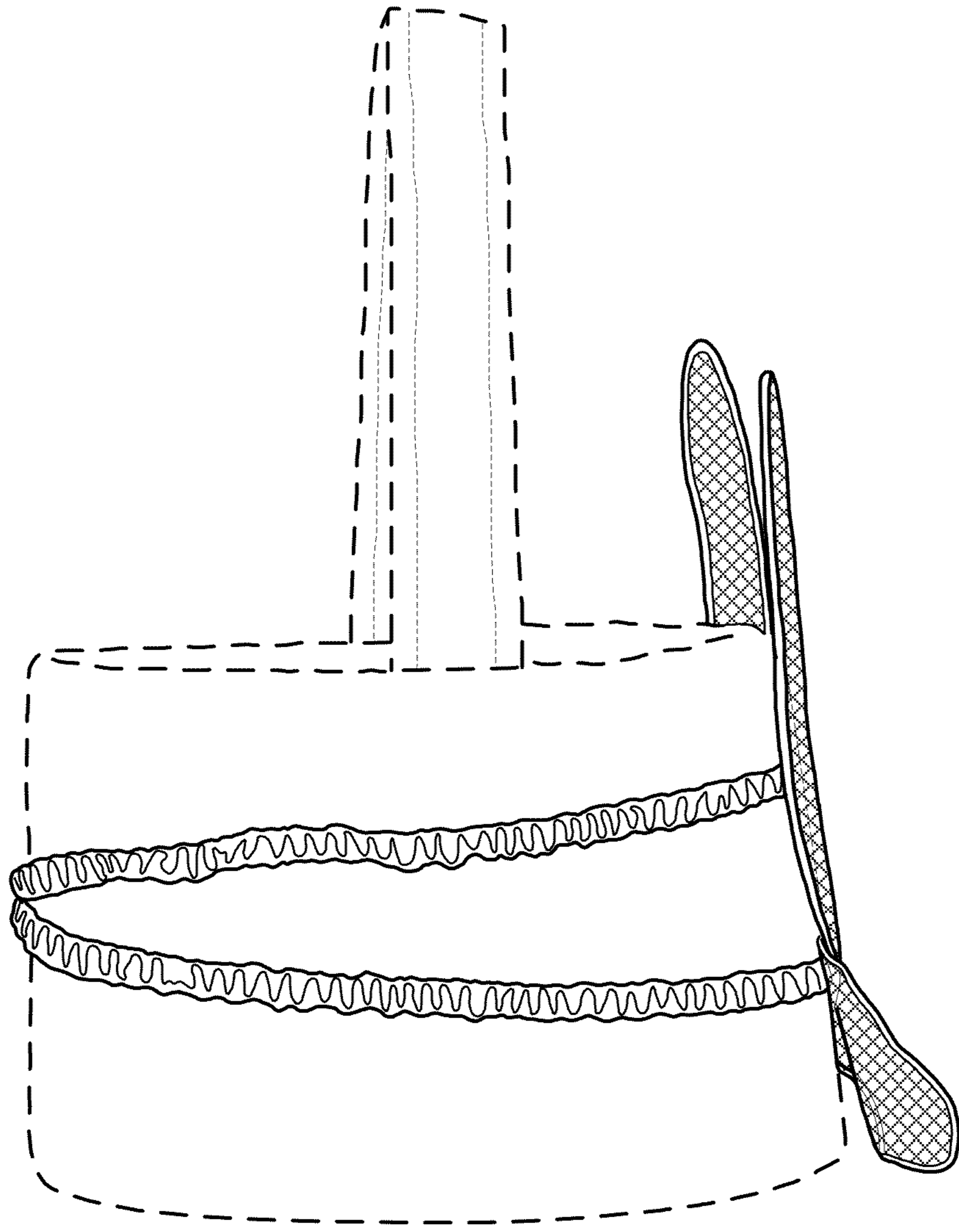




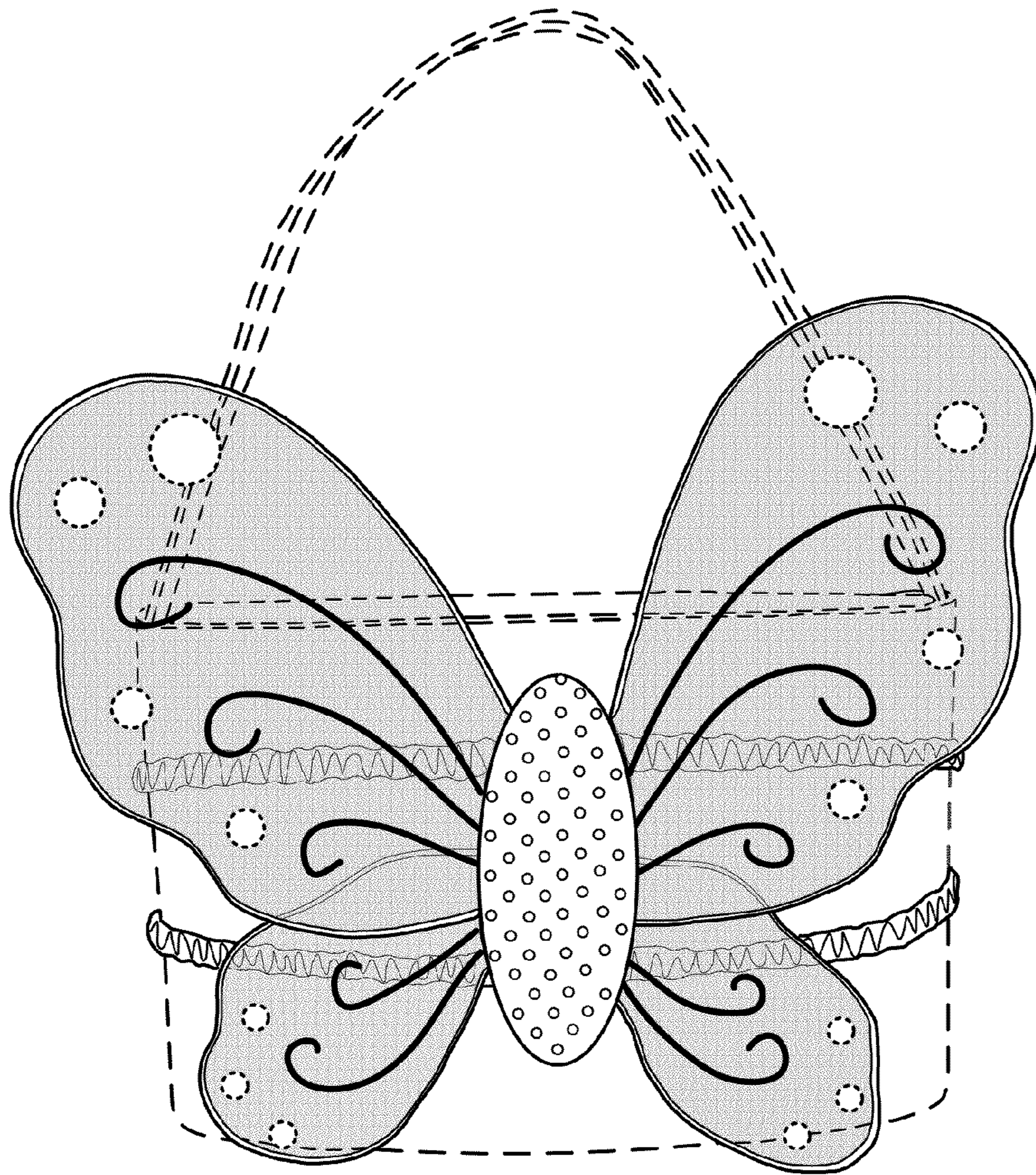

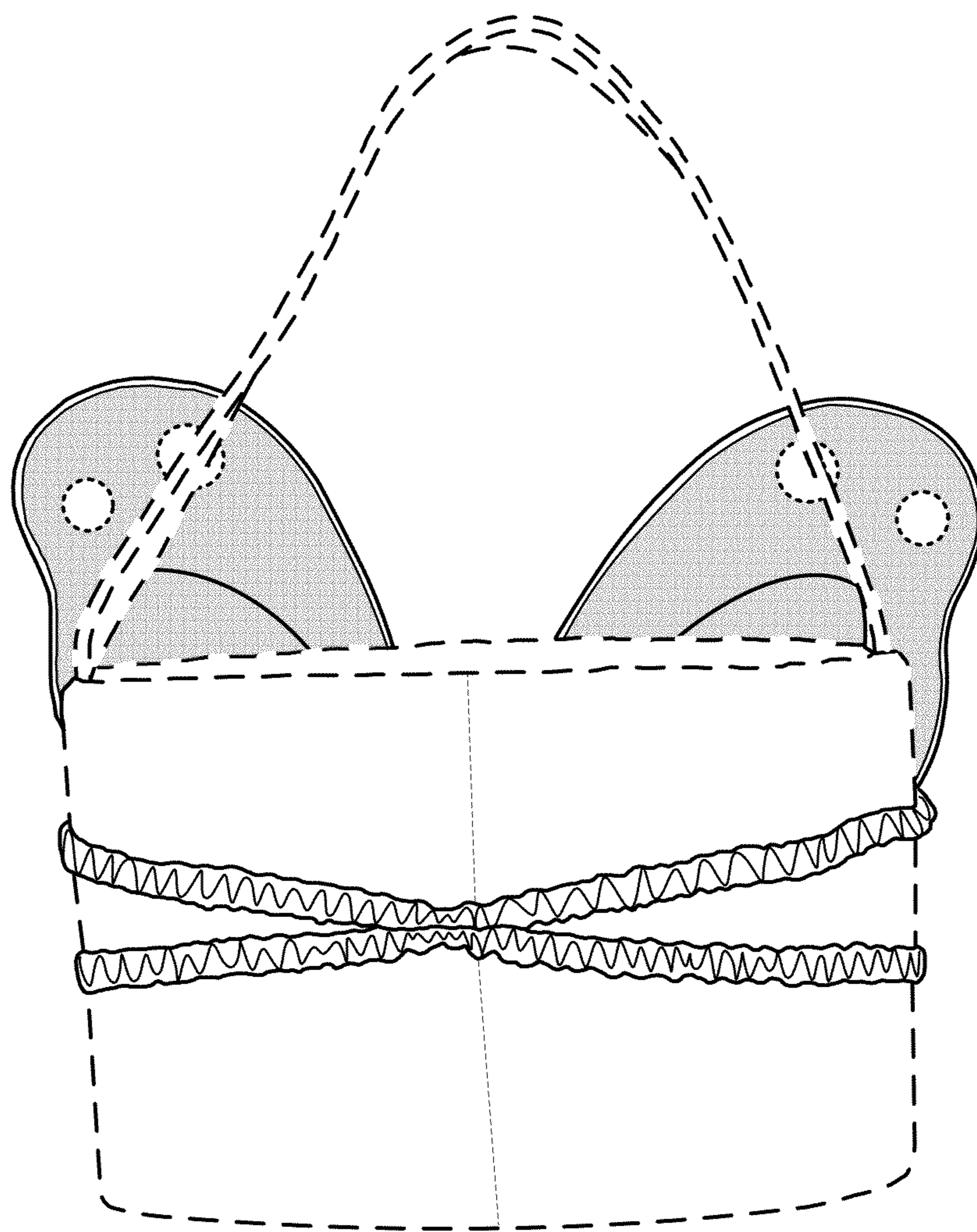

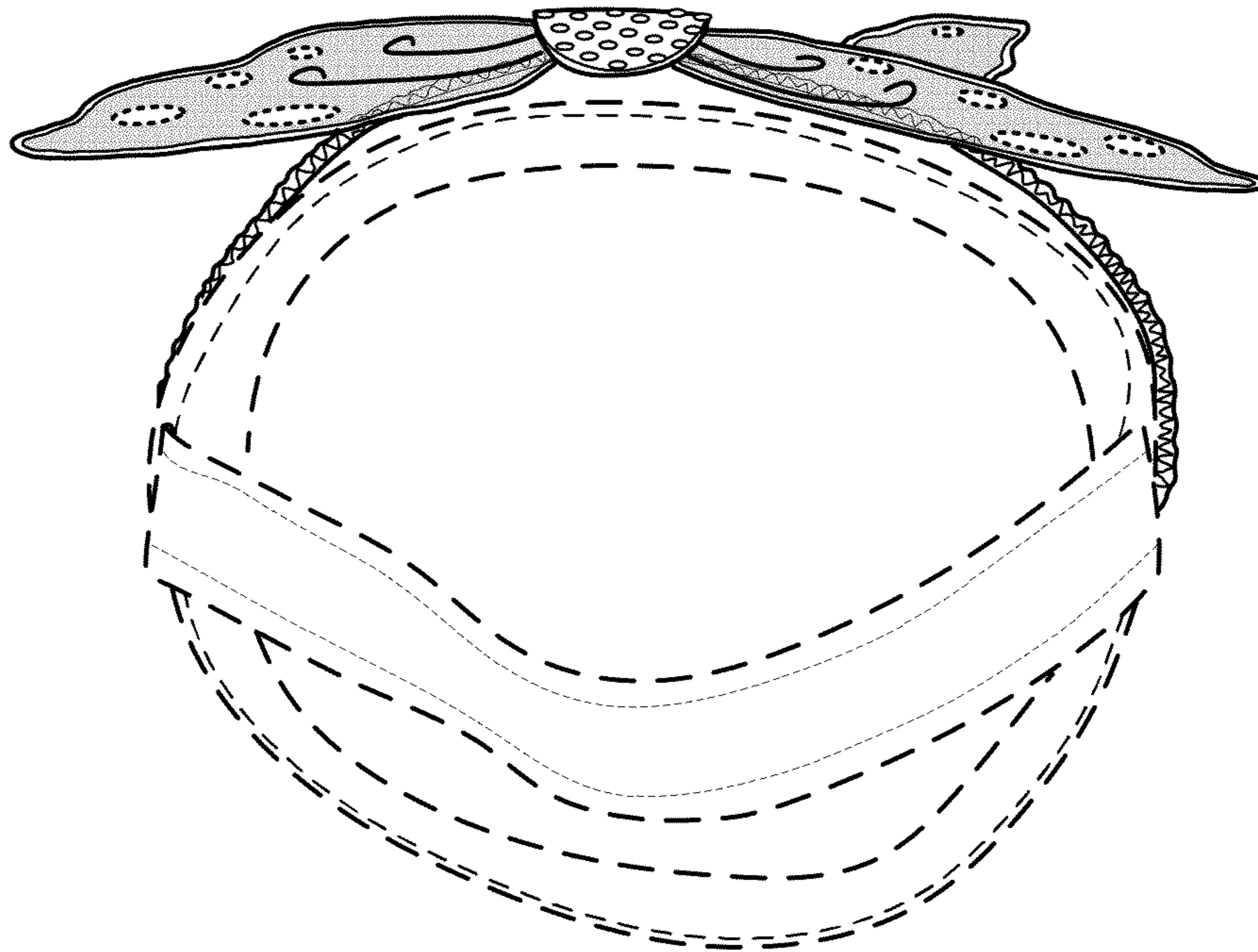

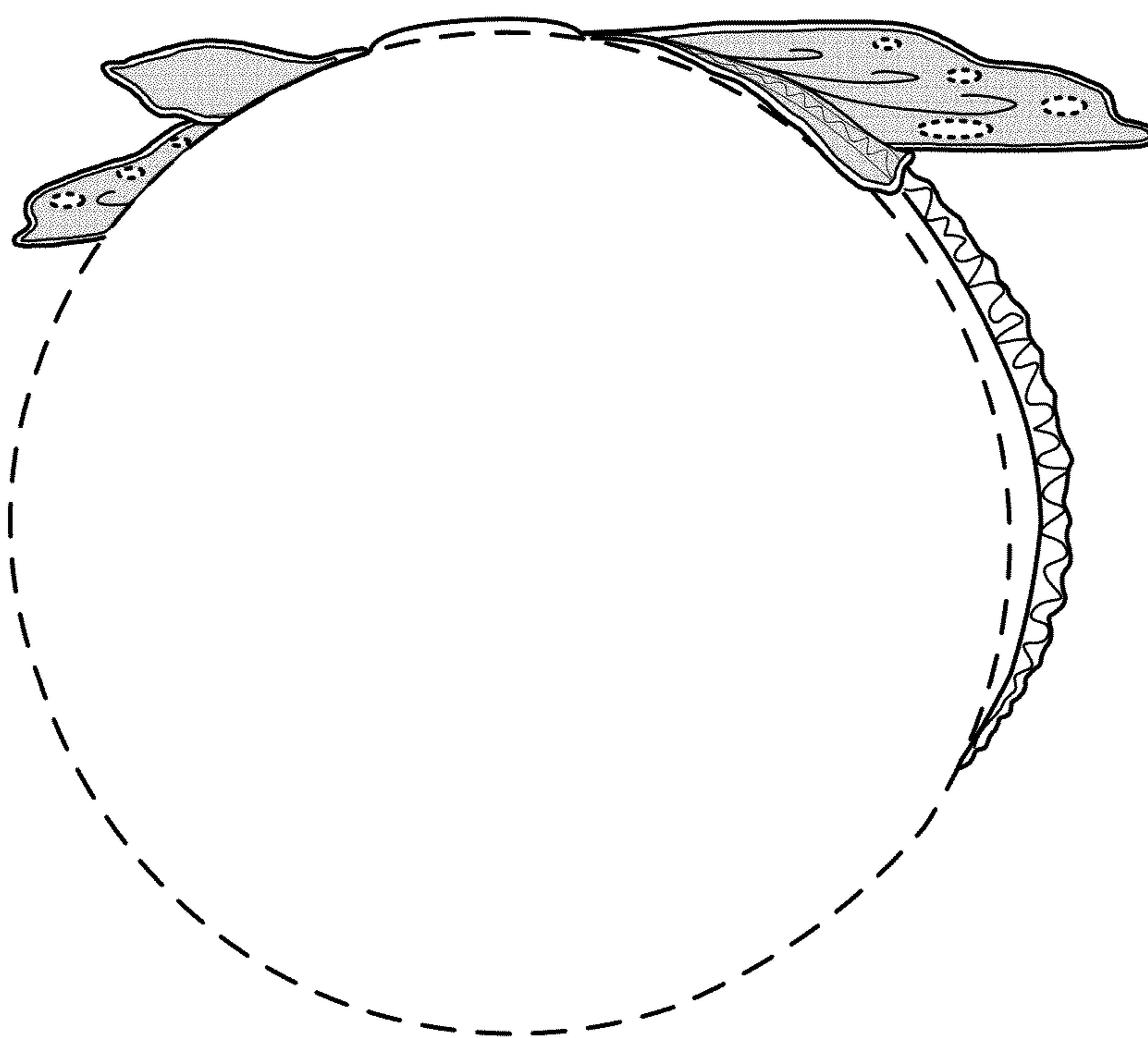
