(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a rocking chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a rocking chair, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 8, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 8.

The broken lines showing frog features applied to the chair in the figures depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

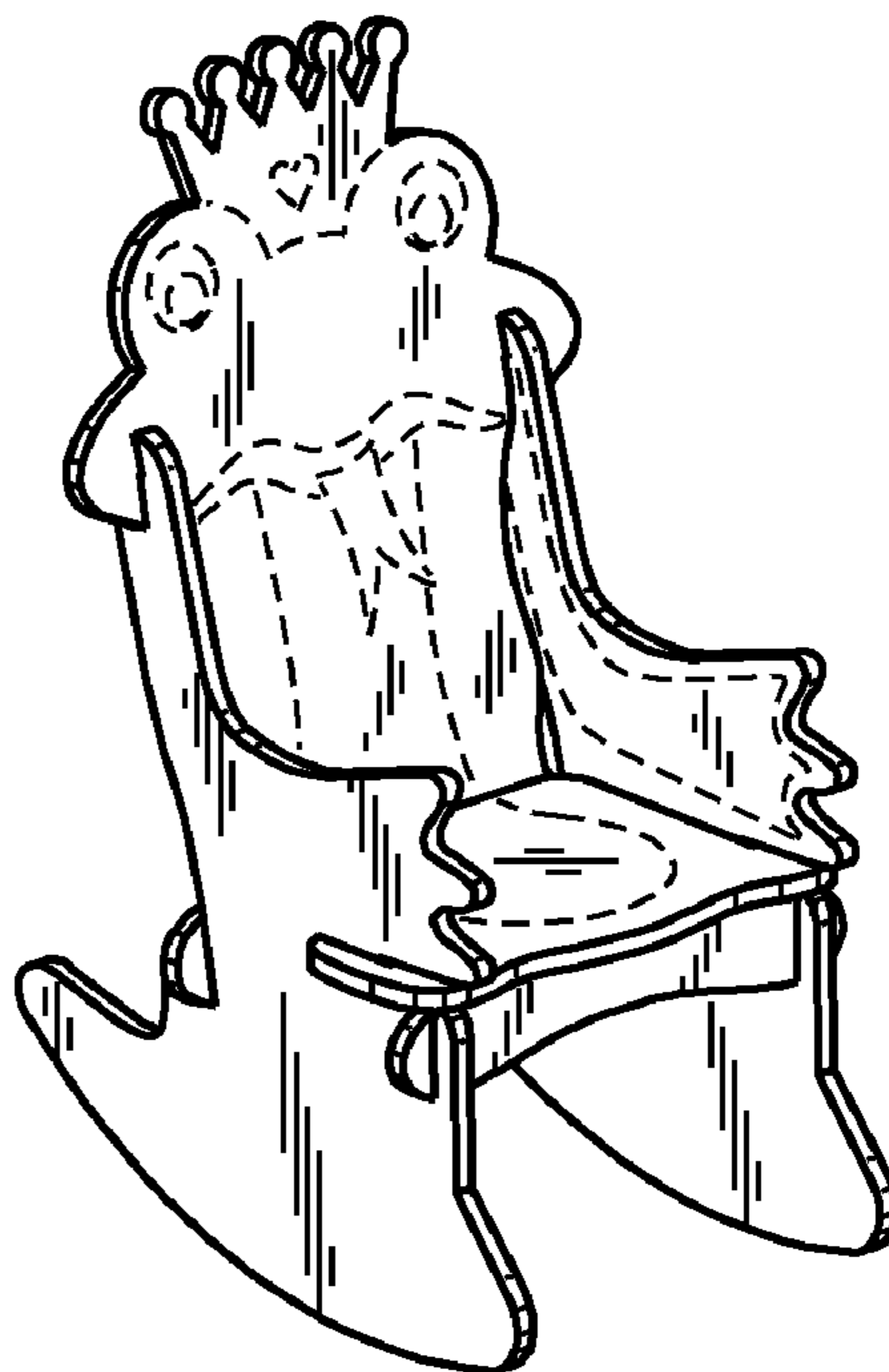
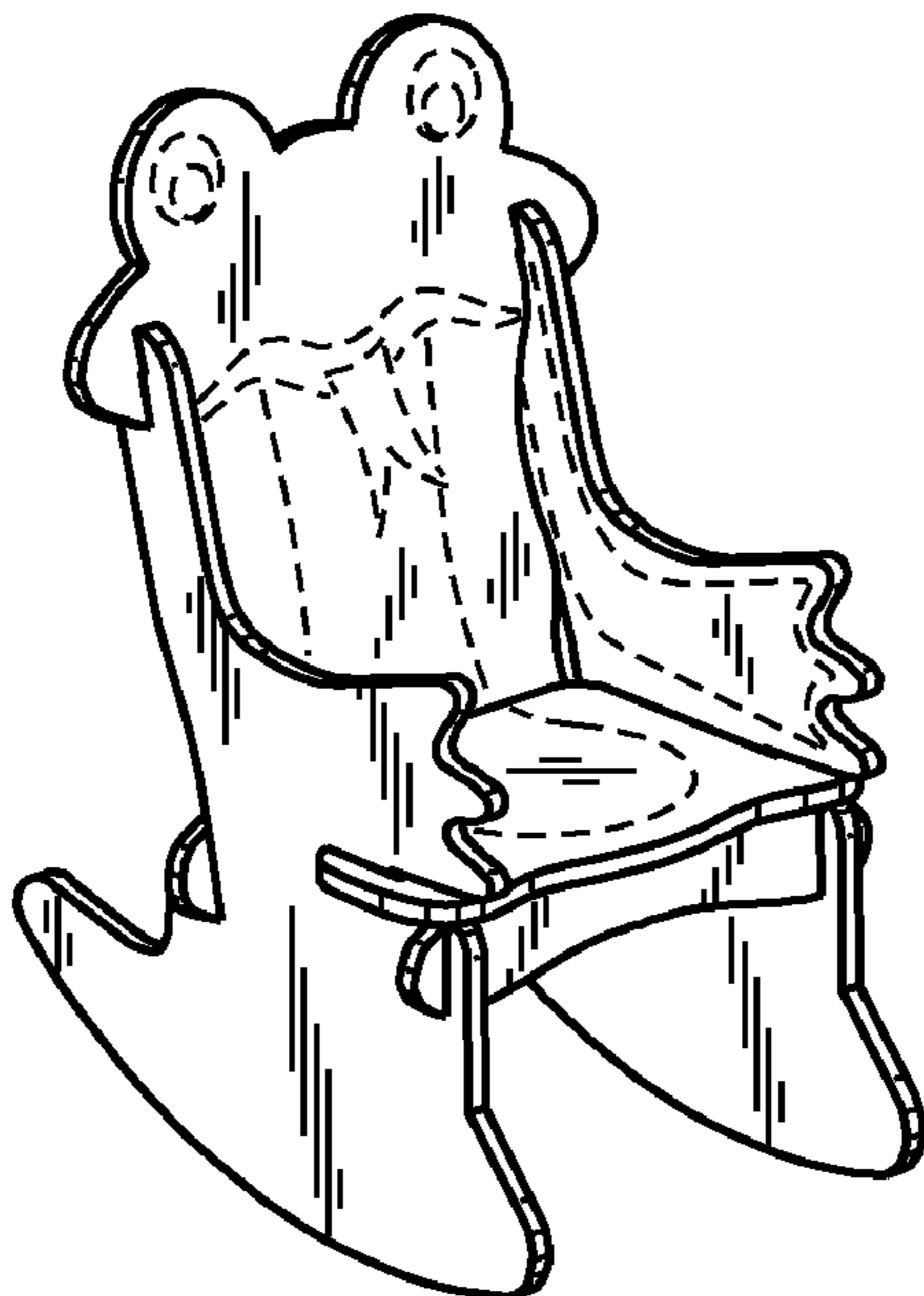

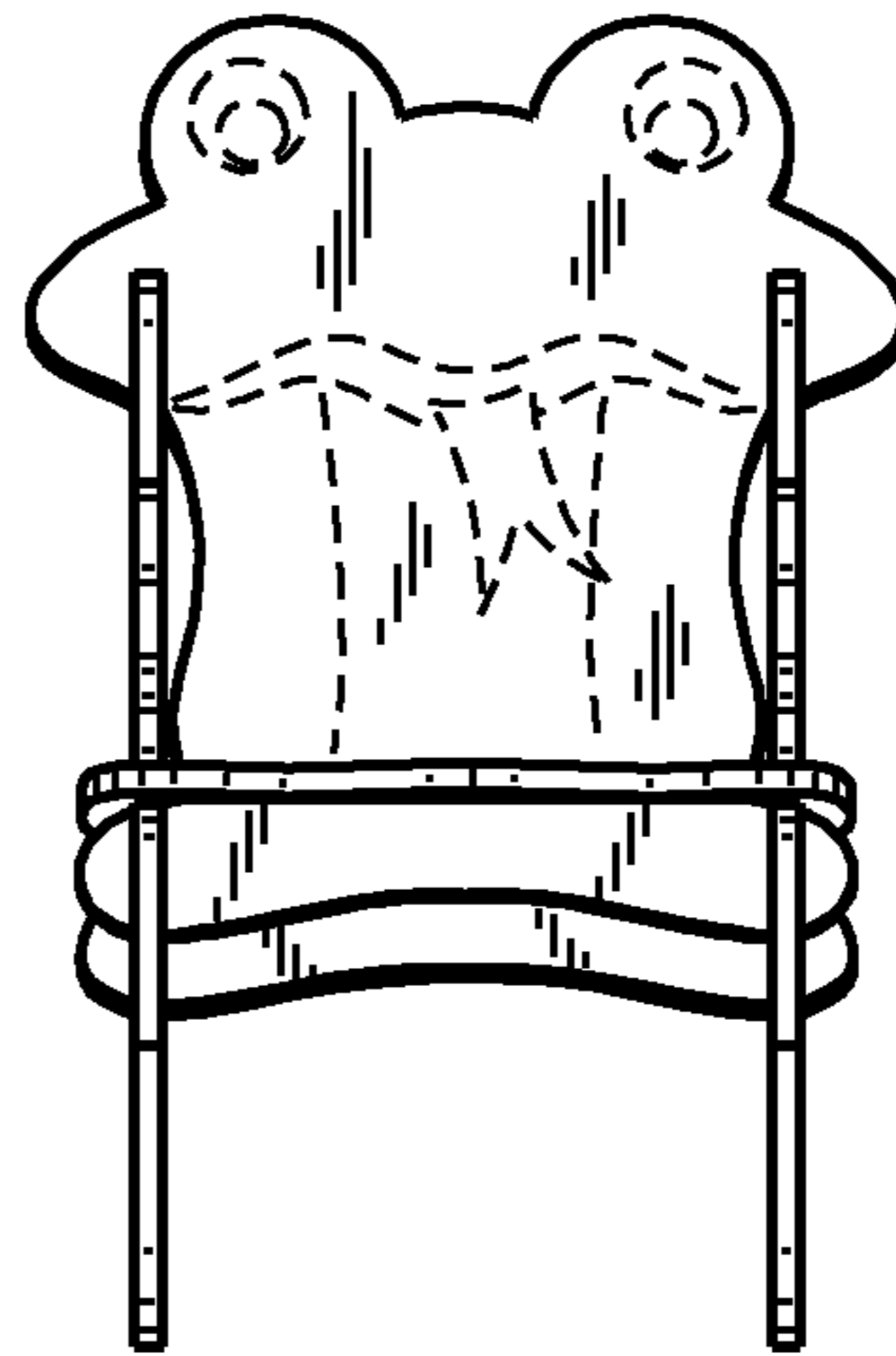
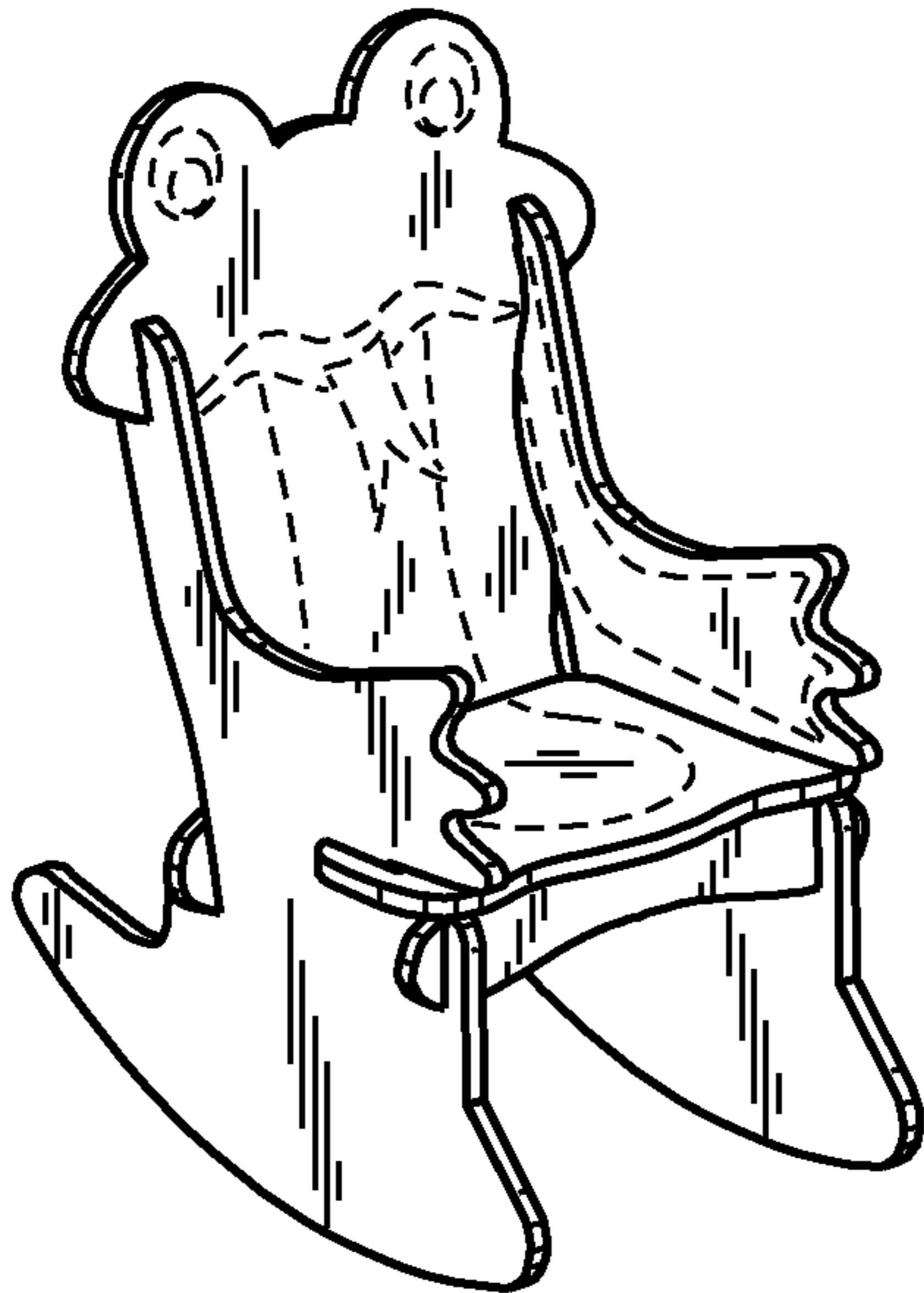

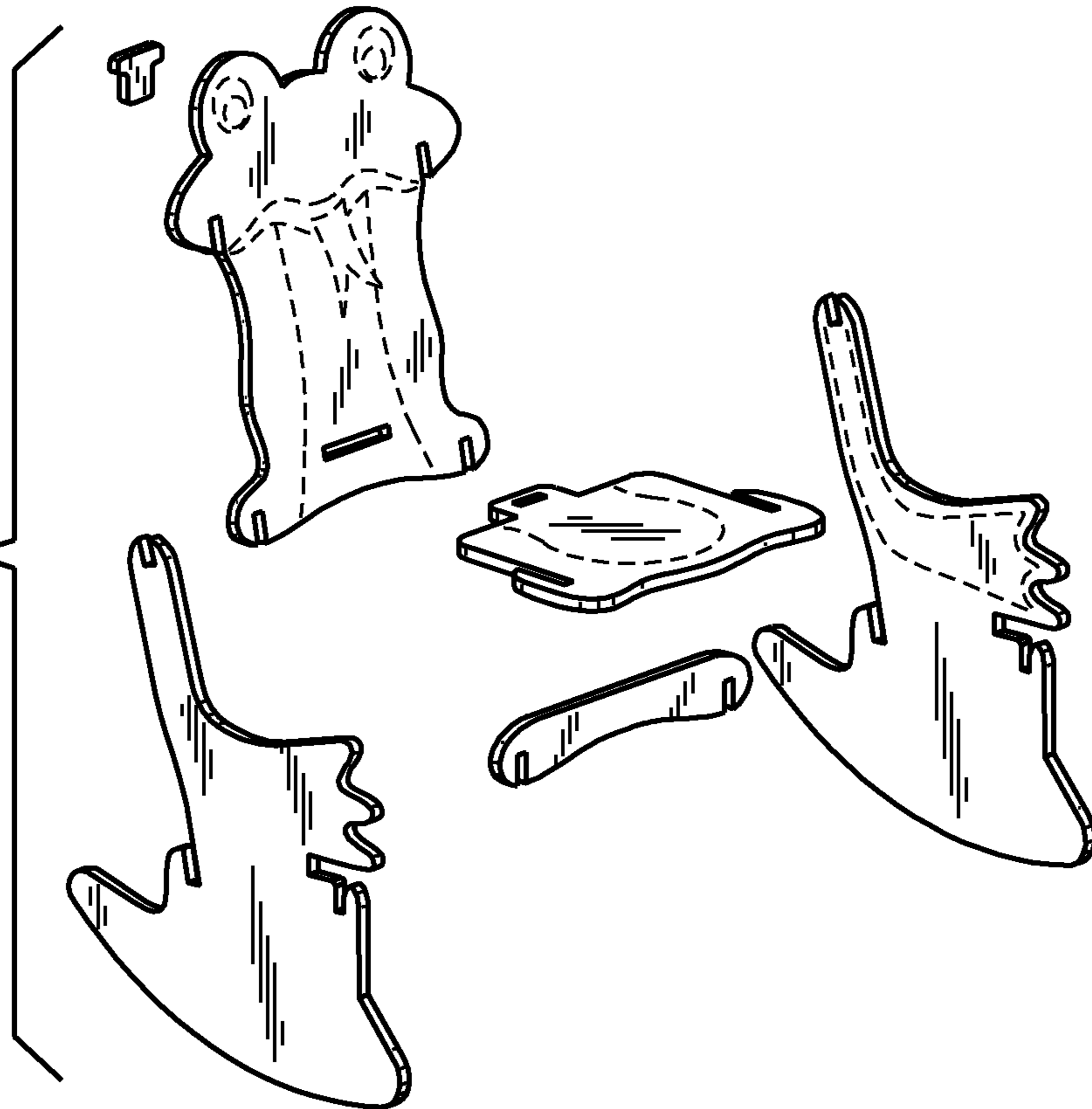

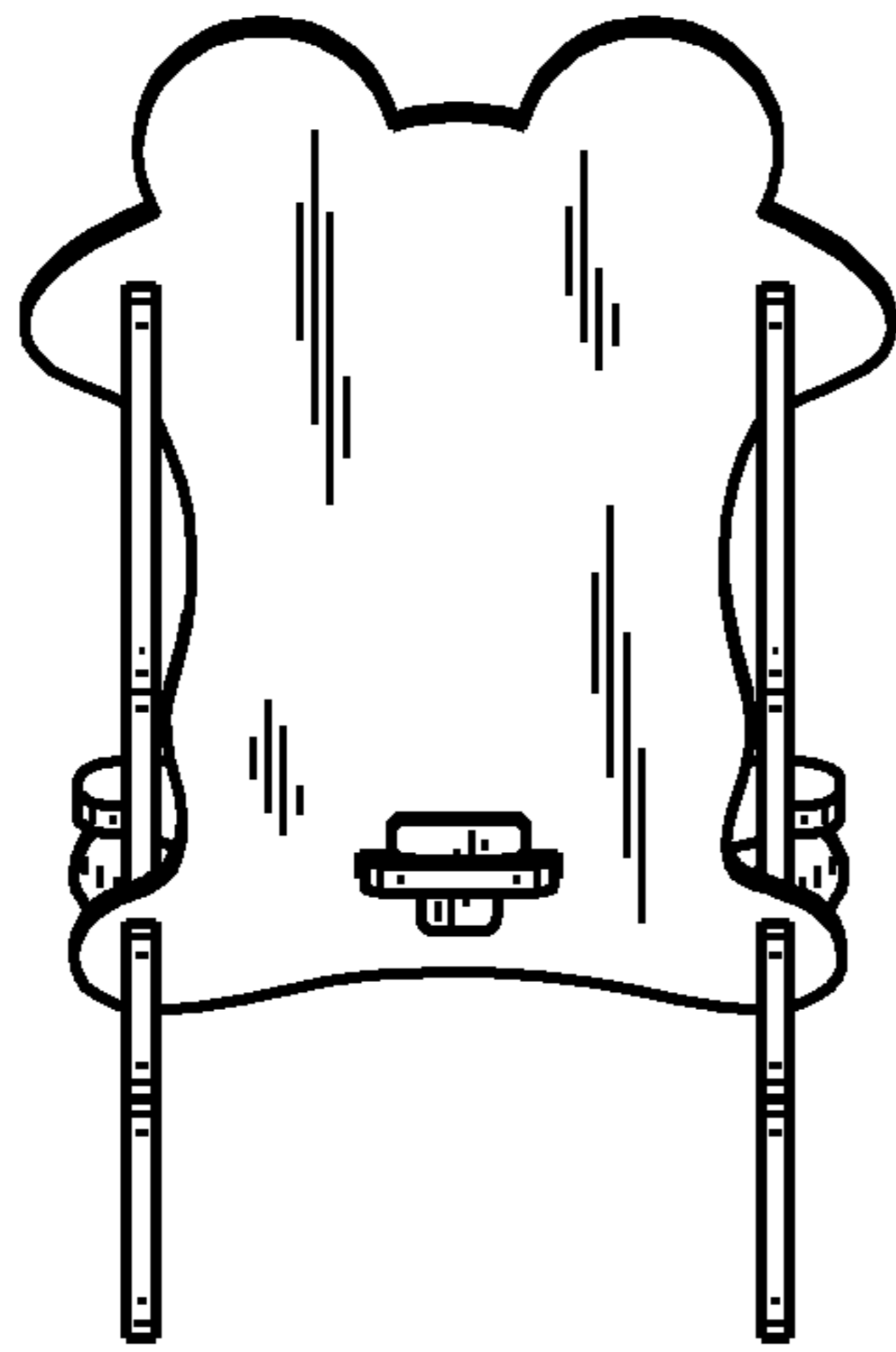

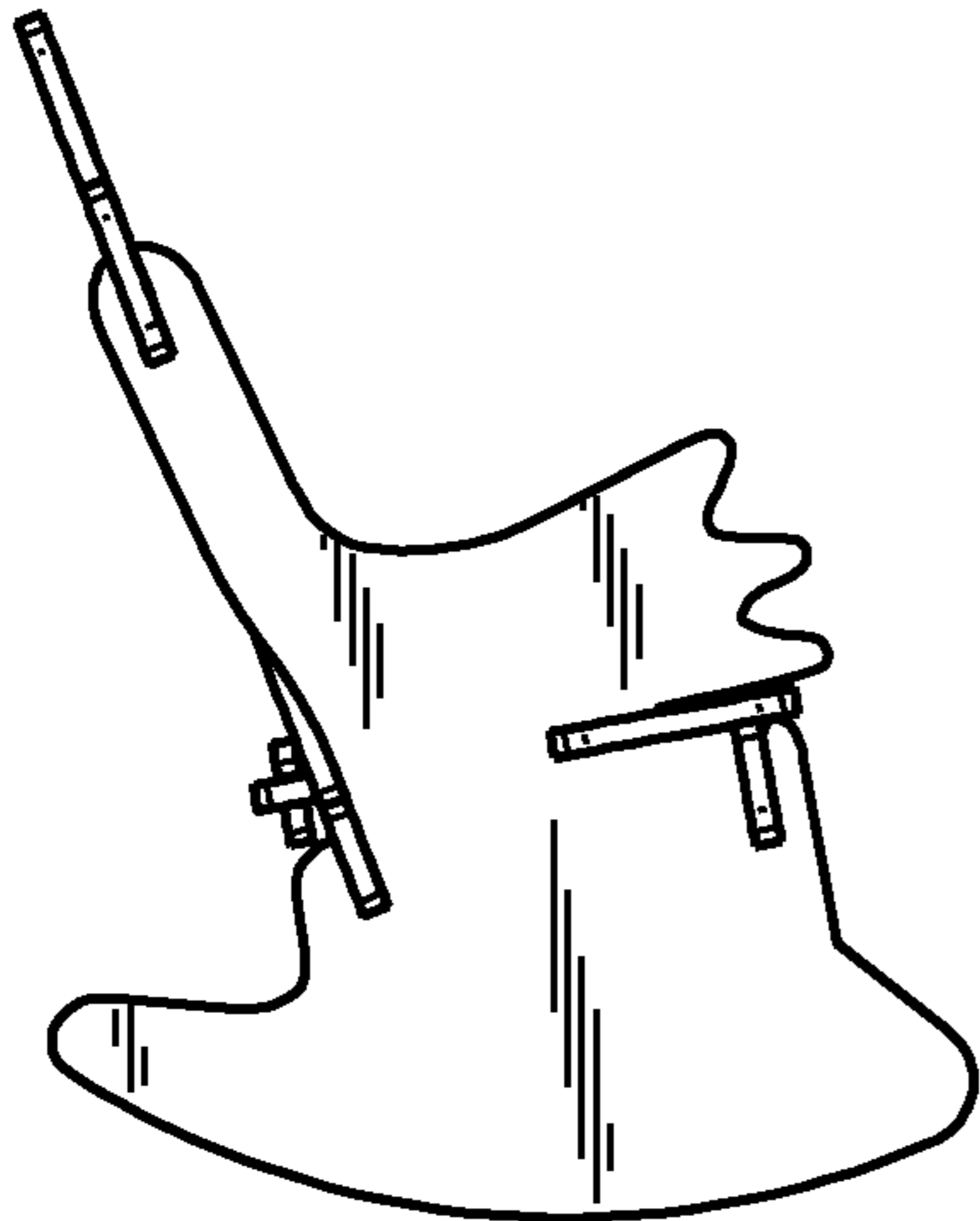
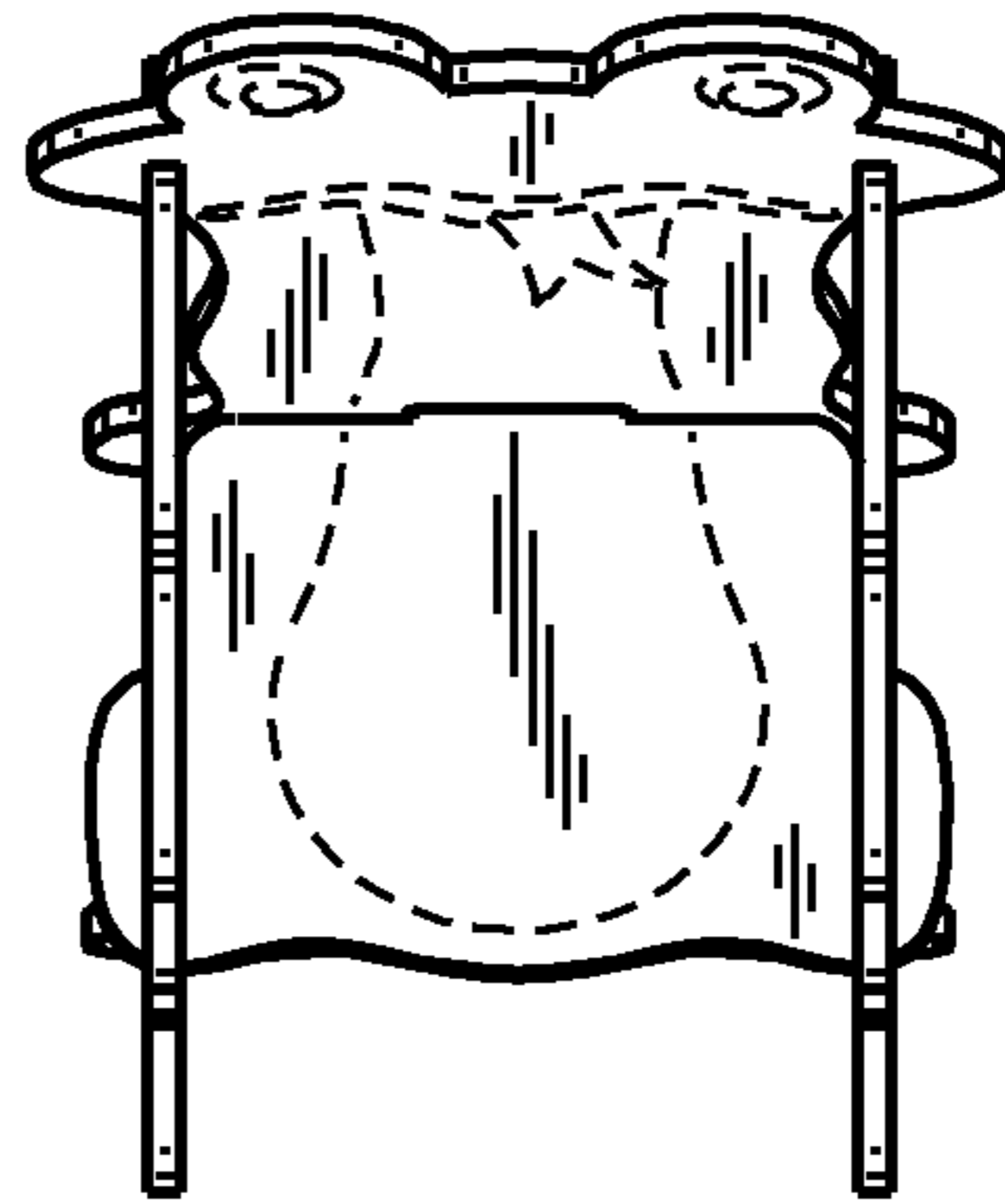

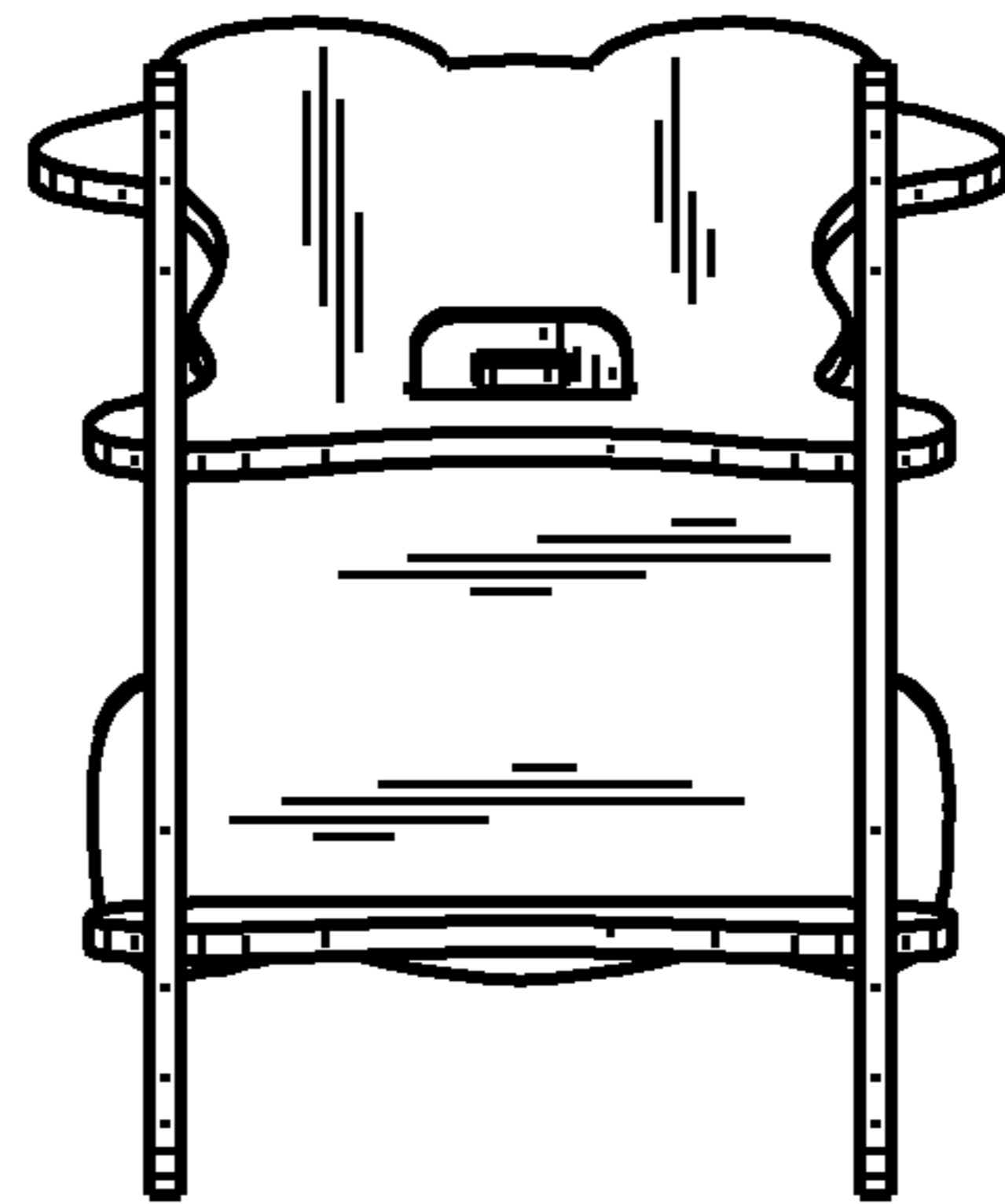

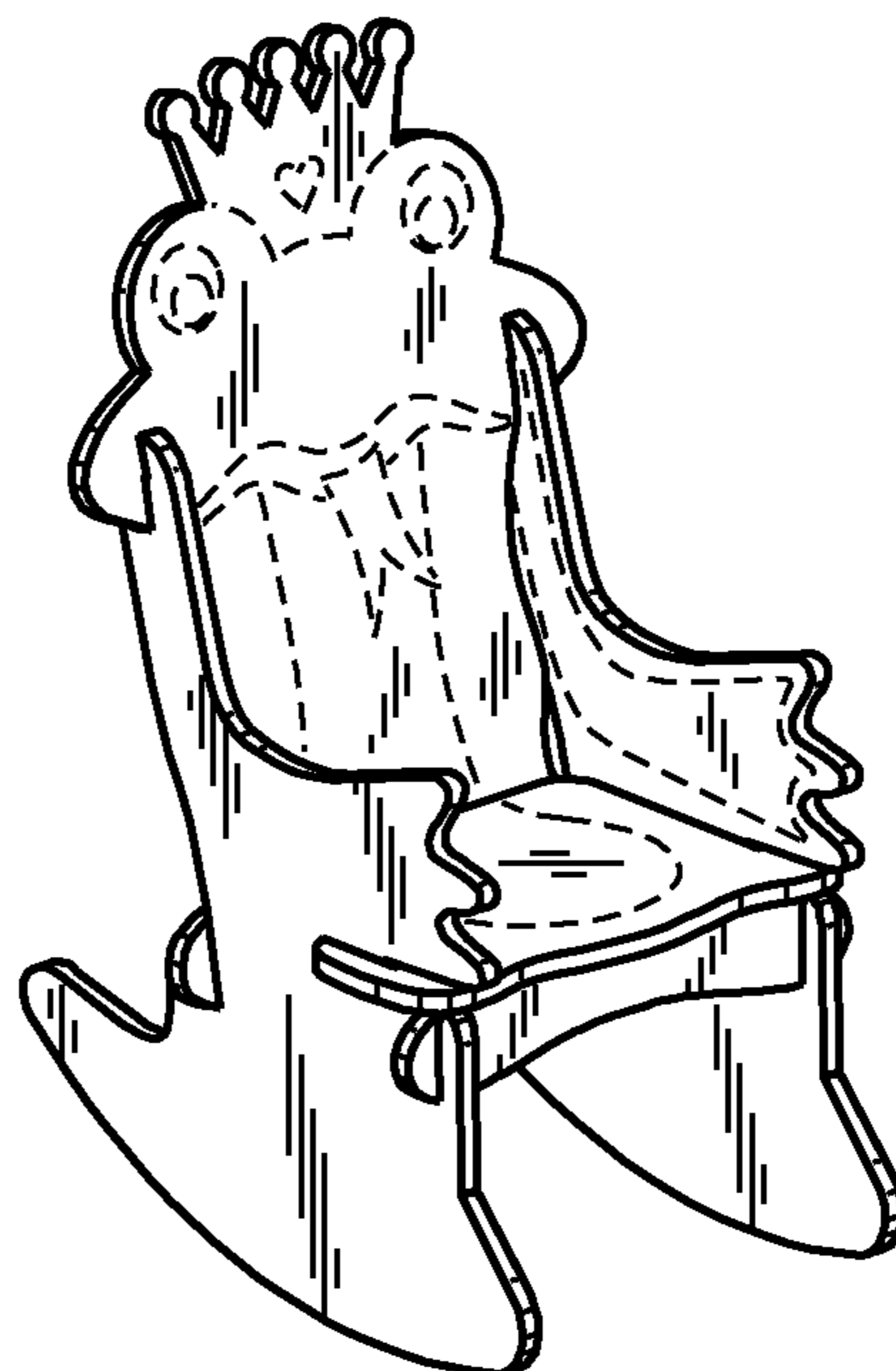

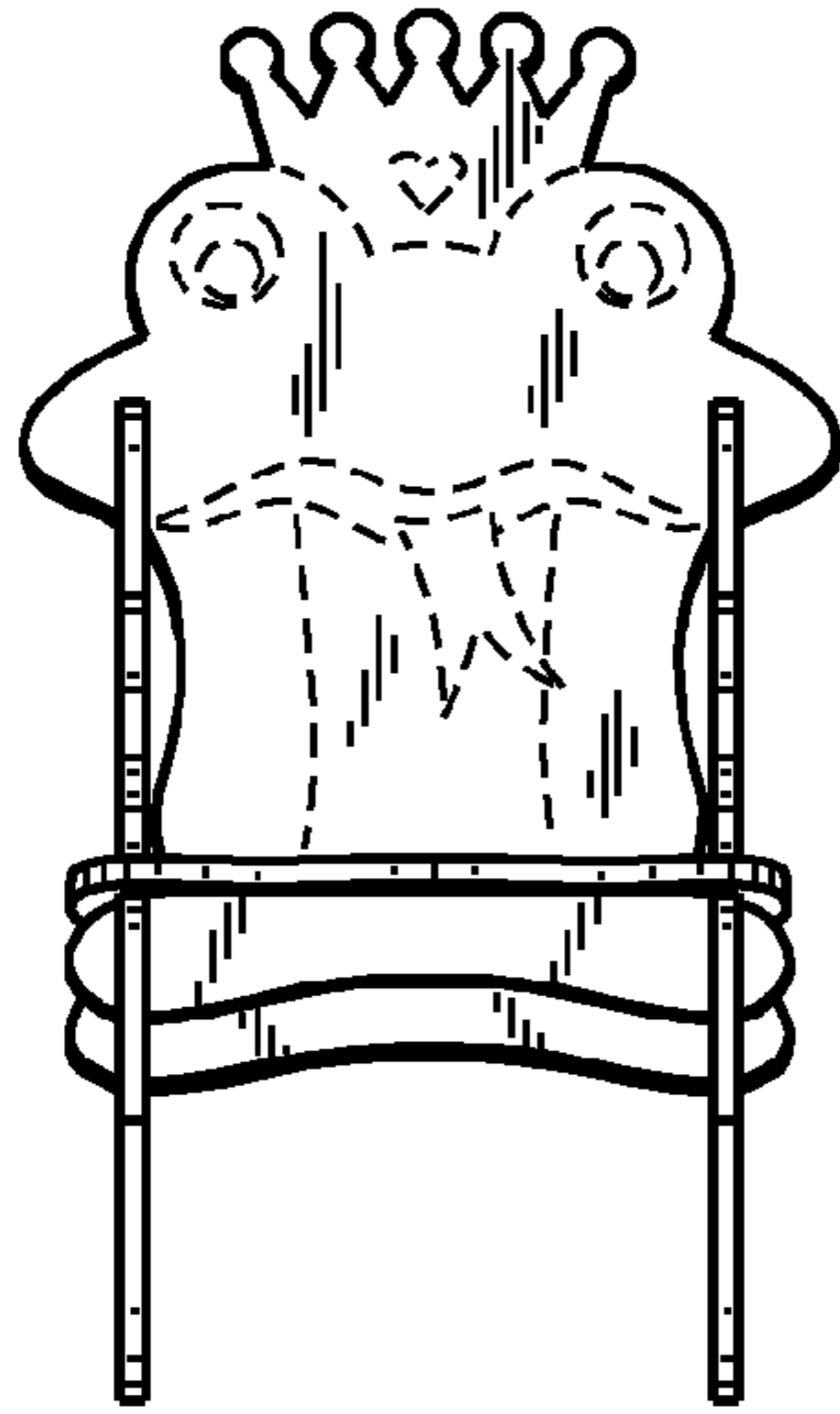

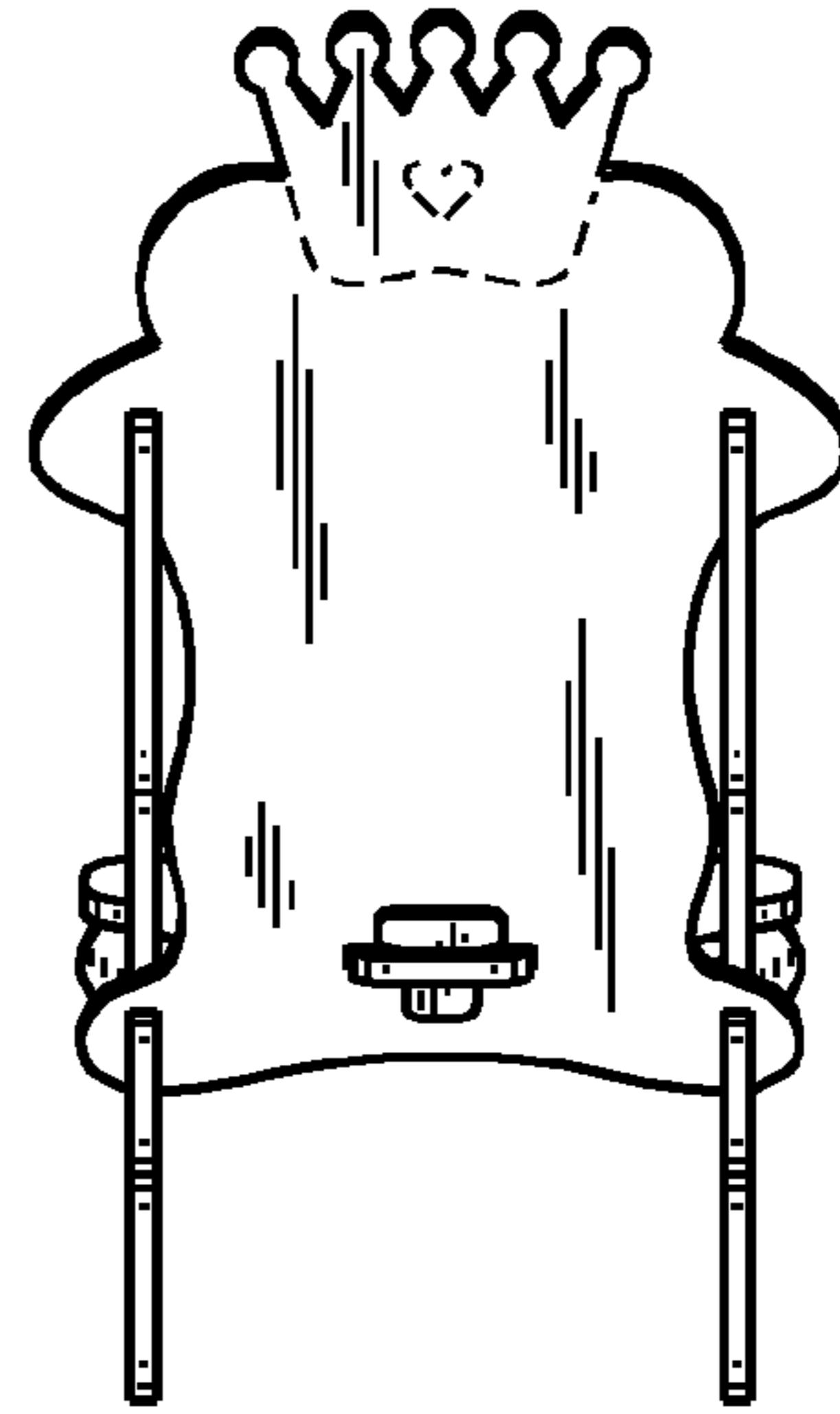

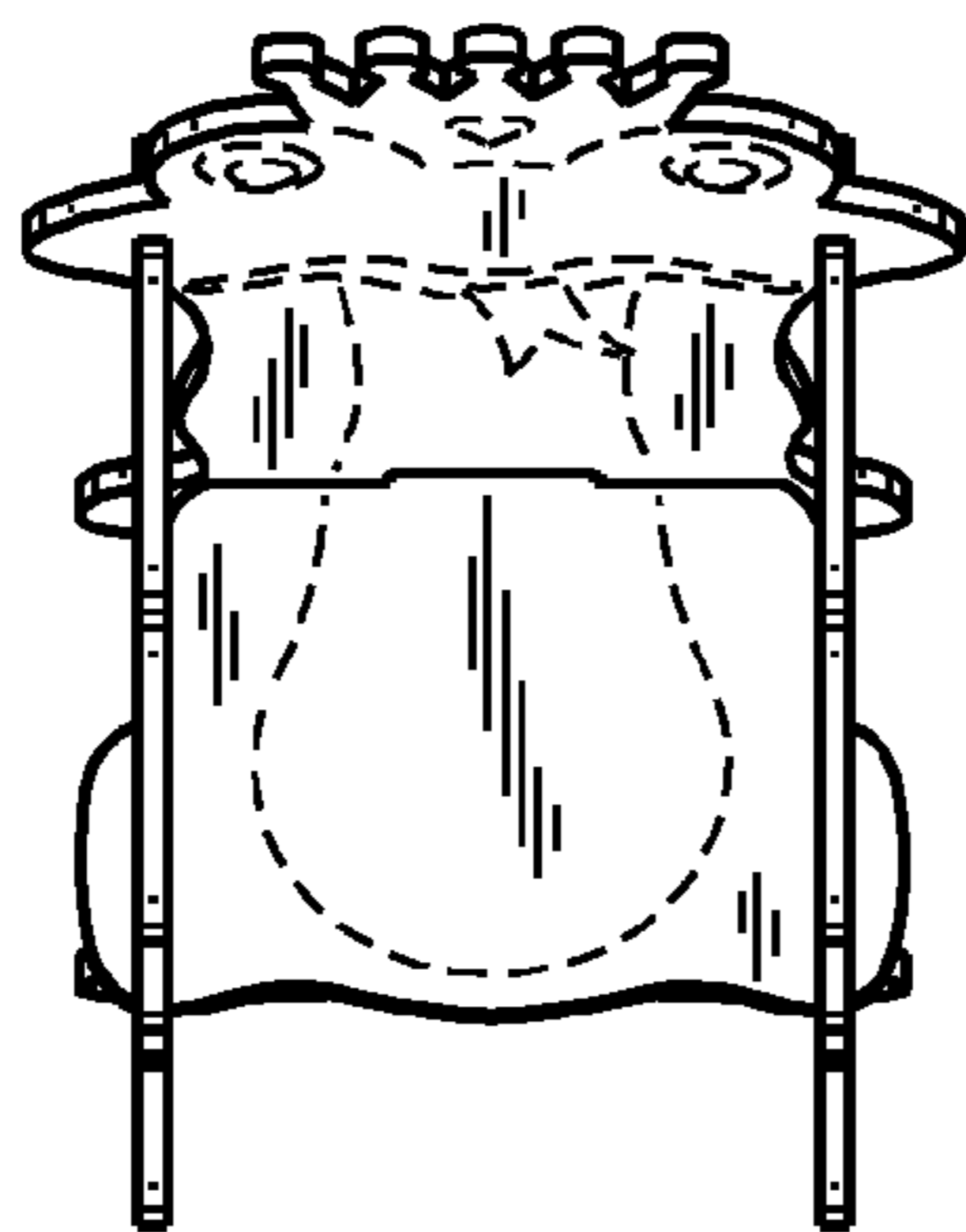

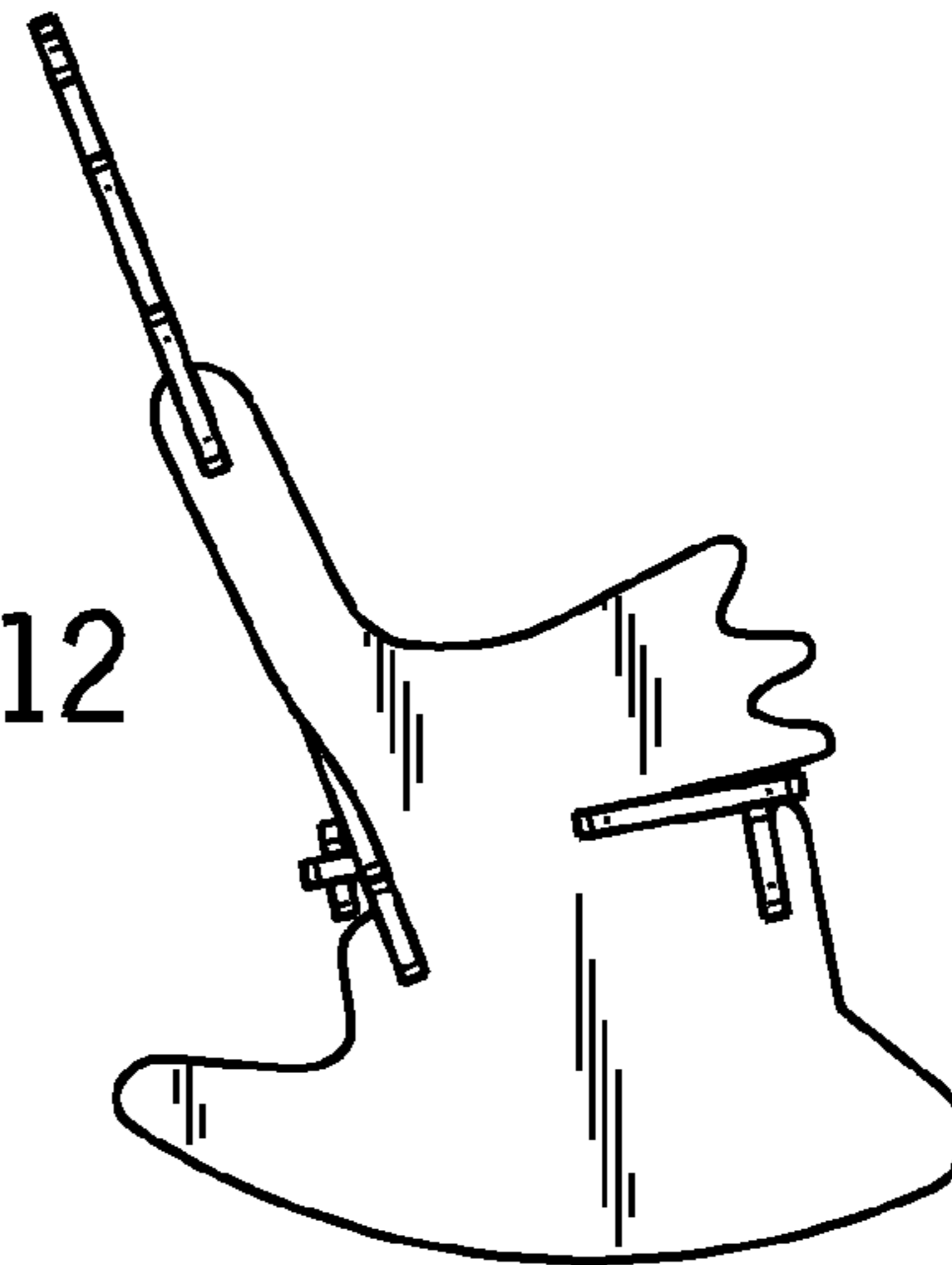
