FIG. 3 is left side elevational view as shown;

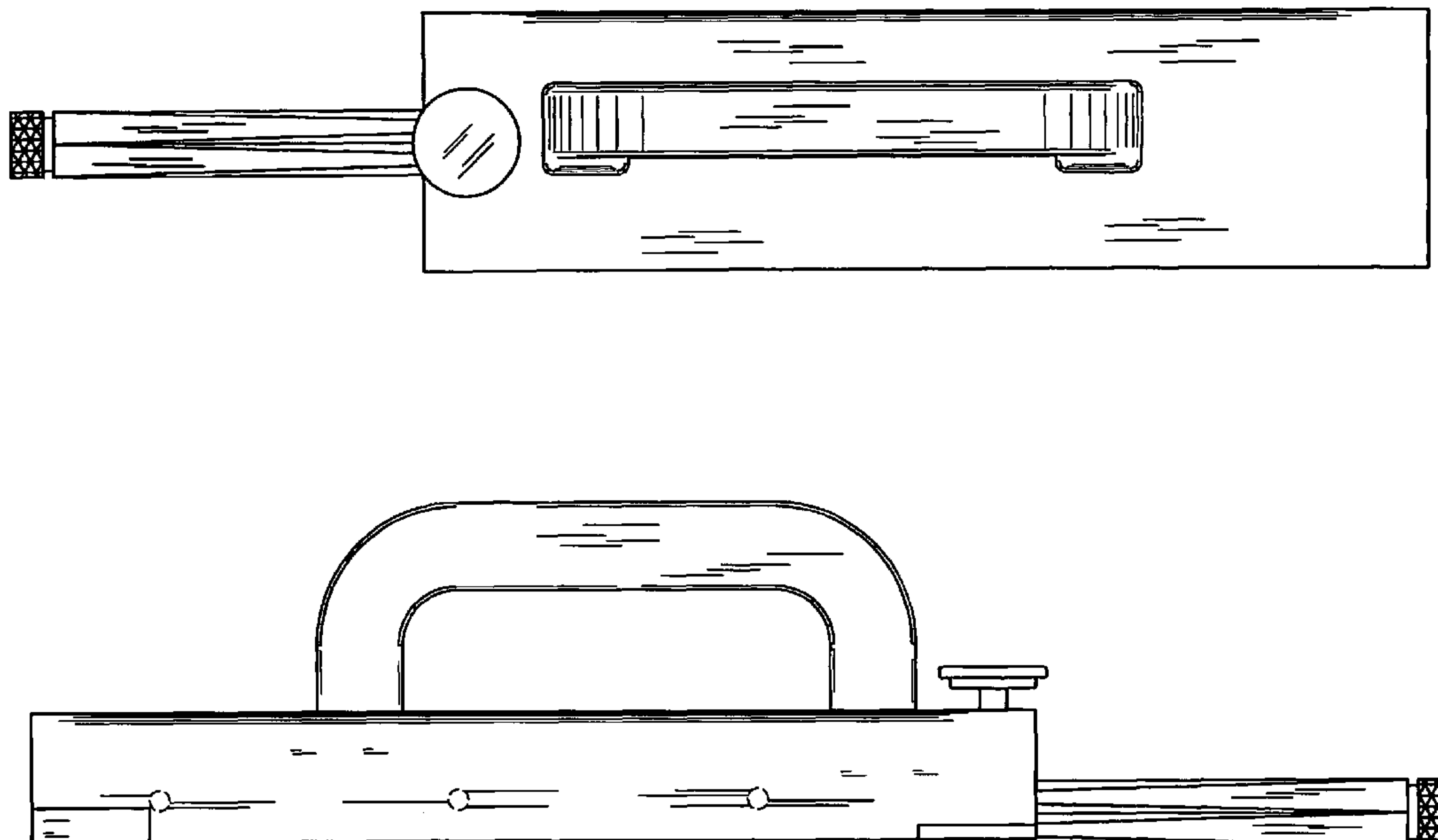
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

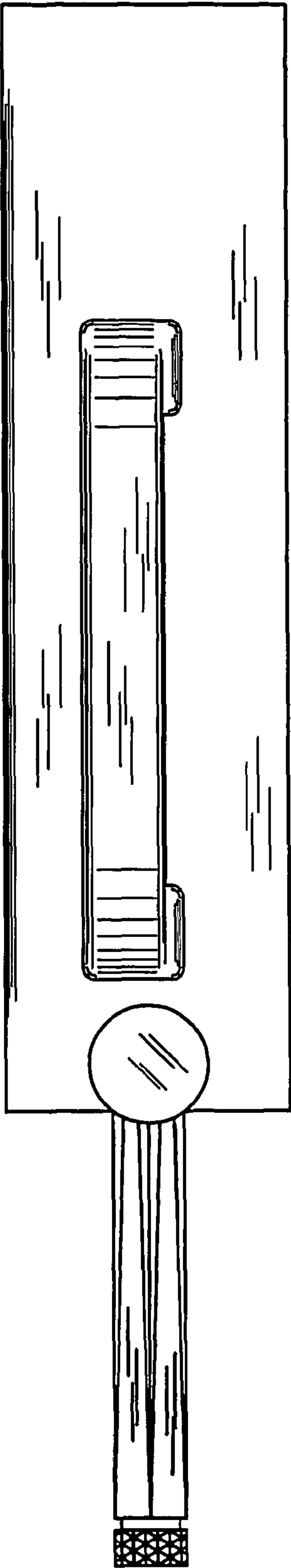

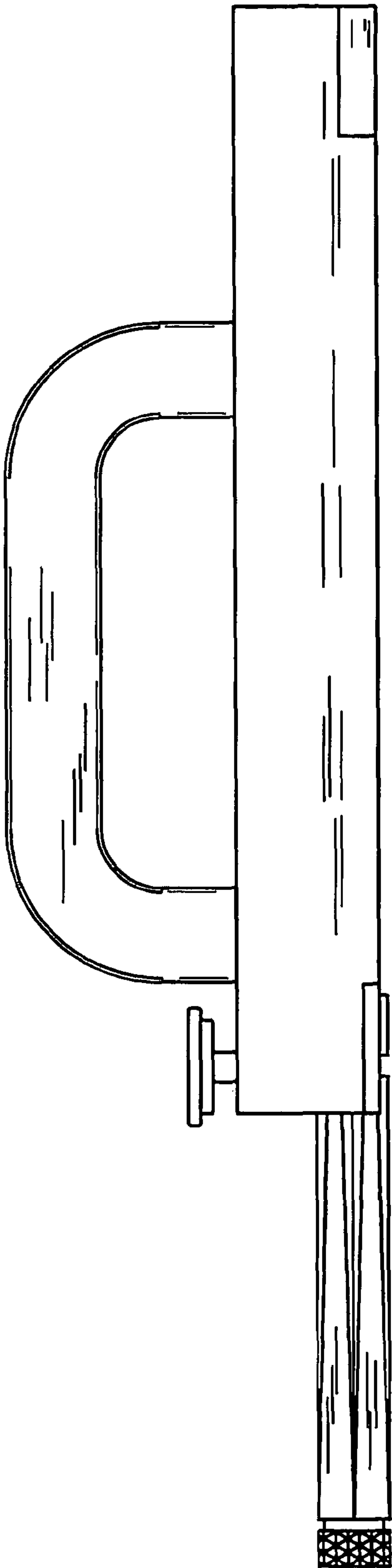

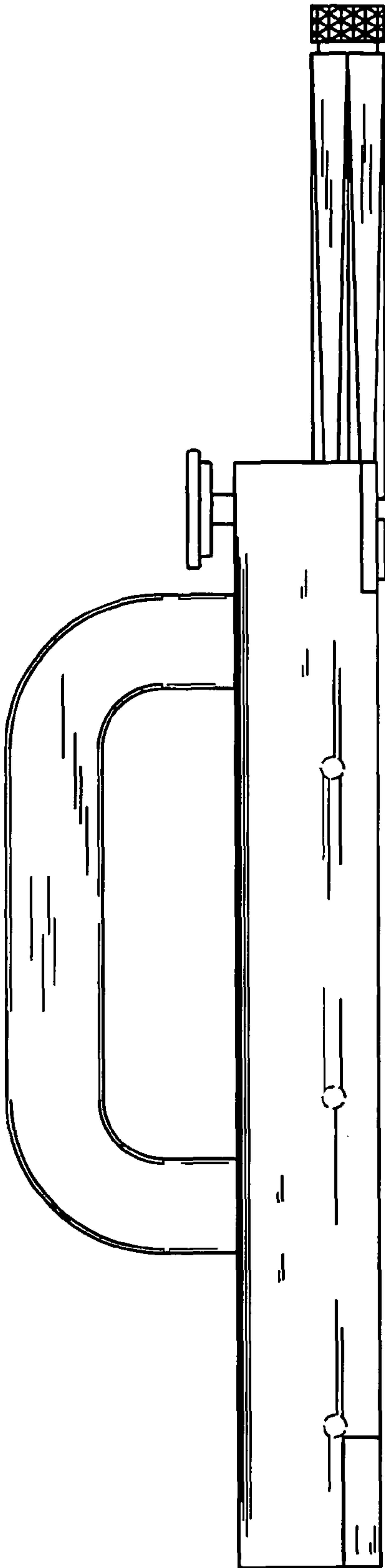

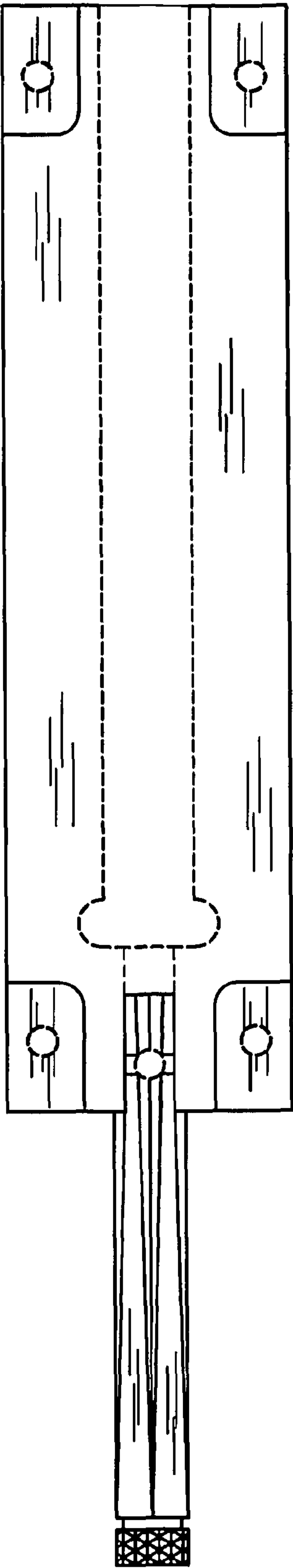

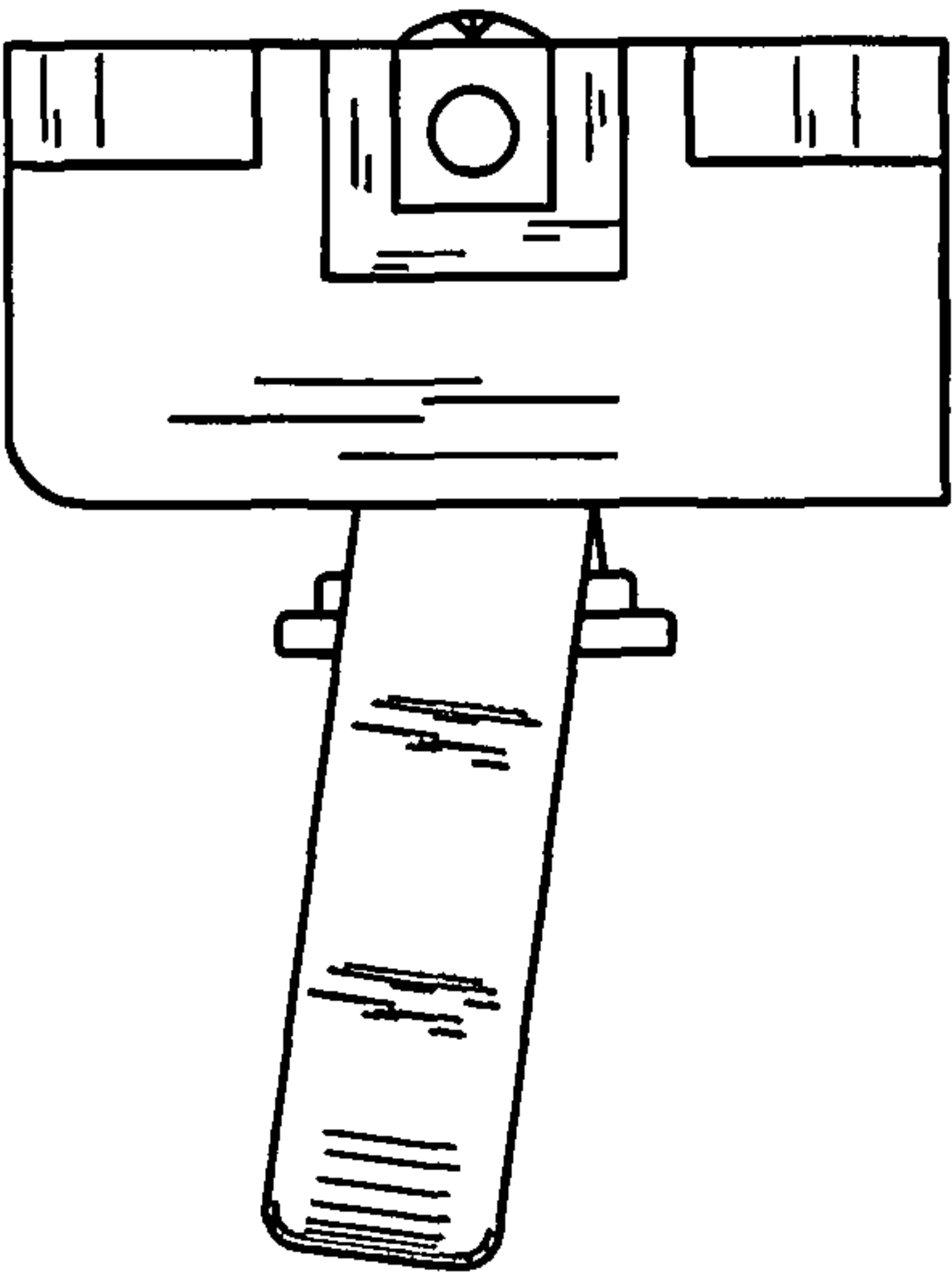

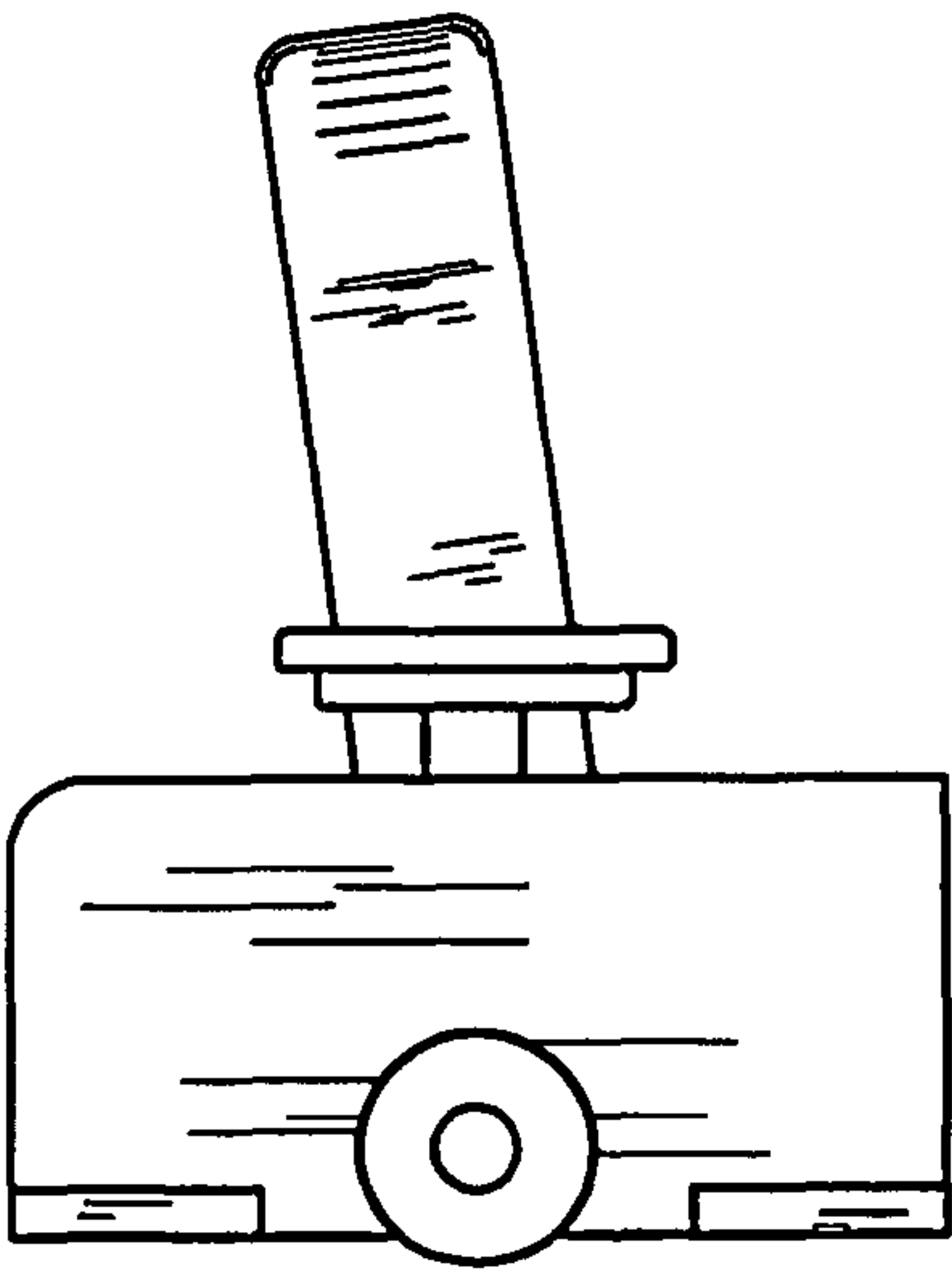
