The ornamental design for a disk sponge holder of frozen confection drops, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a disk sponge holder of frozen confection drops showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and

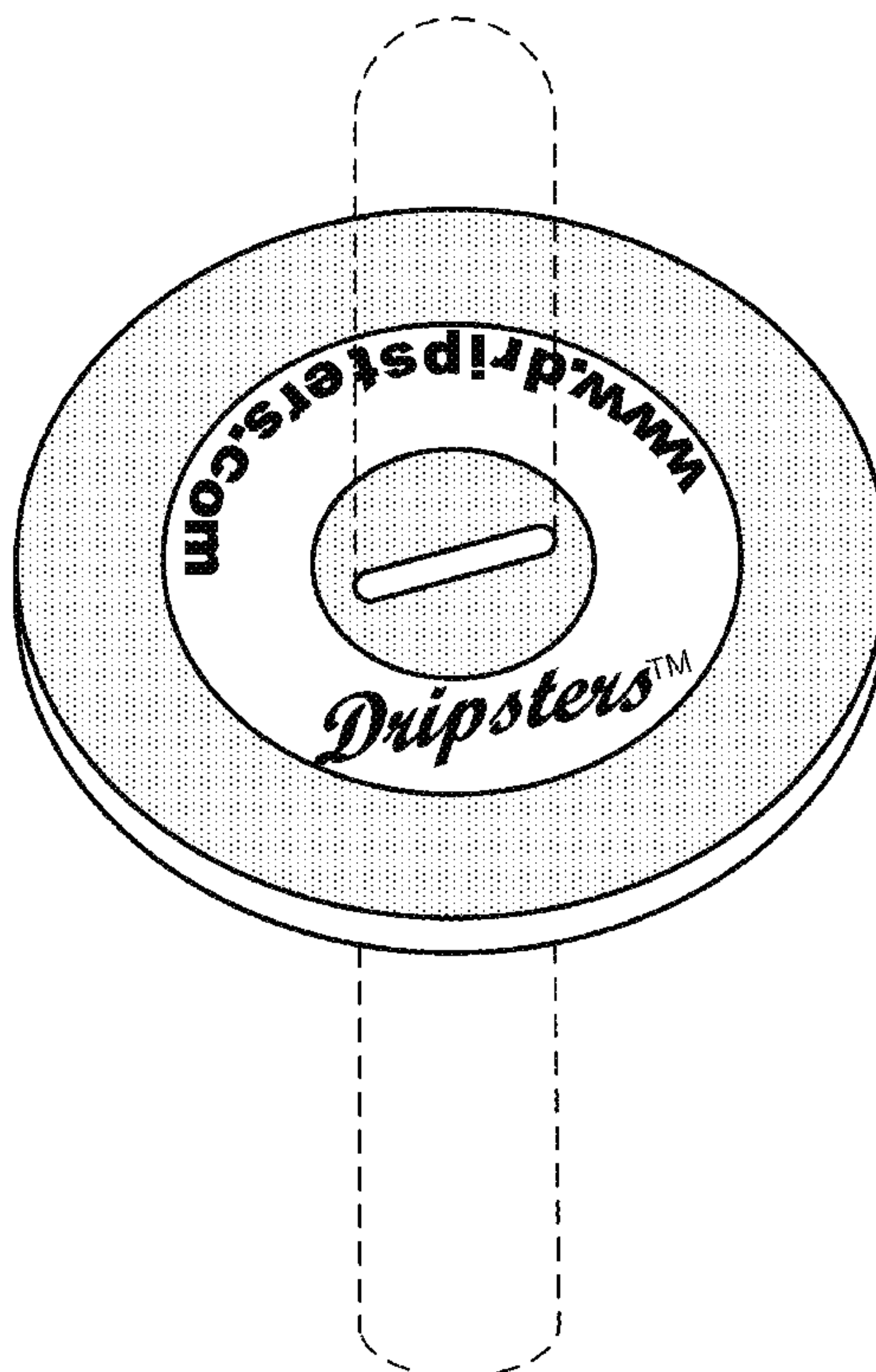

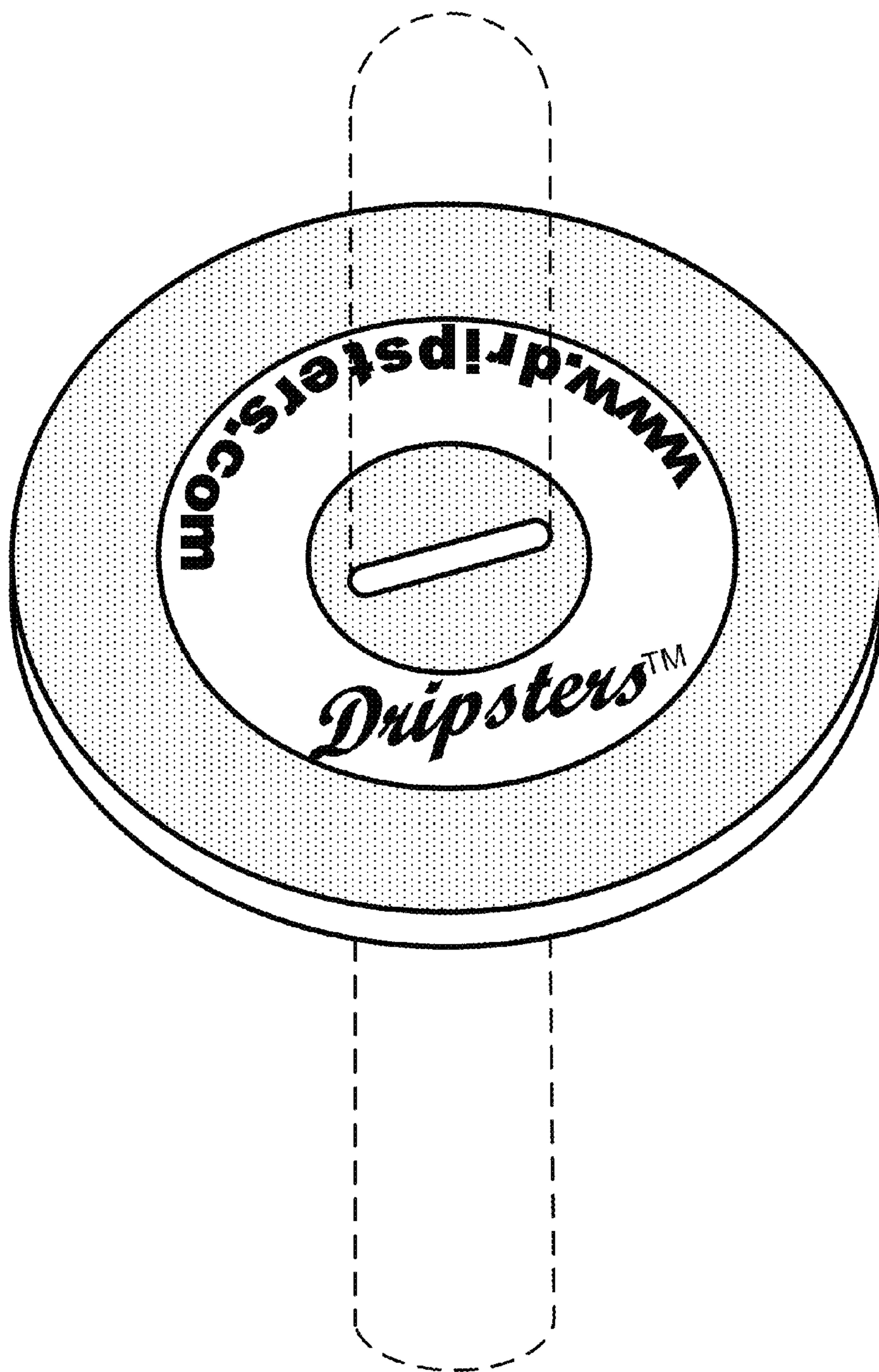

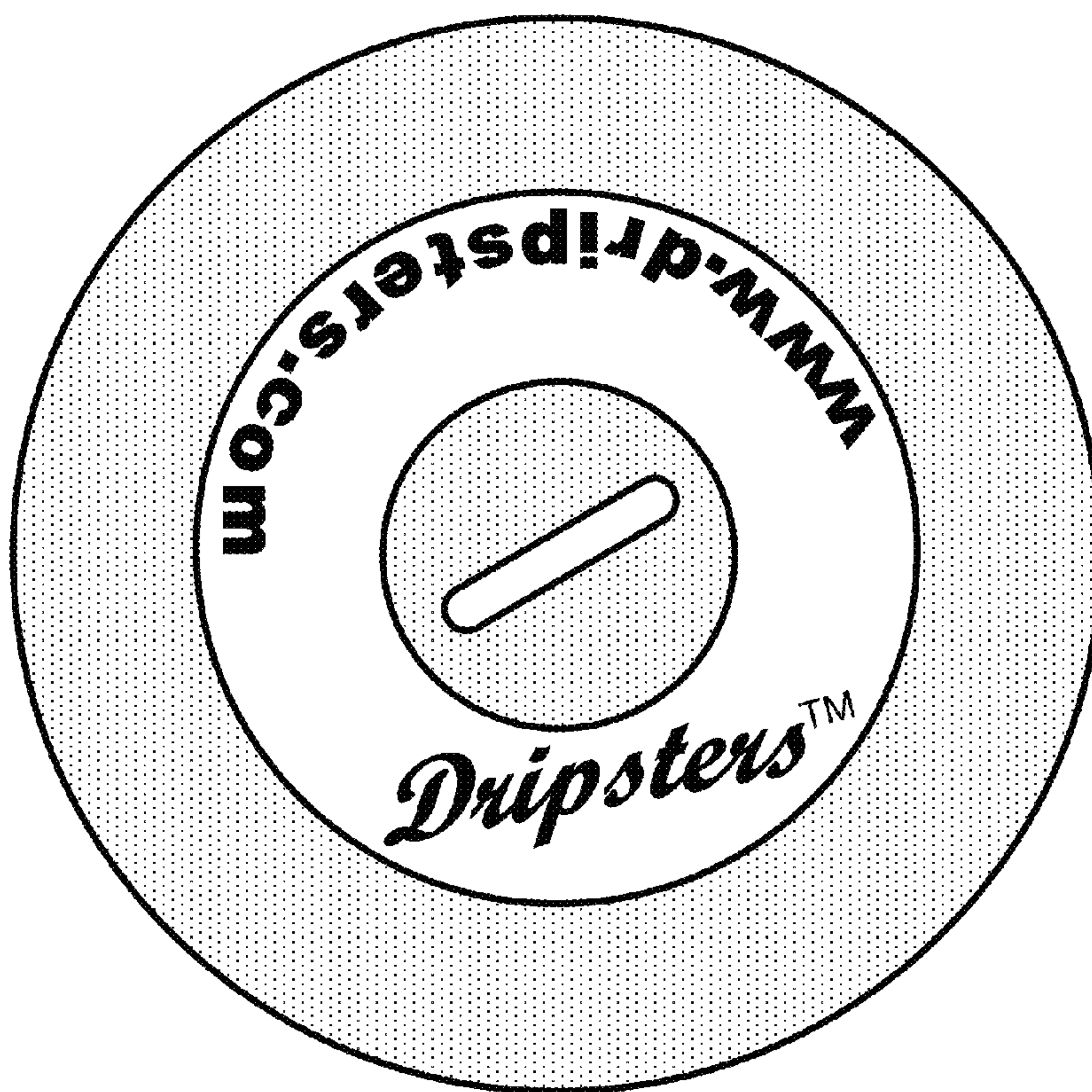

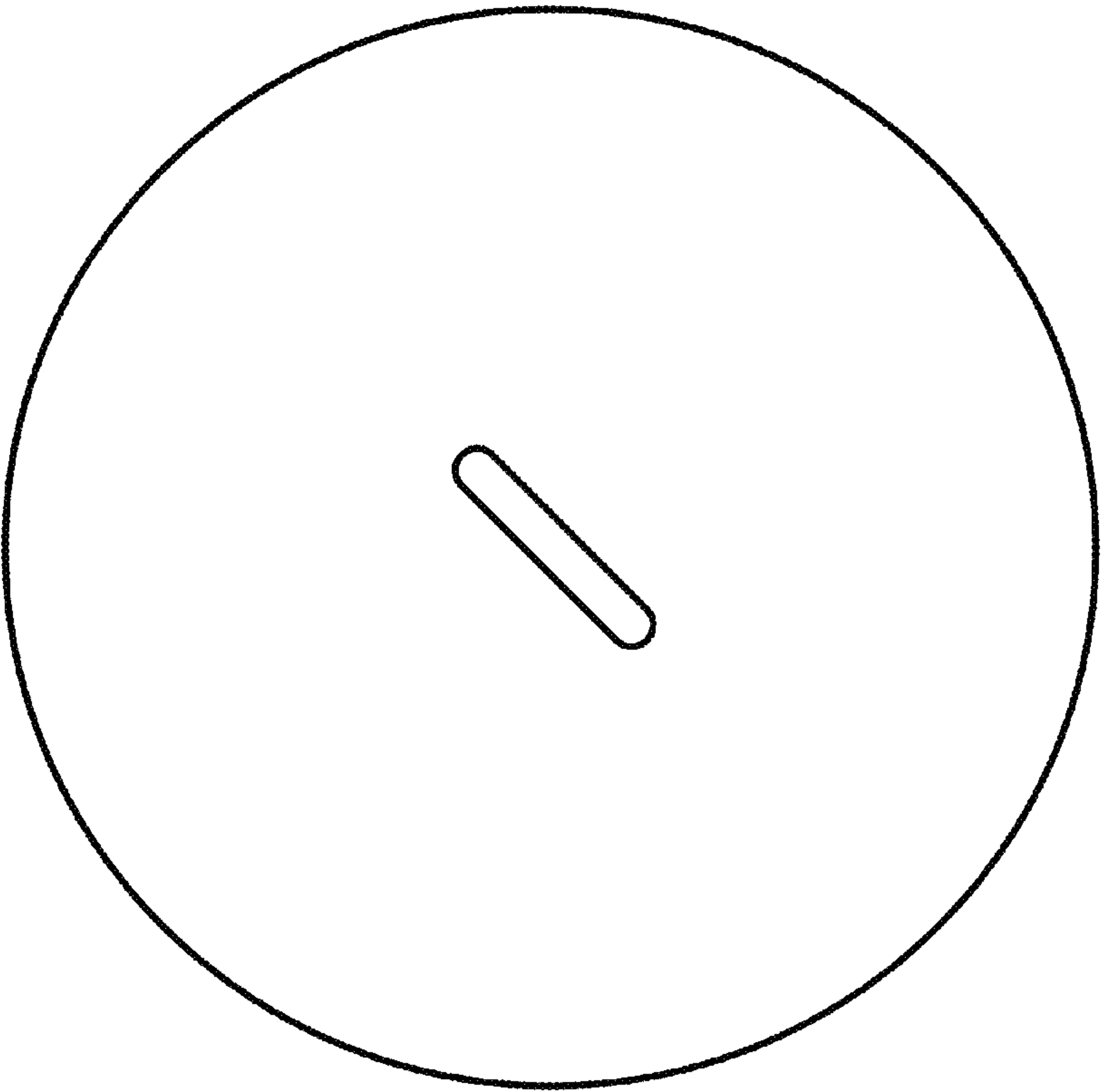

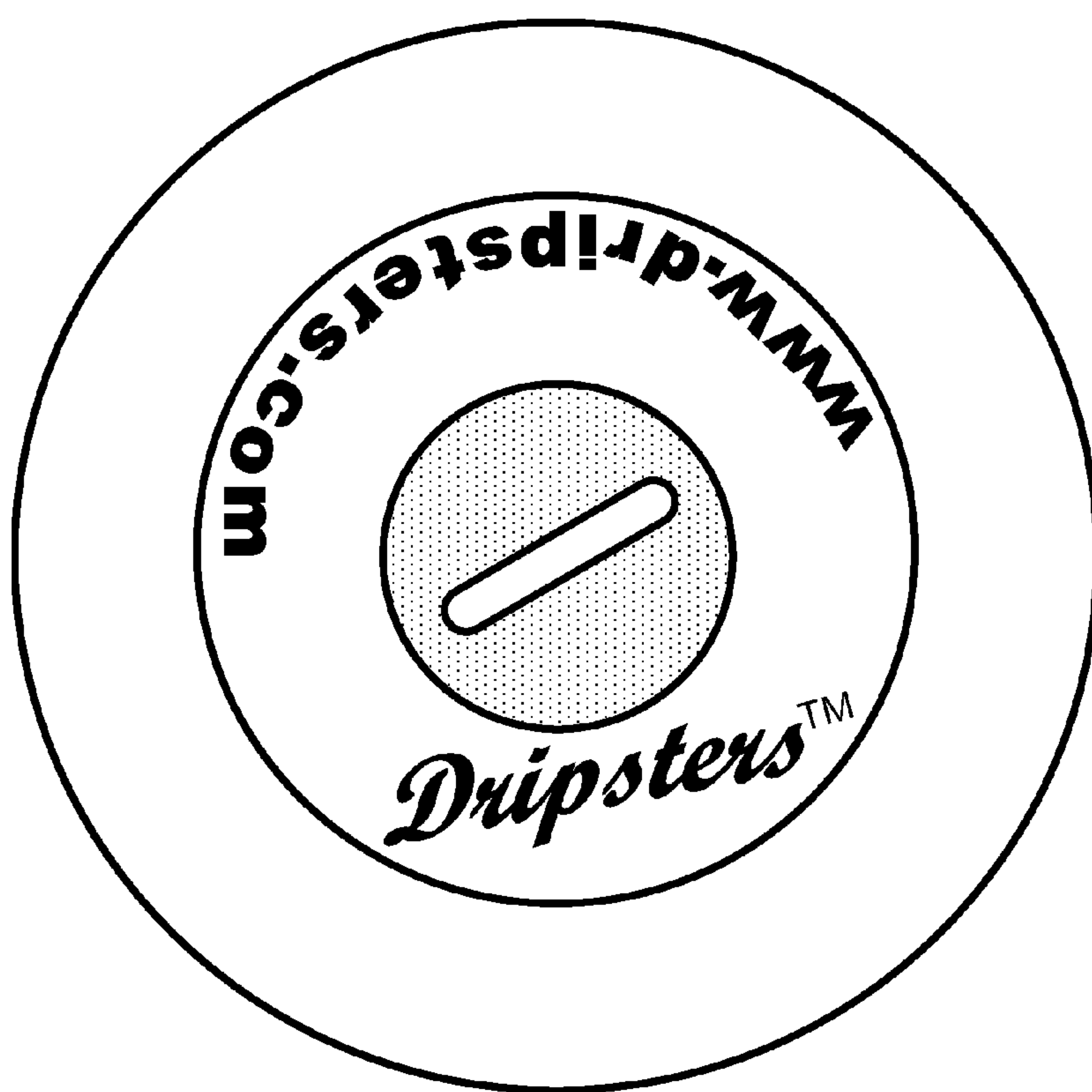

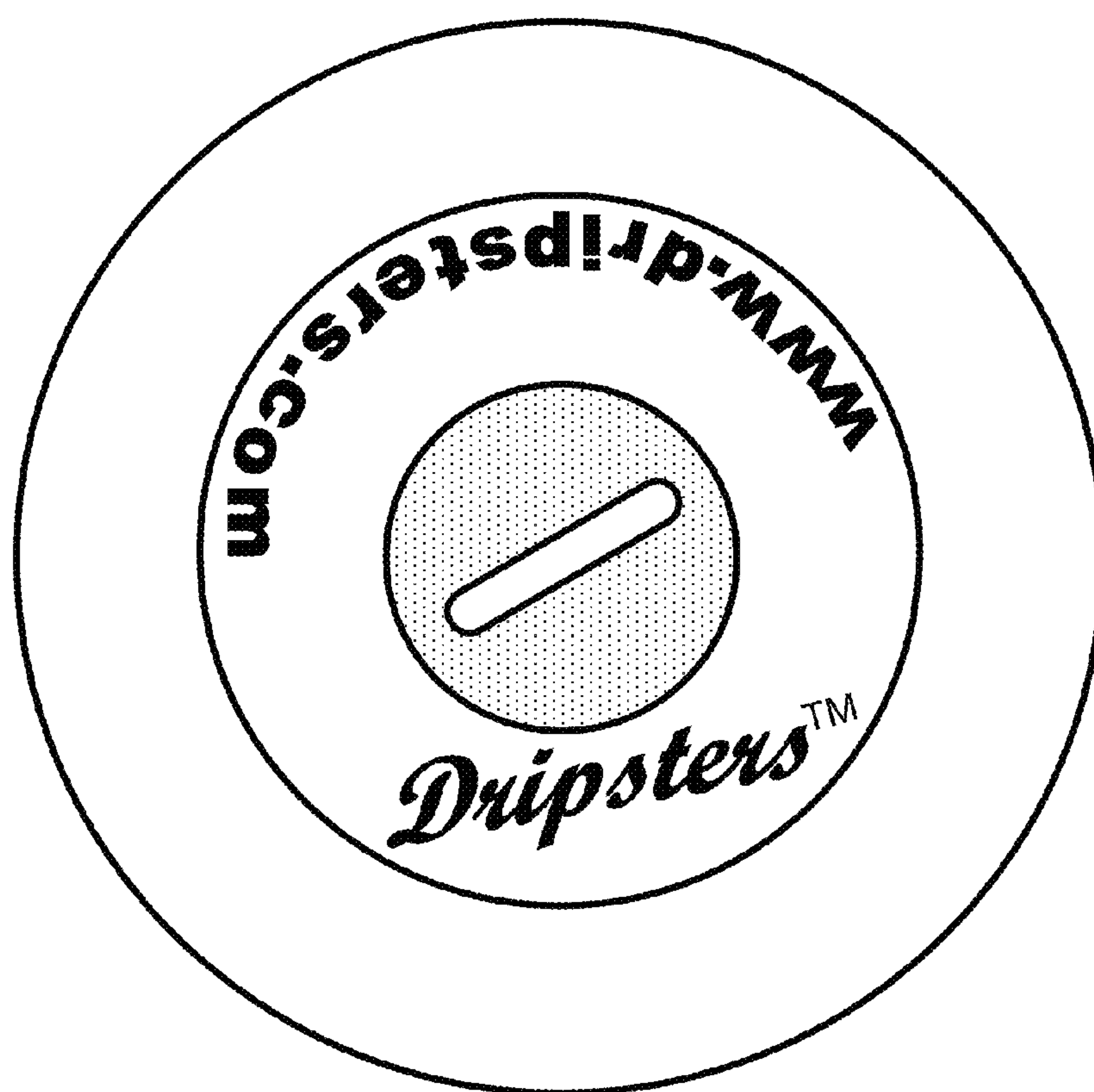
