(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a snowmobile fairing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from a front, left side of a snowmobile fairing according to our design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from a rear, left side thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view taken from a bottom left side thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

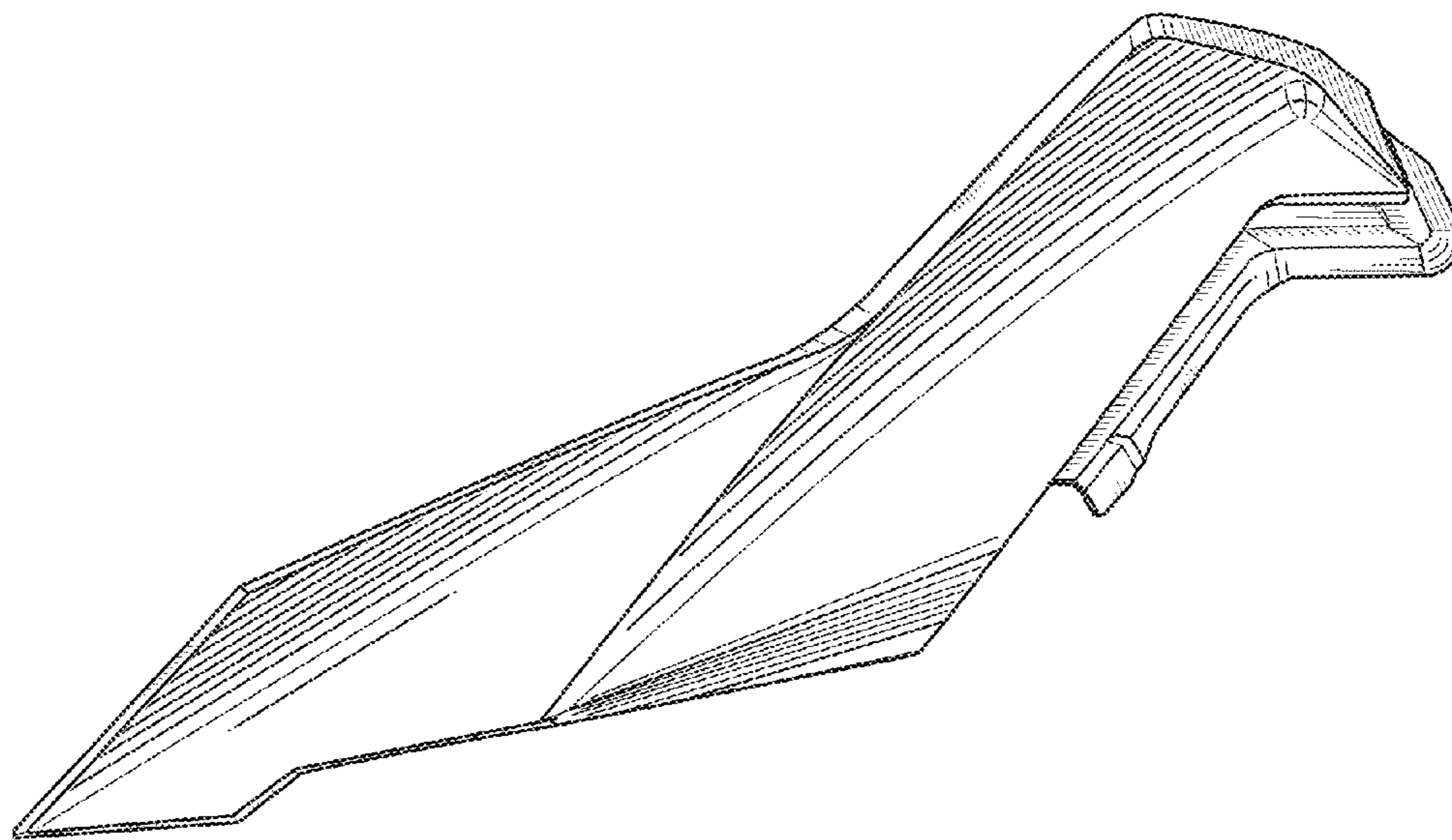
FIG. 8 a right side elevation view taken from a bottom, right side thereof; and,

FIG. 9 is a perspective view taken from a front, left side thereof shown on a snowmobile shown in dashed lines.

Throughout the Figures, where shown: (i) the dashed lines showing additional structure of the snowmobile fairing are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; (ii) the unshaded surfaces form no part of the claimed design; and (iii) the dotted/dashed lines illustrate unclaimed boundaries of surfaces claimed as part of the design. The invention includes mirror images of the snowmobile fairing shown in the Figures.

The claim includes a second embodiment of the snowmobile fairing, which is a mirror image of the views of the invention shown in the figures.

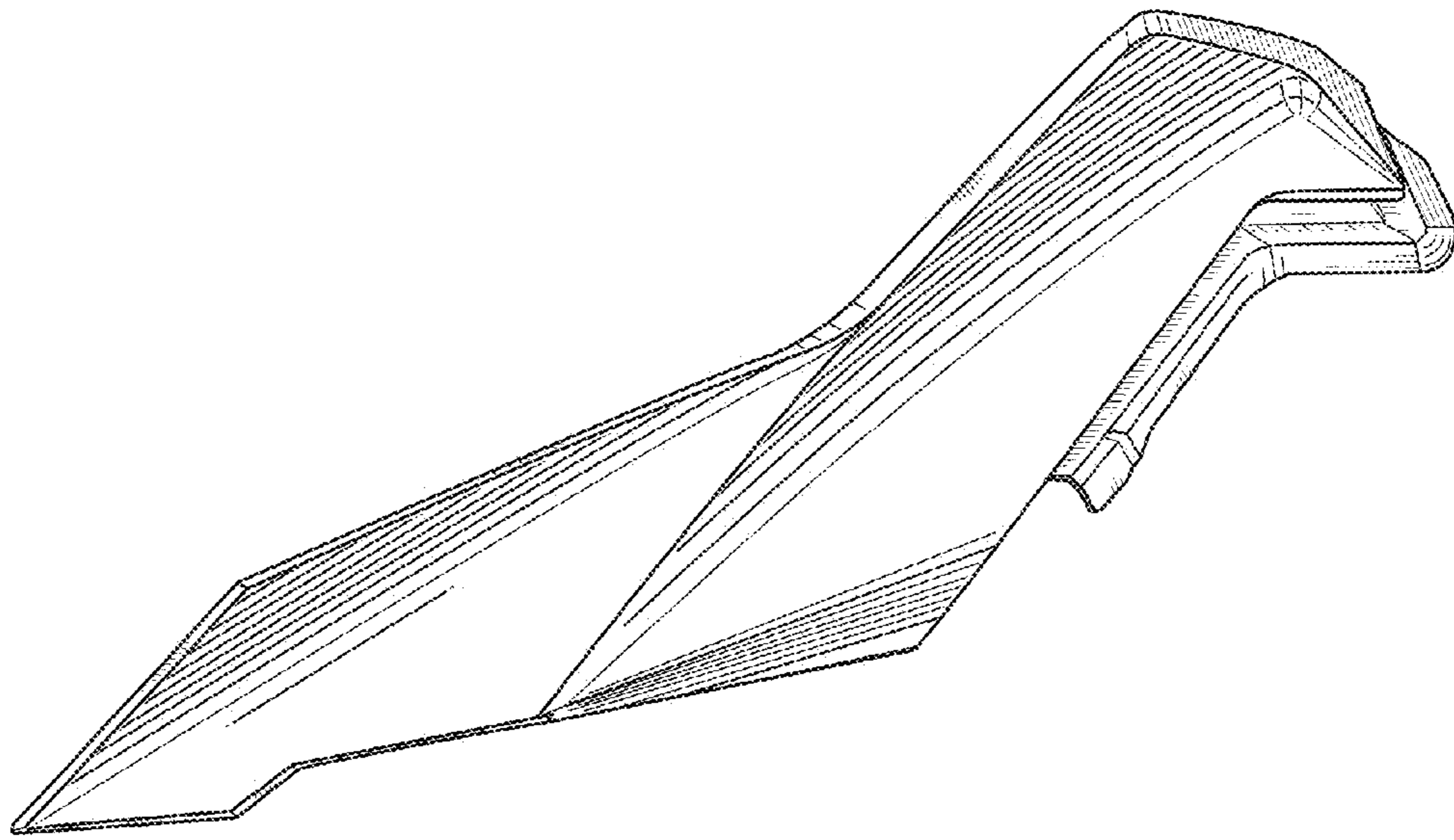

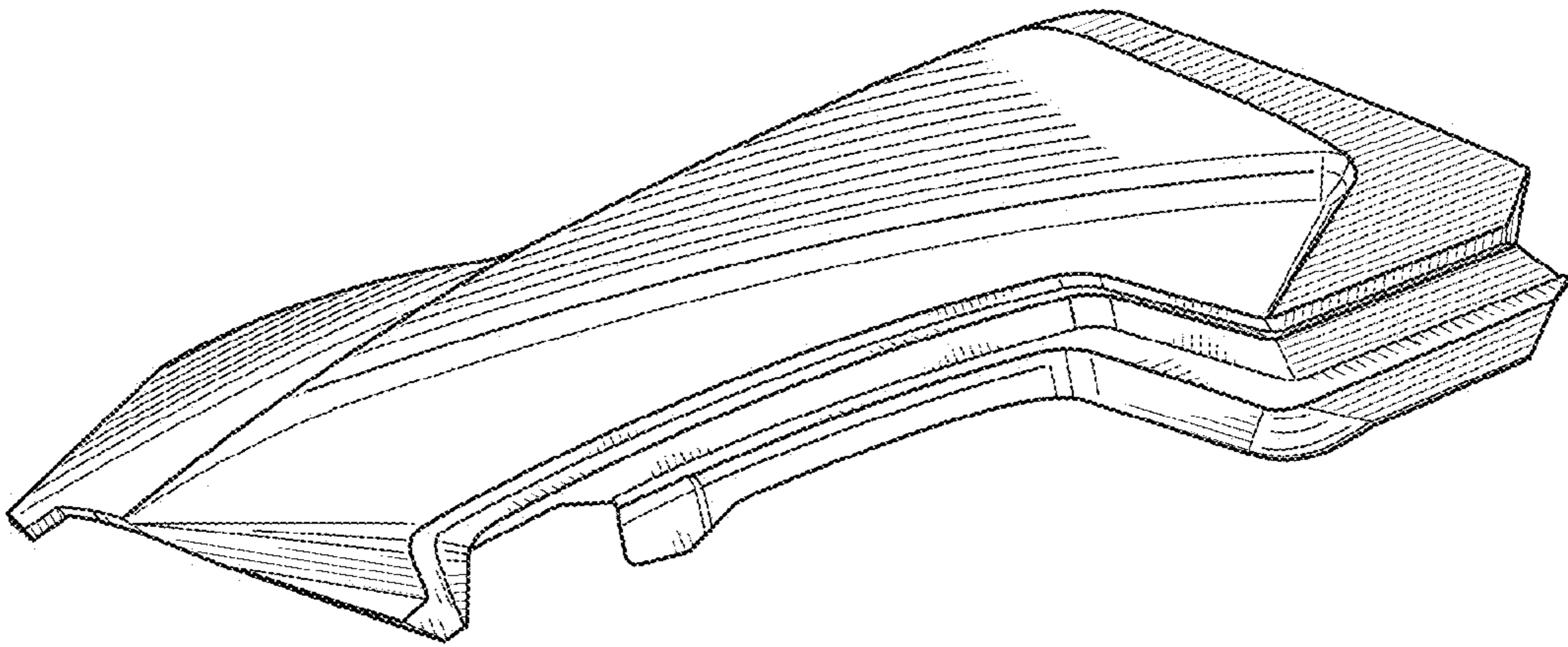

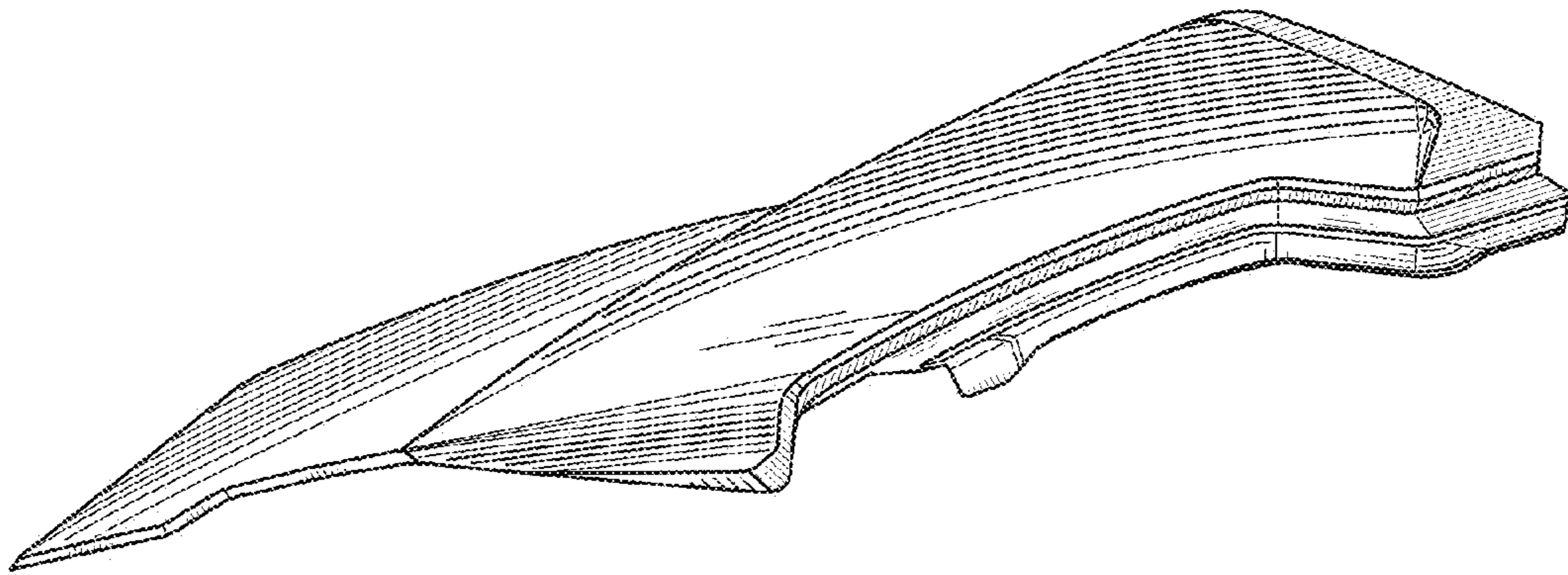

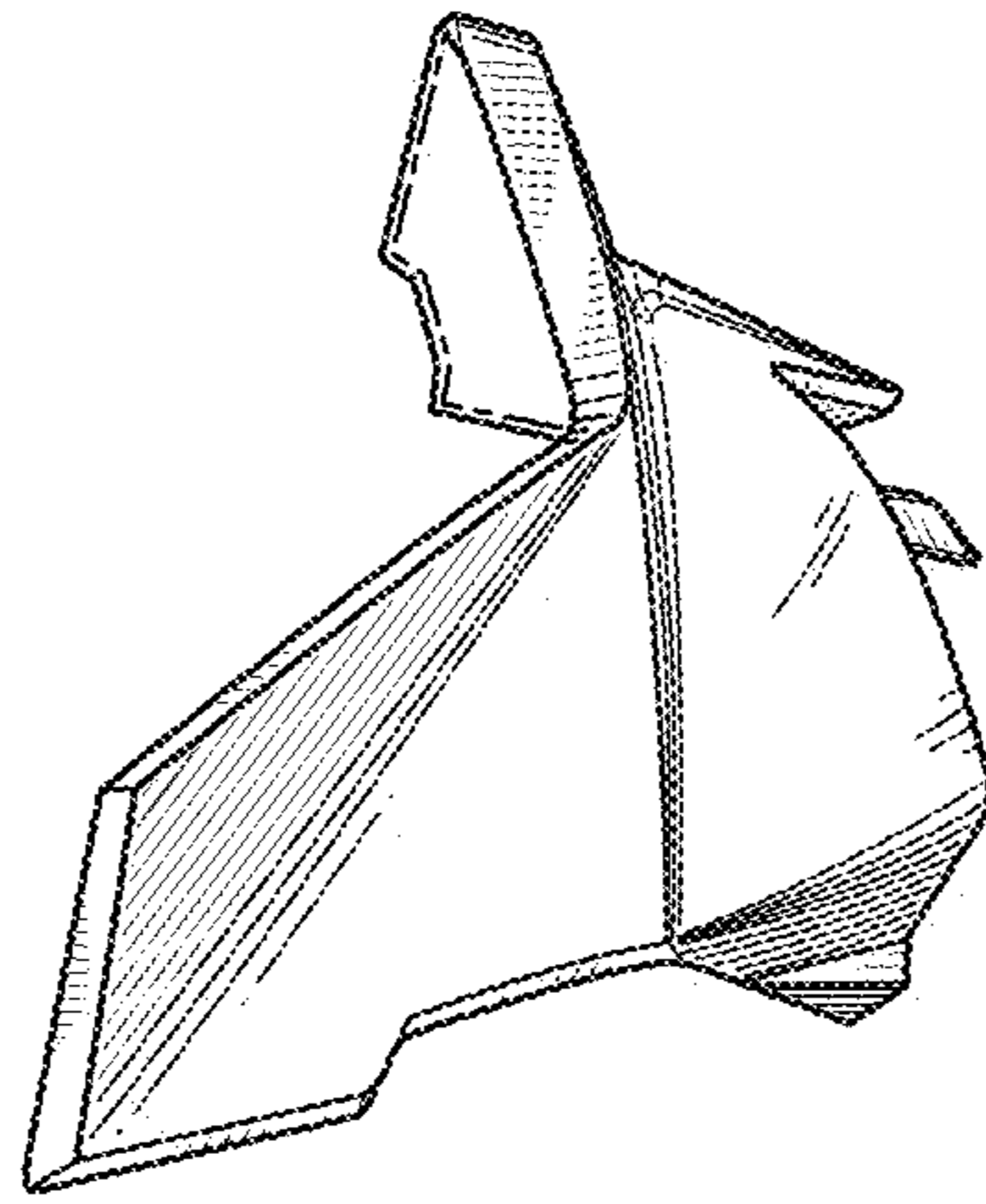

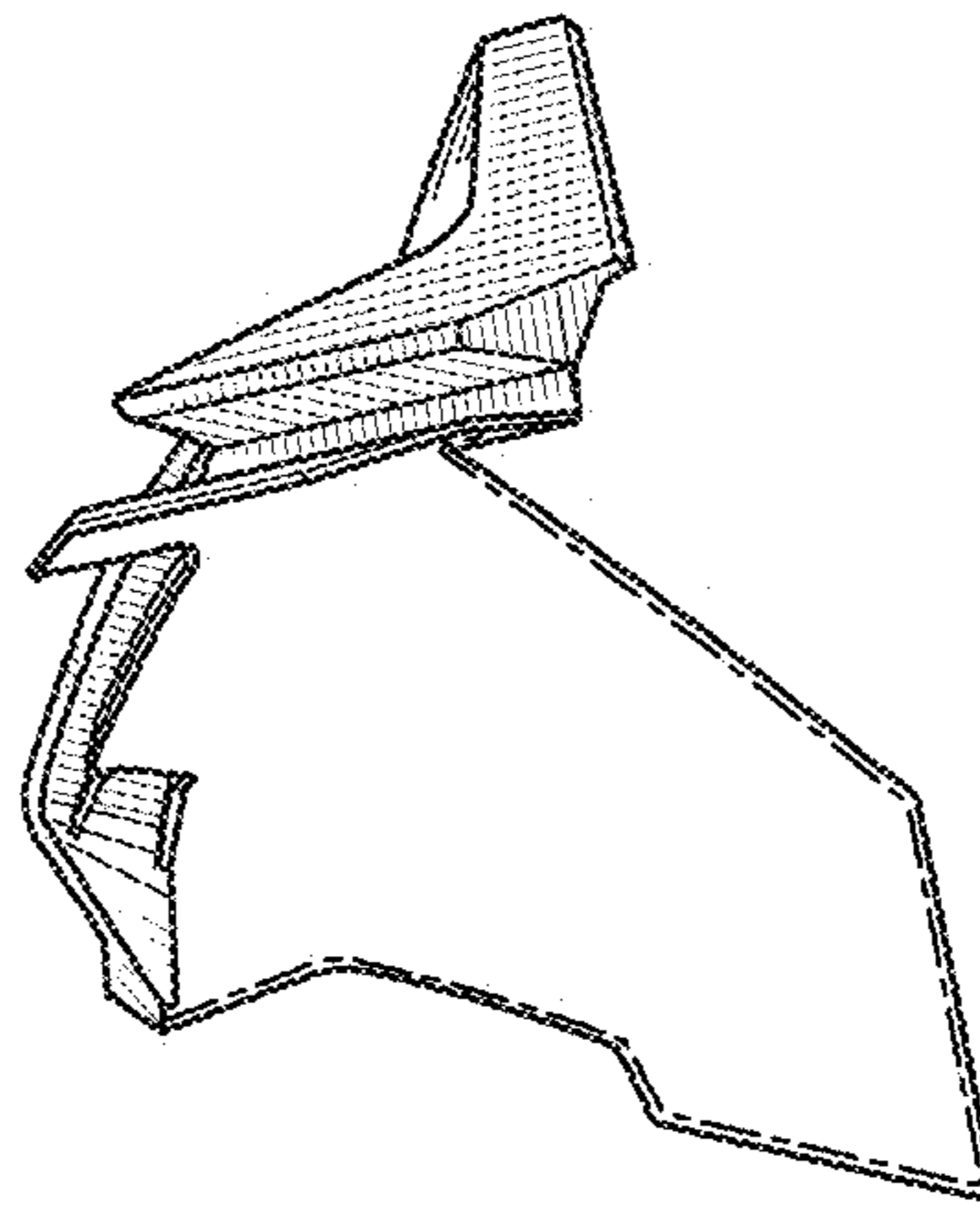

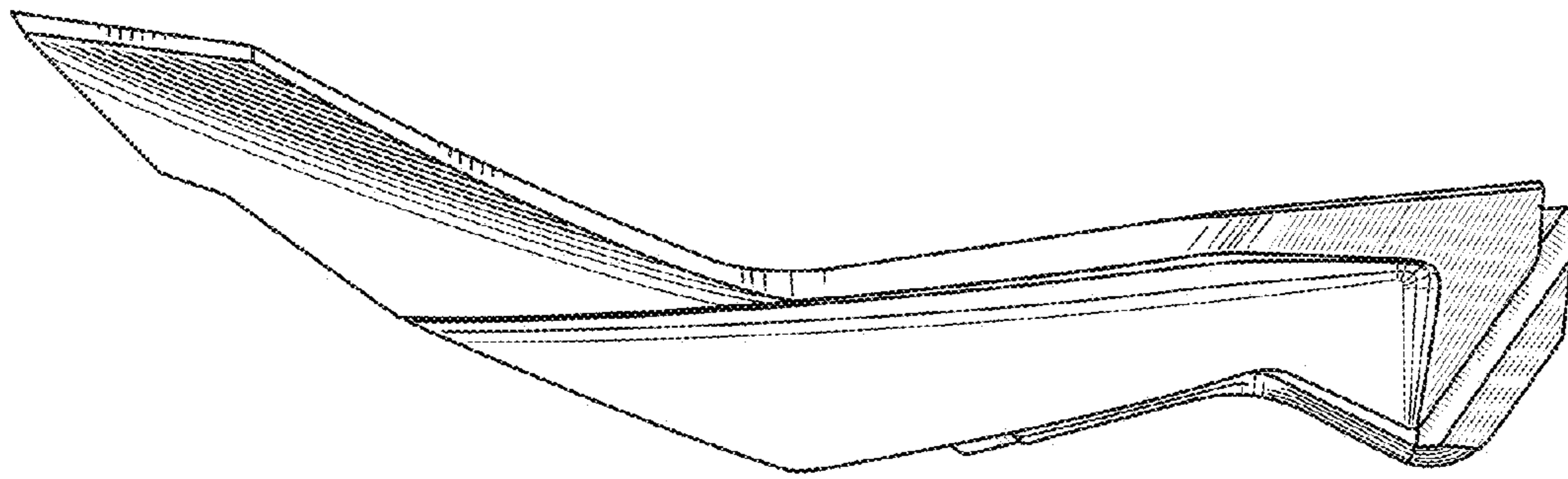

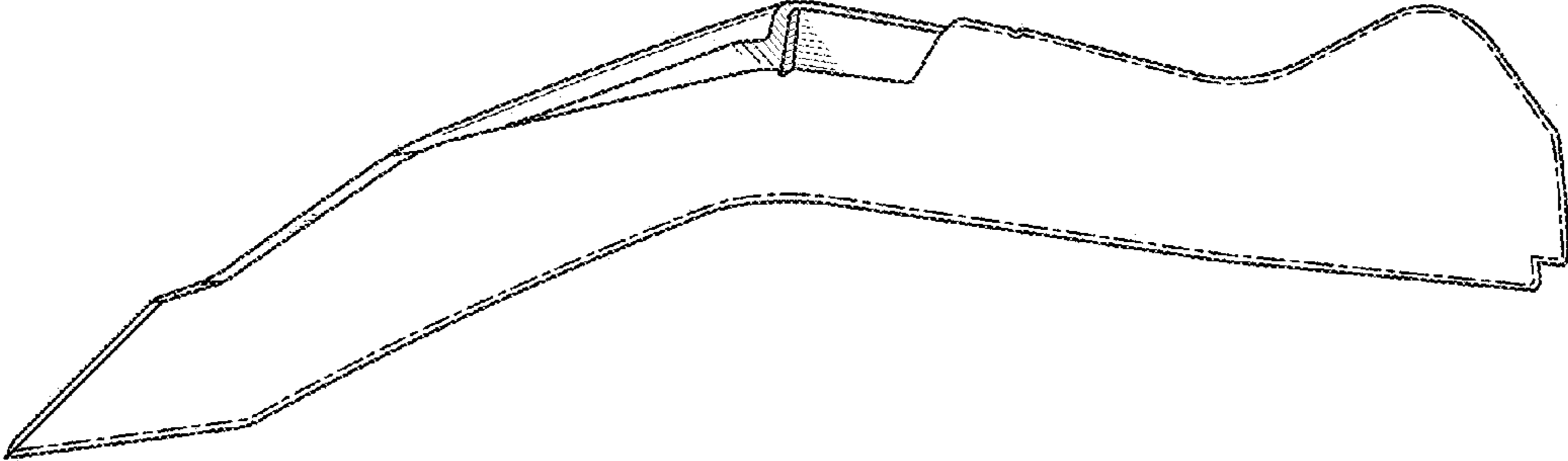

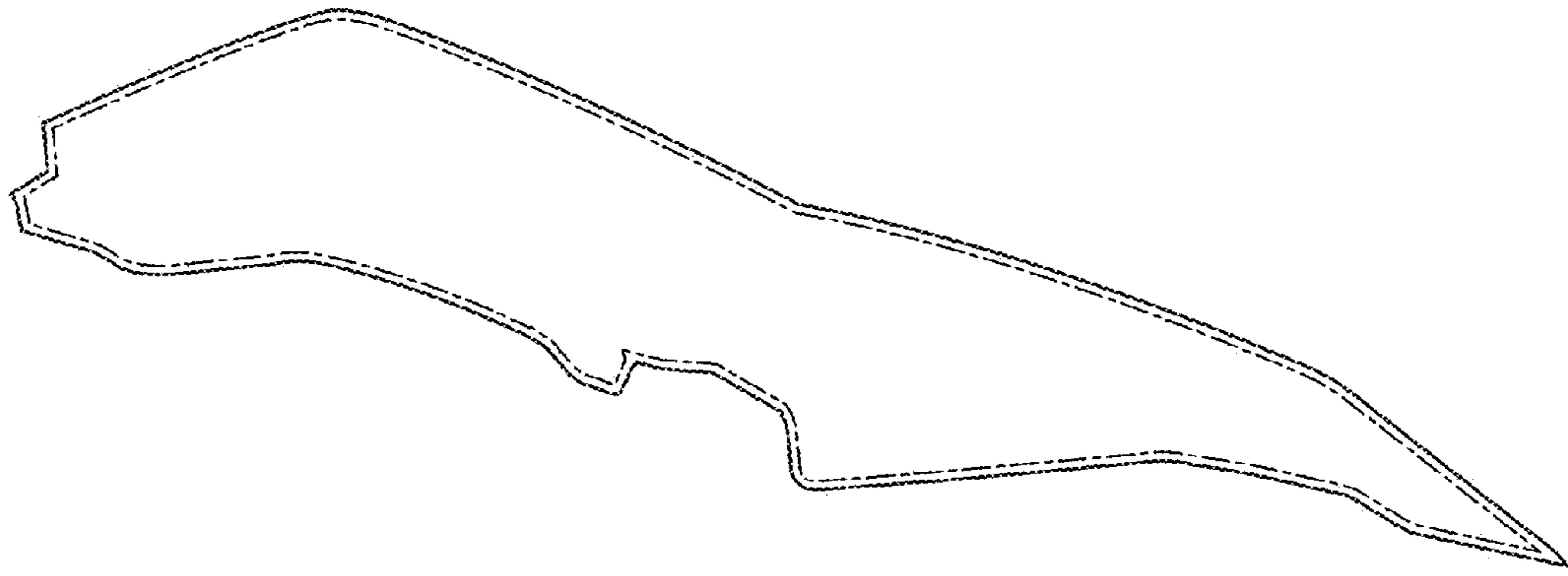

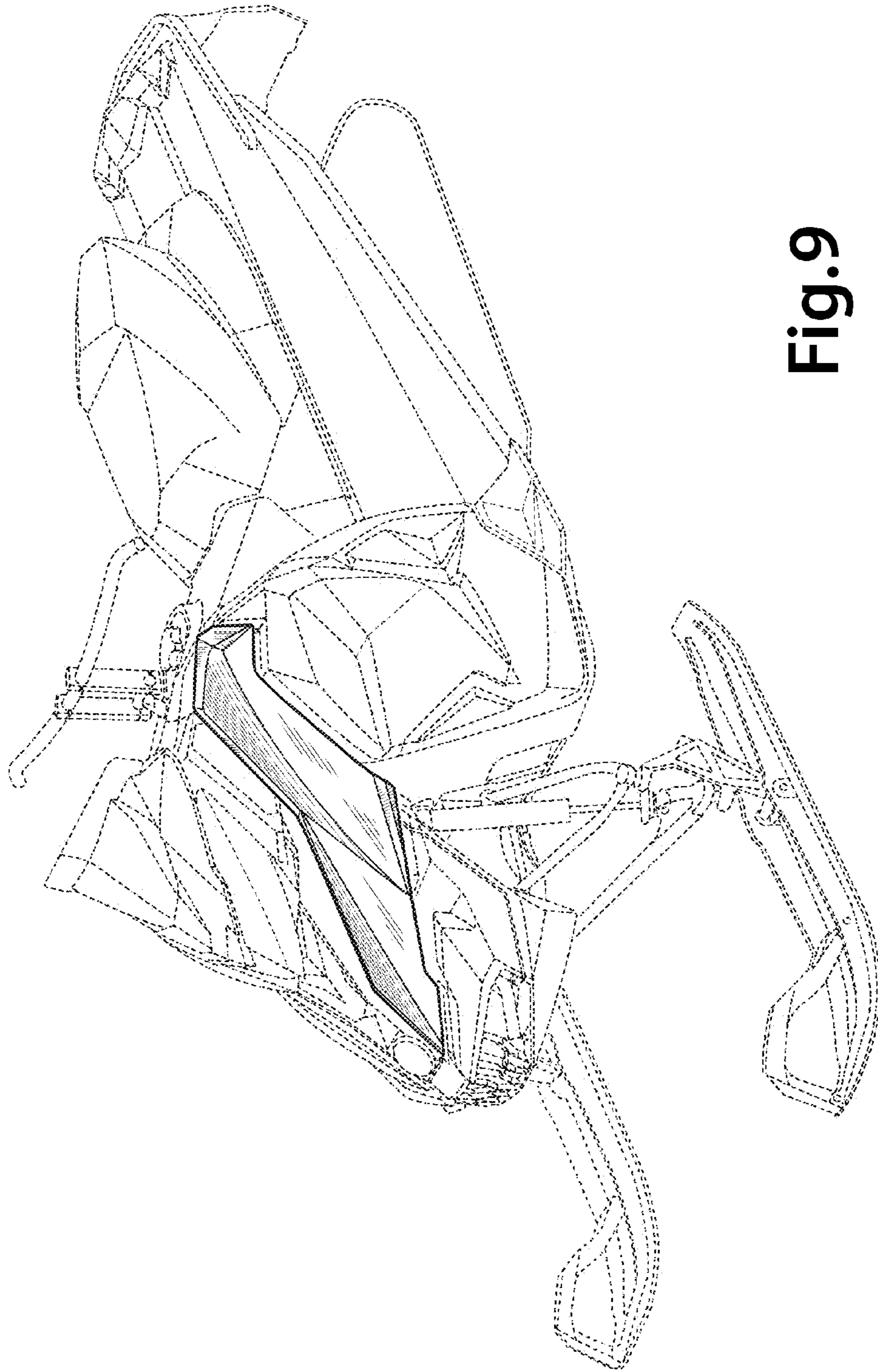
