The ornamental design for a lower torso article of clothing with plurality of access seams, as shown and described.

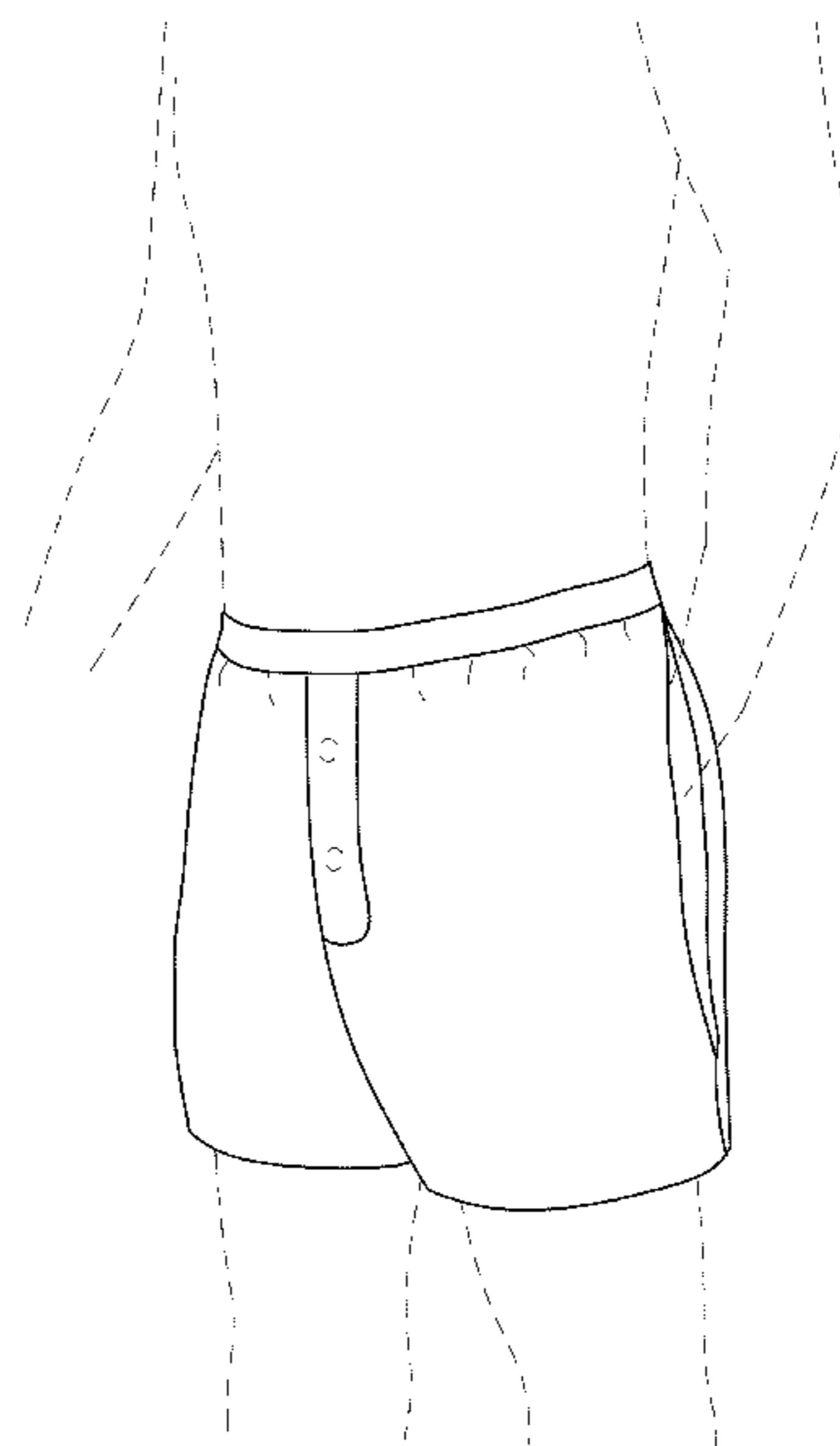
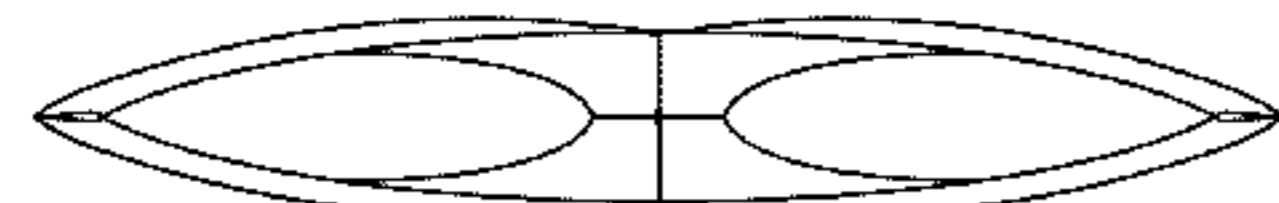
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lower torso article of clothing with plurality of access seams;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left elevational view thereof, the right elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is an isometric view thereof, showing our design being used.

The broken lines showing a partial human figure in the drawings illustrate the environment in which the design is used, and assists in showing how the claimed design appears when worn. The broken lines shown on the article itself illustrate unclaimed features. The broken-line subject matter forms no part of the claim.

The claimed lower torso article of clothing with plurality of access seams is used by persons who need to take a shower where other people are present and want additional privacy. The access seams/slits permit a user to access and wash all body parts covered by the instant invention while their private parts are not exposed.

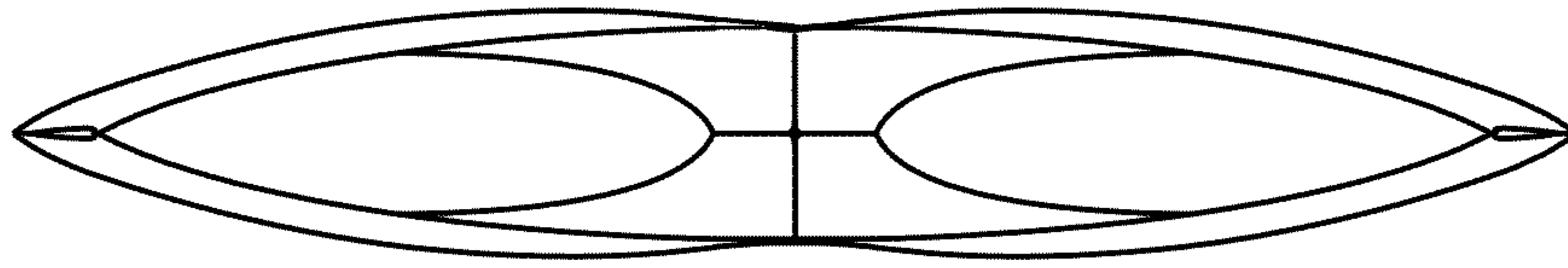

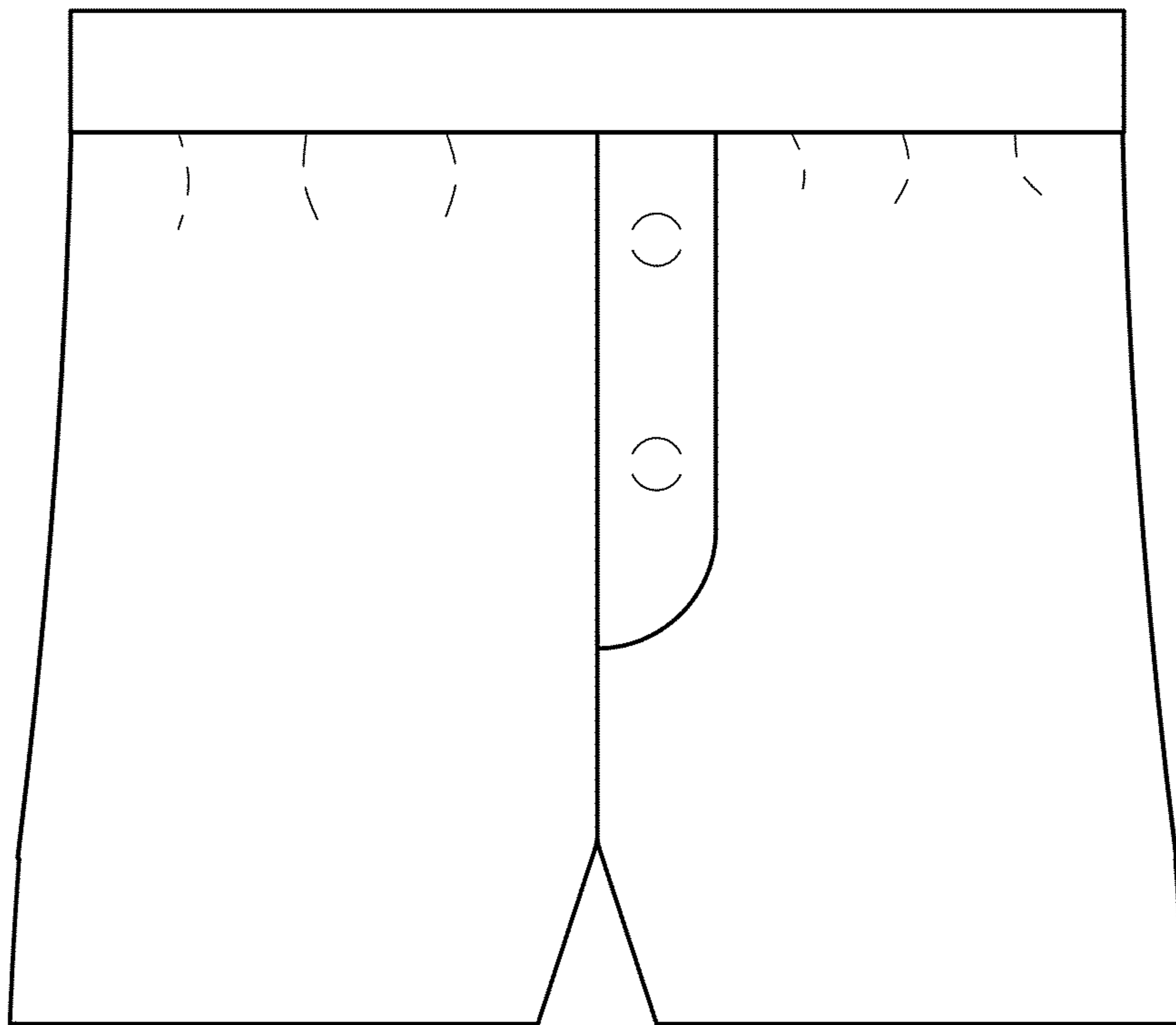

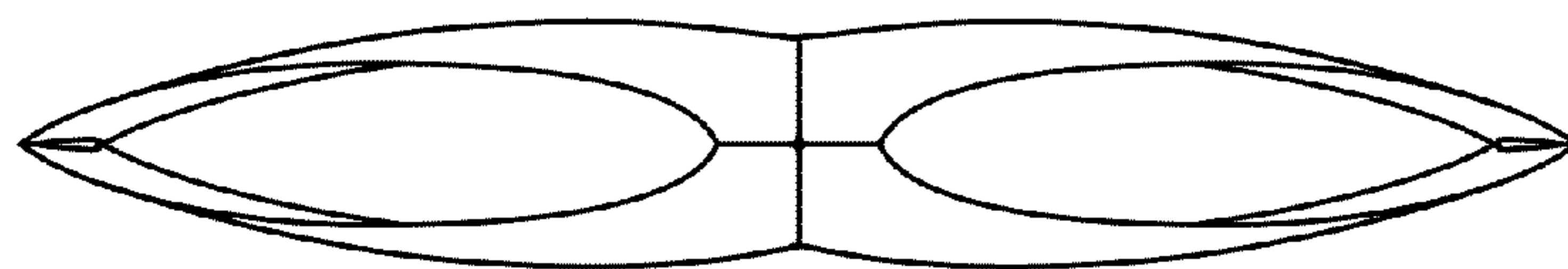

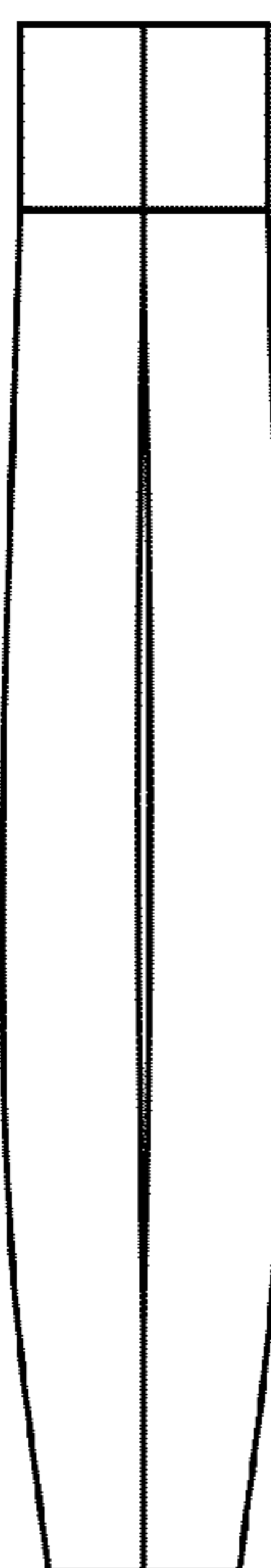

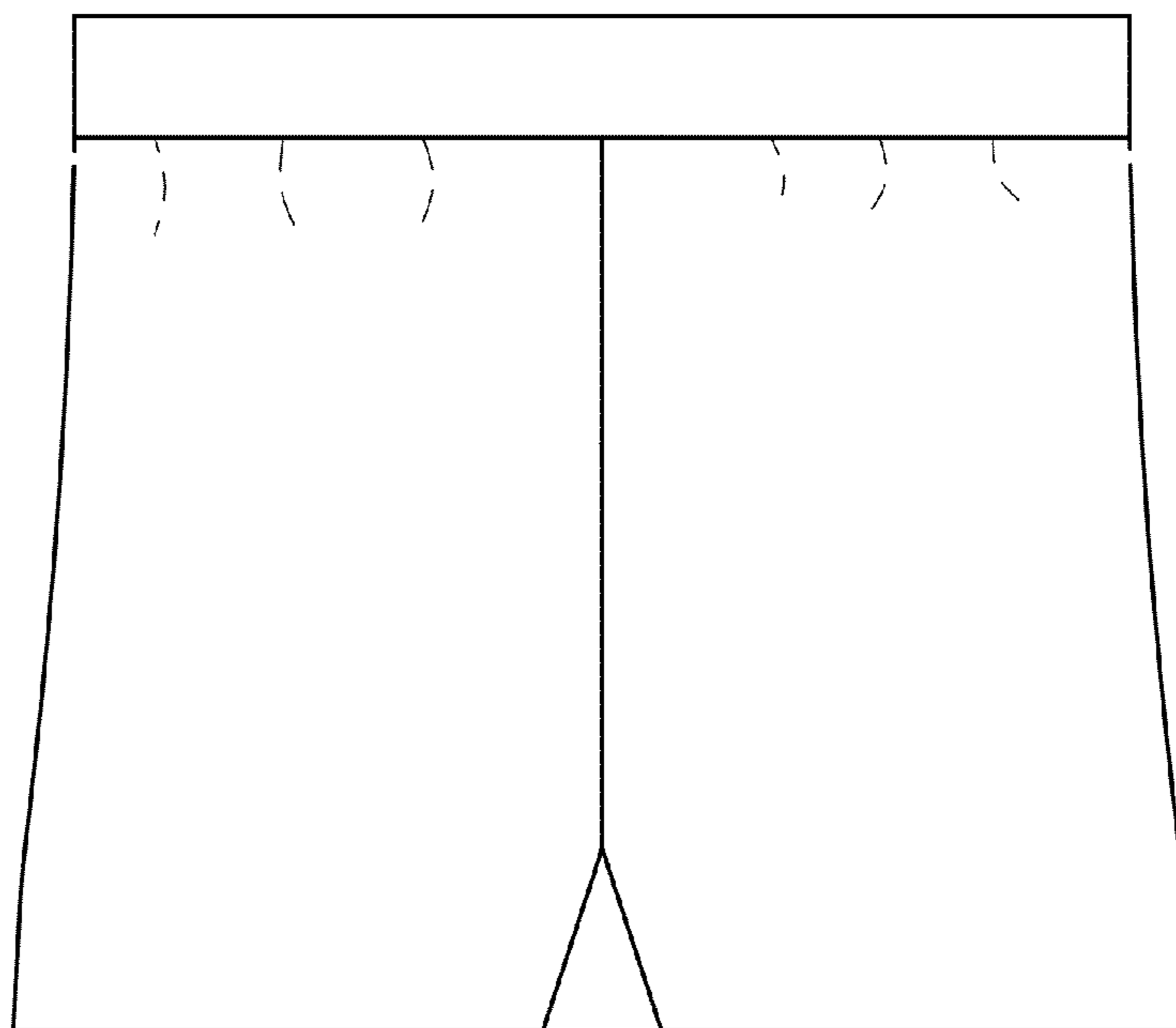

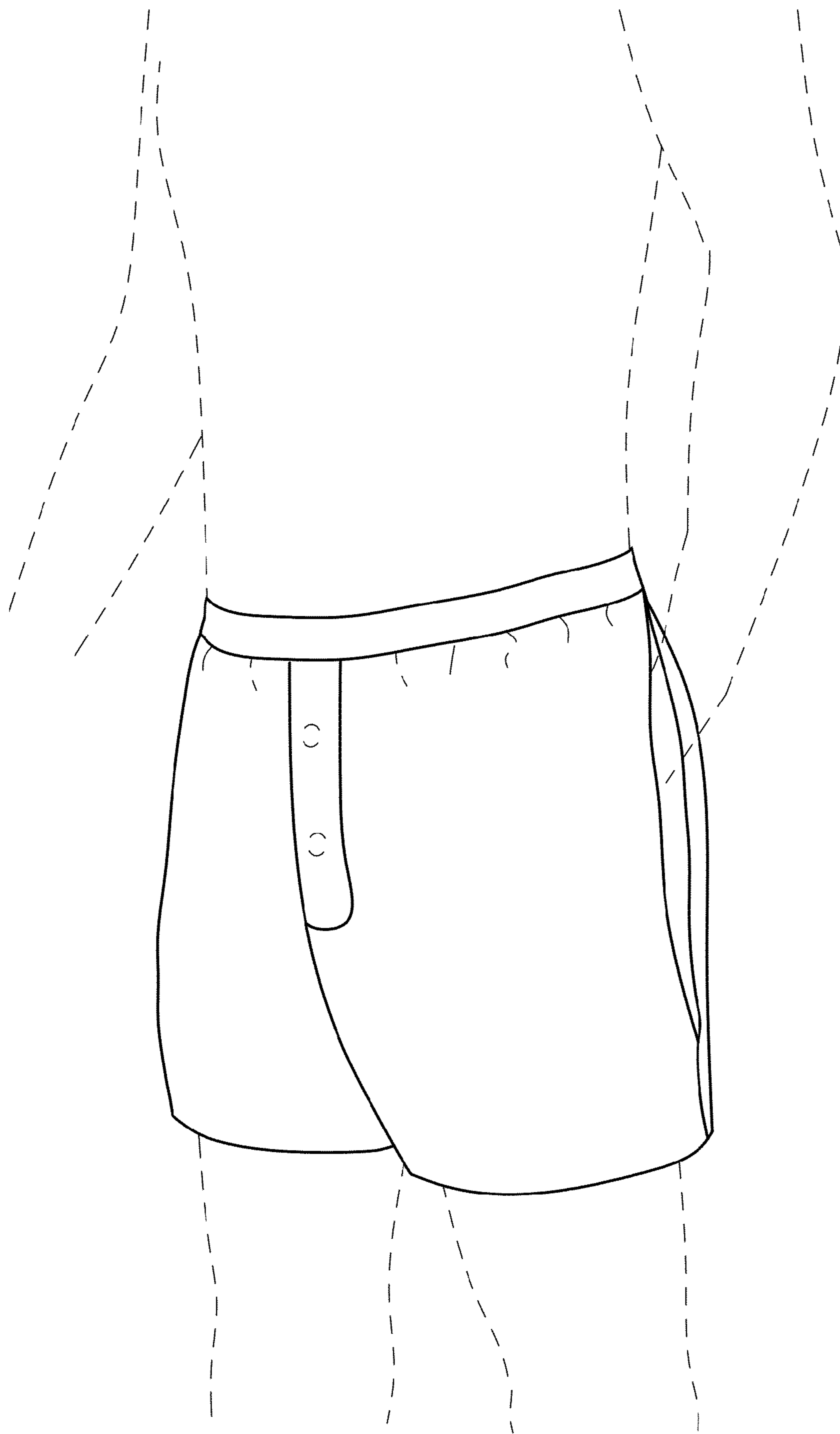
