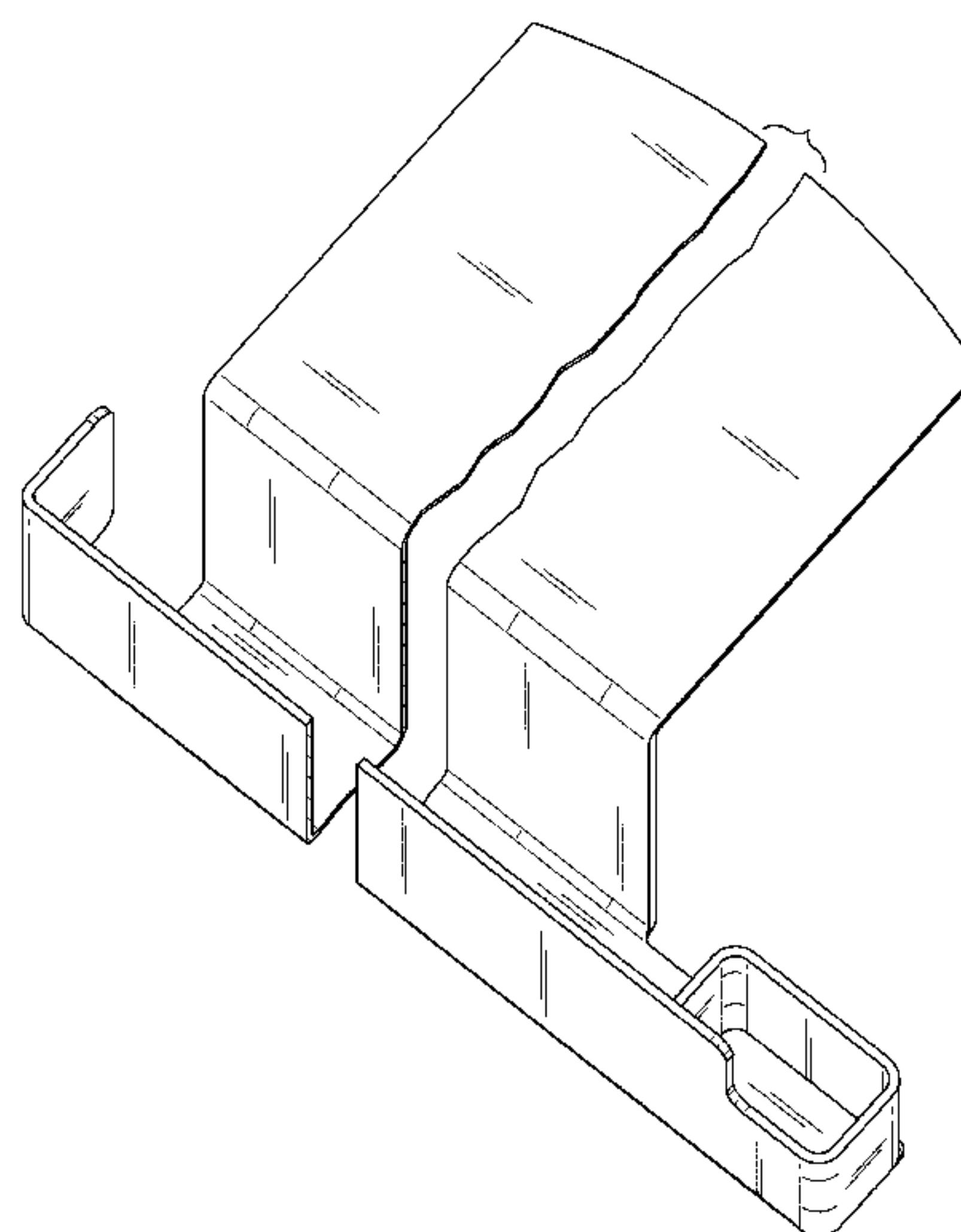
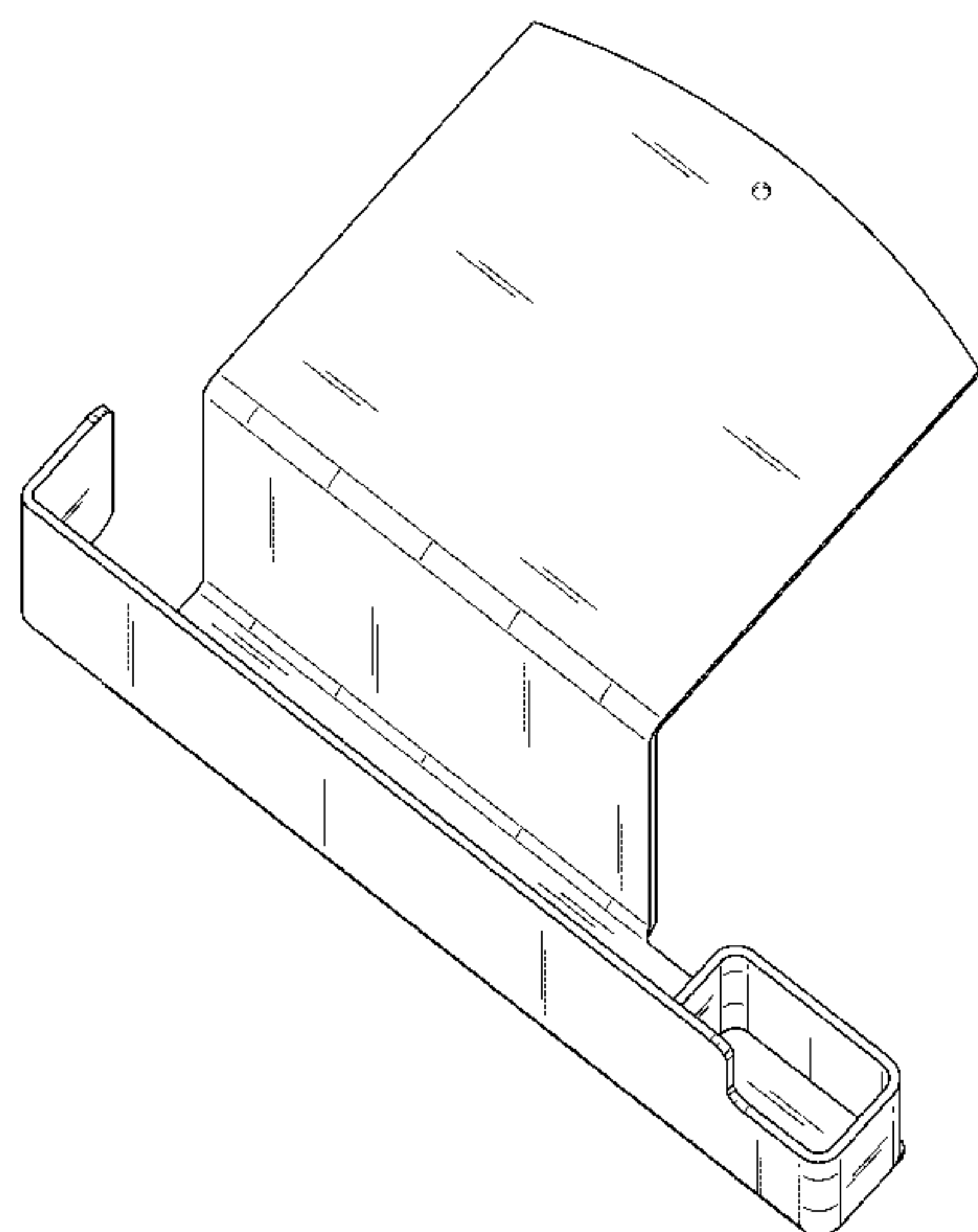
The ornamental design for a storage caddy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a storage caddy showing a first embodiment of my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, and left side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 9 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a second embodiment thereof, with the article shown broken away in the horizontal dimension to indicate an unclaimed width; and, FIG. 10 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a third embodiment thereof.

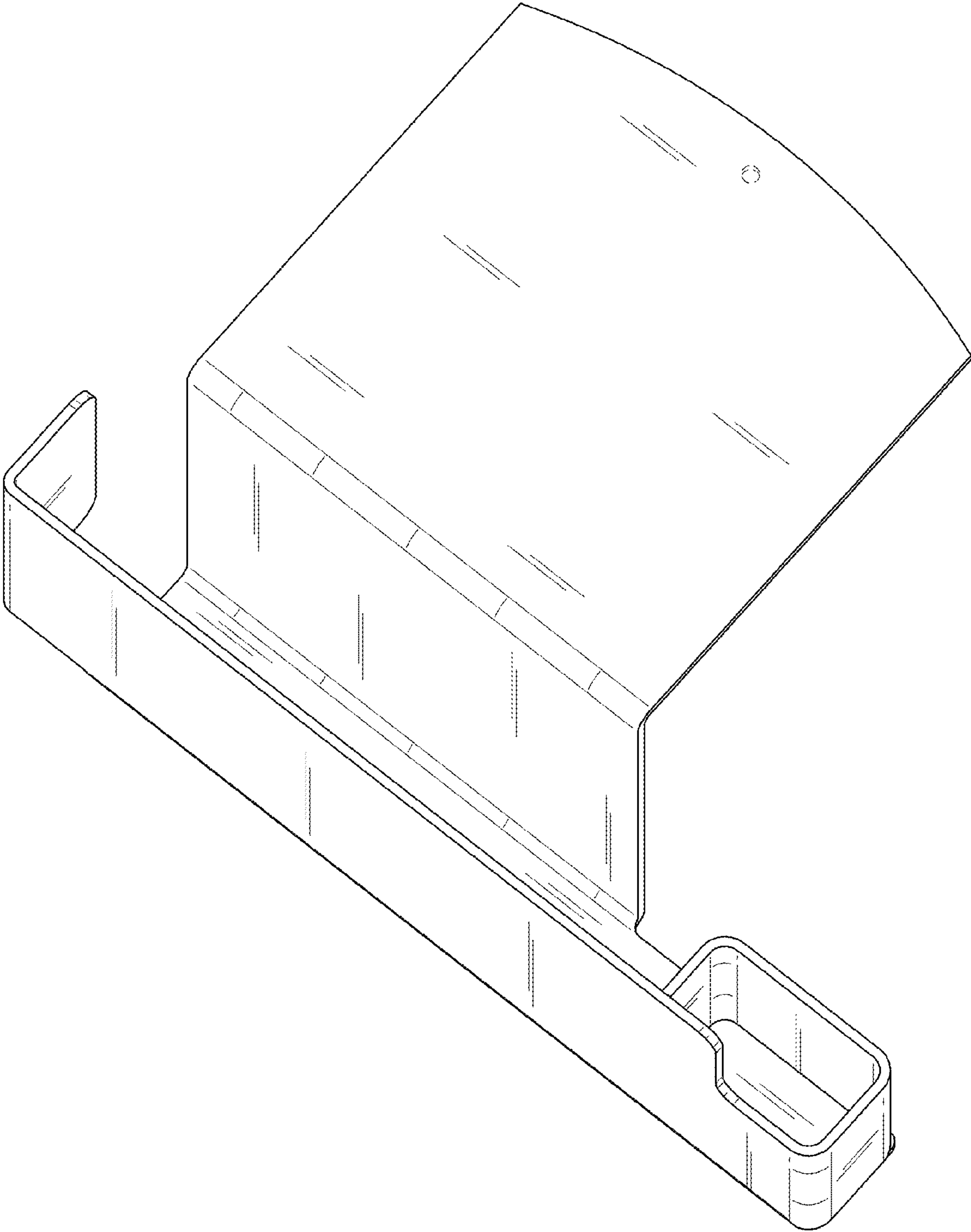

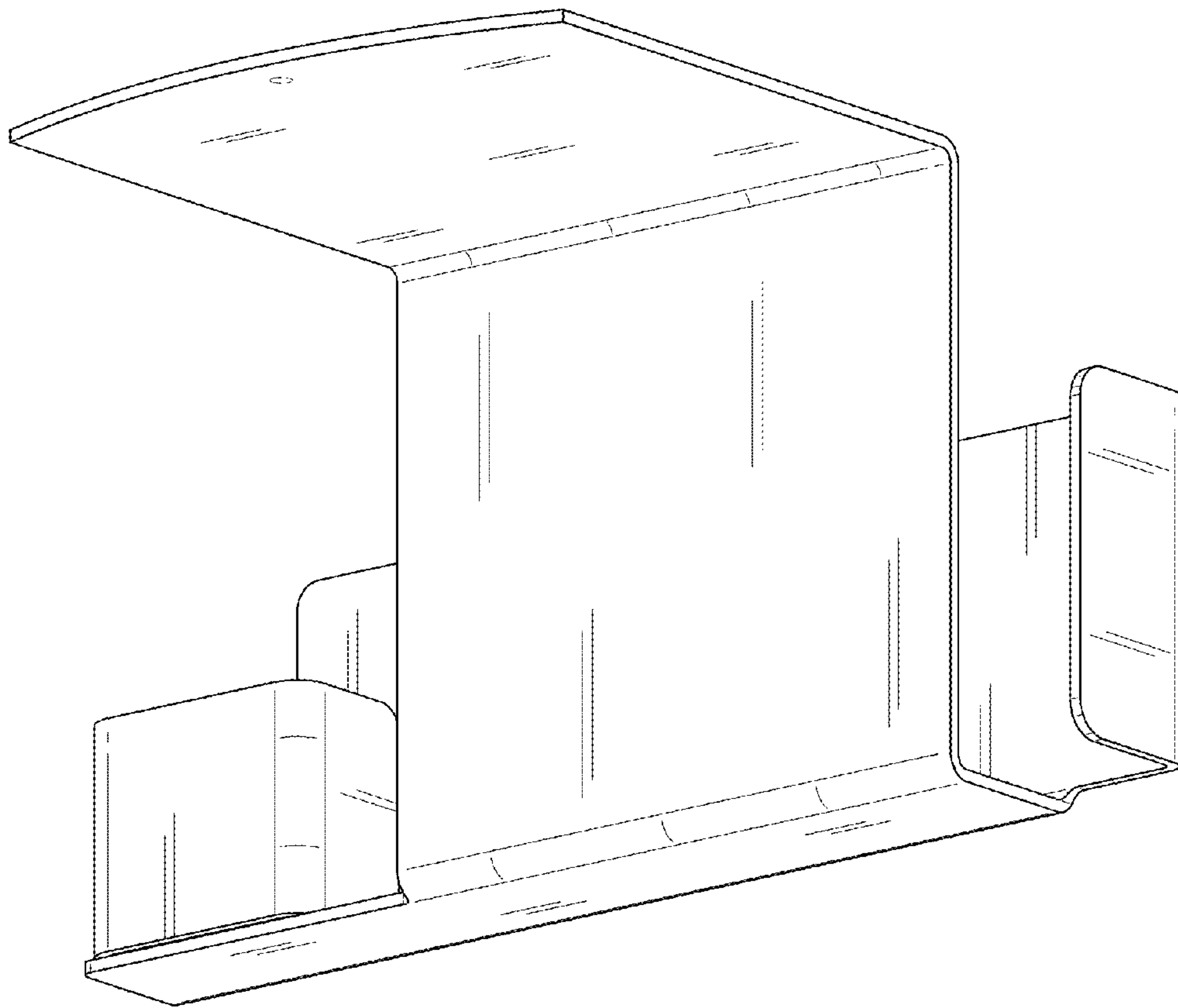

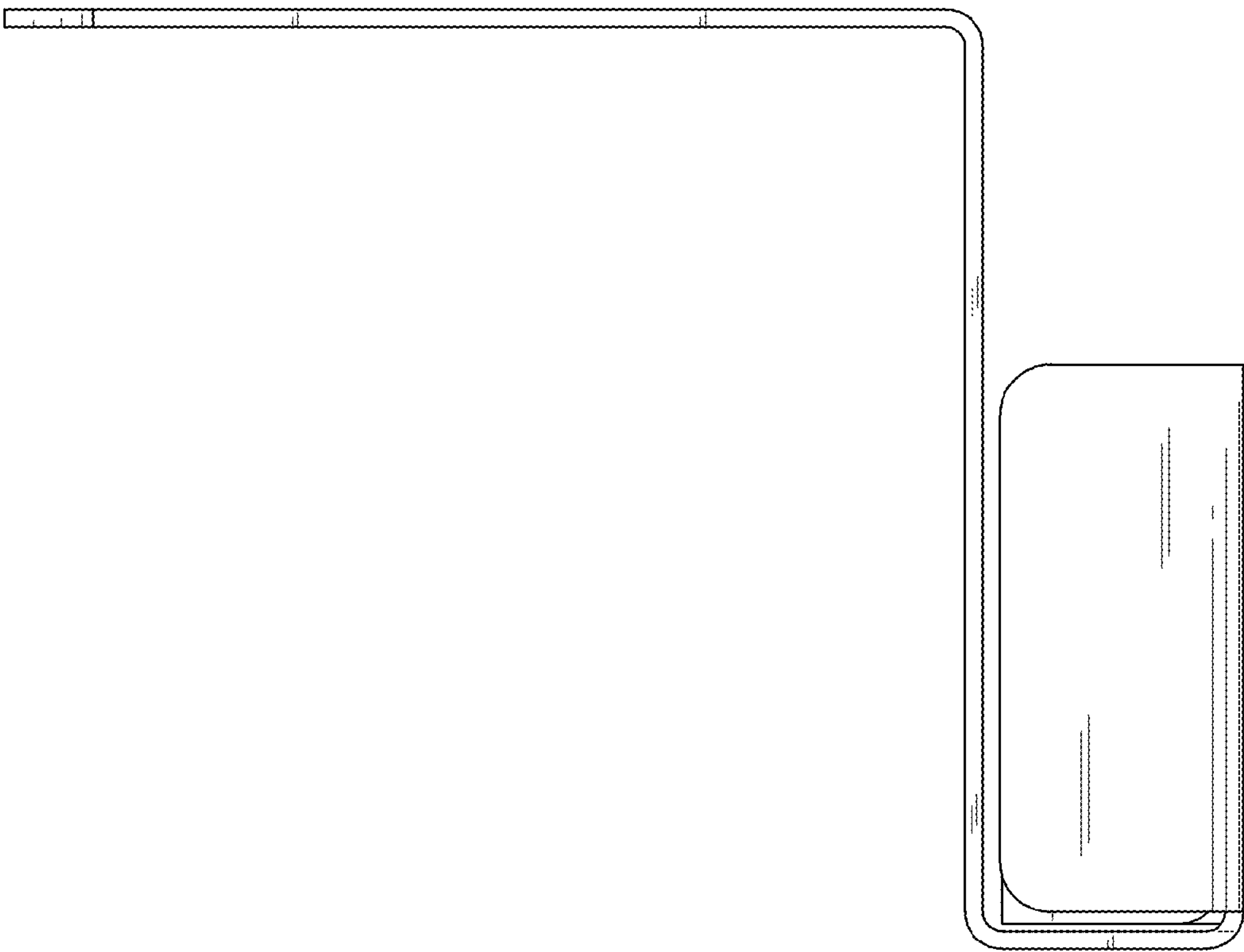

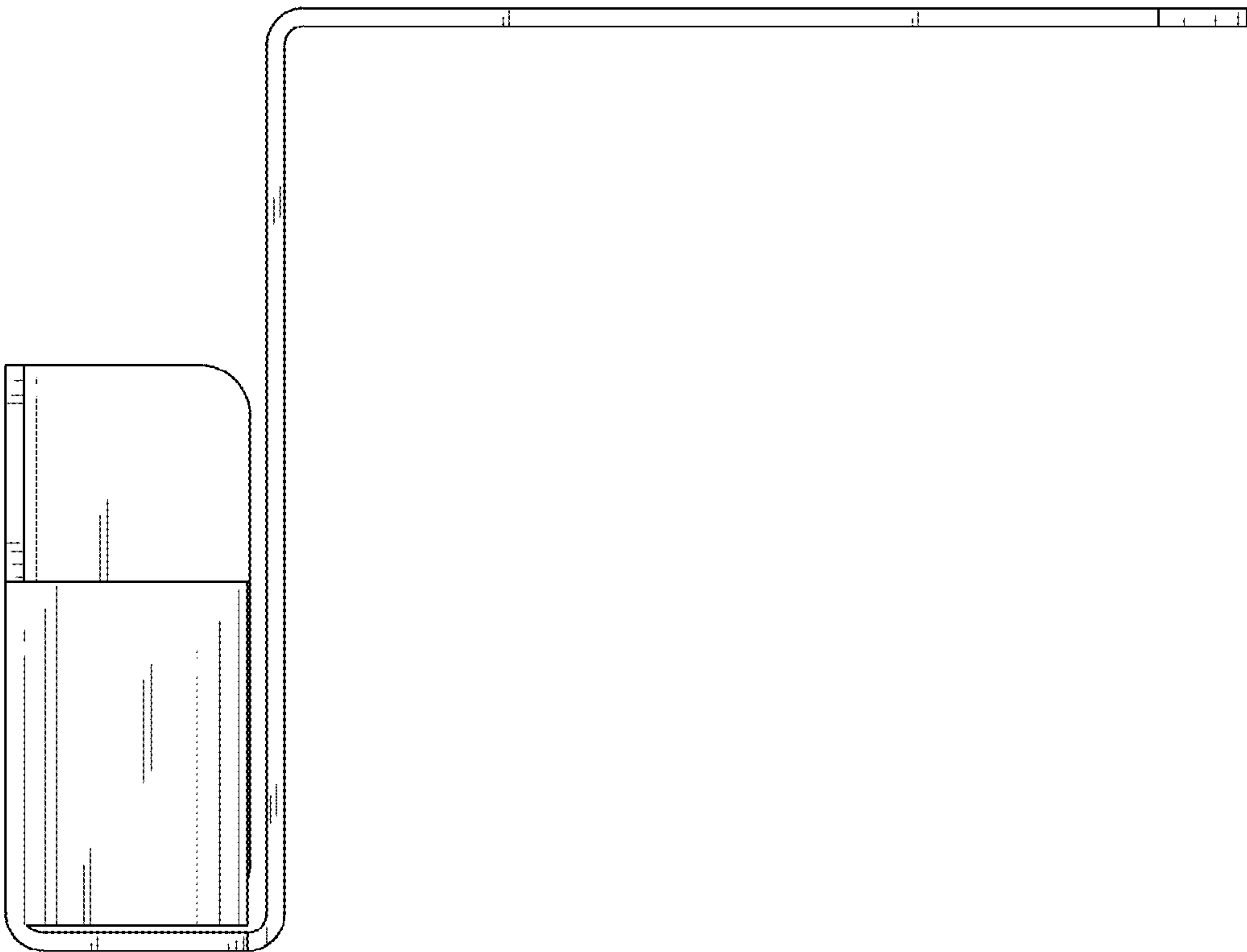

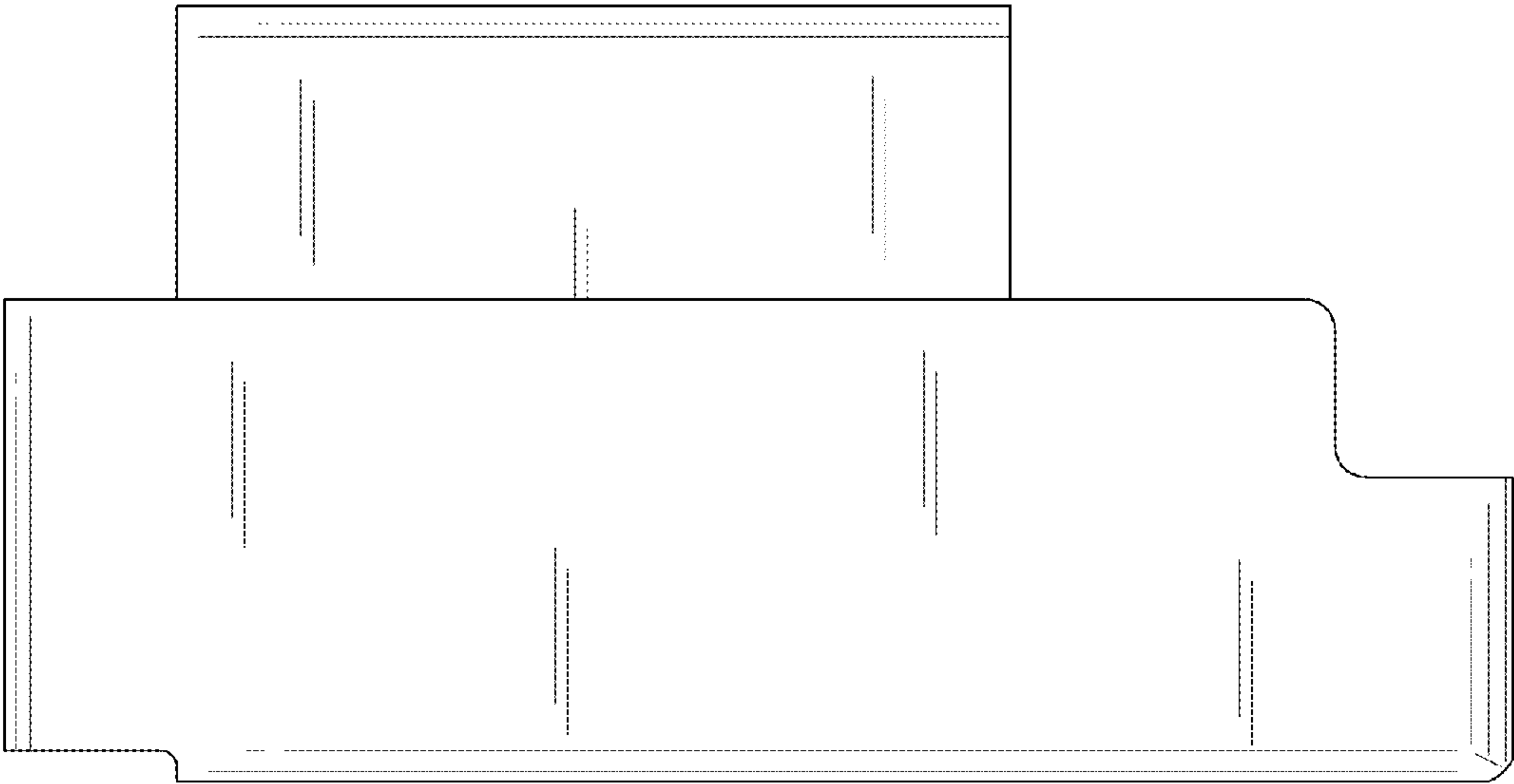

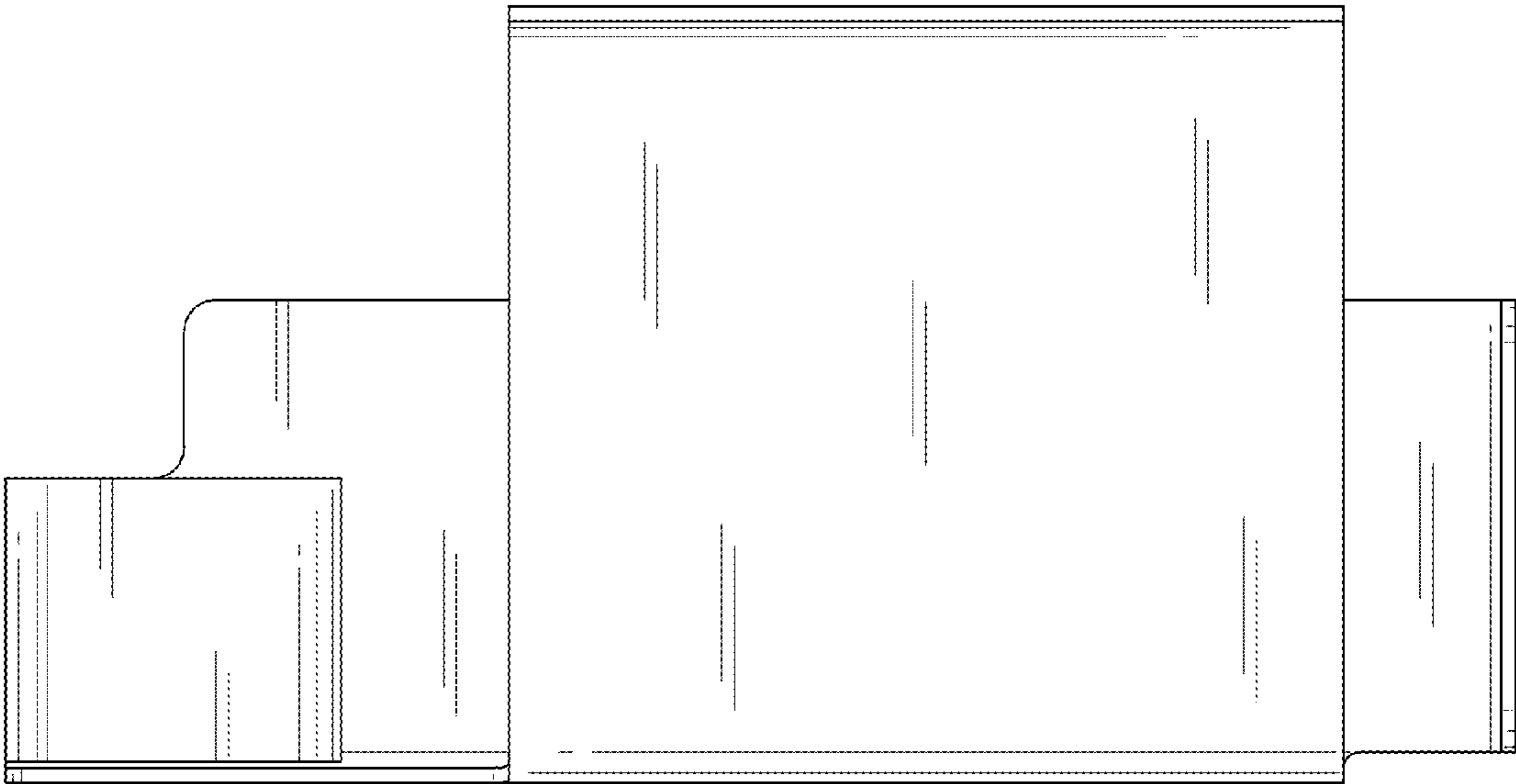

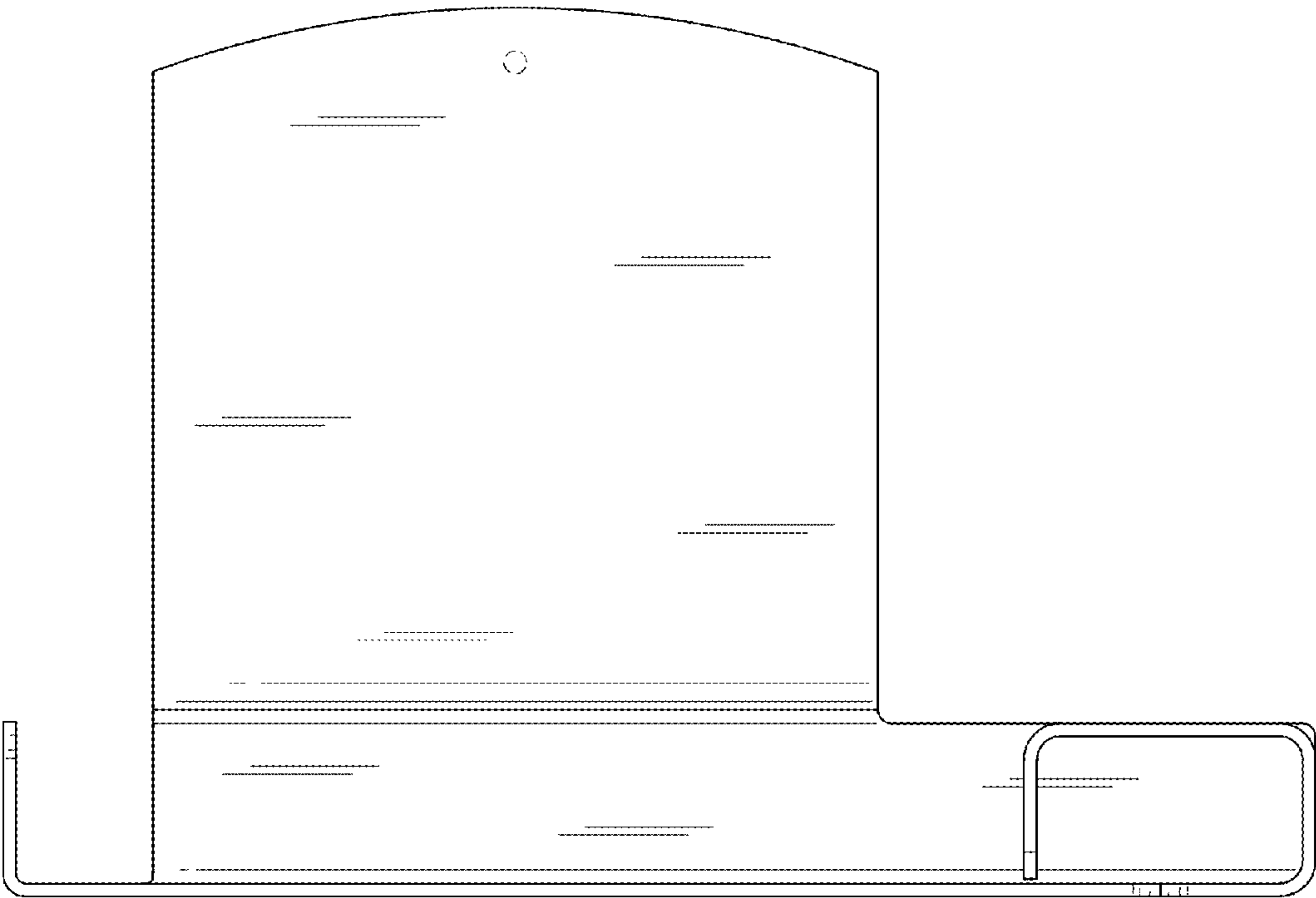

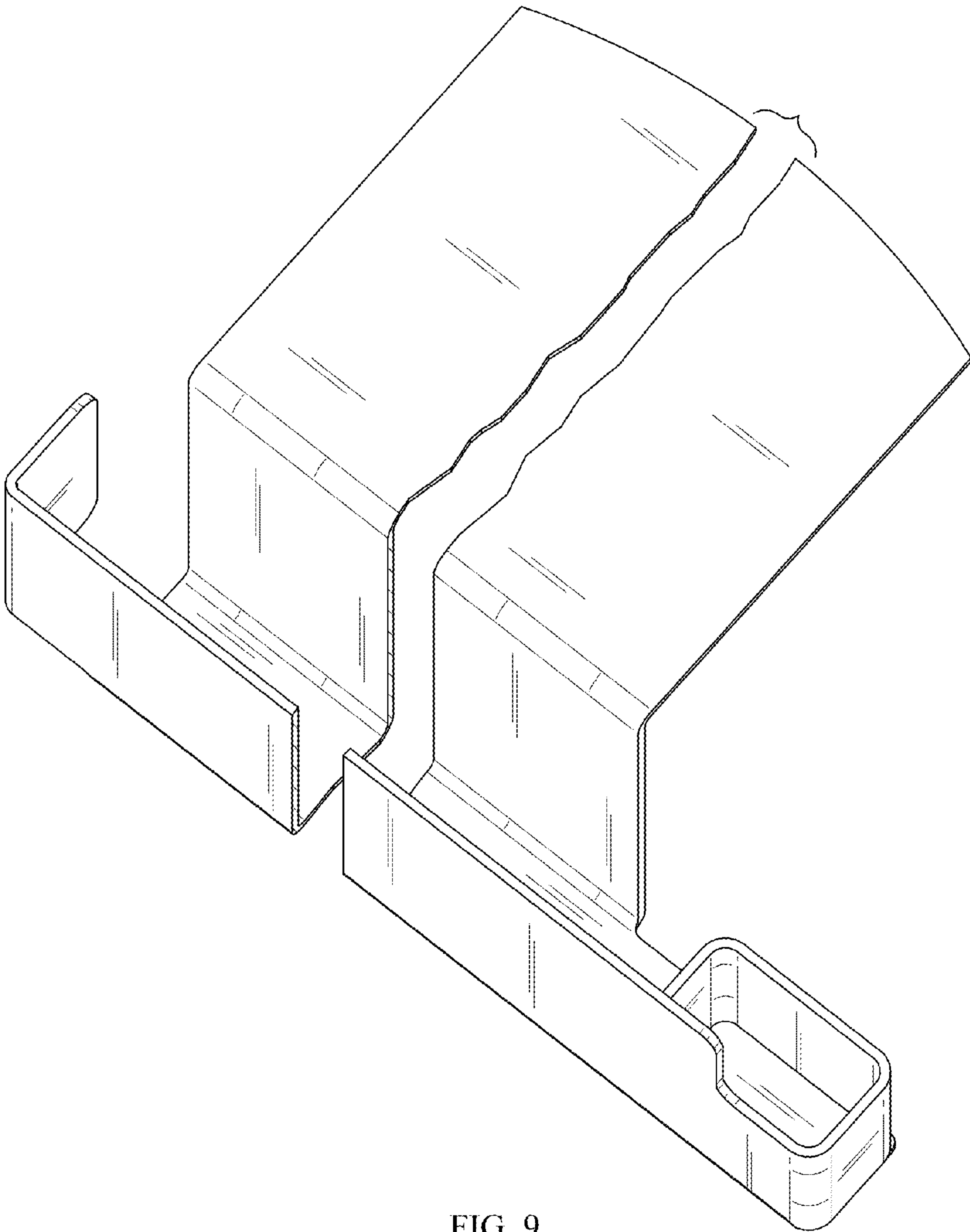

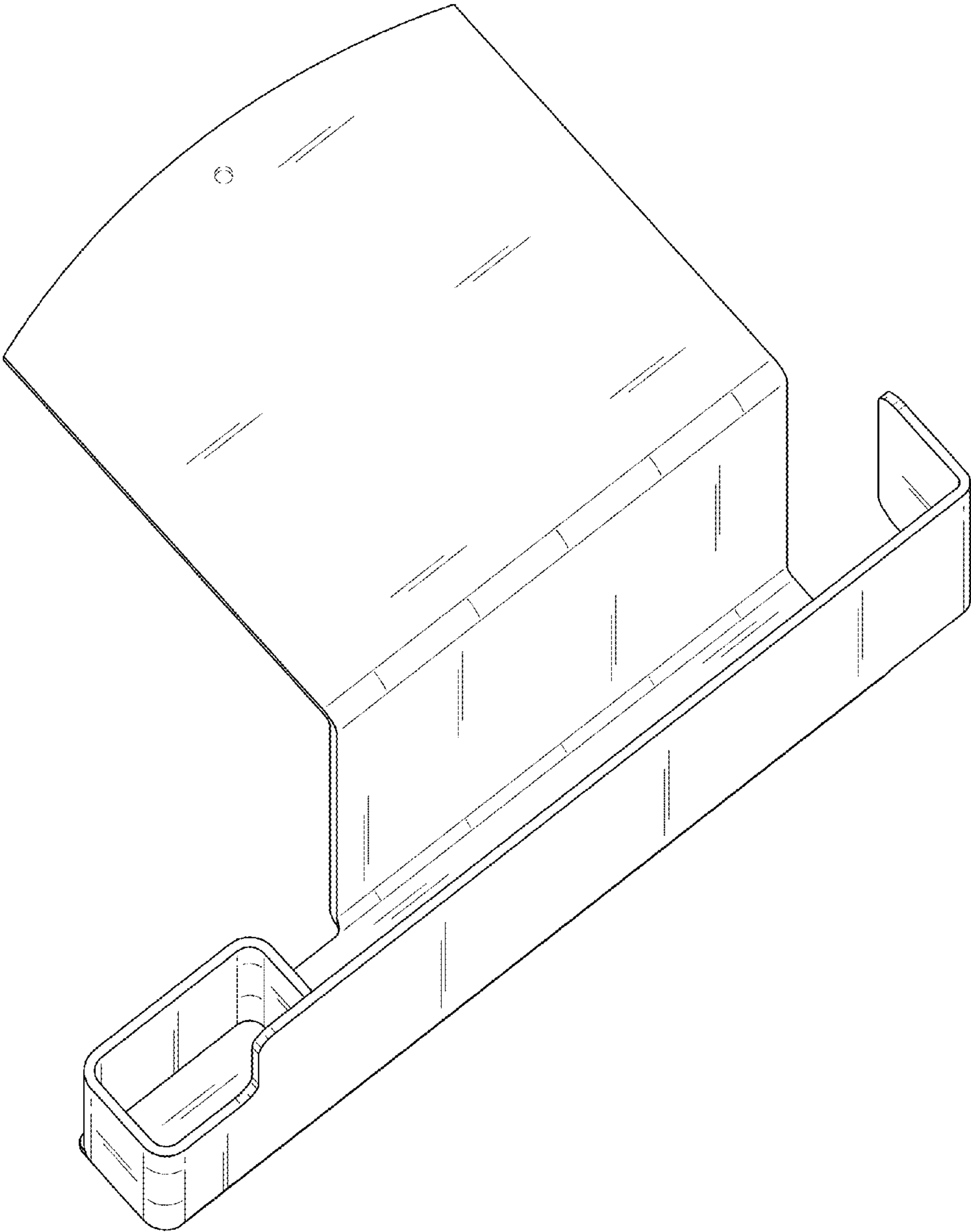
