DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a first embodiment of the surgical safety marker of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

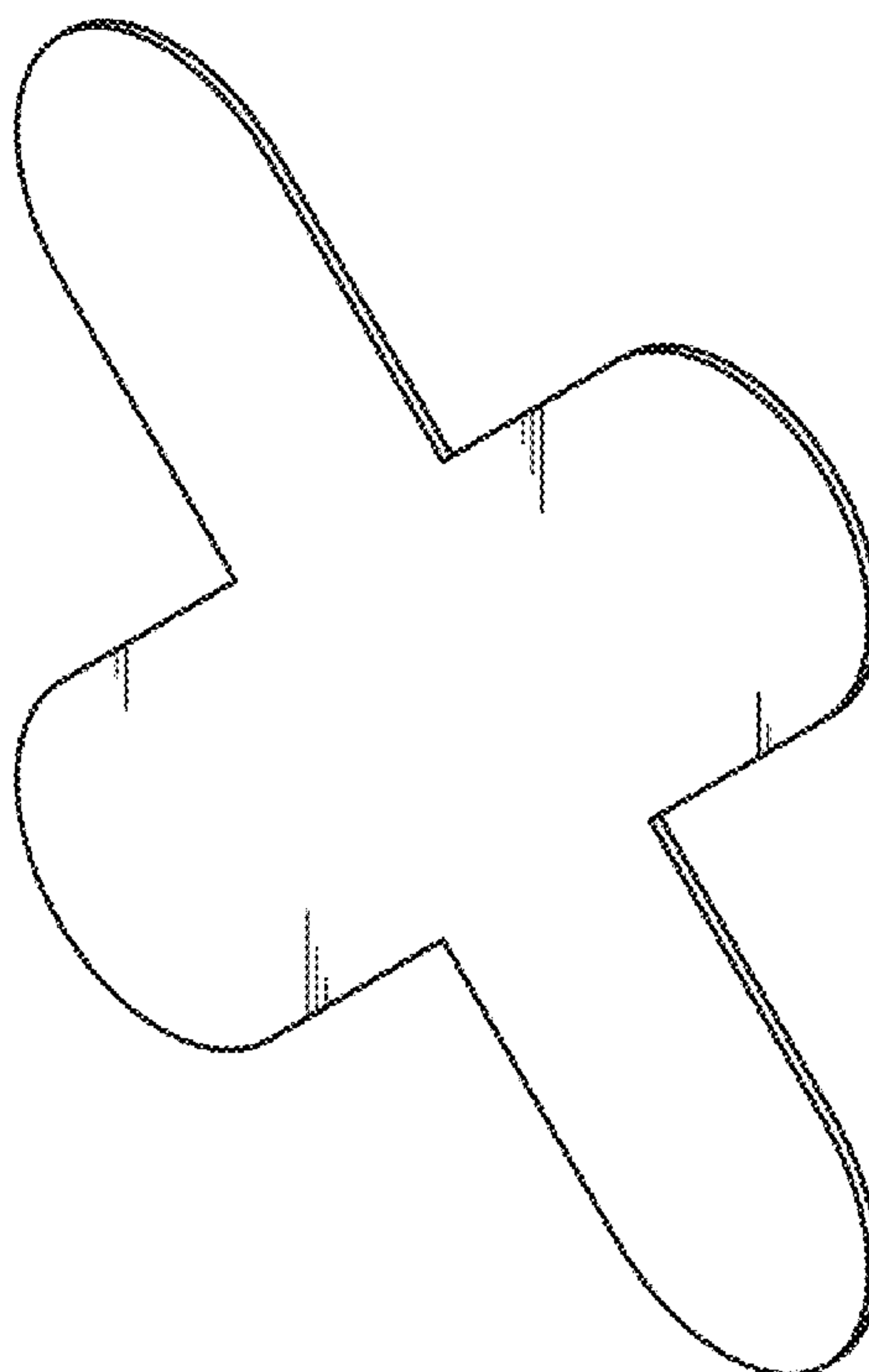
FIG. 3 is a rear side elevation view thereof, the front side being a mirror image;

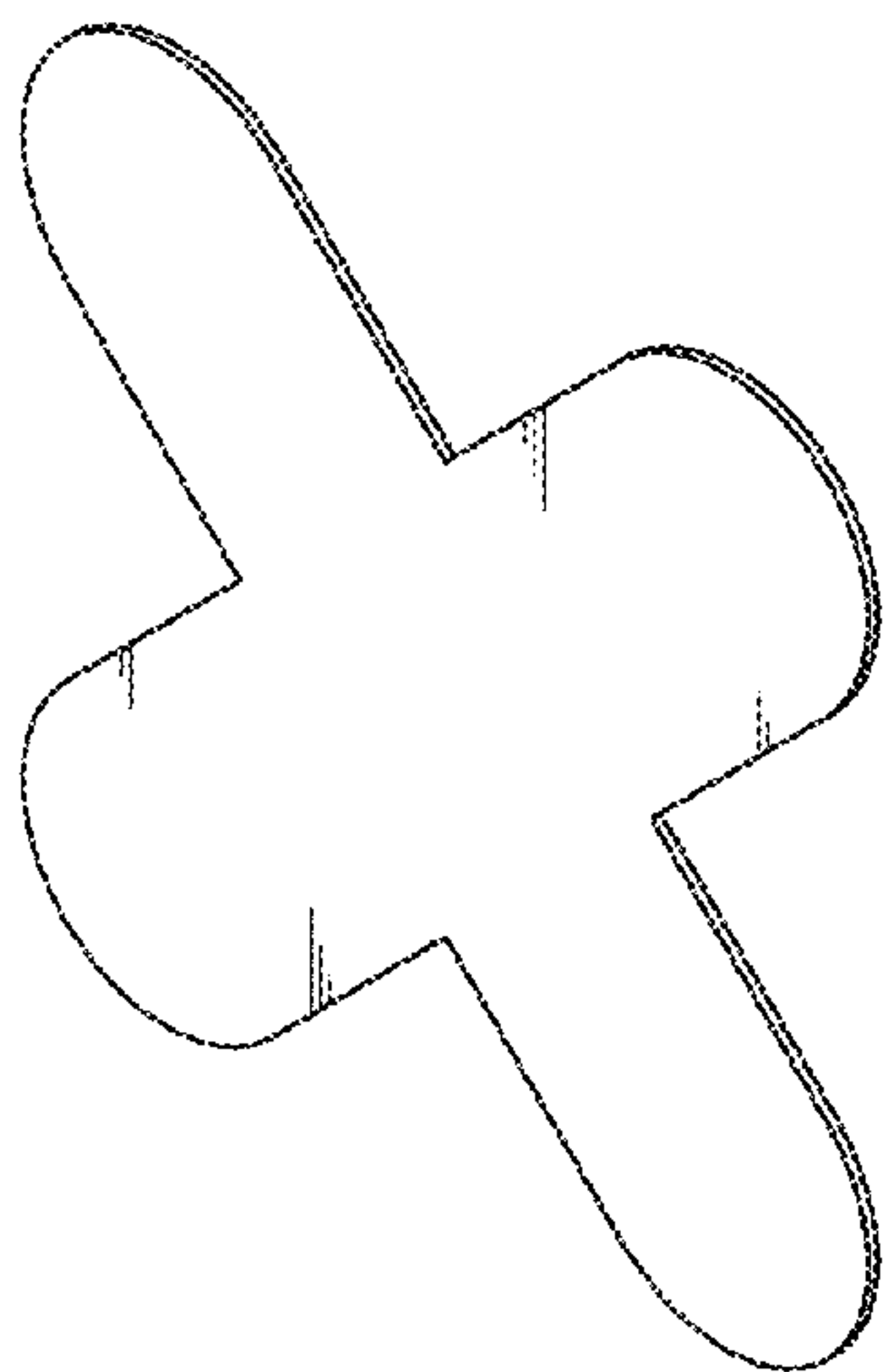

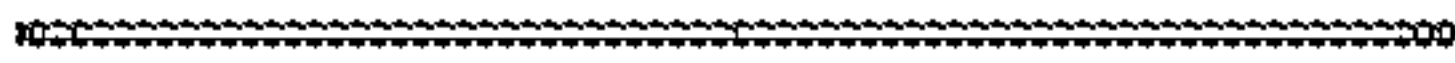

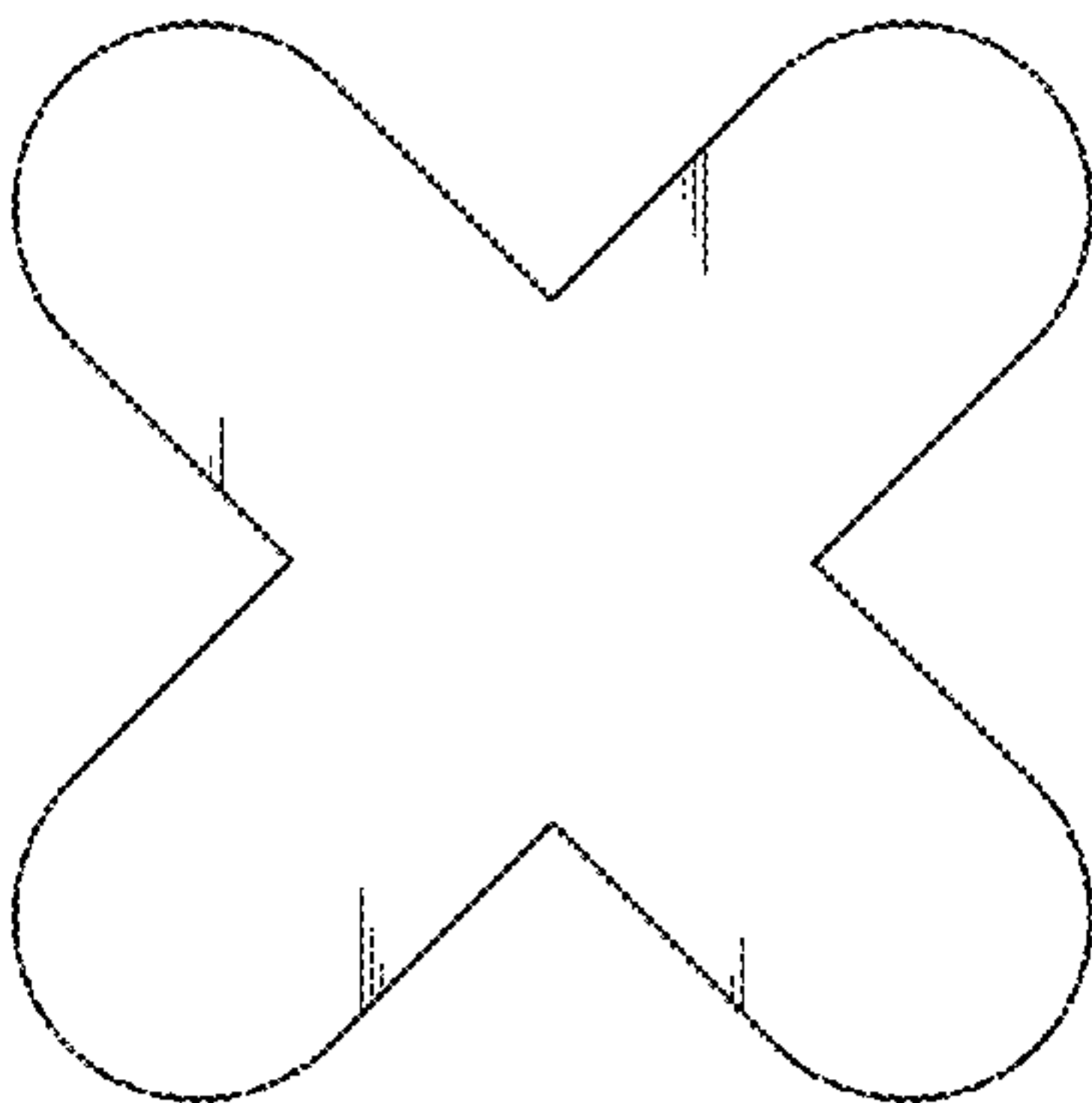

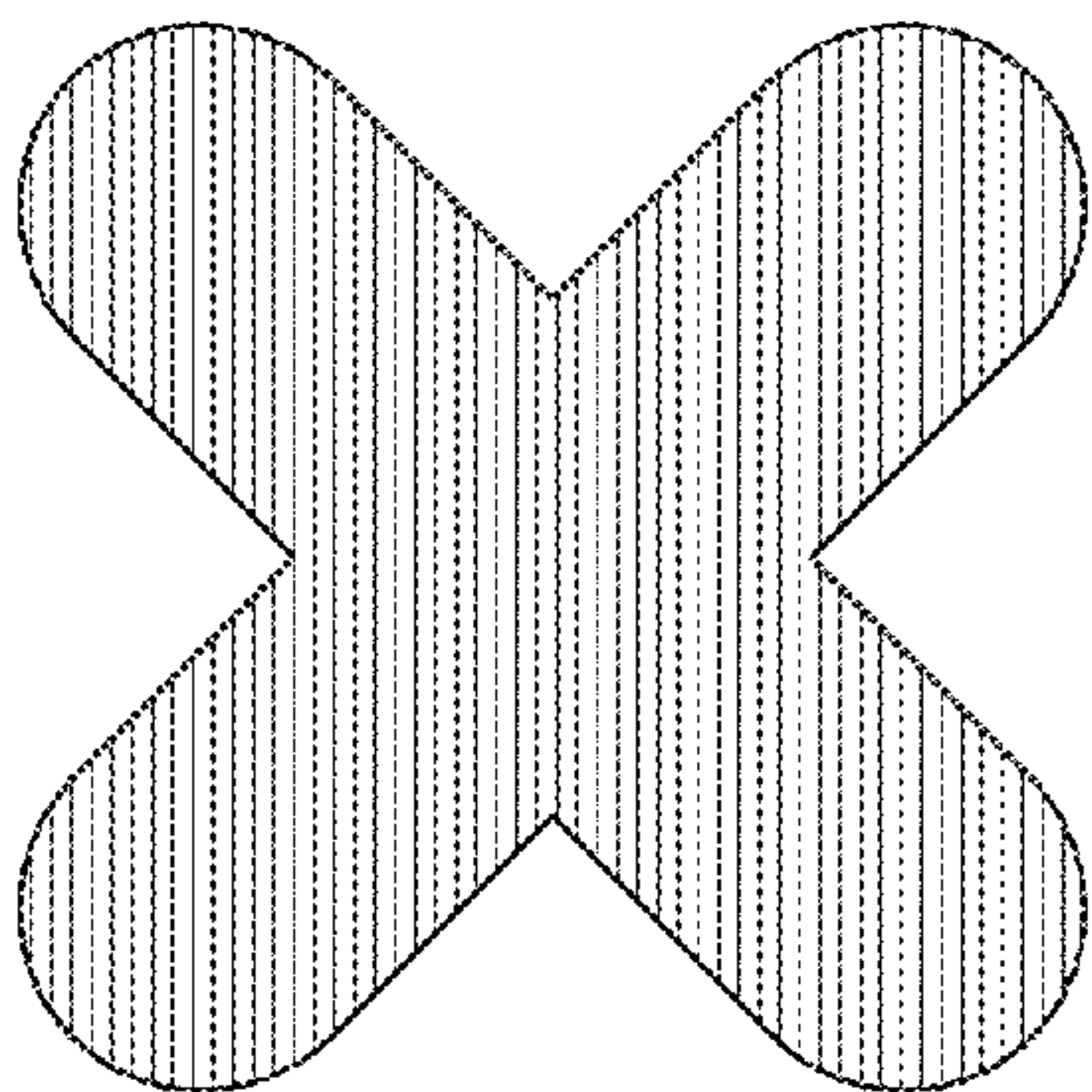
