DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of the frame and curb box of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a bottom, front and right side perspective view of the frame and curb box of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top view of the frame and curb box of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the frame and curb box of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the frame and curb box of FIG. 1.

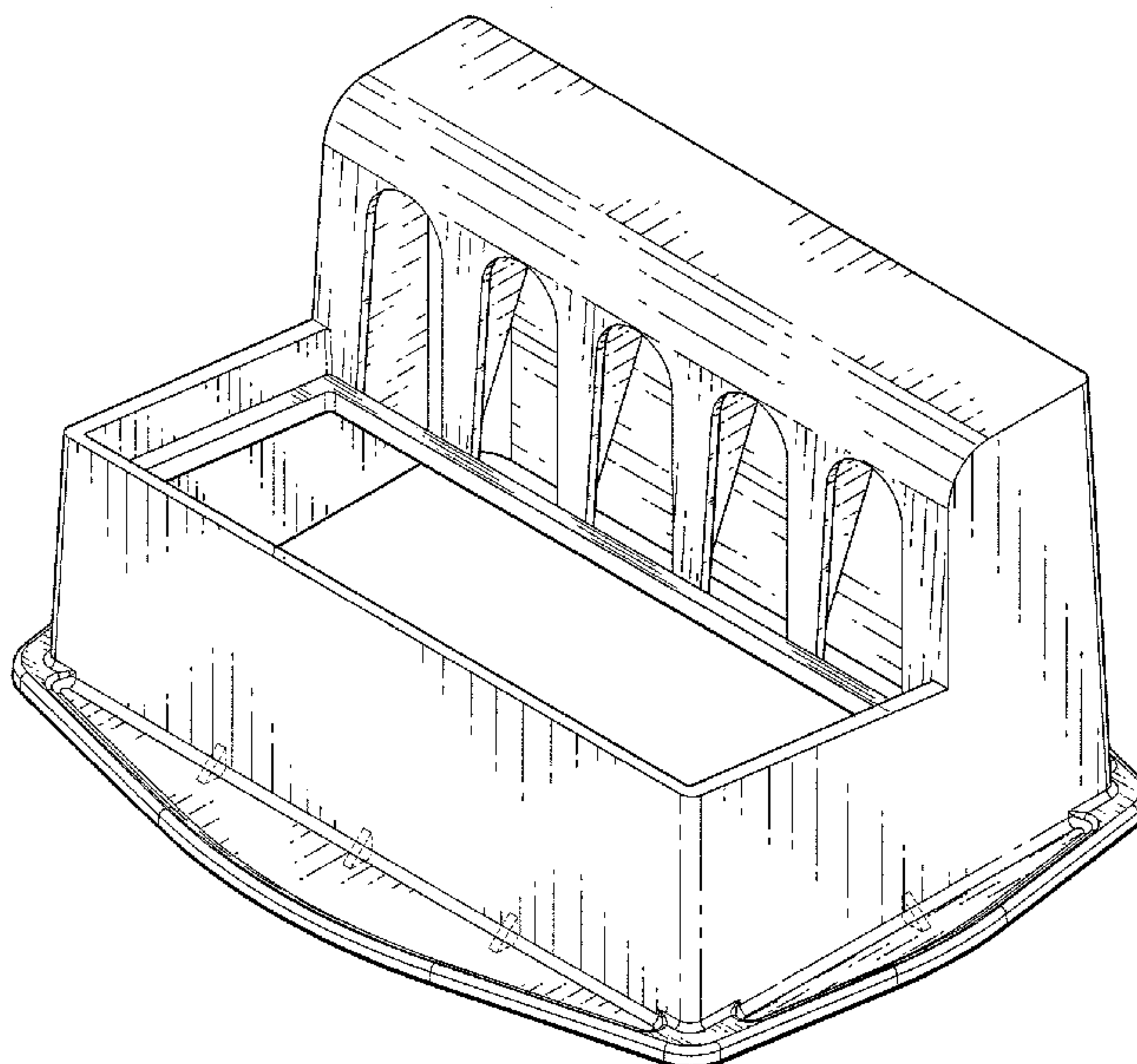
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the frame and curb box of FIG. 1; and,

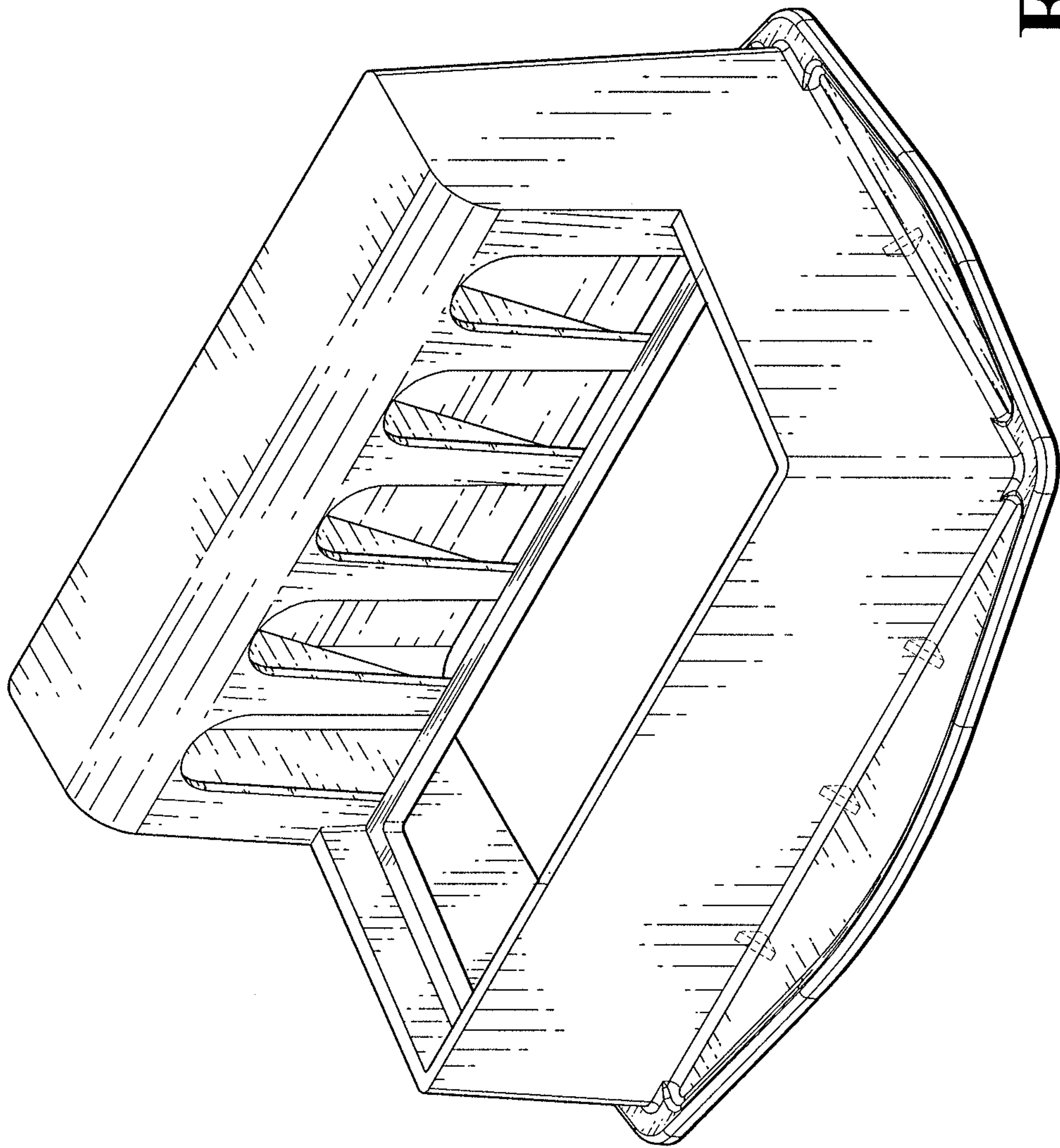

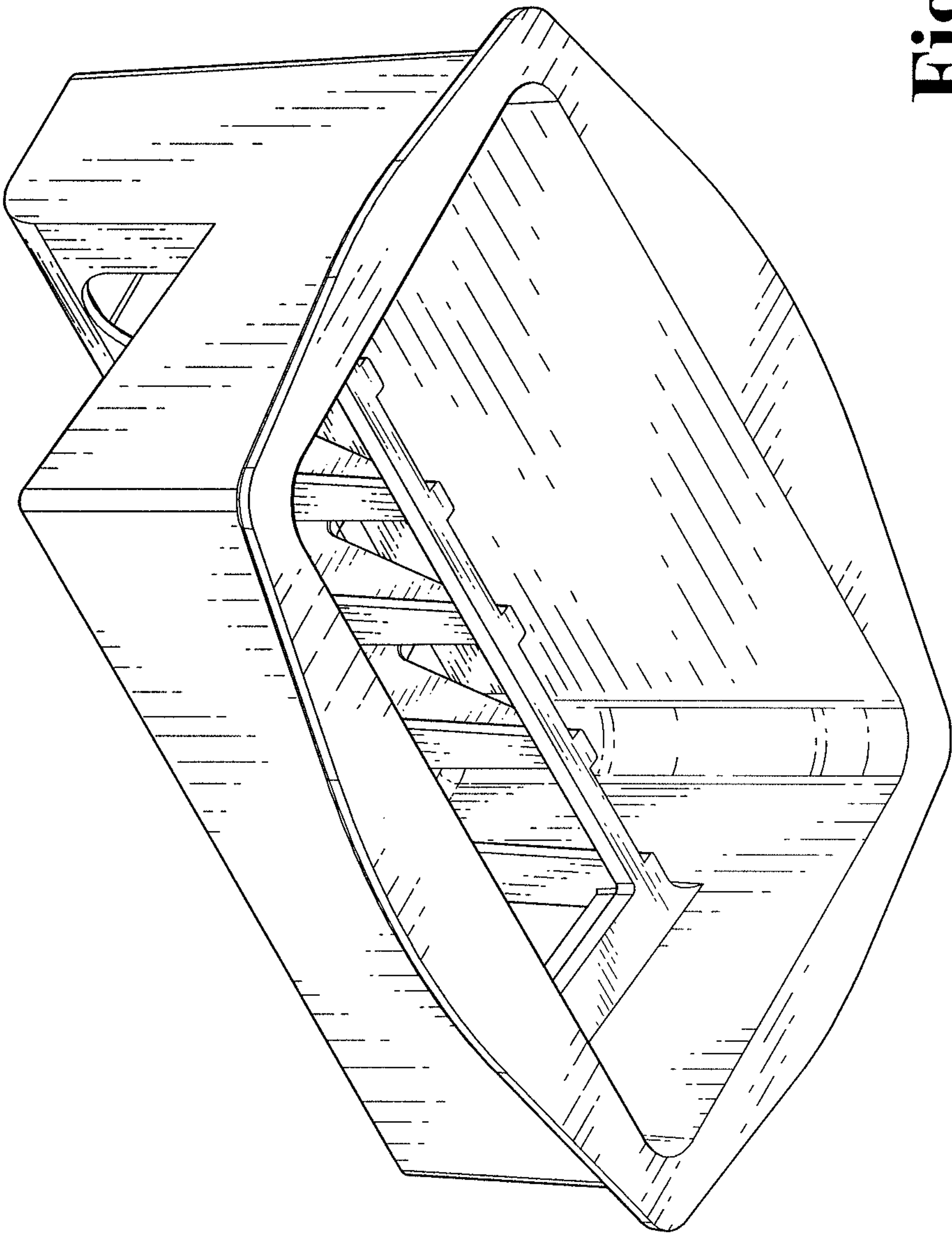

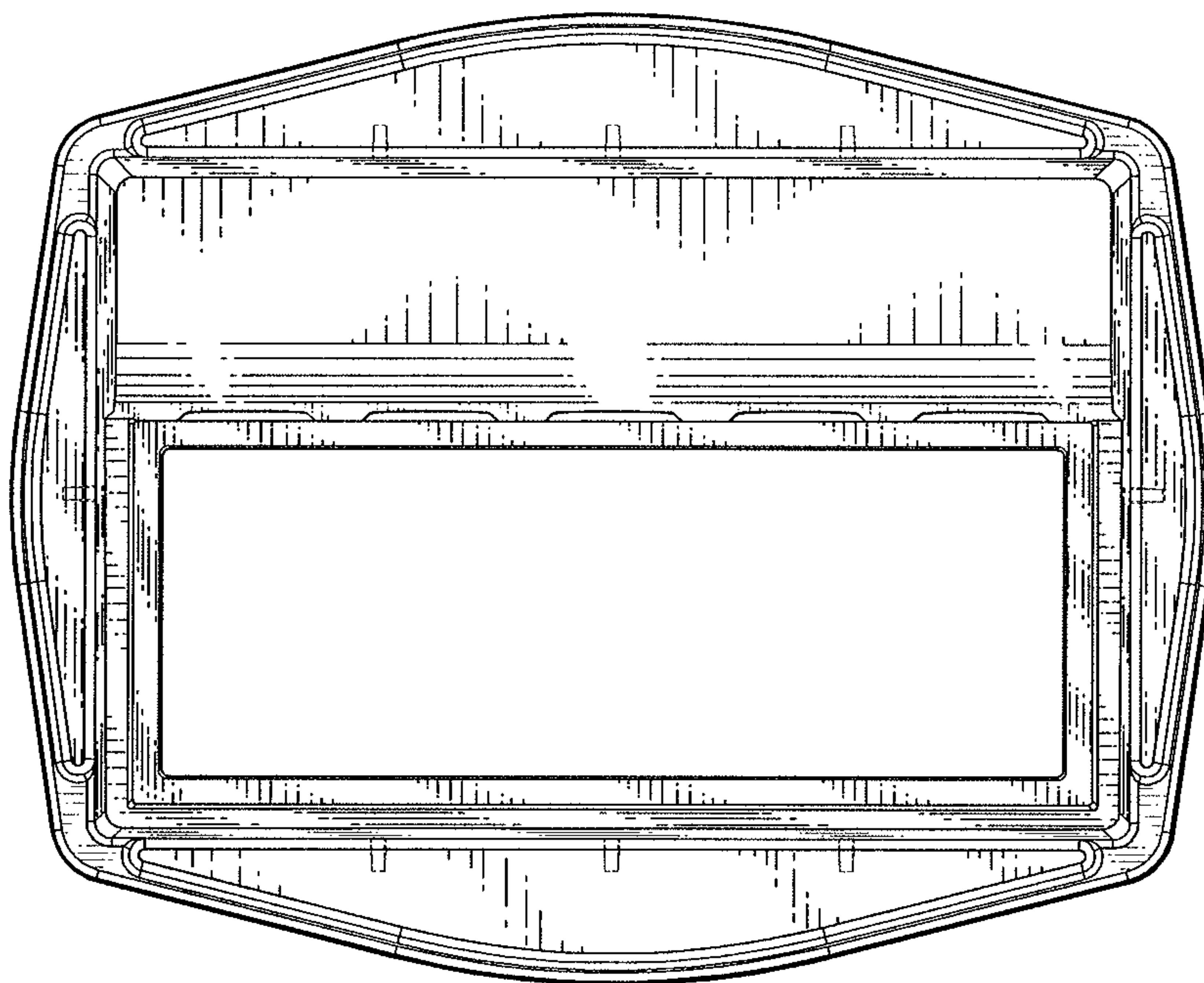

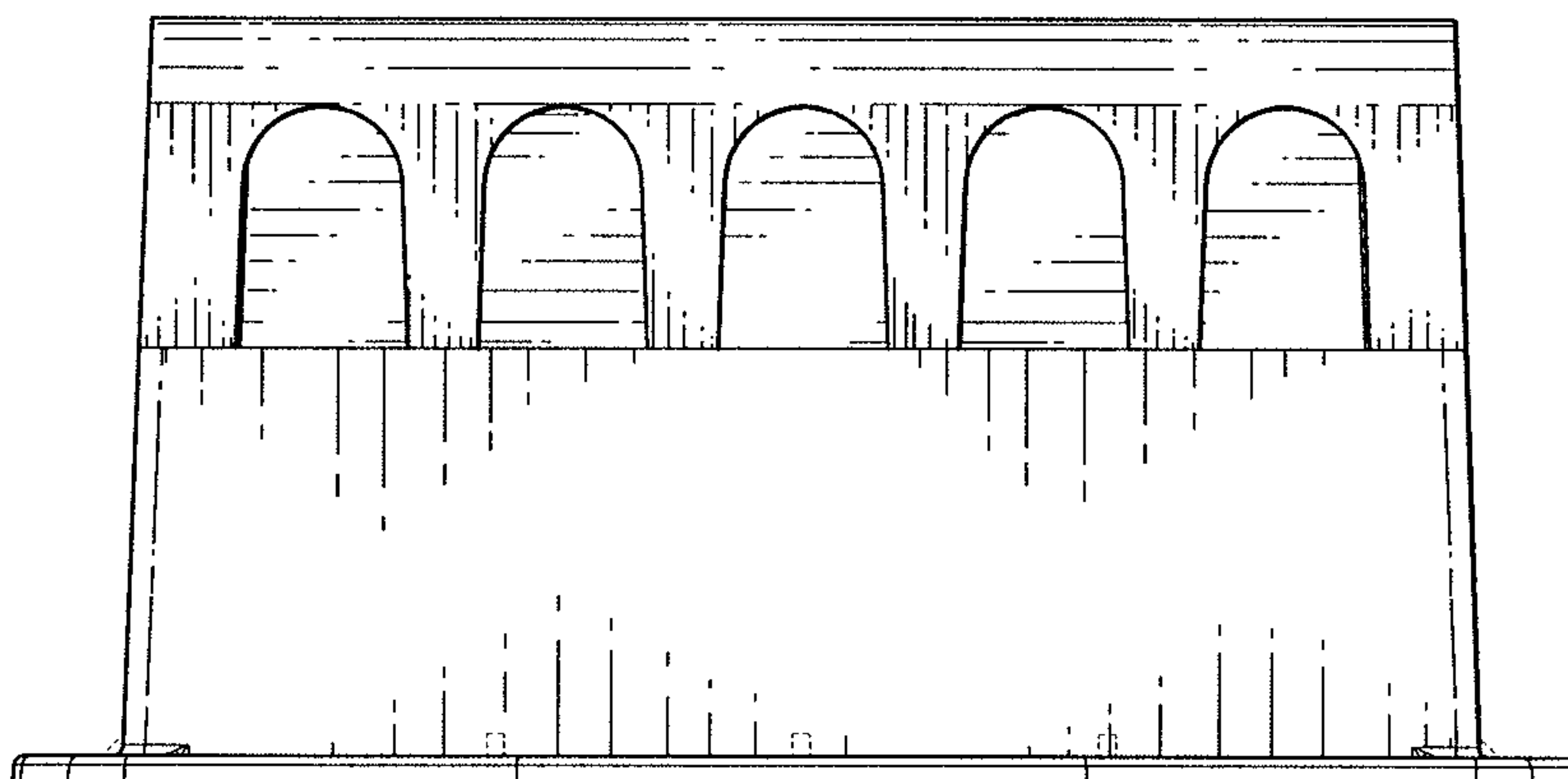

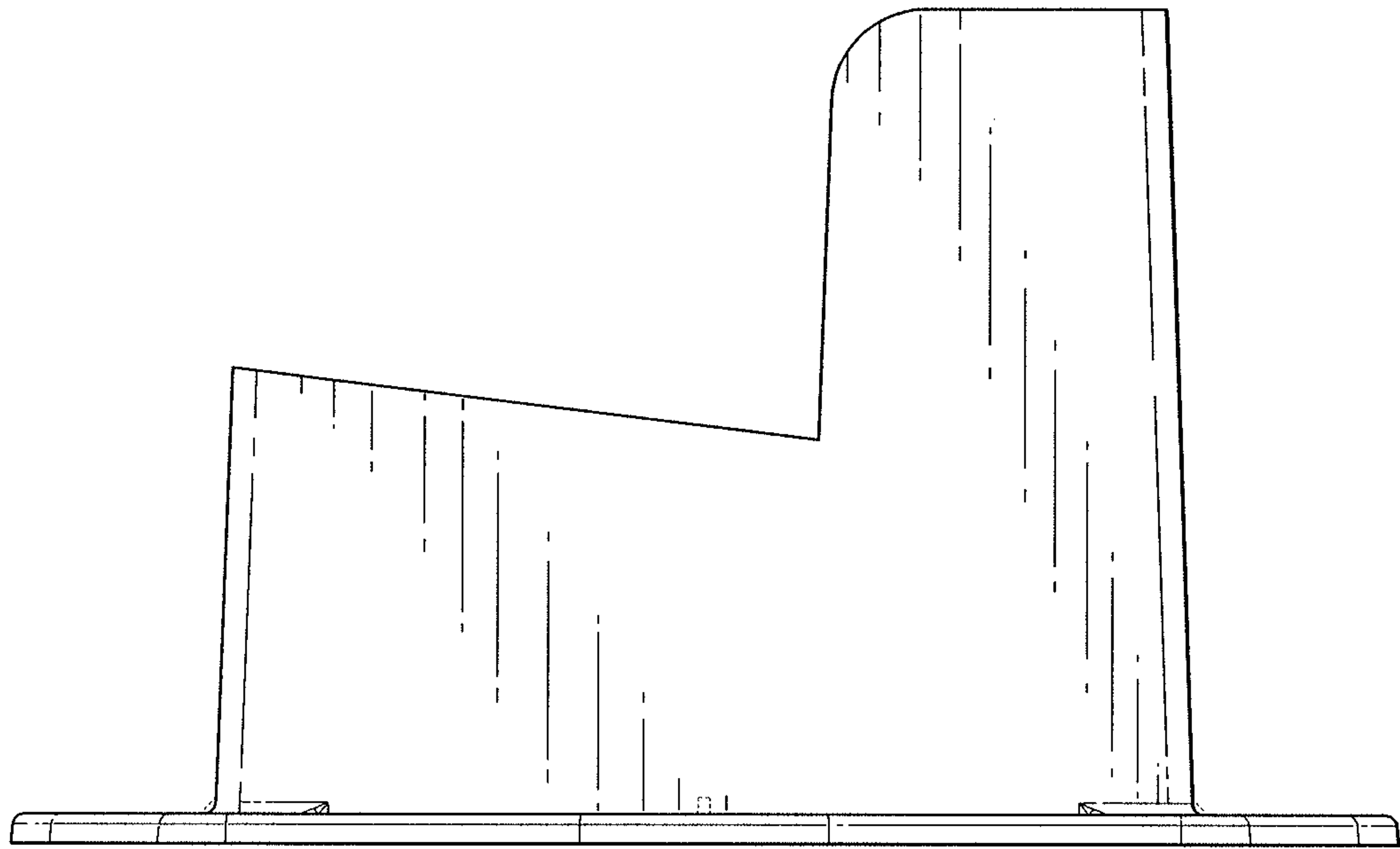

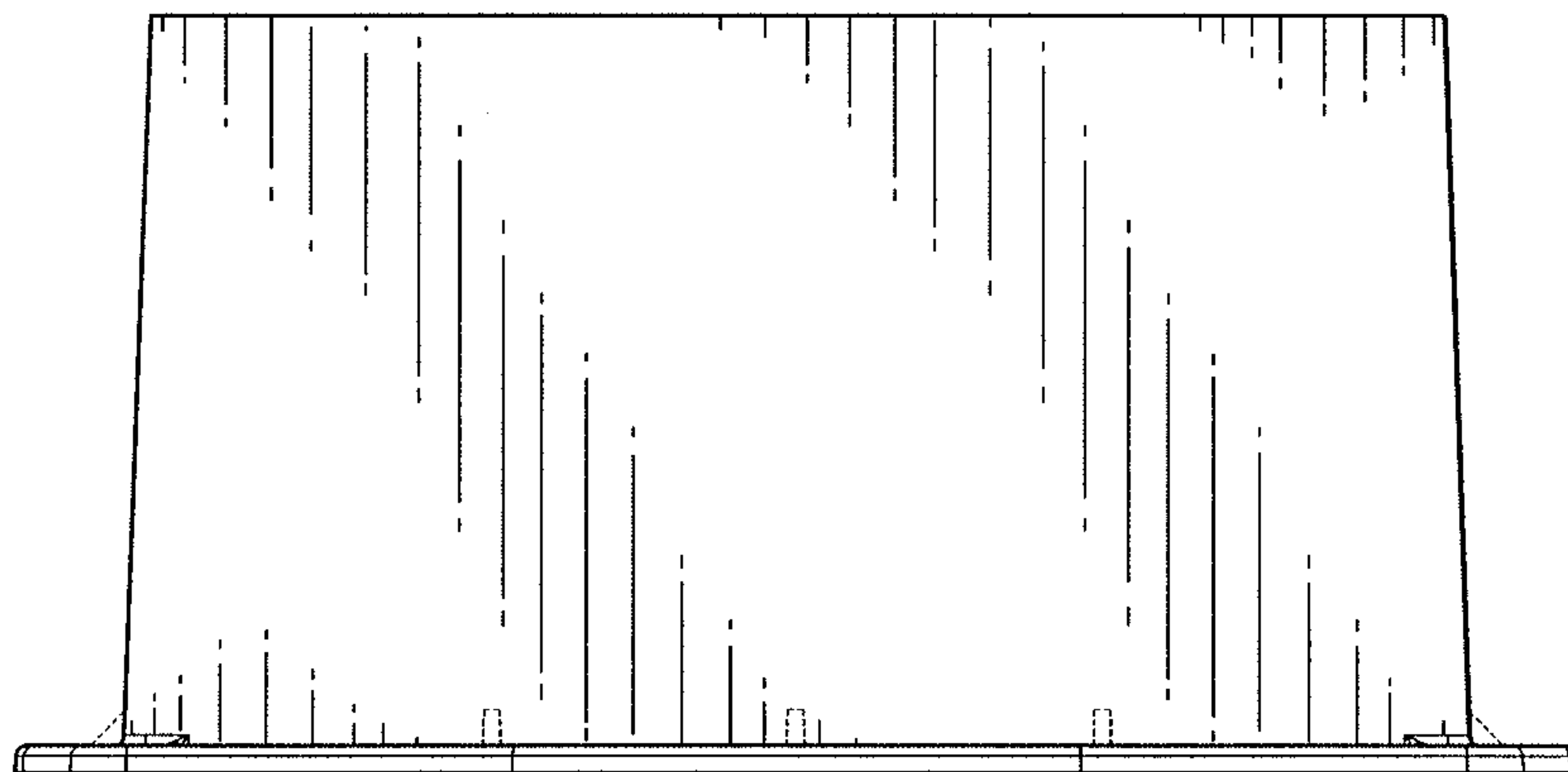

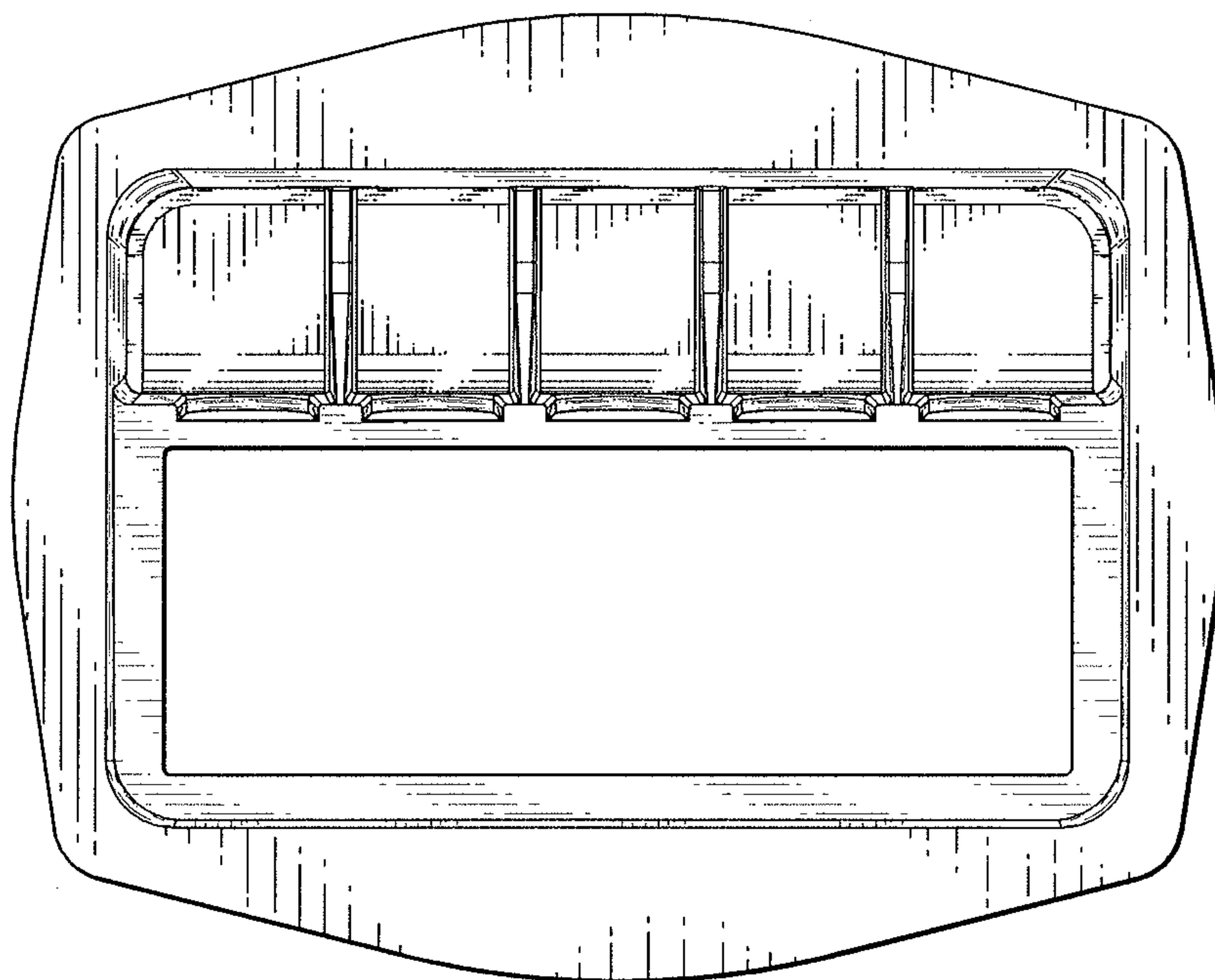
