The ornamental design for a dollhouse unit, as shown and described.

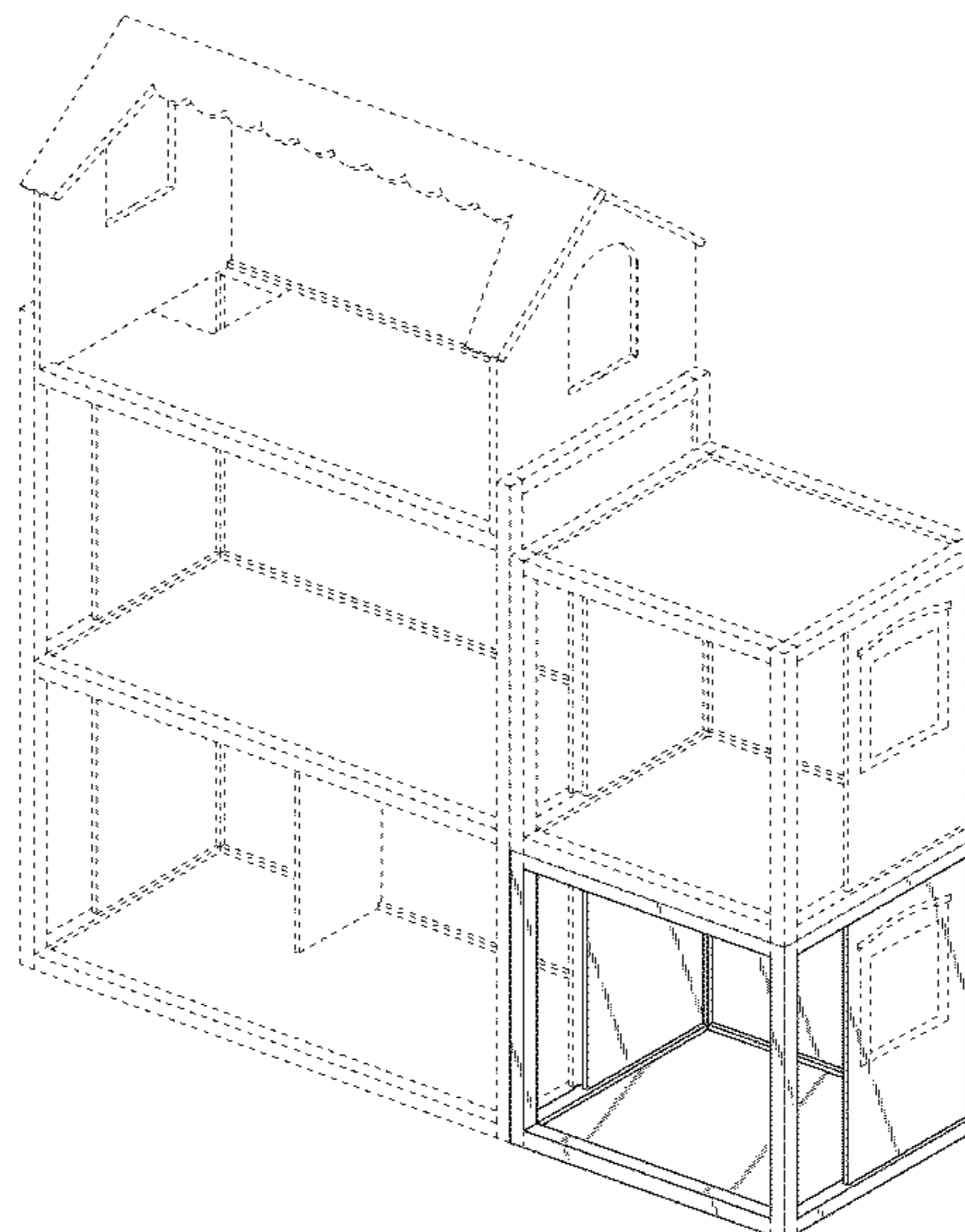
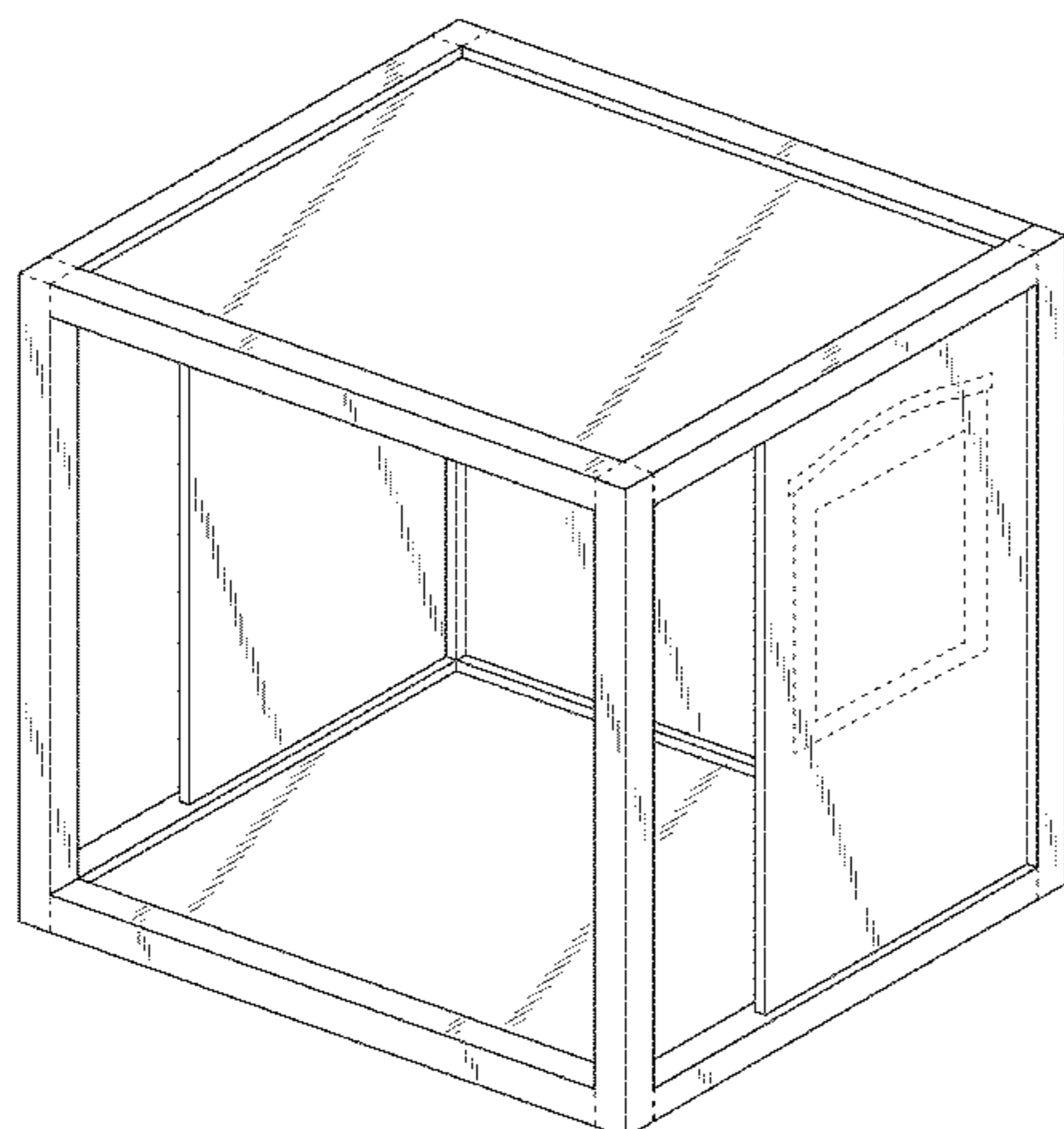
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, perspective view of a dollhouse unit showing a first embodiment of our new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view; and FIG. 5 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being identical to the front view.

FIG. 6 is a front, perspective view of the dollhouse unit of FIG. 1 shown in smaller scale and with additional environmental subject matter; FIG. 7 is a front view thereof; FIG. 8 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 9 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 10 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 11 is a top view thereof; and, FIG. 12 is a bottom view thereof.

The features shown in broken lines with consistent dash lengths in FIGS. 1-12 illustrate dollhouse unit ornamentation, features, and/or environment that form no part of the claimed design.

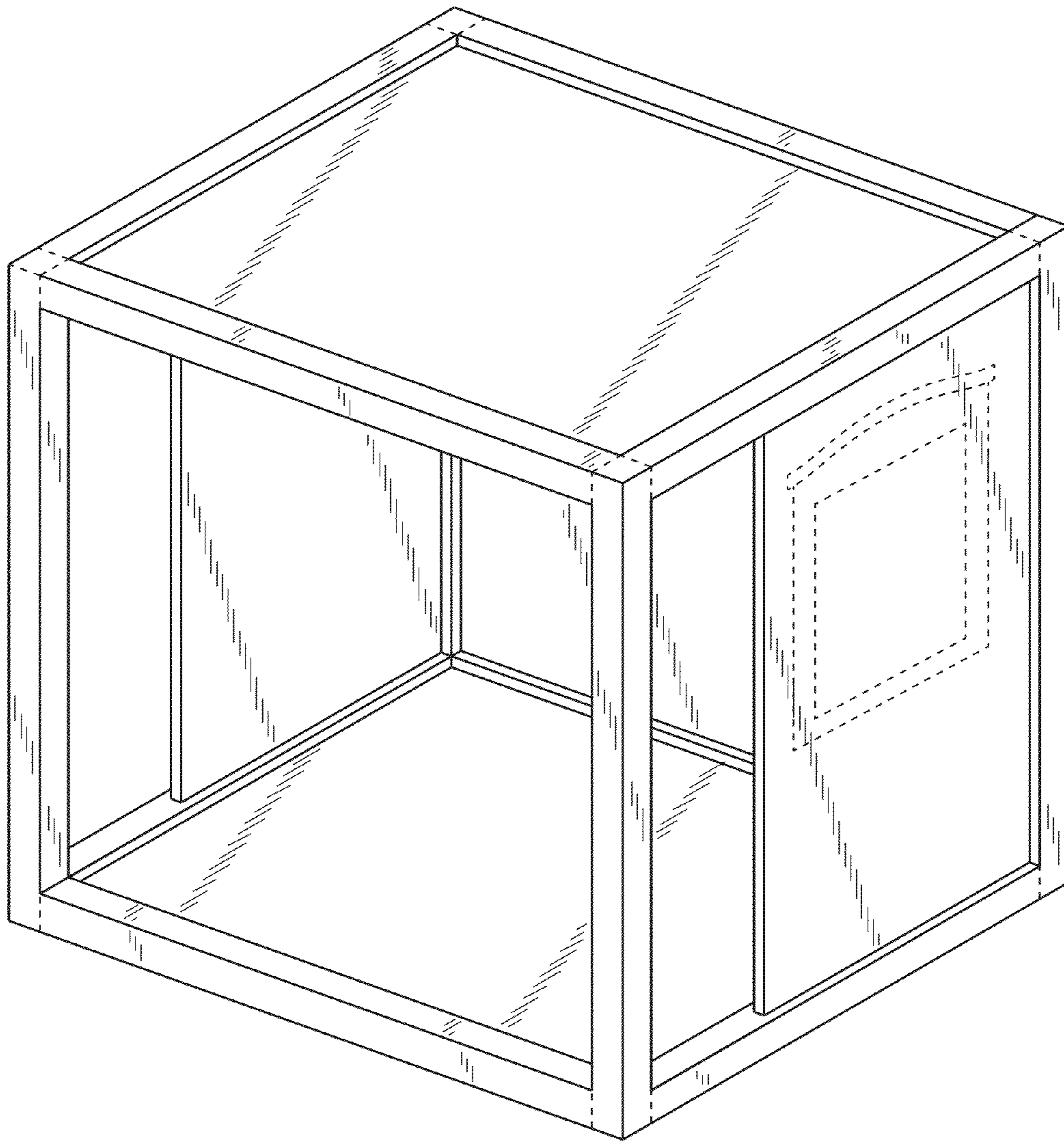

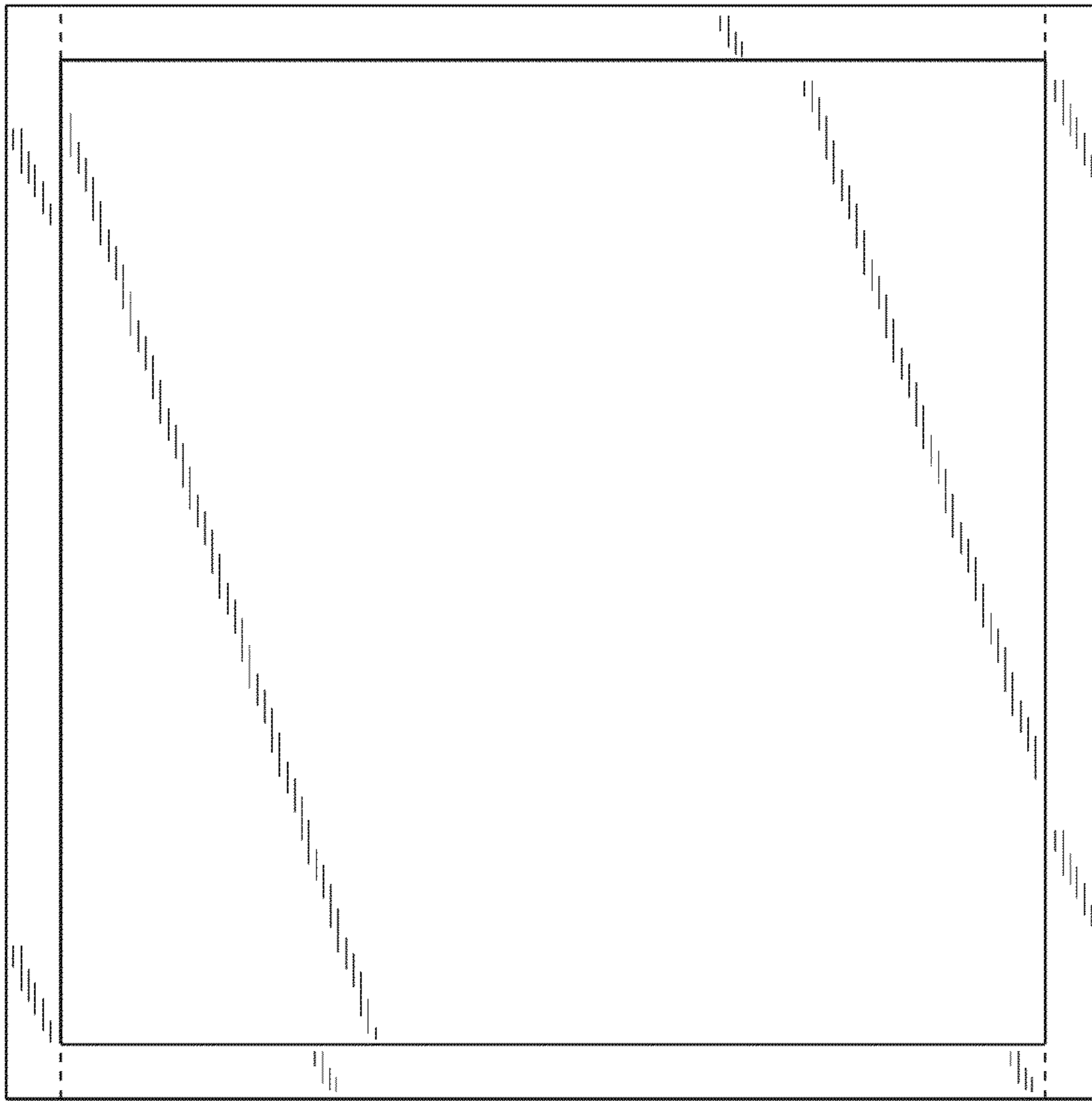

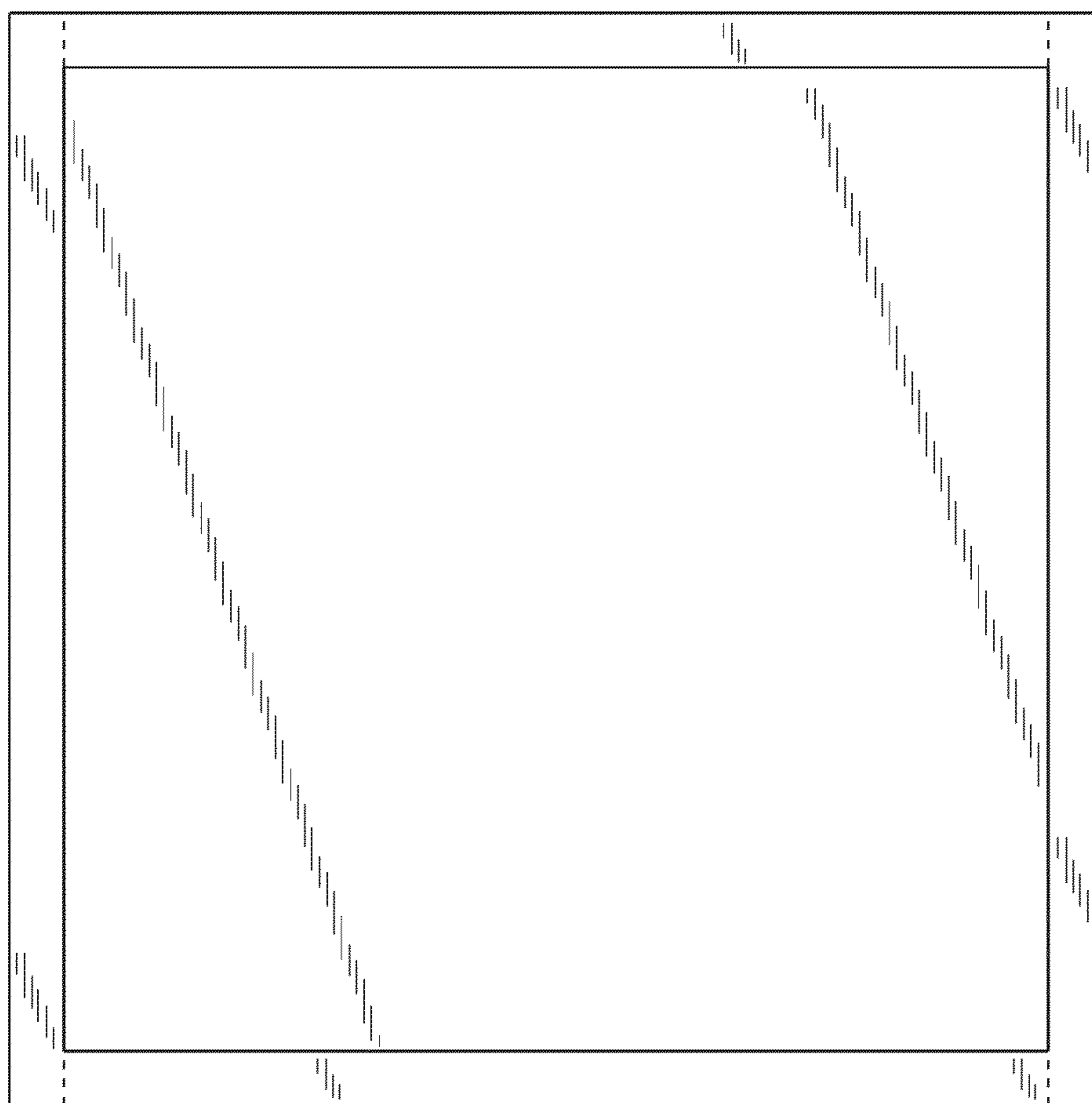

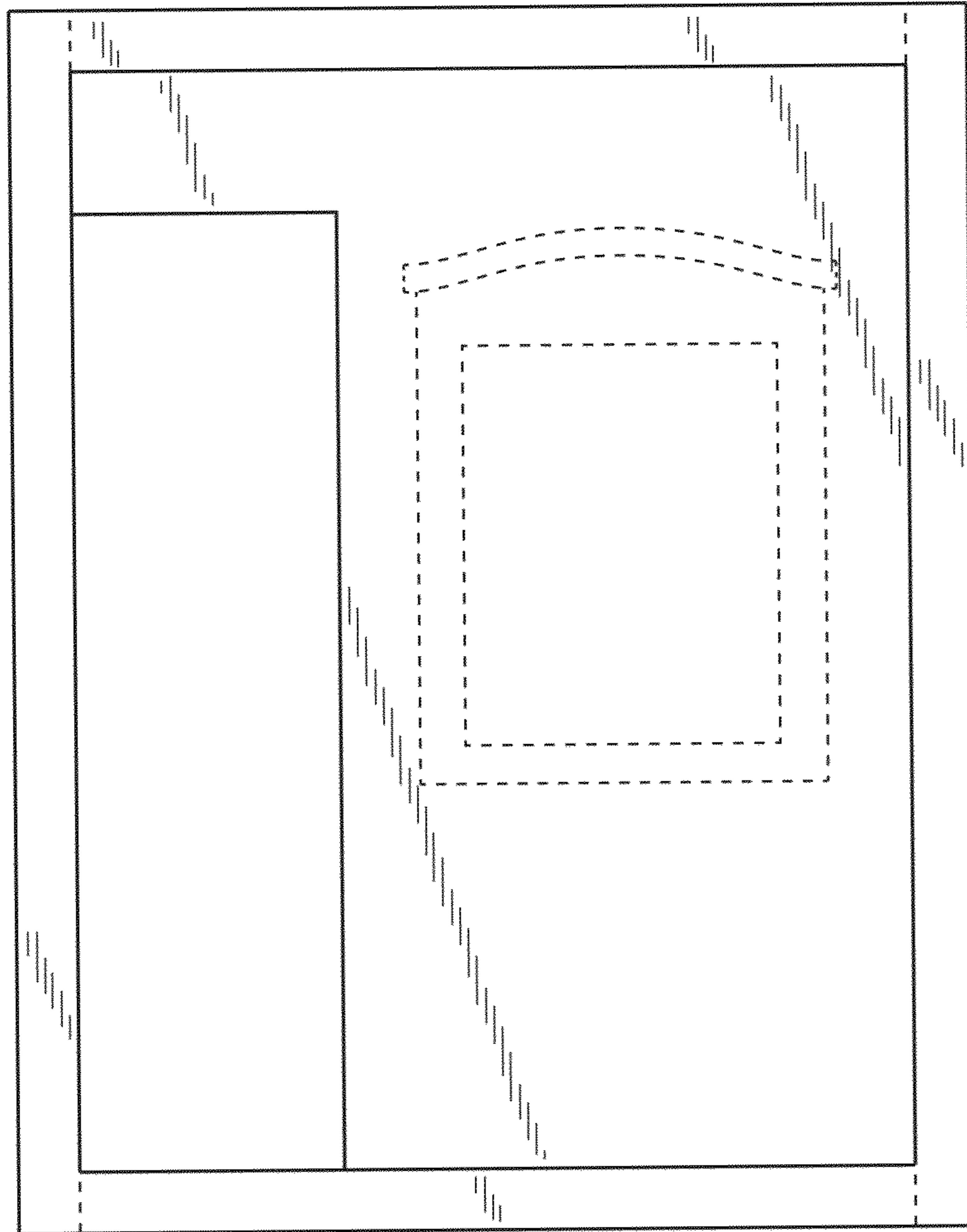

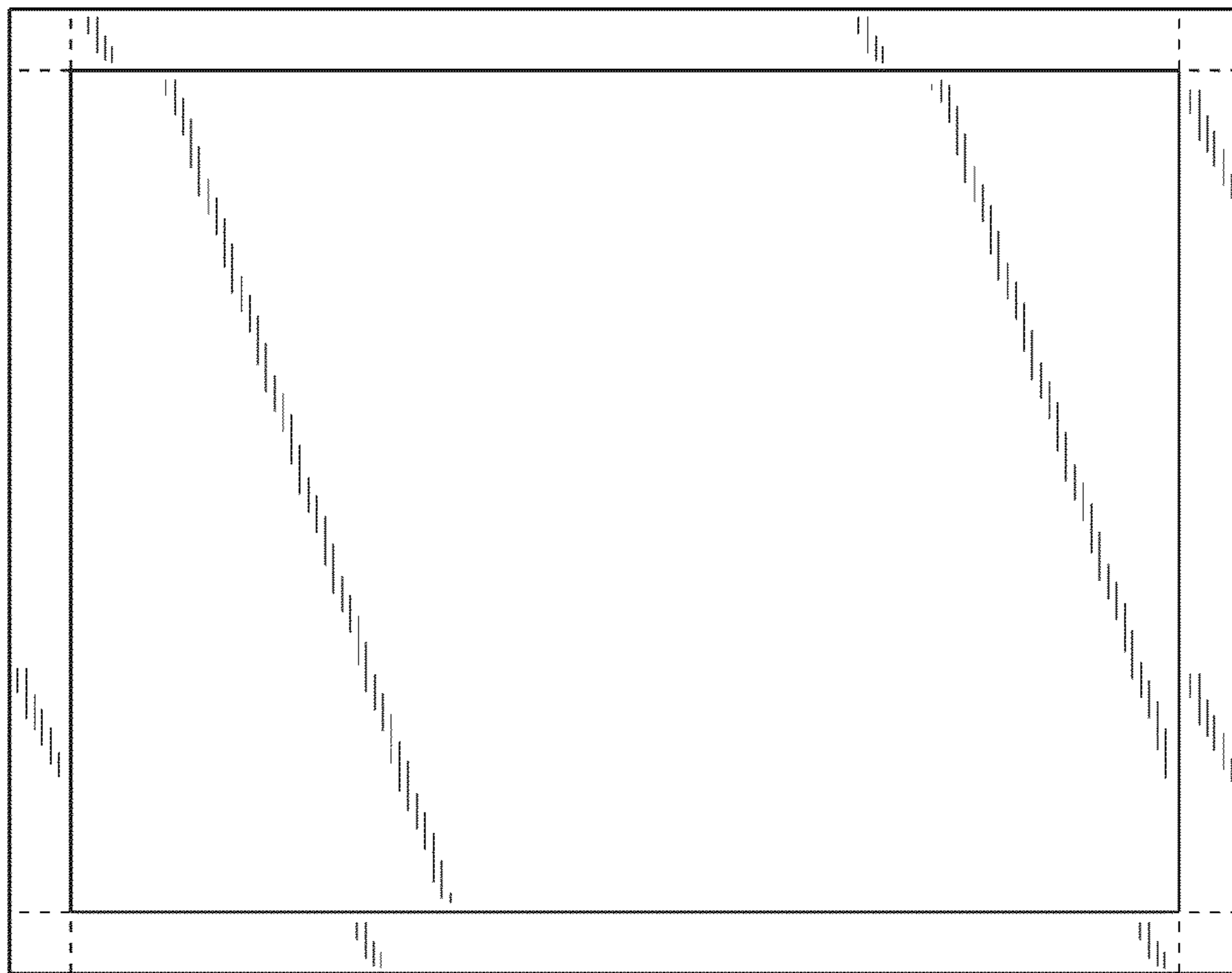

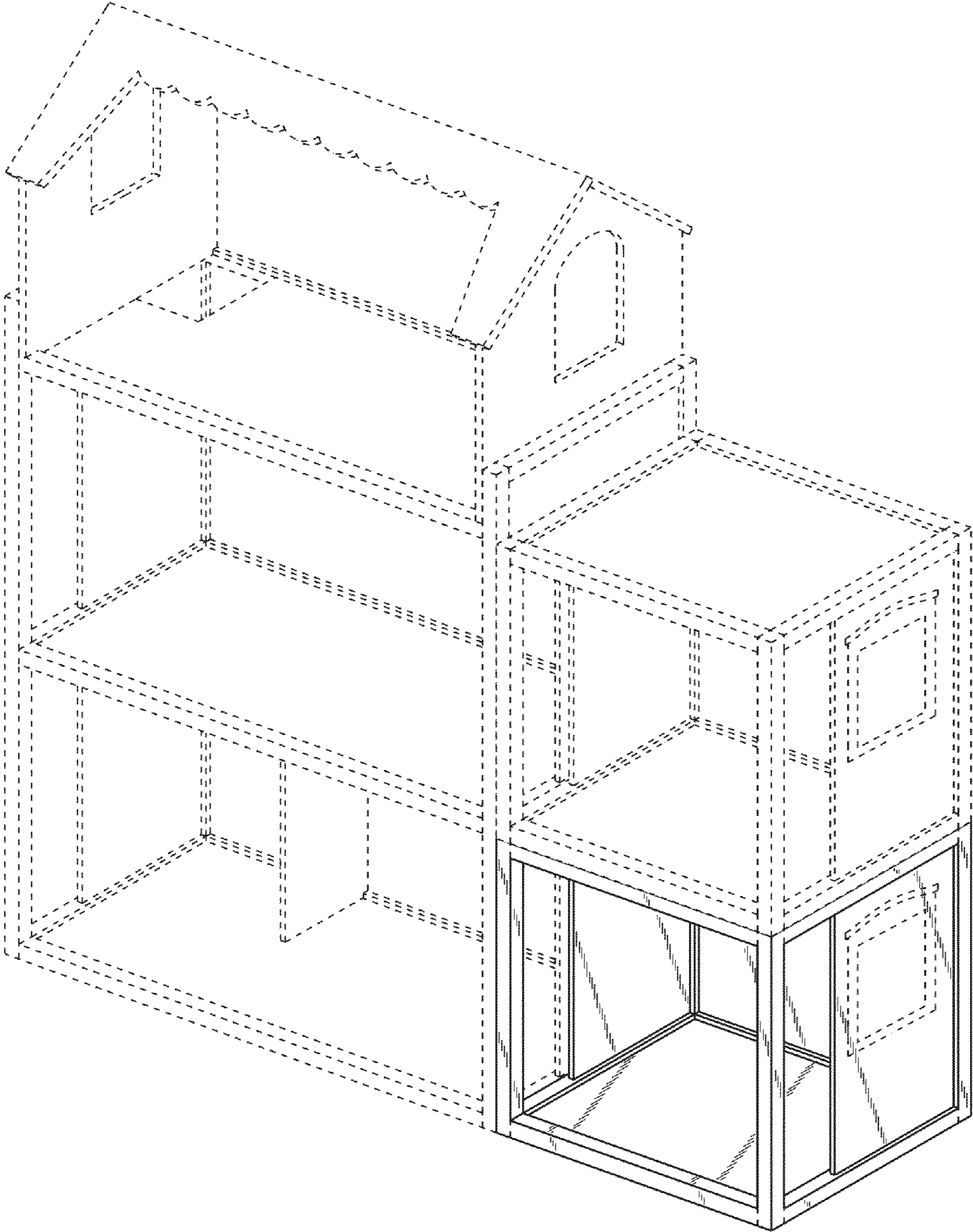

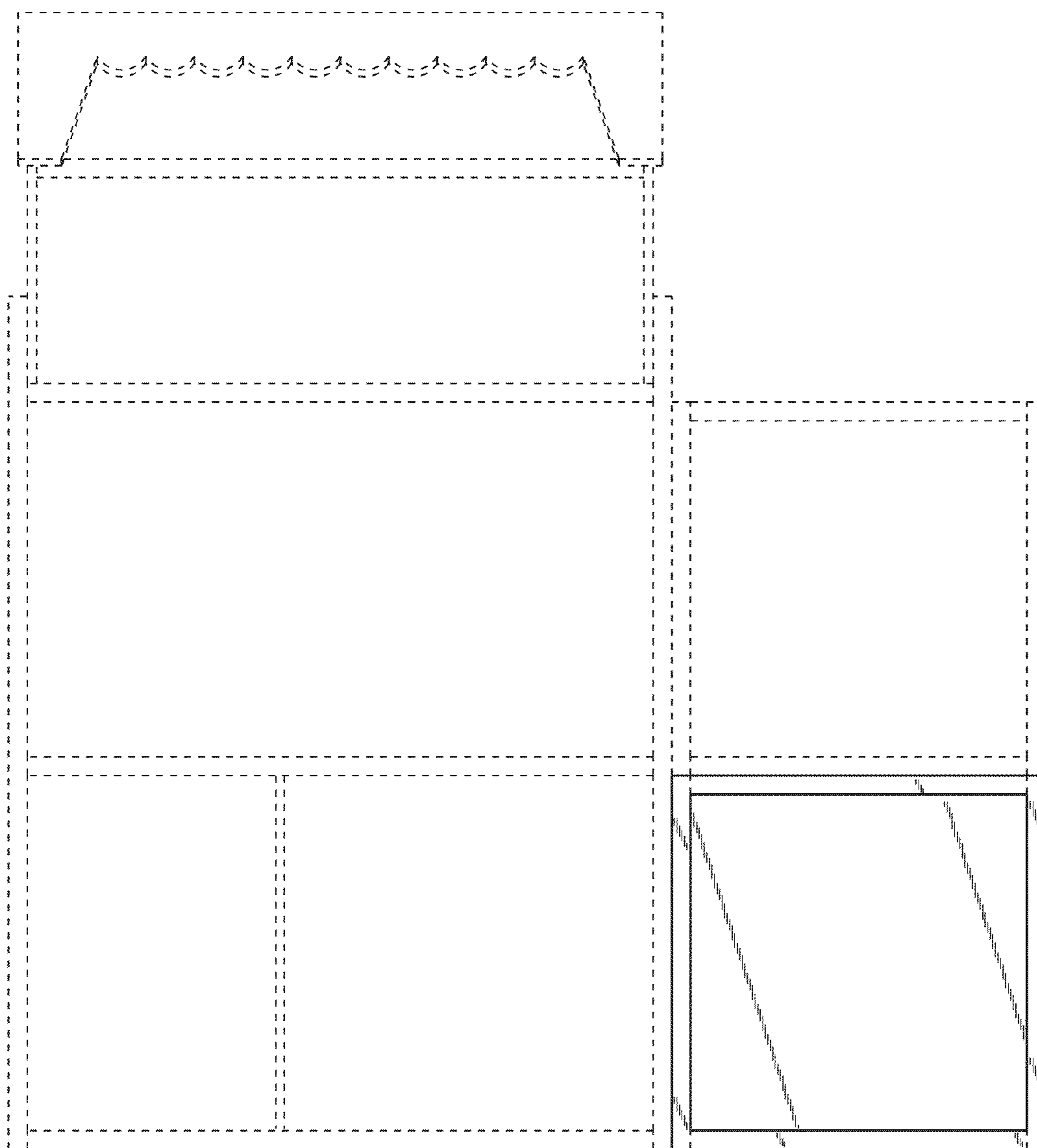

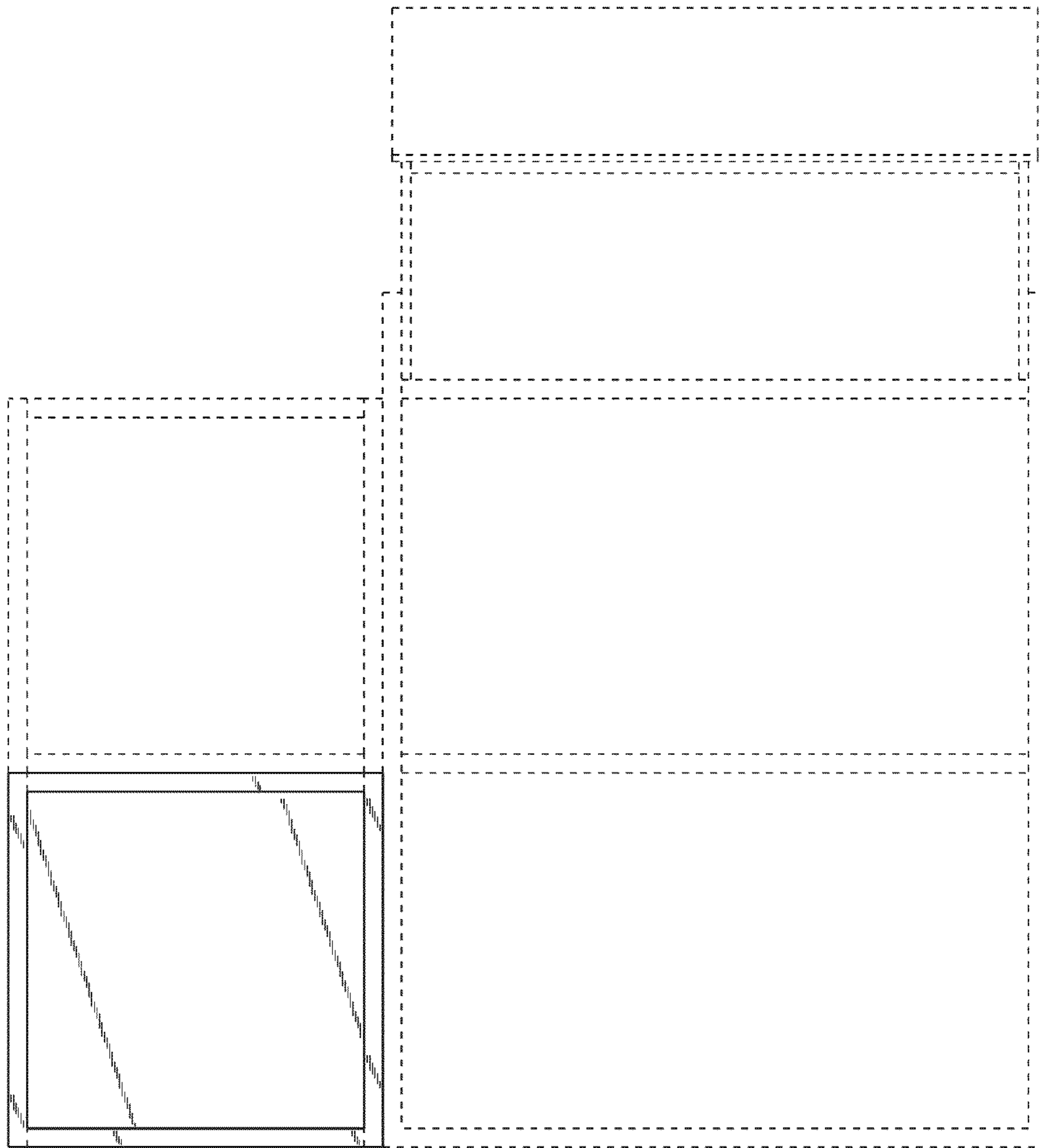

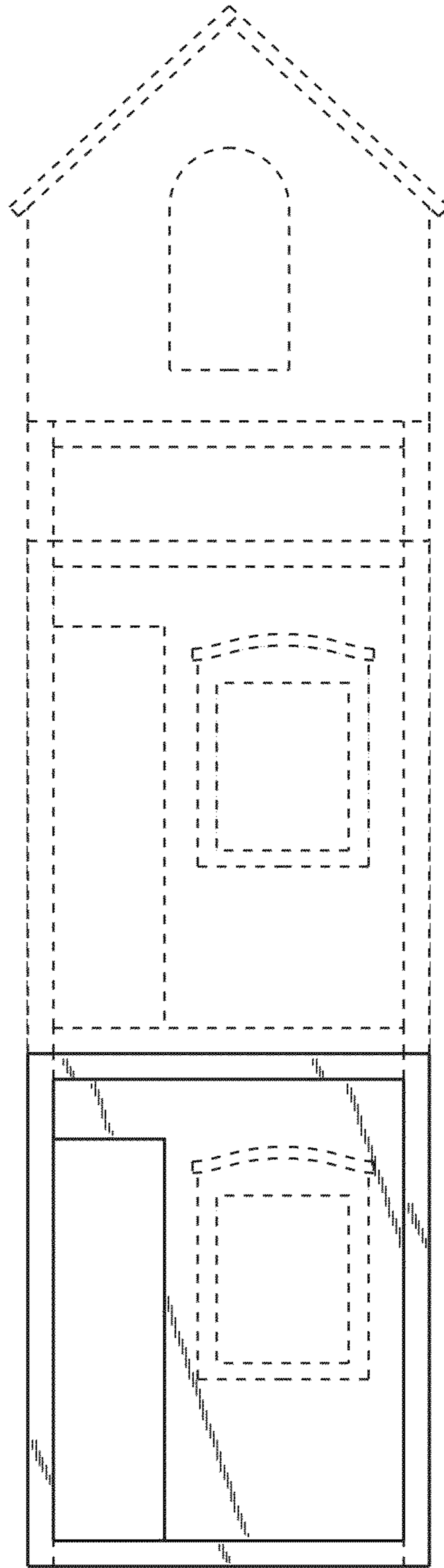

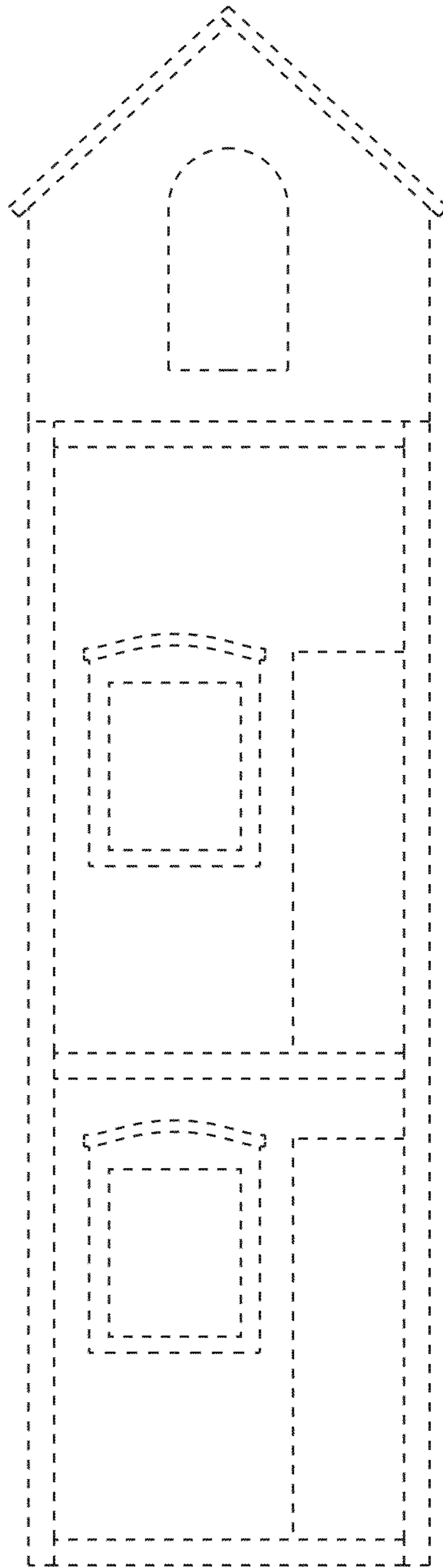

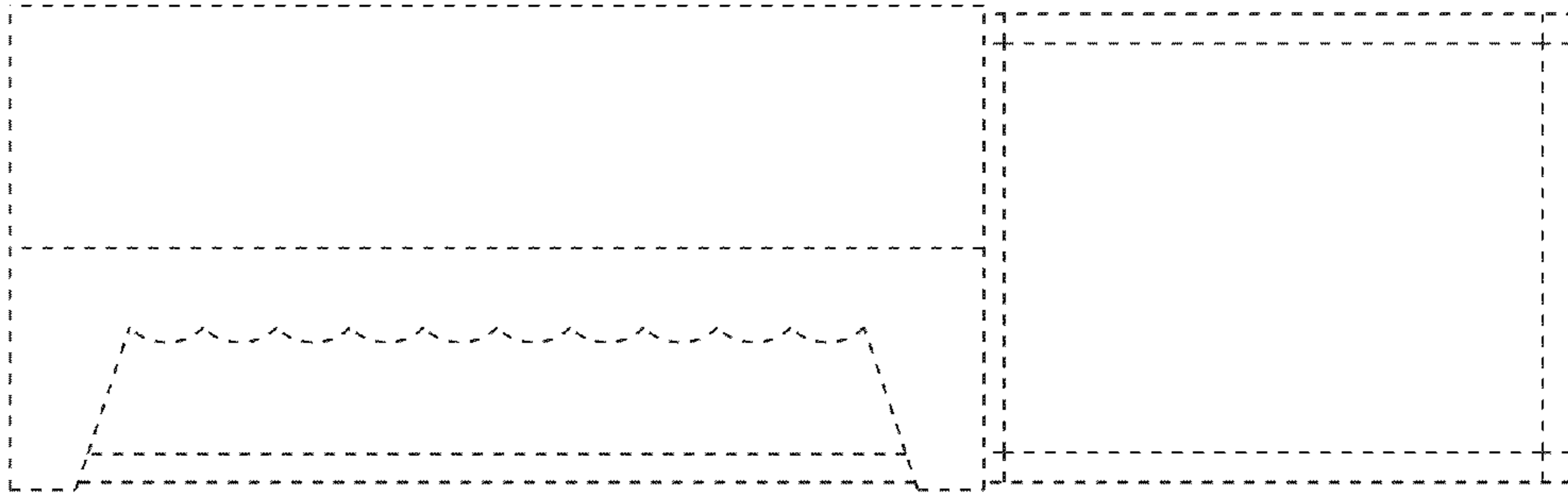

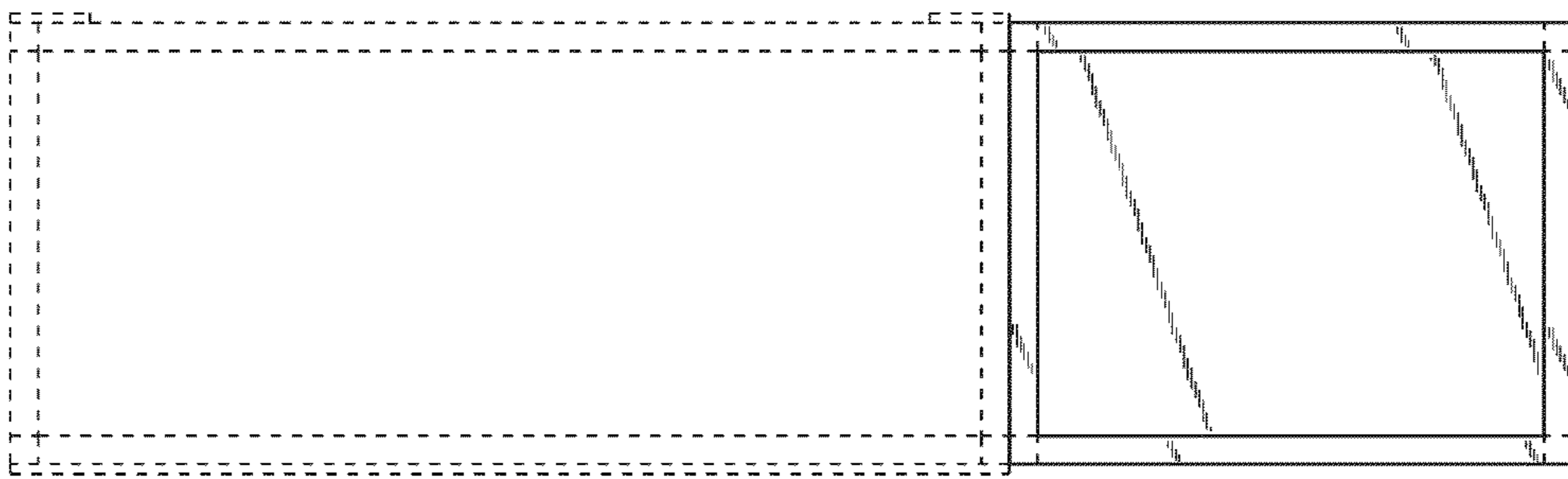
