DESCRIPTION

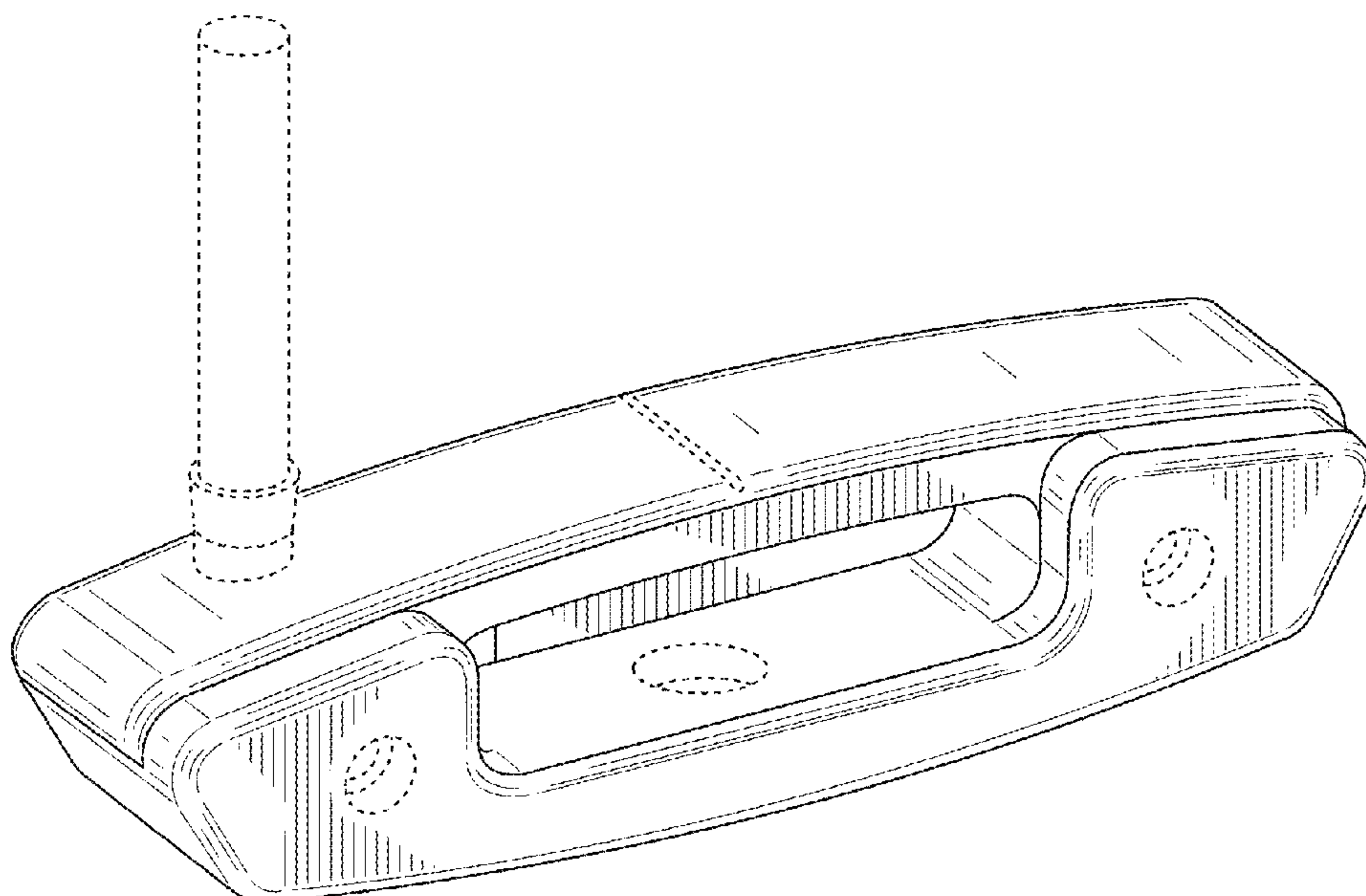
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FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the golf putter head showing

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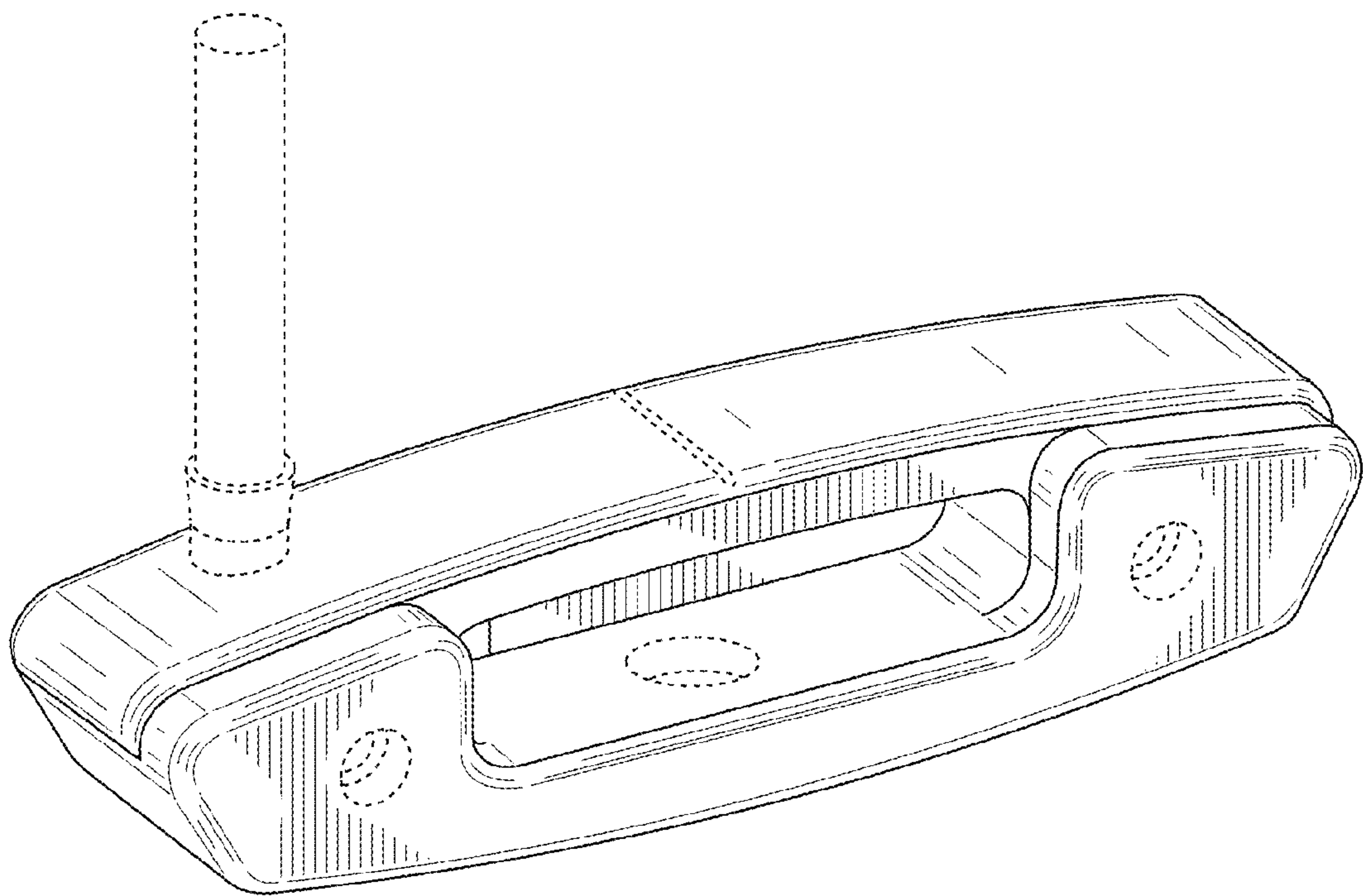

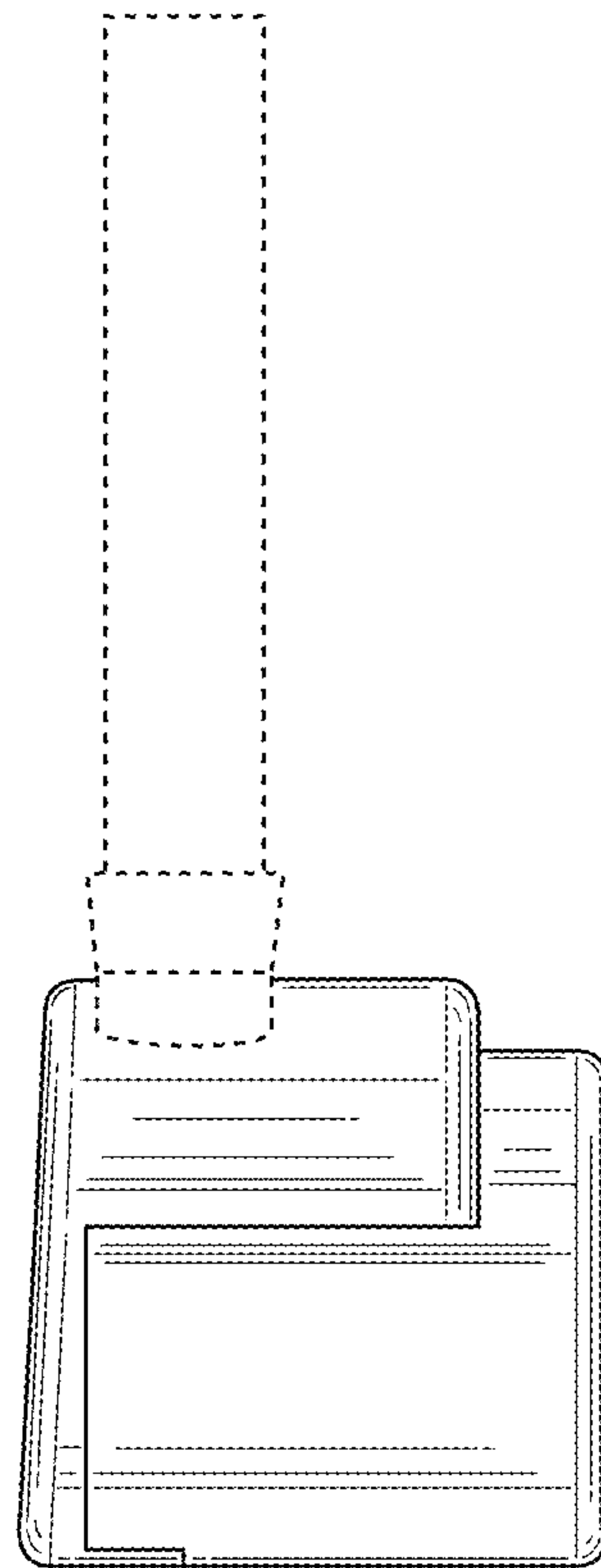

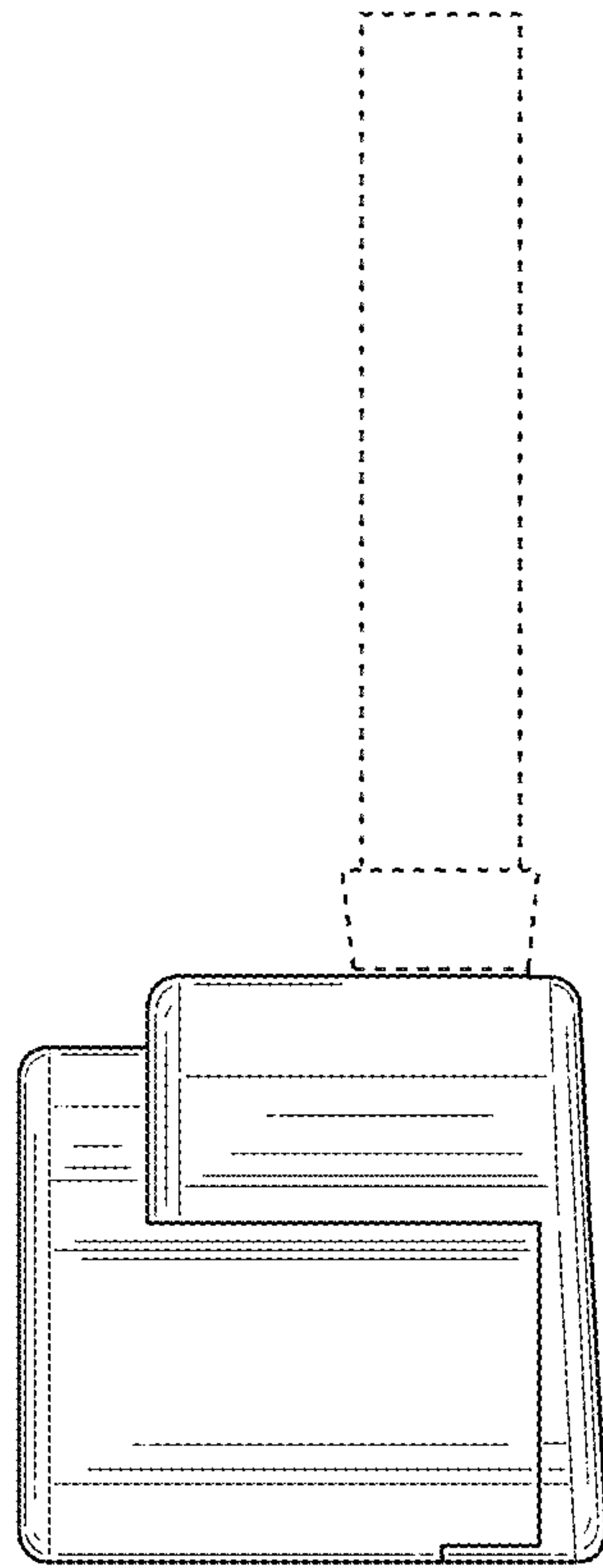

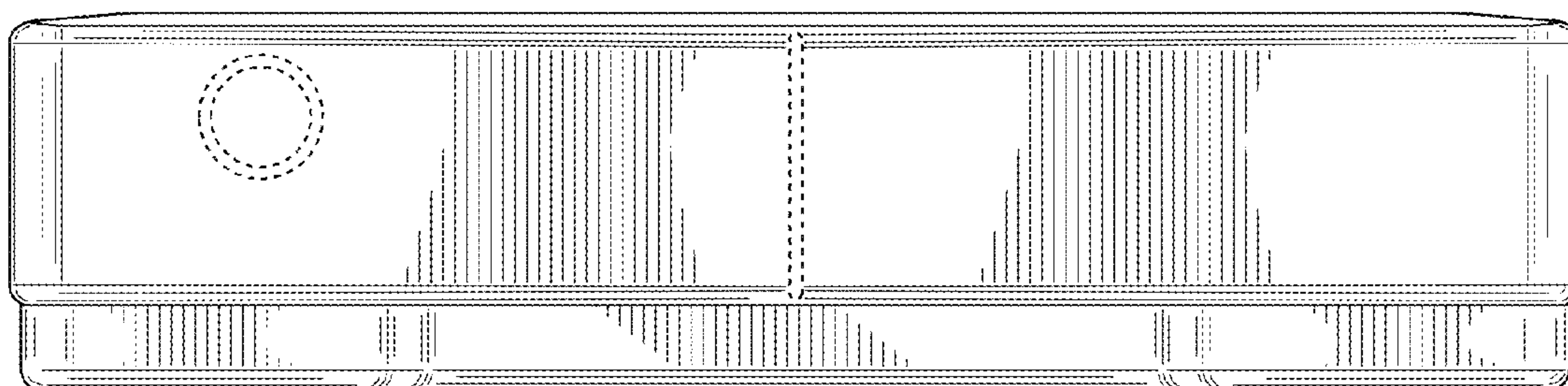

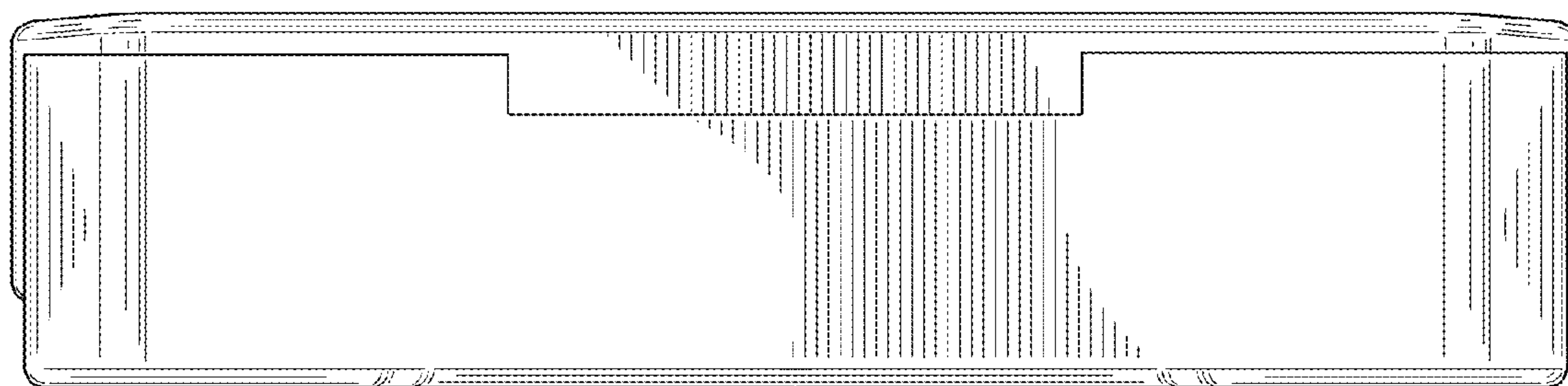

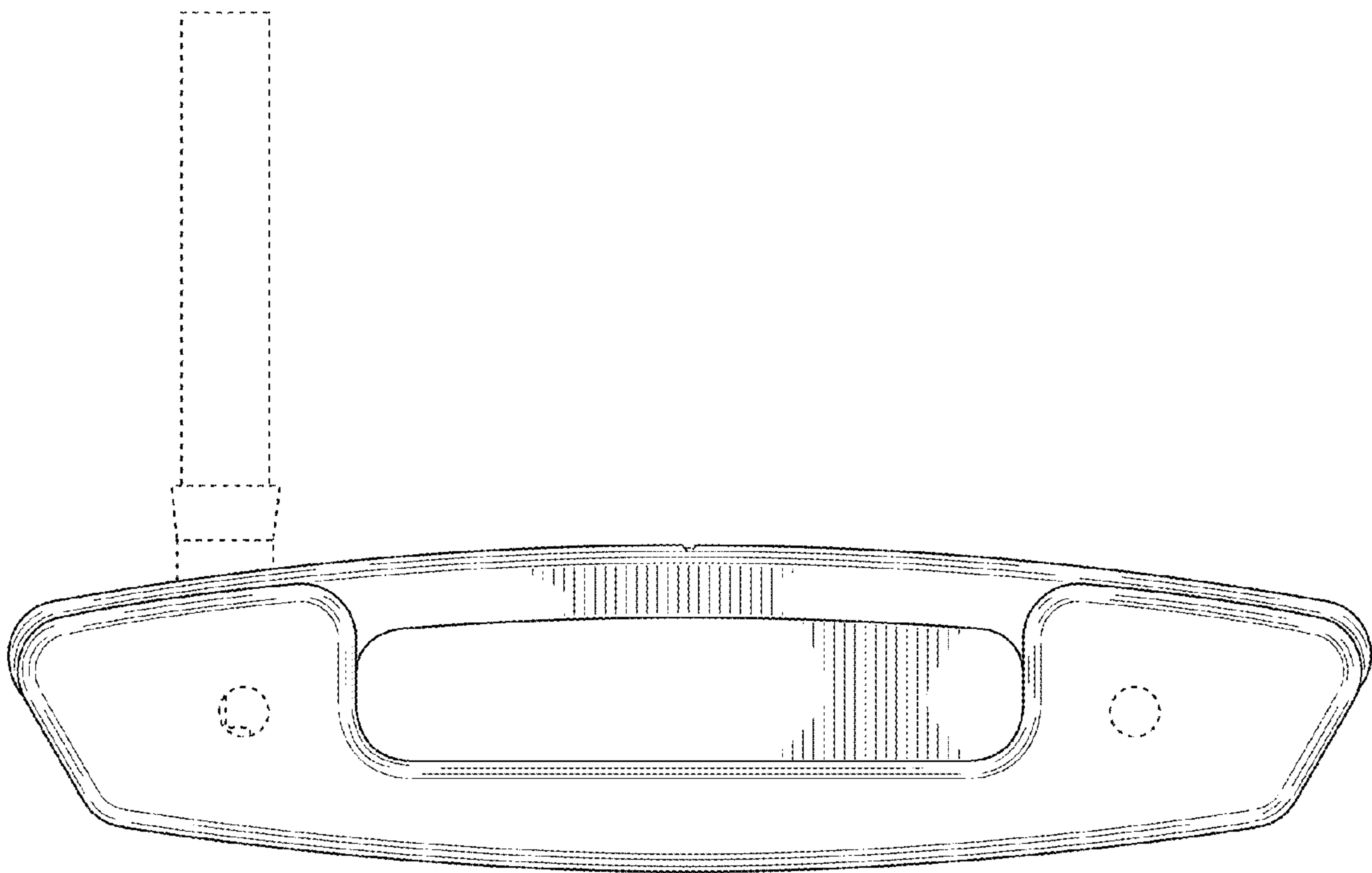

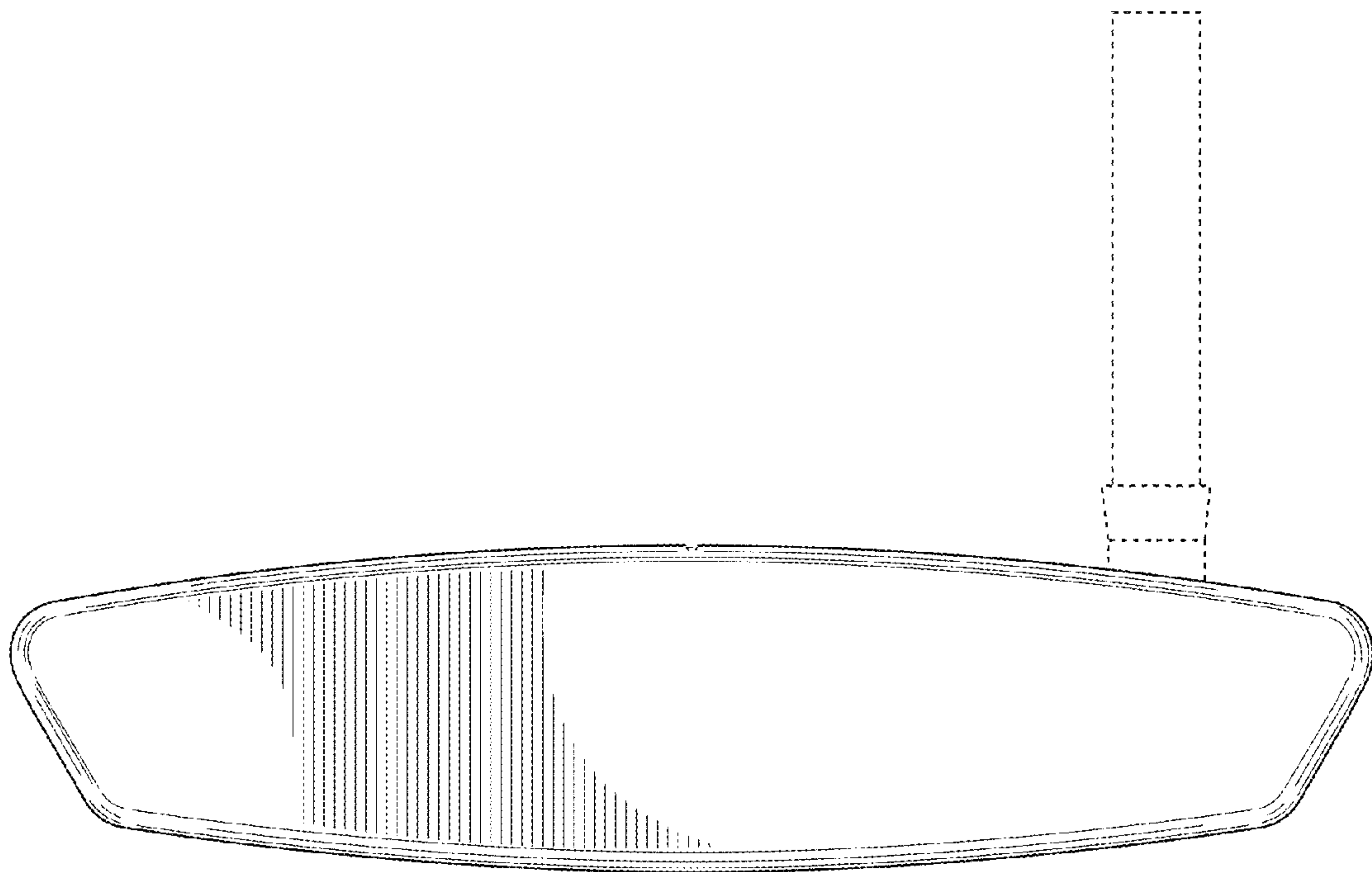
