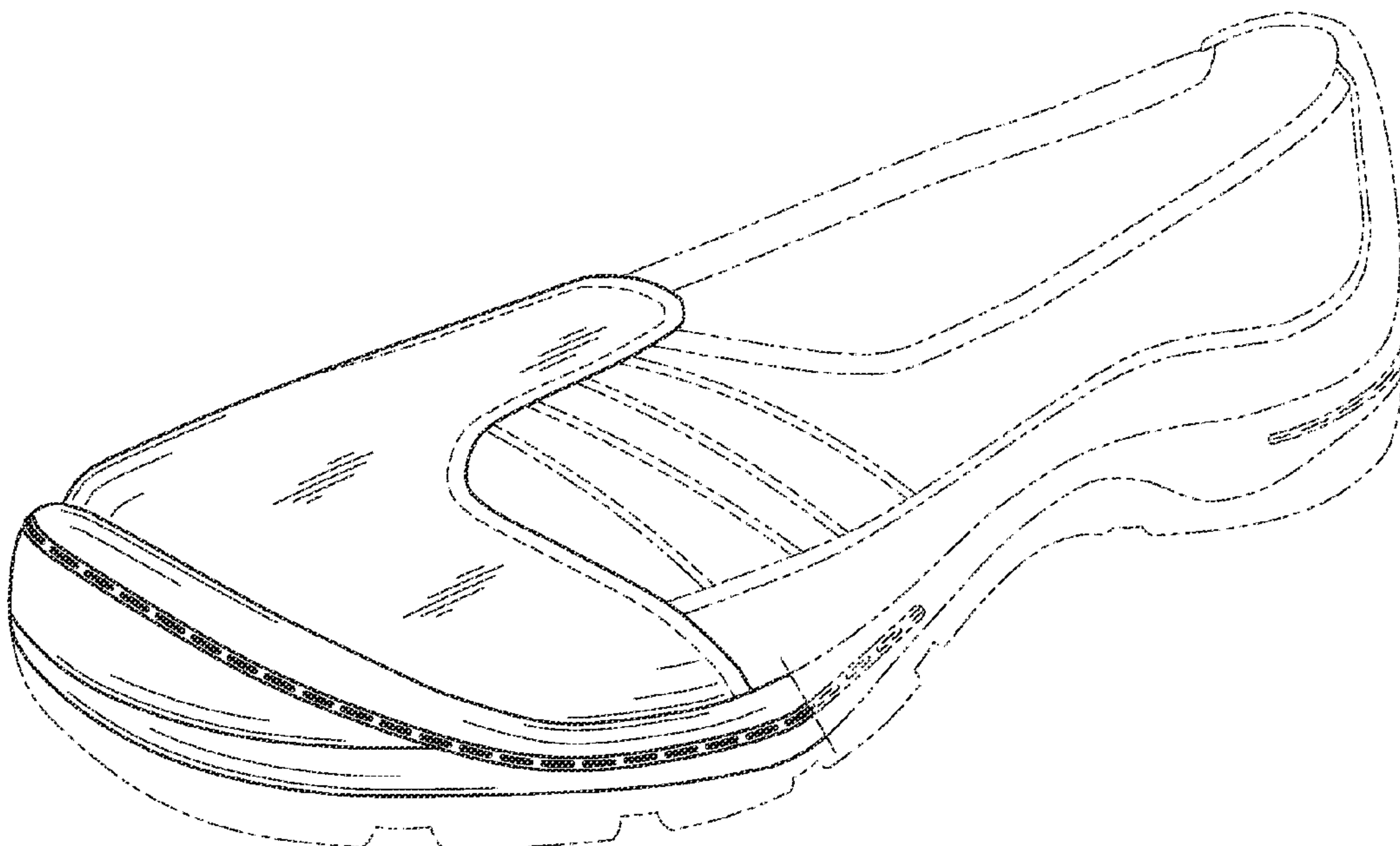
The ornamental design for toe cap with stitch pattern for a footwear item, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toe cap with stitch pattern for a footwear item showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a top view thereof.

The uneven broken lines shown in the drawings represent portions of the toe cap with stitch pattern for a footwear item that form no part of the claimed design. The even broken lines on the toe cap represent thread stitching that are part of the claimed design.

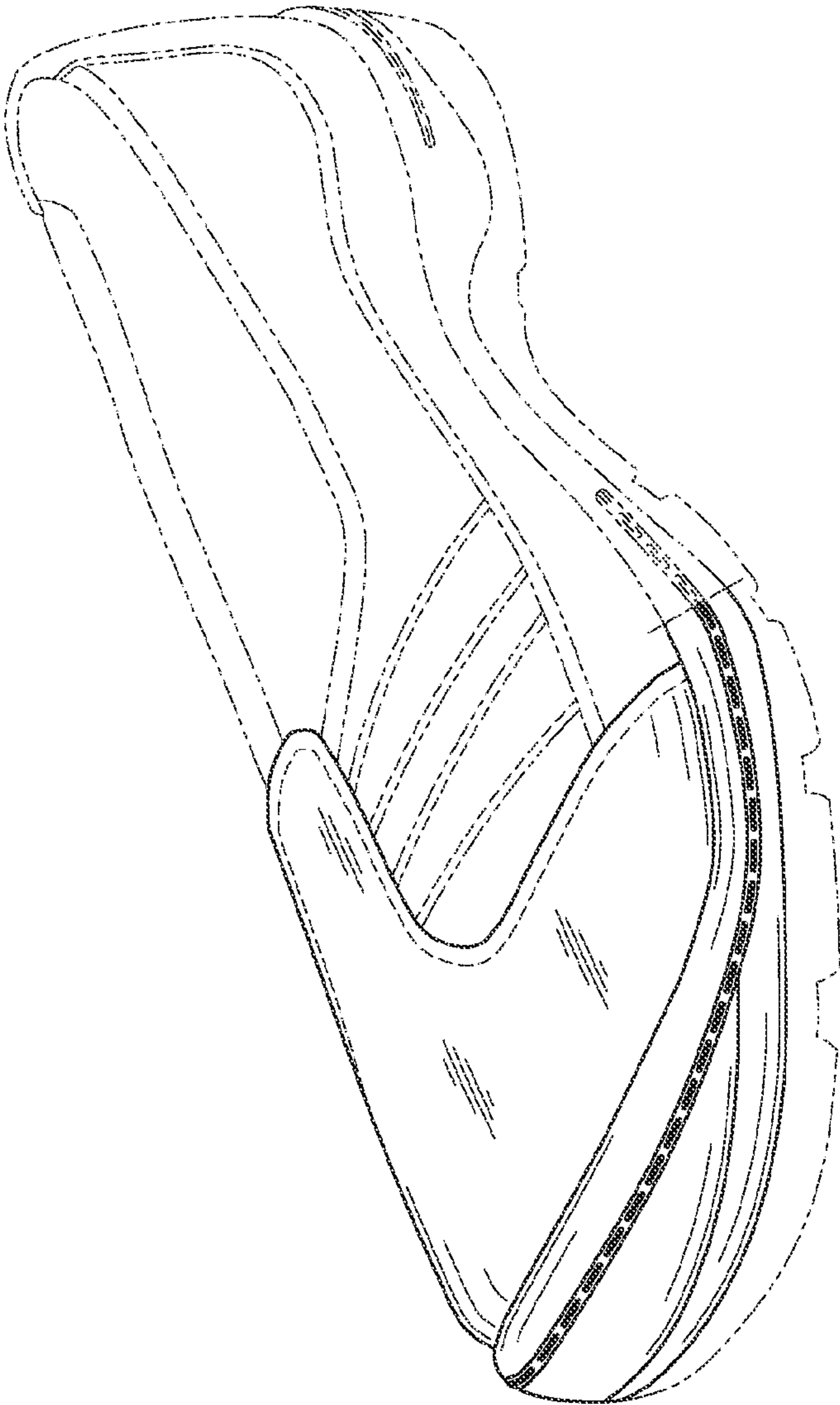

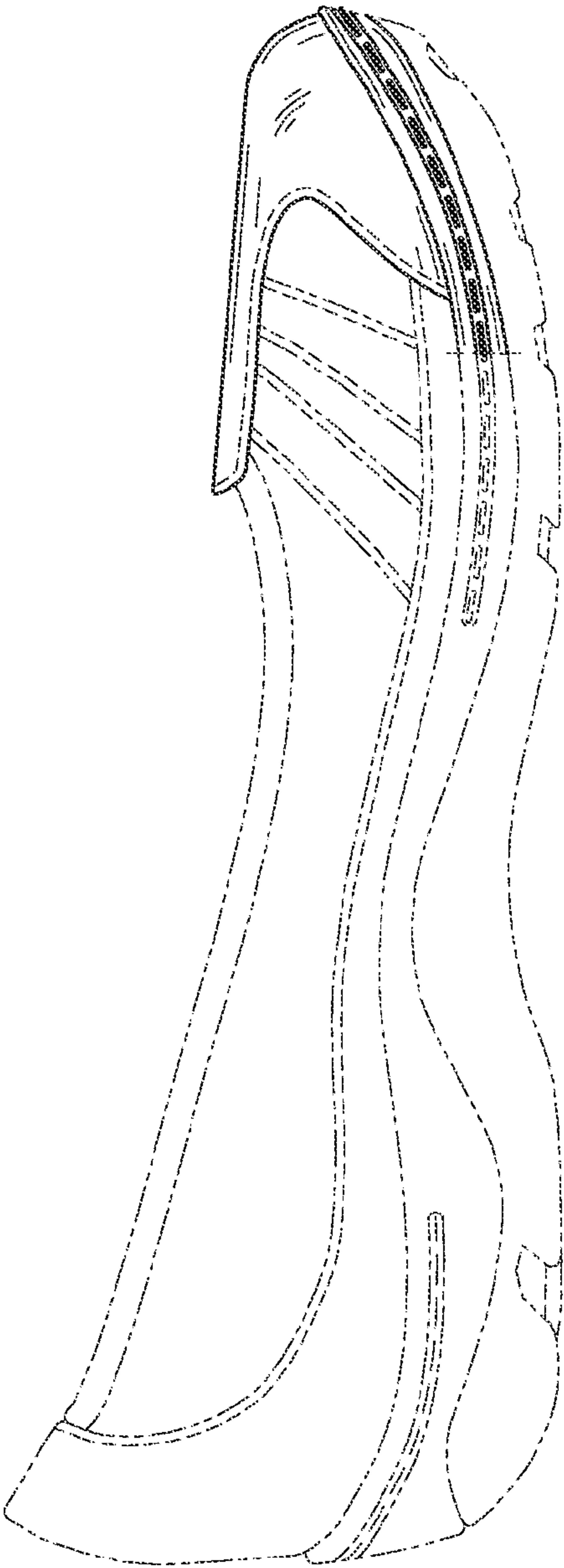

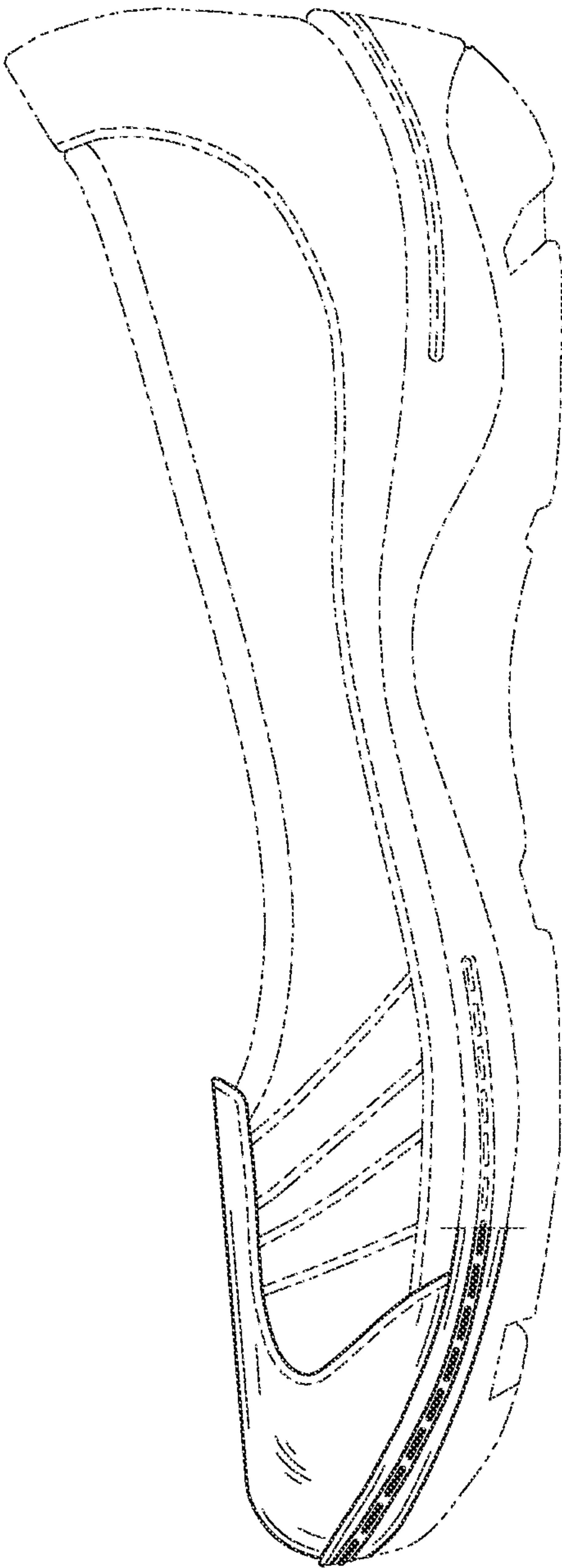

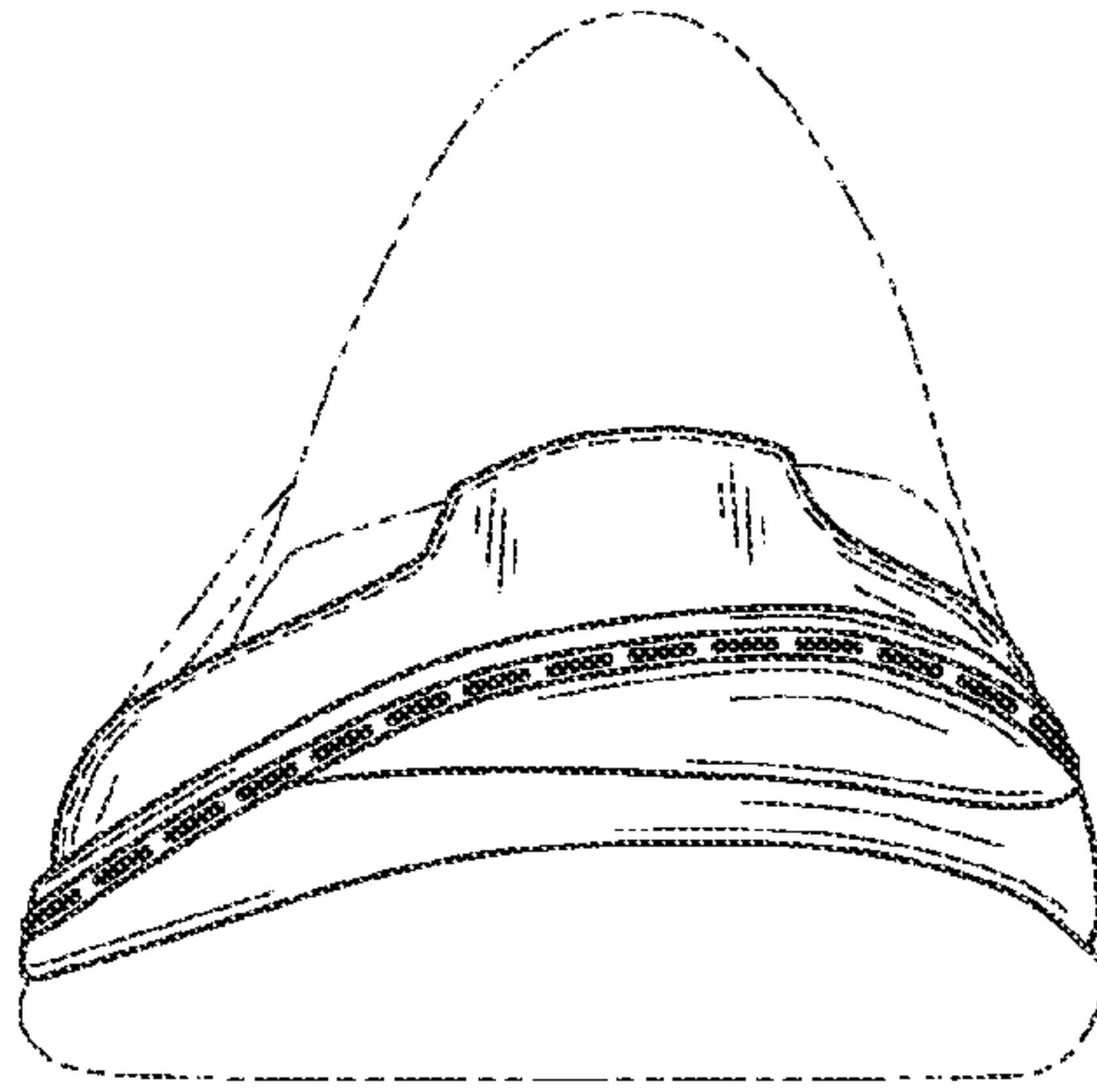

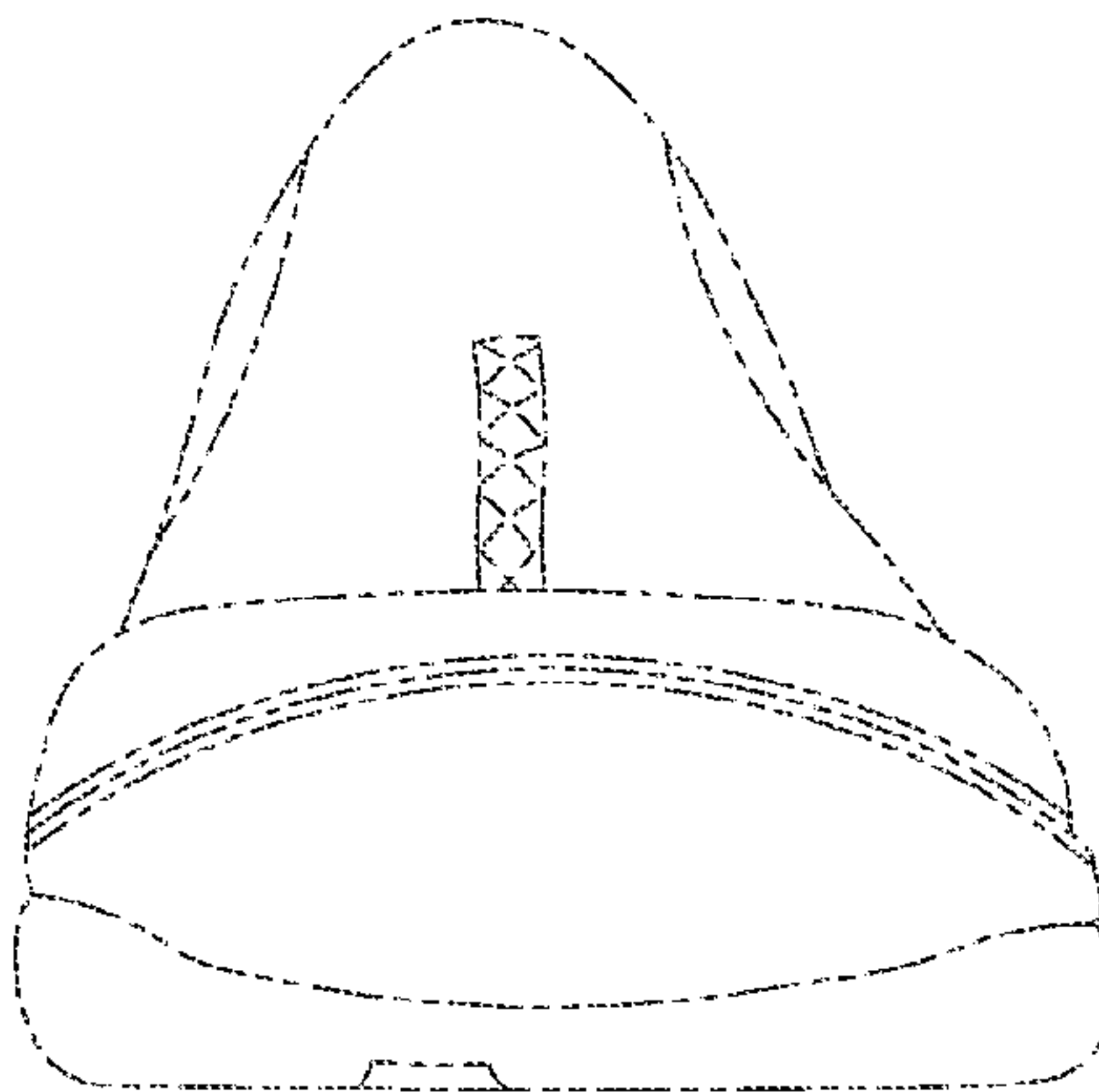

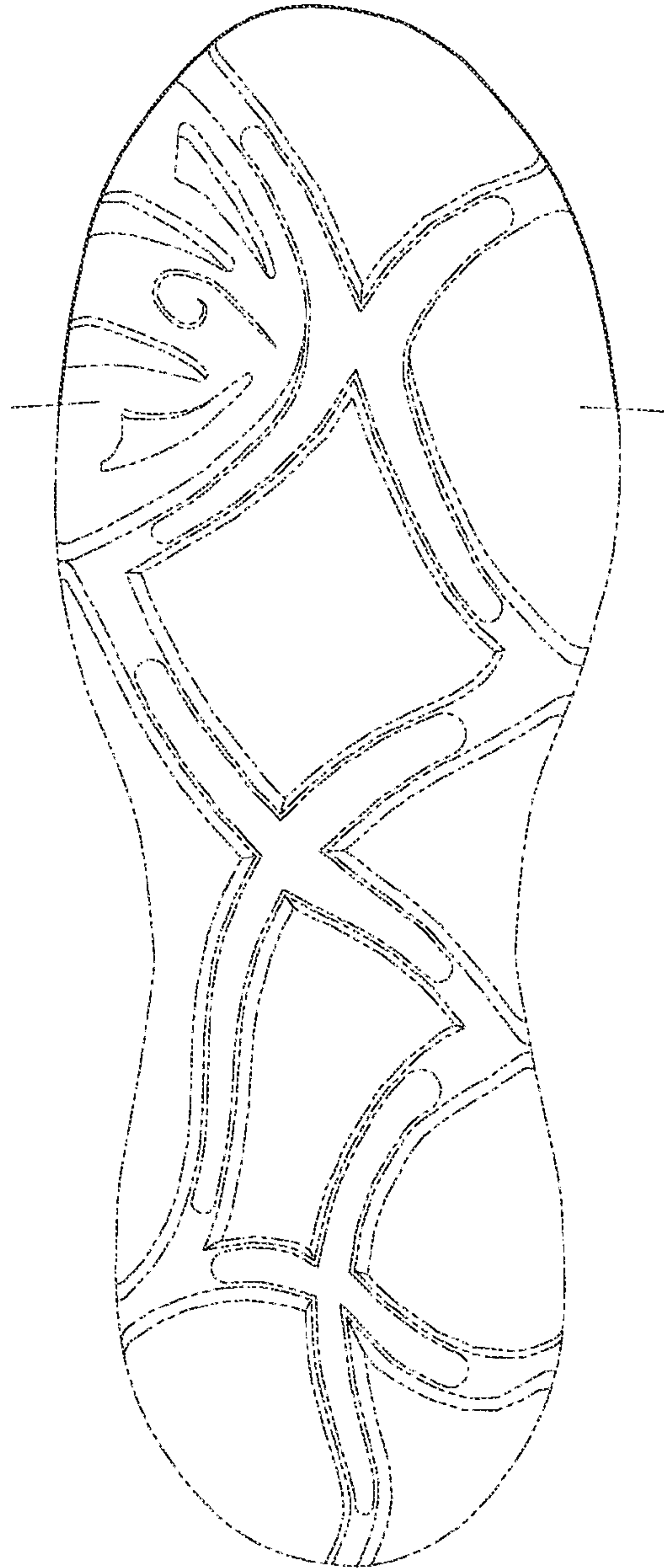

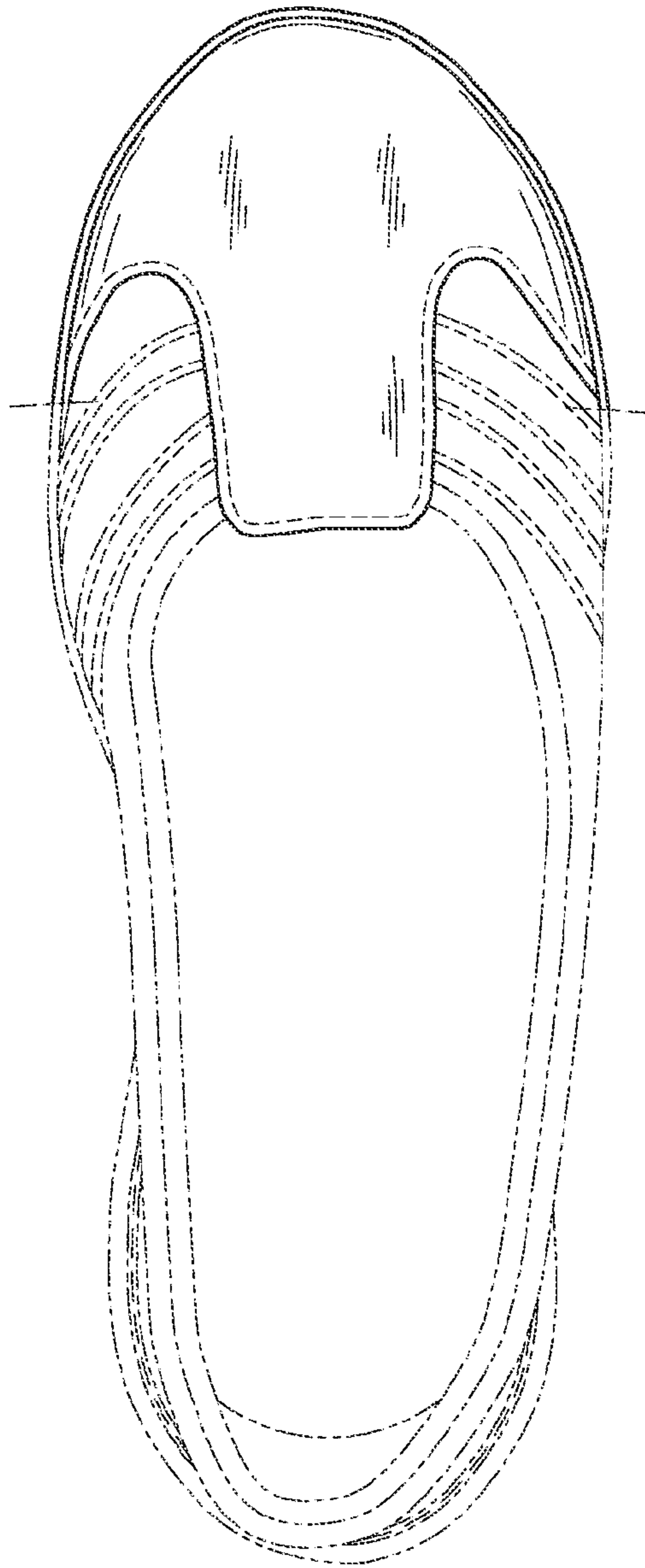
