**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the baby jump suit, showing my new design; and,

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof.

The larger dashed line showing of sleeves, collar and placket is included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the article as environment, with the line itself and the area within, forming no part of the claimed design.

The smaller dashed line showing of buttons and stitching along the collar and placket is included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the article as environment and form no part of the claimed design.

The smaller dashed line showing along the shoulders, sides, inseams, feet, and zipper is included for the purpose of illustrating stitching and is part of the claimed design.

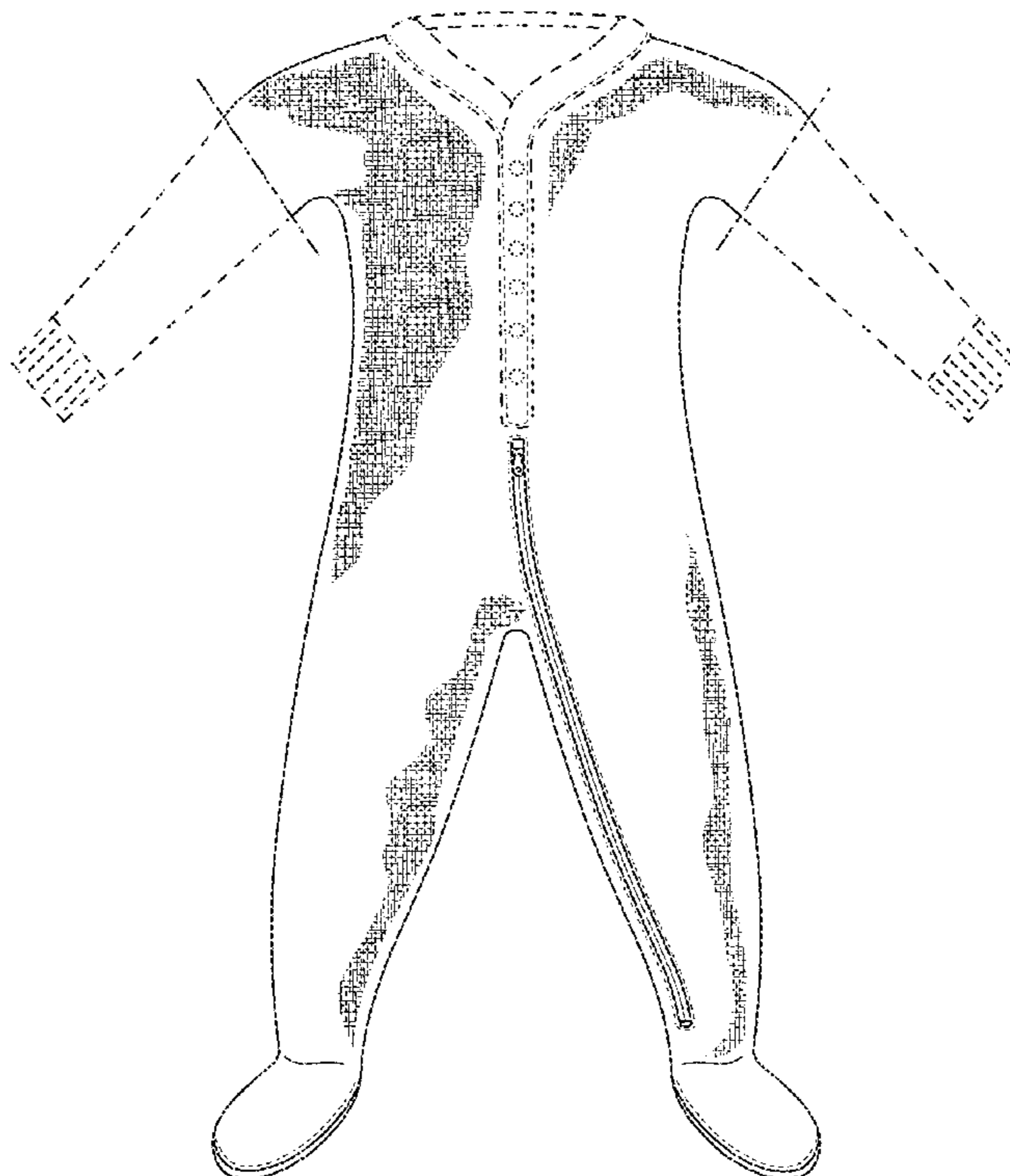
The alternating long and short dashed line showing across the sleeves is included for the purpose of illustrating the boundary of the claimed design.

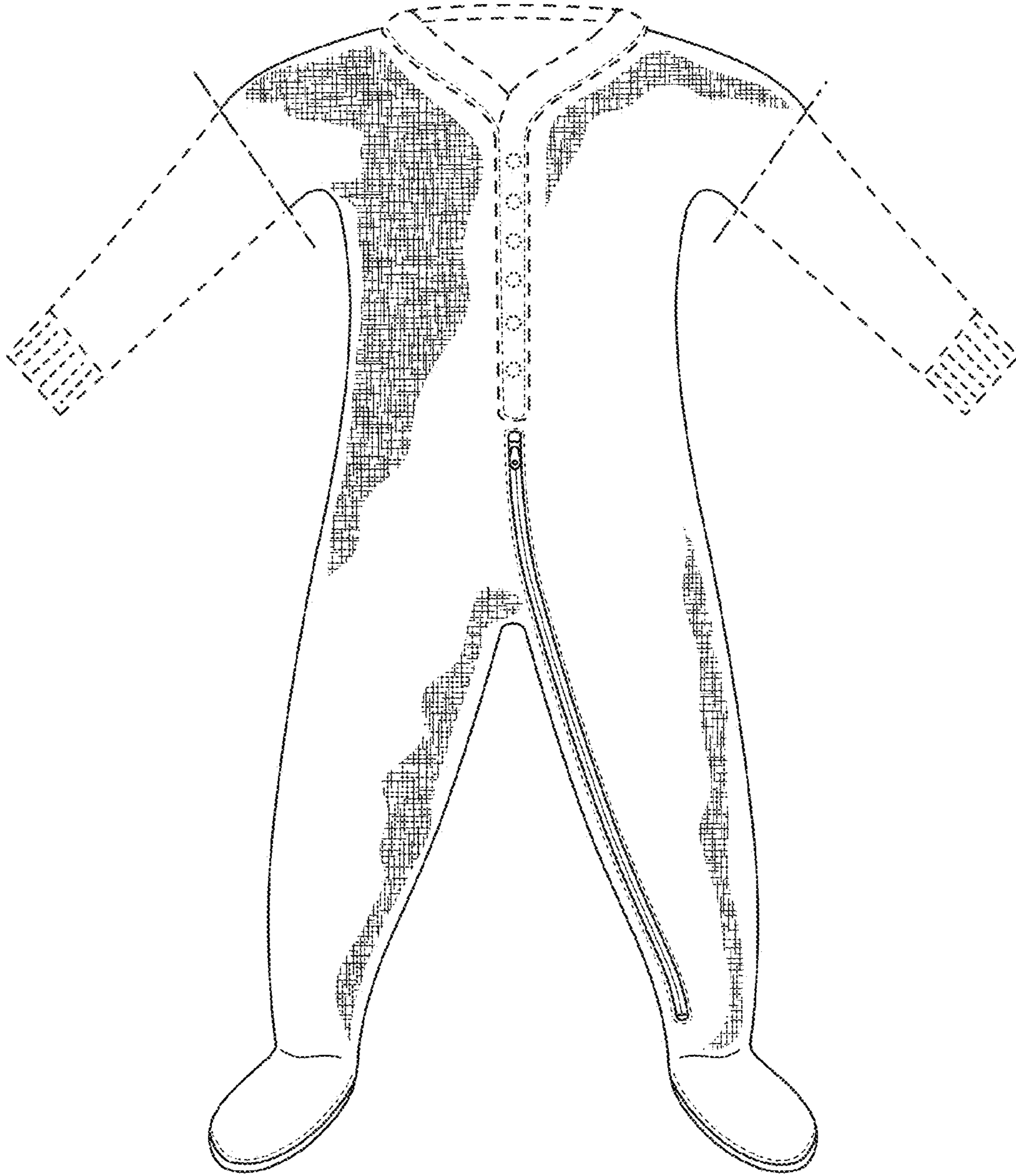

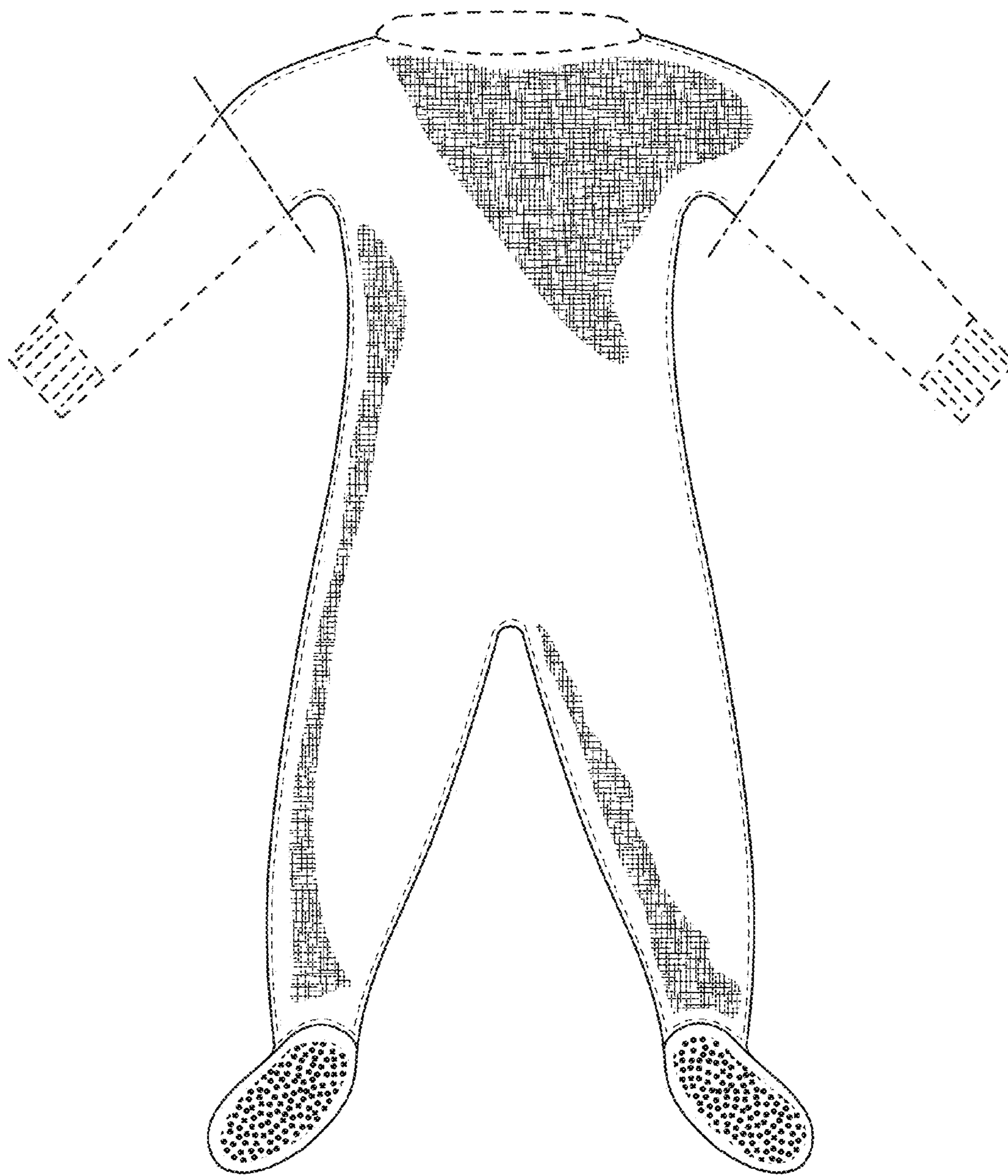
