sling showing my new invention, in condition of use.

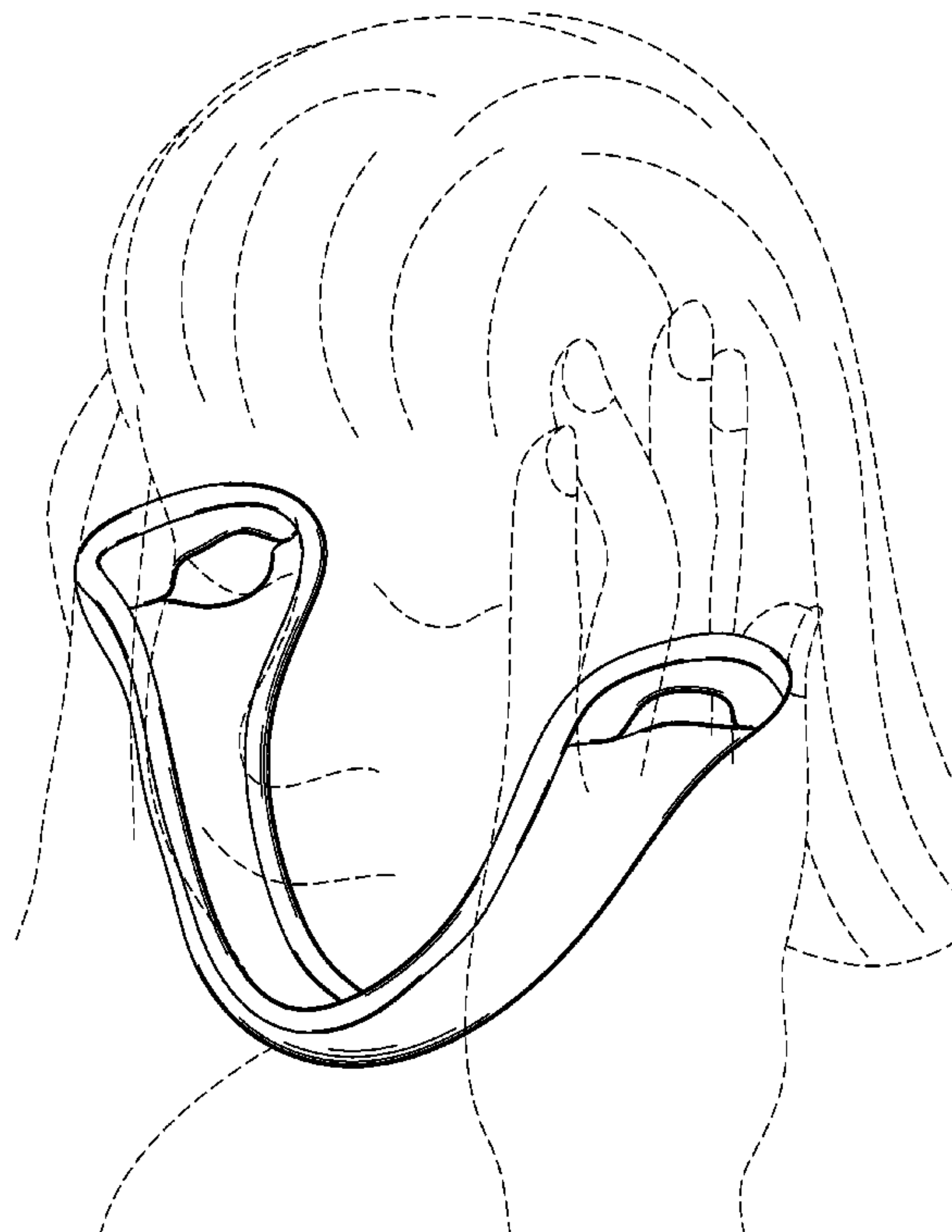
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being identical

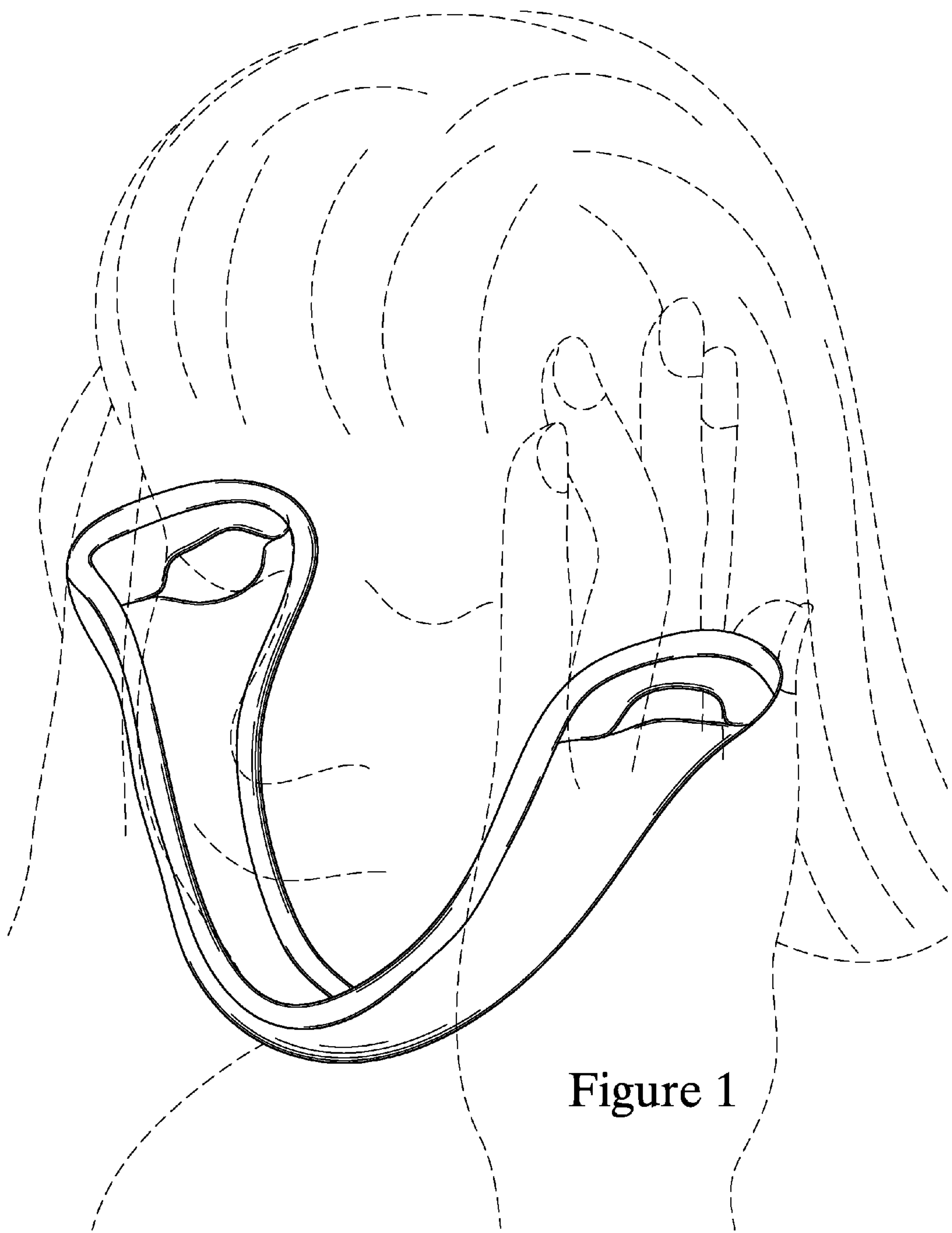

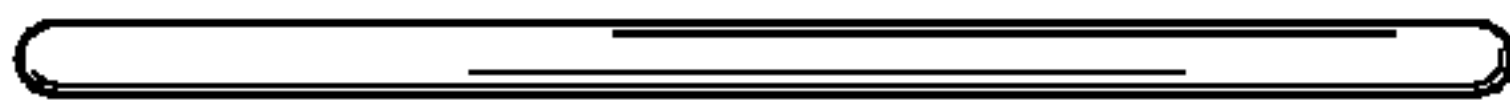

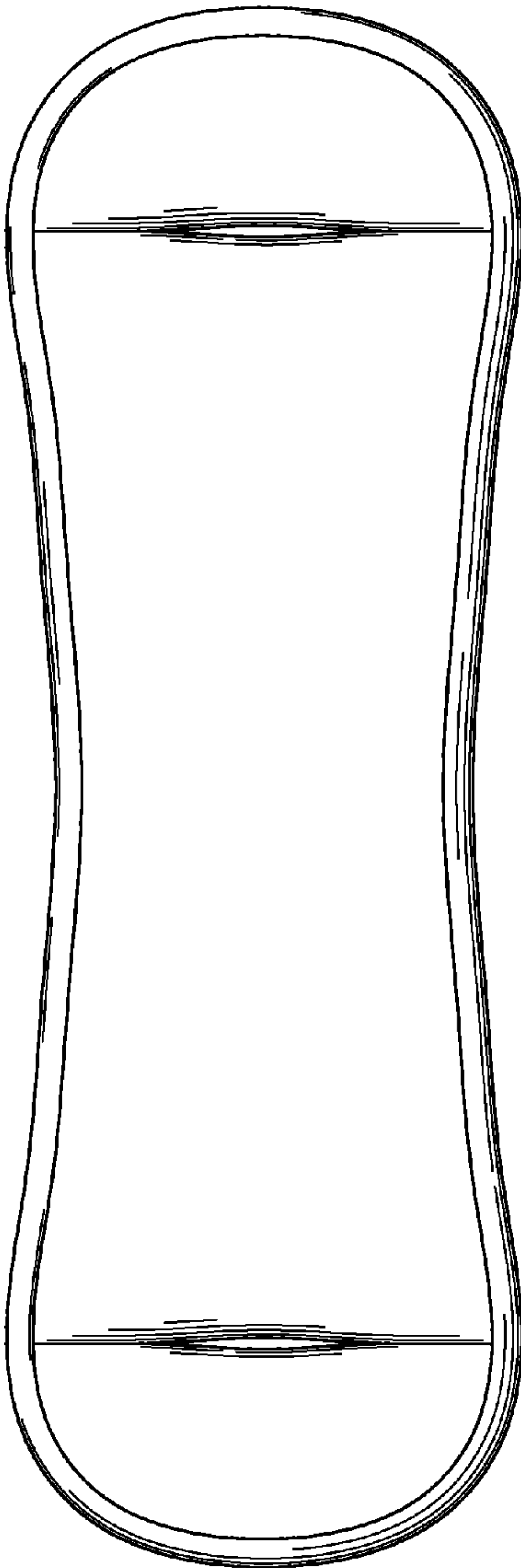
