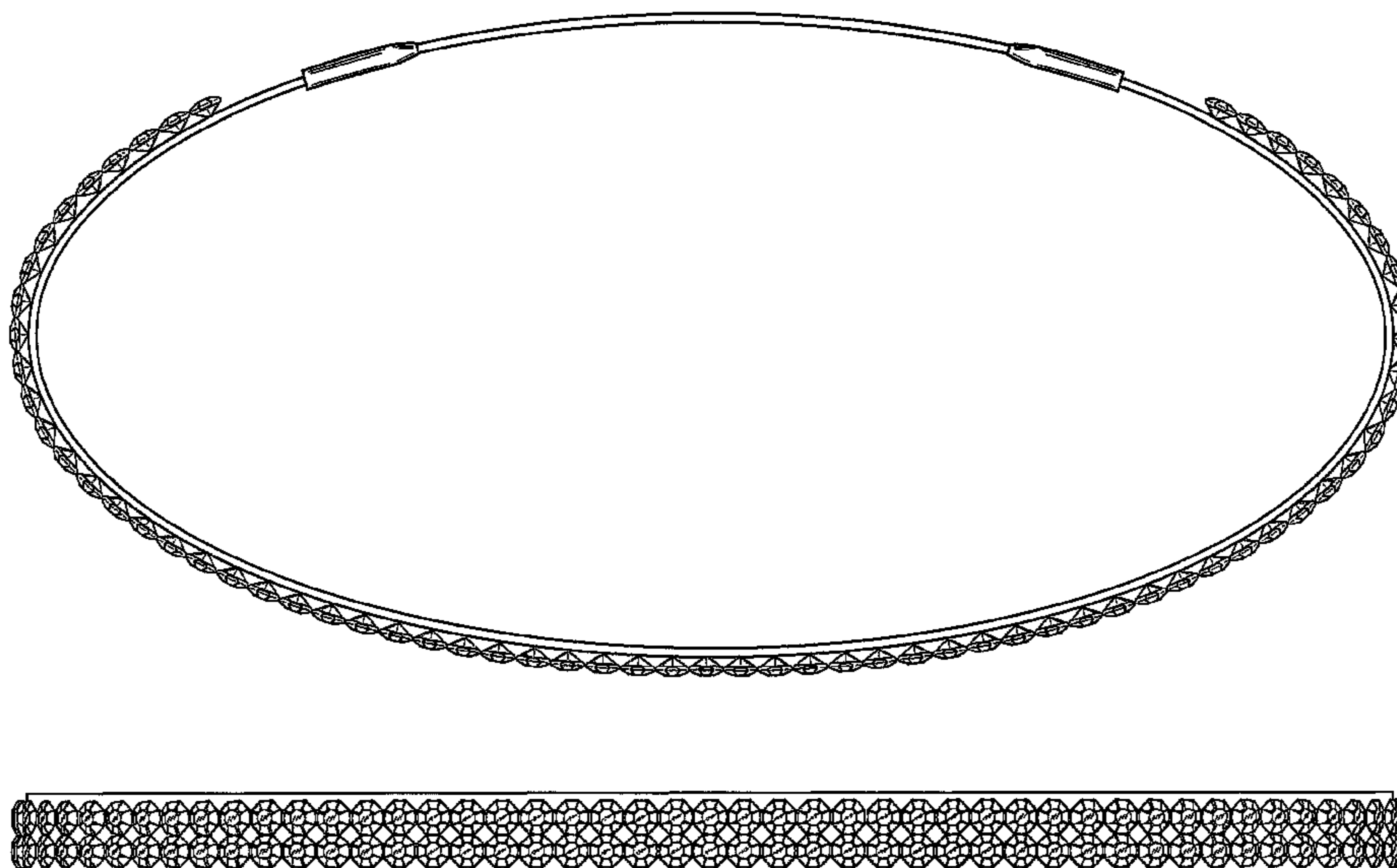

(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a headband, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top view of a first embodiment of a headband, showing my design, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view;
FIG. 5 is a detail front view of a portion thereof;
FIG. 6 is a detail top view of a portion thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front view of a second embodiment of a headband, the top view being the same as FIG. 1, and the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view;
FIG. 8 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view;
FIG. 10 is a detail front view of a portion thereof, the detail top view of a portion thereof being as shown in FIG. 6;
FIG. 11 is a top view of a third embodiment of a headband, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view, the detail top view of a portion thereof being as shown in FIG. 6;
FIG. 12 is a front view thereof, the detail front view of a portion thereof being as shown in FIG. 5;
FIG. 13 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 14 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view;
FIG. 15 is a front view of a fourth embodiment of a headband, the top view being as shown in FIG. 11, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view, the detail top view of a portion thereof being as shown in FIG. 6, the detail front view of a portion thereof being as shown in FIG. 10;
FIG. 16 is a rear view thereof; and,
FIG. 17 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view.
Portions of the headband are shown separated and bound by a bracket to show indeterminate length.

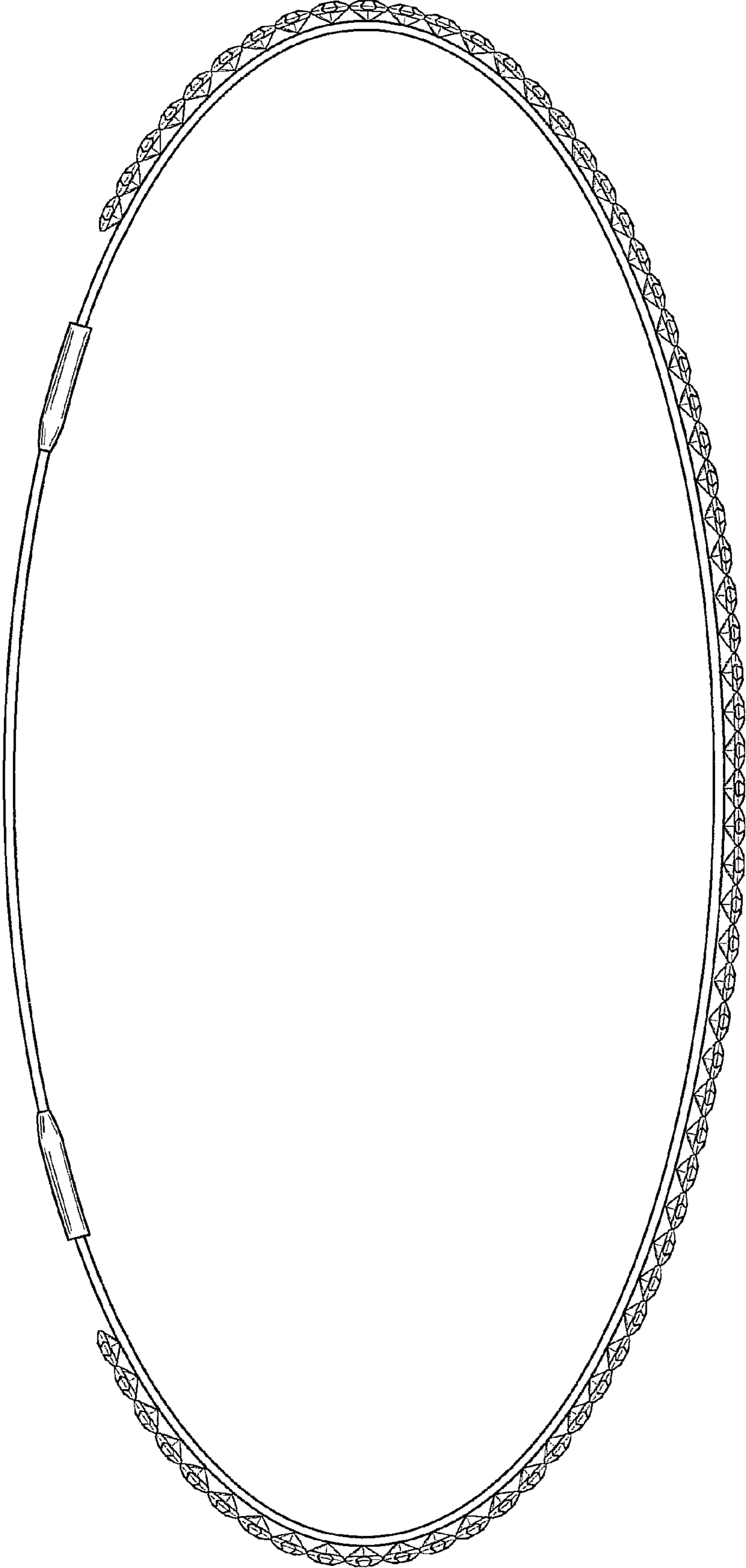

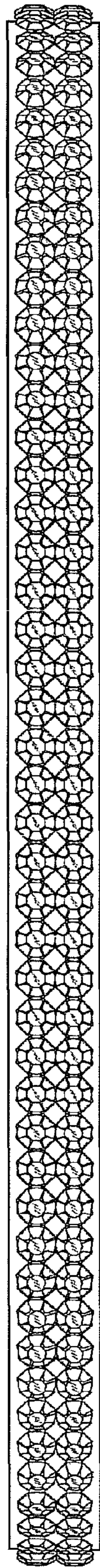

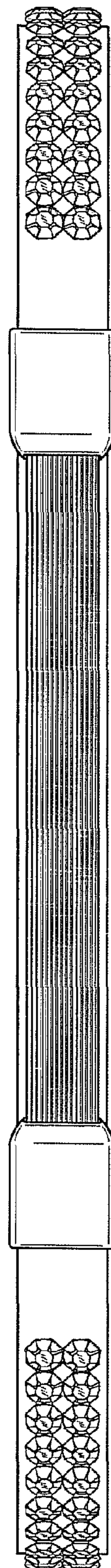

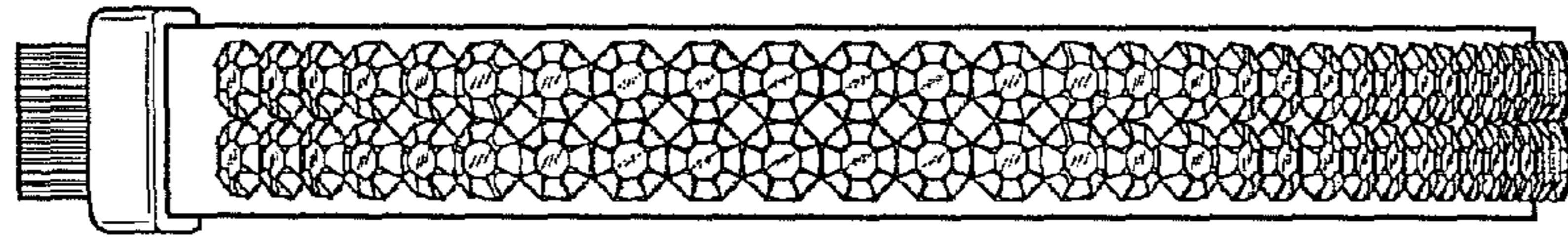

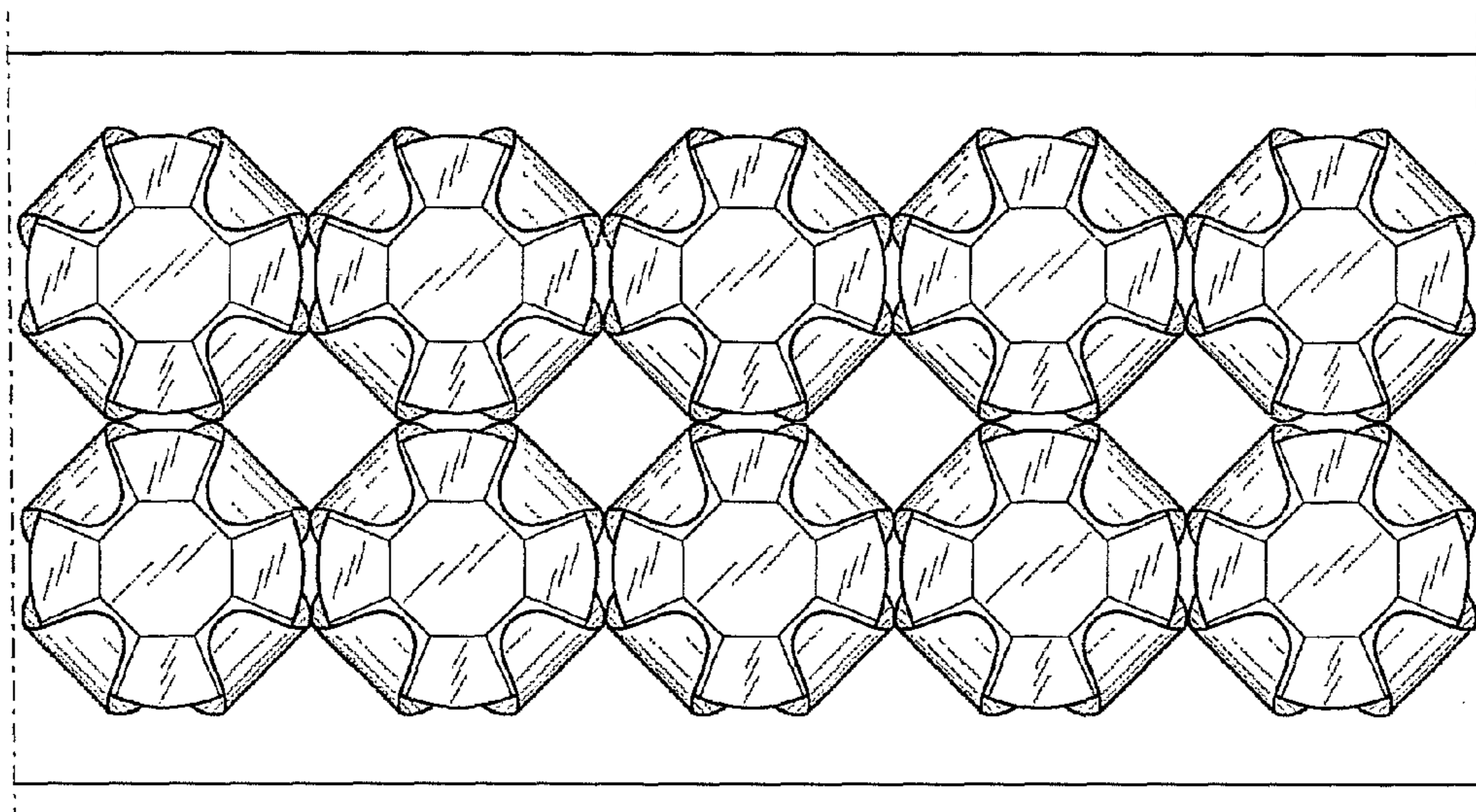

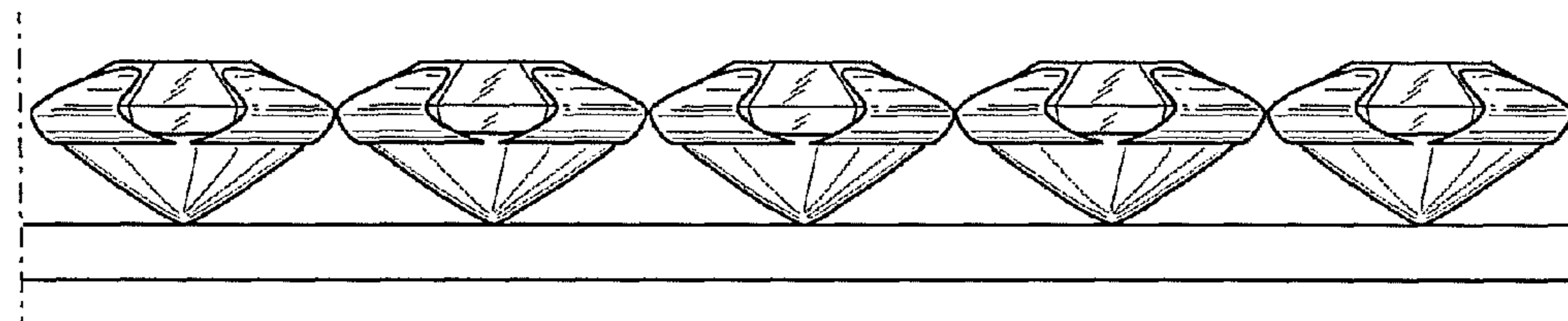

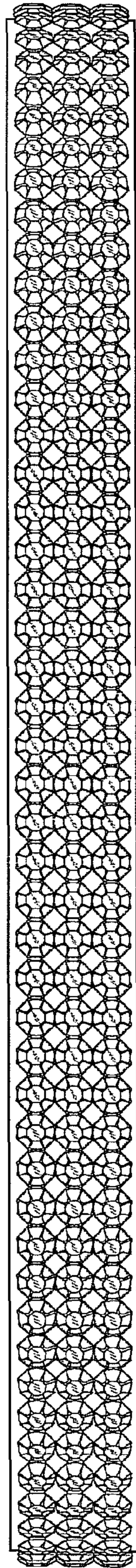

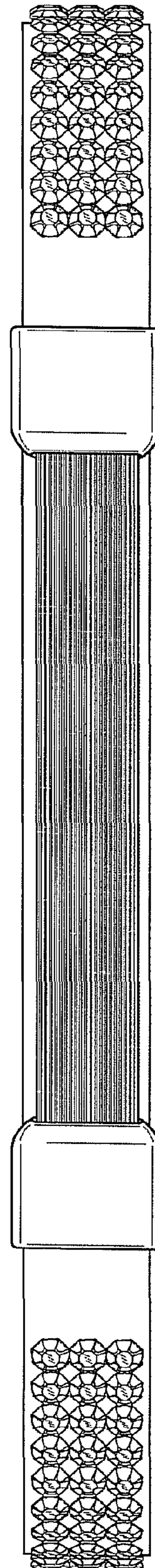

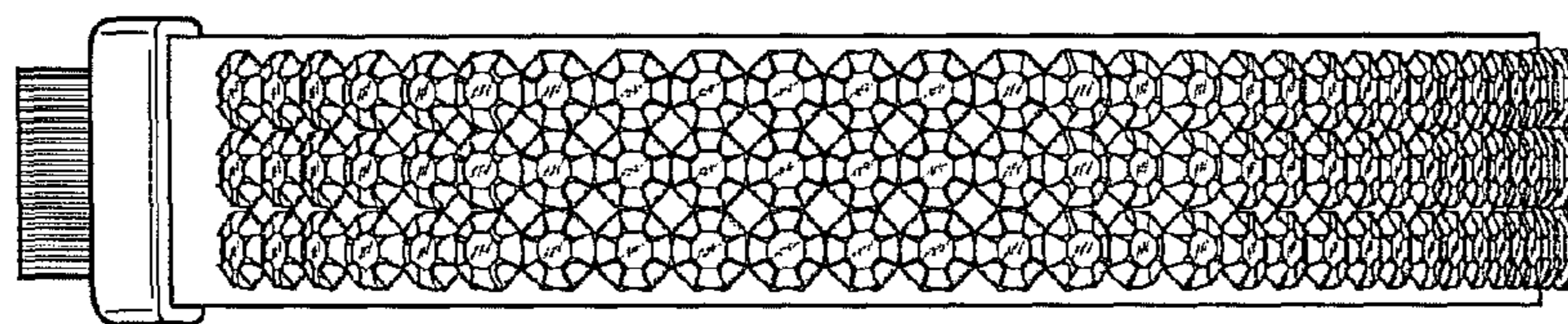

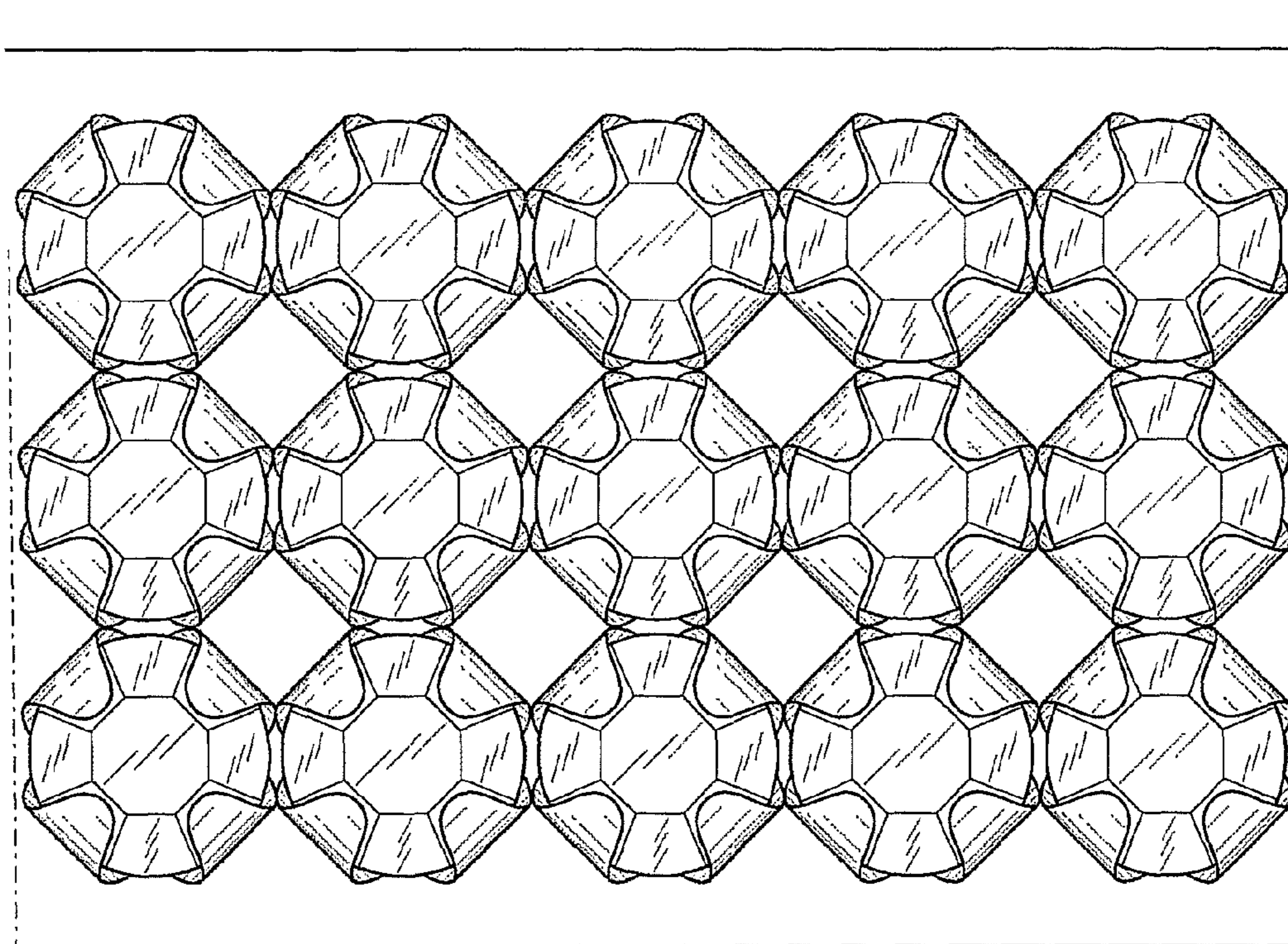

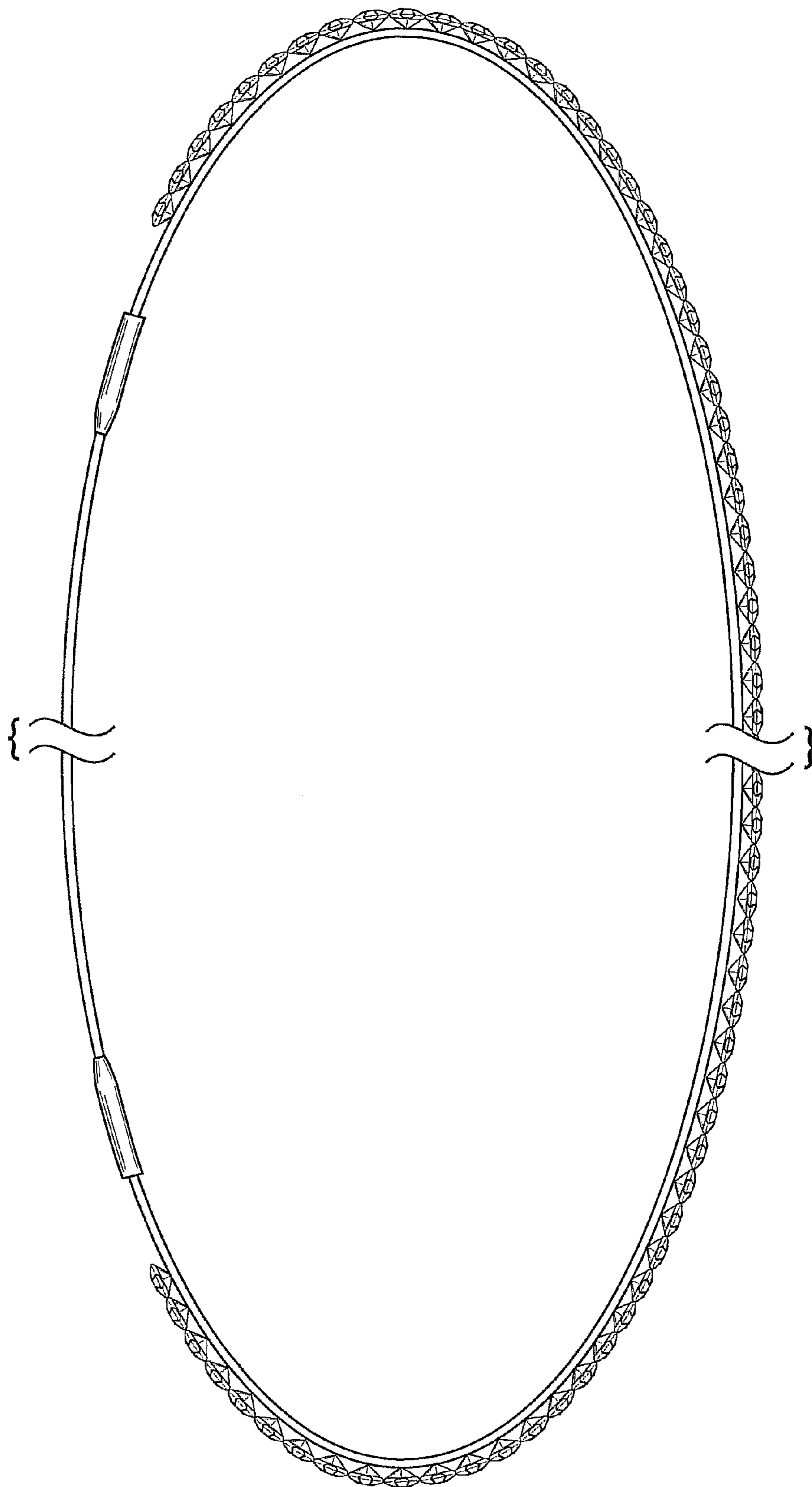

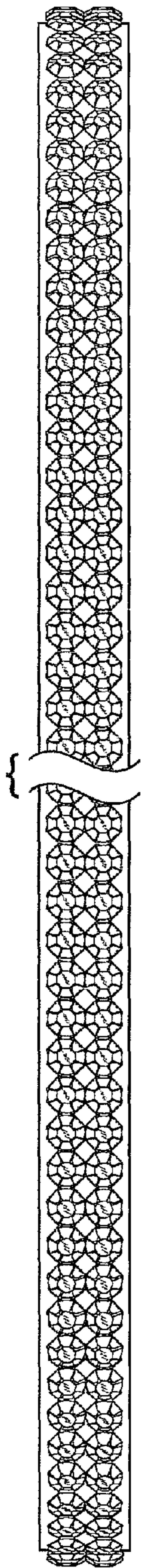

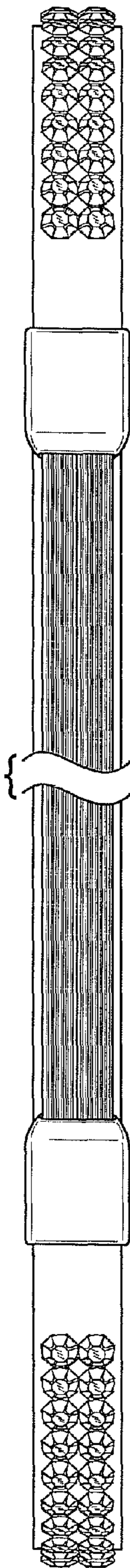

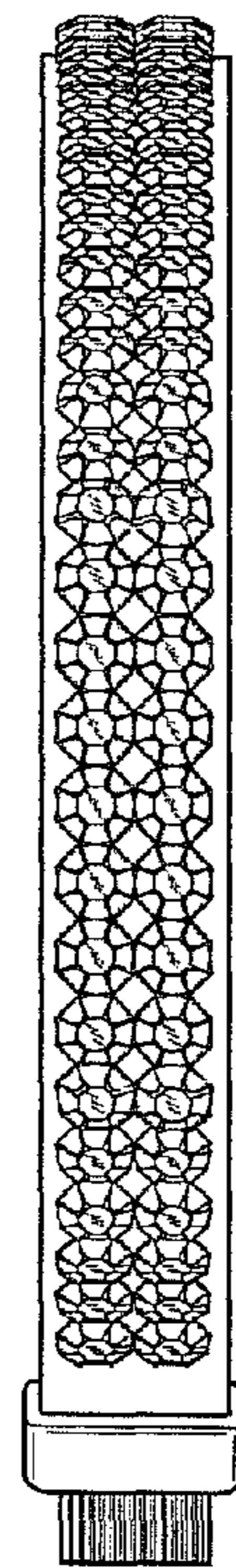

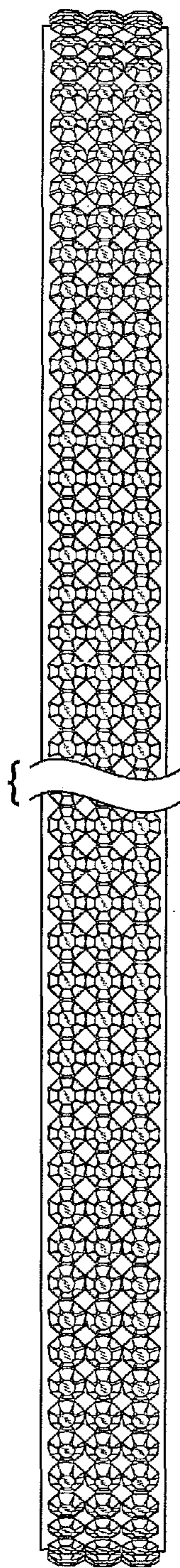

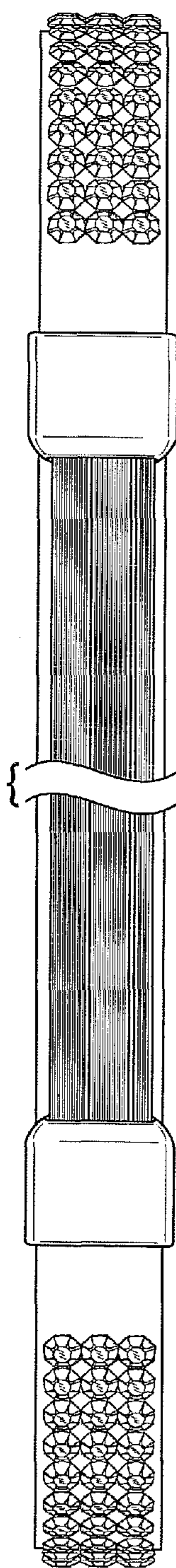

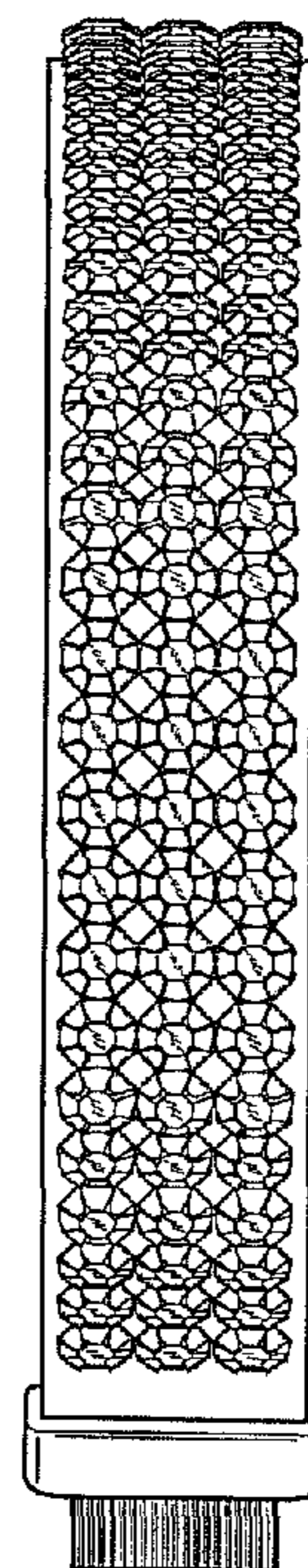
