(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a mask for the administration of inhaled medication, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1. Perspective view of the front of the mask, viewed from the top left.

FIG. 2. Perspective view of the rear of the mask, viewed from the top right.

FIG. 3. An elevation view of the front of the mask.

FIG. 4. An elevation view of the left side of the mask. An elevation of the right side would be an identical mirror image.

FIG. 5. An elevation view of the top of the mask; and,

FIG. 6. An elevation view of the bottom of the of the mask.

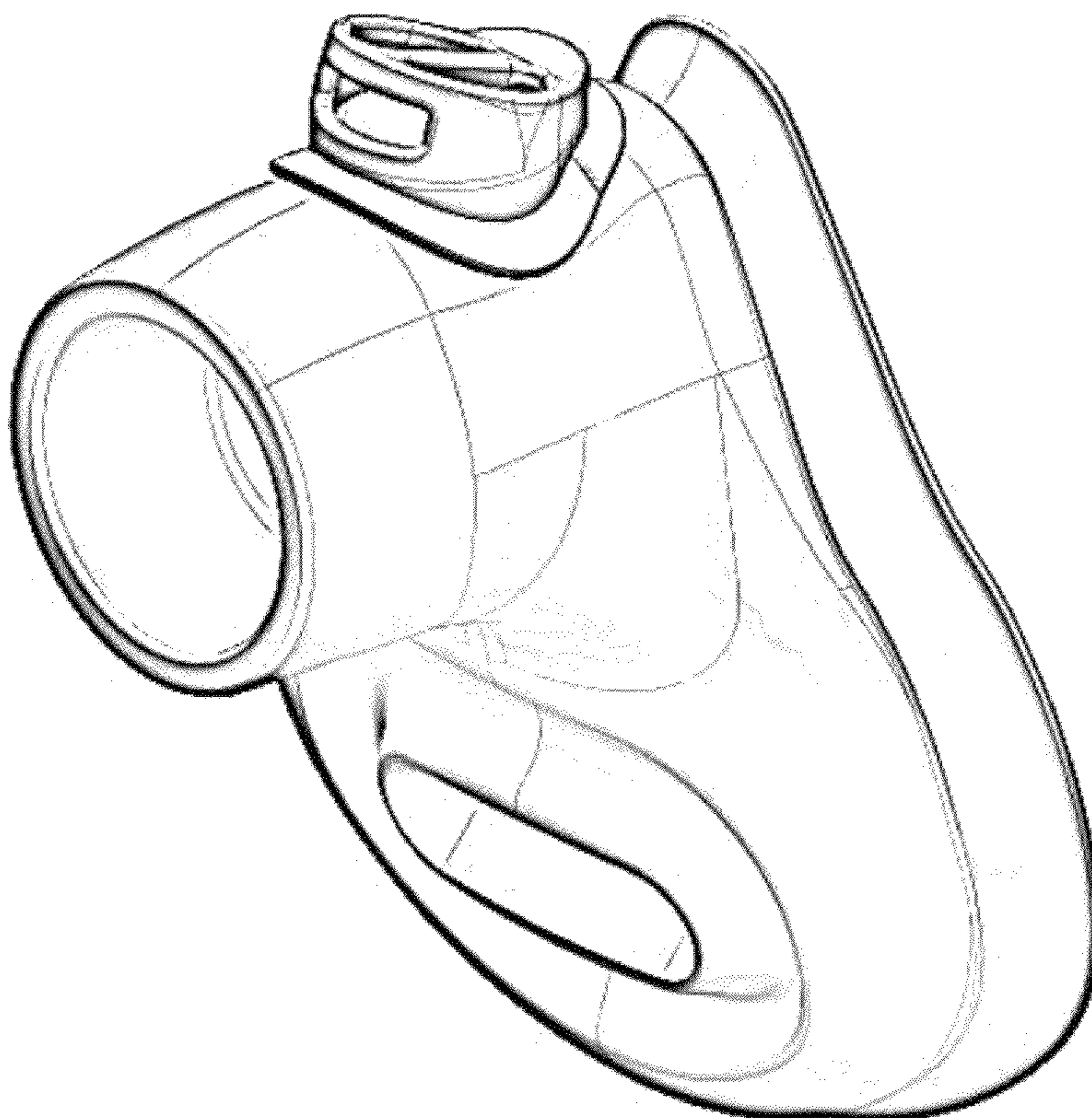

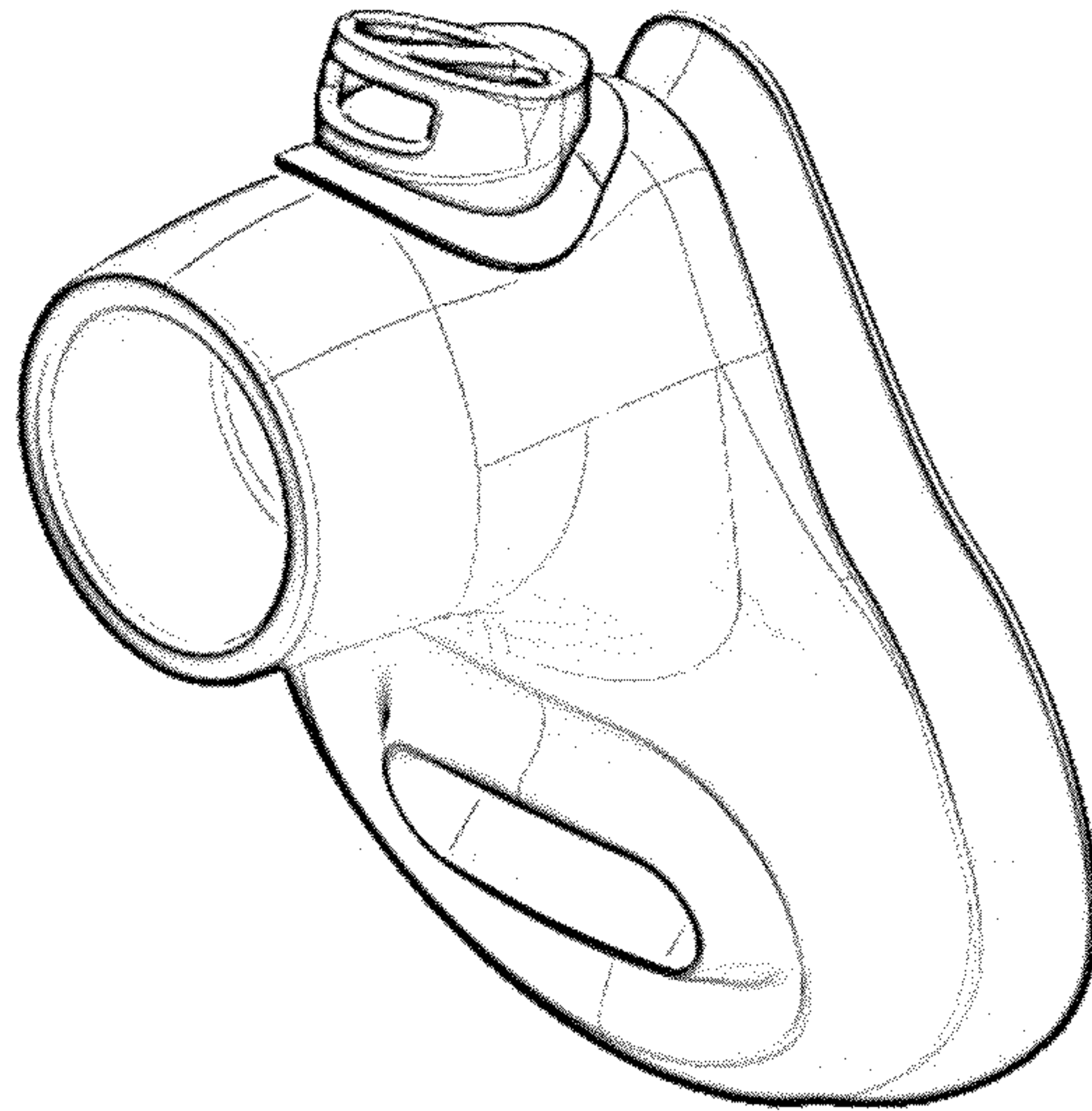

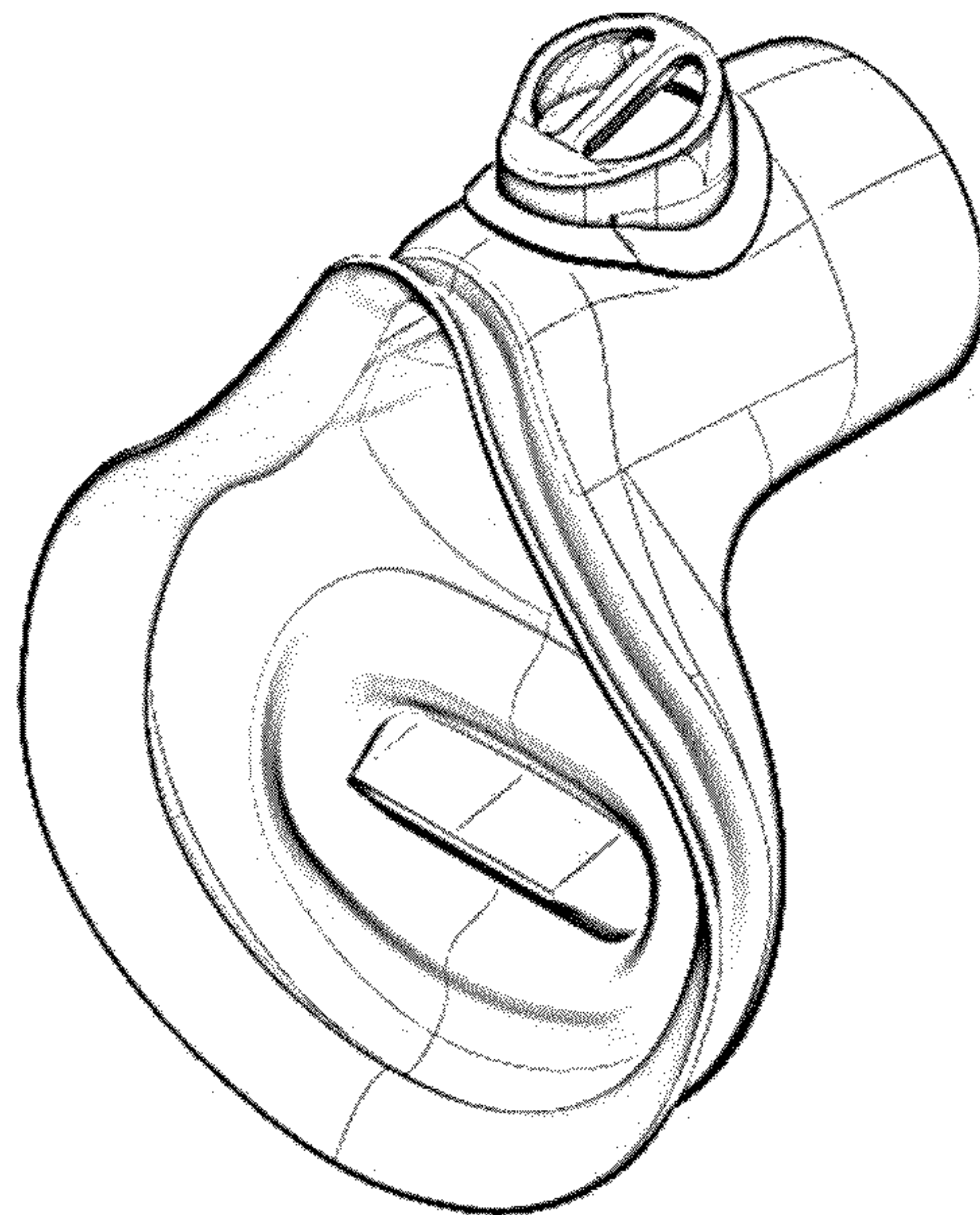

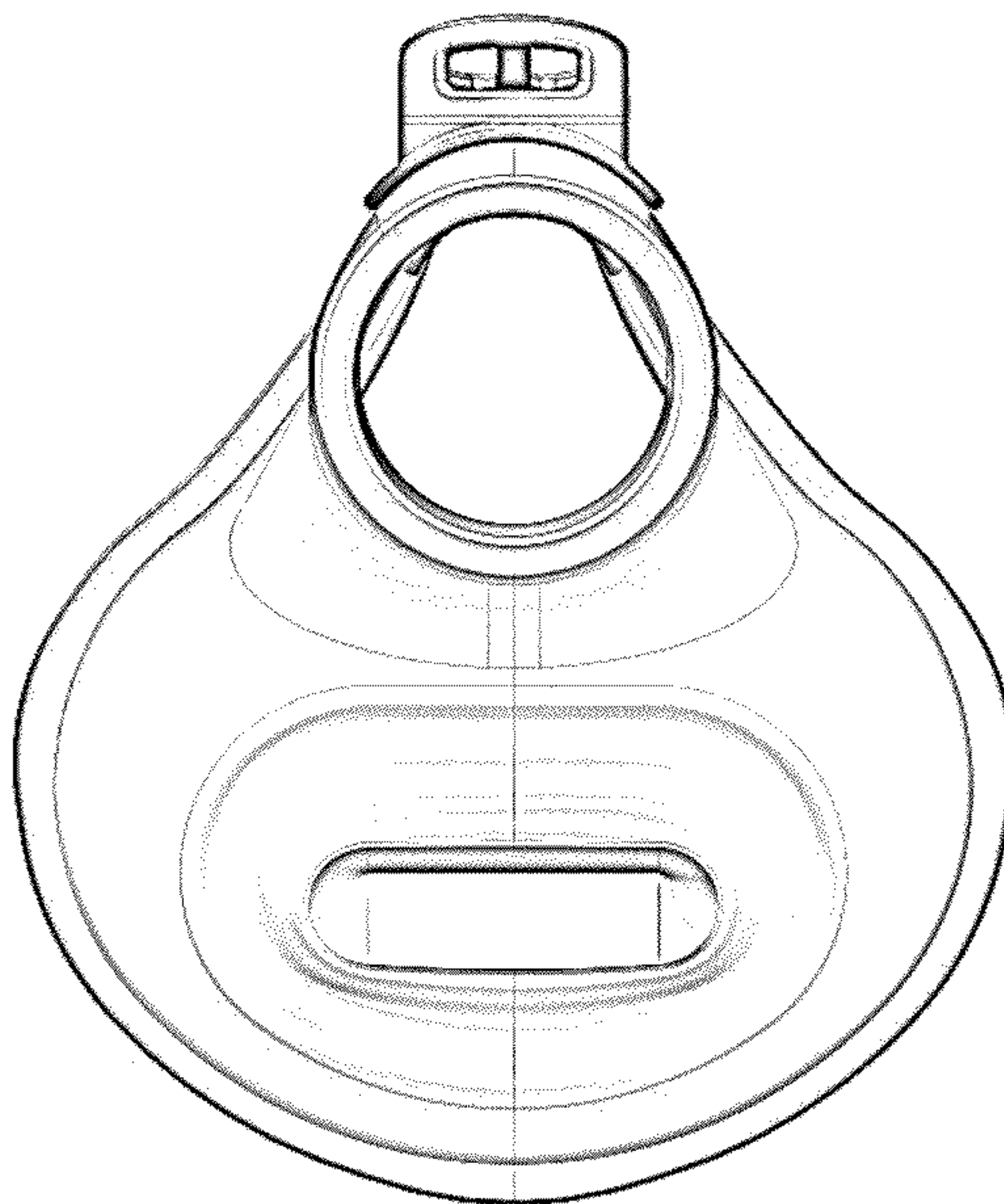

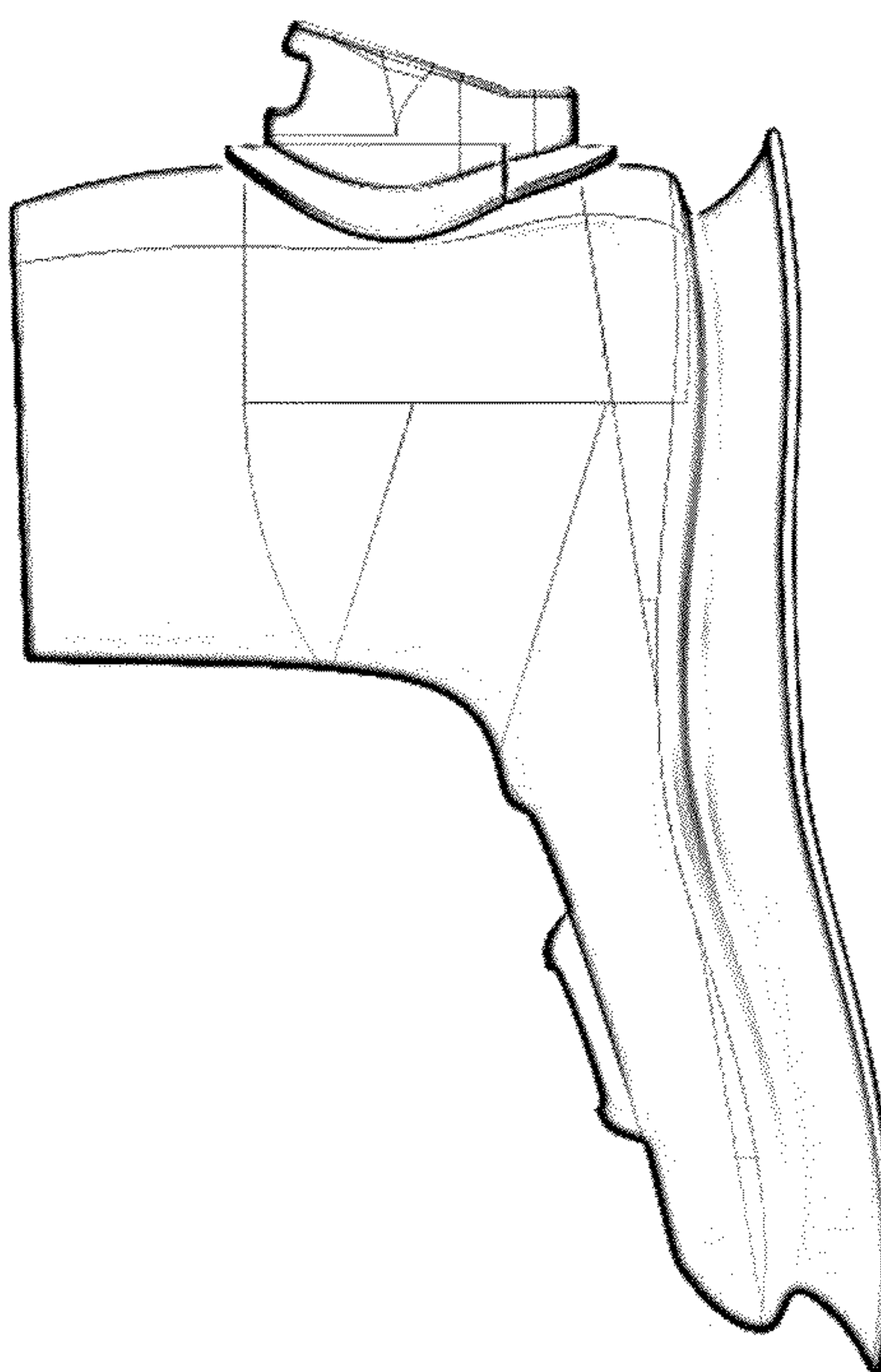

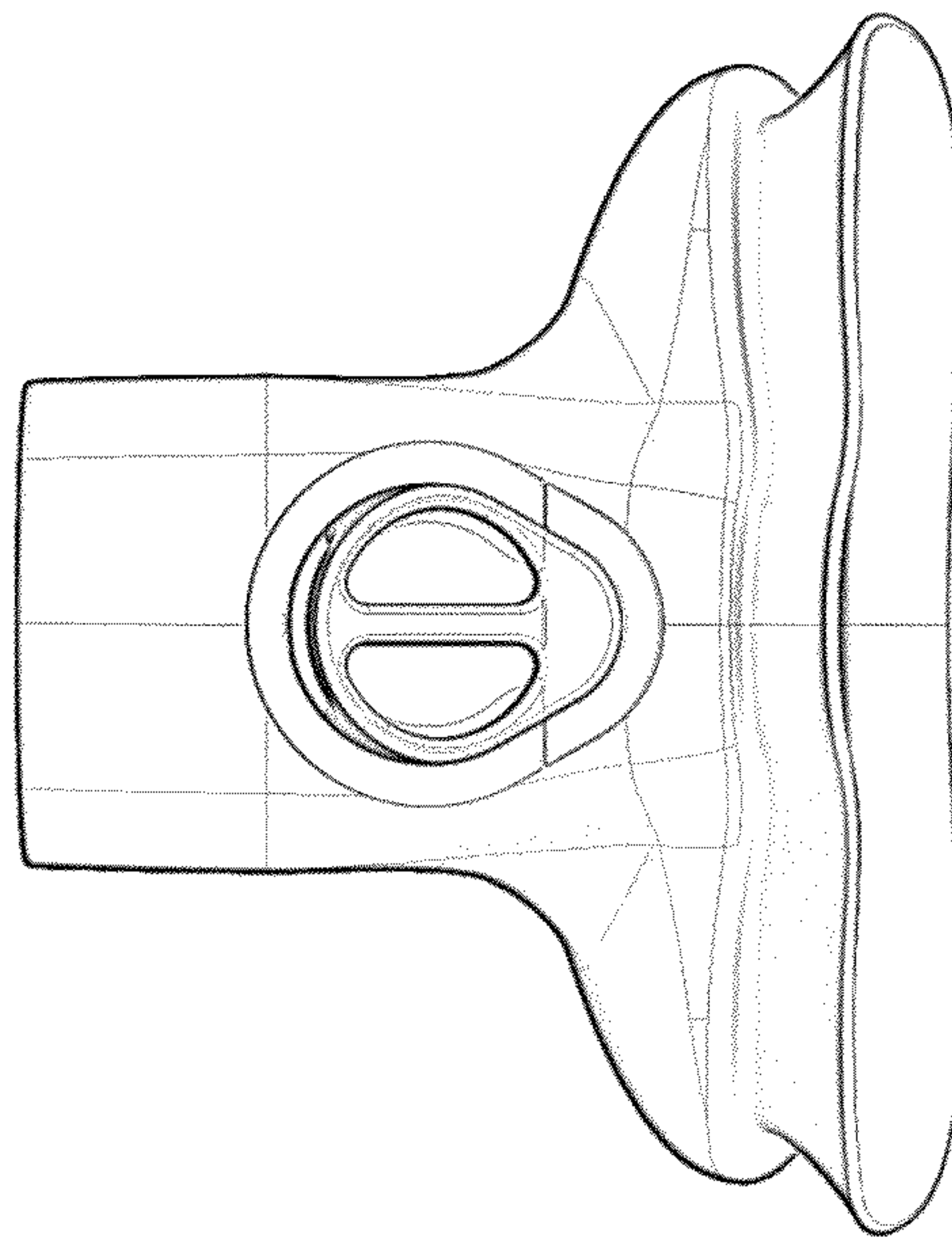
