FIG. 8 is an elevational right view of the computer mouse design of FIG. 1.

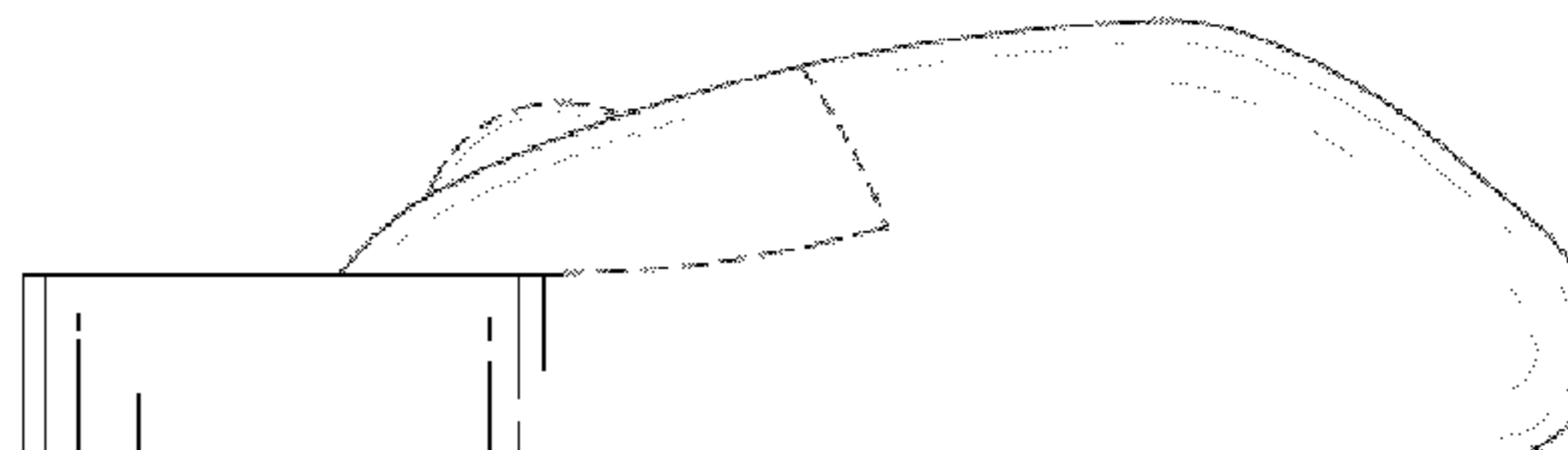
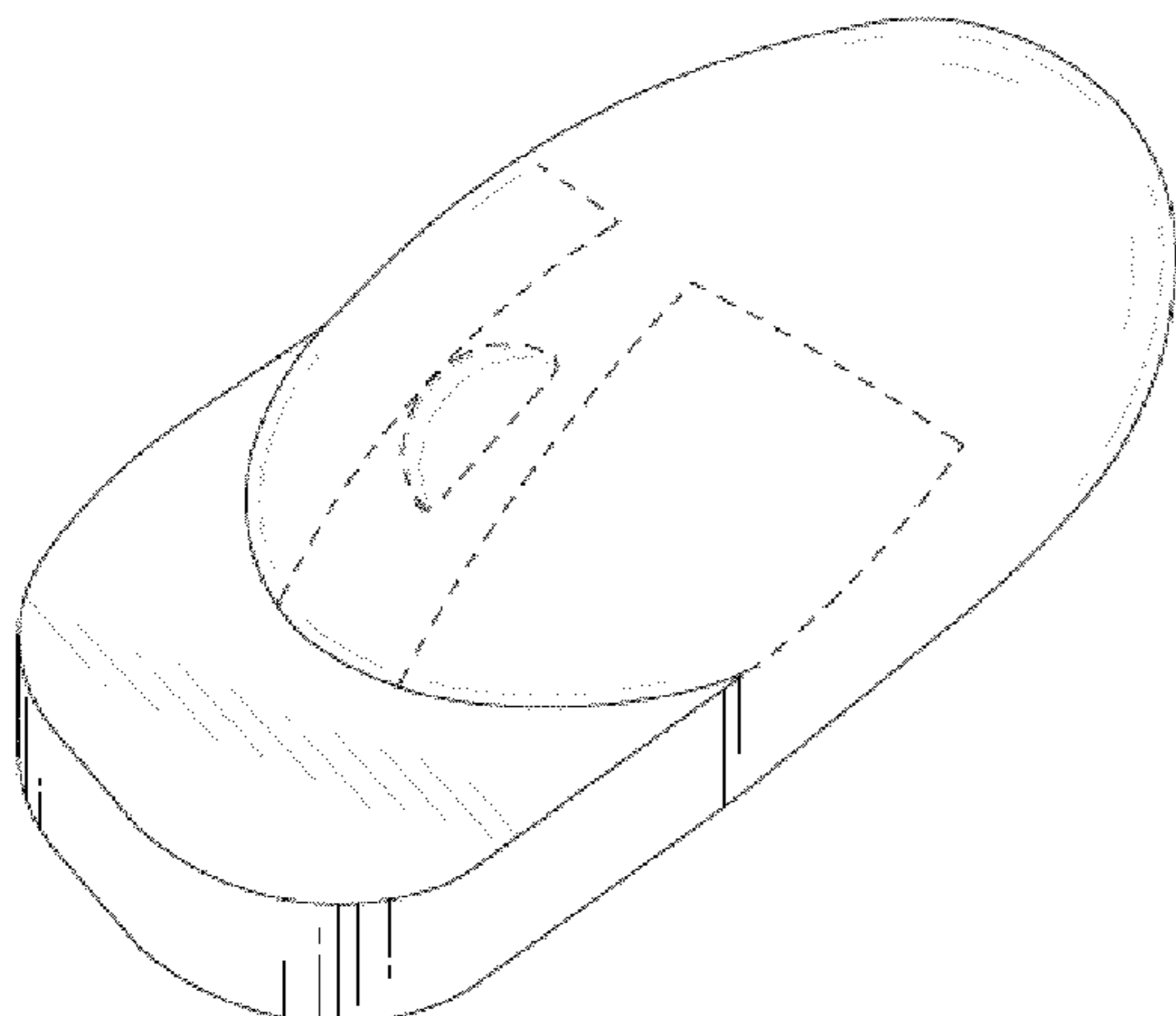

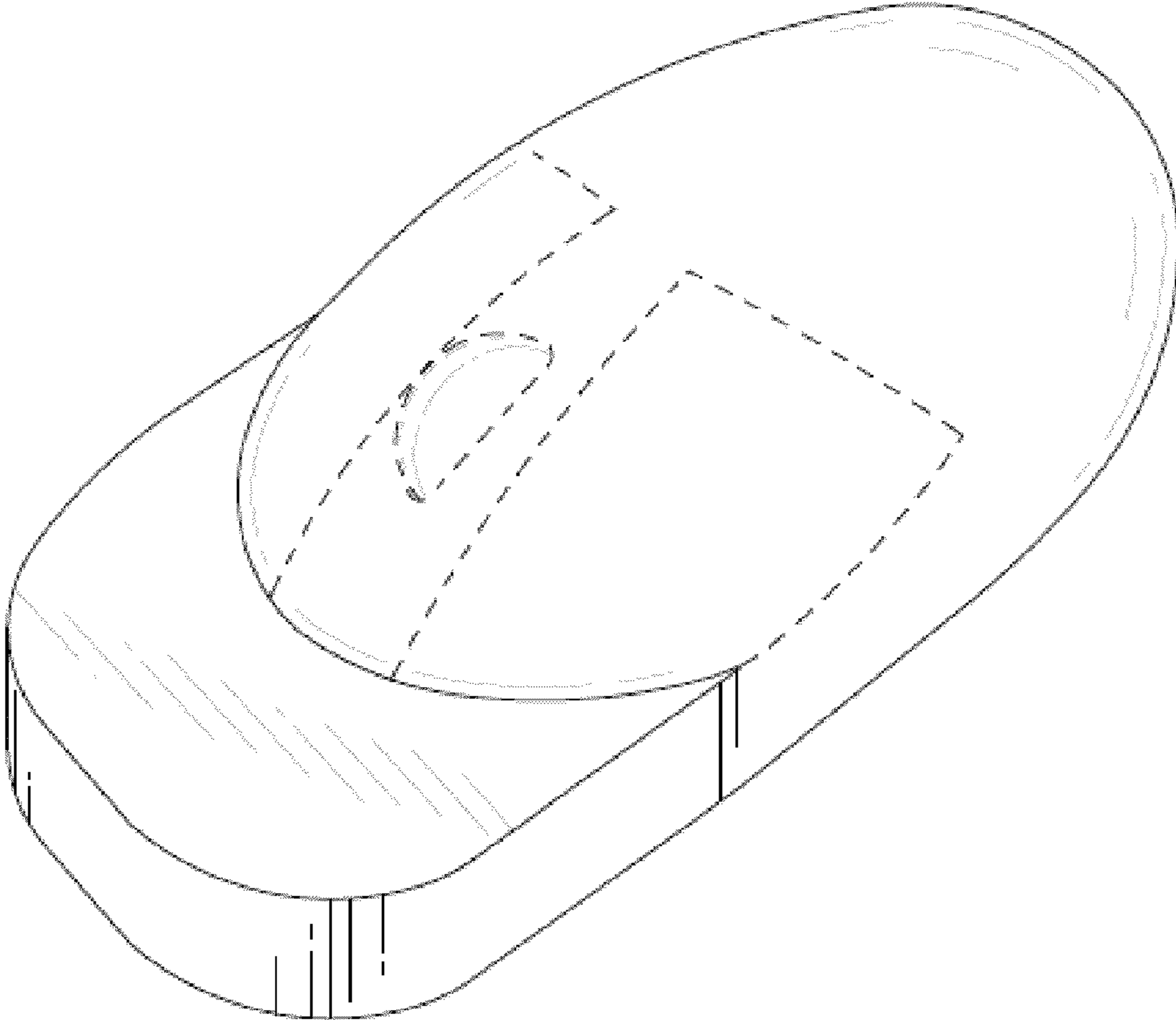

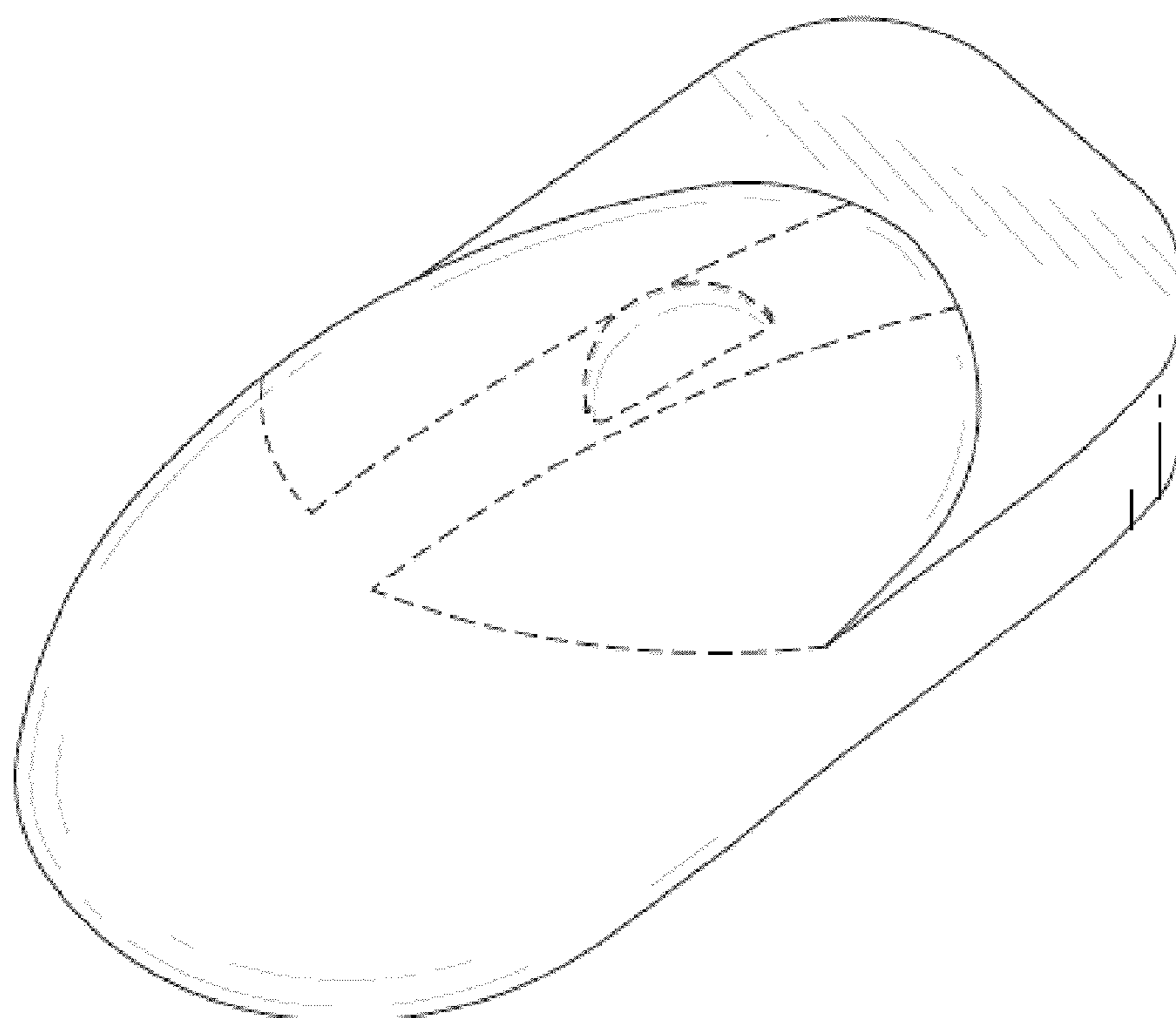

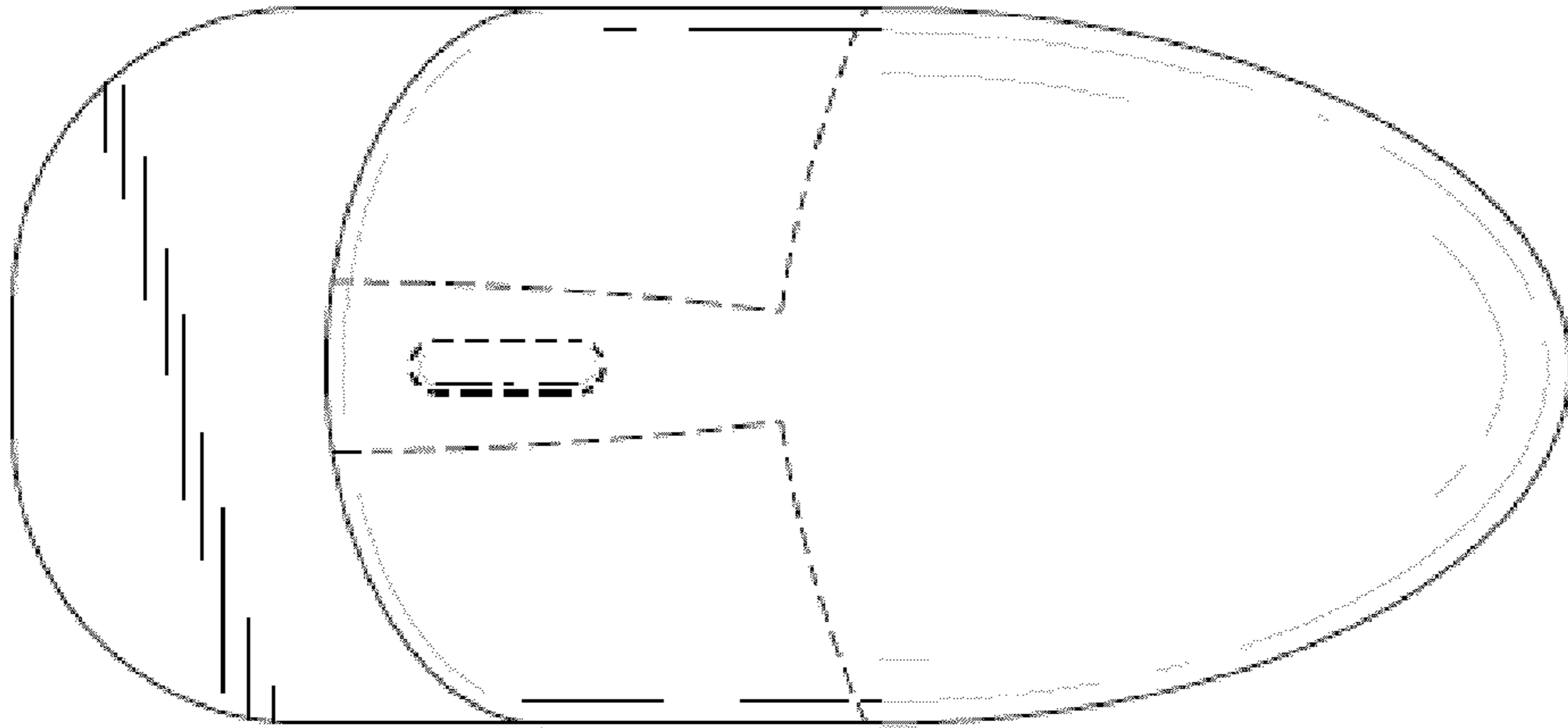

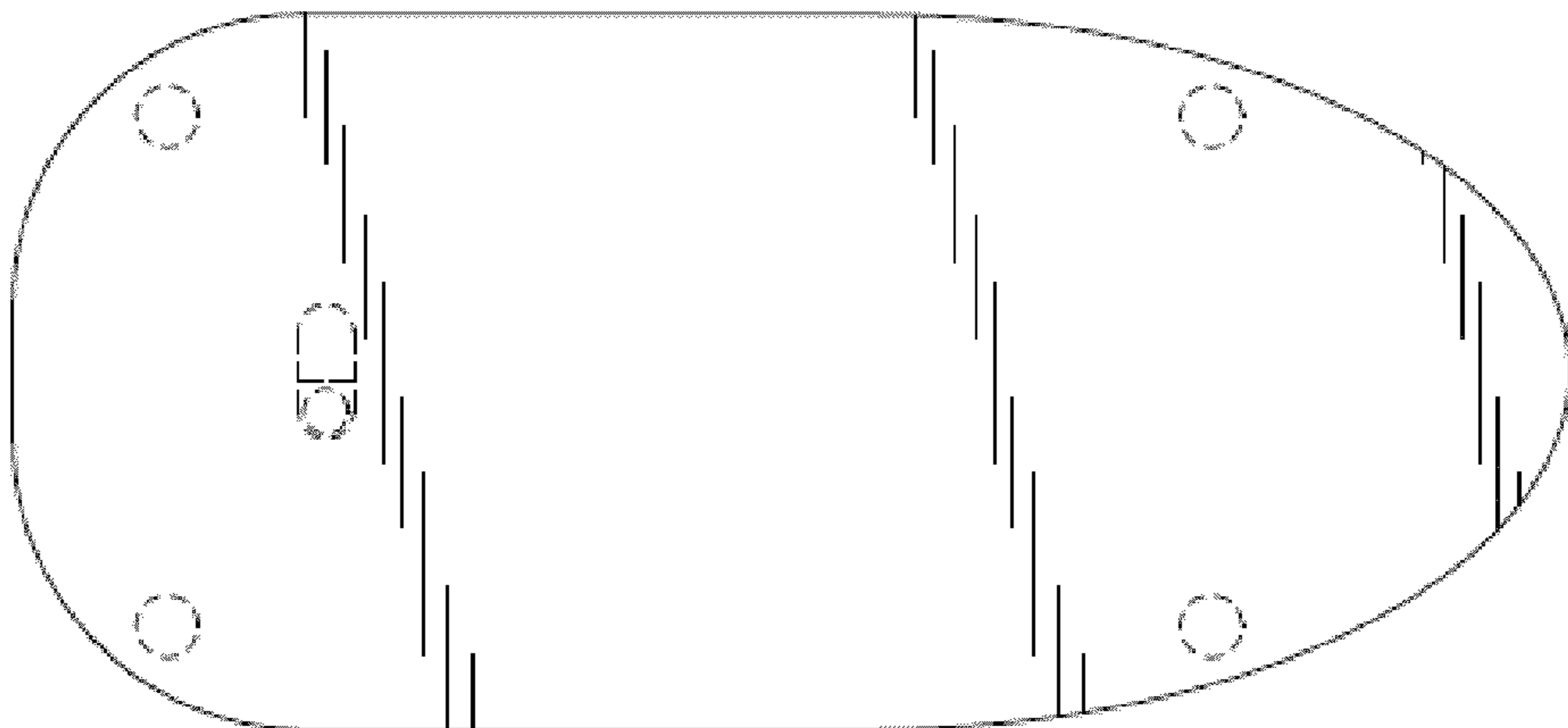

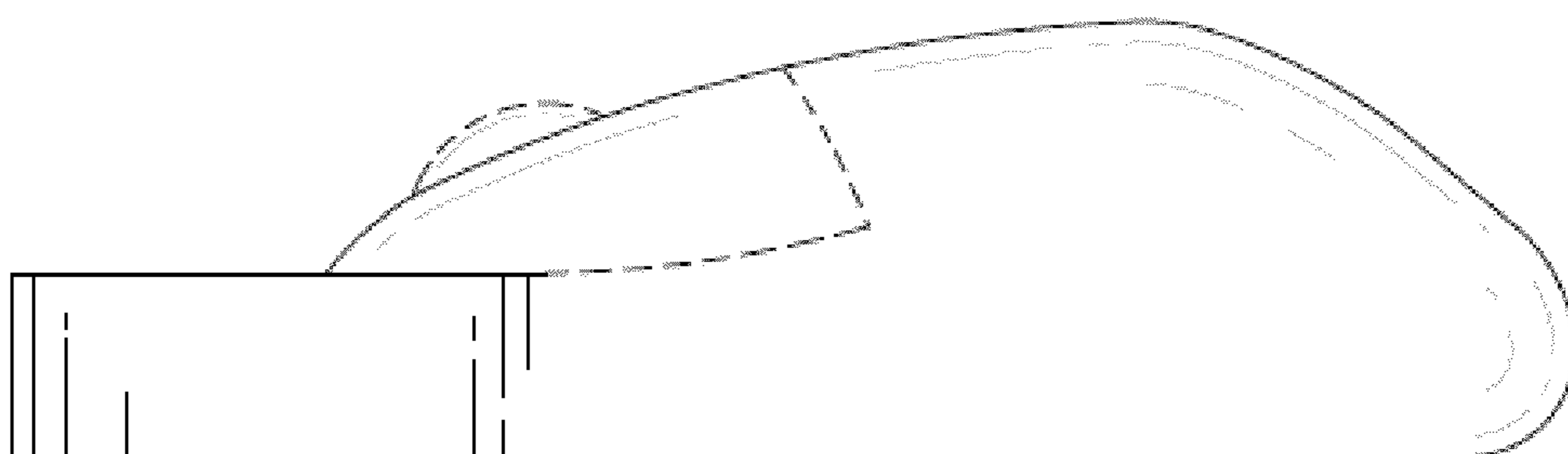

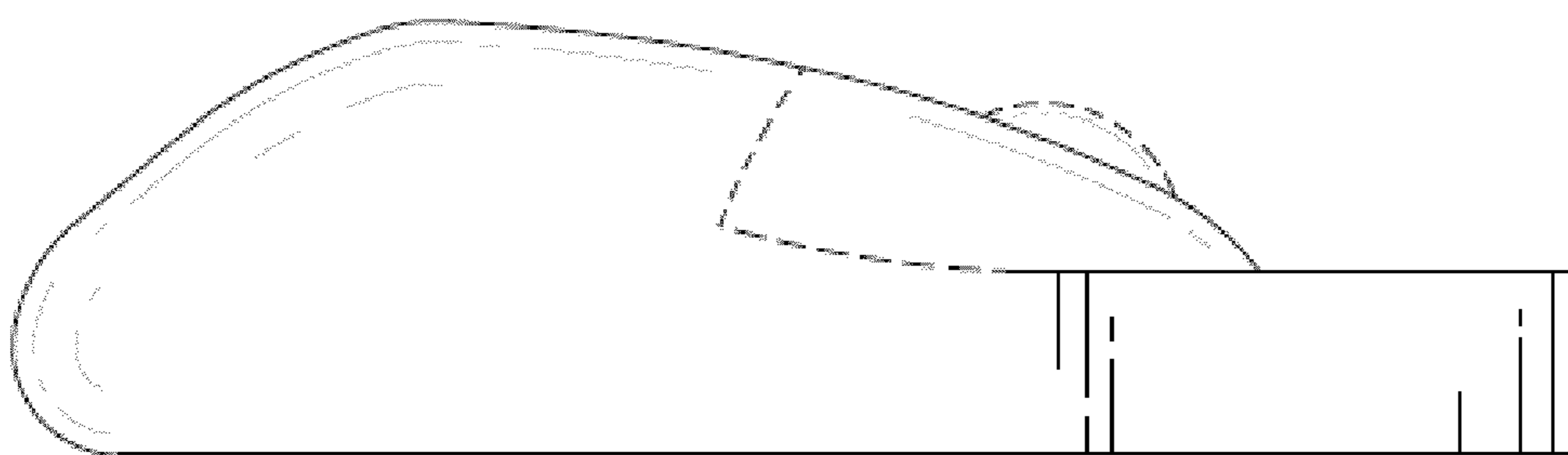

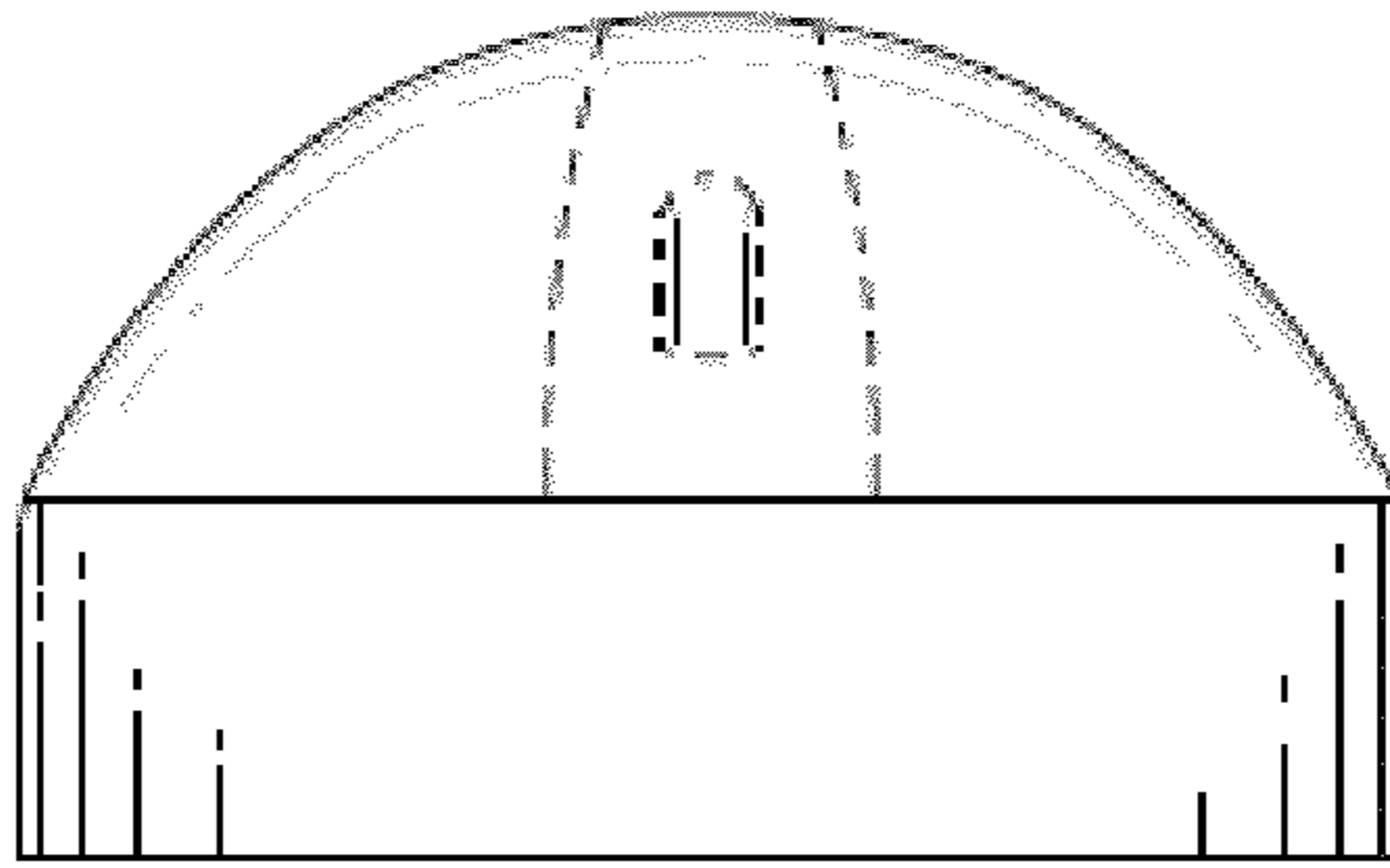

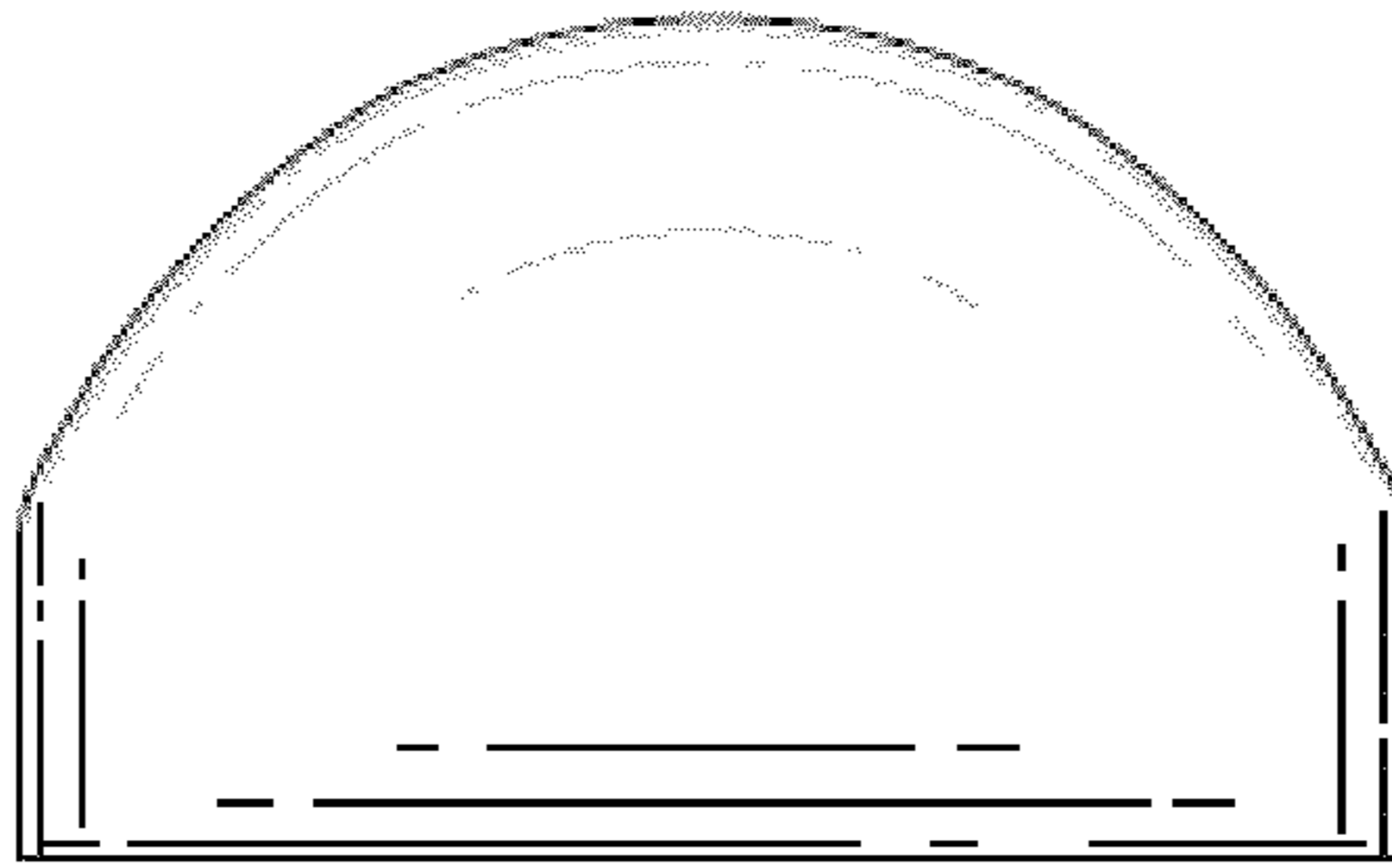
