(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pressed coin pendant, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the pressed coin pendant showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the pressed coin pendant of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a back view of the pressed coin pendant of FIG. 1.

FIG. 12 is an opposite side view of the pressed coin pendant of FIG. 8.

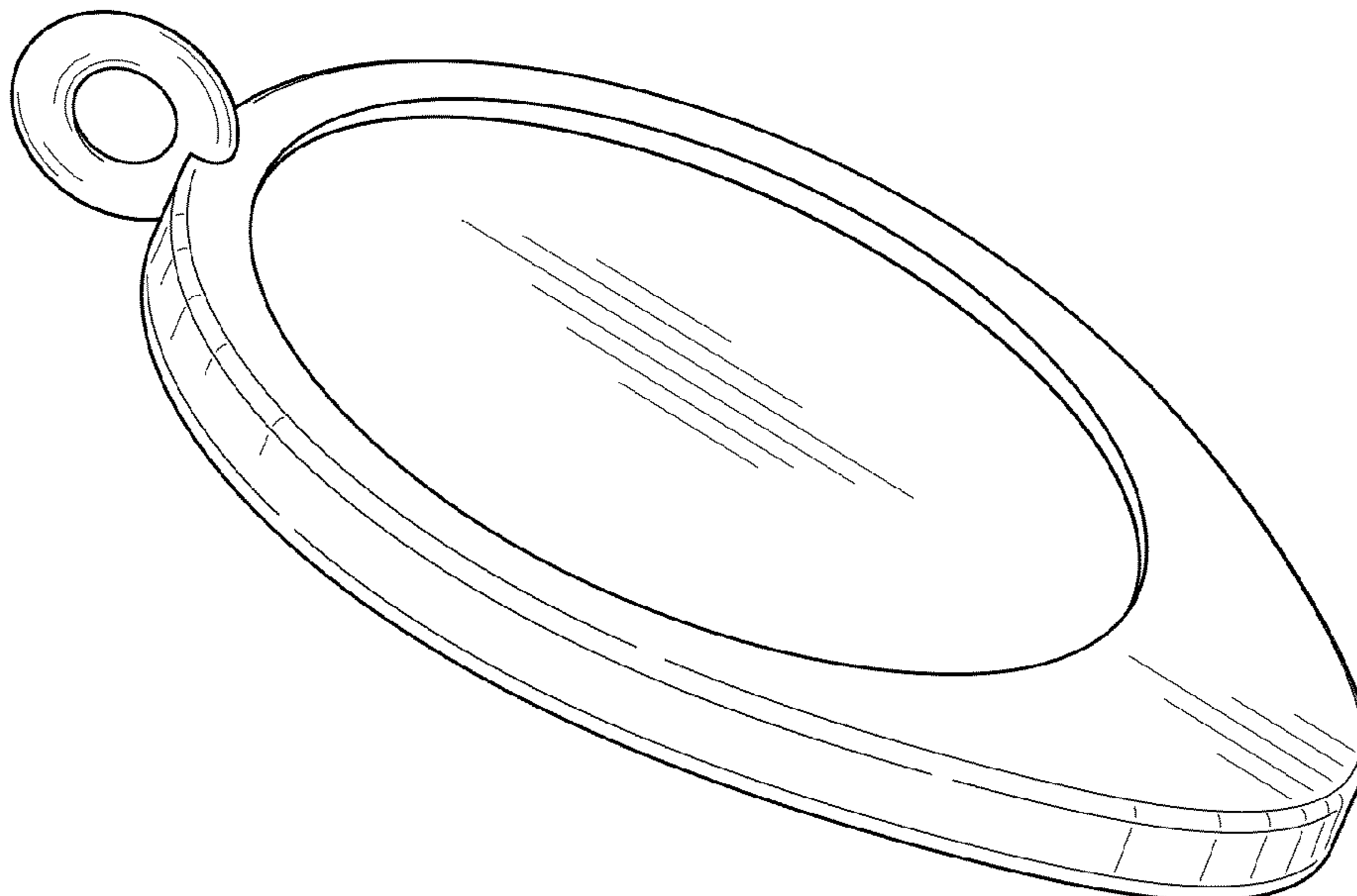
FIG. 13 is a top view of the pressed coin pendant of FIG. 8;

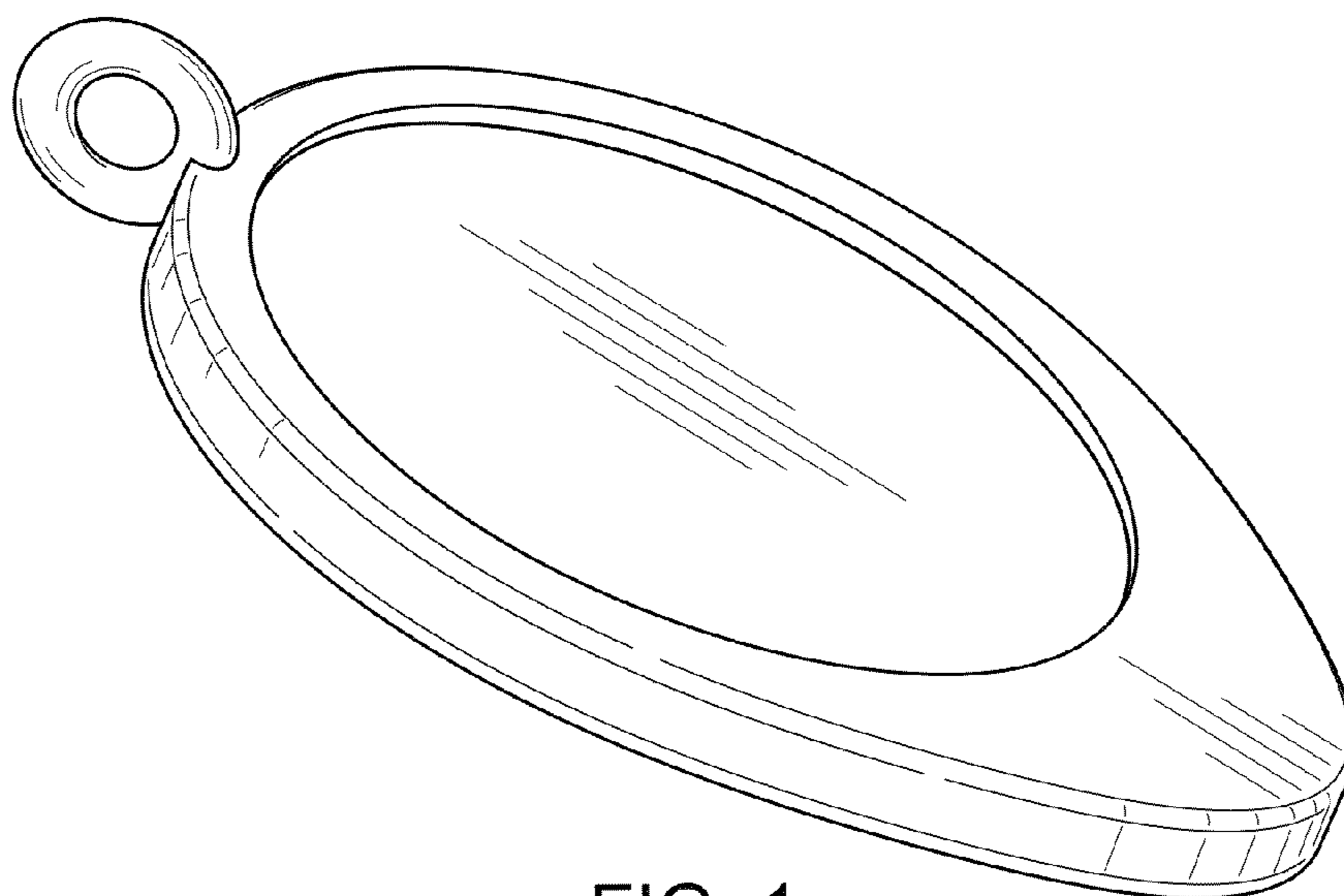

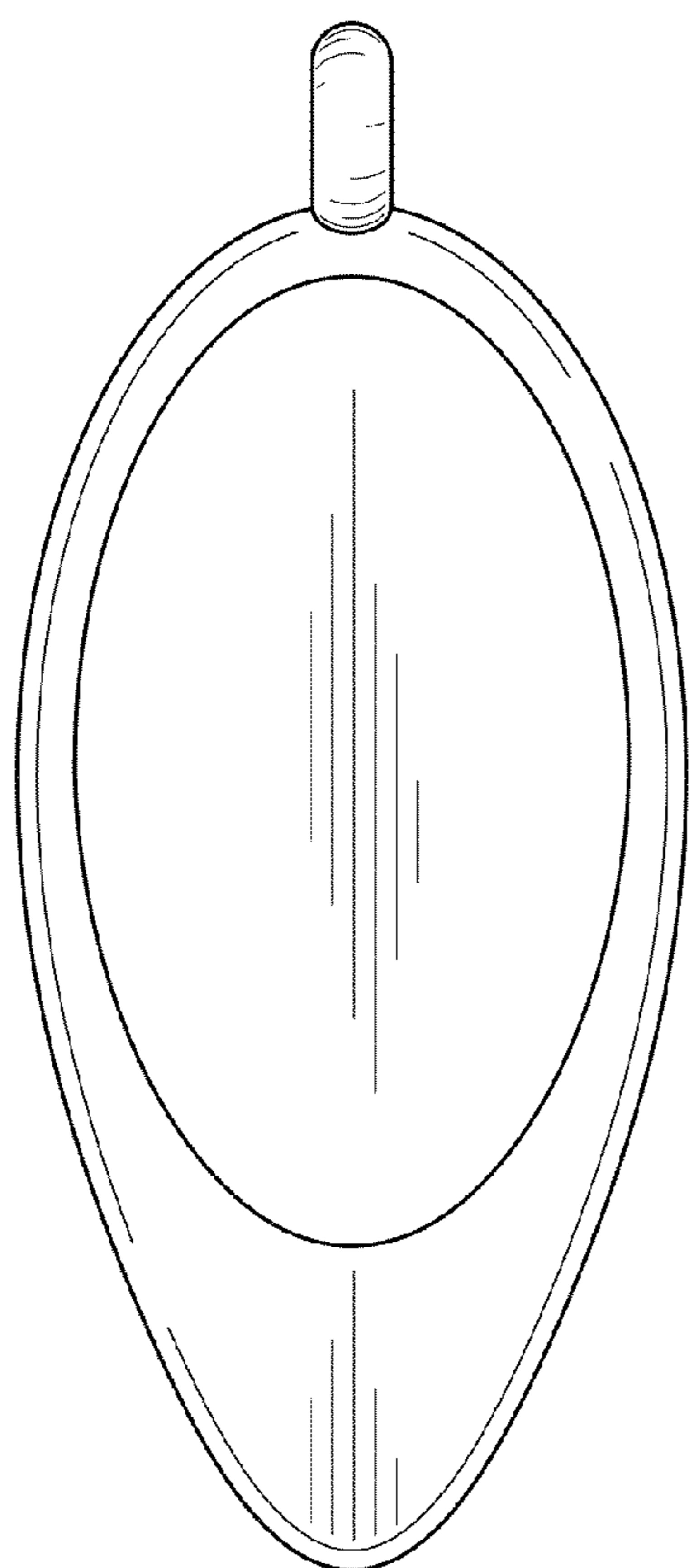

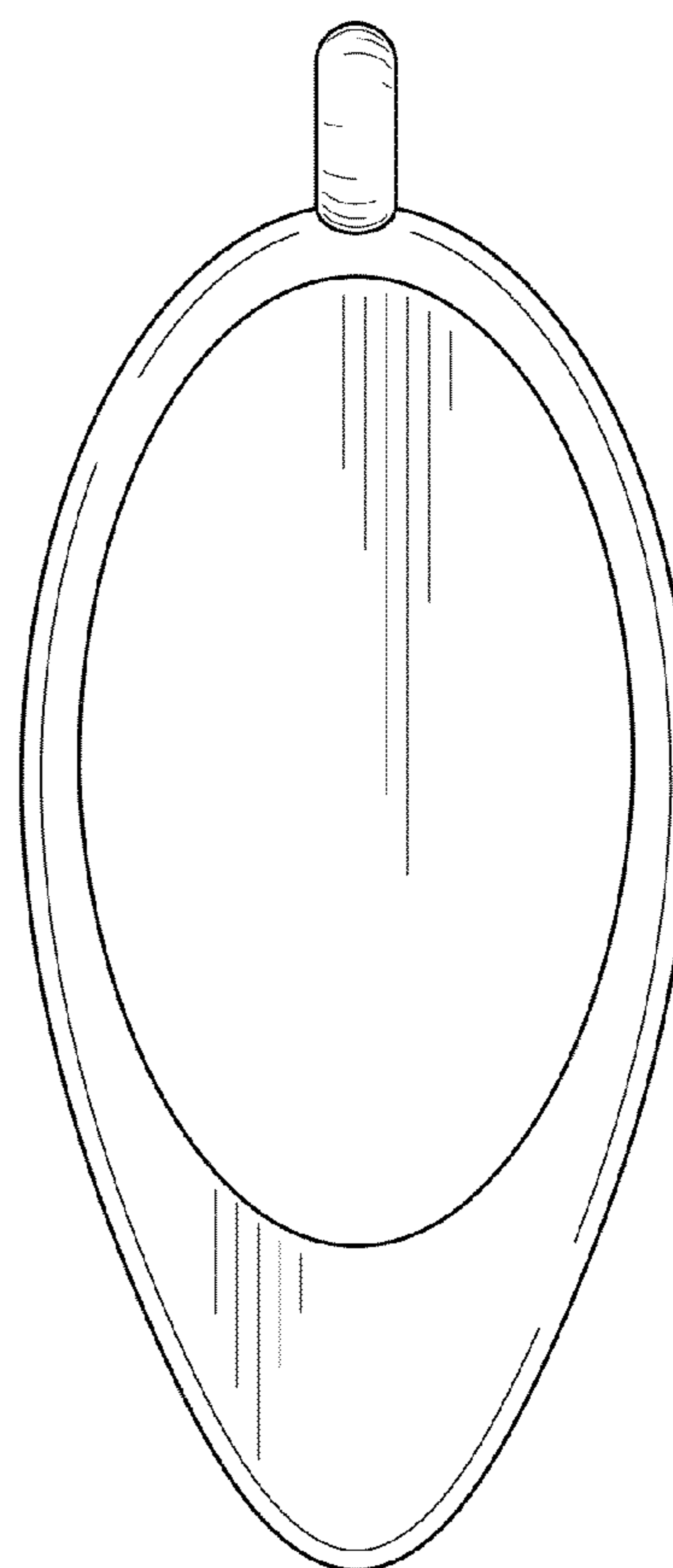

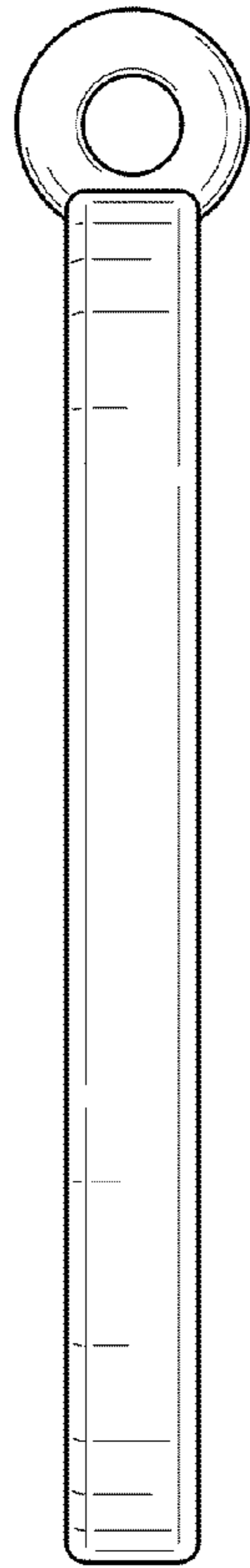

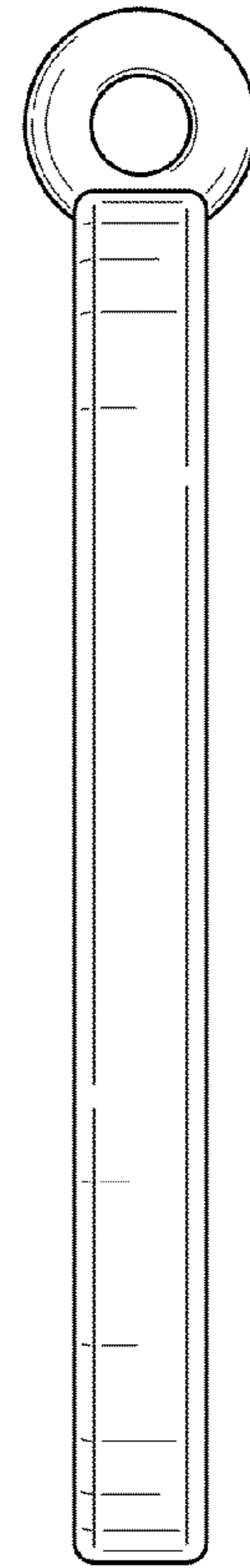

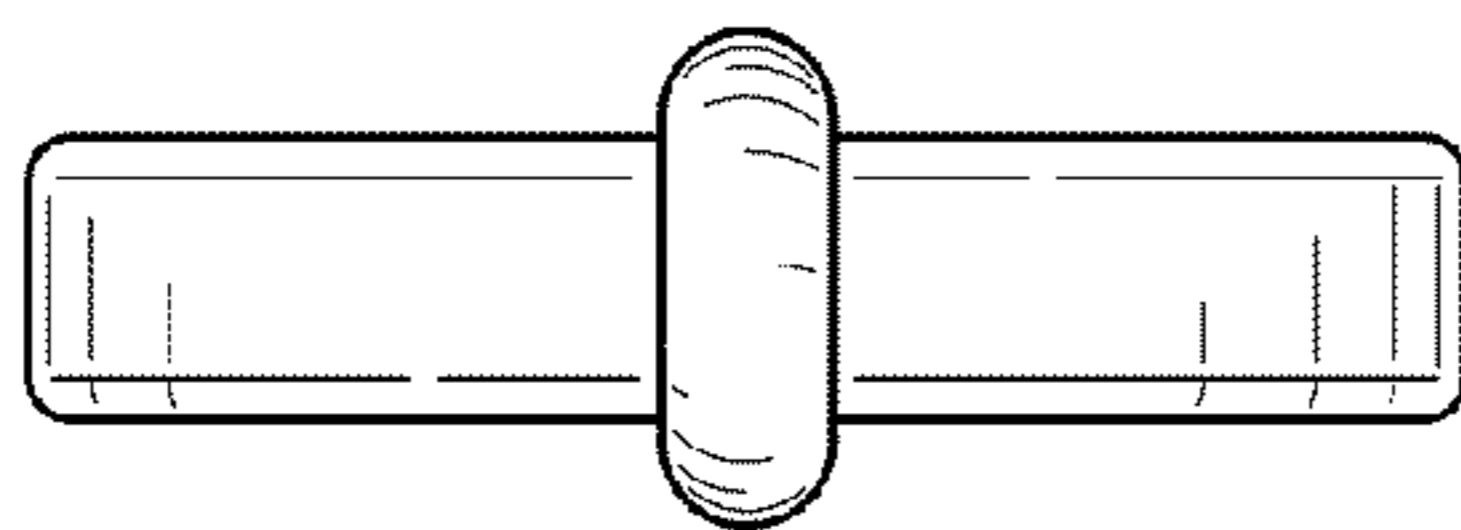

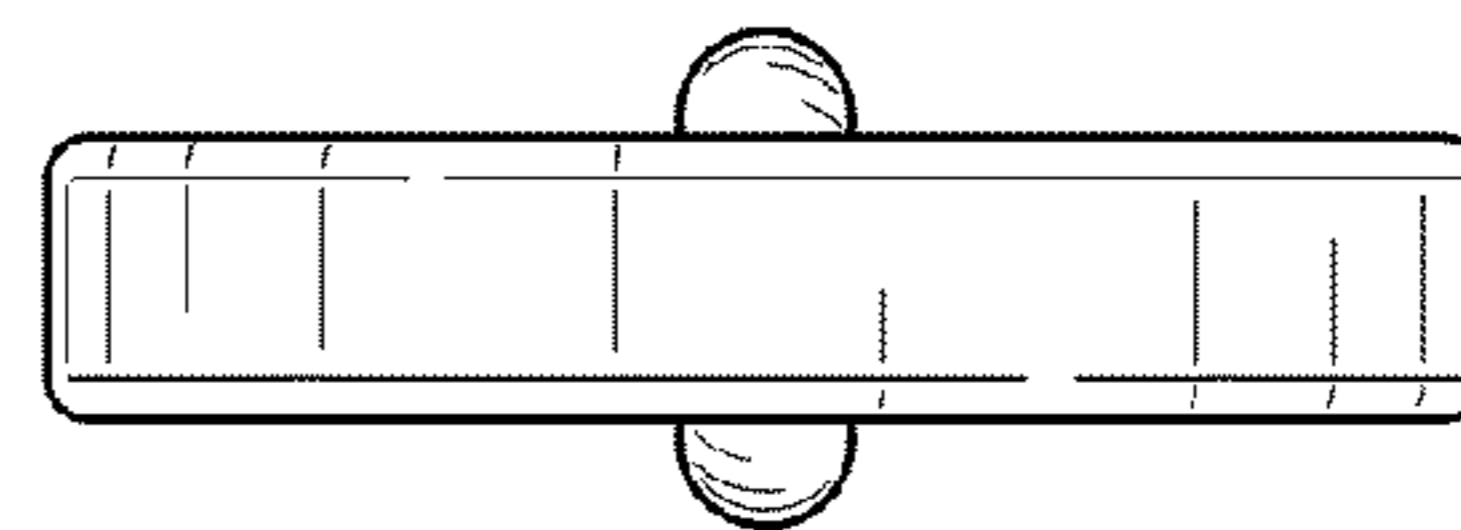

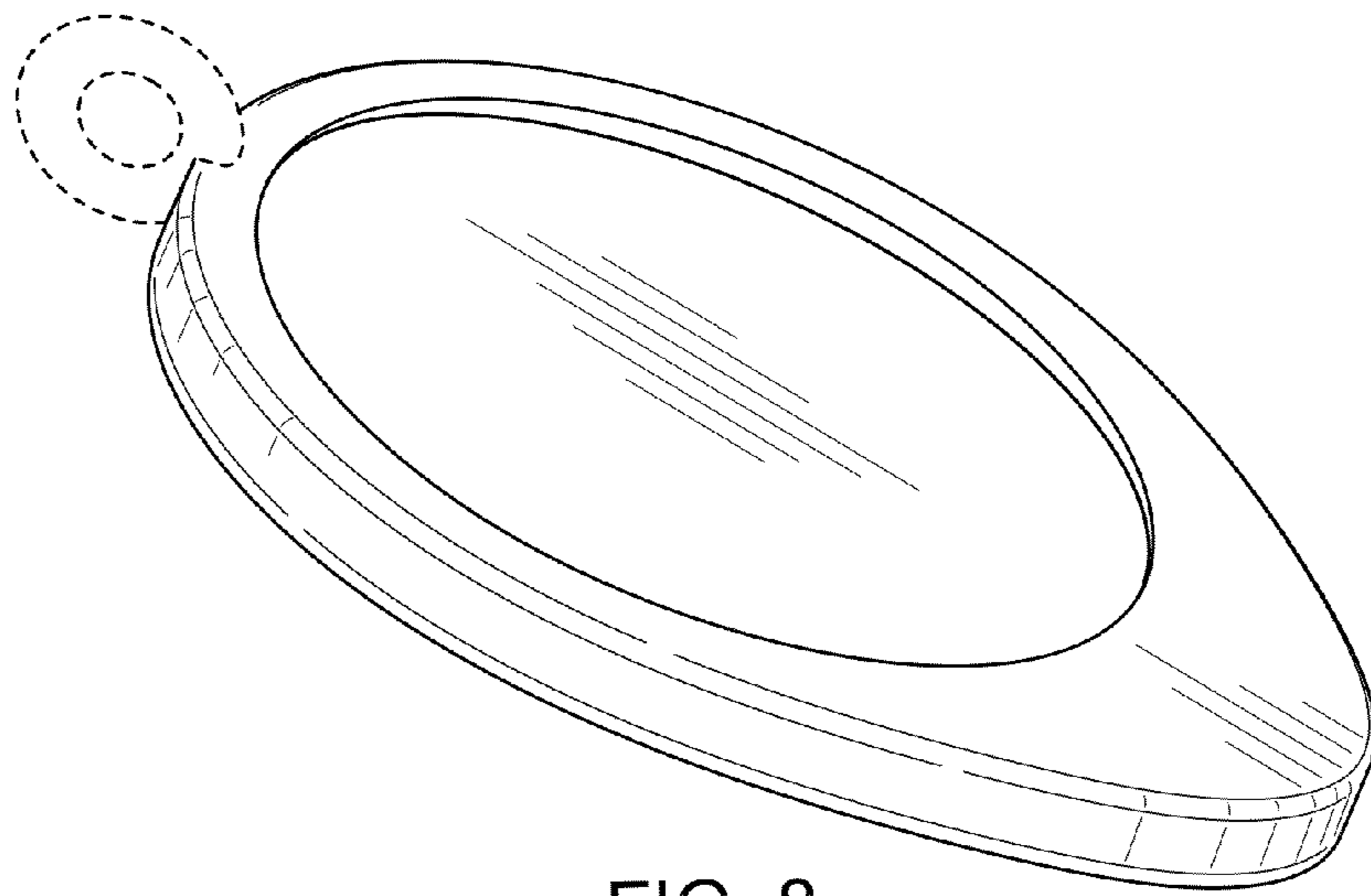

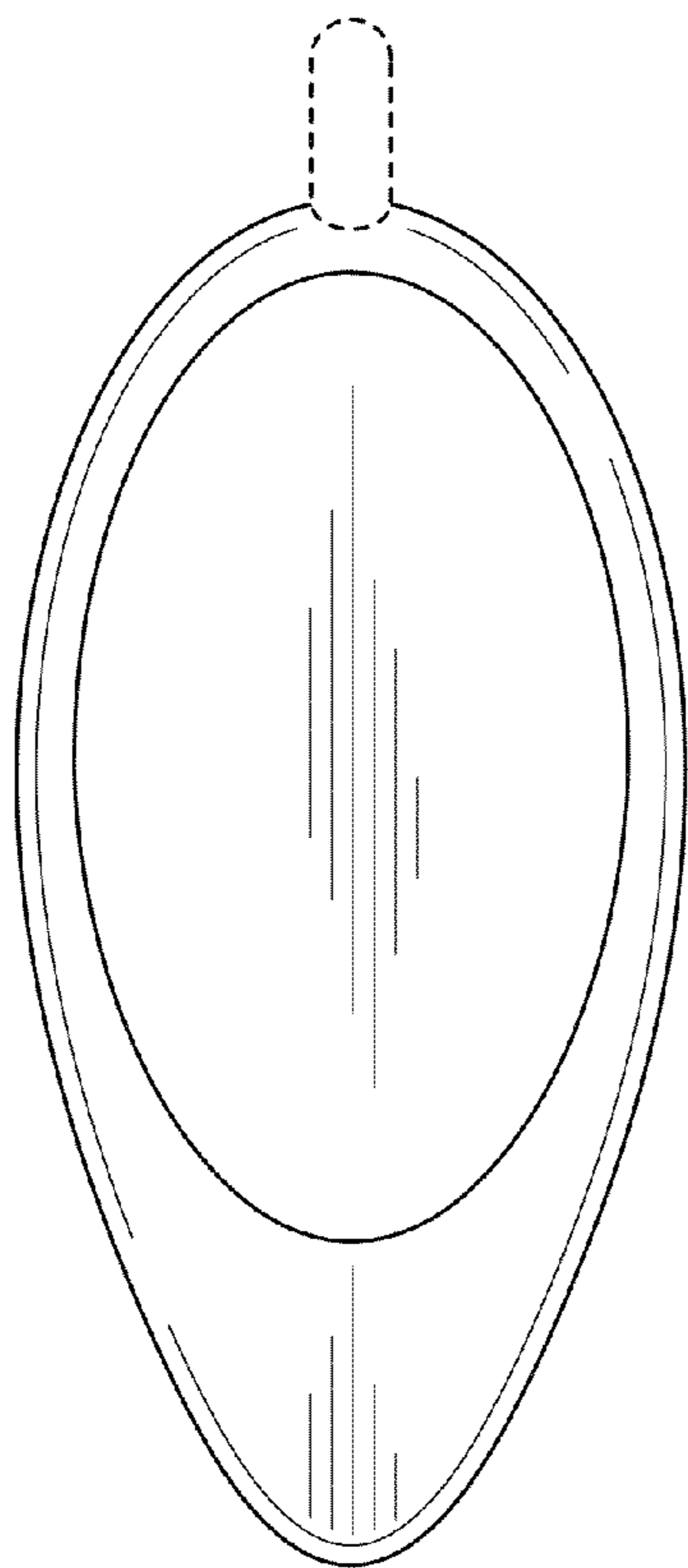

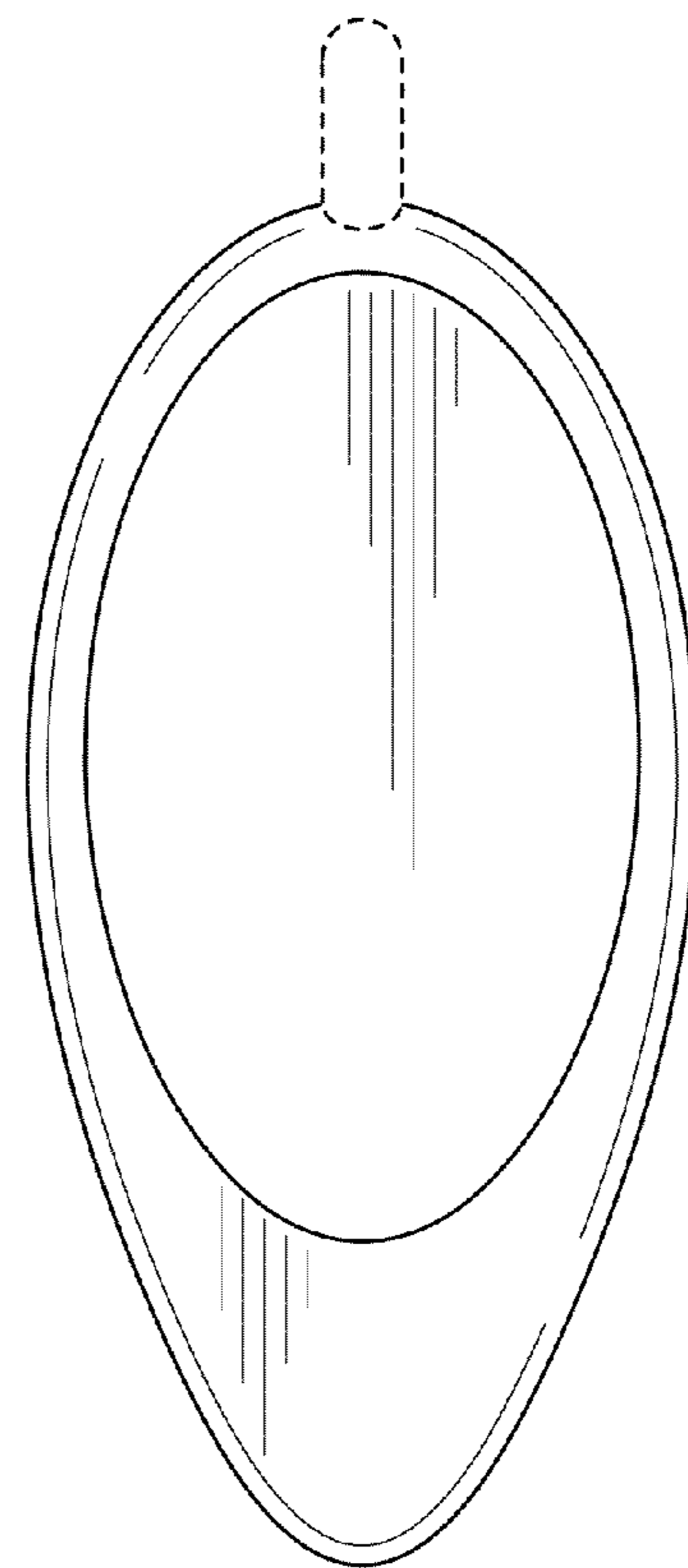

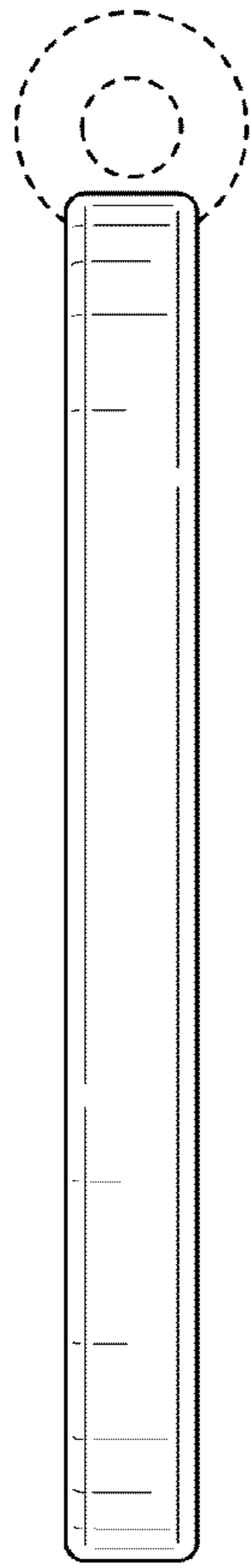

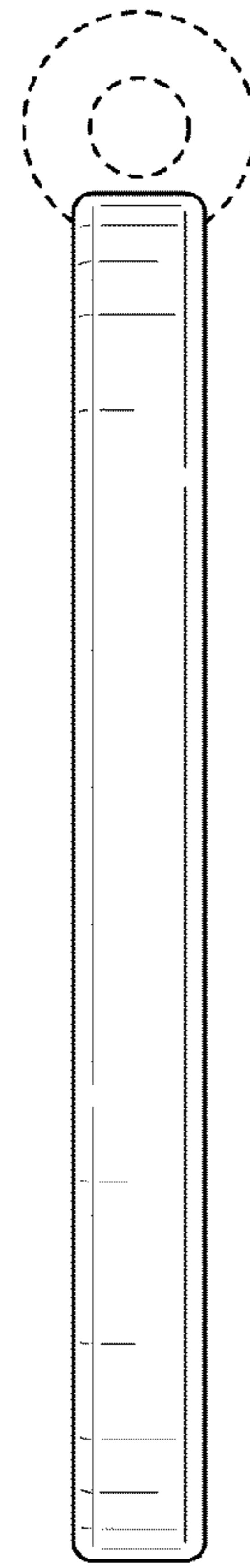

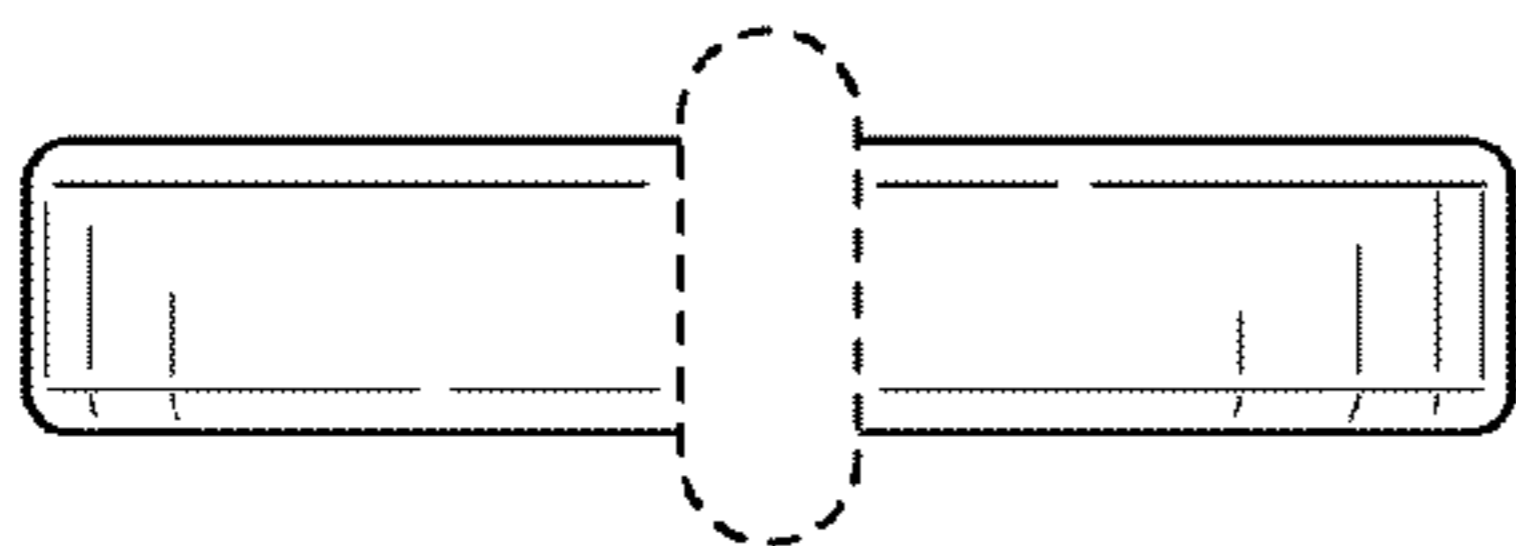

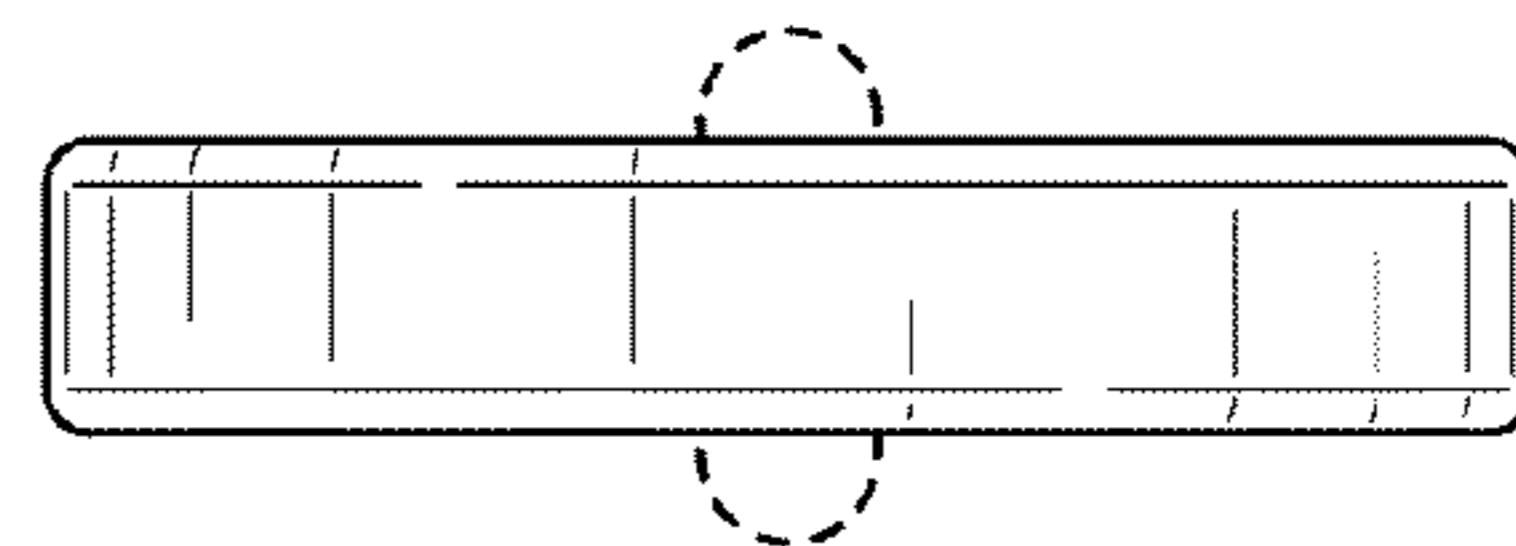
