FIG. 4 is a right isometric view thereof.

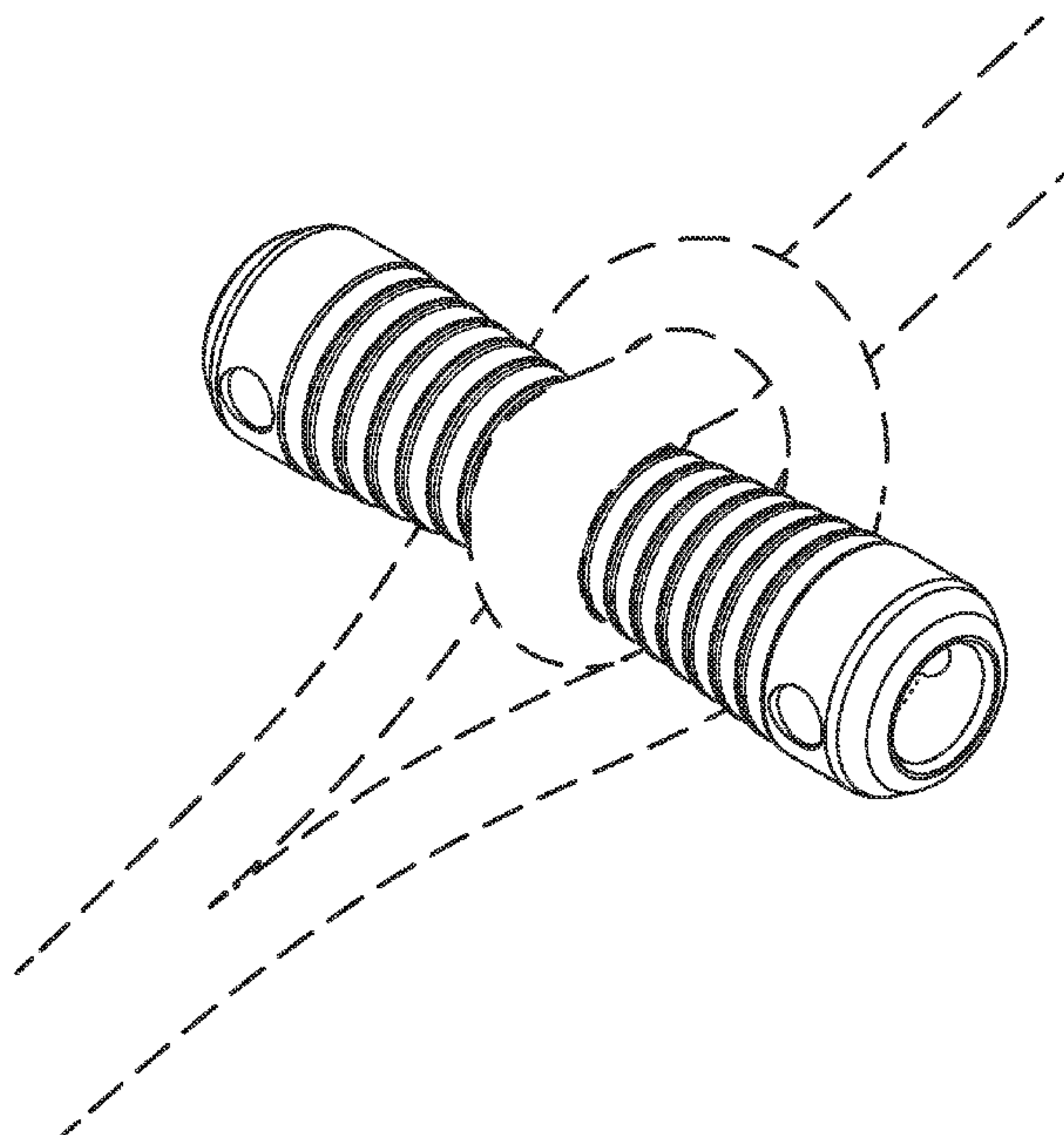
FIG. 5 is a left isometric view thereof.

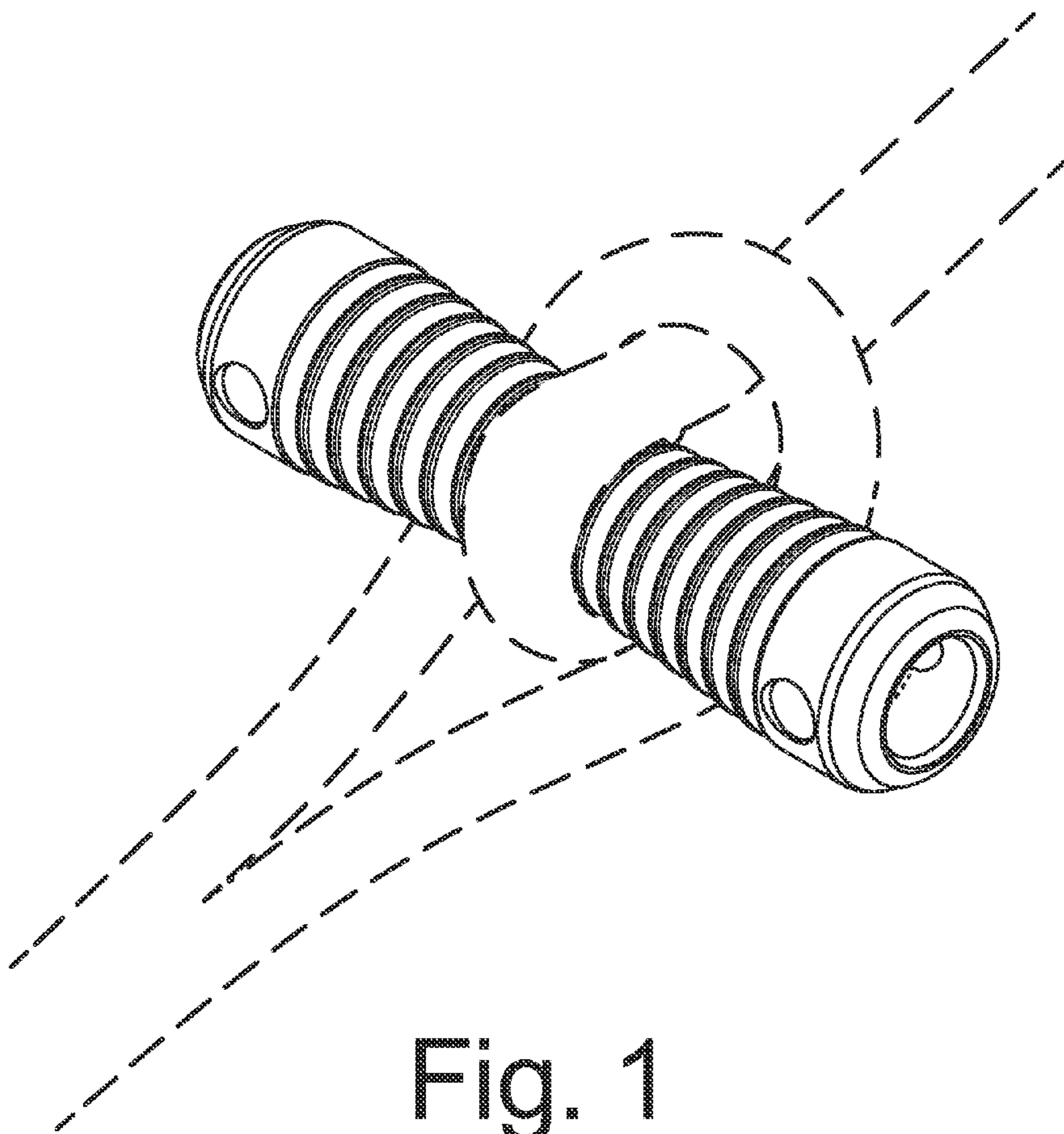
FIG. 6 is a left end view thereof; and,

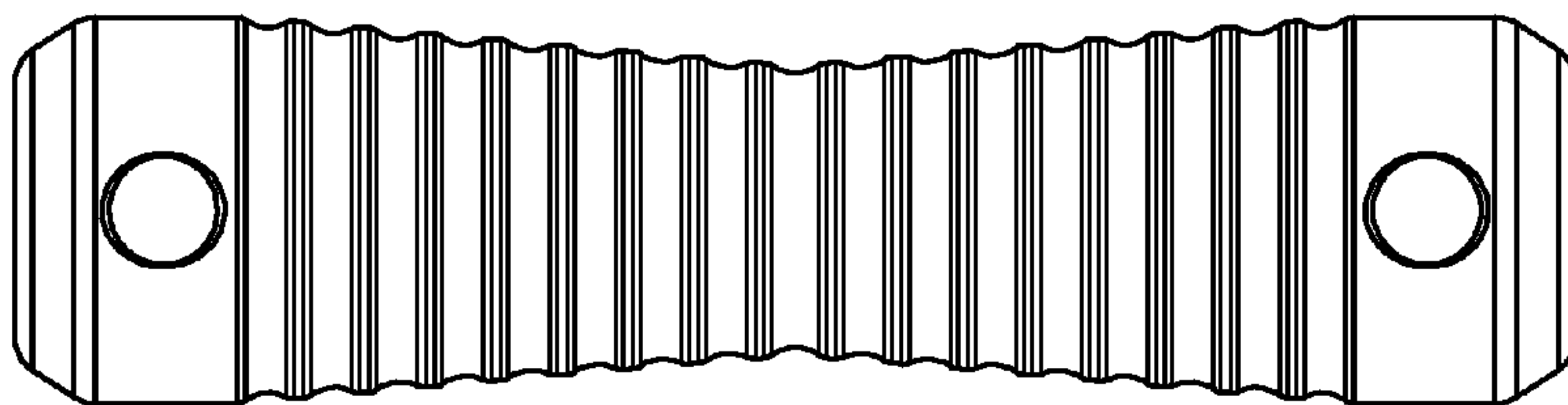

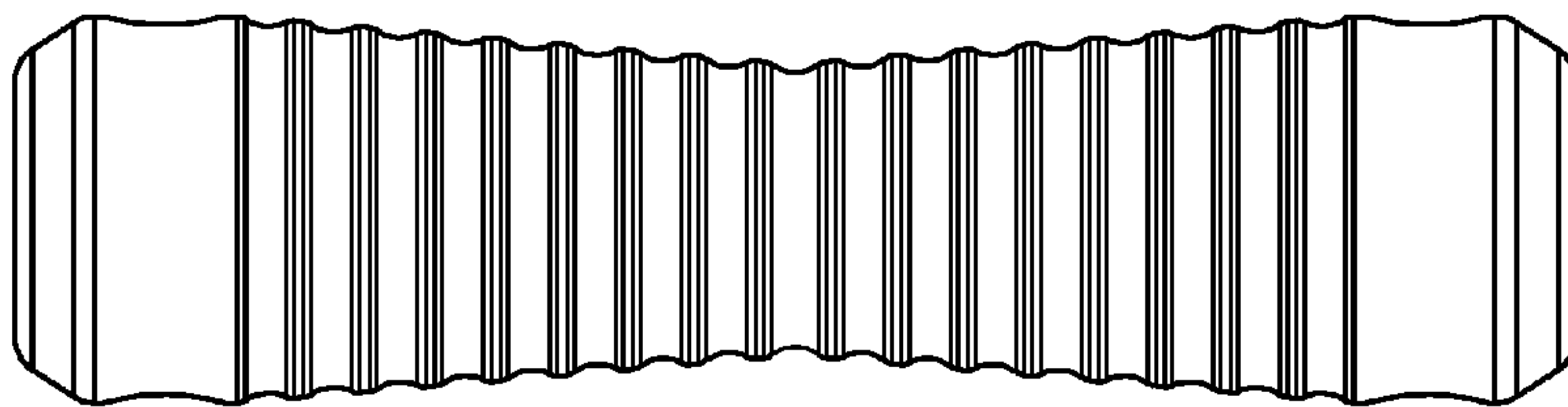

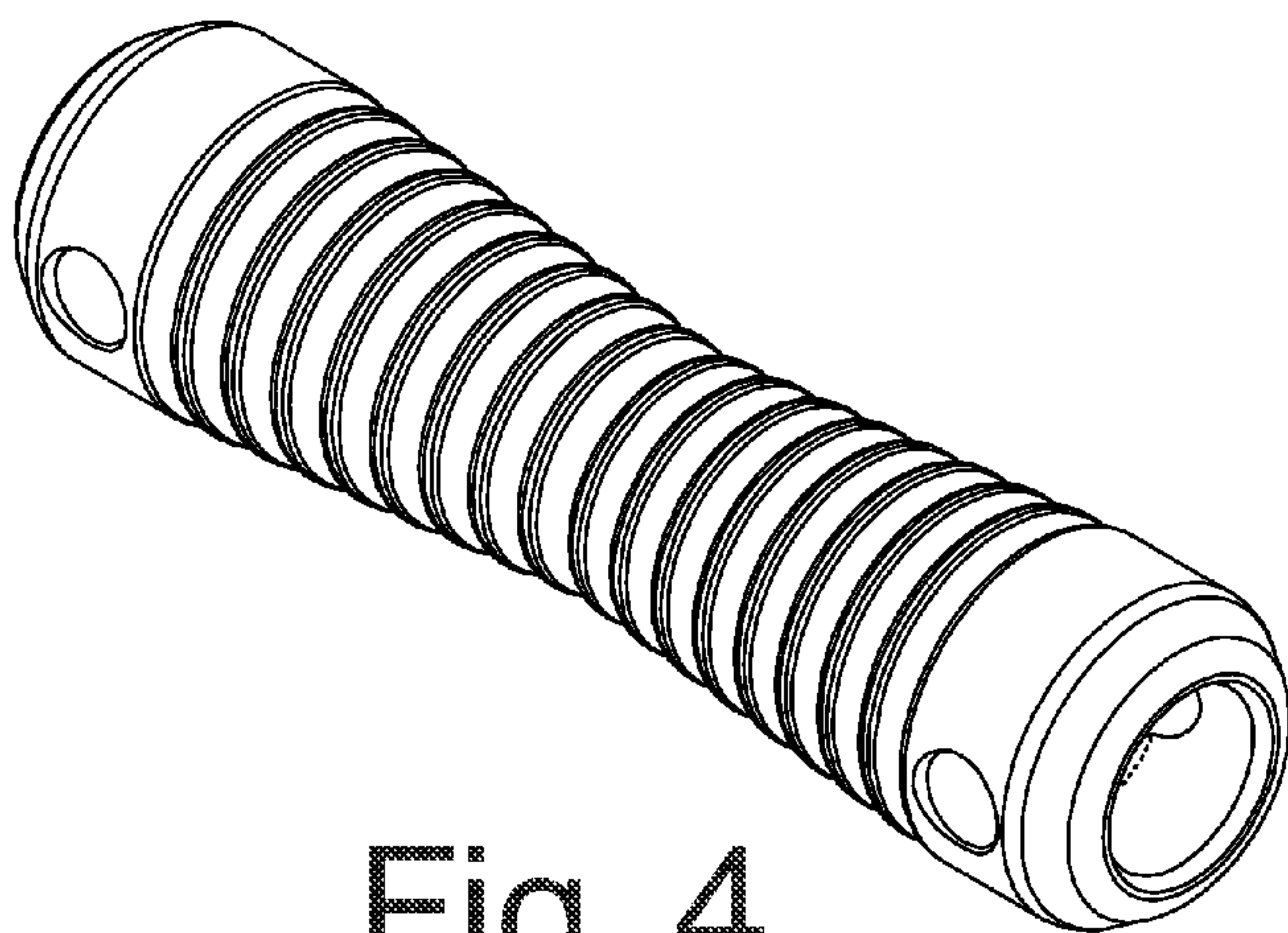

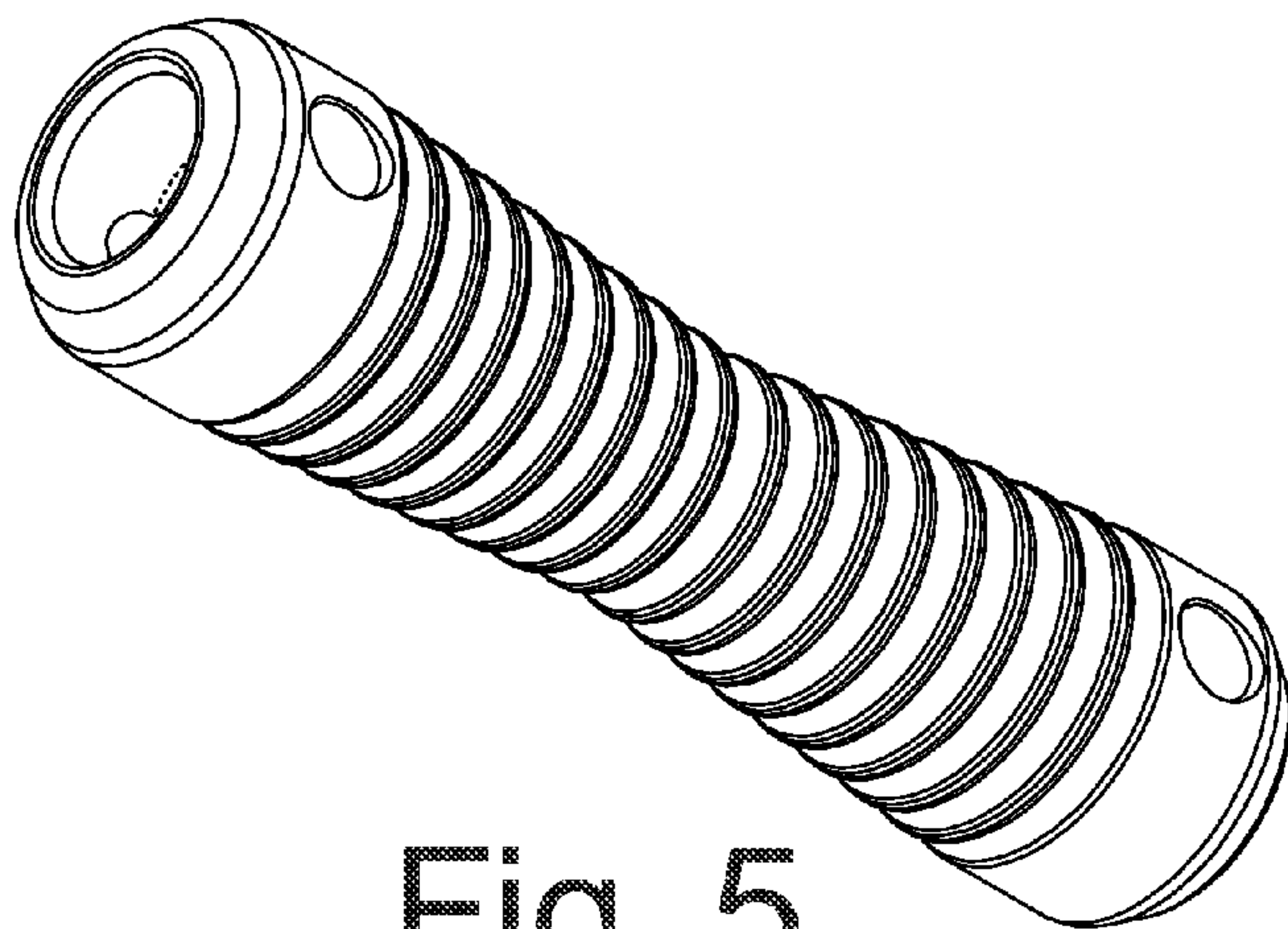

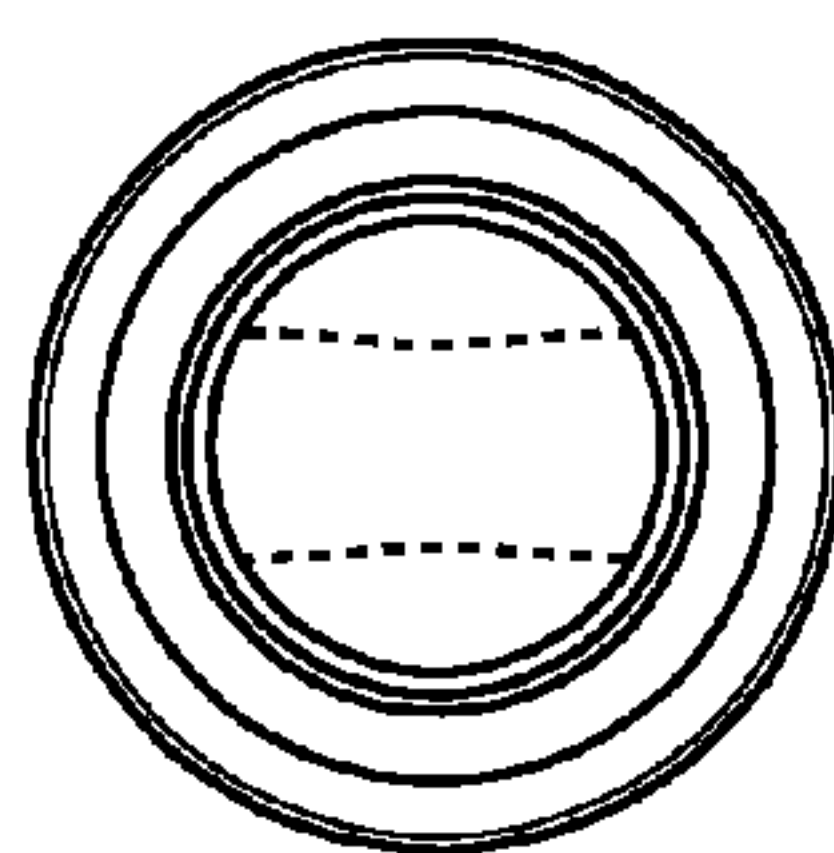

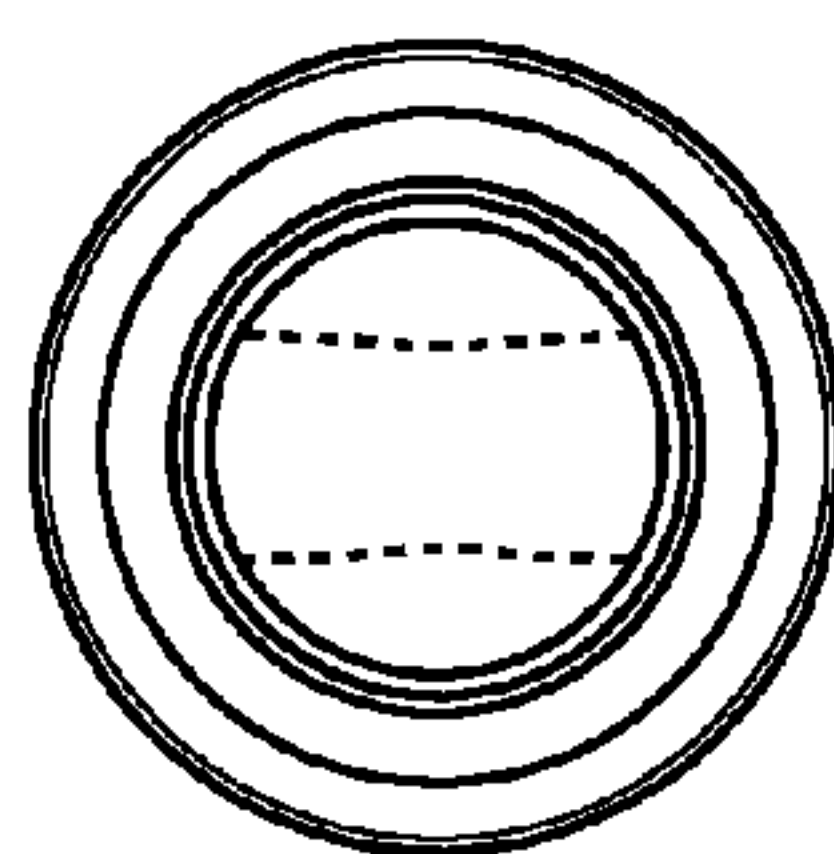
