**DESCRIPTION**

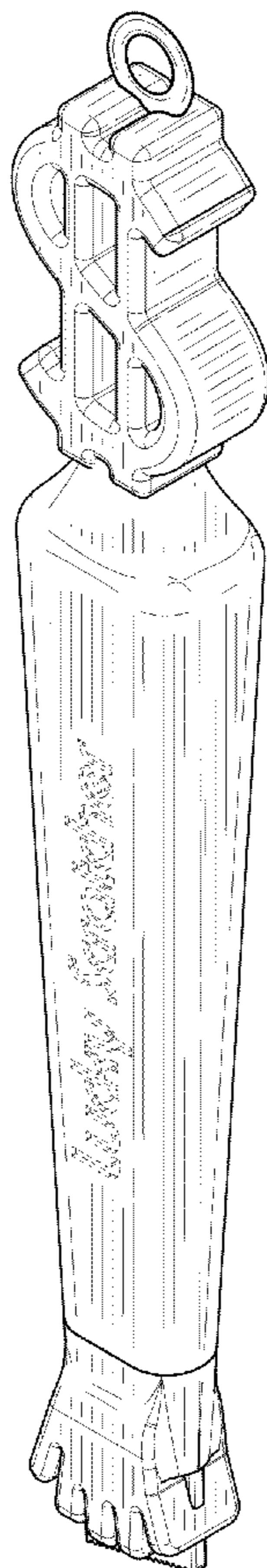
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lottery ticket scratcher, showing my new design;

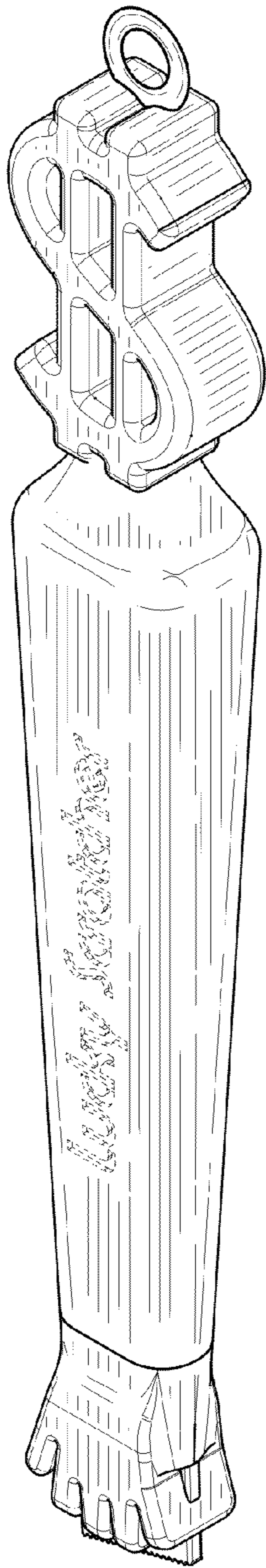

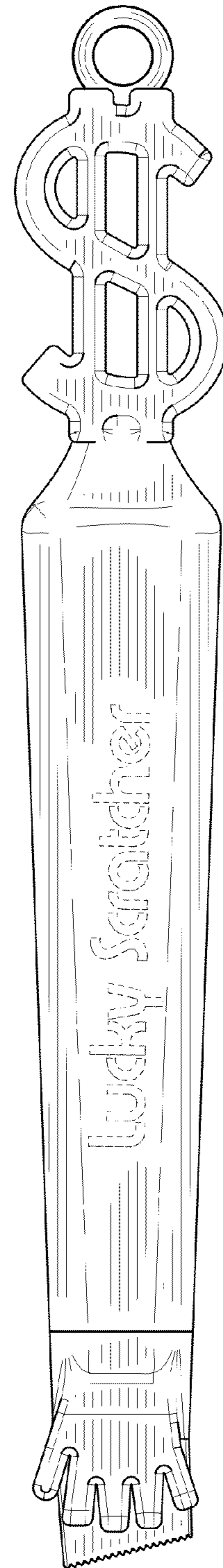

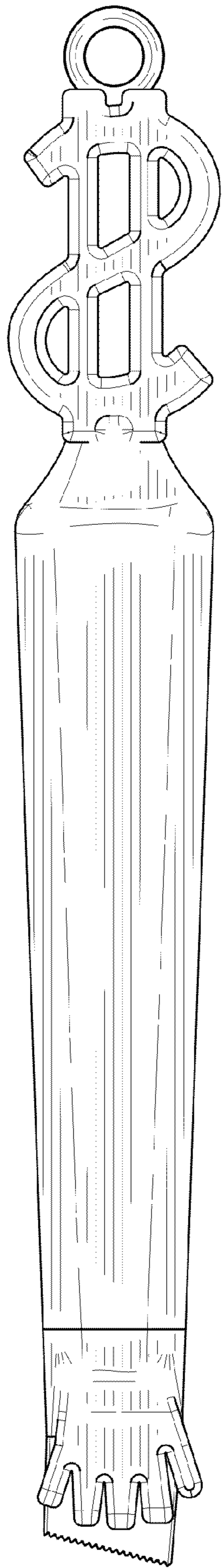

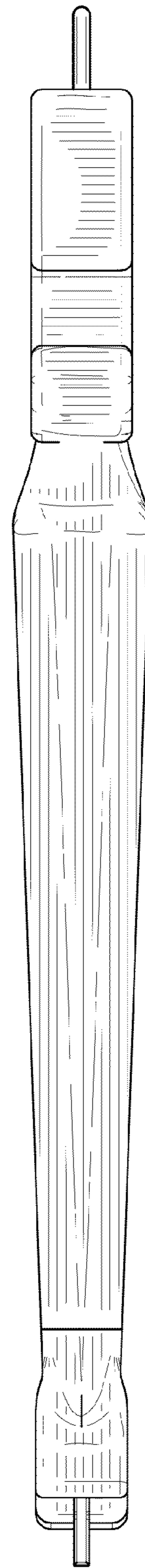

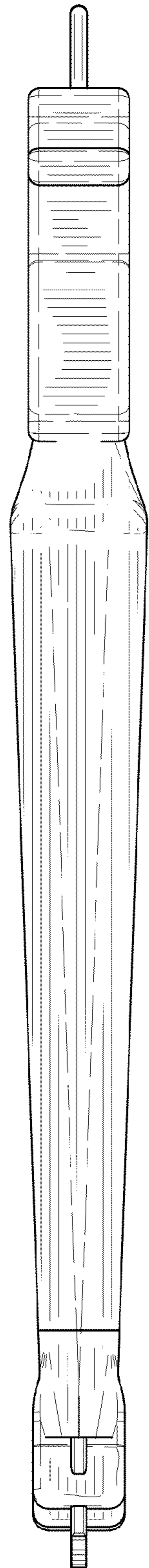

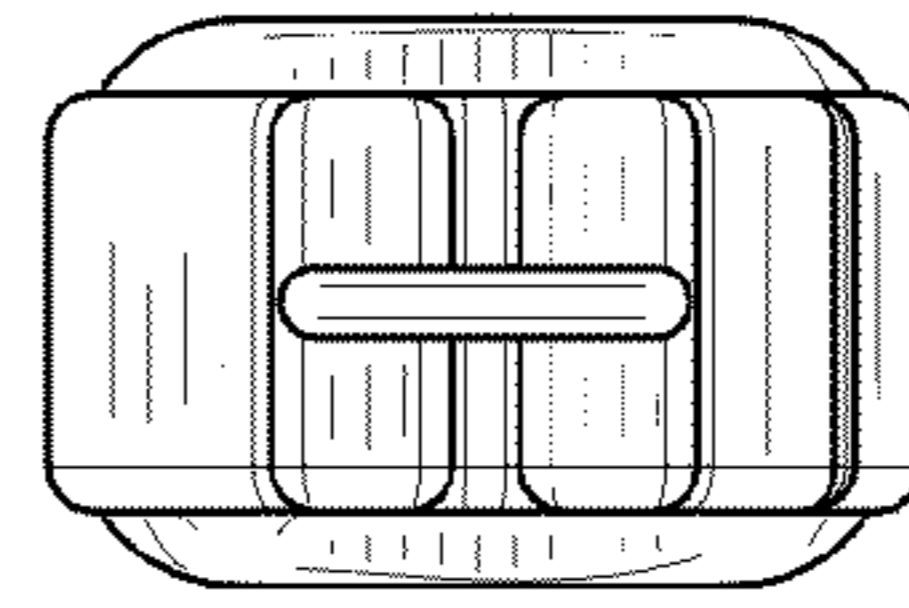

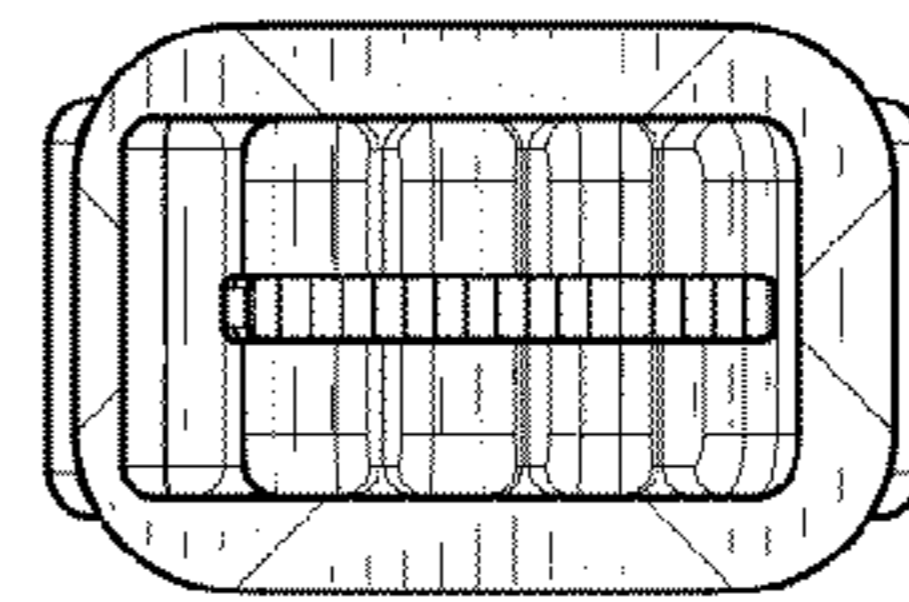
