(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lid for a container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lid for a container, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being identical;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view being identical; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of the lid for a container represent unclaimed subject matter and form no part of the claimed design.

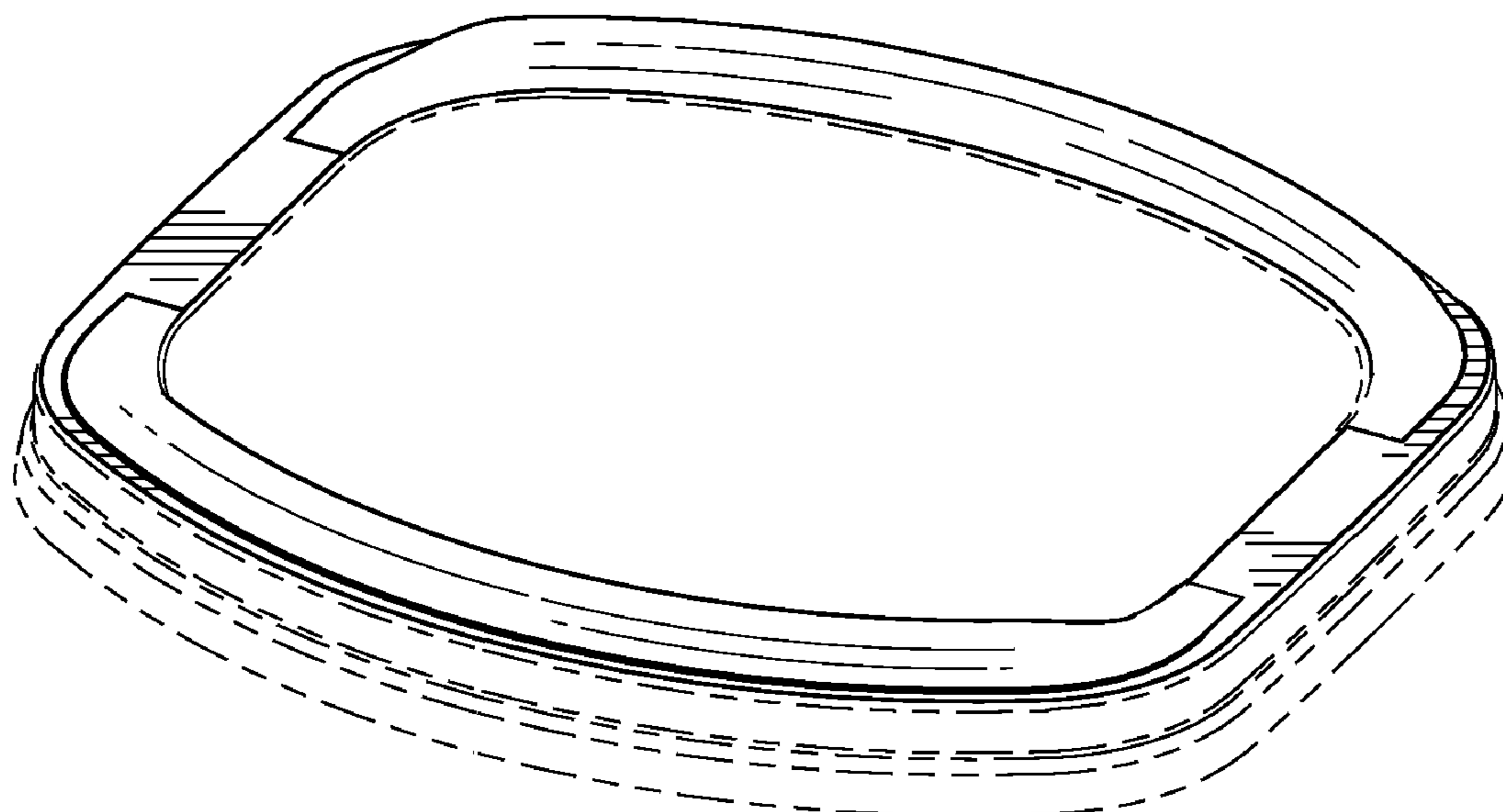

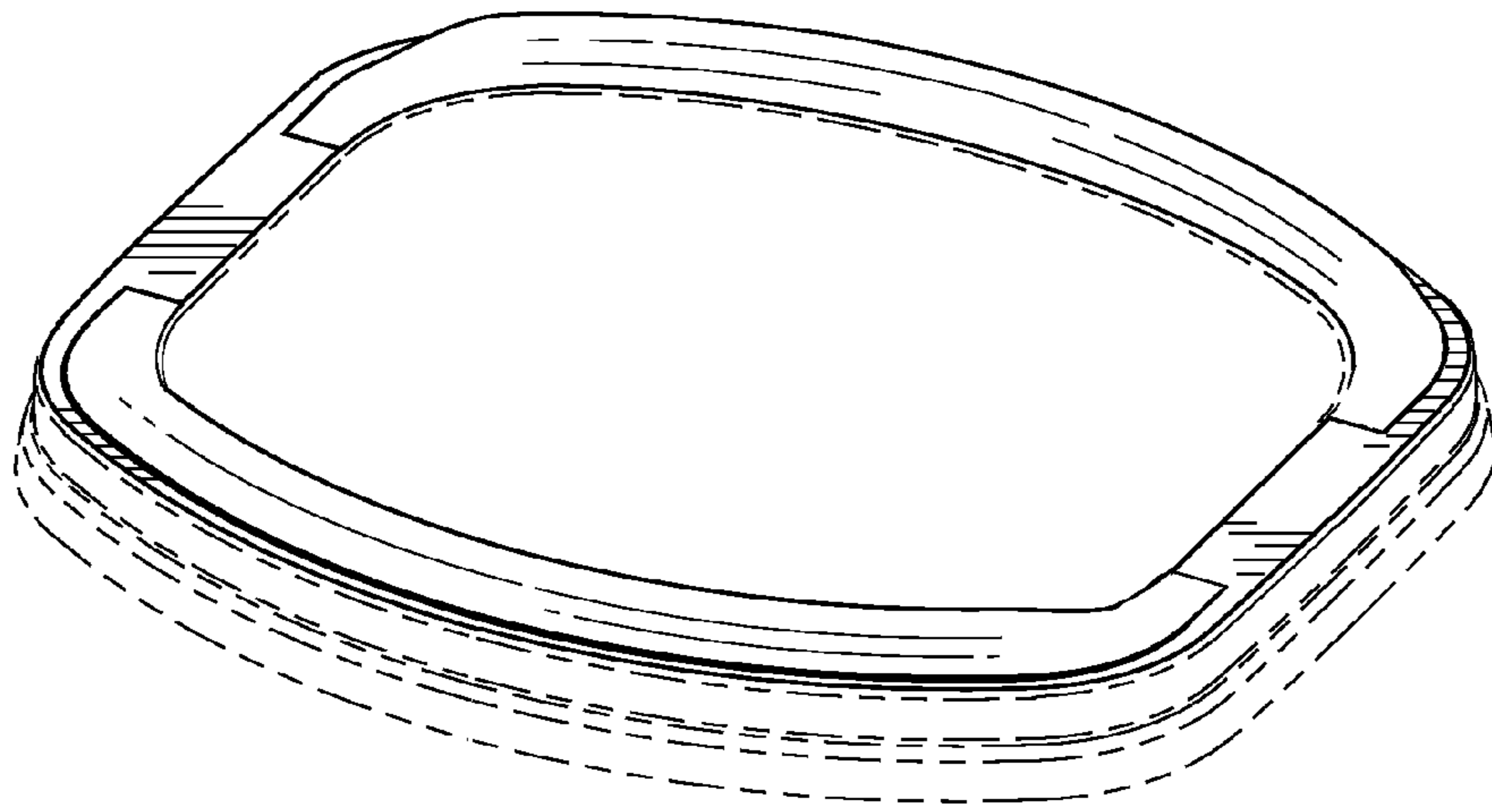

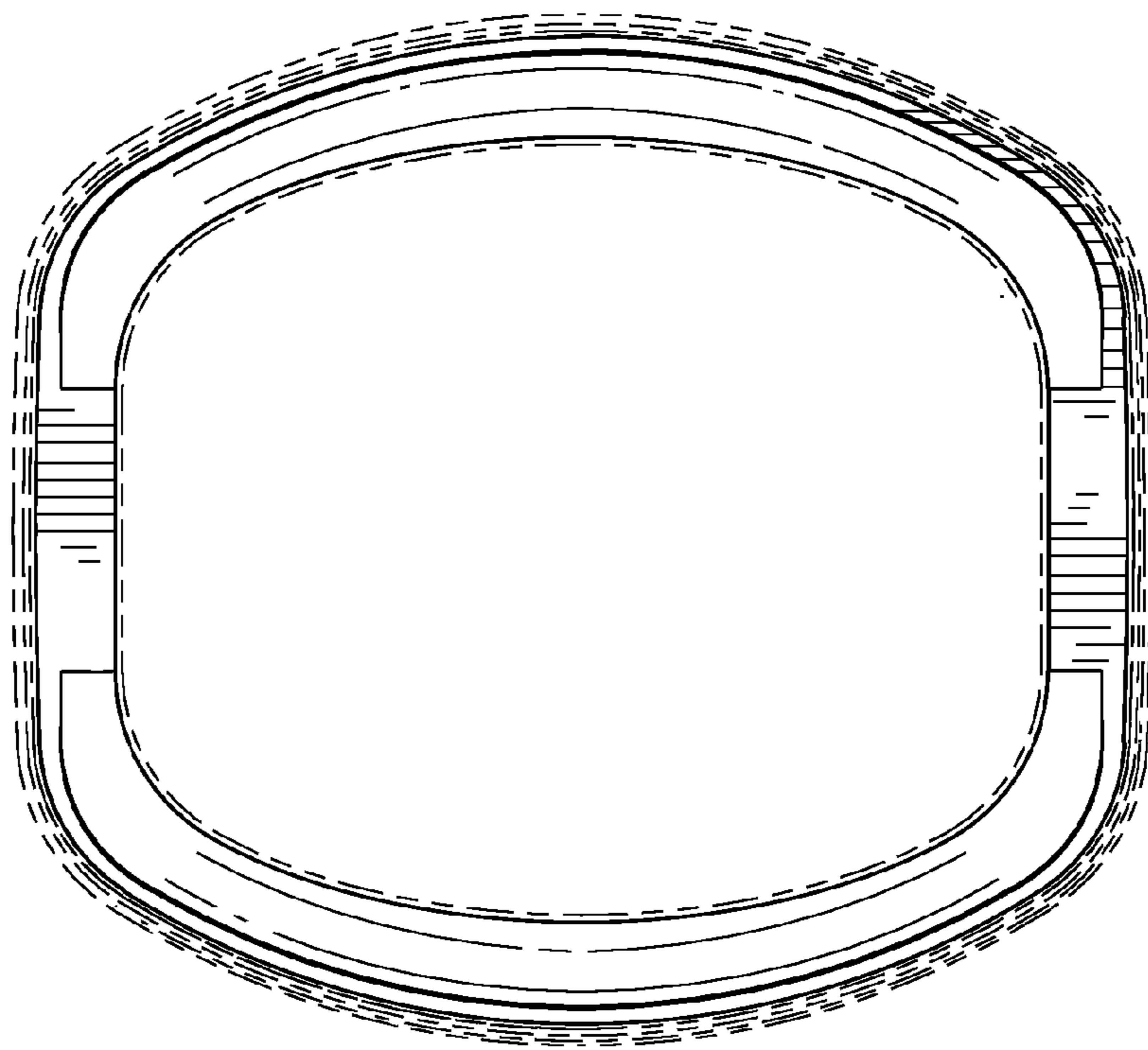

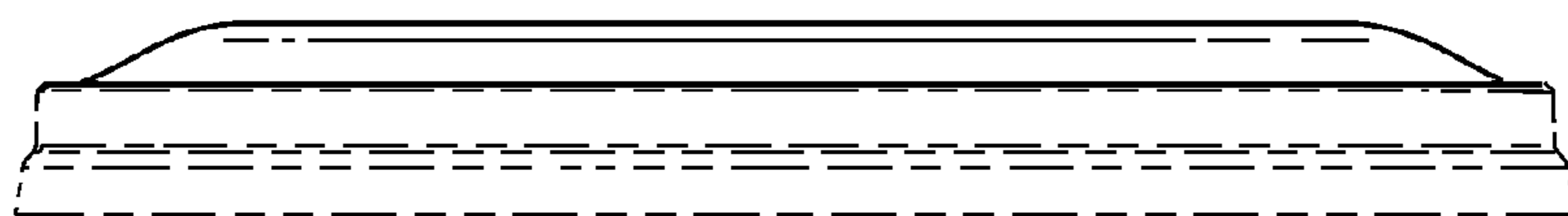

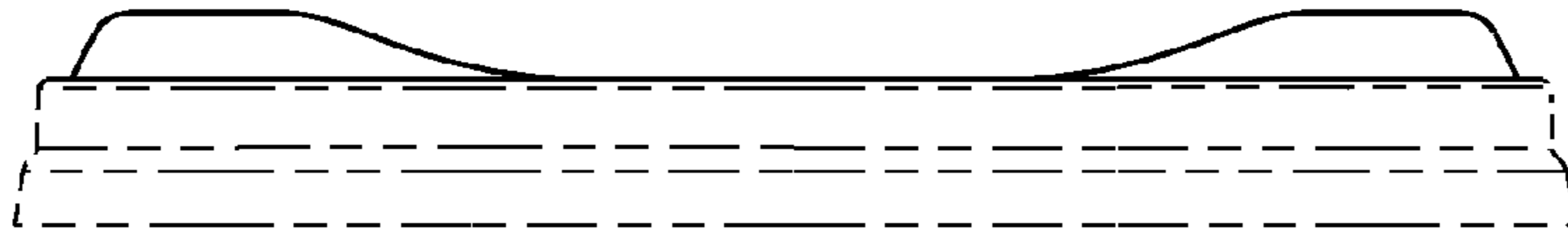
