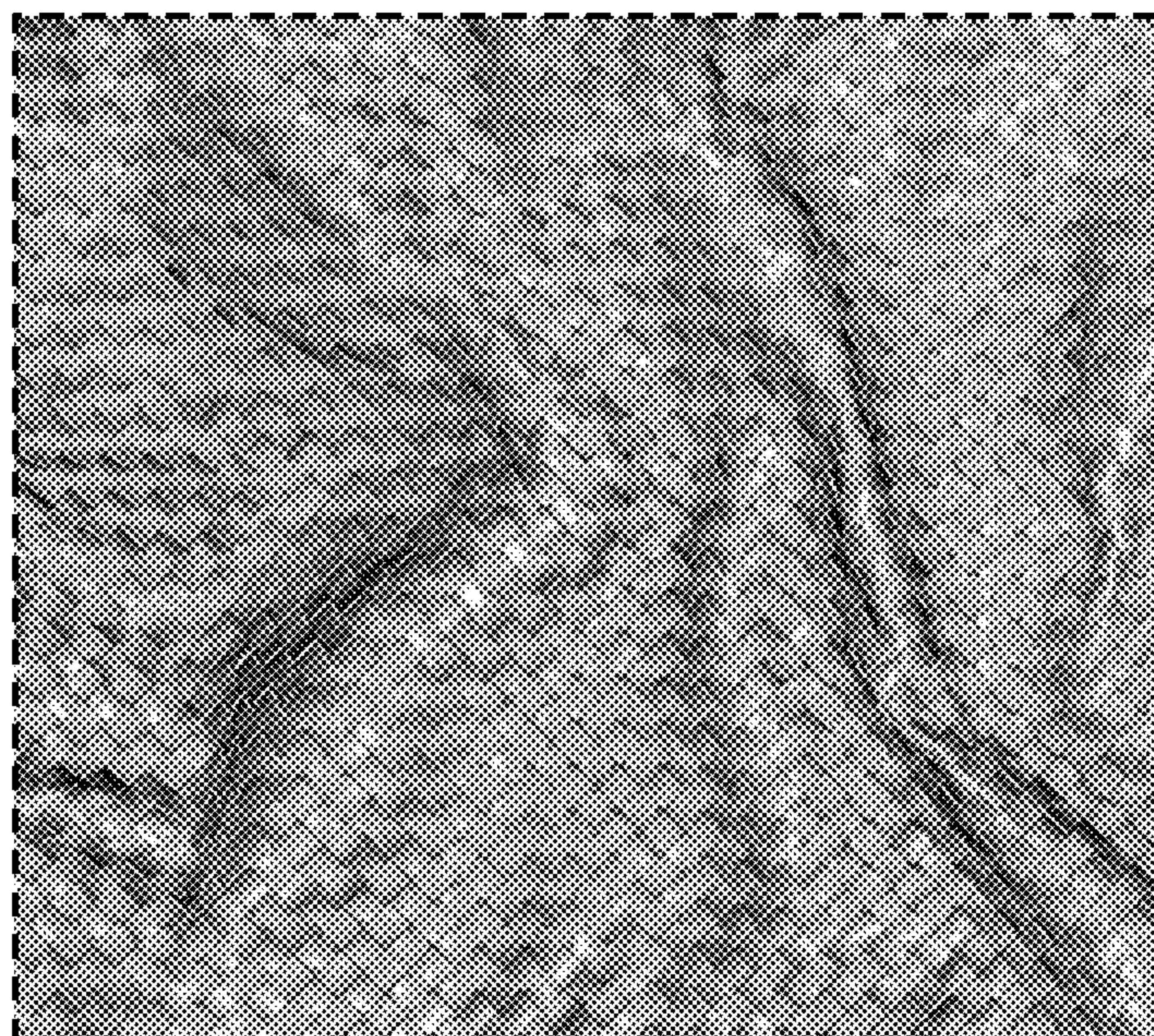
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fabric, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an overall view of a fabric according to the design; FIG. 2 is a duplicate view of the design of FIG. 1 showing the areas of the details; FIG. 3 is an enlarged detail of FIG. 1 indicated on FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a second enlarged detail of FIG. 1 indicated on FIG. 2; and, FIG. 5 is a third enlarged detail of FIG. 1 indicated on FIG. 2. The broken lines circumscribing the details form no part of the claimed design. The fabric is flat and planar. Depth forms no part of the claimed design.

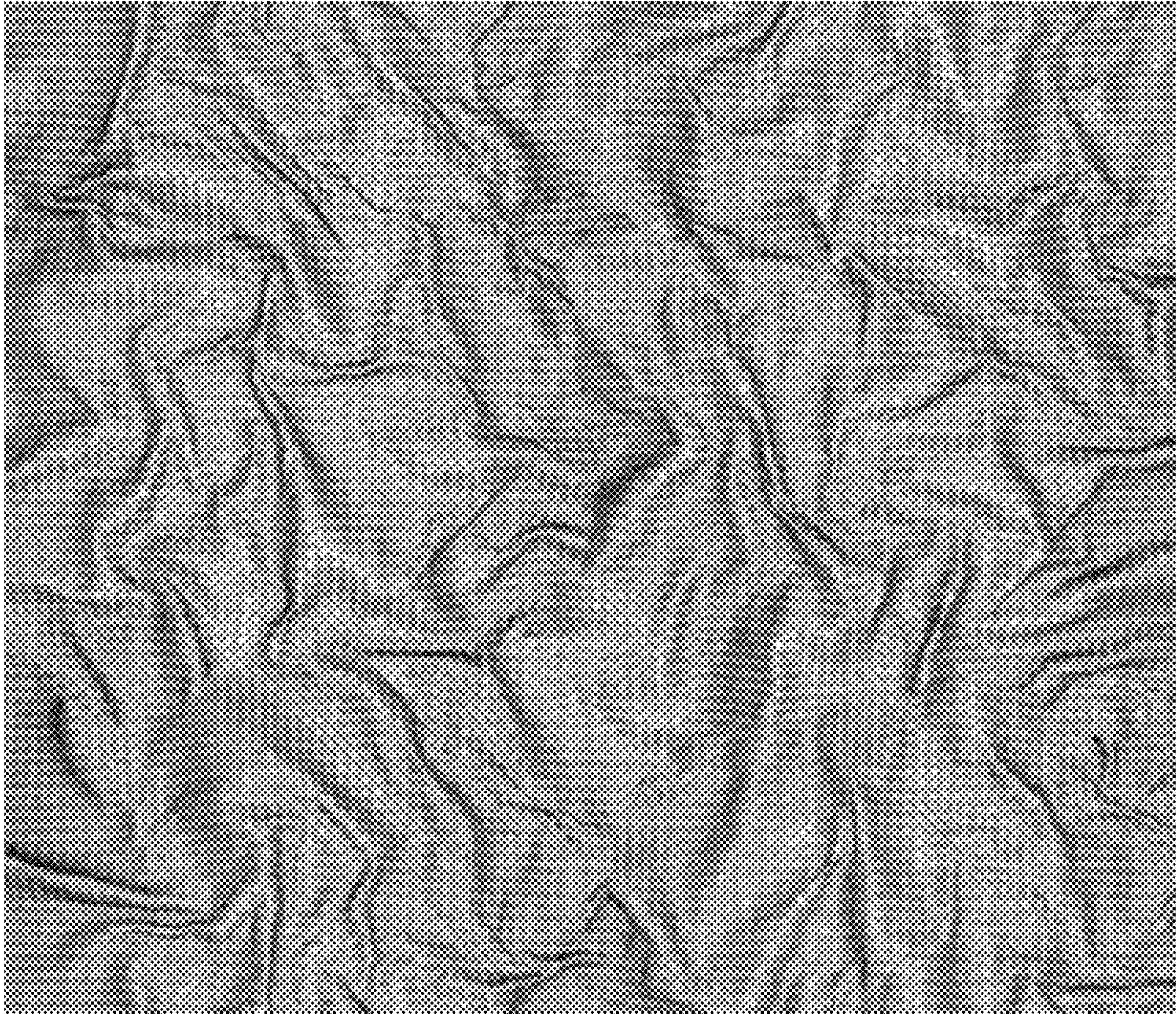

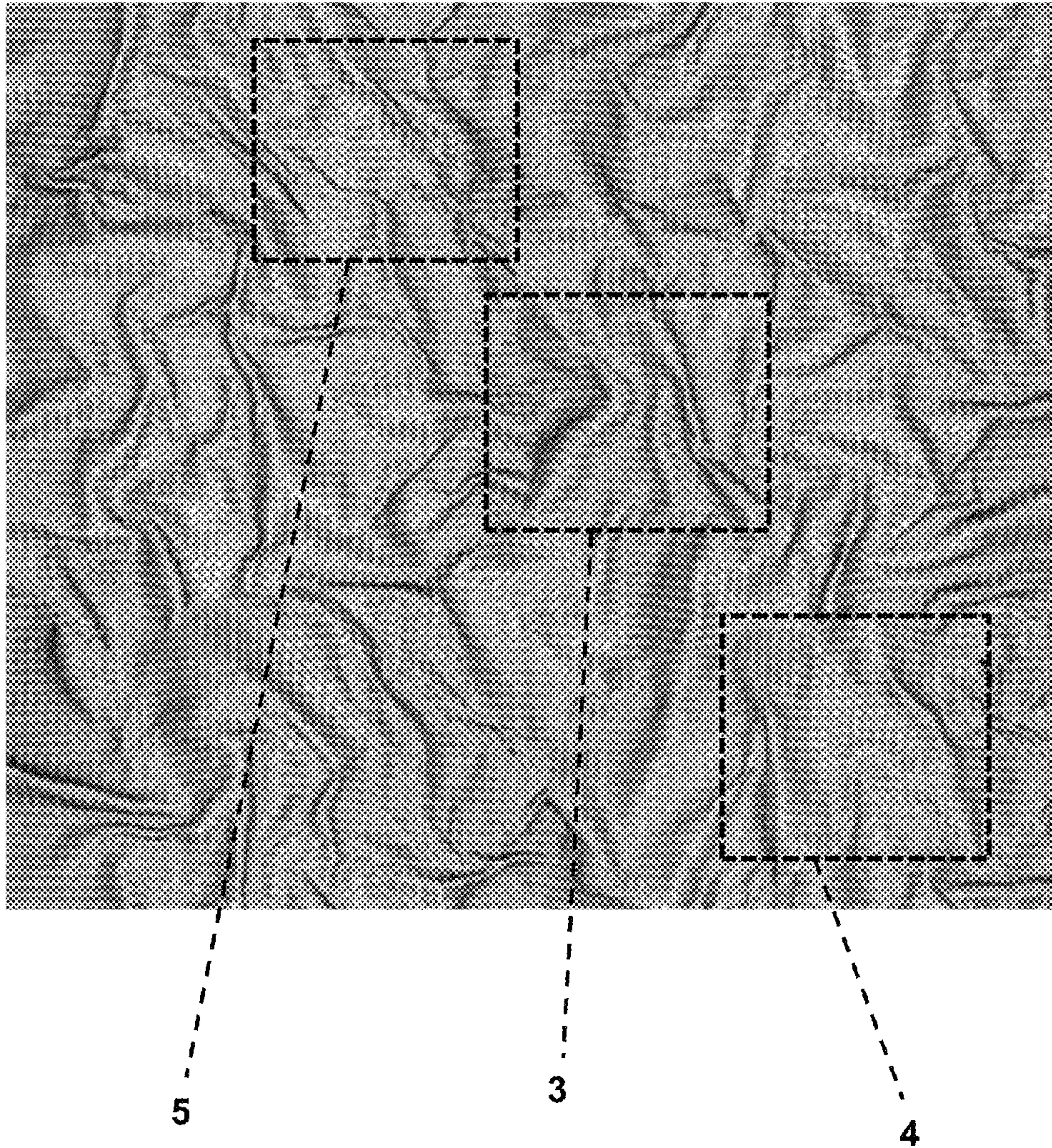

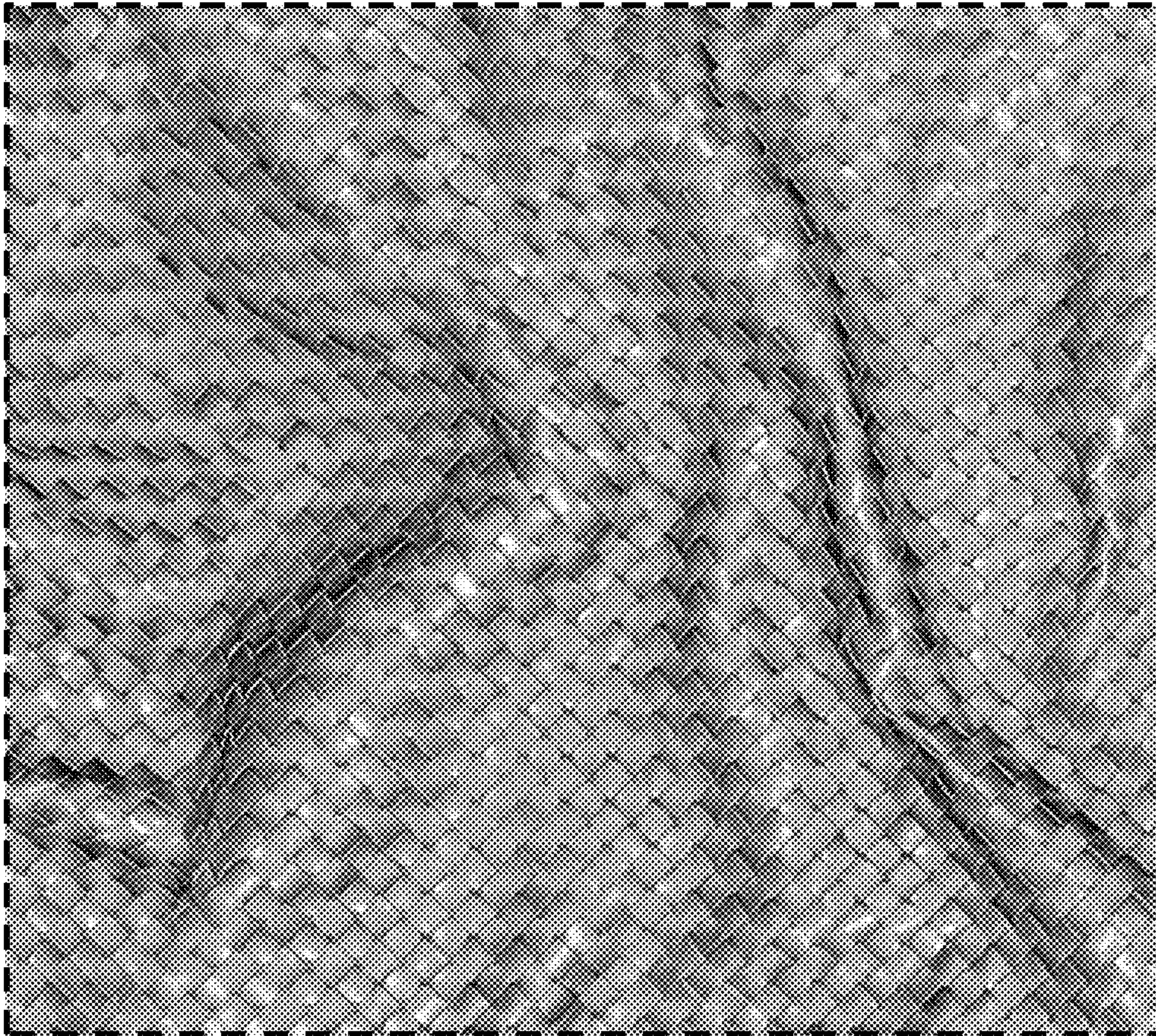

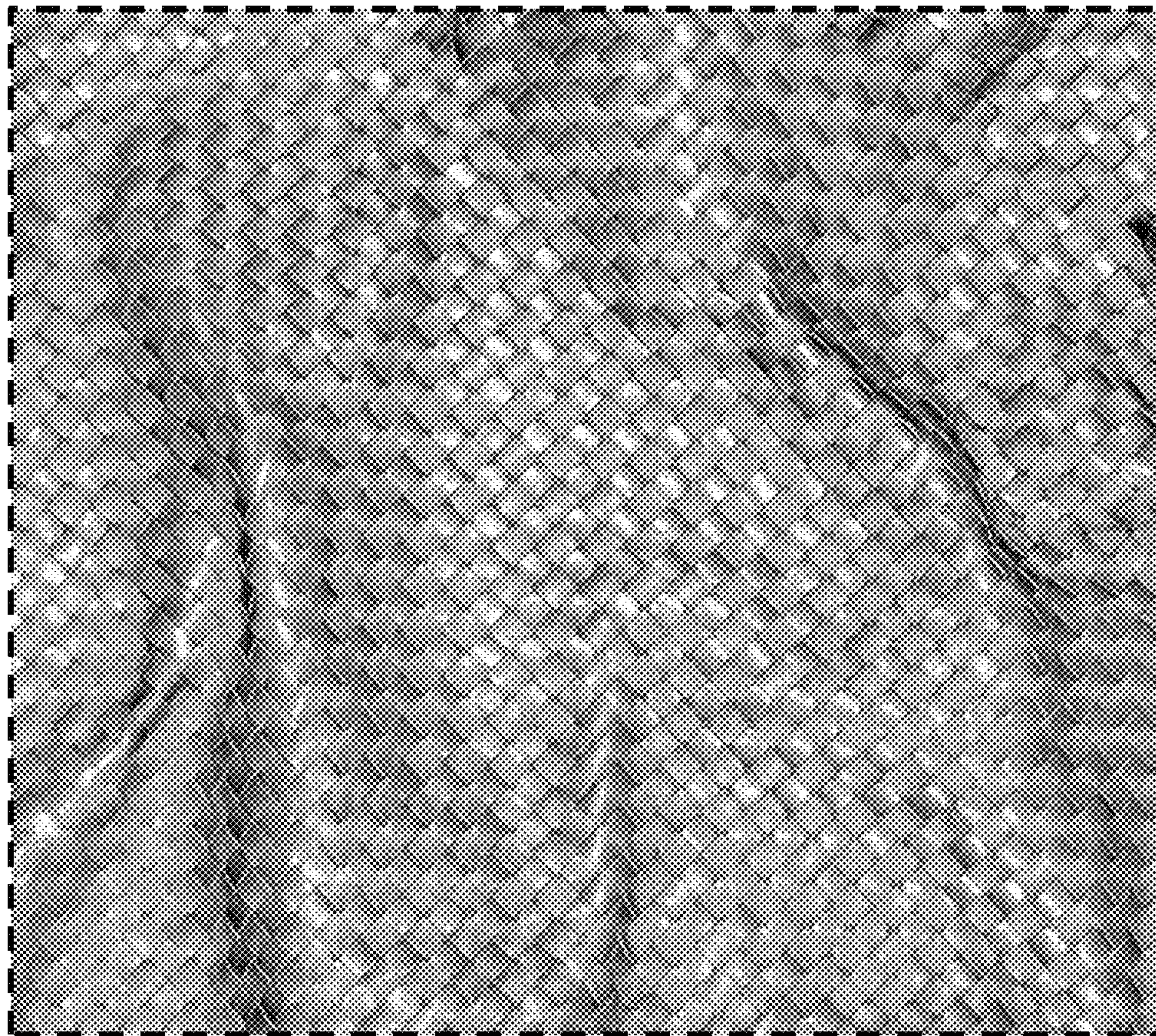

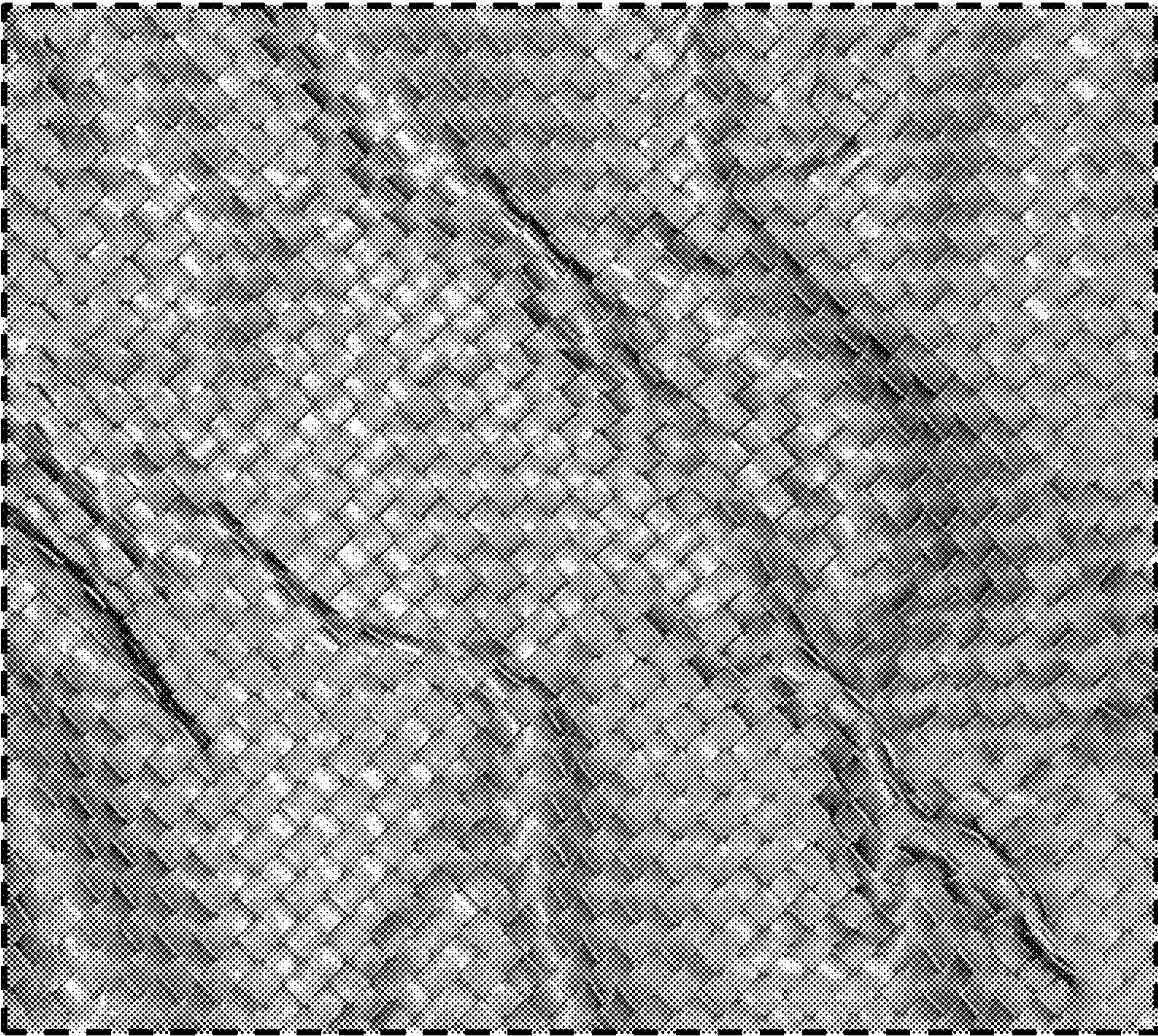
