FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

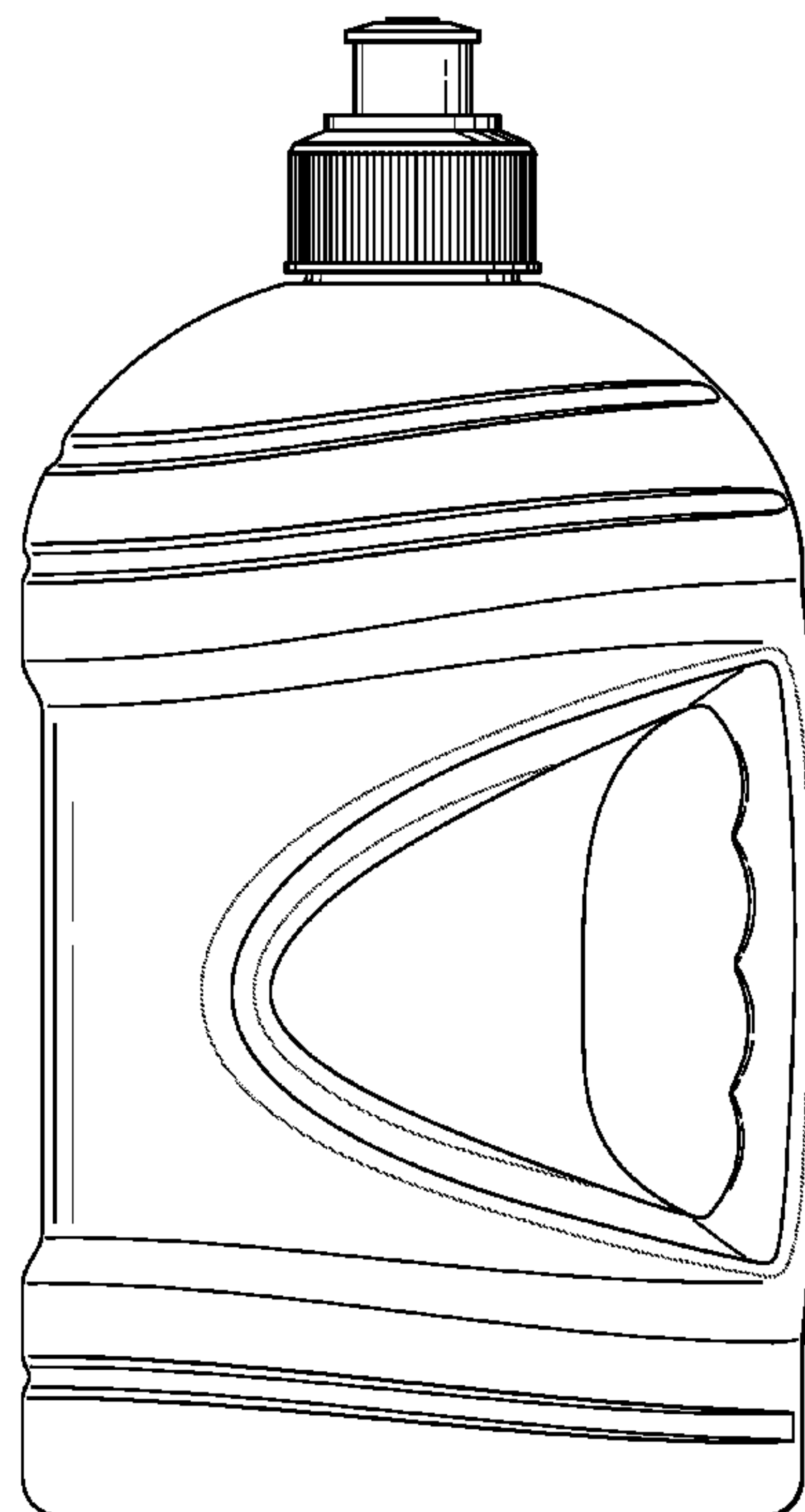
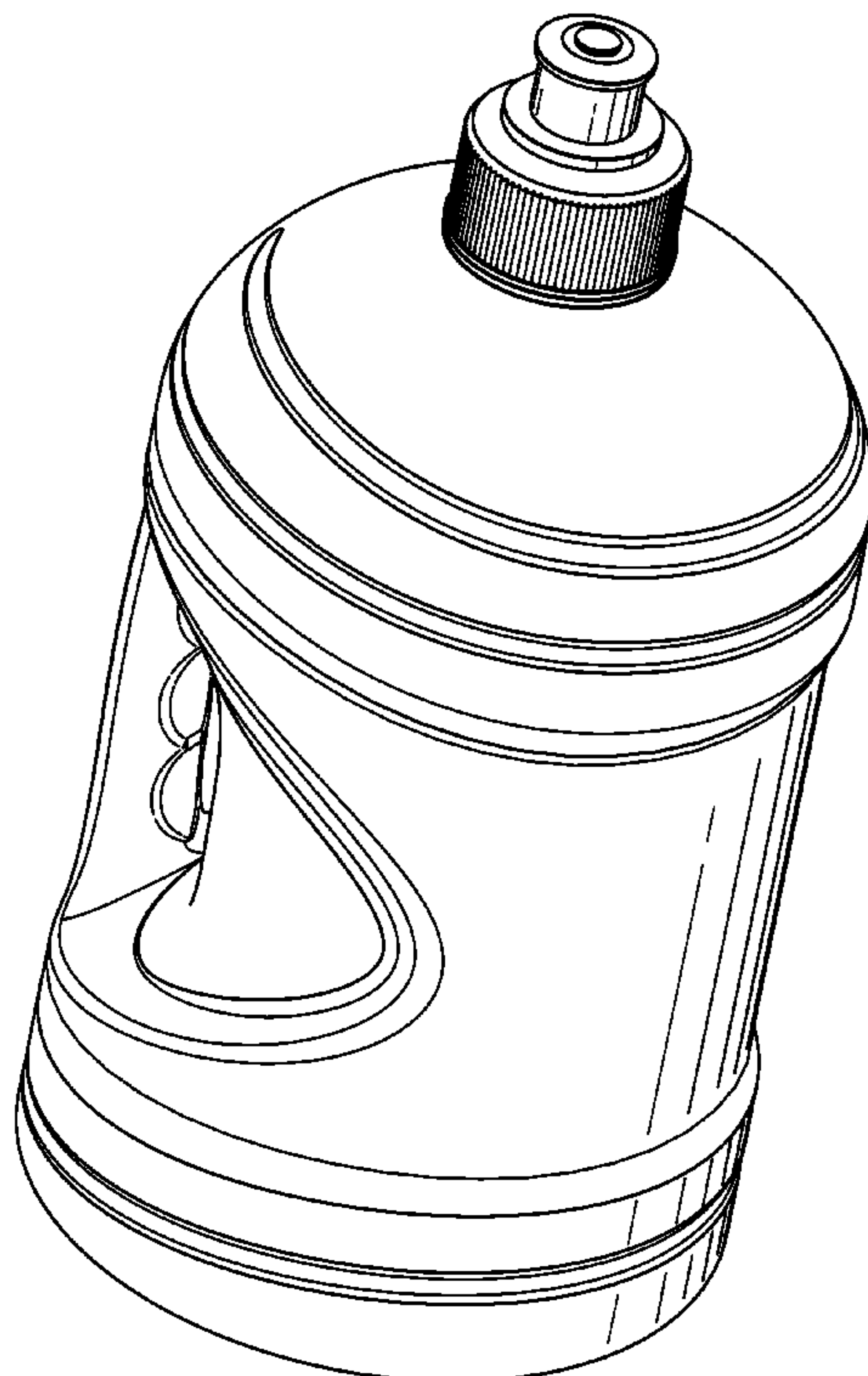
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

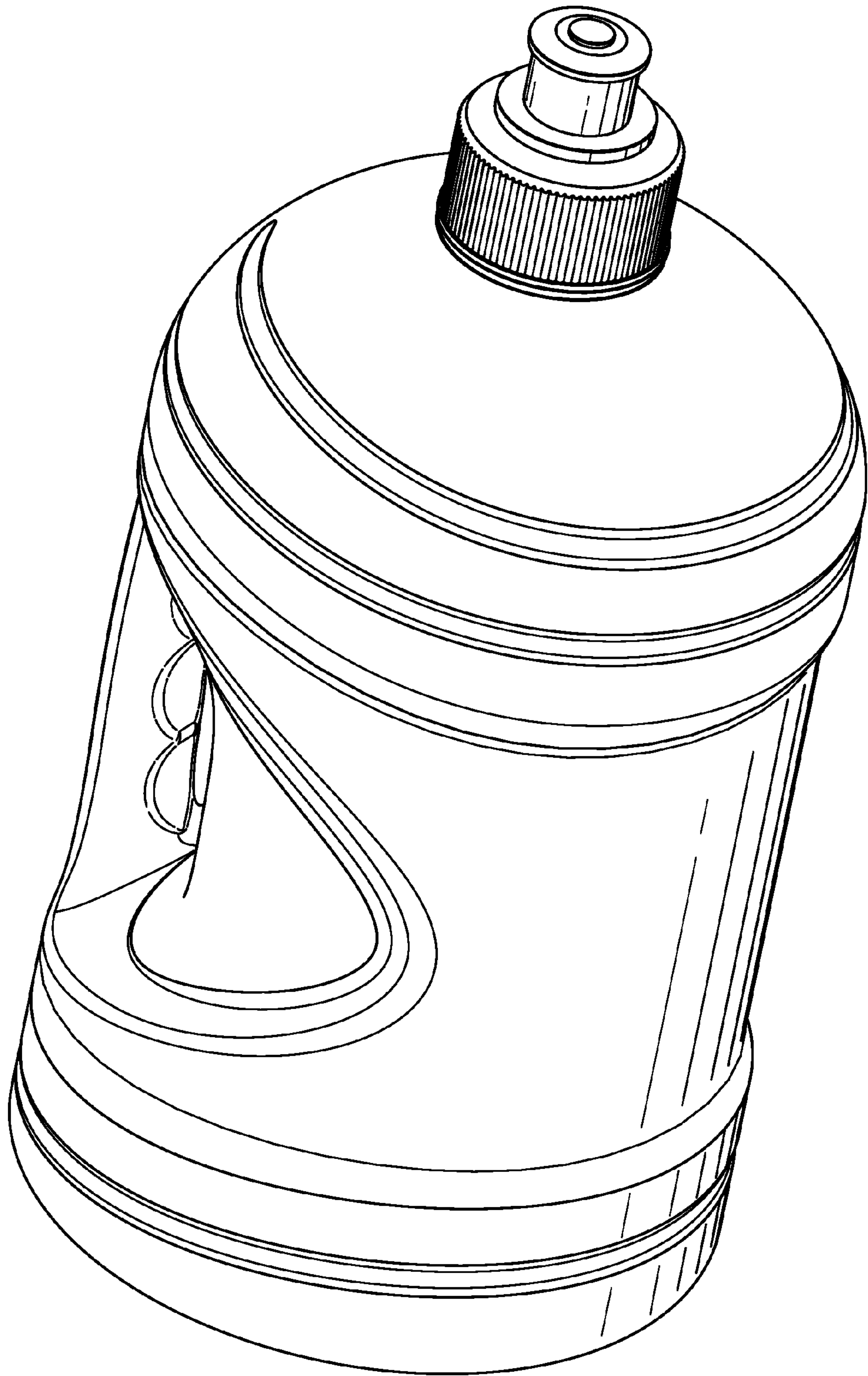

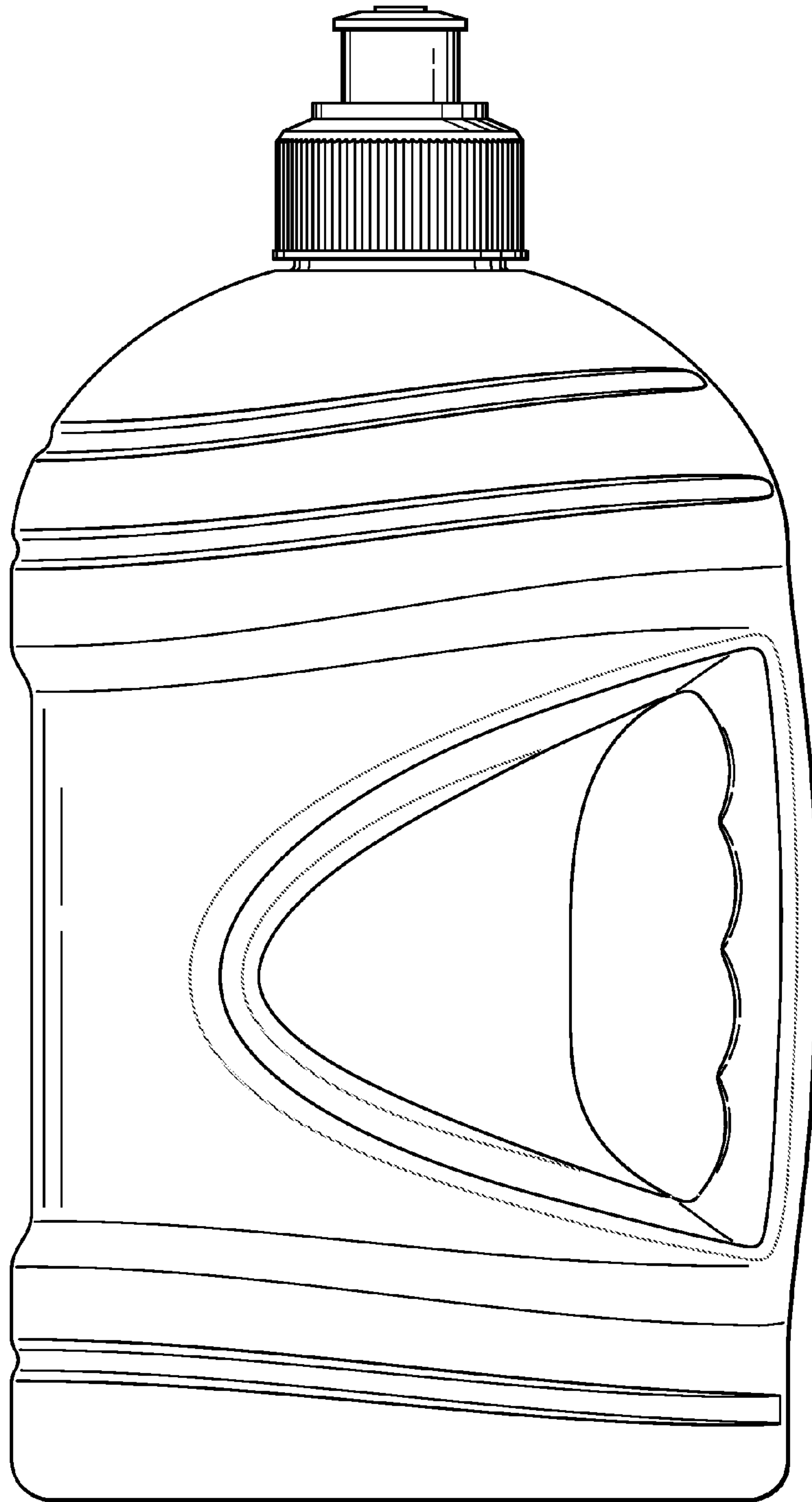

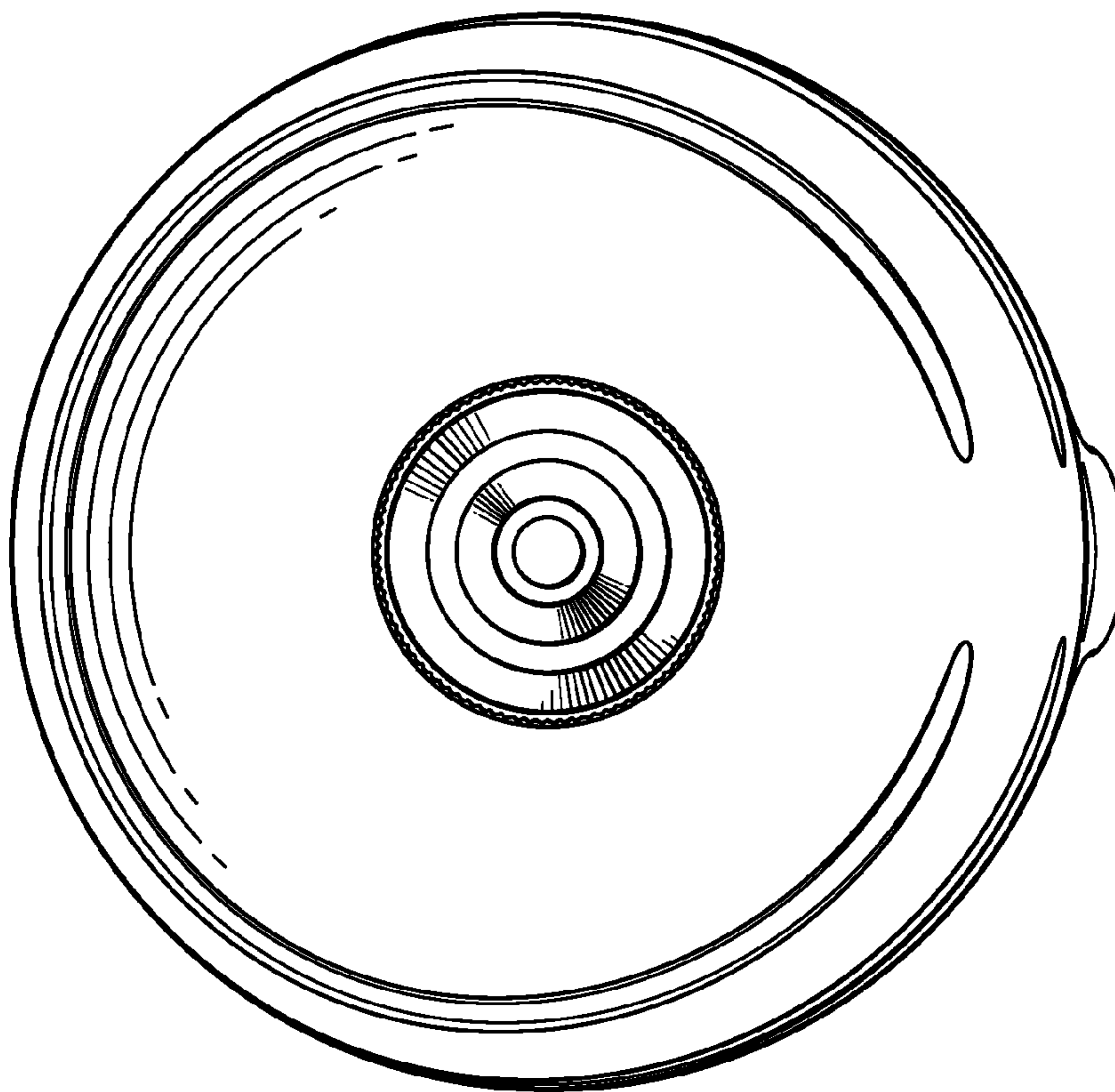
