The ornamental design for the computer with in-and-out icon and slide in-and-out module, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a computer with in-and-out icon and slide in-and-out module showing our new design in an open state;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof;

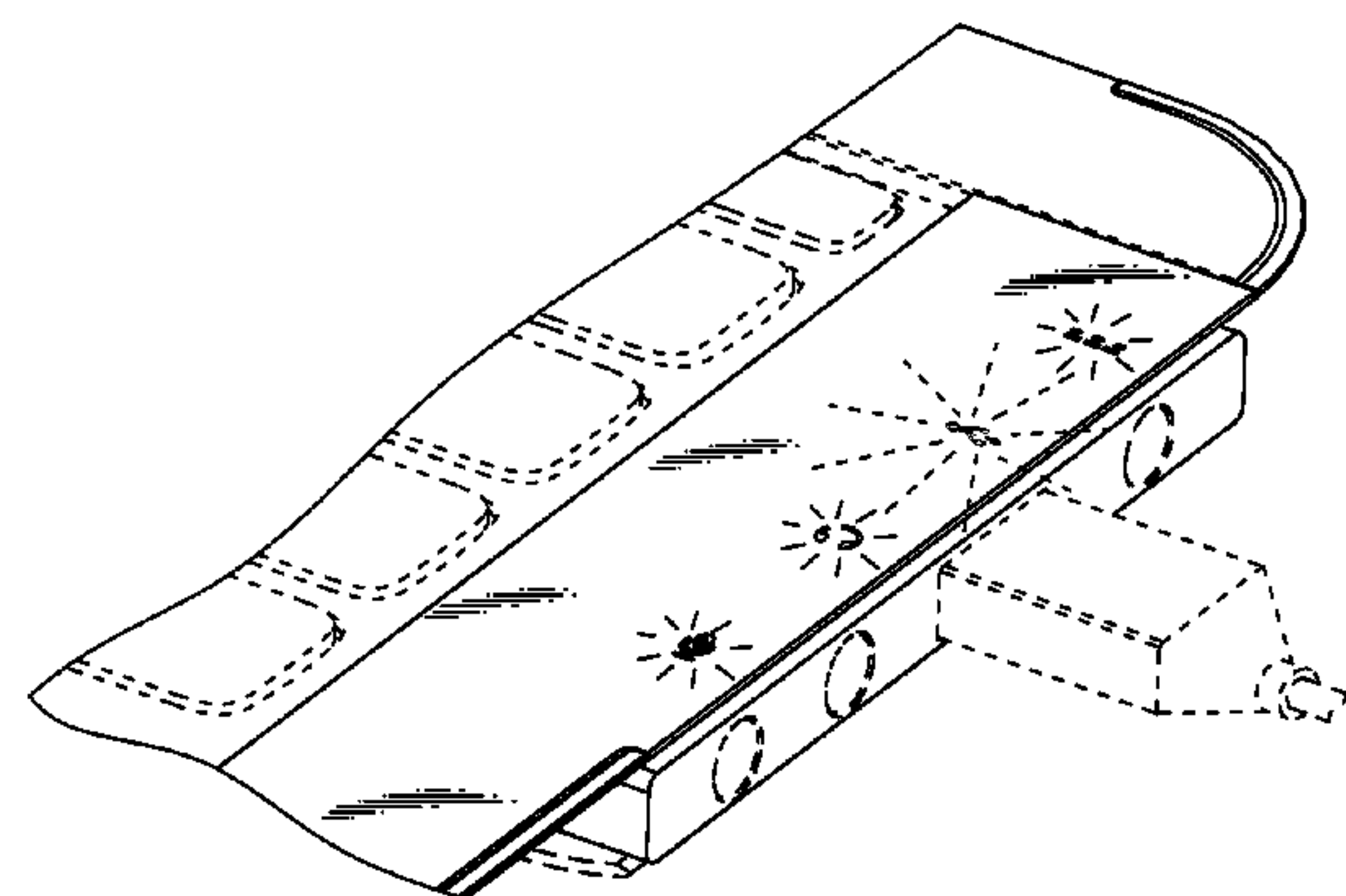
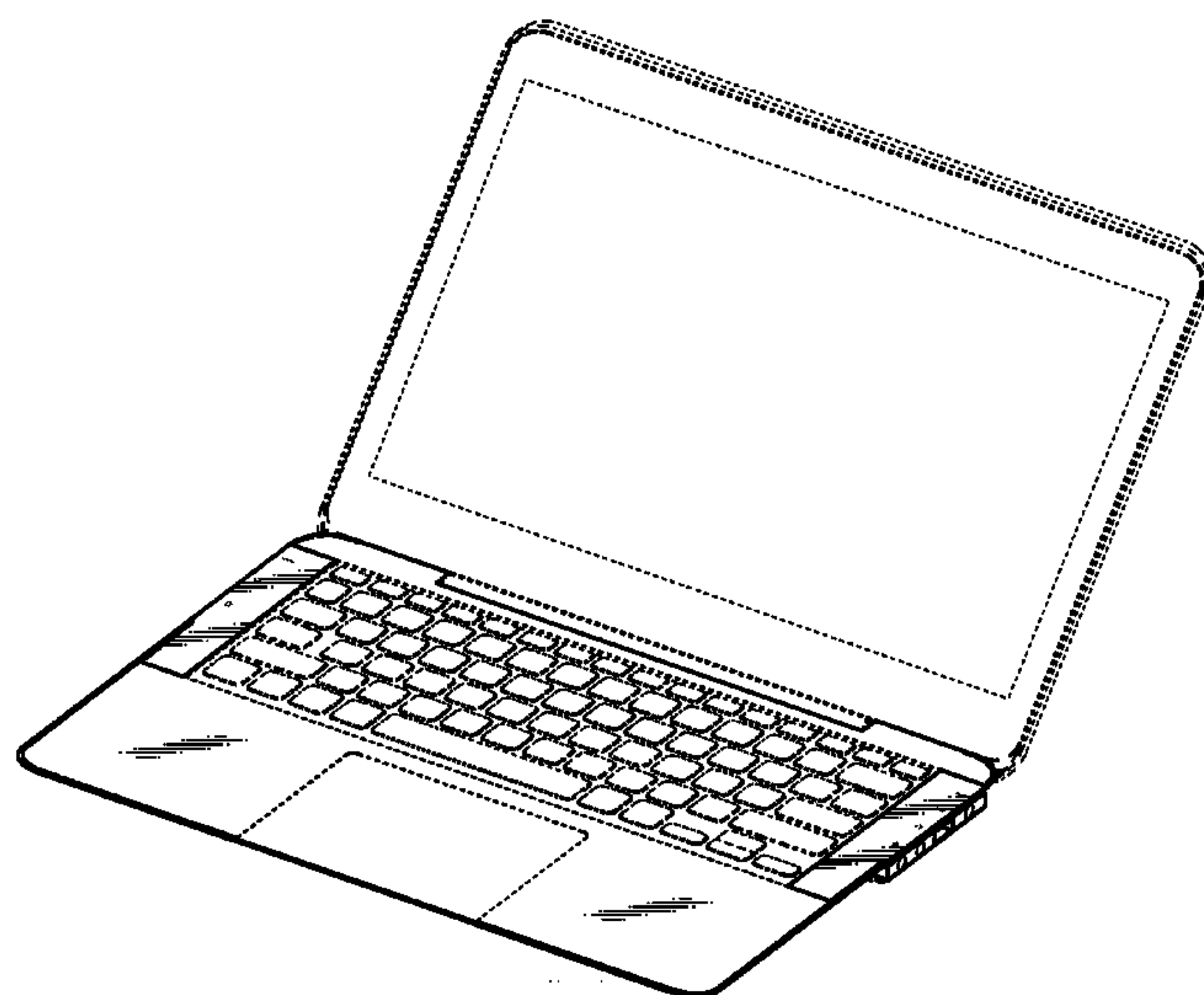
FIG. 7 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged top, front, and right perspective view of the in-and-out module of FIG. 1 in open state with in-and-out icon in low light condition; and,

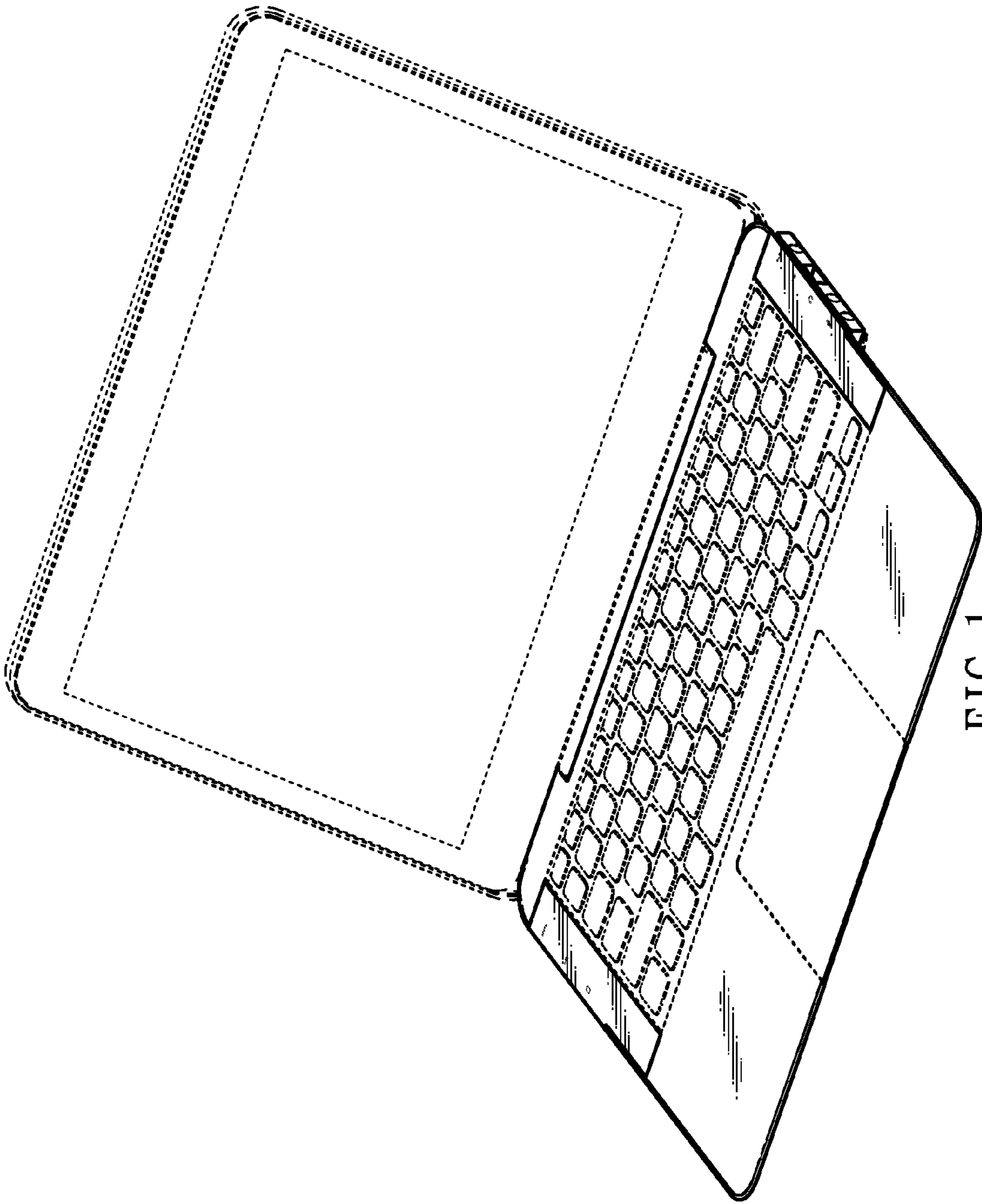

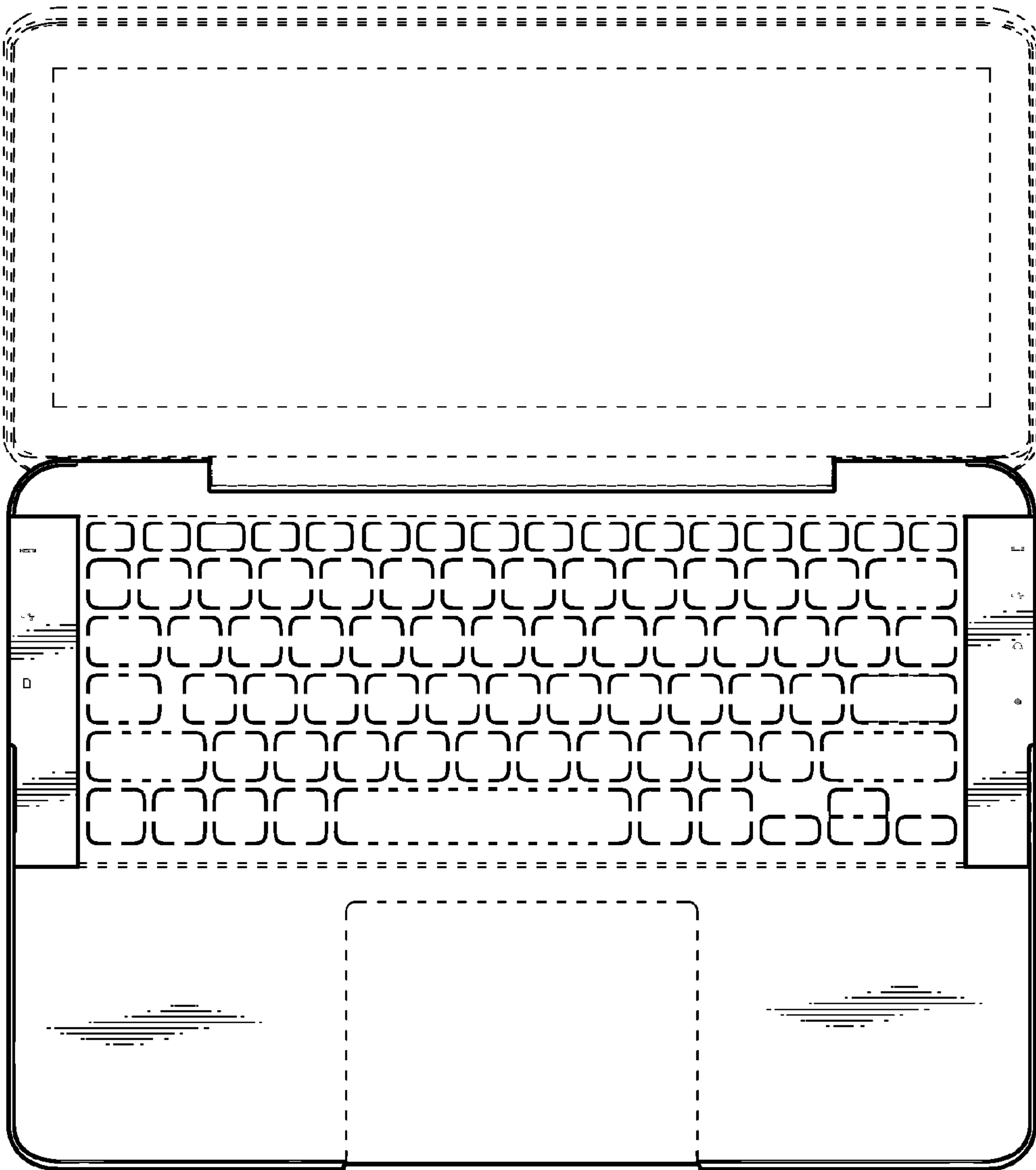

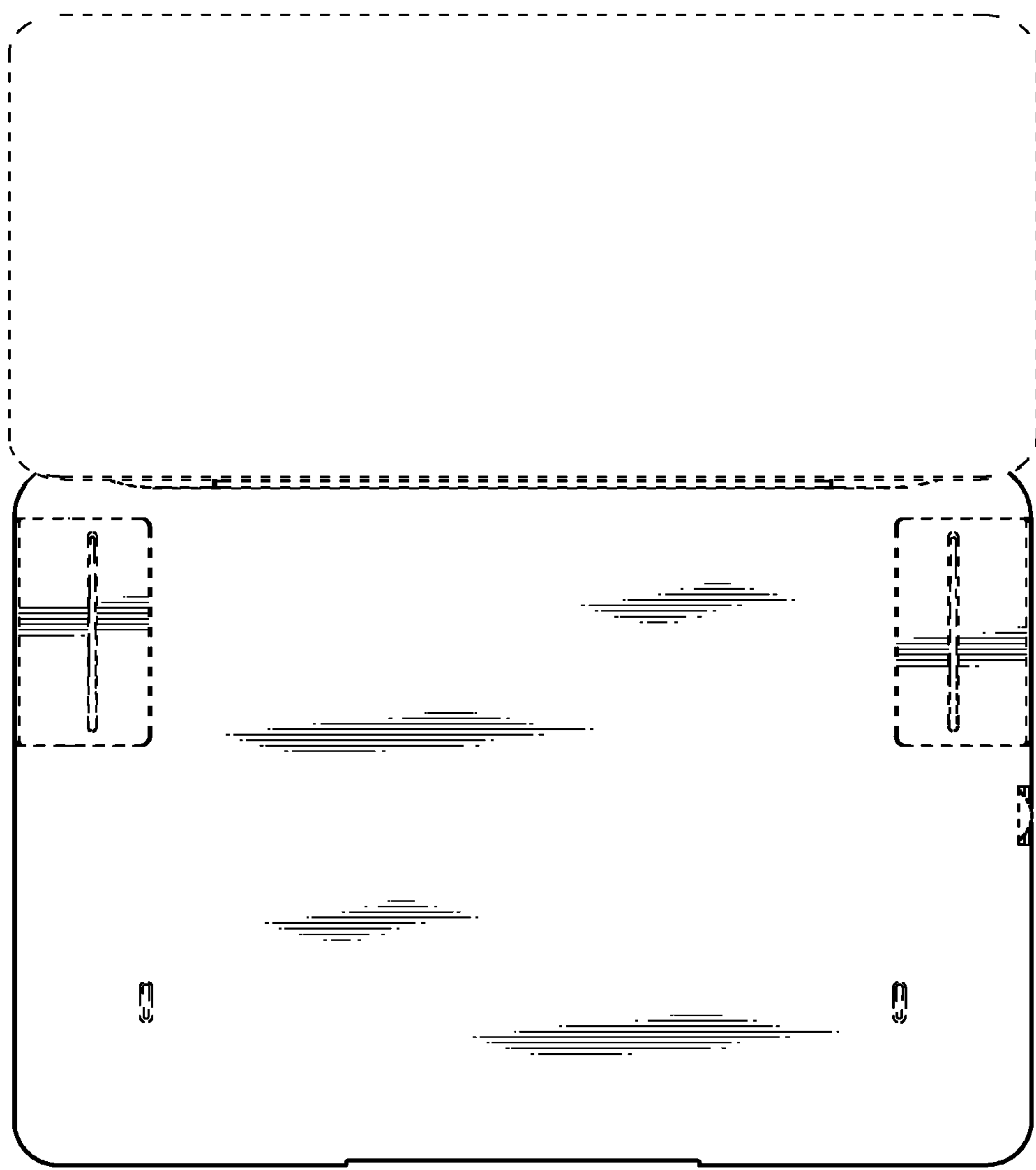

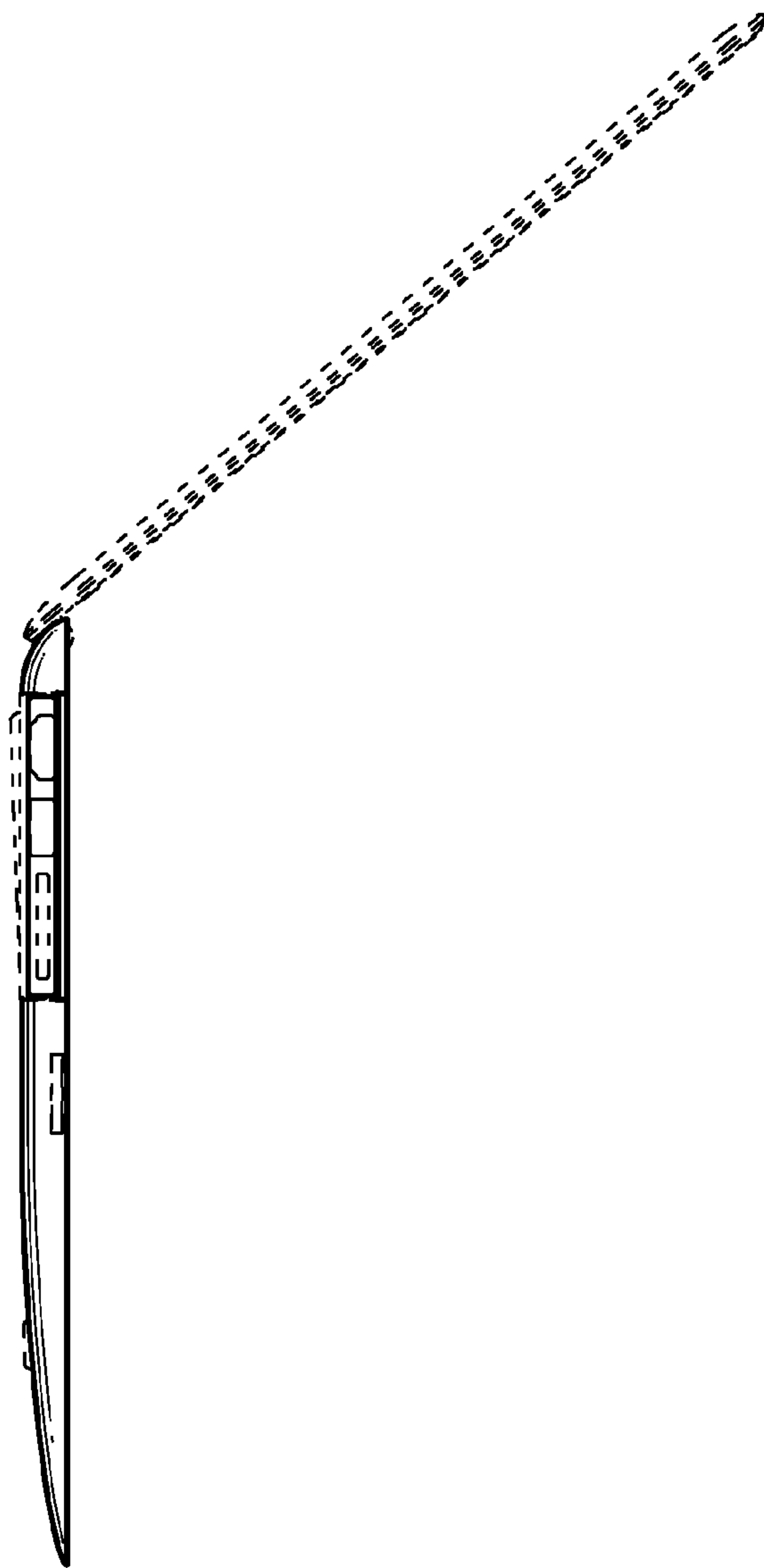

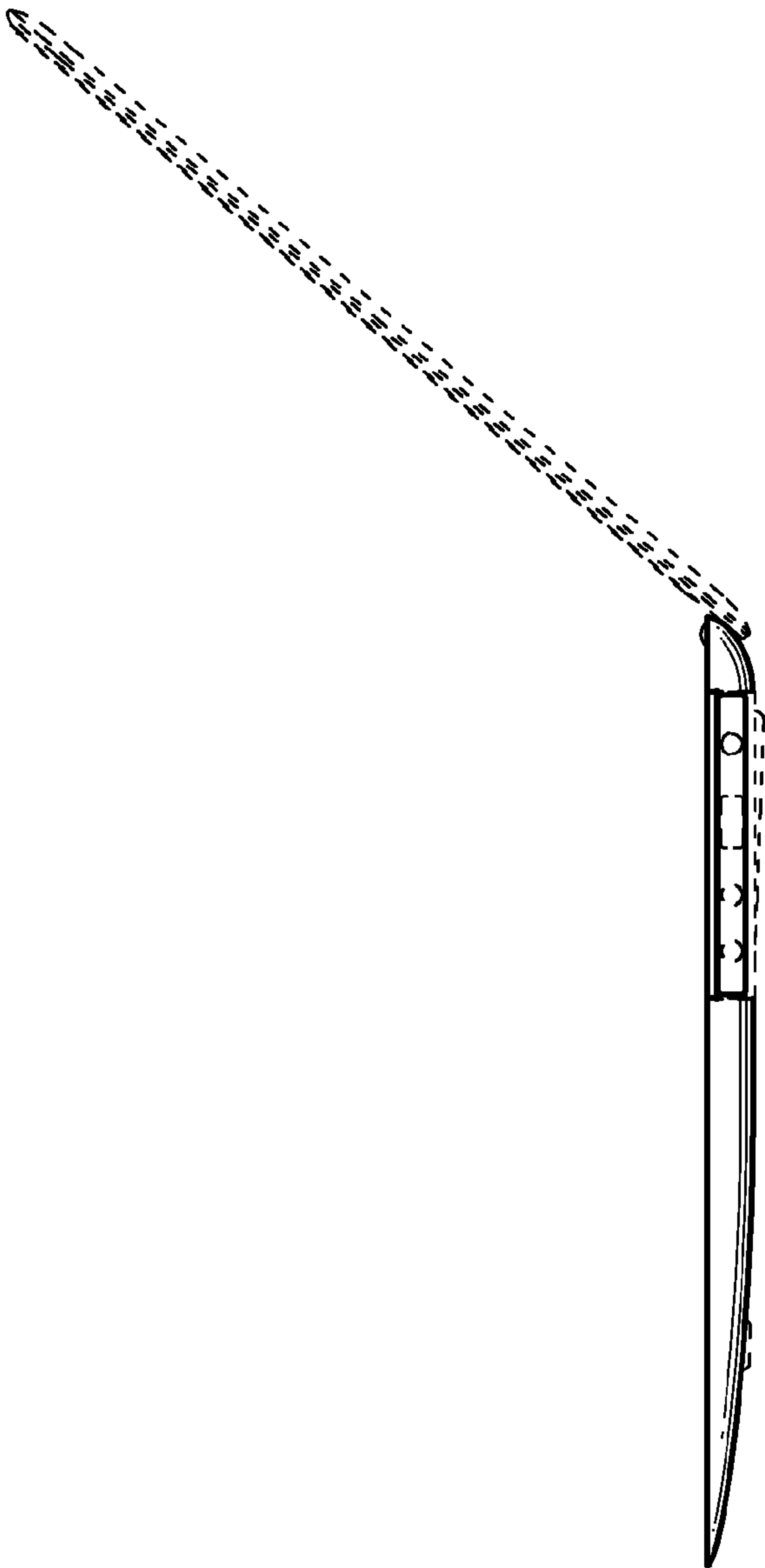

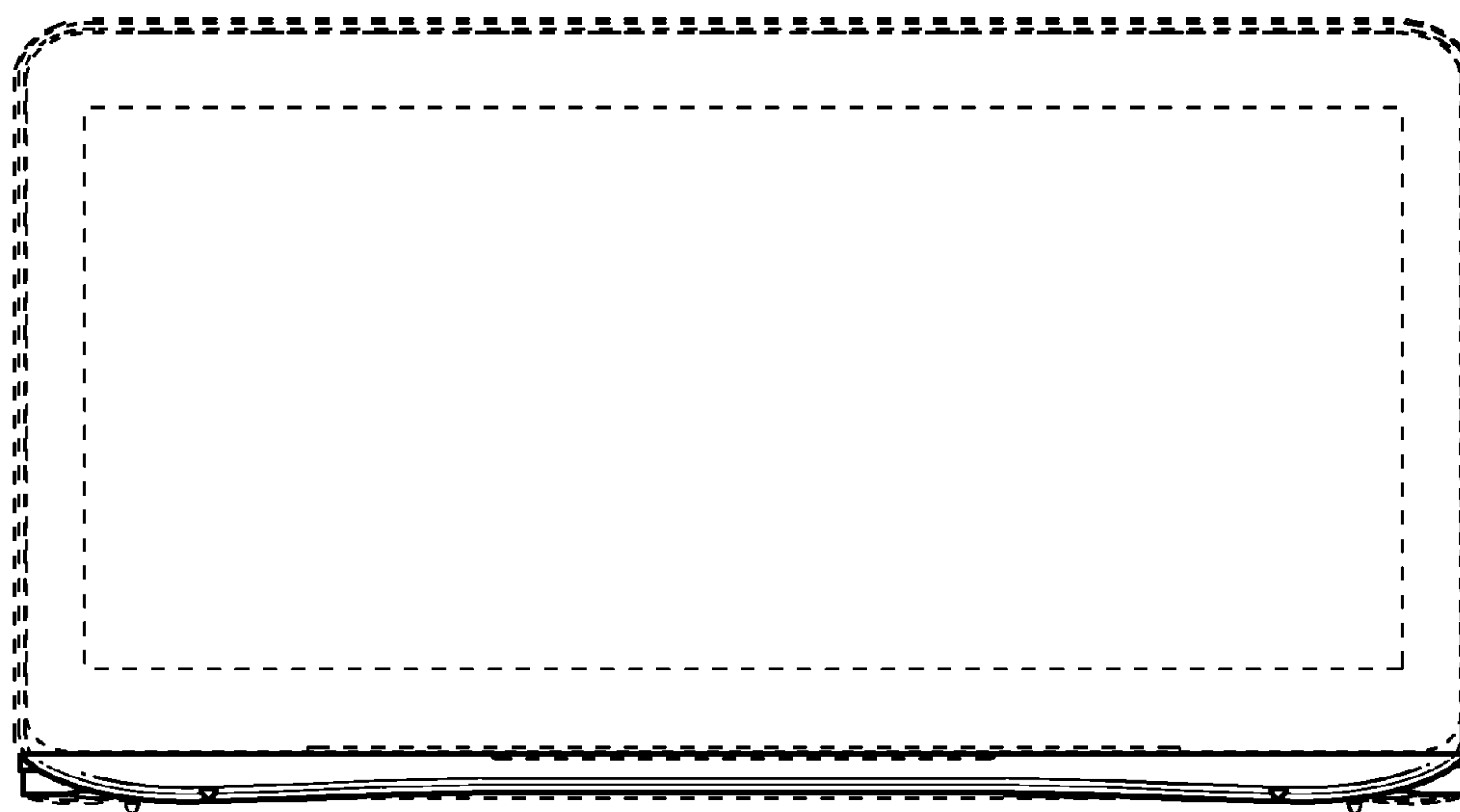

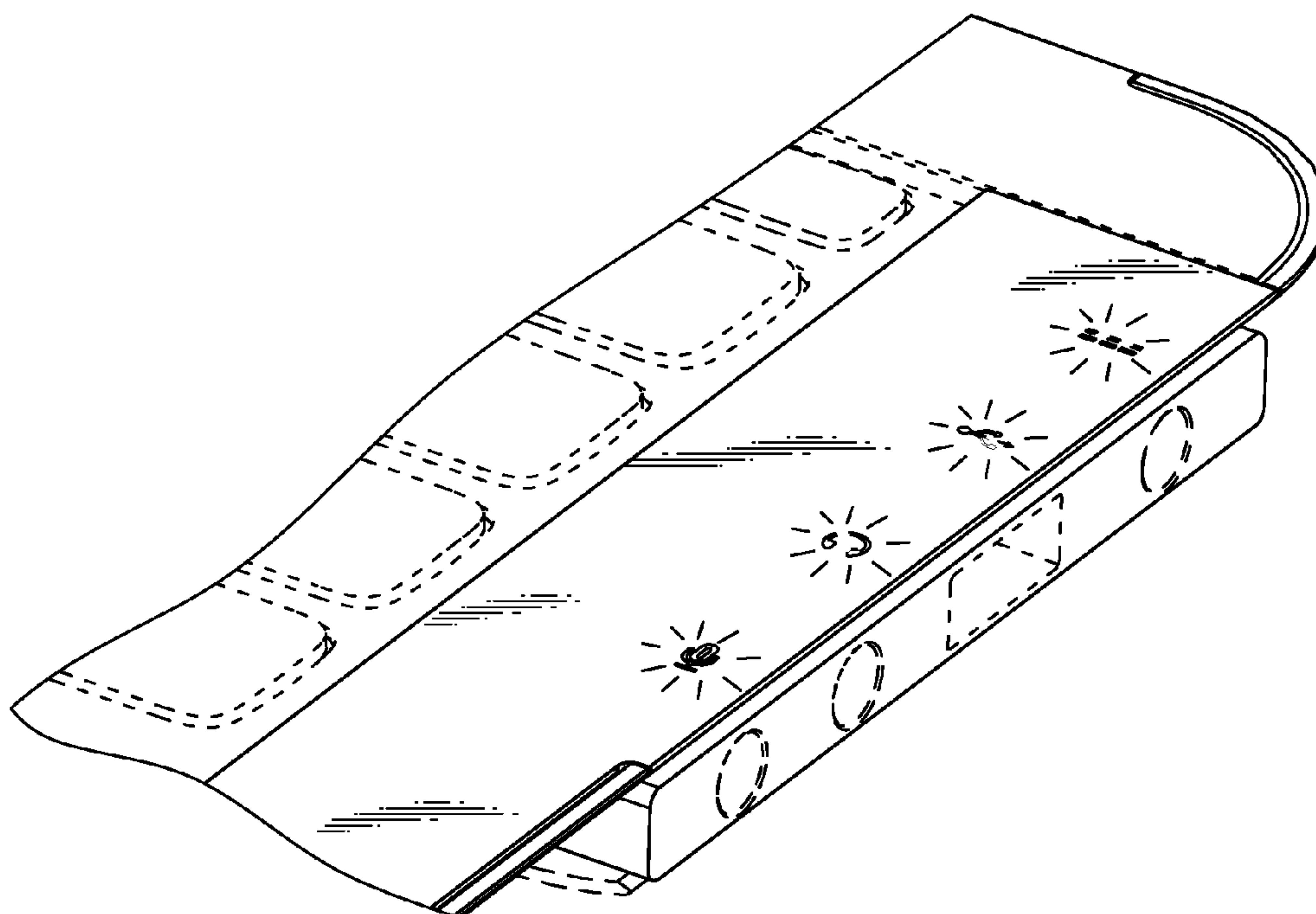

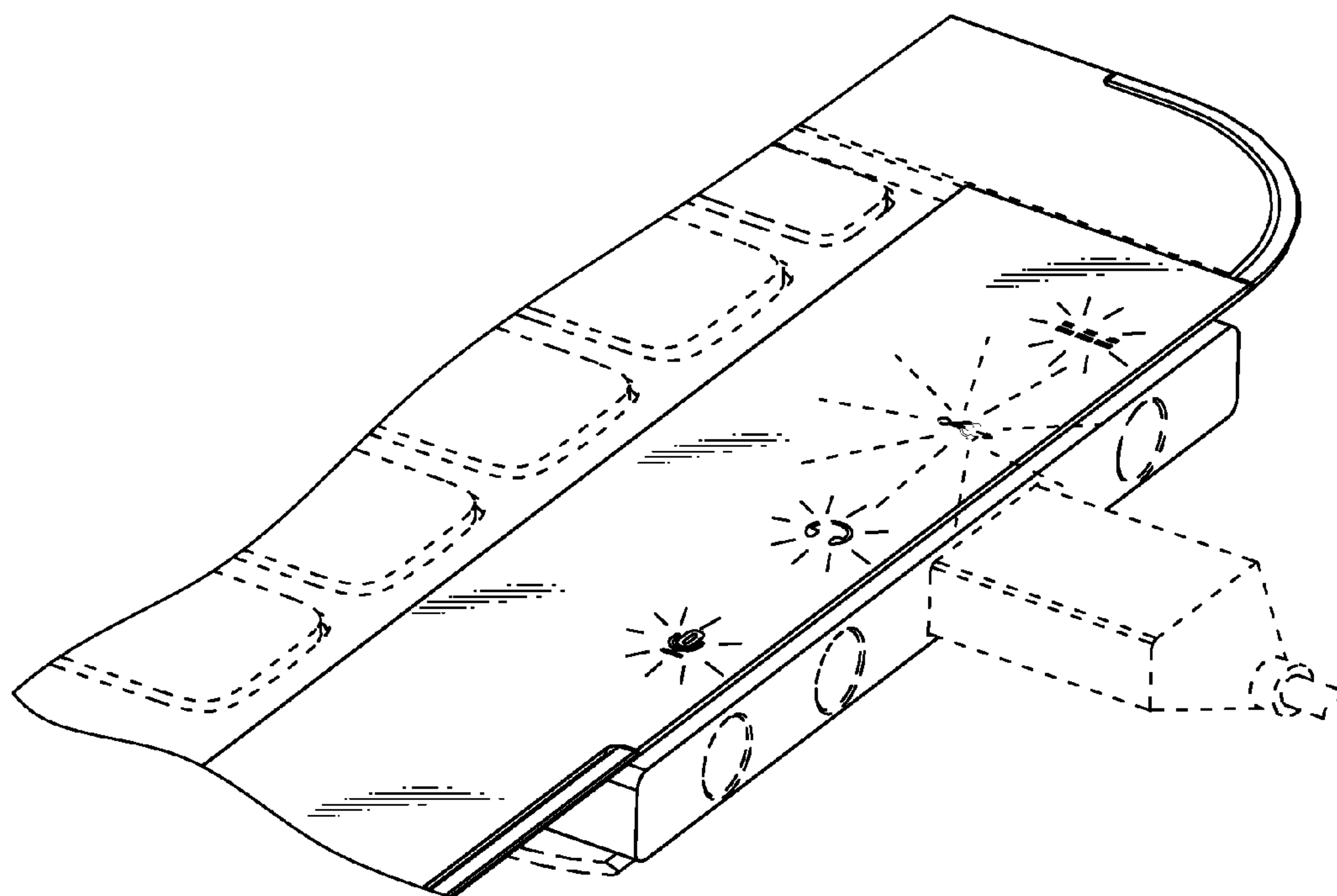
