FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

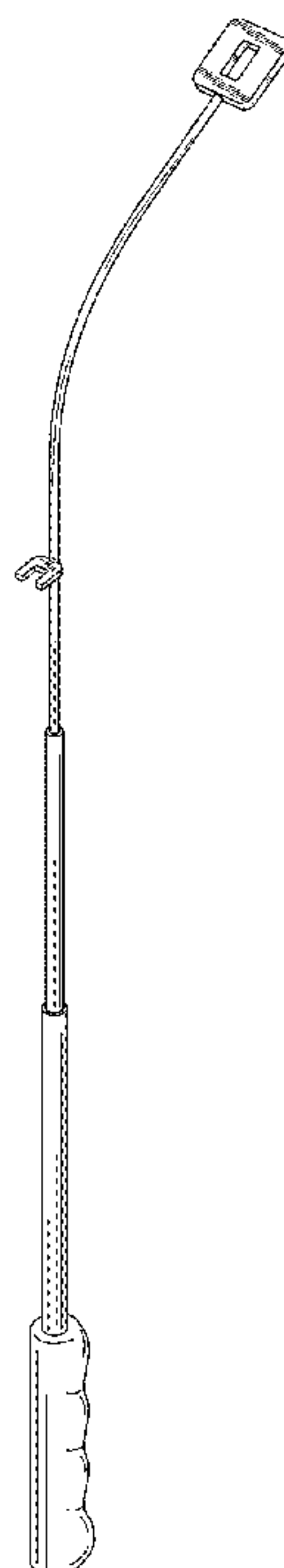
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

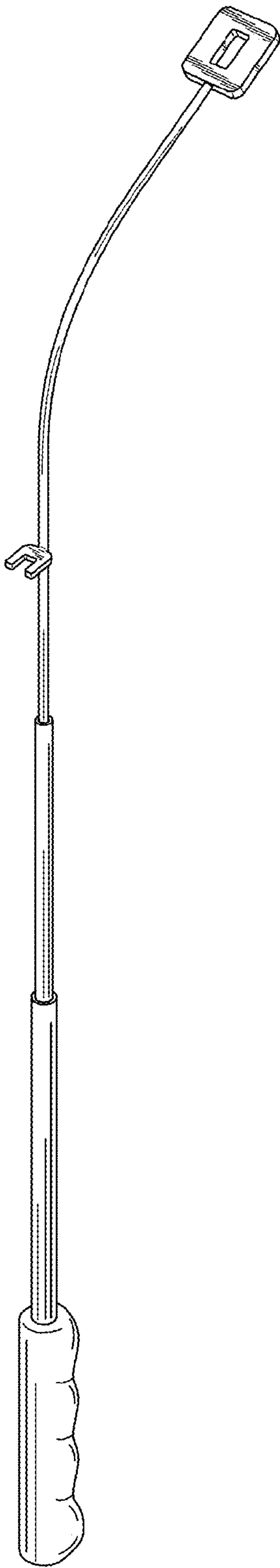

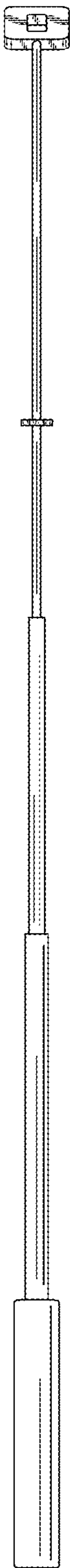

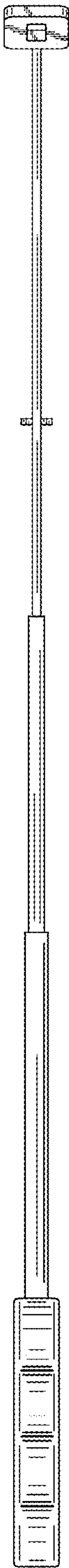

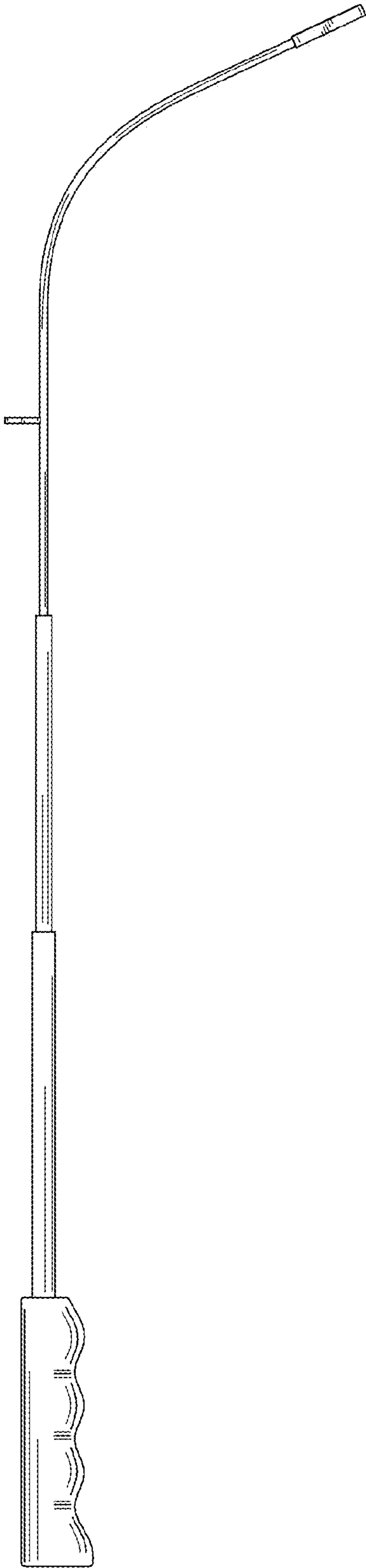

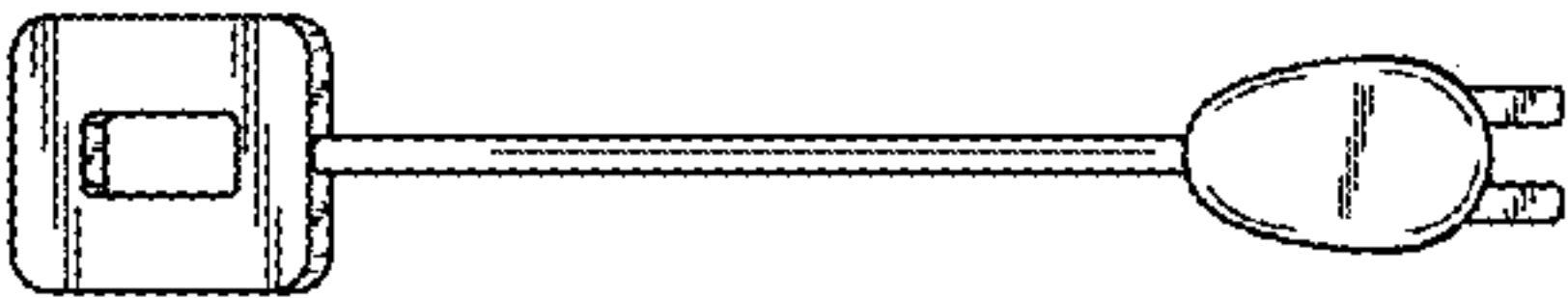
