FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spoke segment of a vehicle wheel according to my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

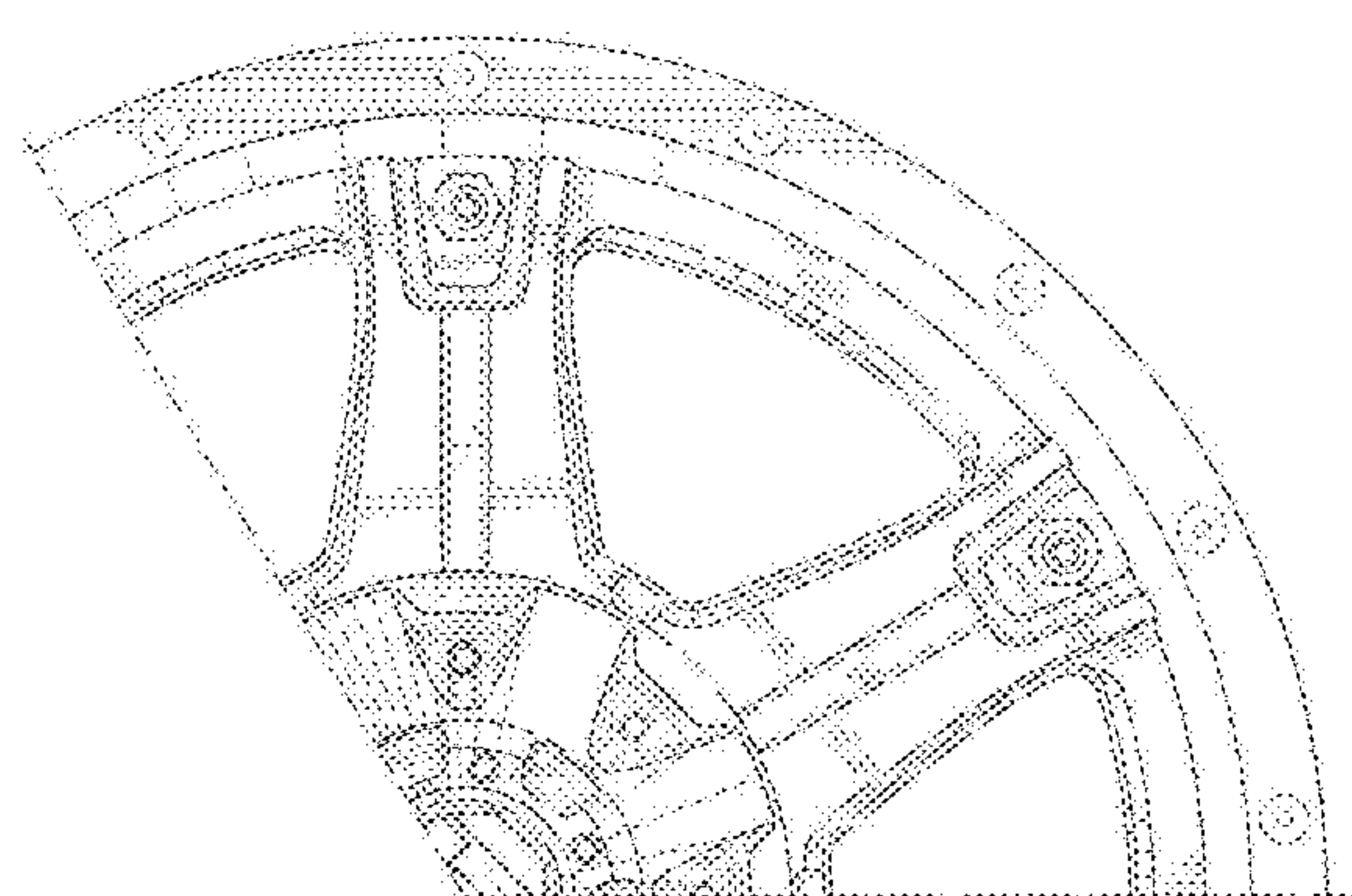
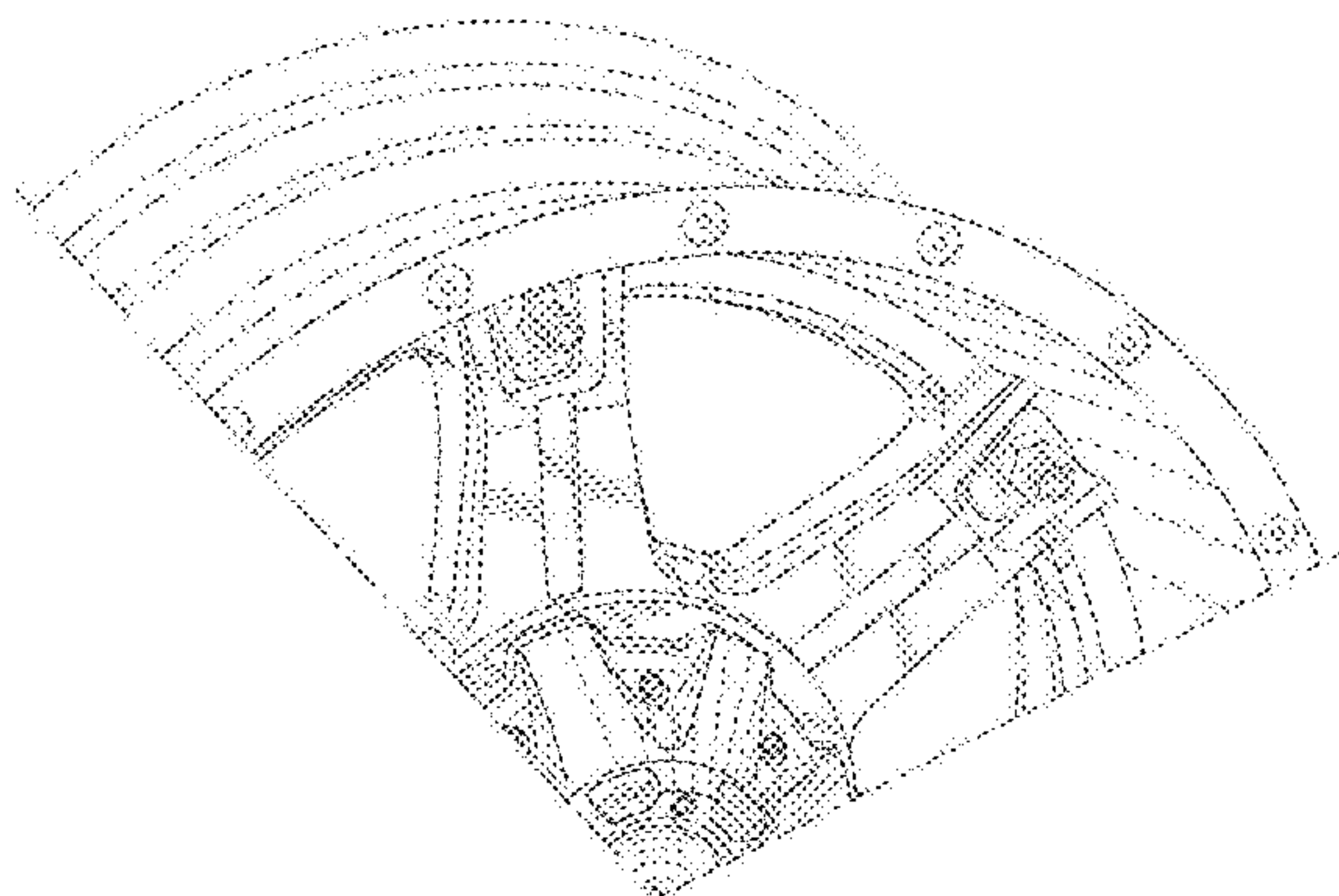

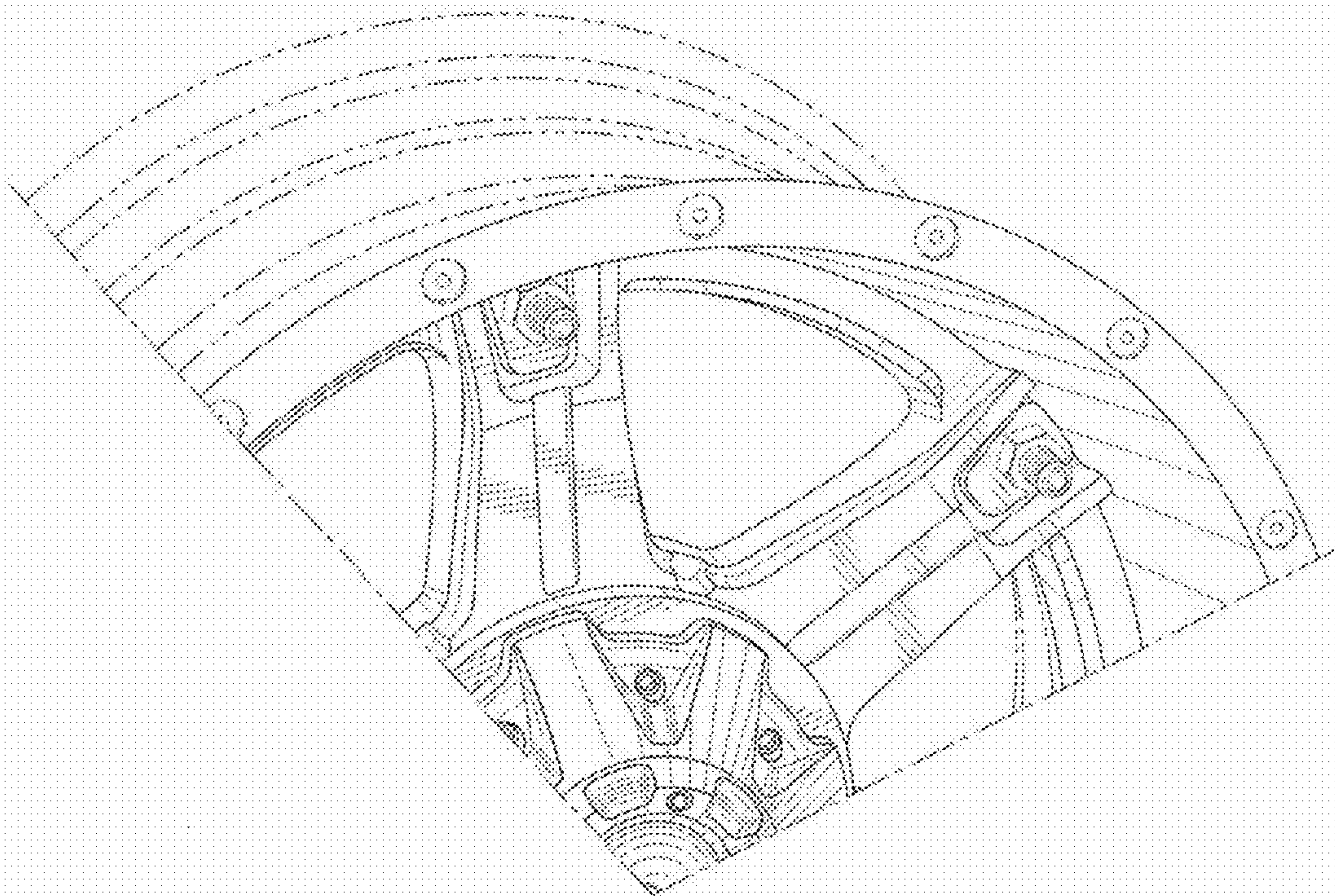
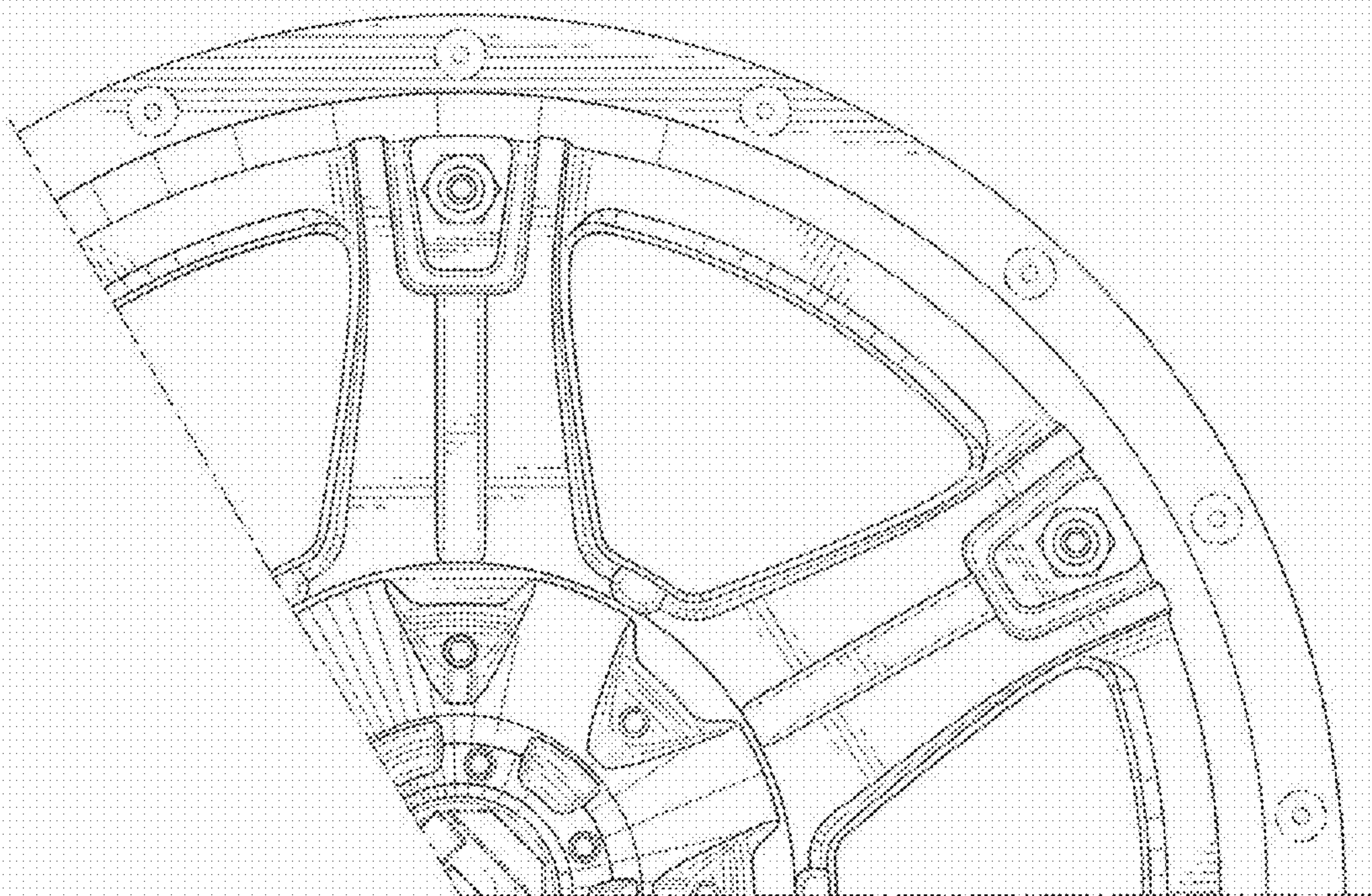
