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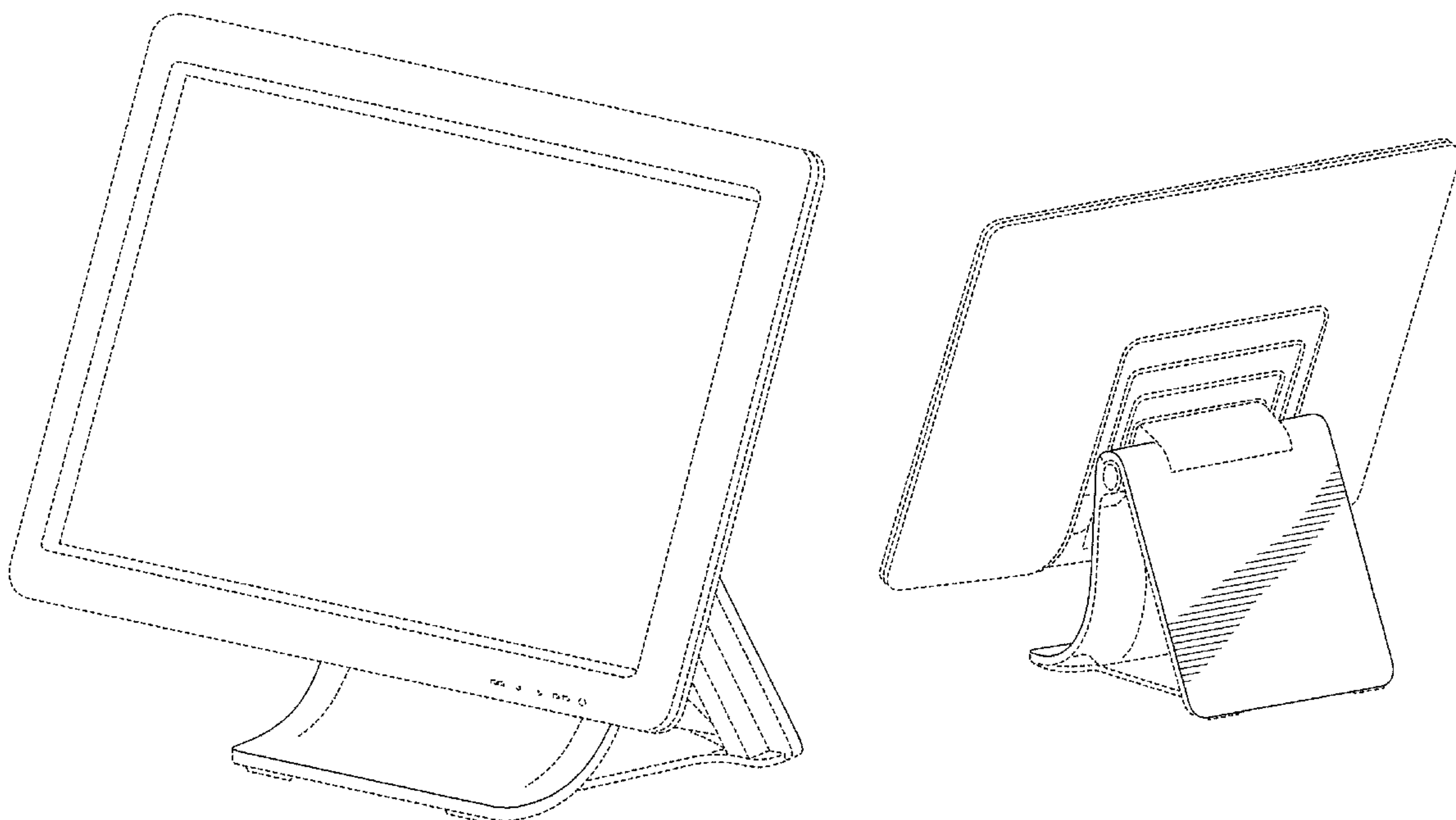
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stand showing my
design, shown in a use configuration with a monitor;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is another right side elevation view thereof.

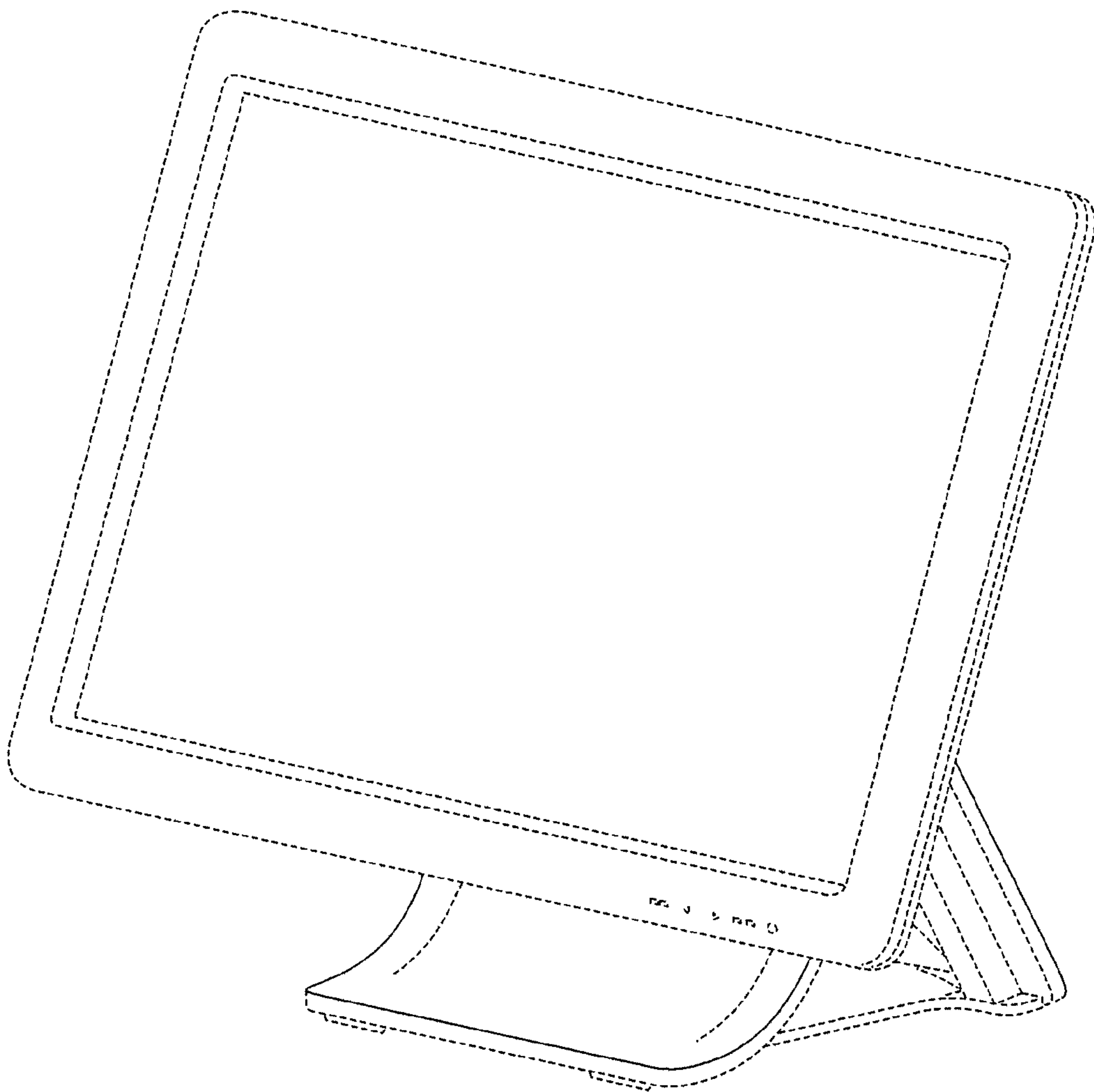

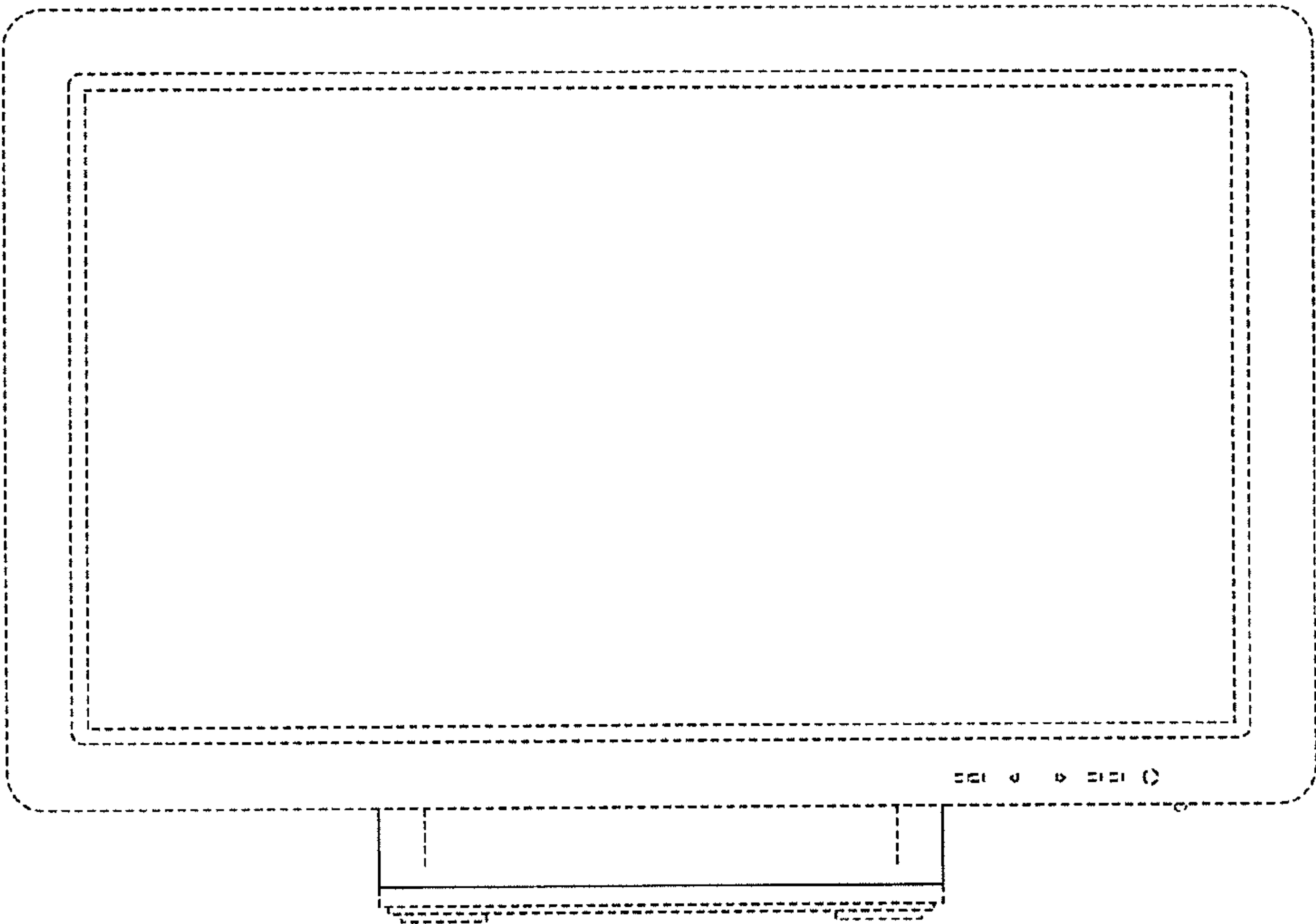

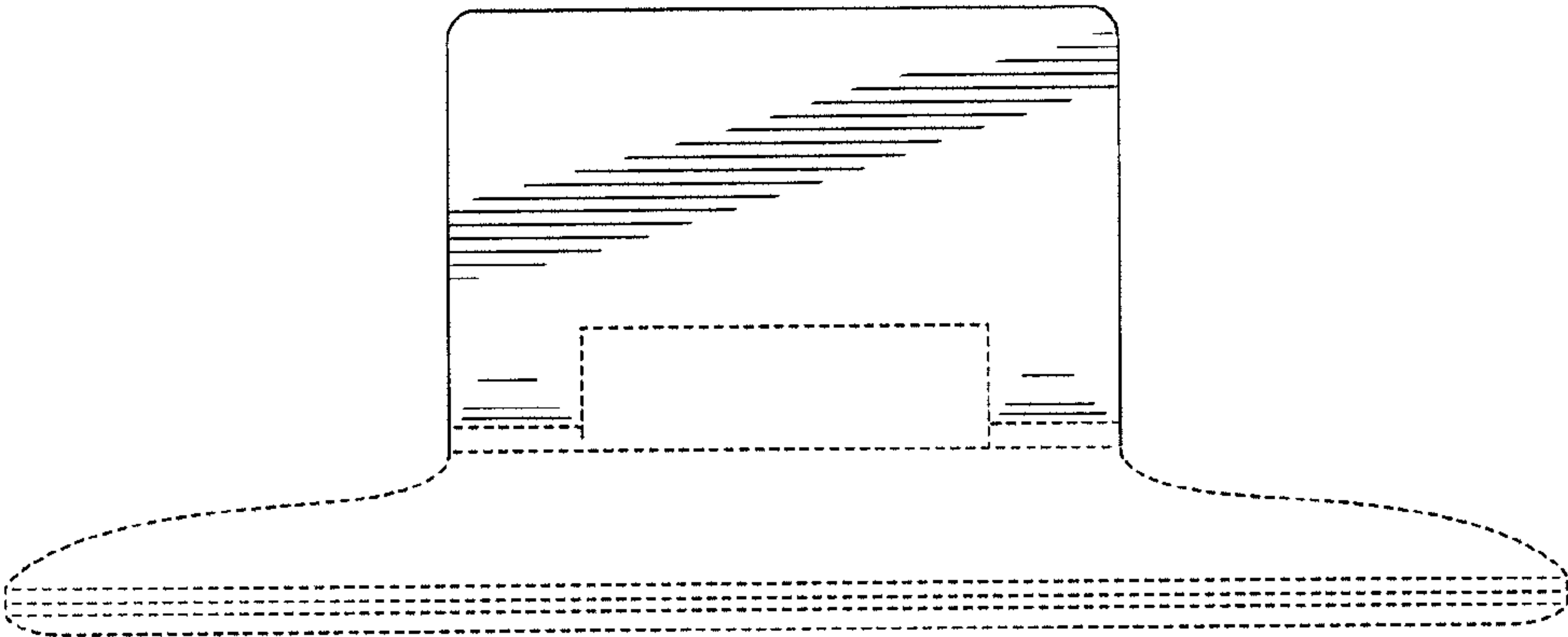

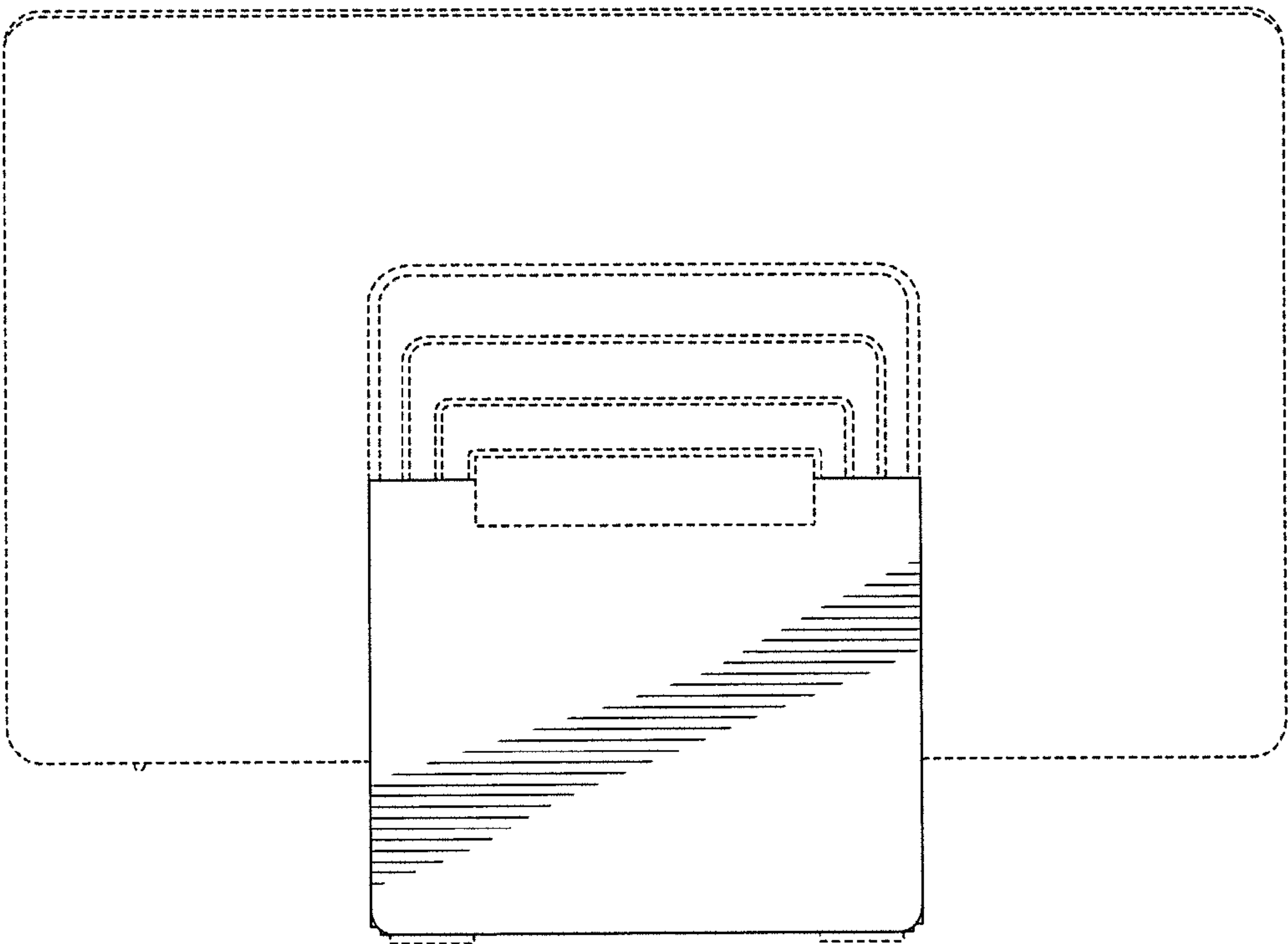

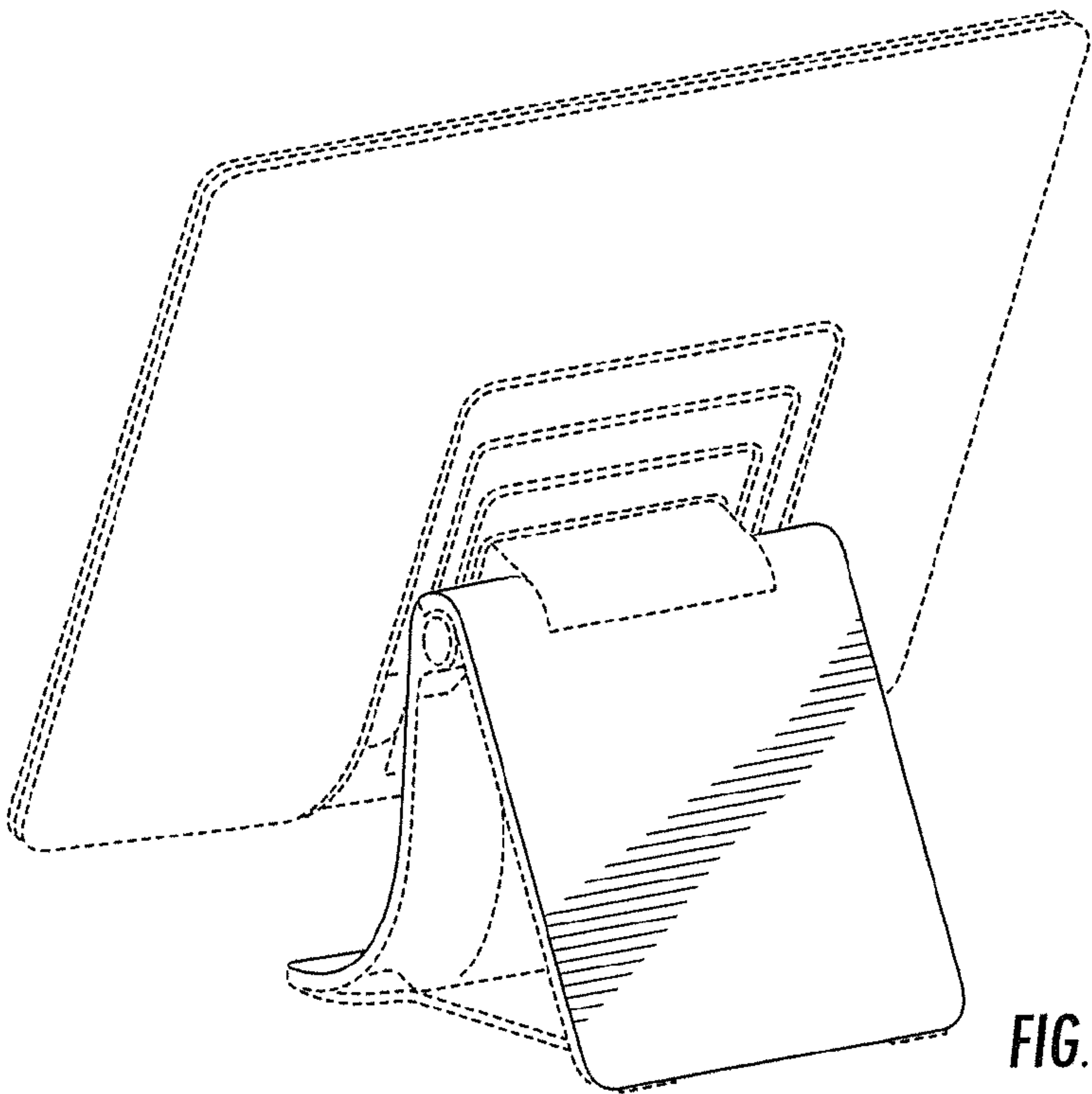

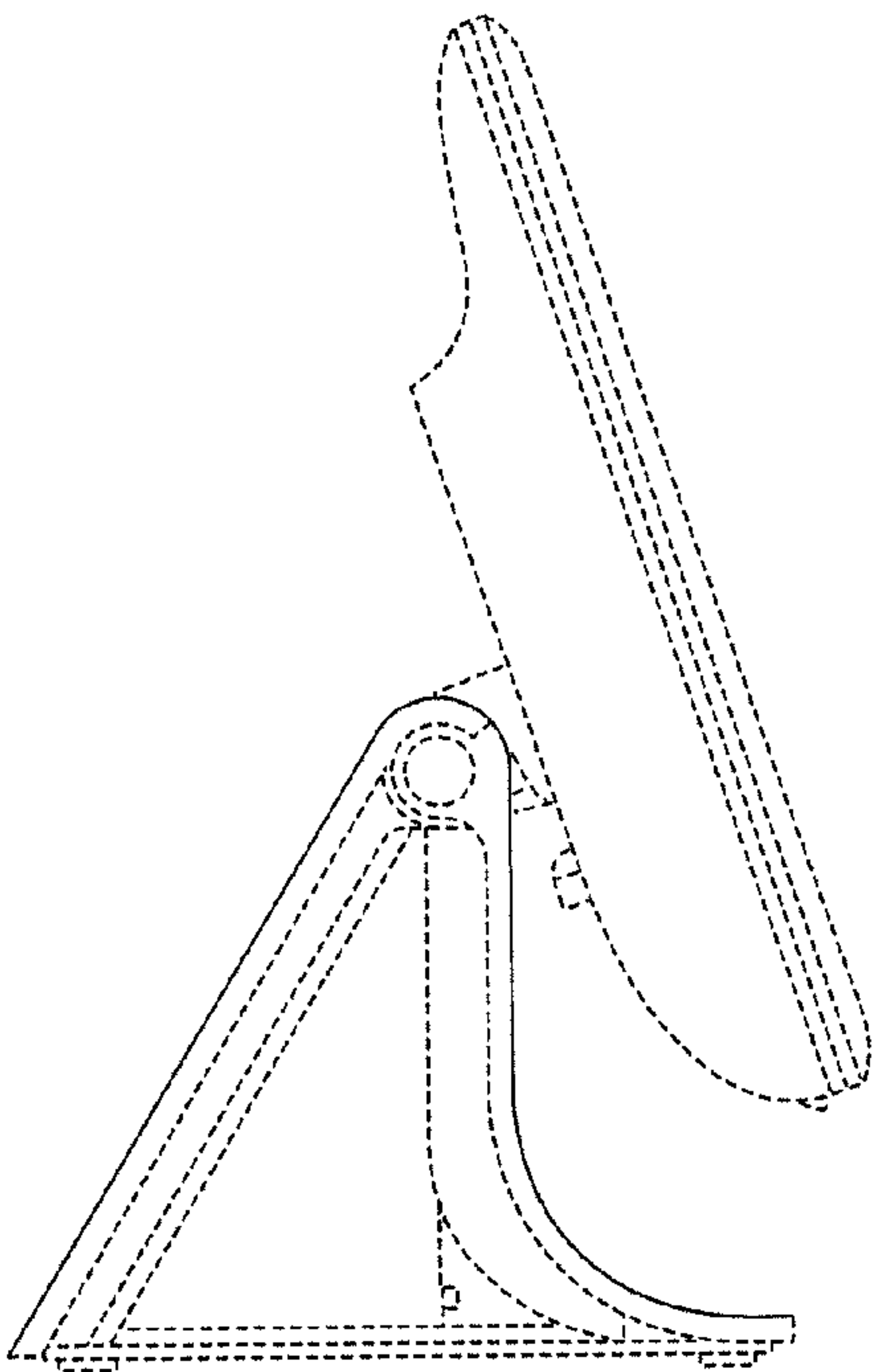

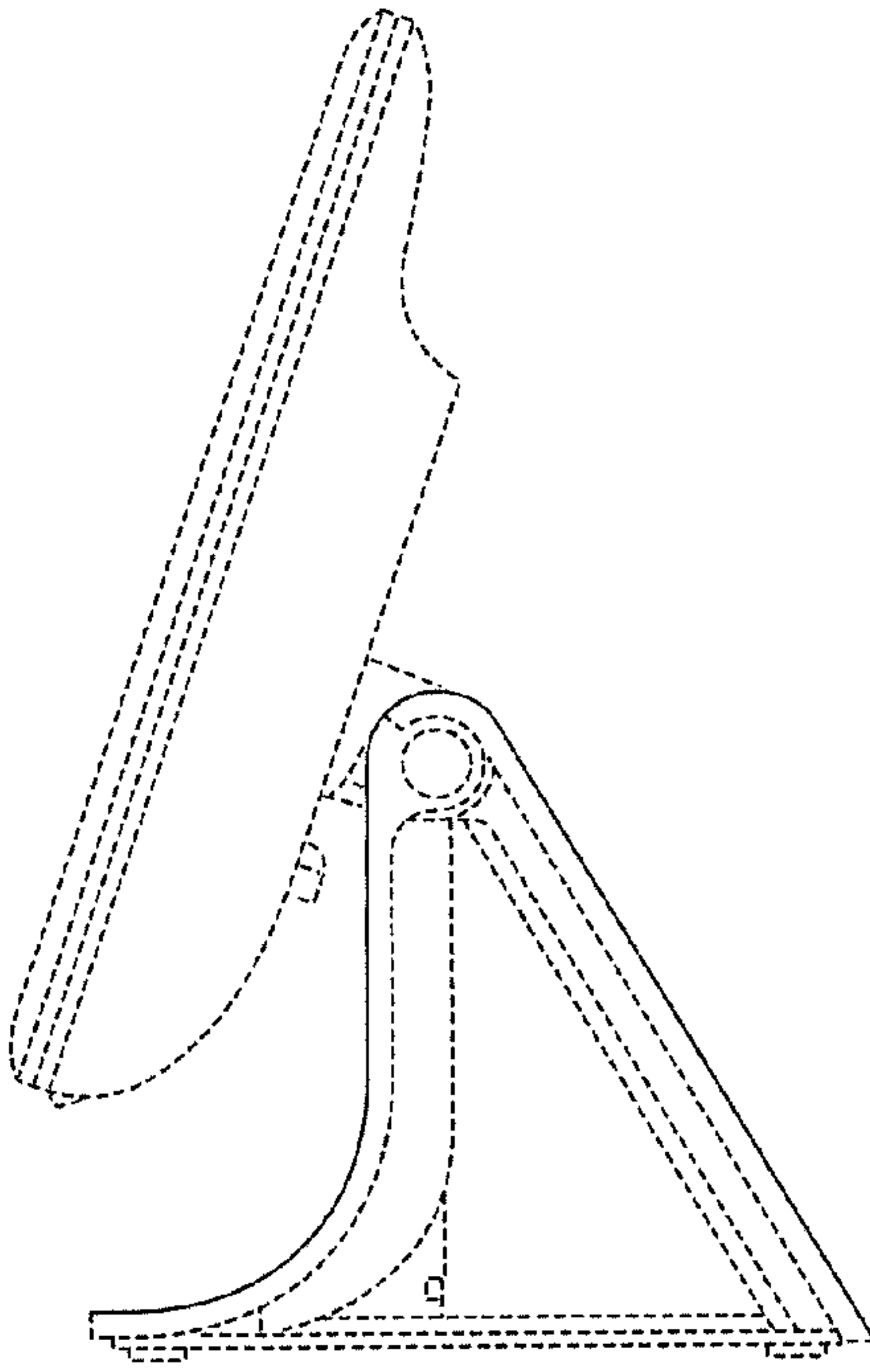

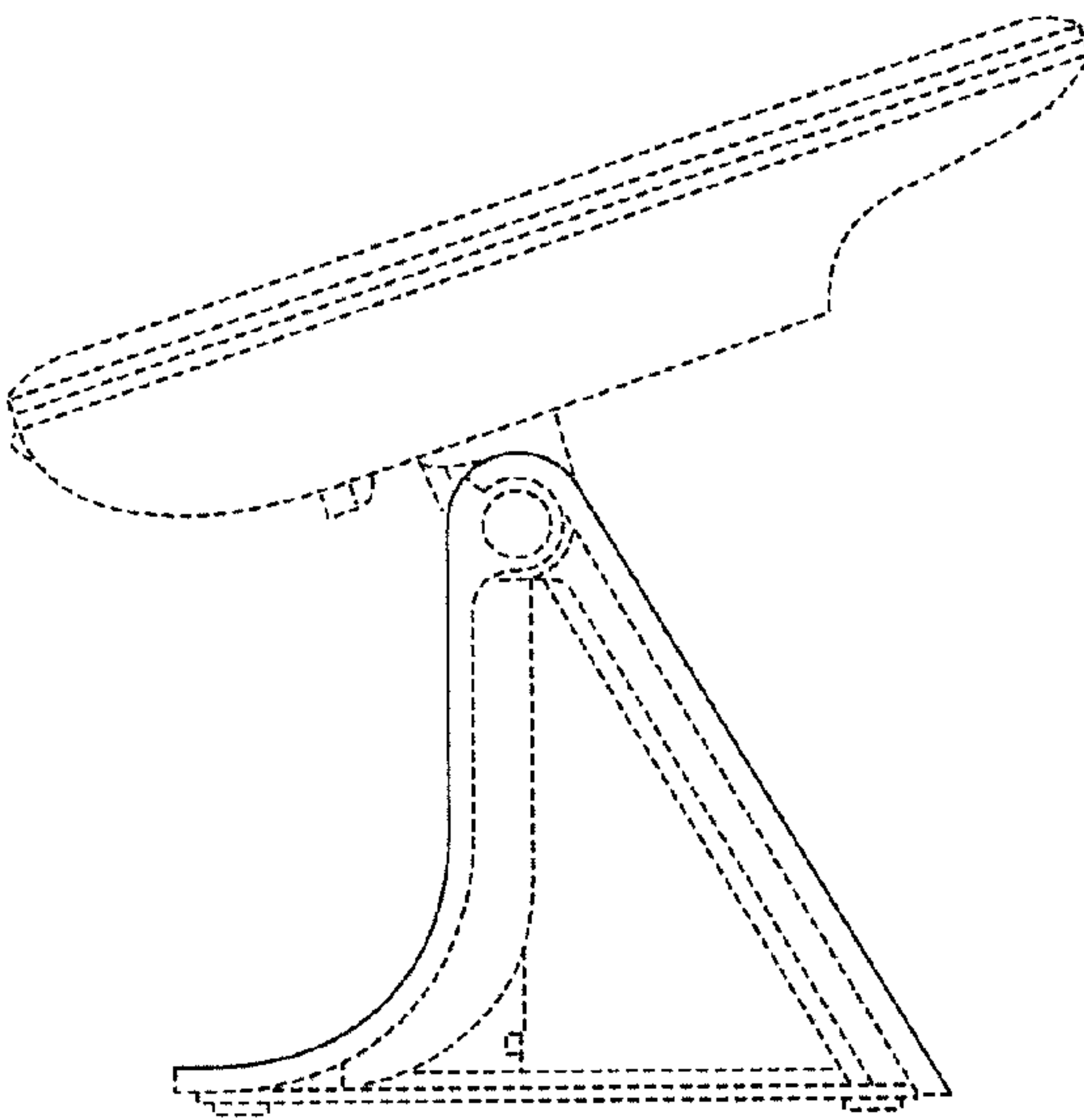
