FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

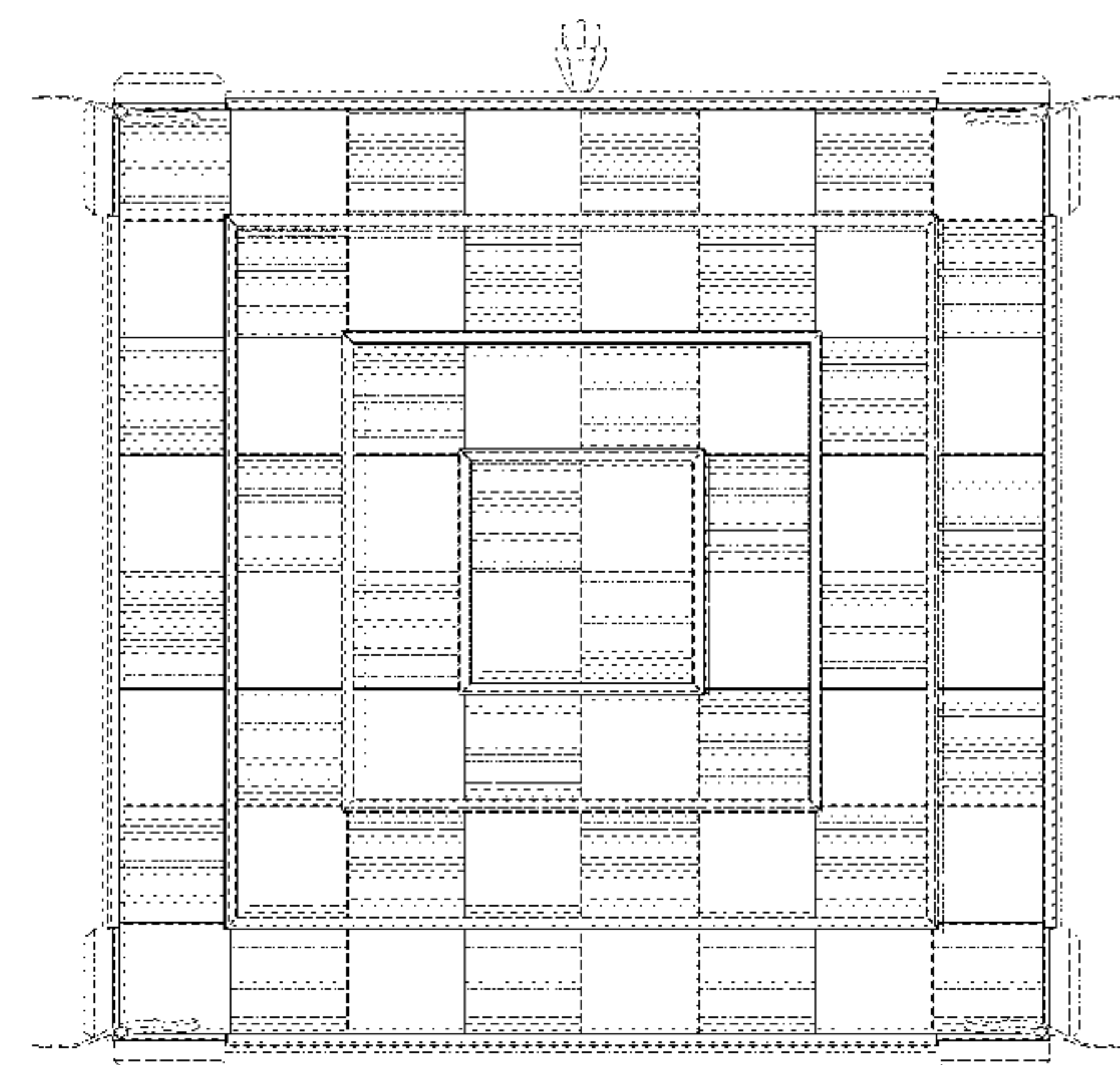
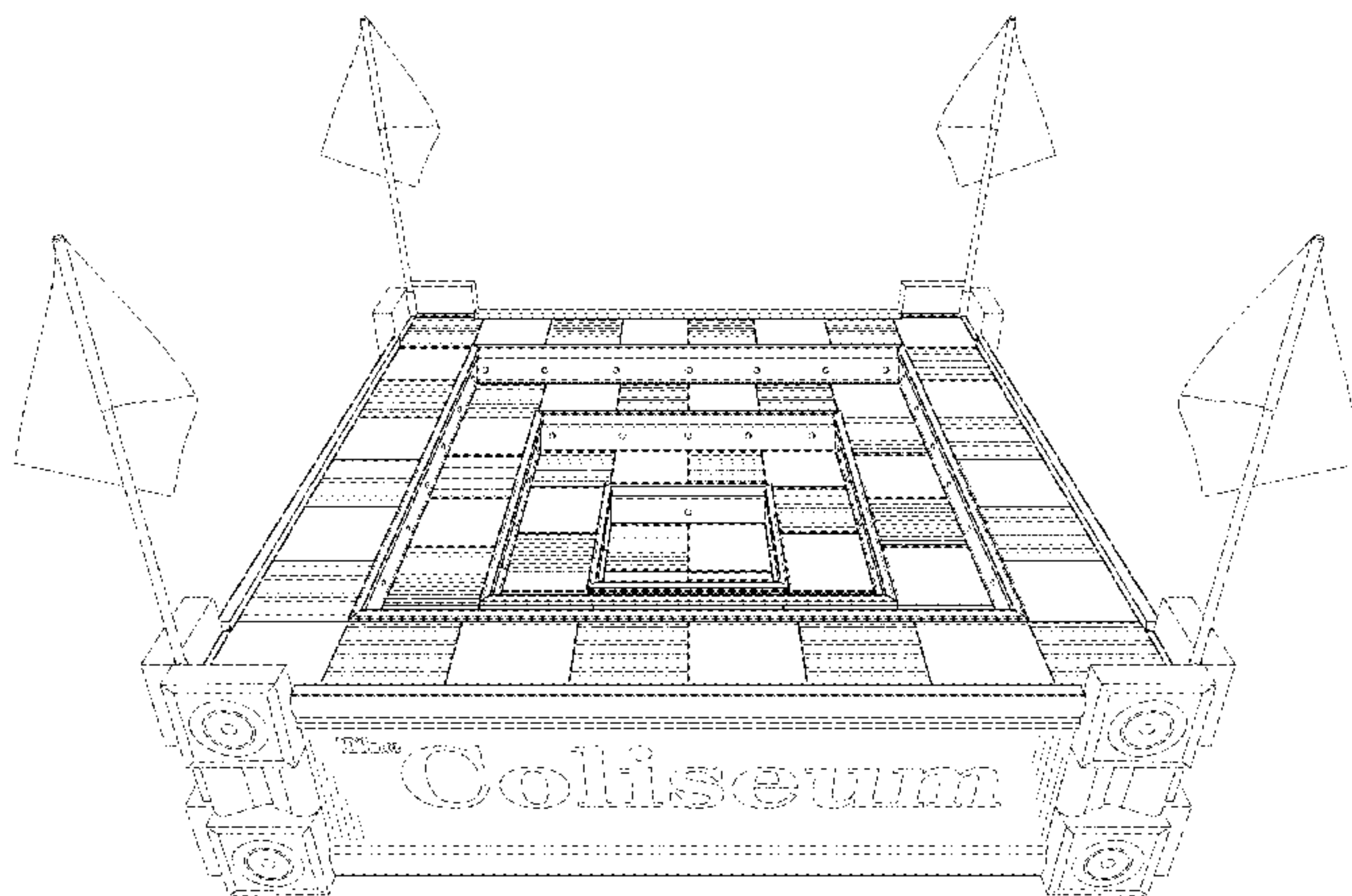
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being identical to the front elevational view;

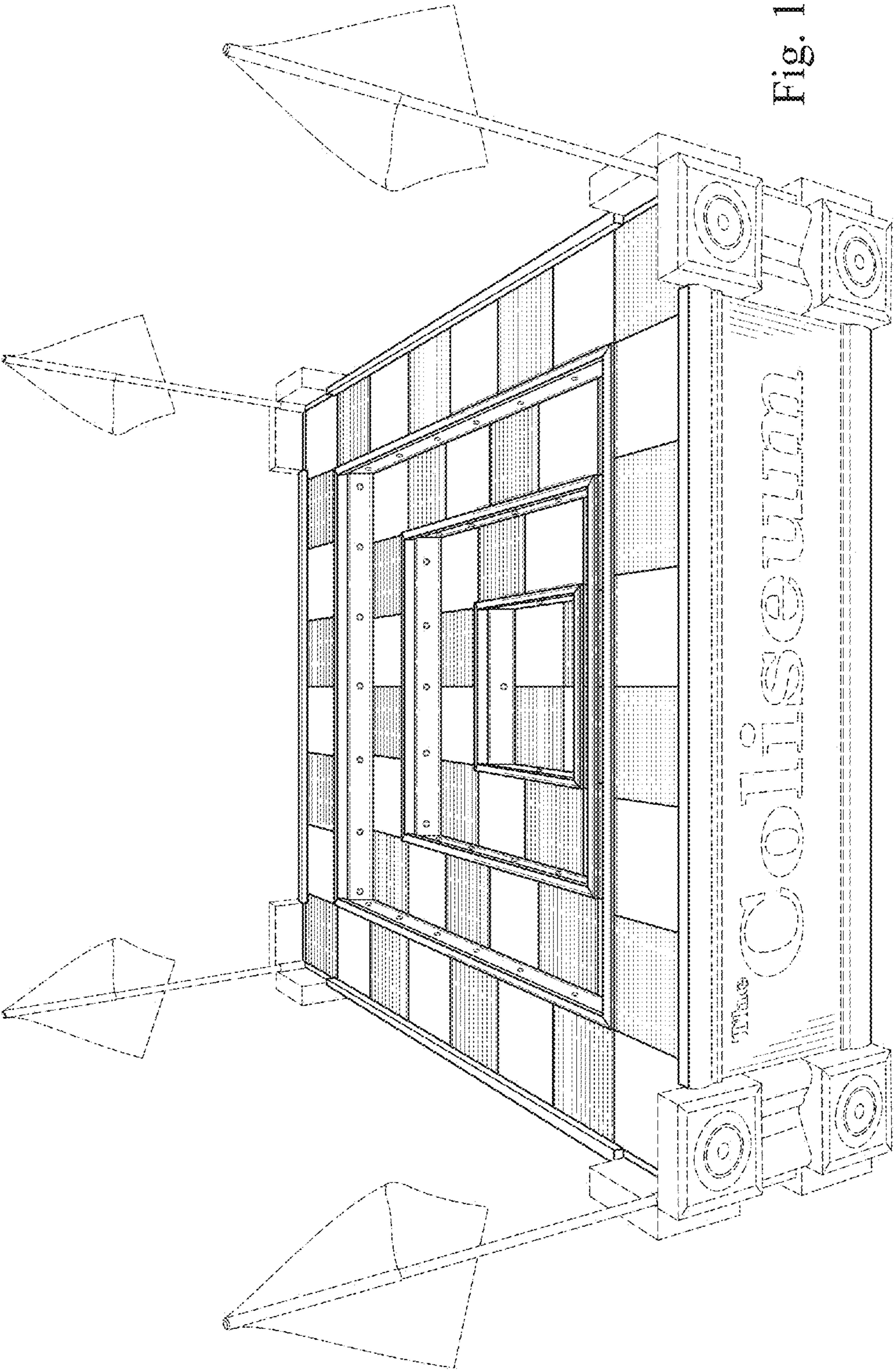

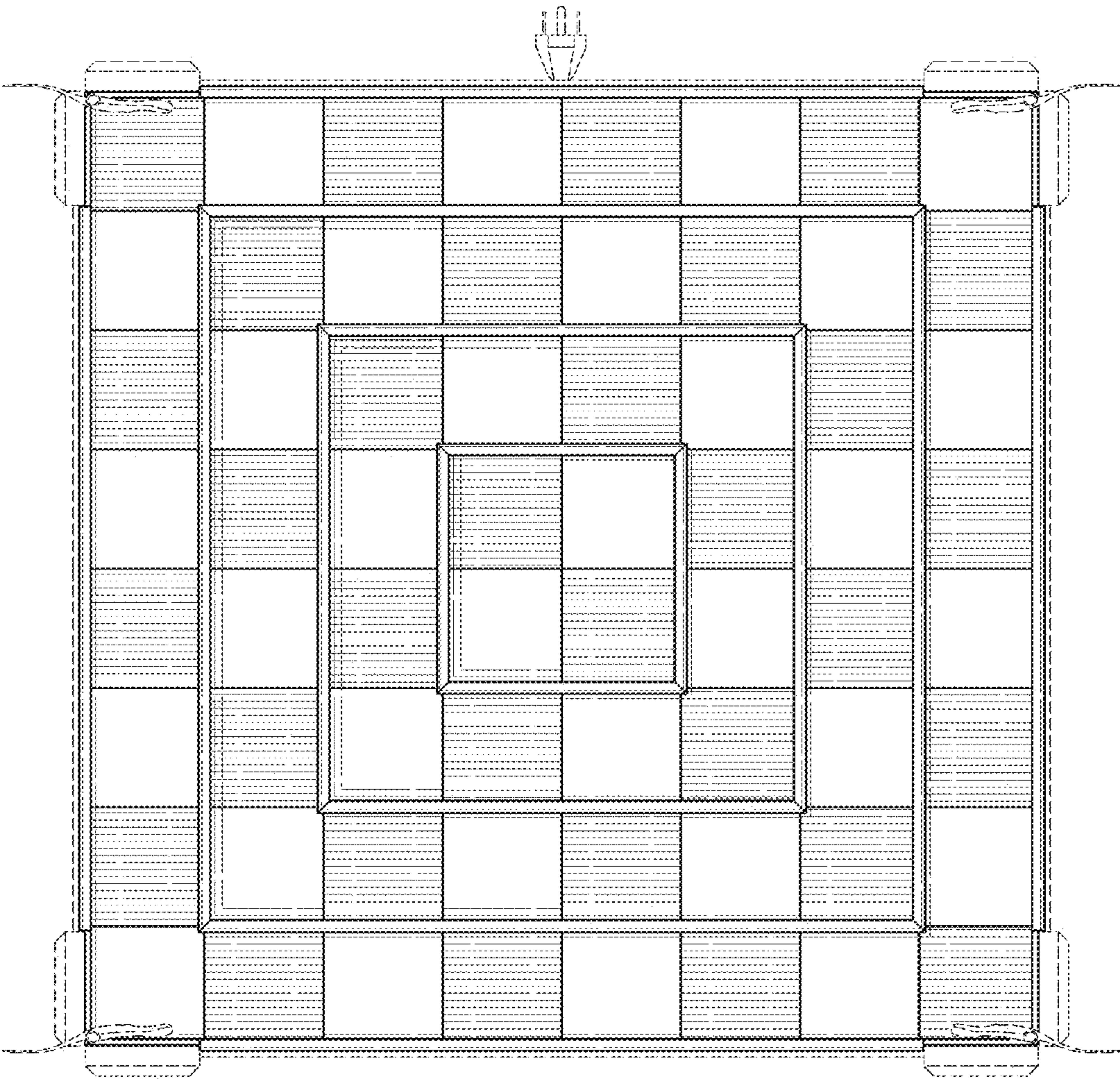

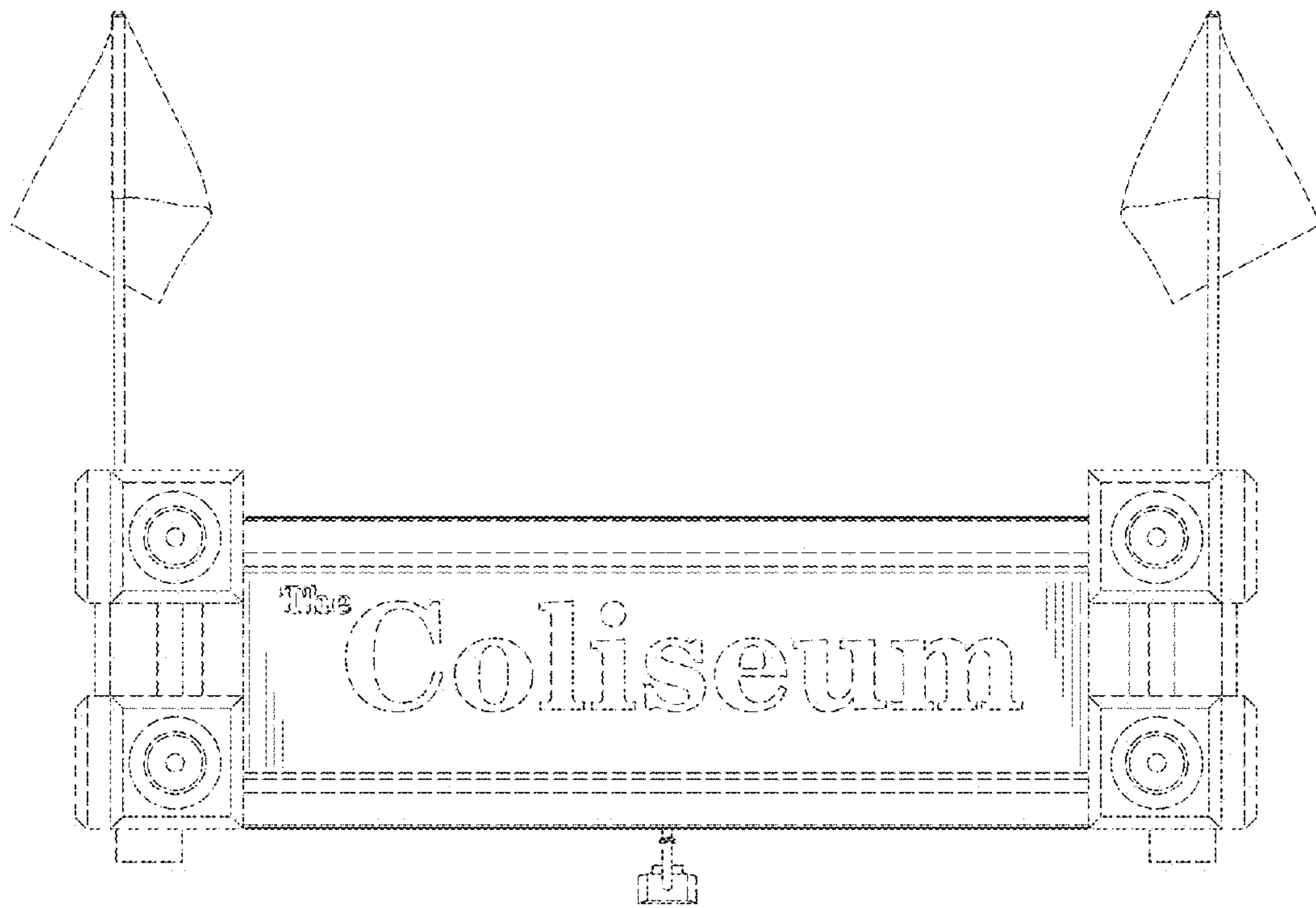

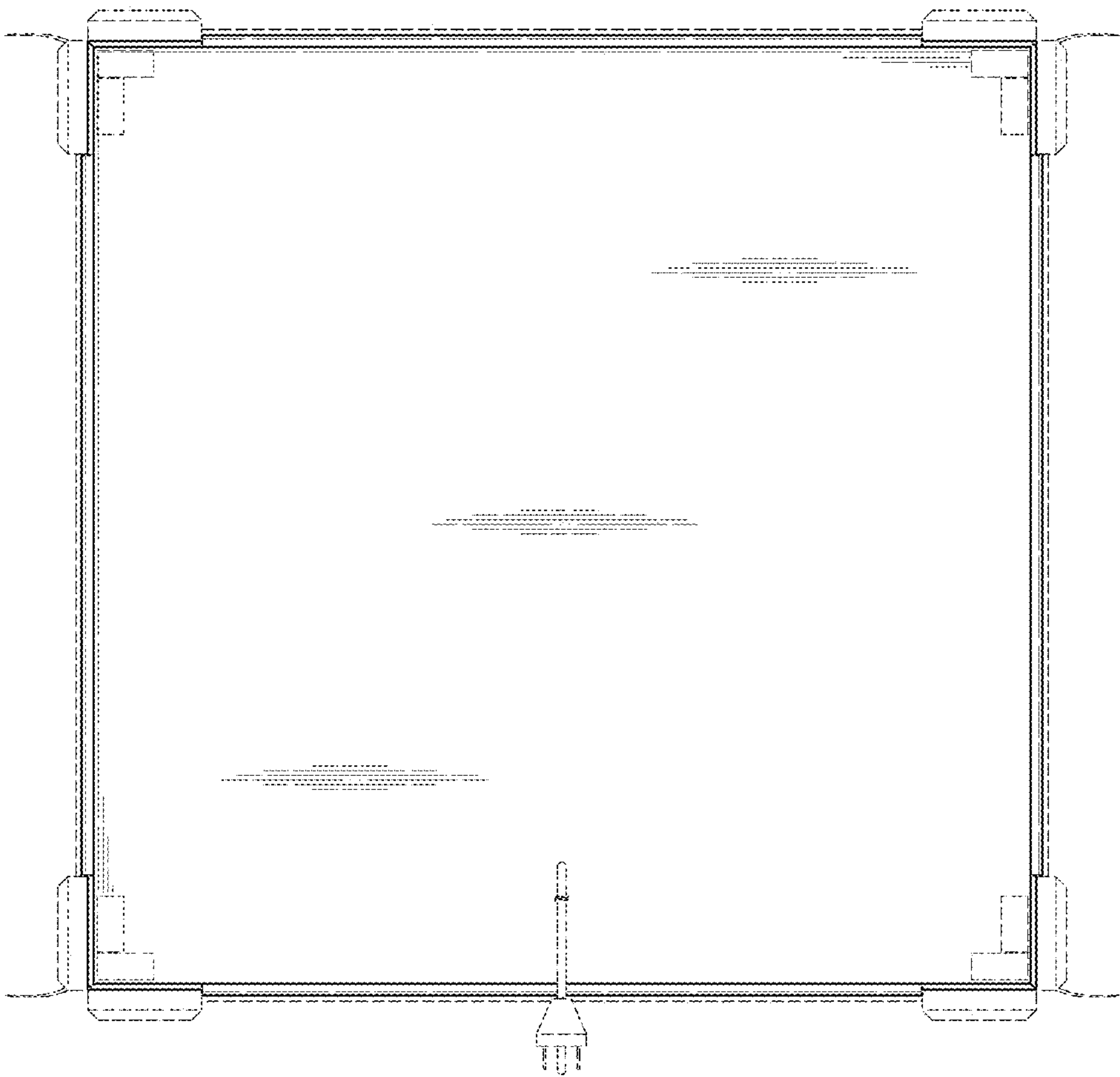

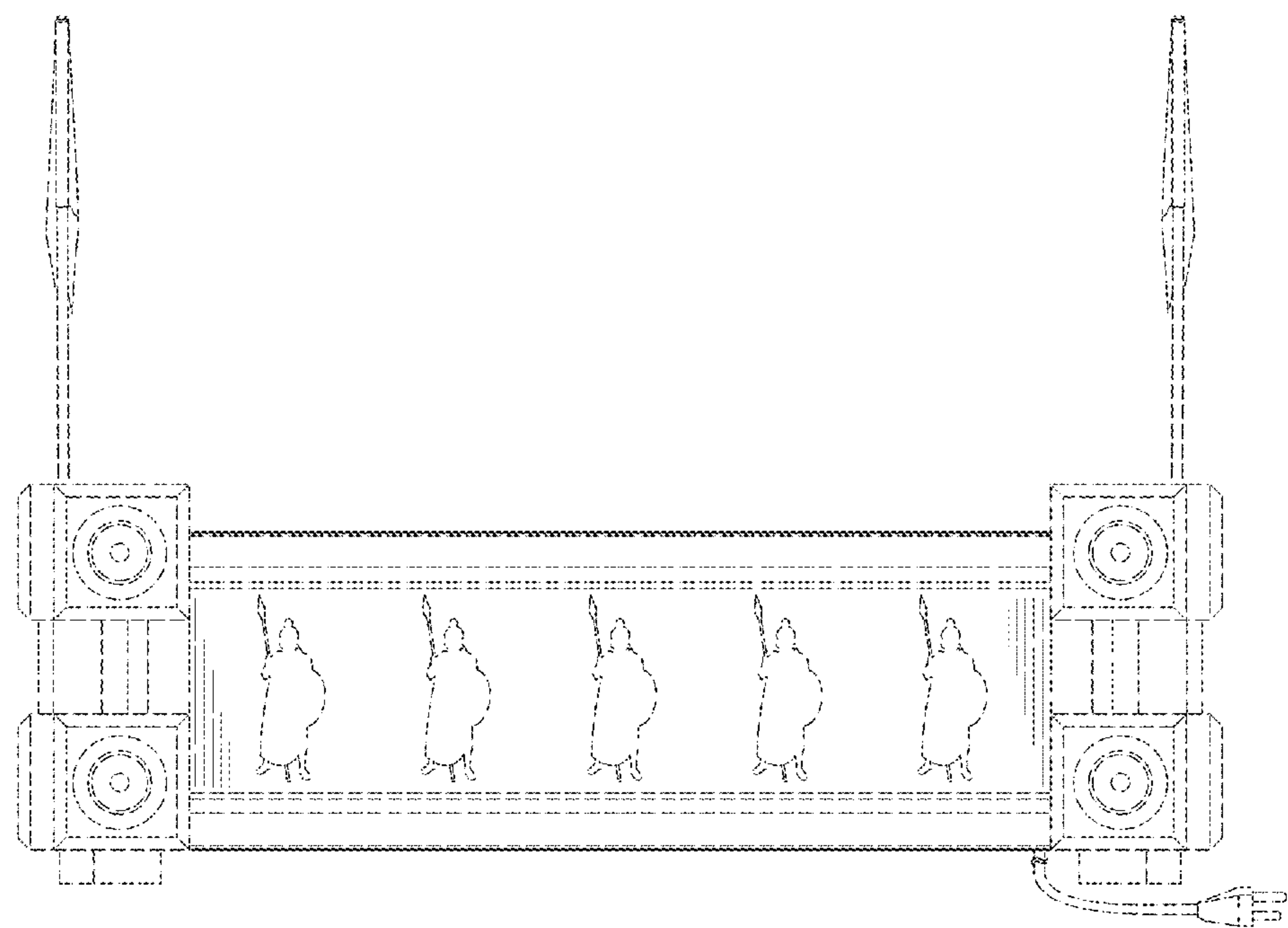
