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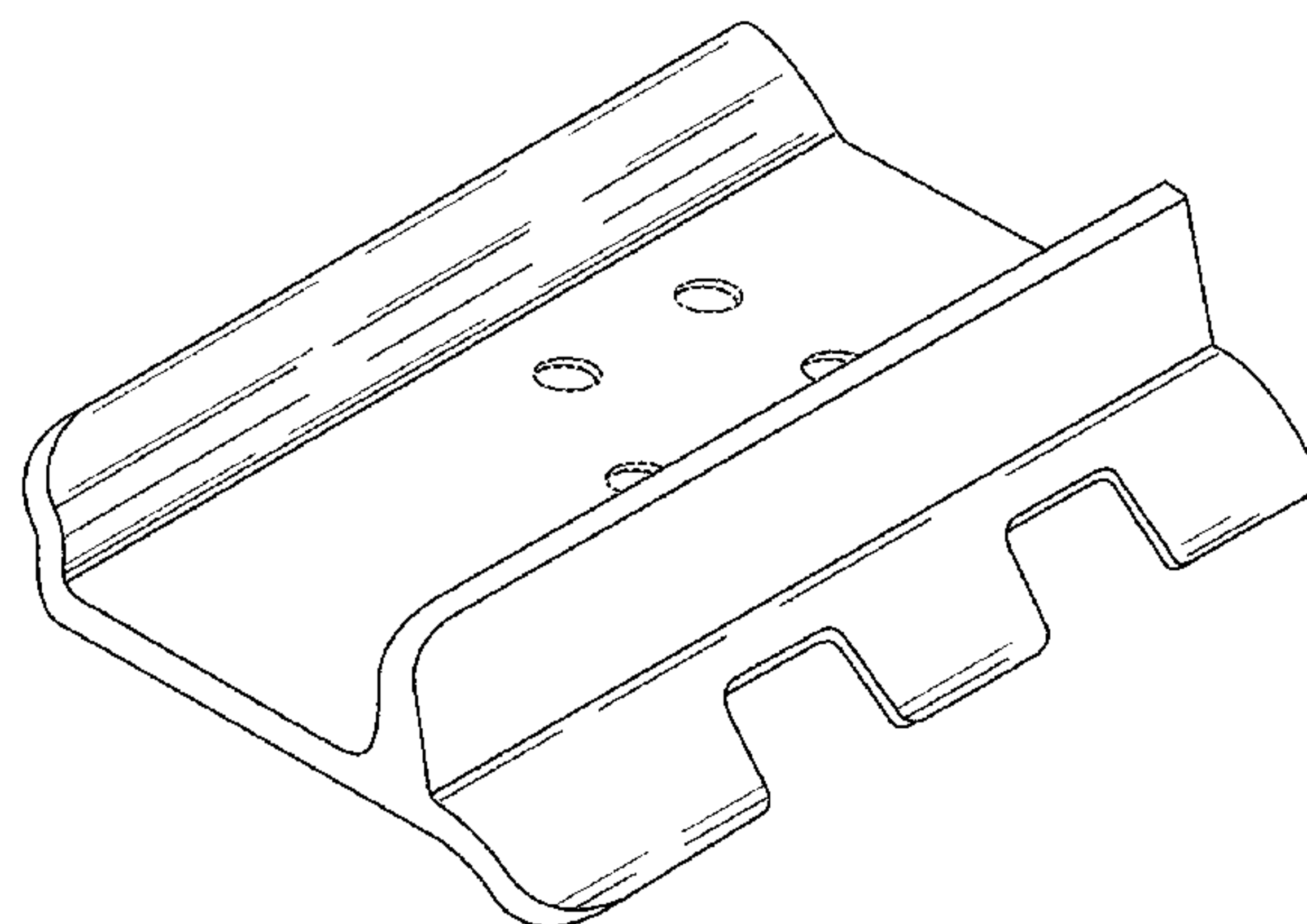
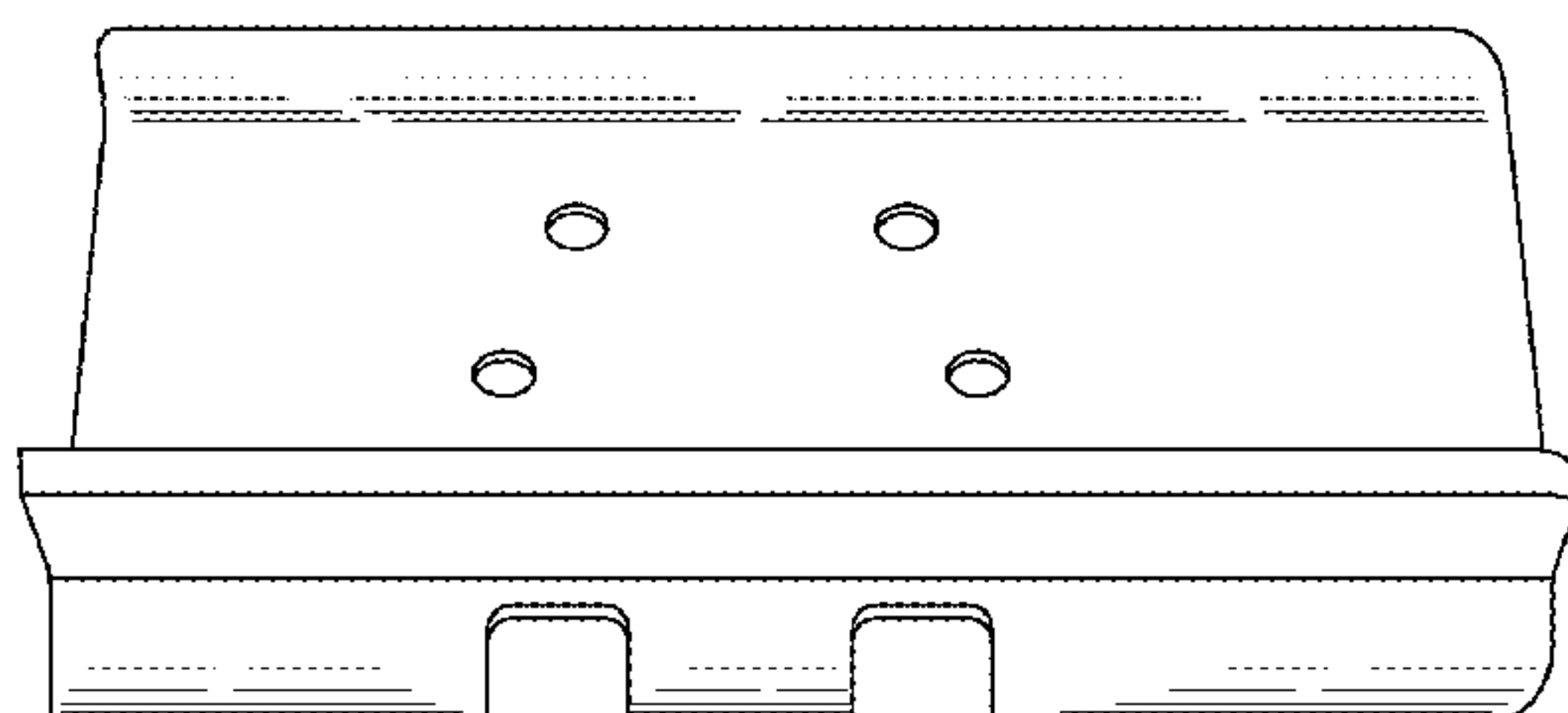
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment for a sweeping track shoe for a track-type machine showing our new design;

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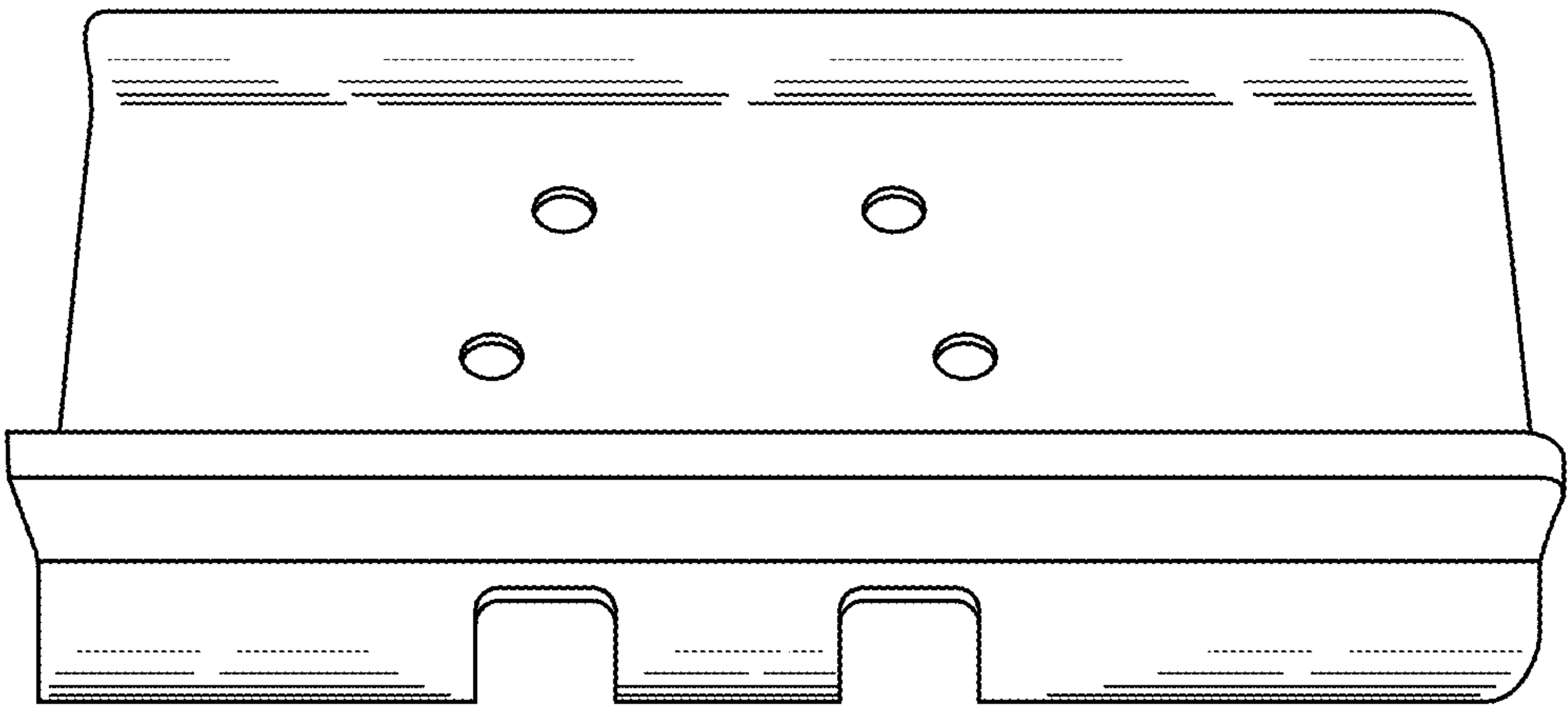

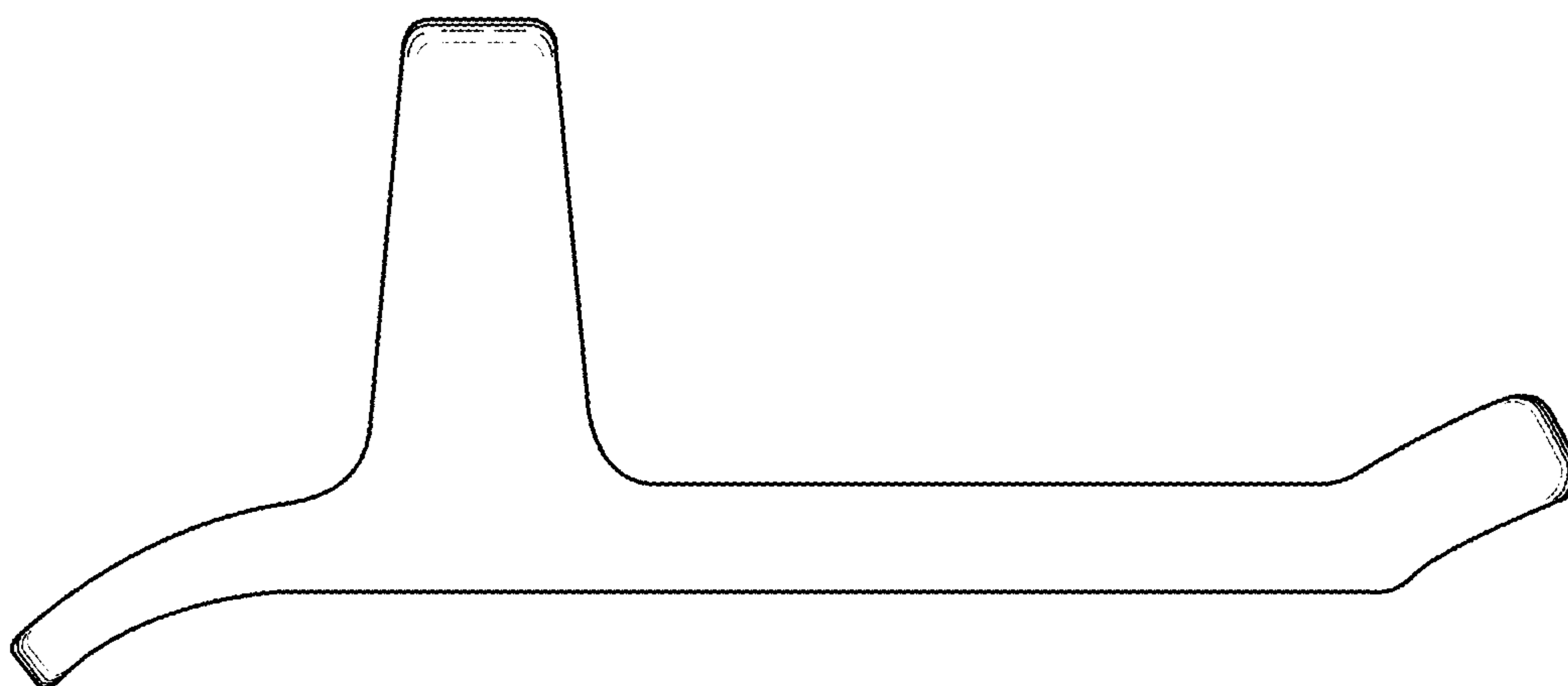

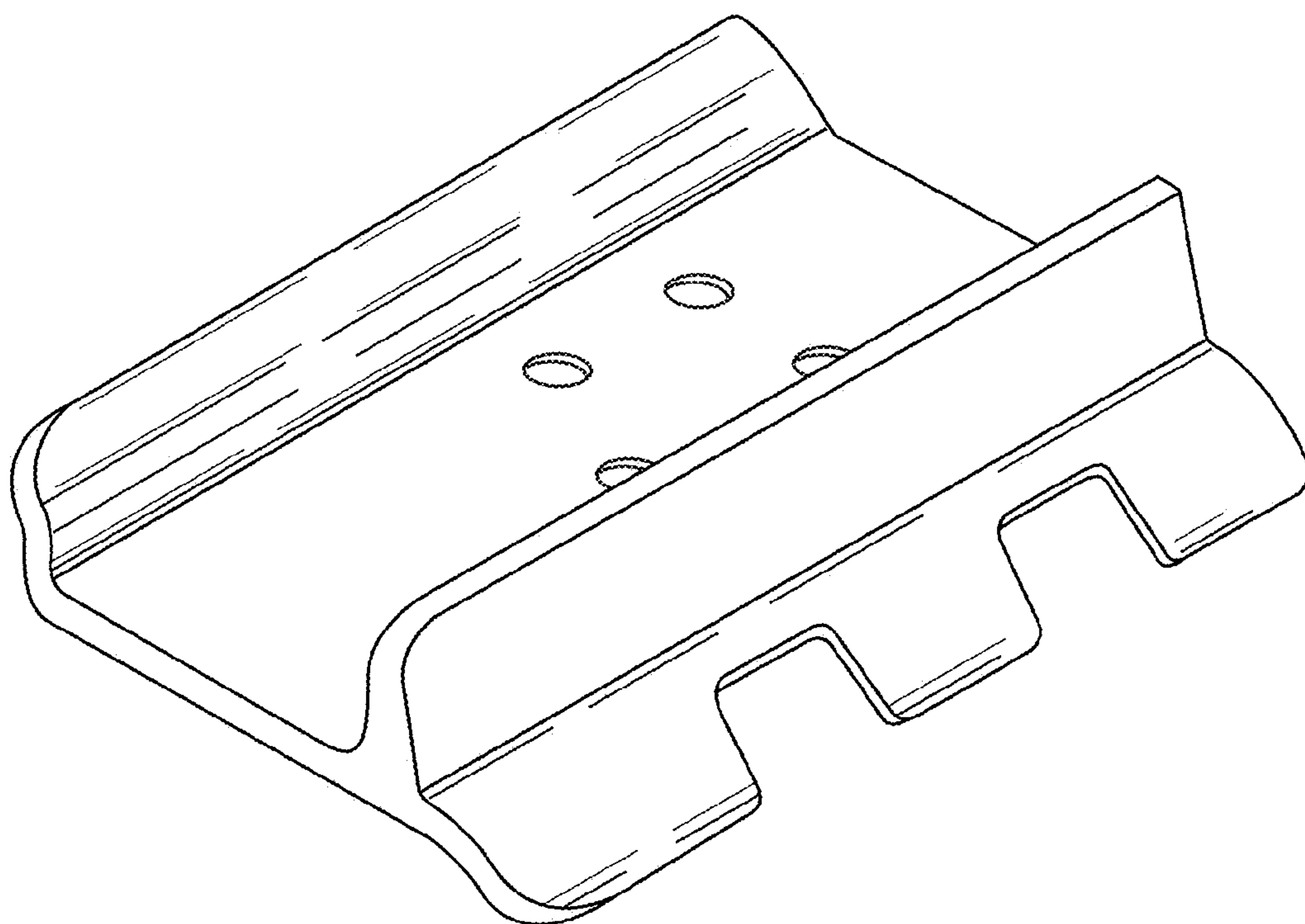
