FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the rifle scope of FIG. 8;

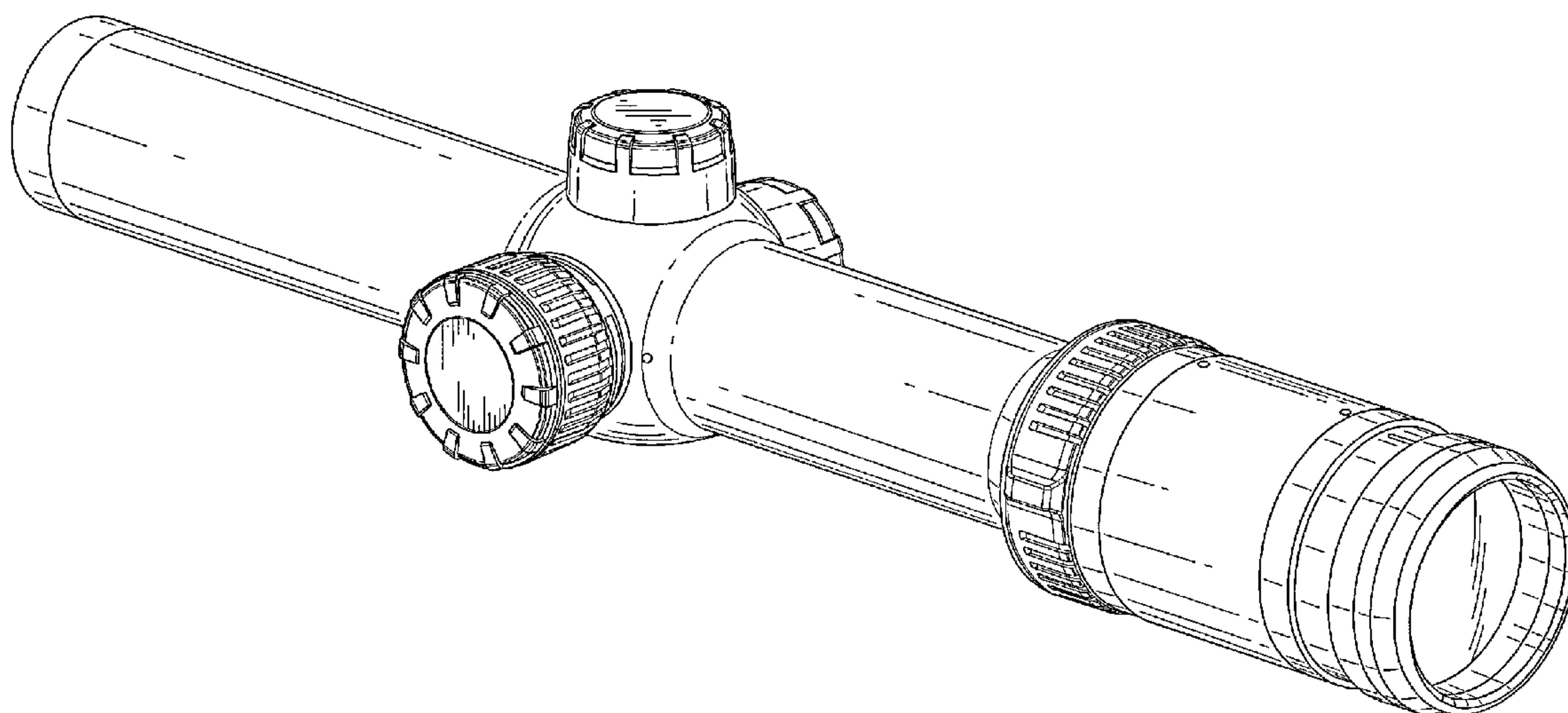
FIG. 11 is a right side elevation view of the rifle scope of FIG. 8;

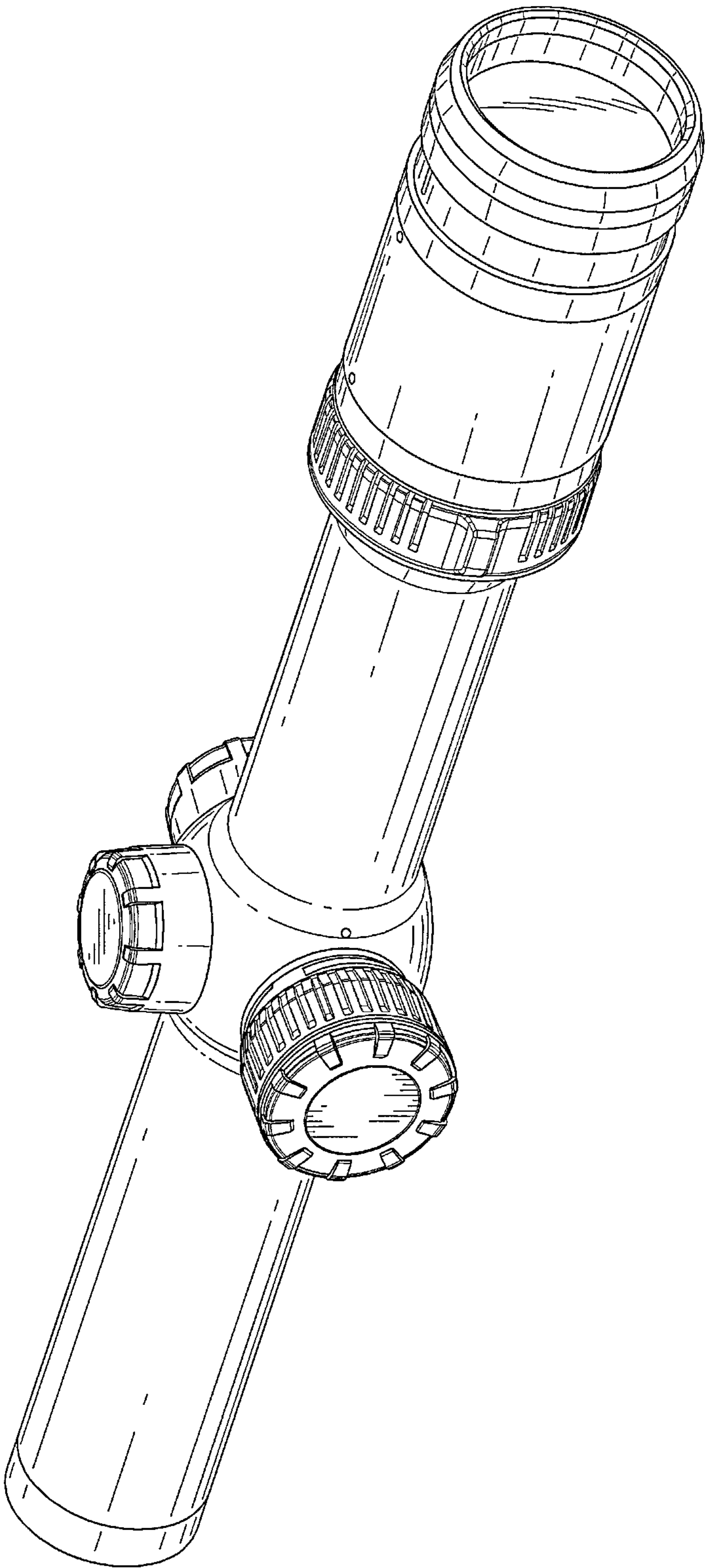

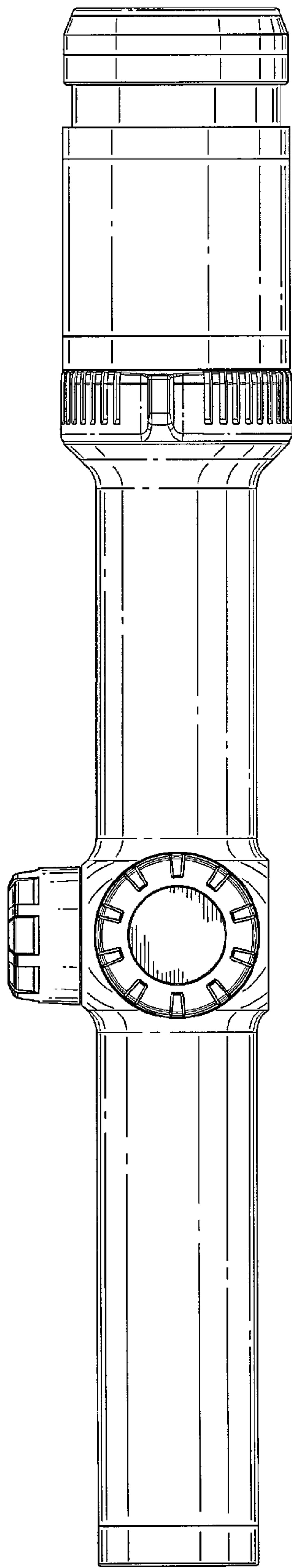

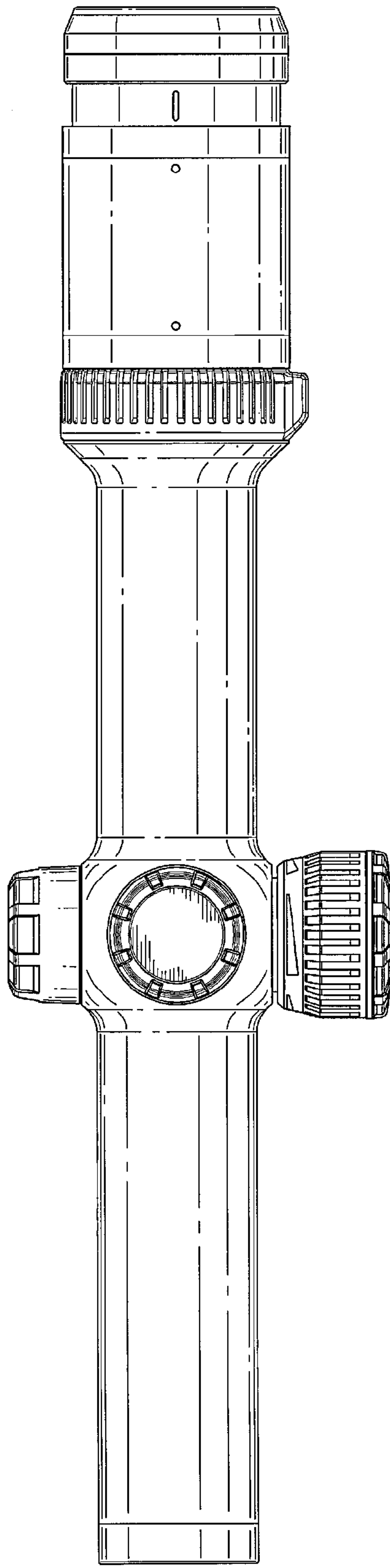

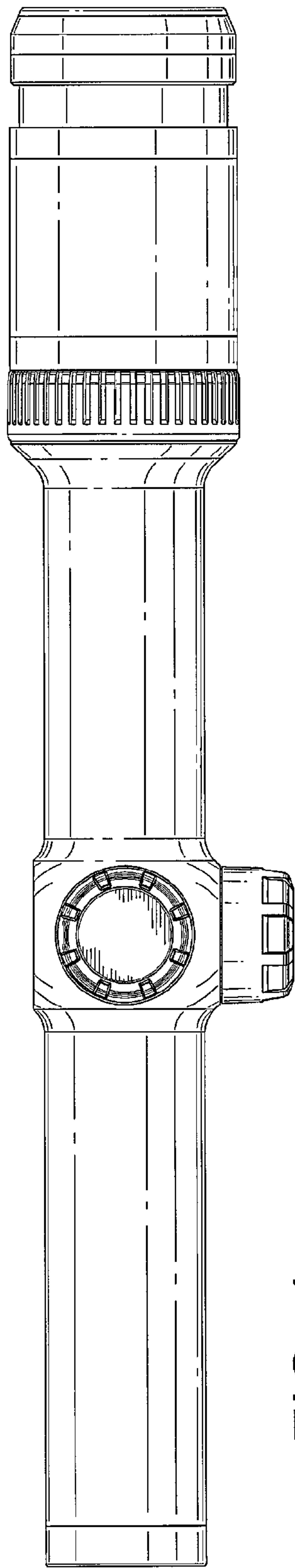

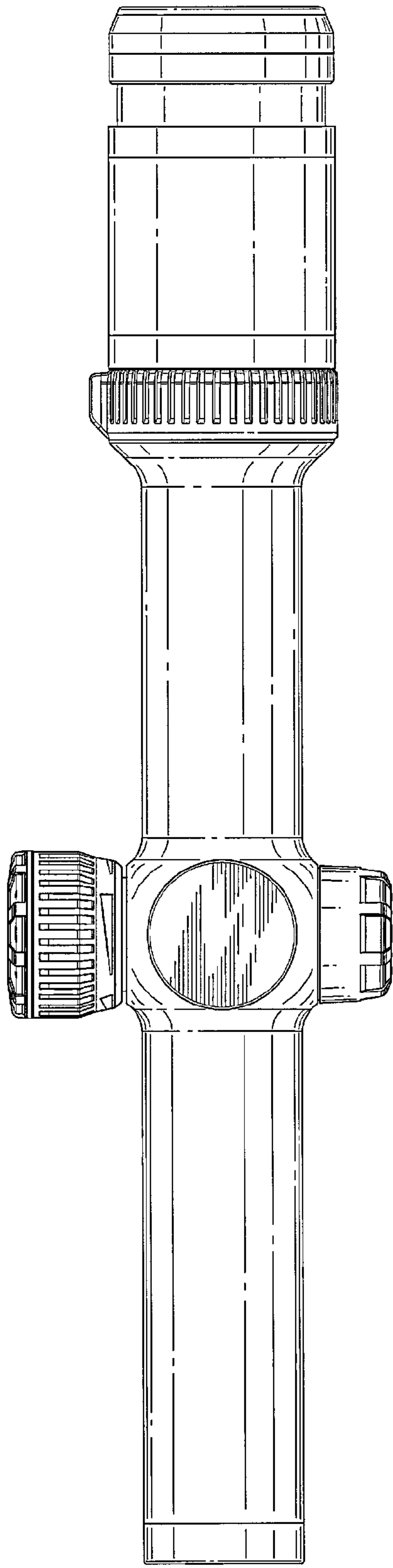

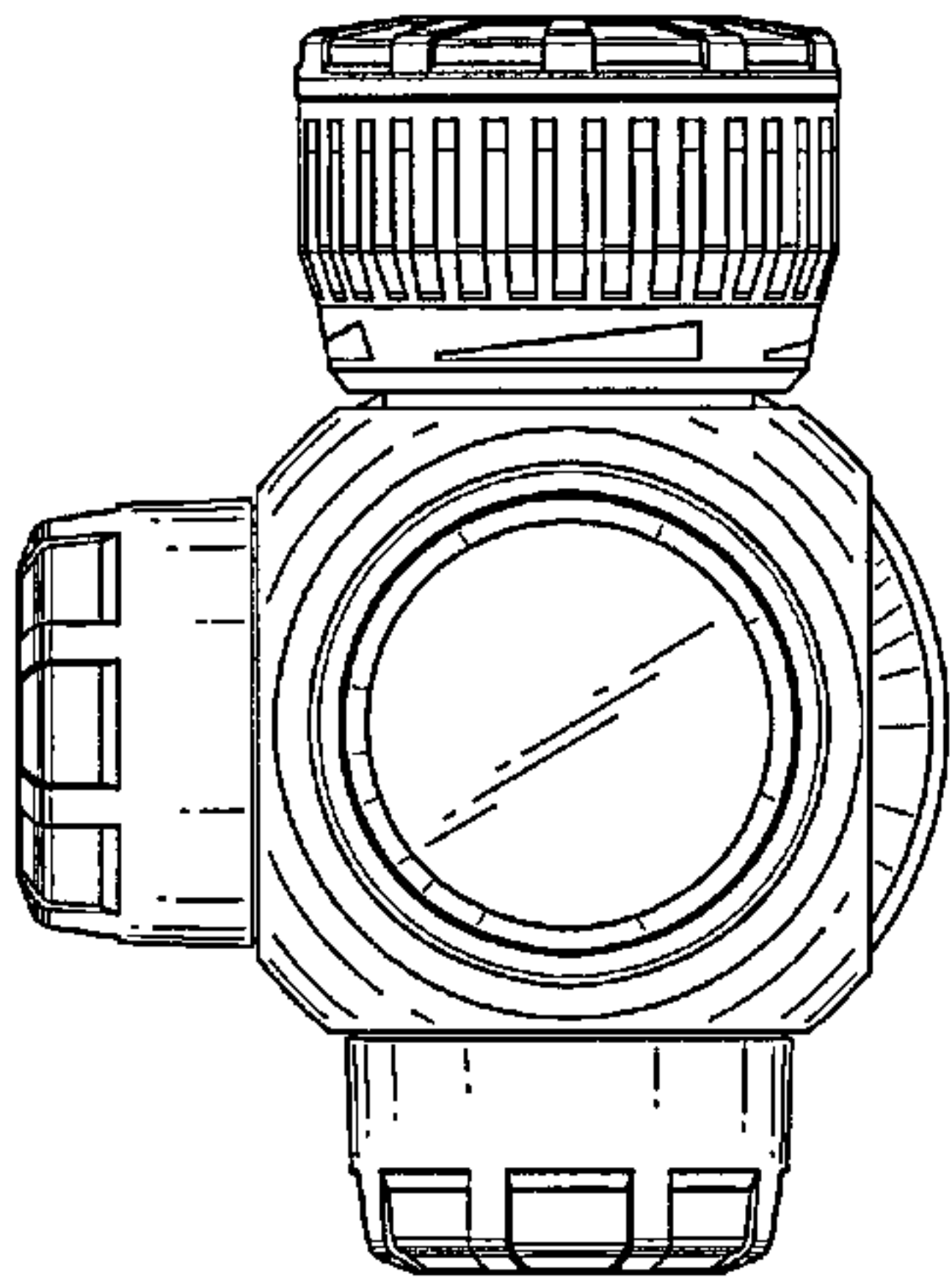

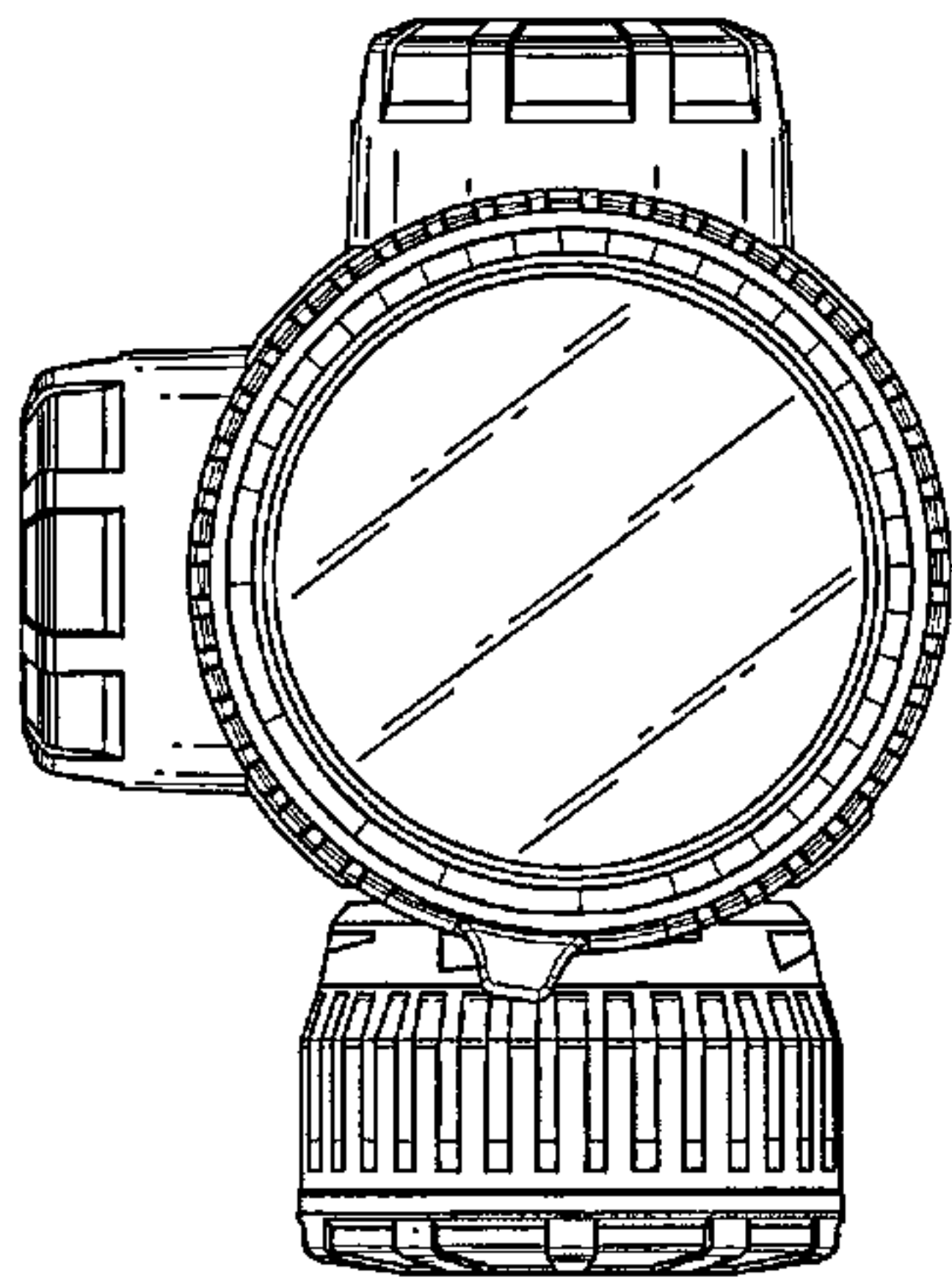

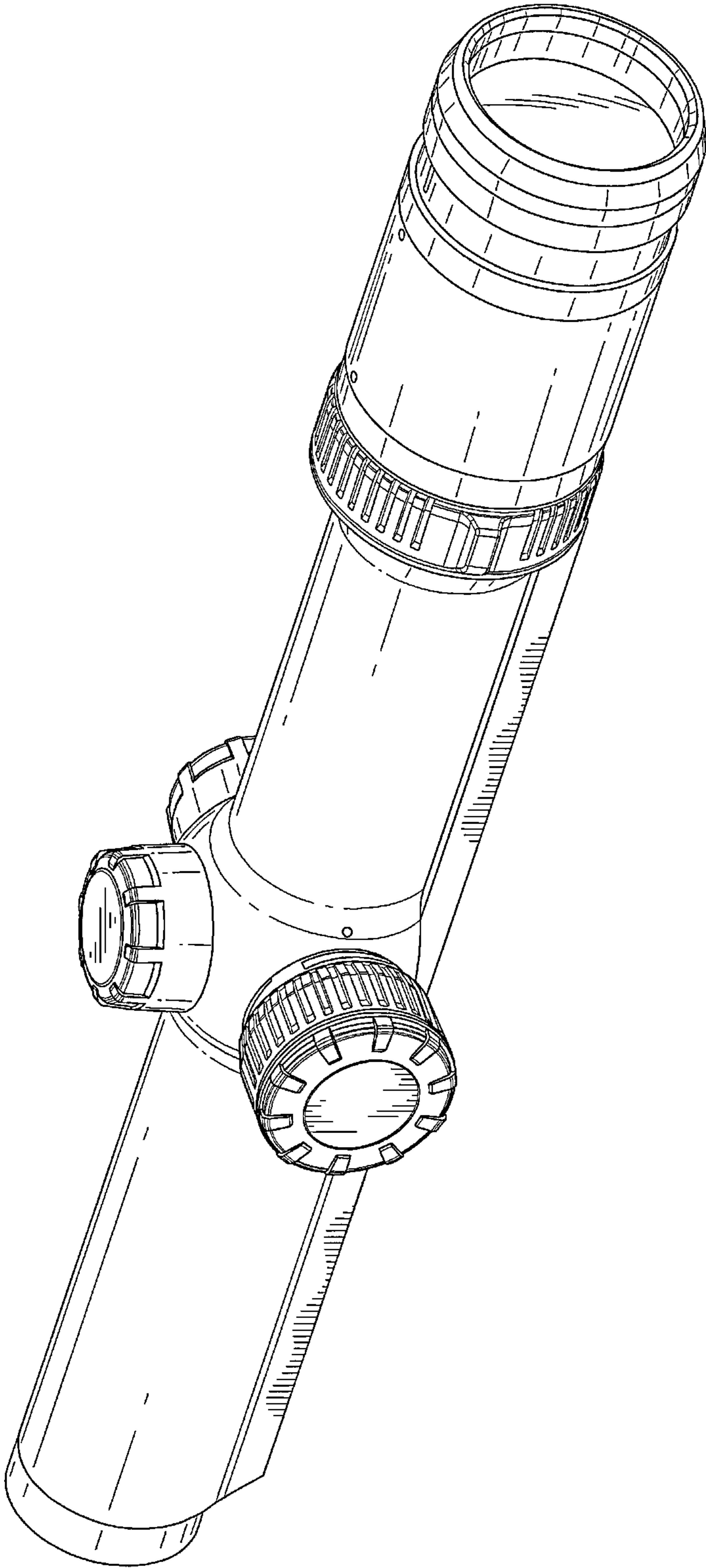

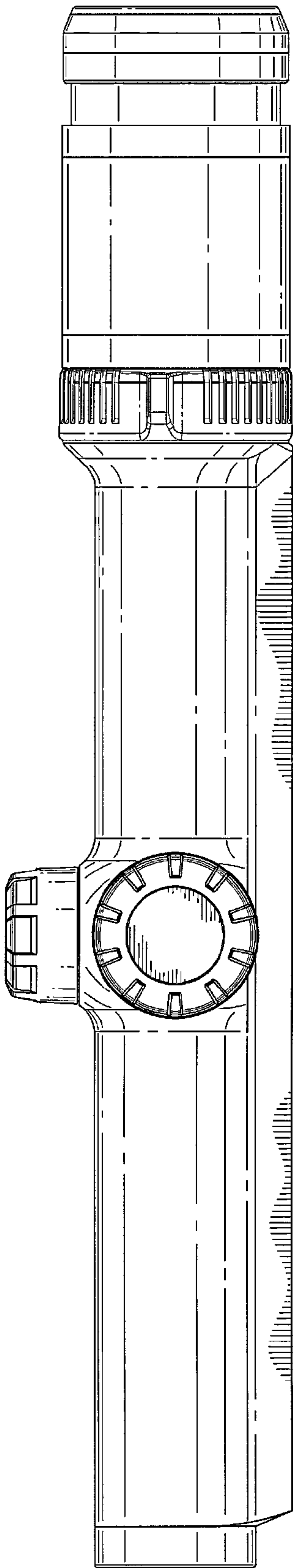

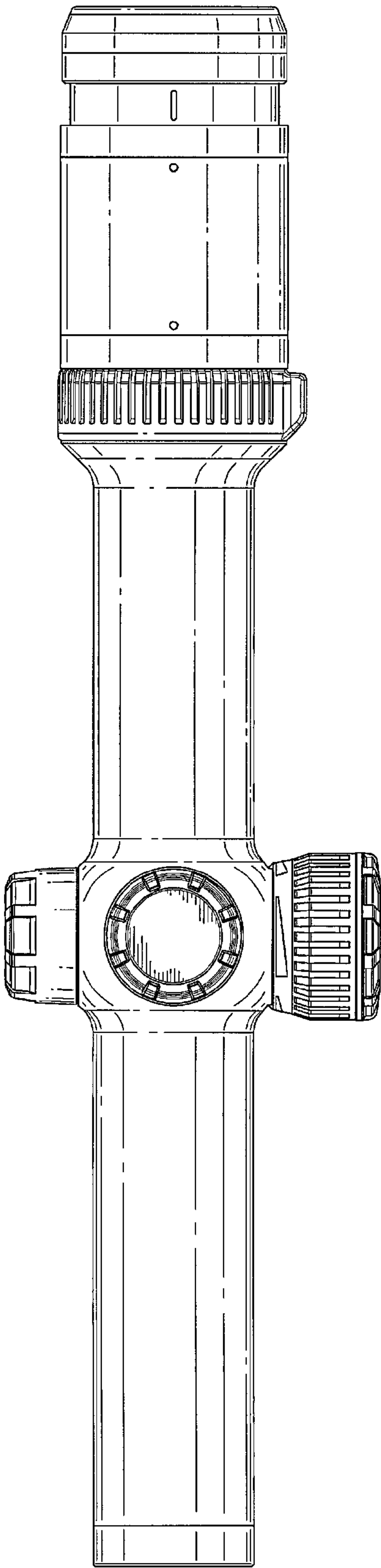

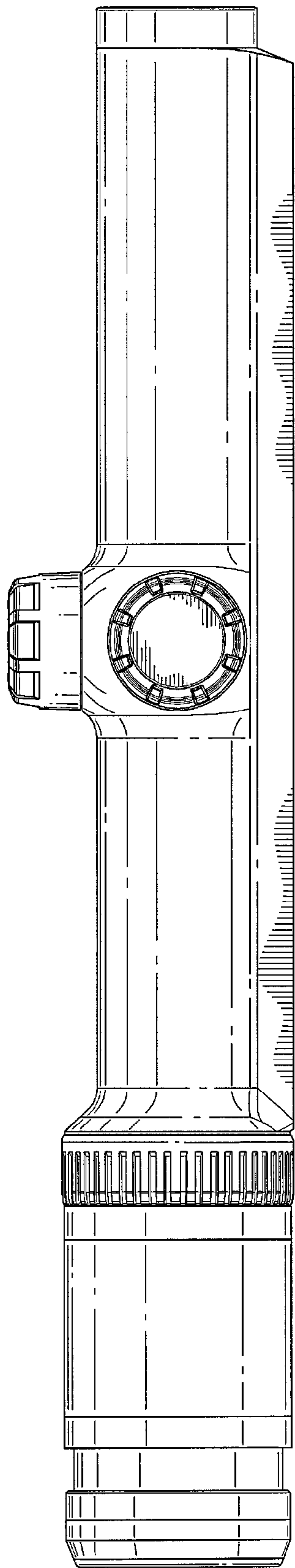

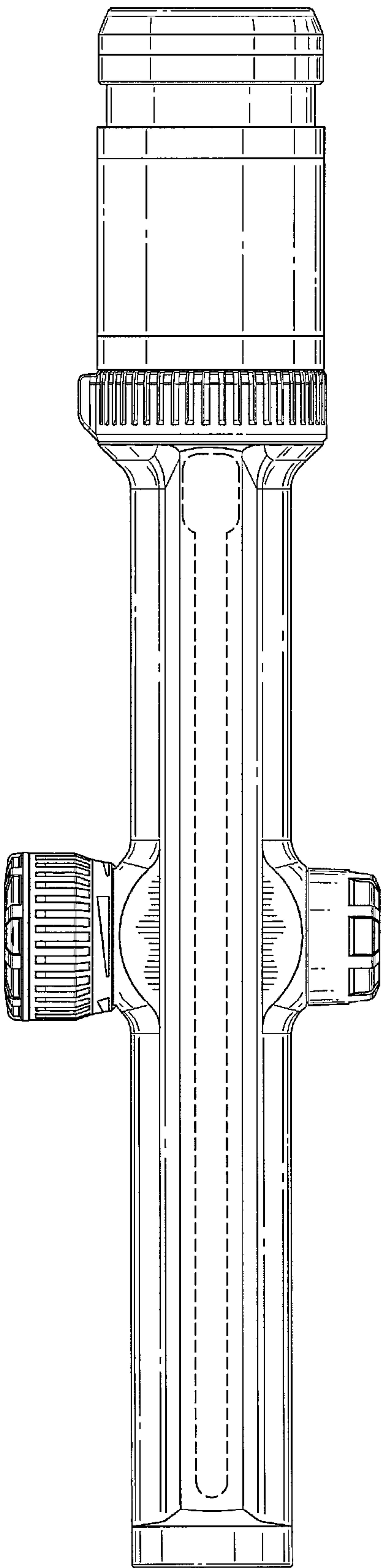

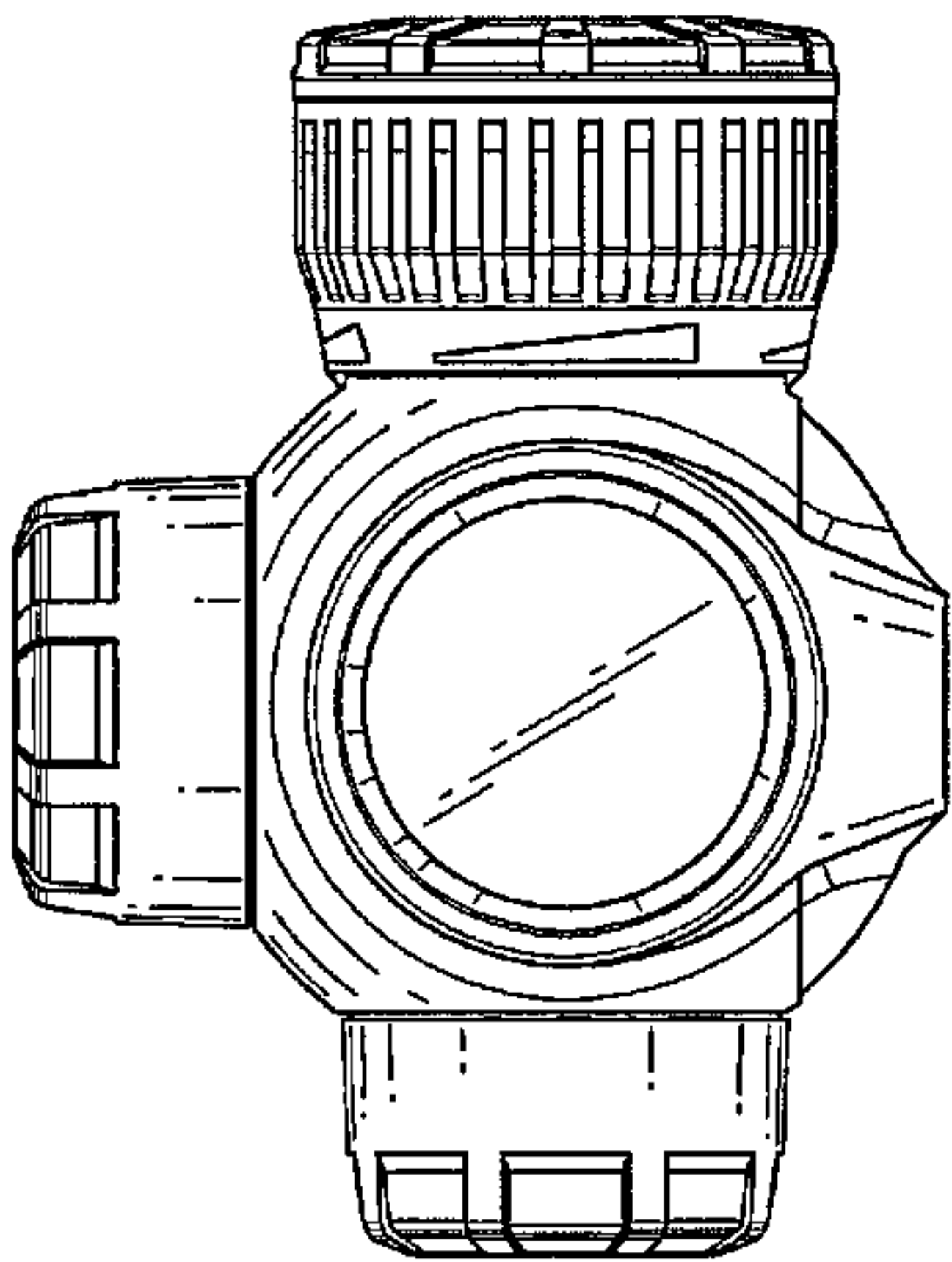

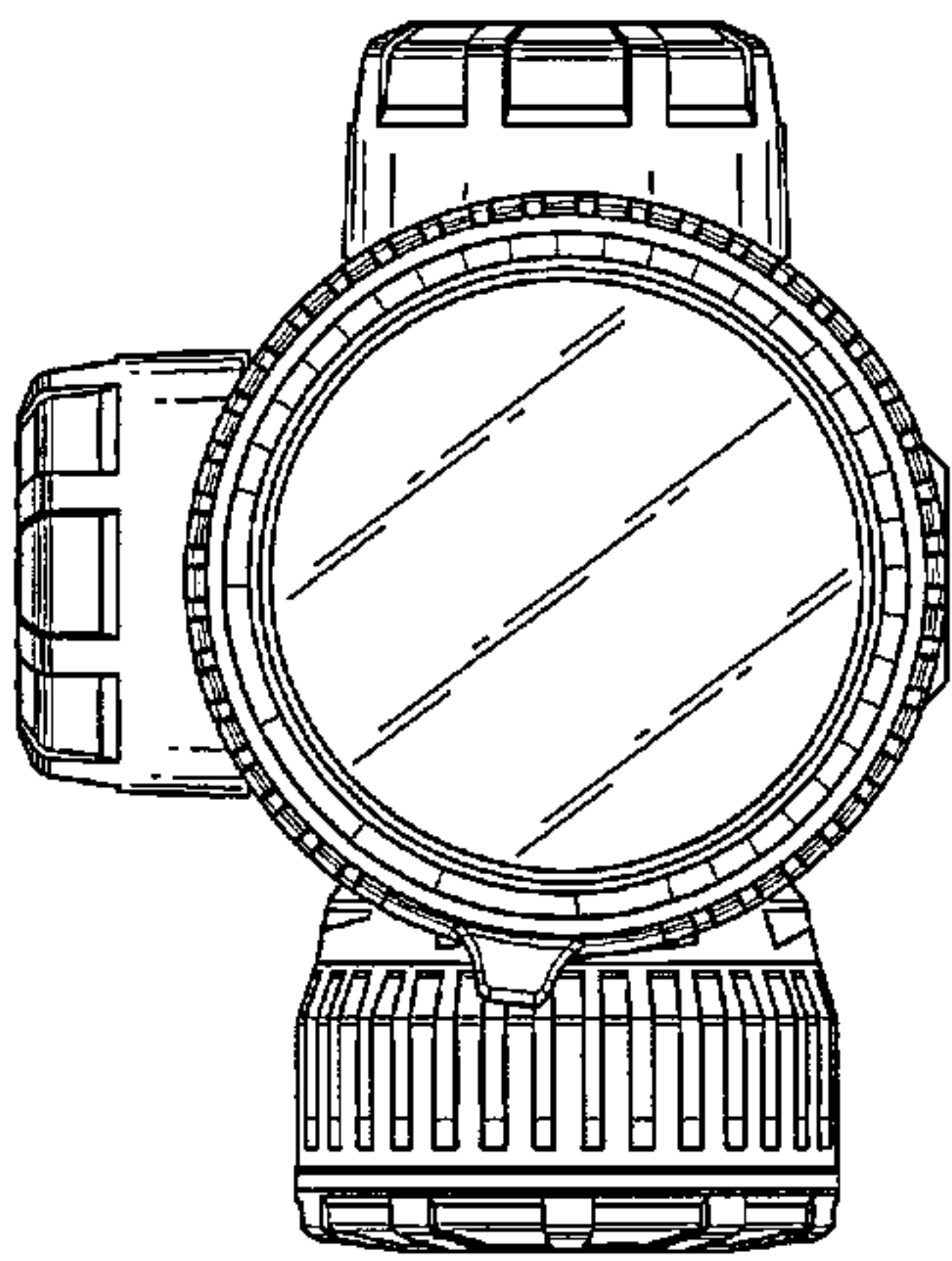
