I claim the ornamental design for a sensor assembly for touch-free faucet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a sensor assembly for touch-free faucet;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the first embodiment of the sensor assembly for touch-free faucet;

FIG. 11 is a right elevation view of the second embodiment of the sensor assembly for touch-free faucet;

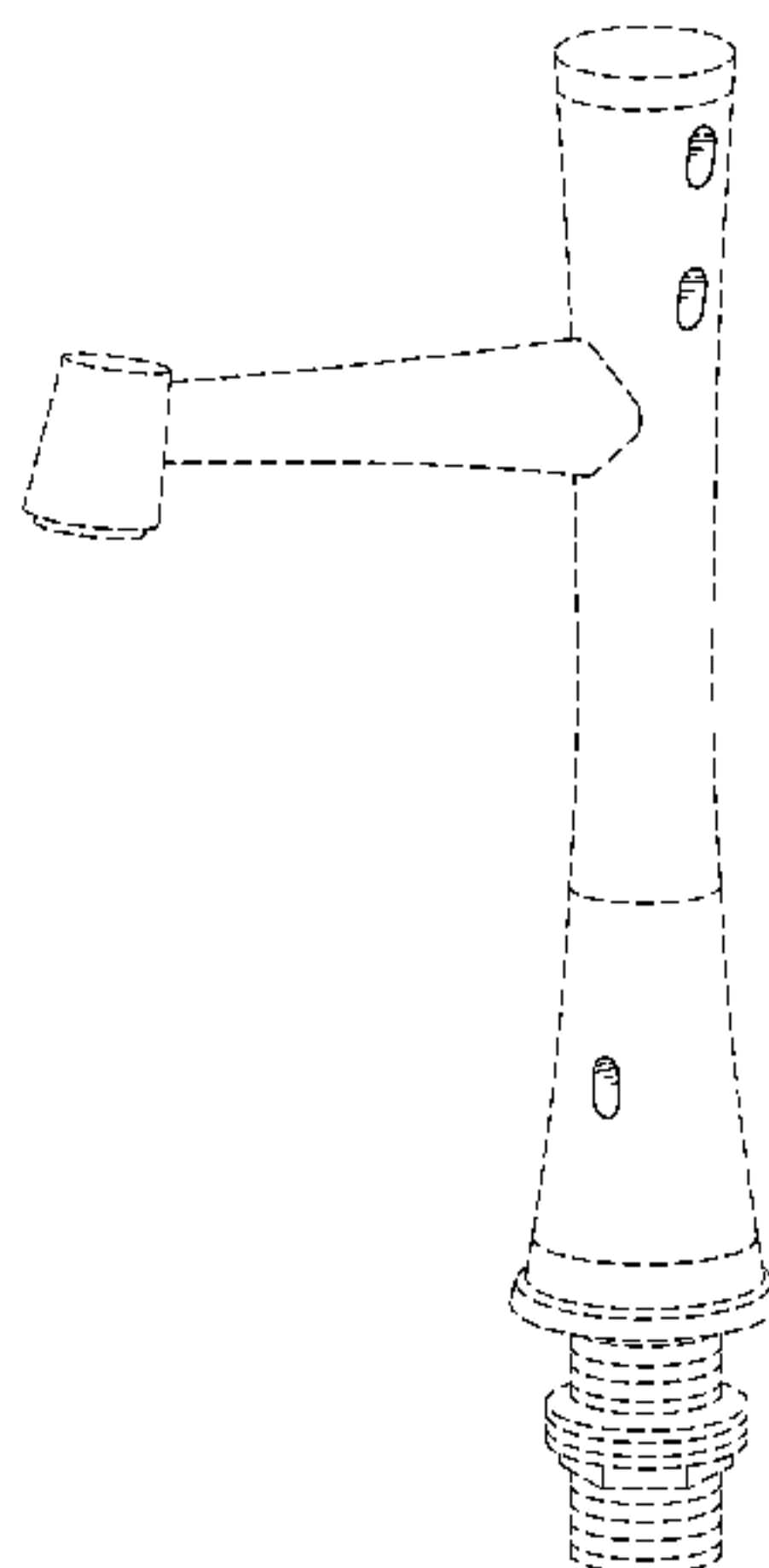
FIG. 12 is a left elevation view of the second embodiment of the sensor assembly for touch-free faucet;

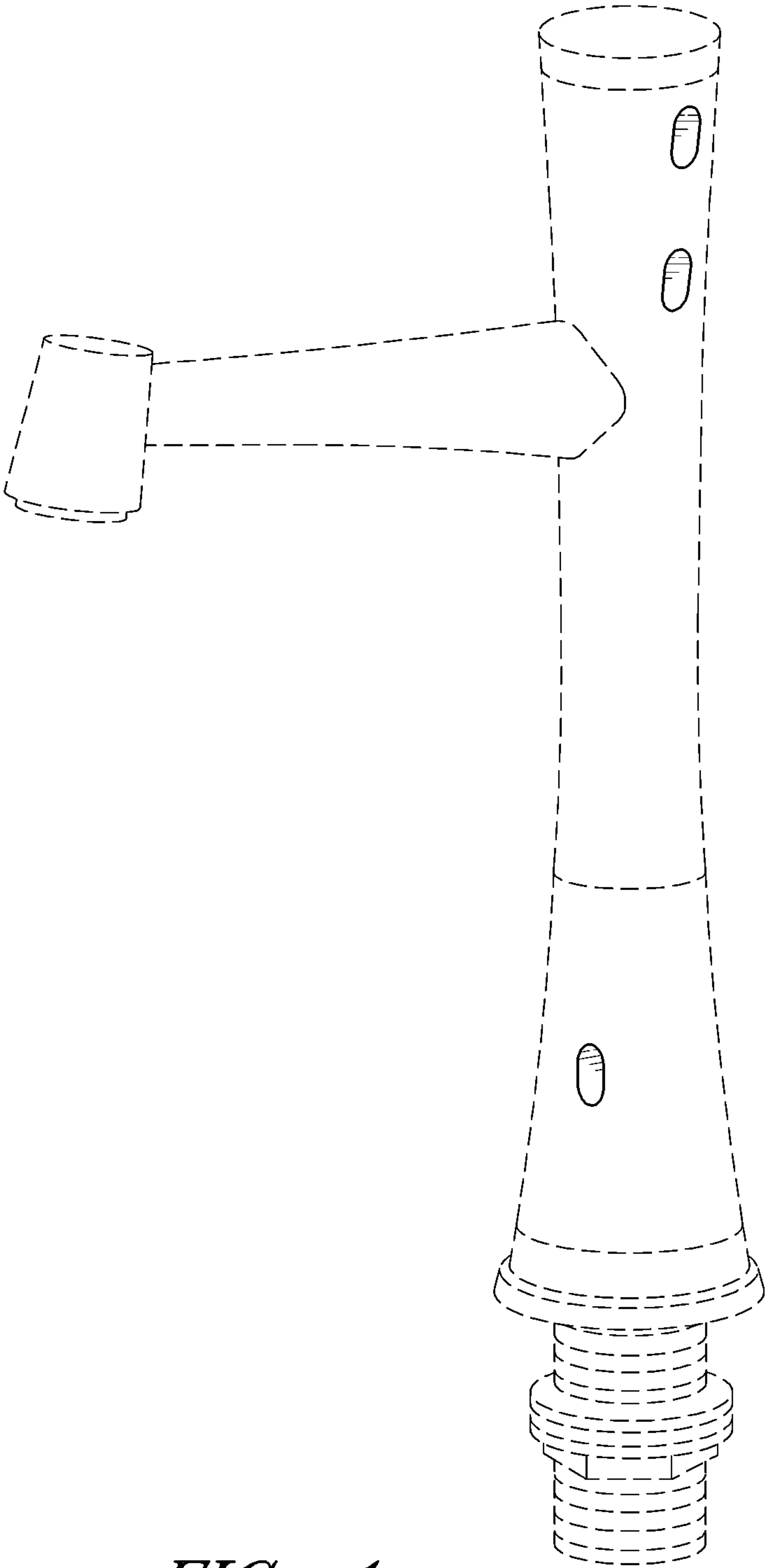

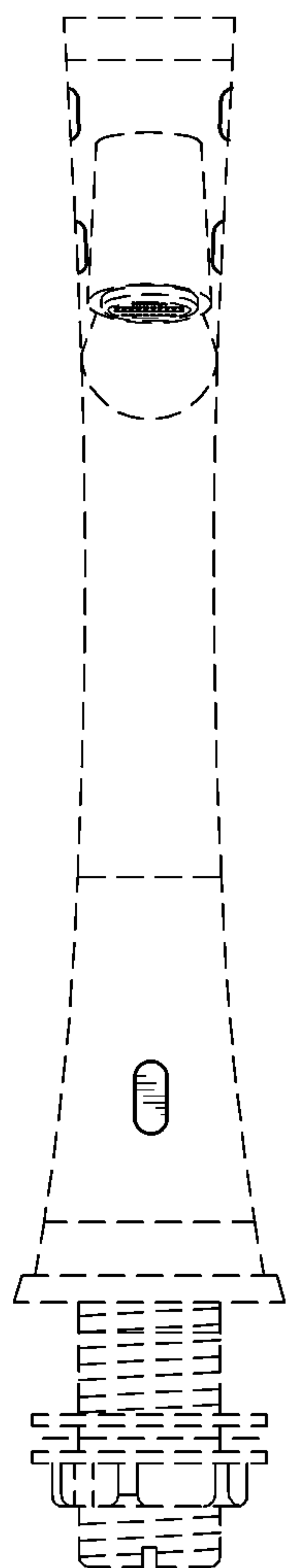

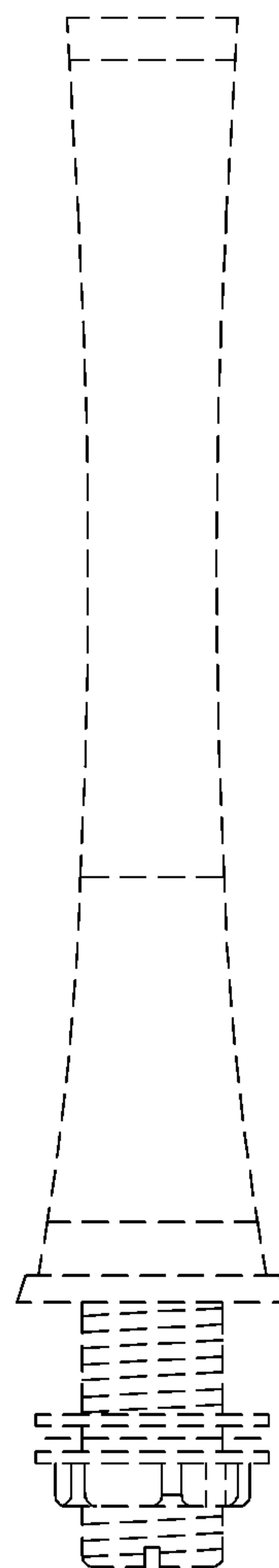

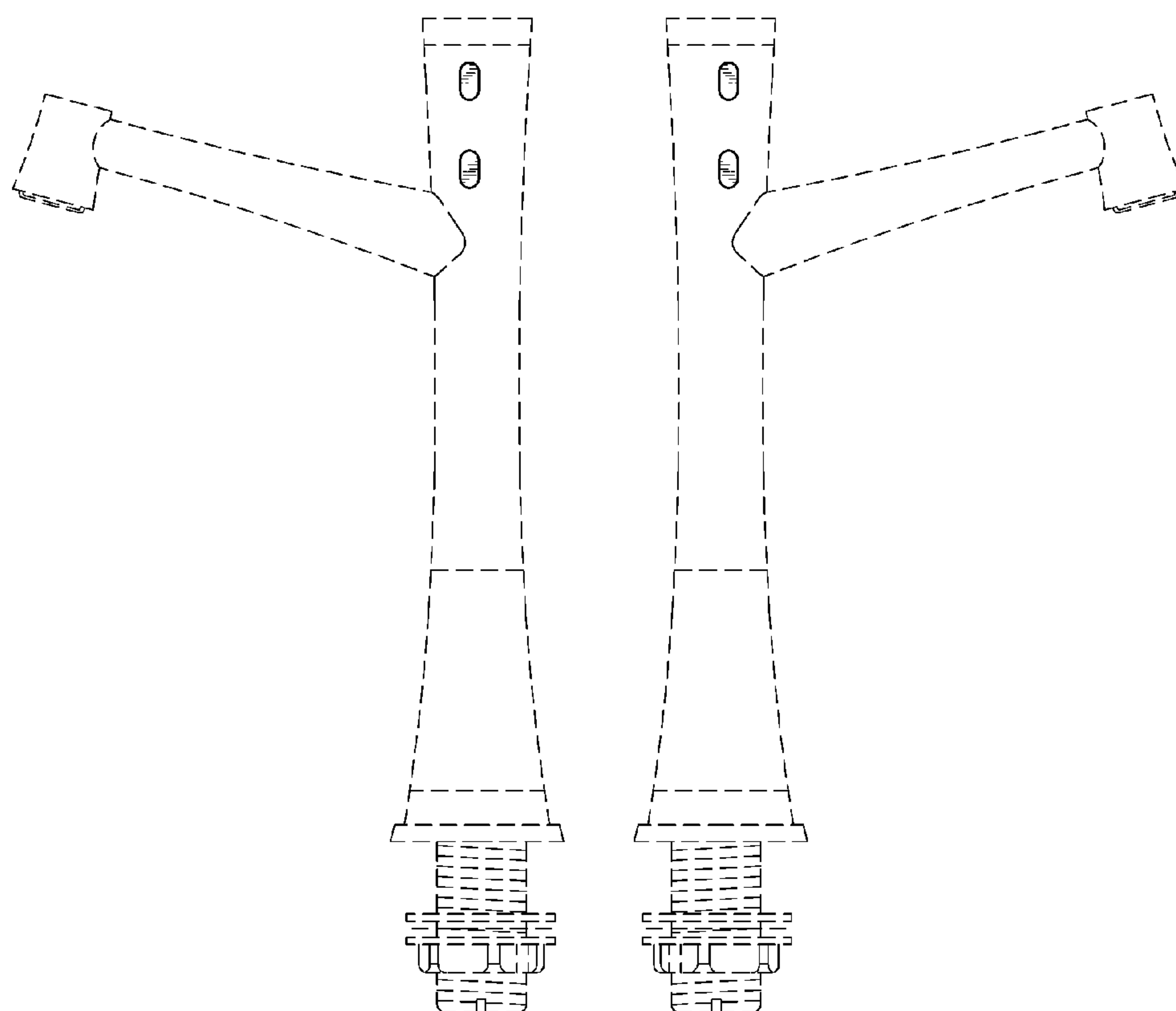

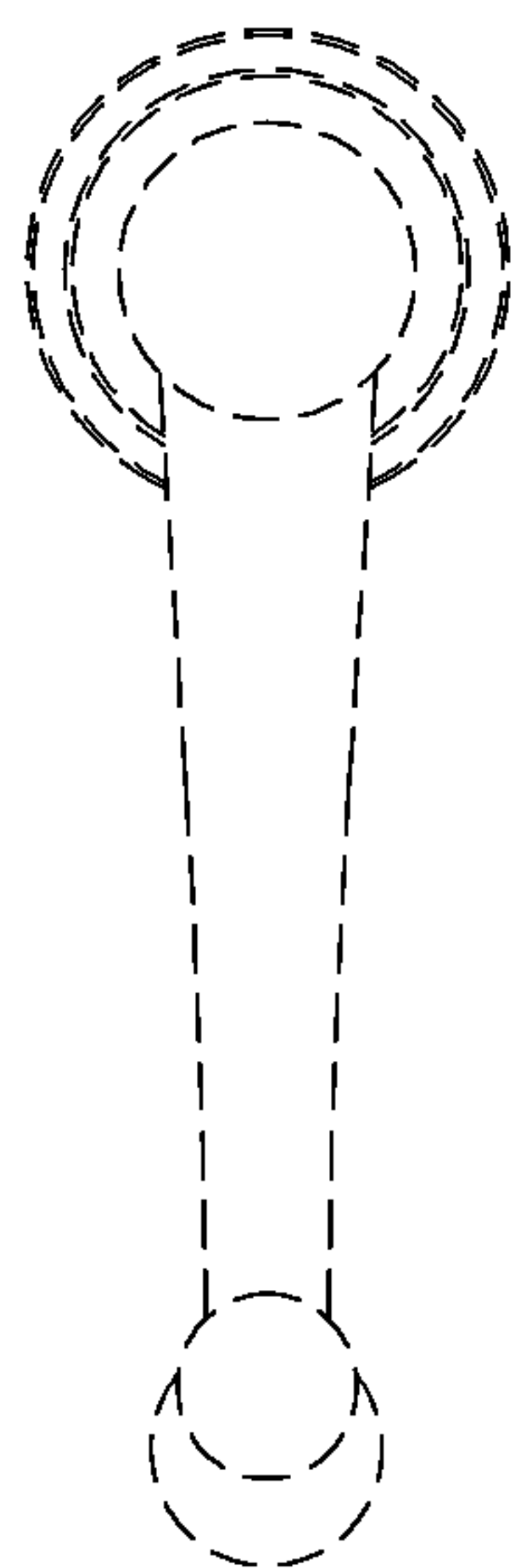

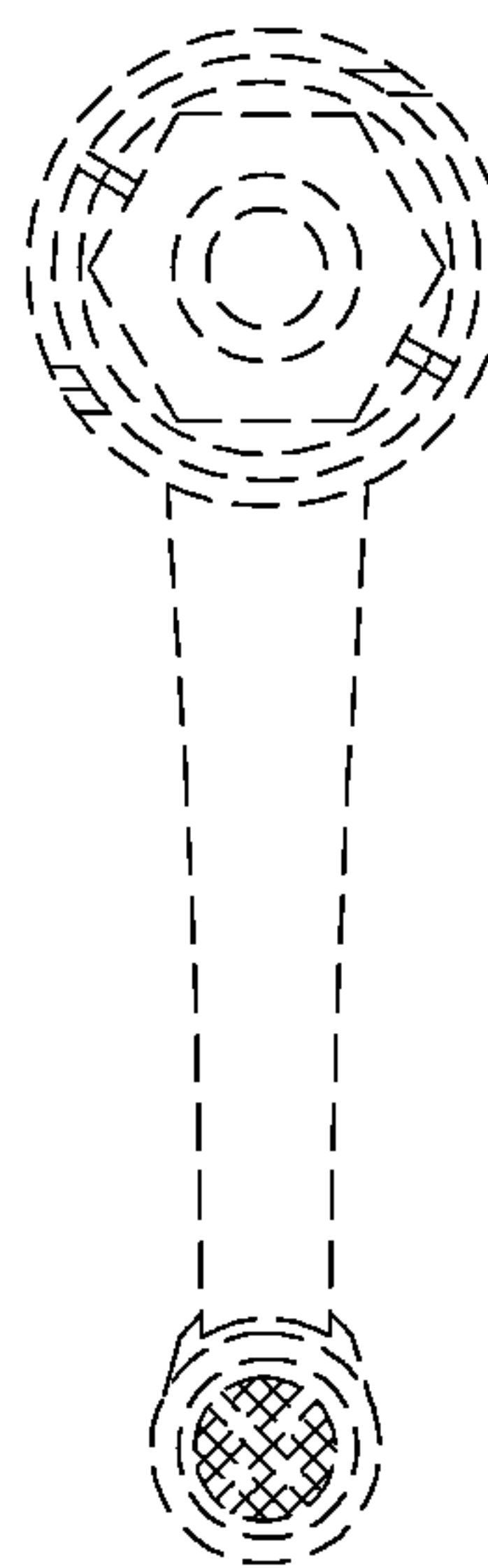

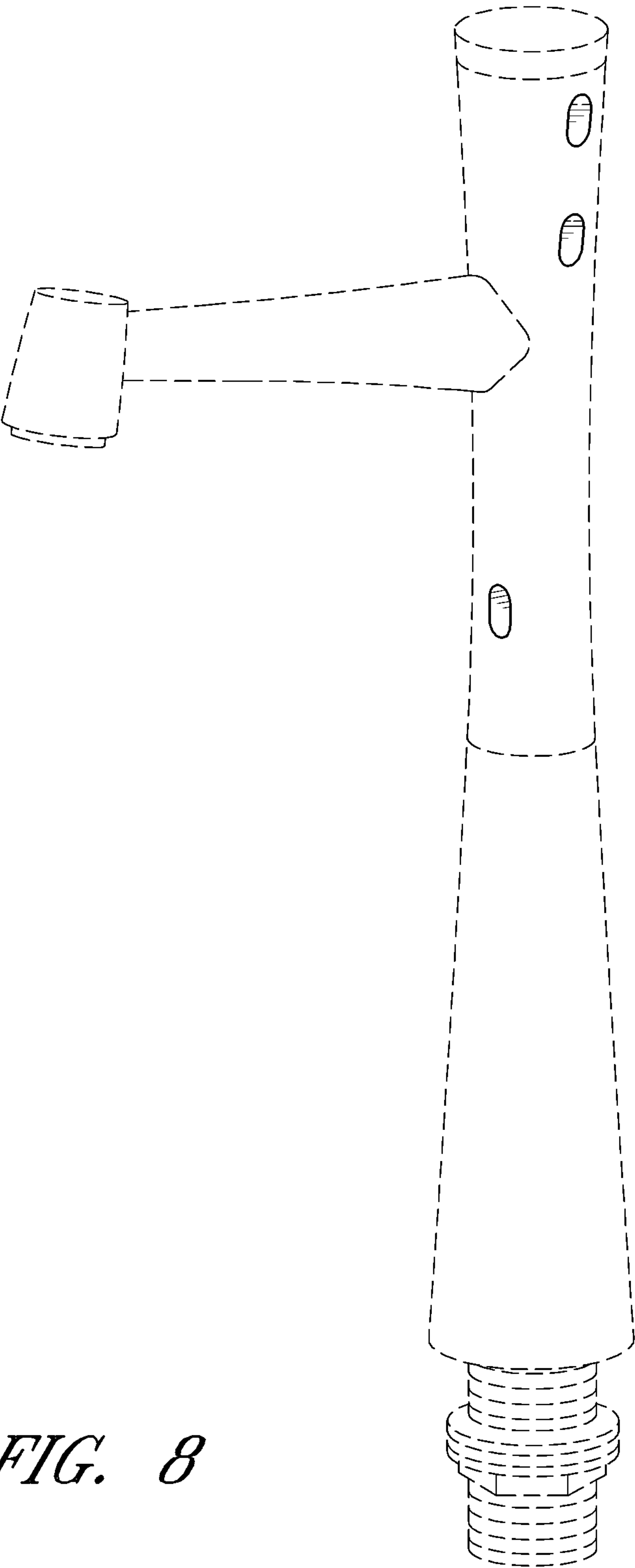

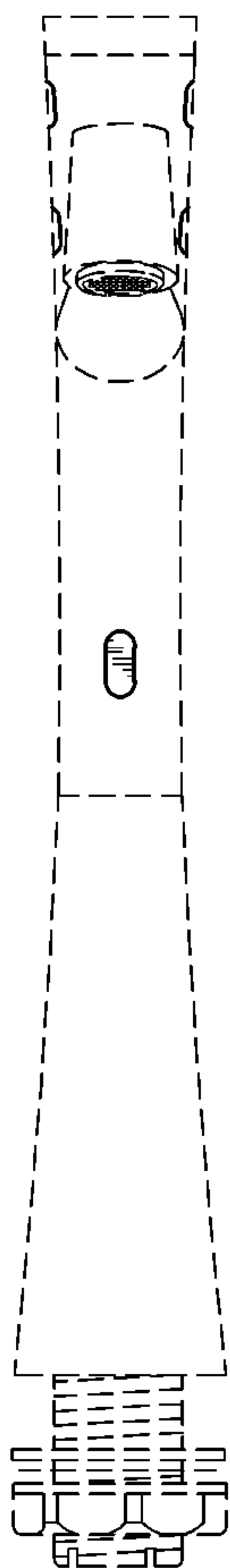

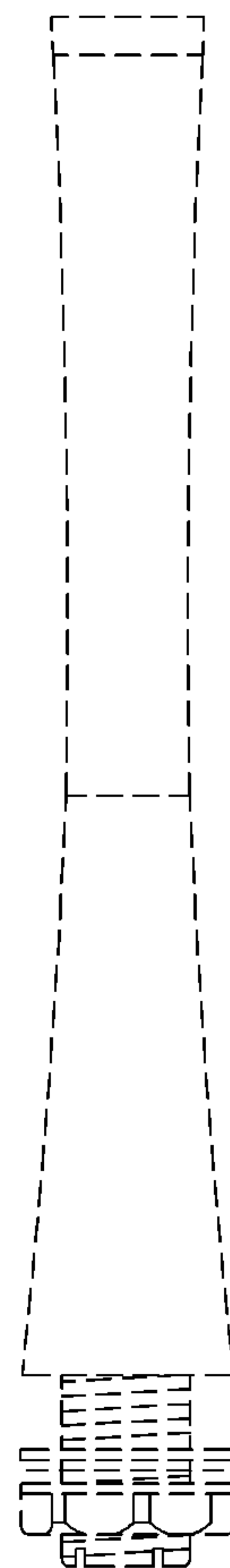

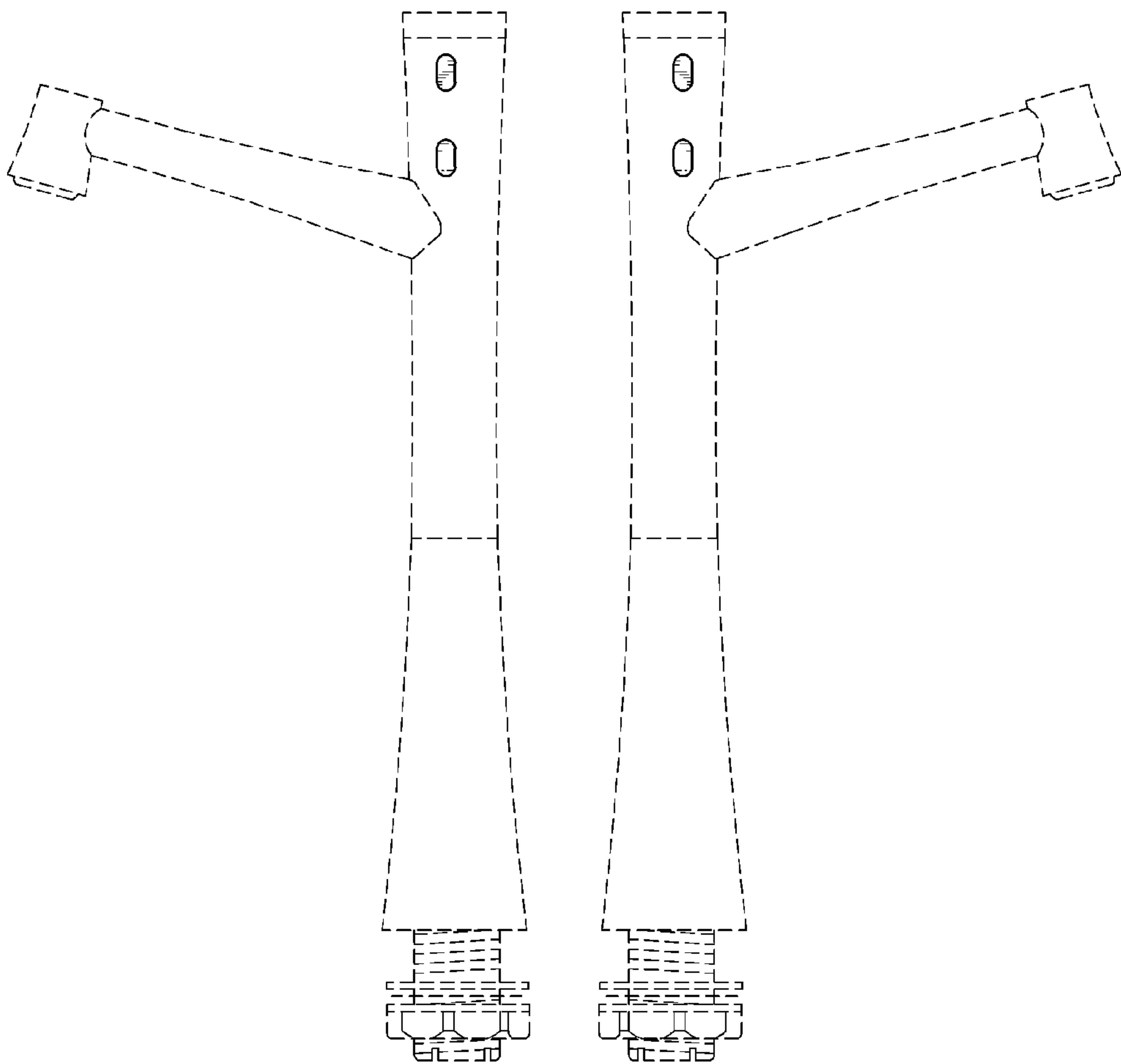

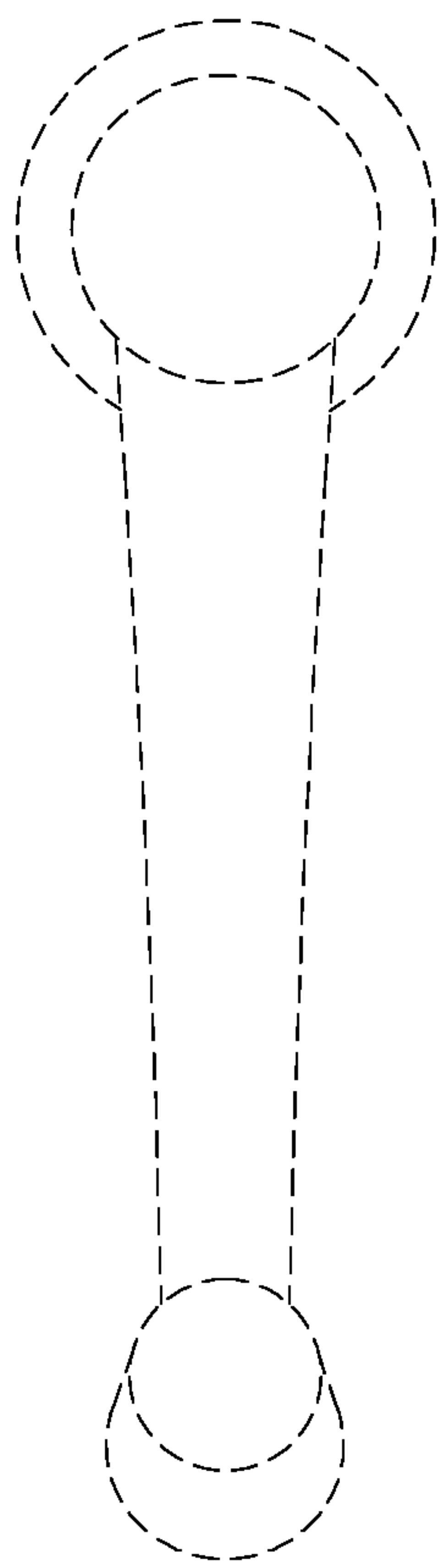

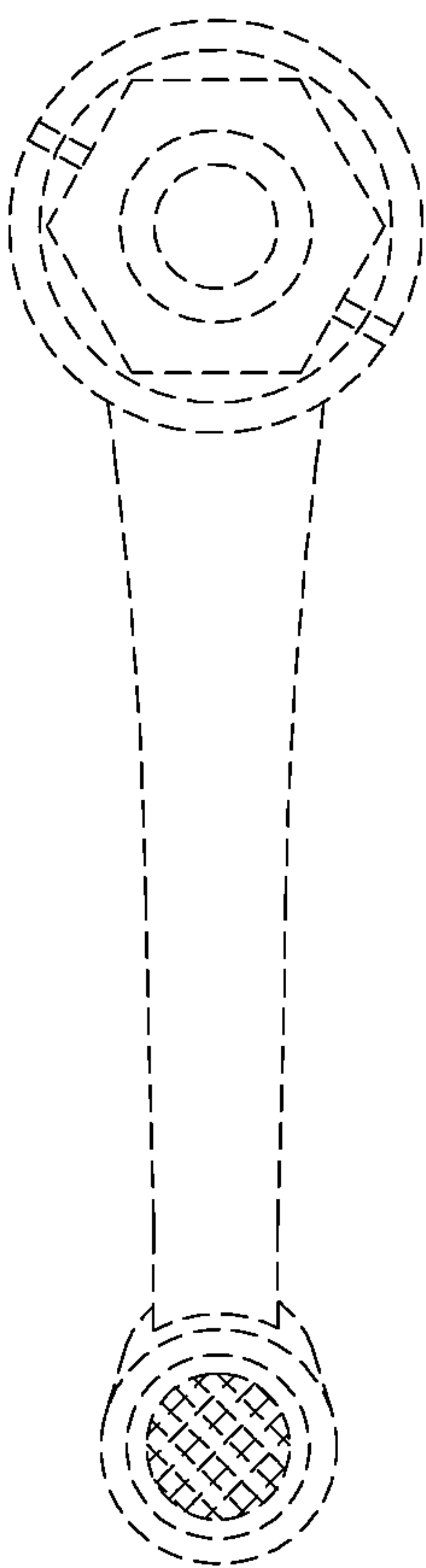
