DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear view of a display screen of digital camera
showing my new design;

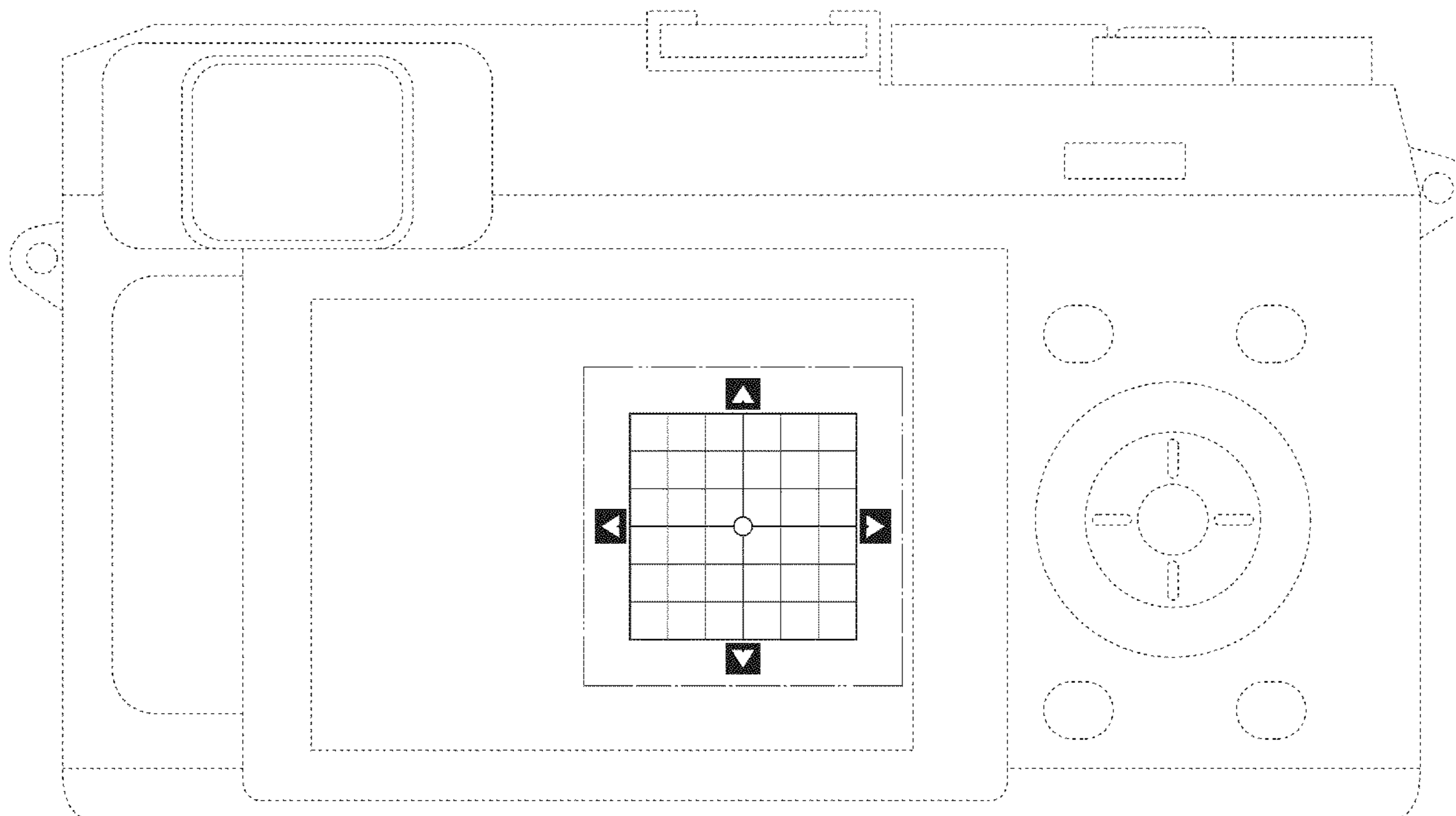

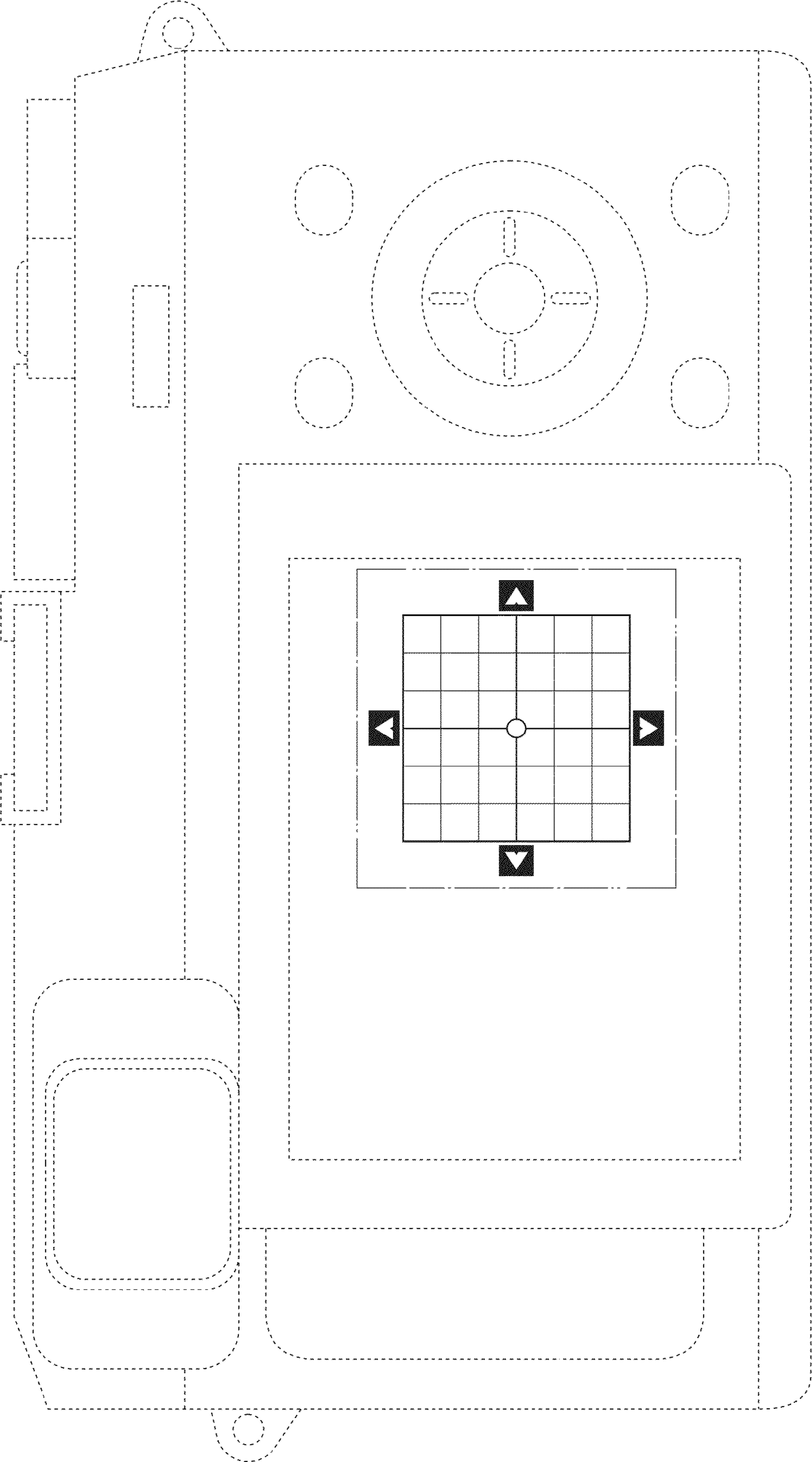

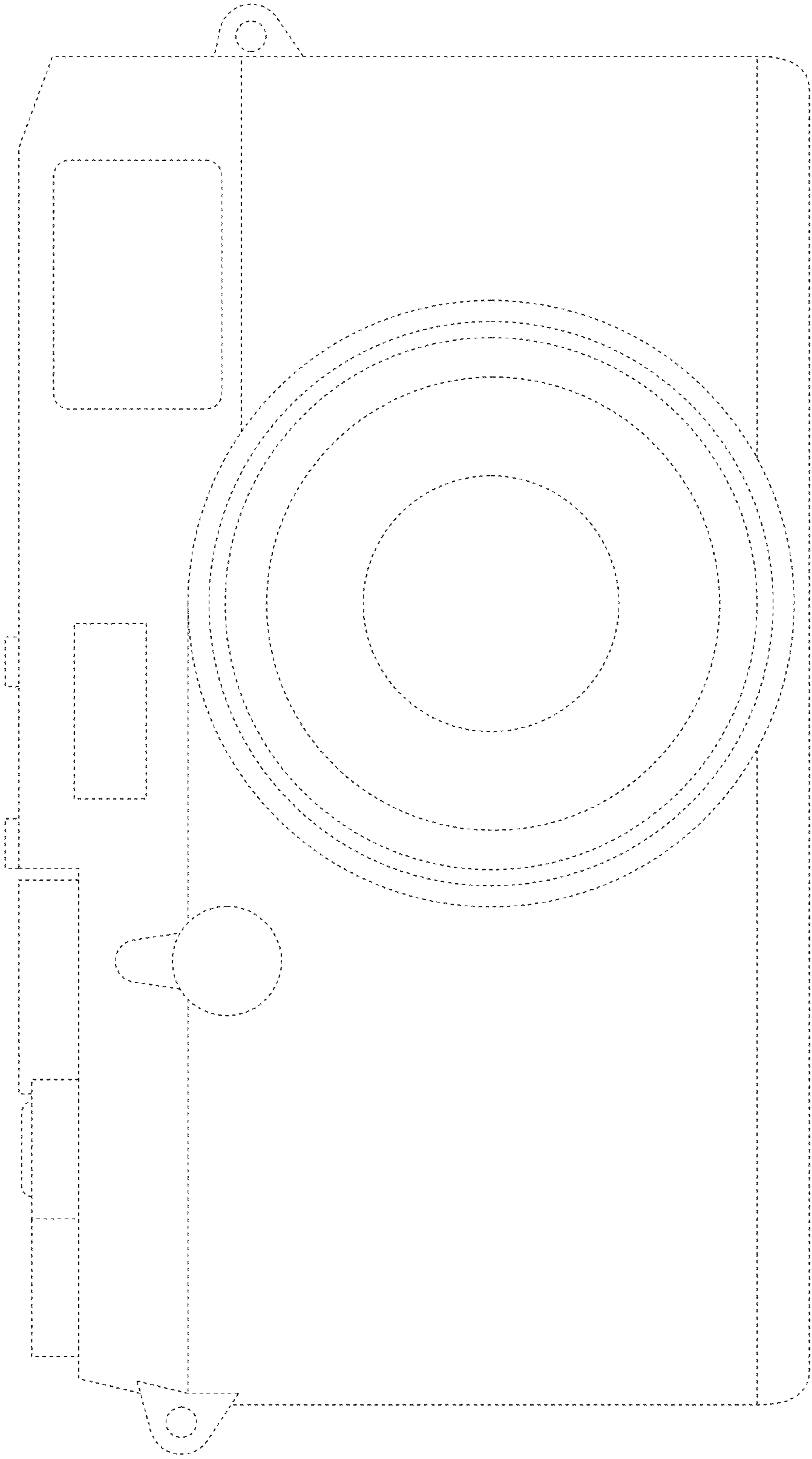

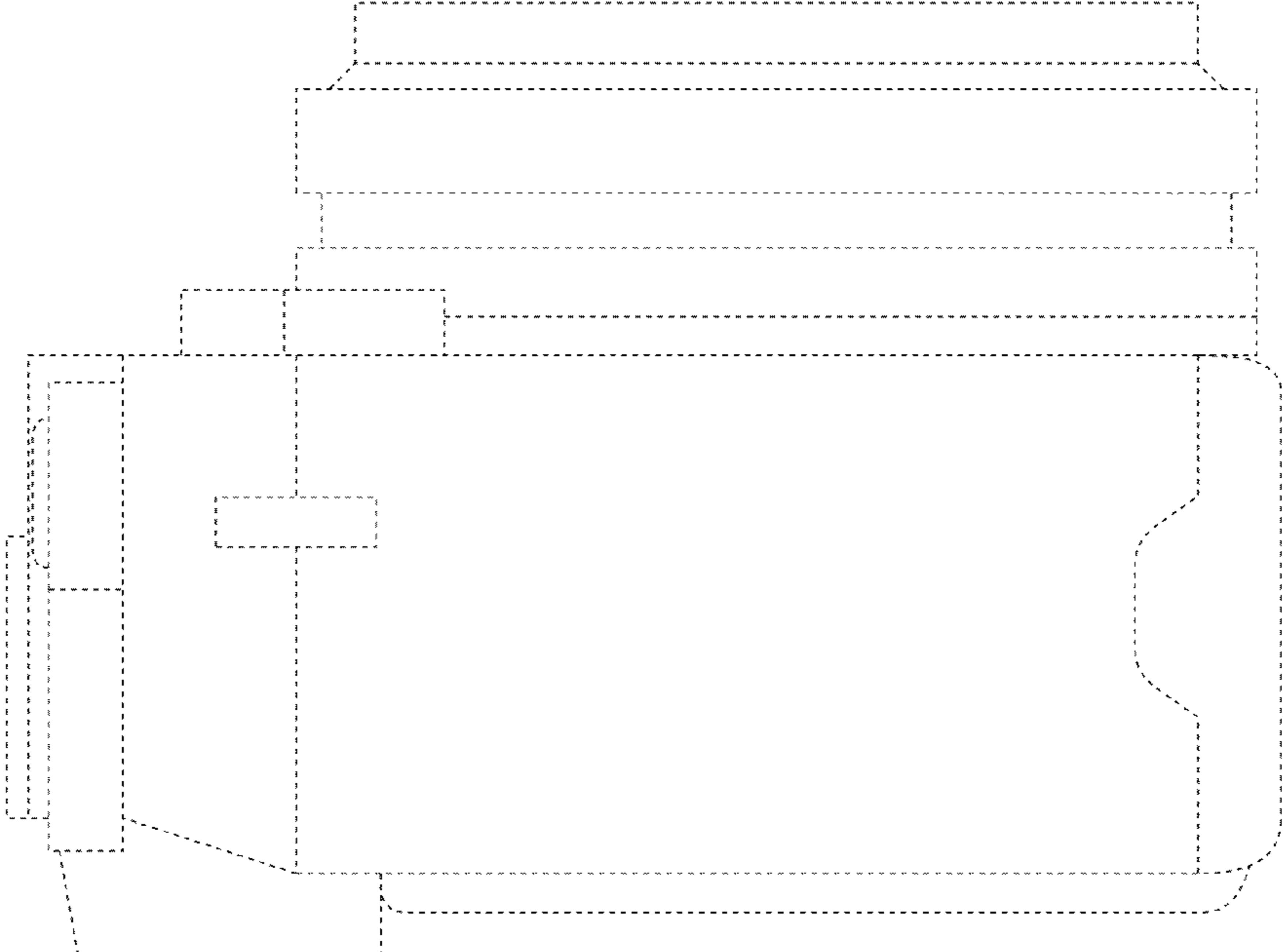

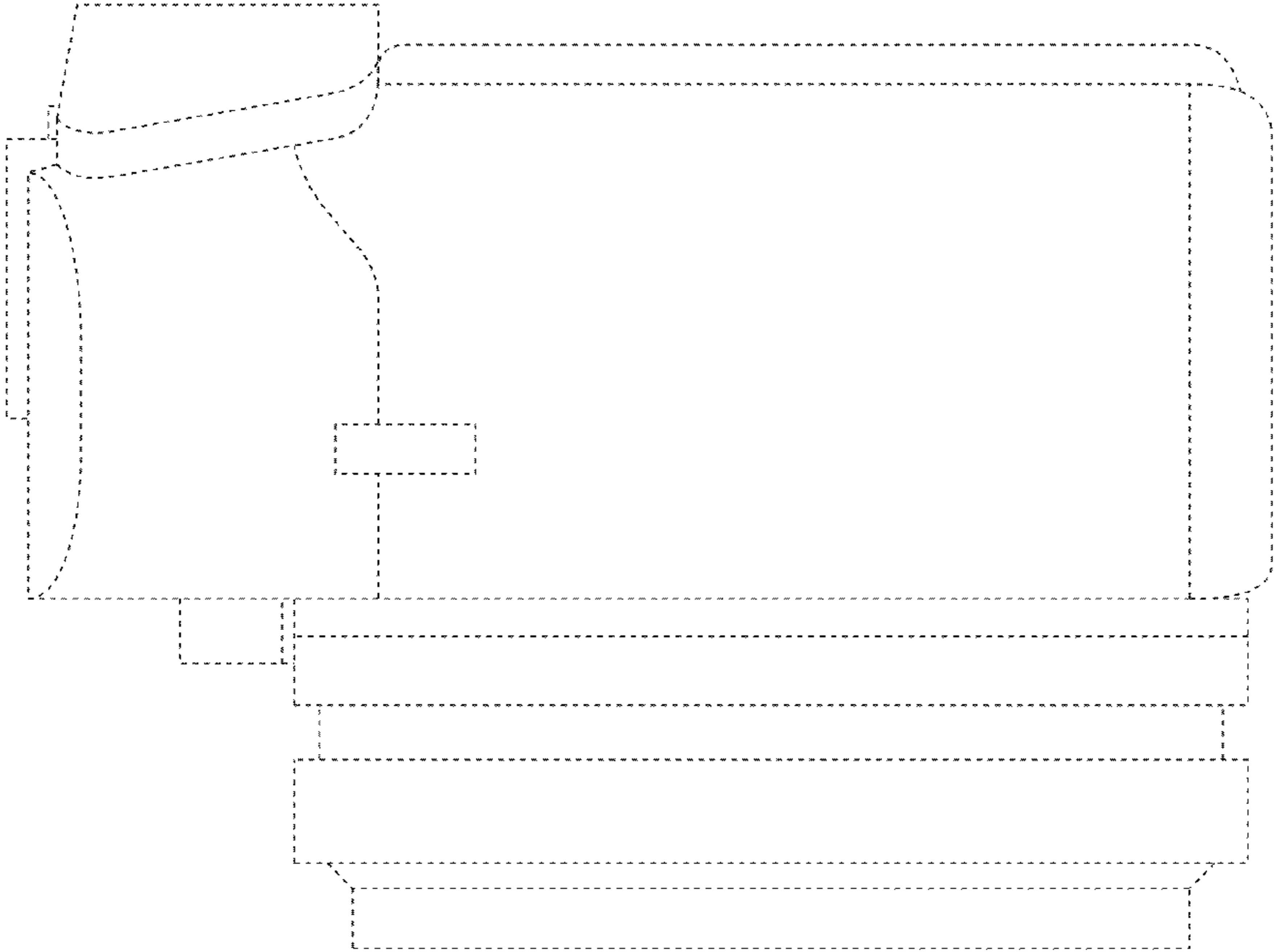

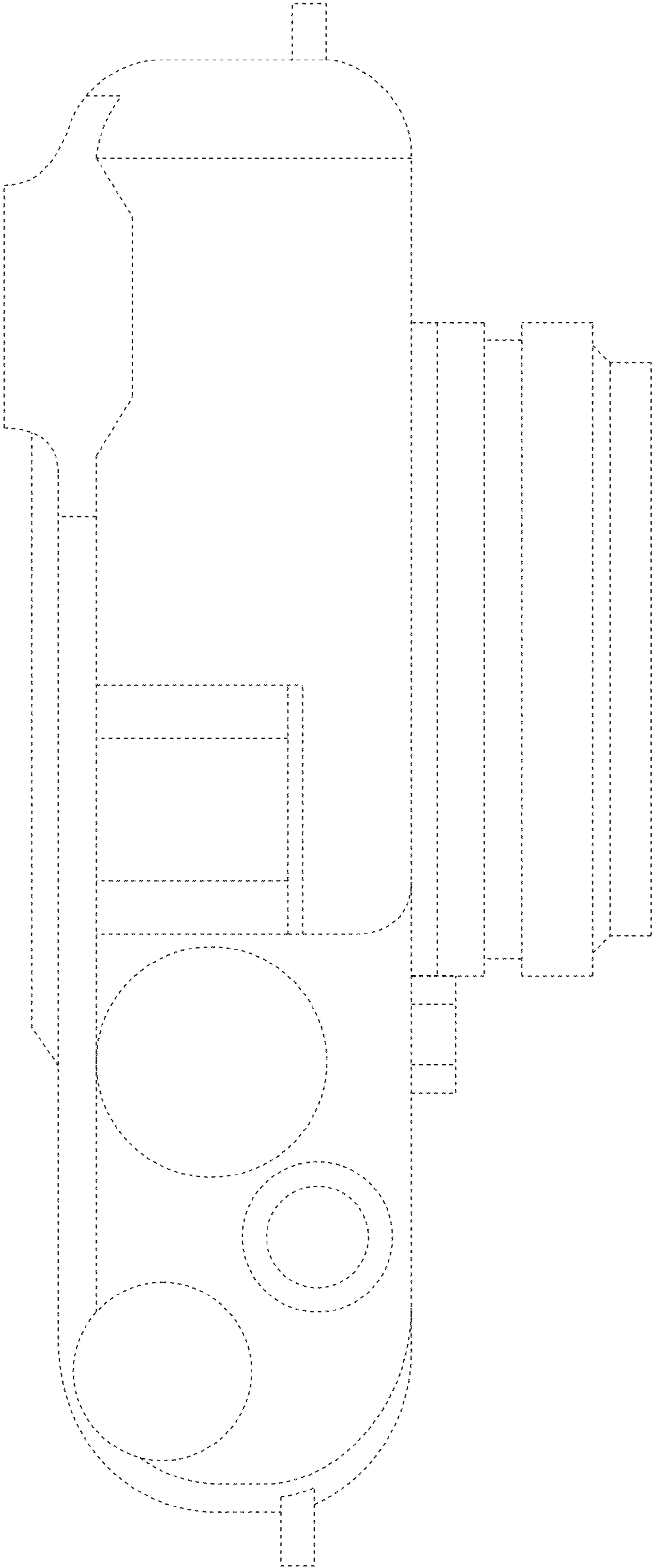
