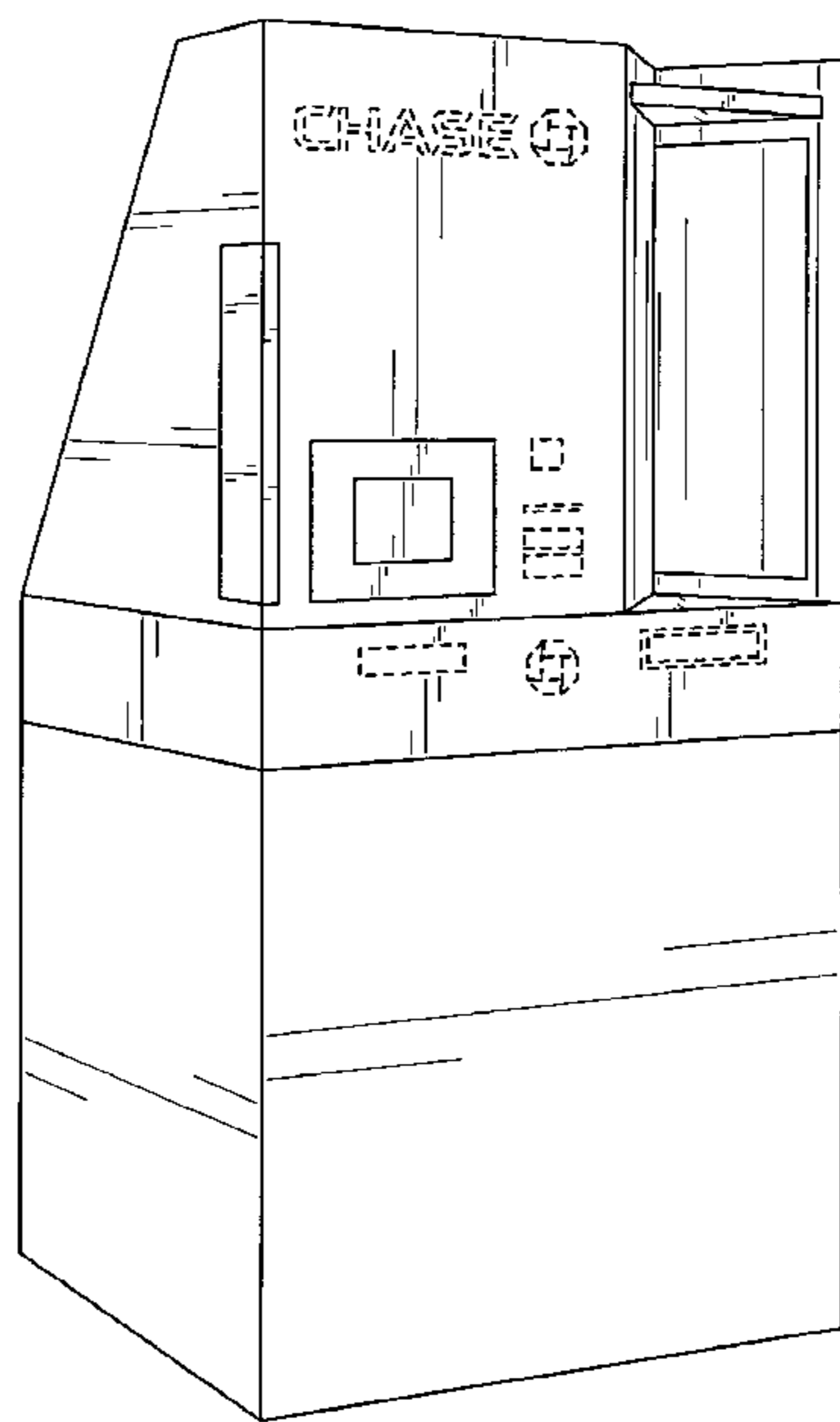
(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a financial transaction machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a financial transaction machine showing our new design.
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is a back elevational view of FIG. 1.
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1.
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1.
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1.
The broken lines in the drawings illustrate environmental structure on the article and form no part of the claimed design.

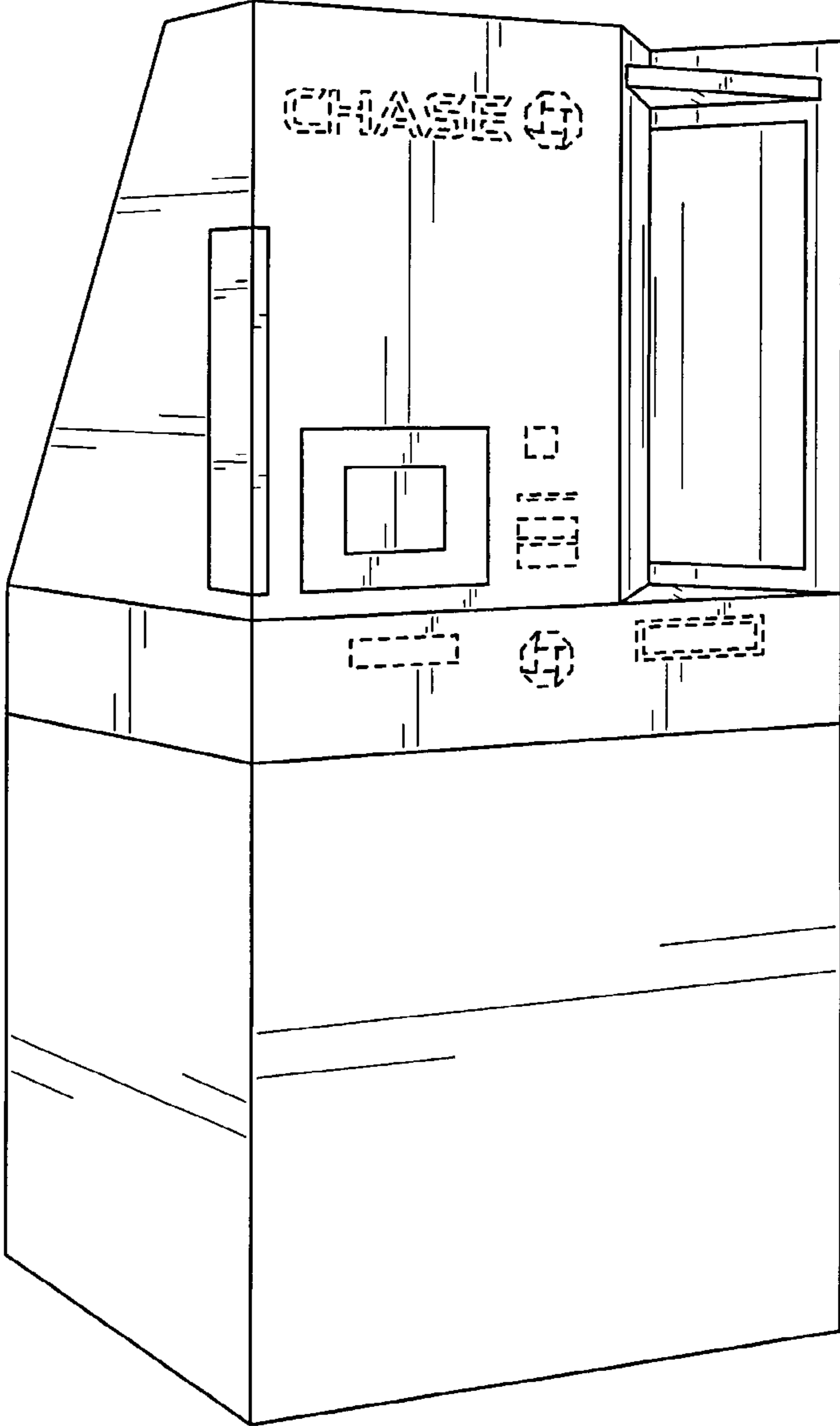

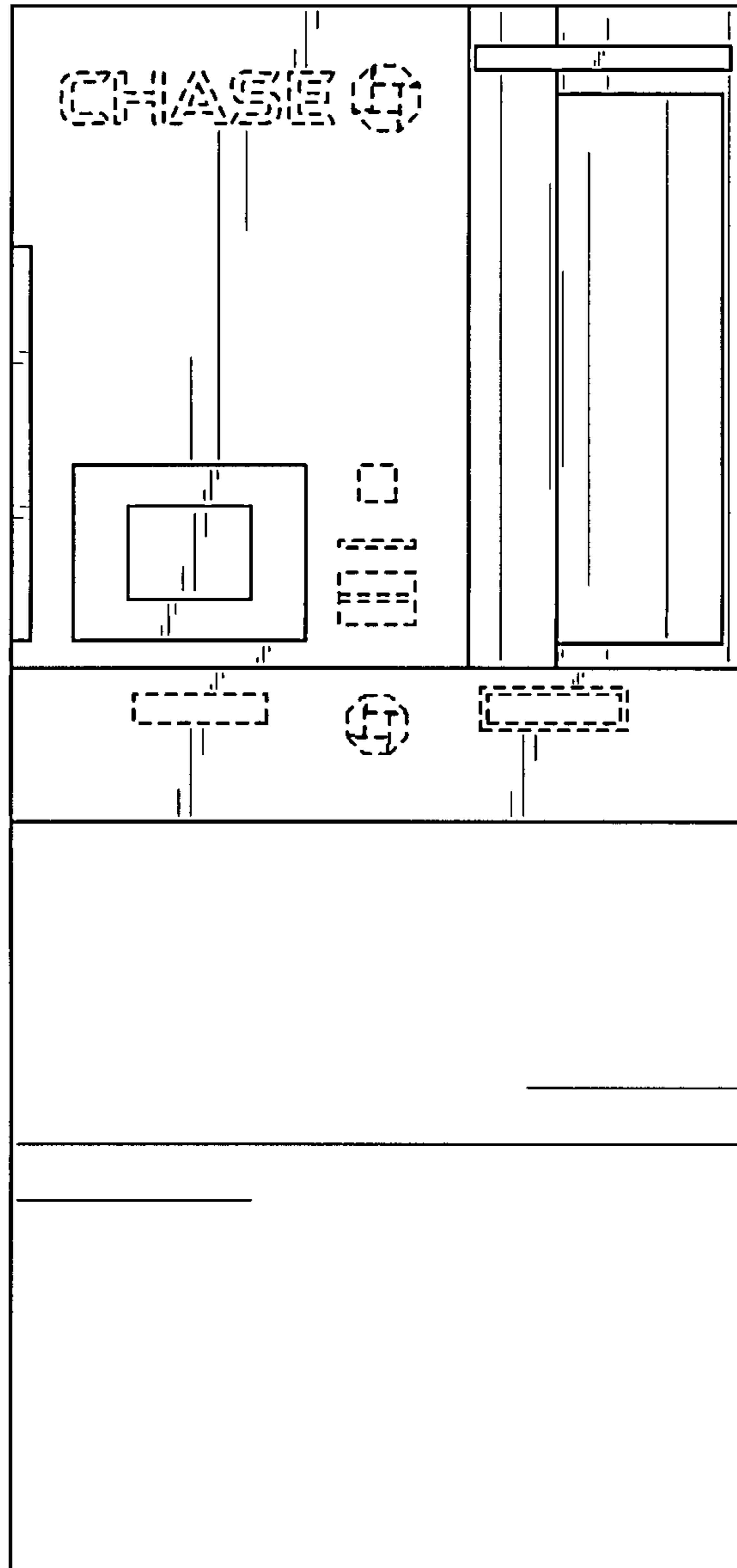

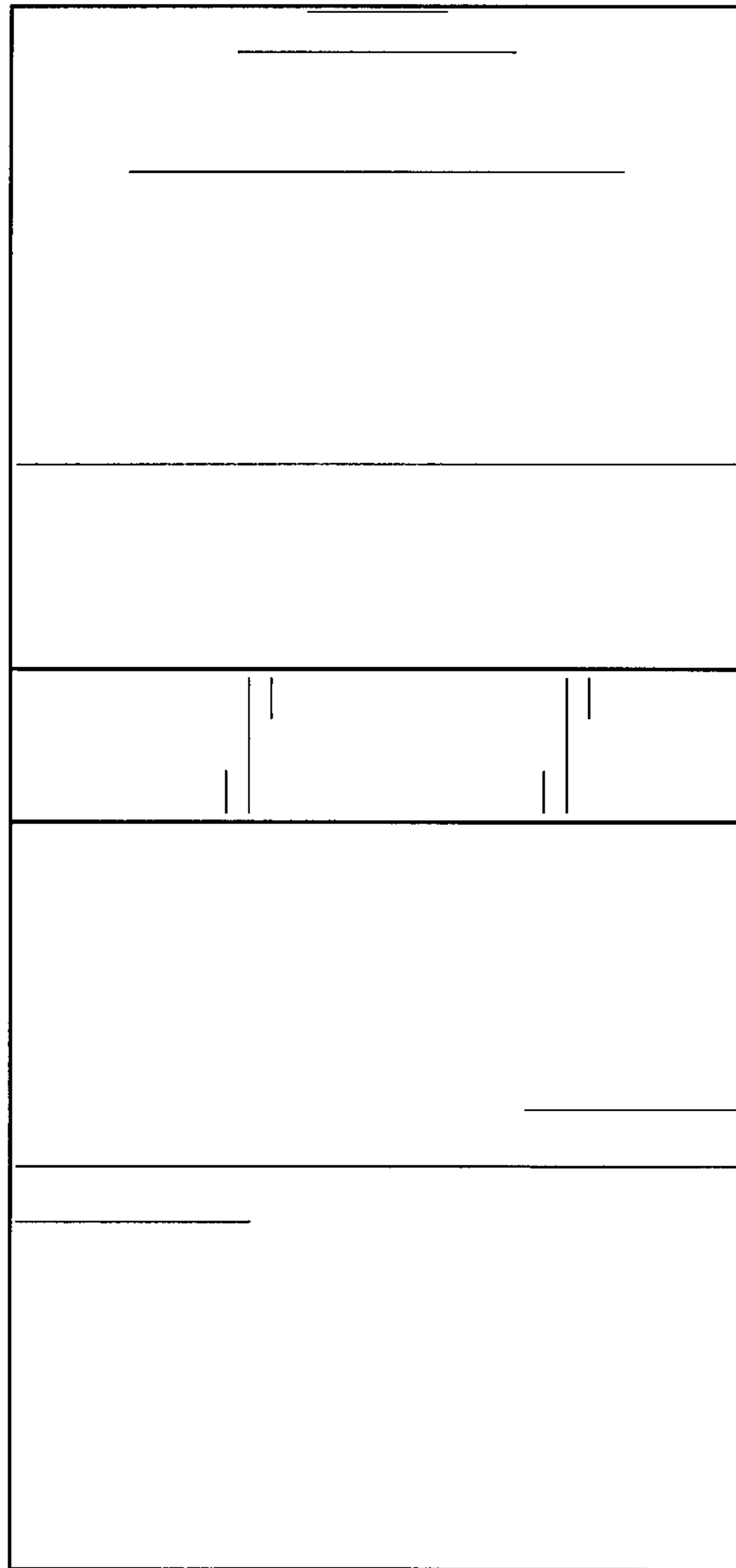

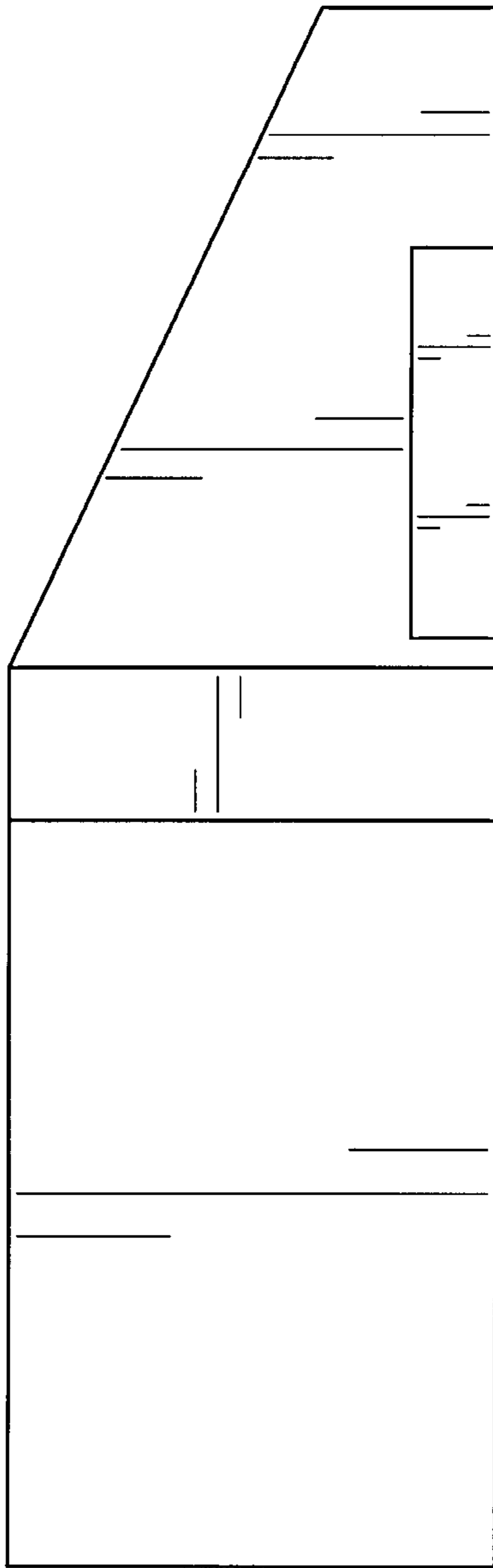

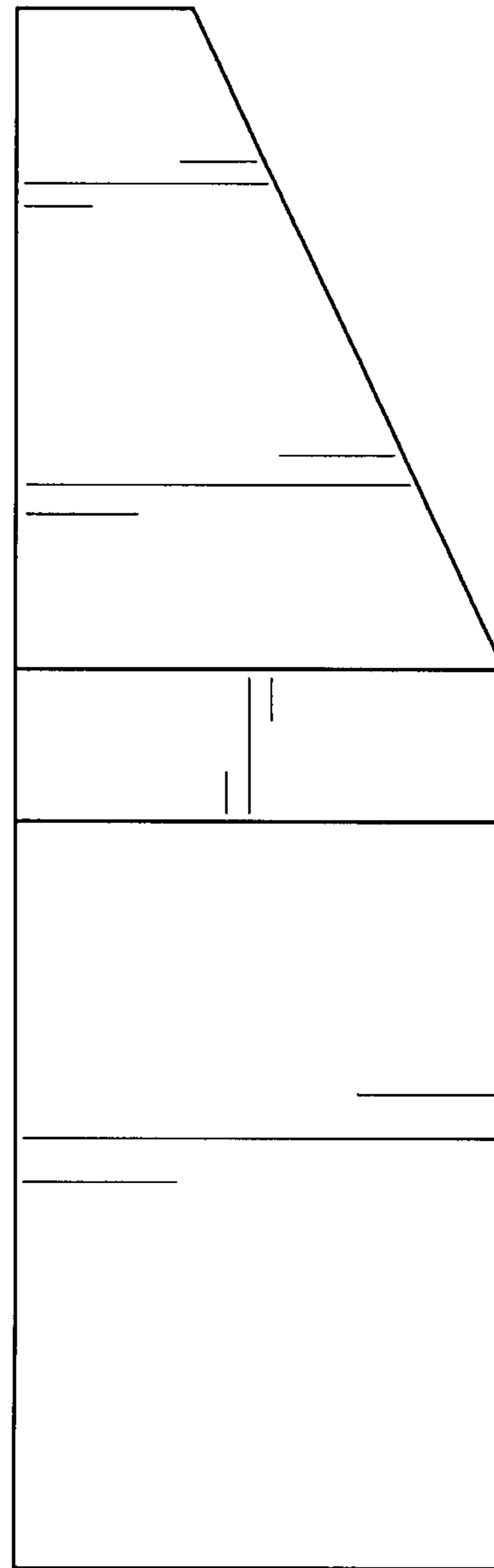

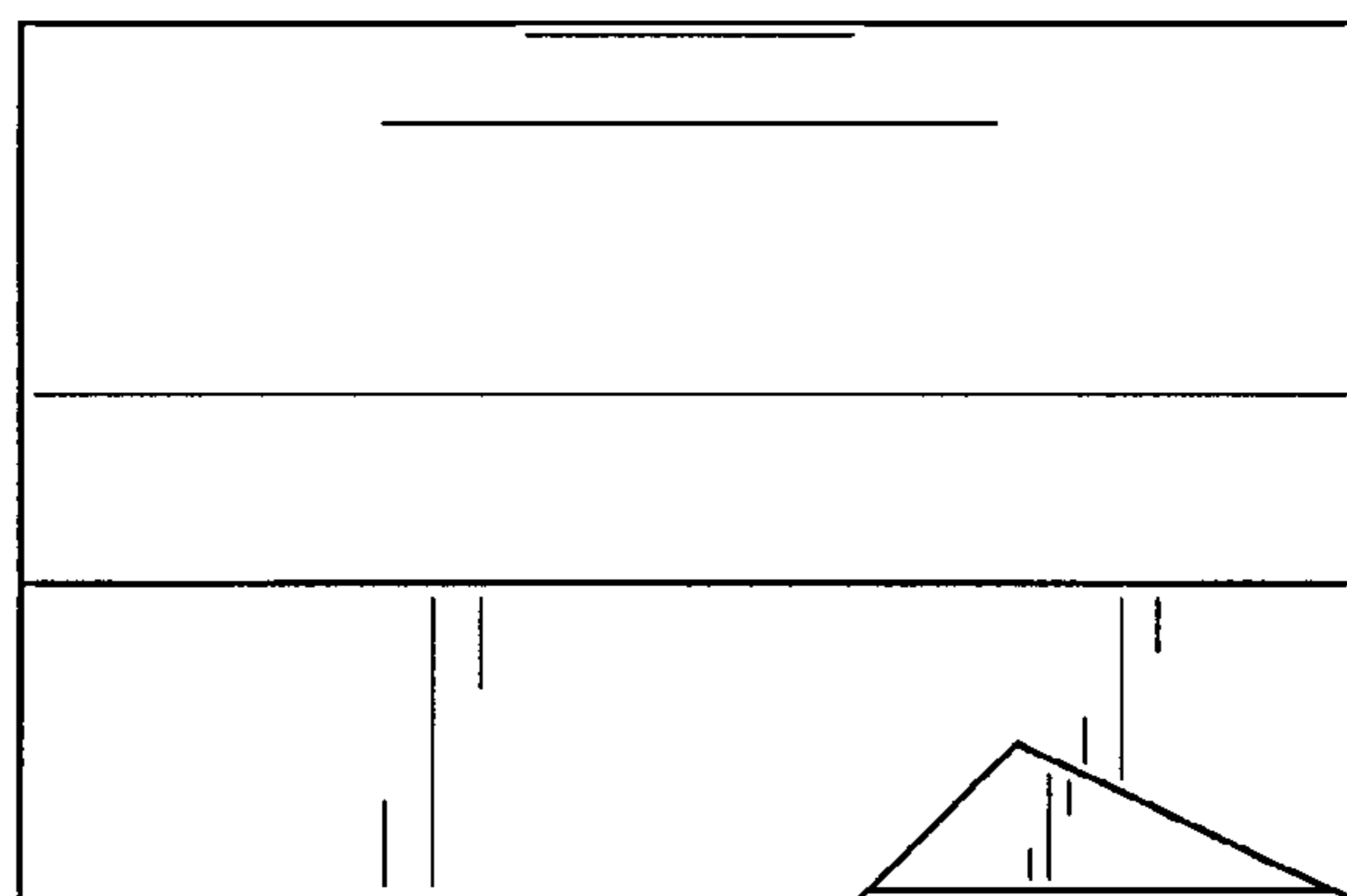

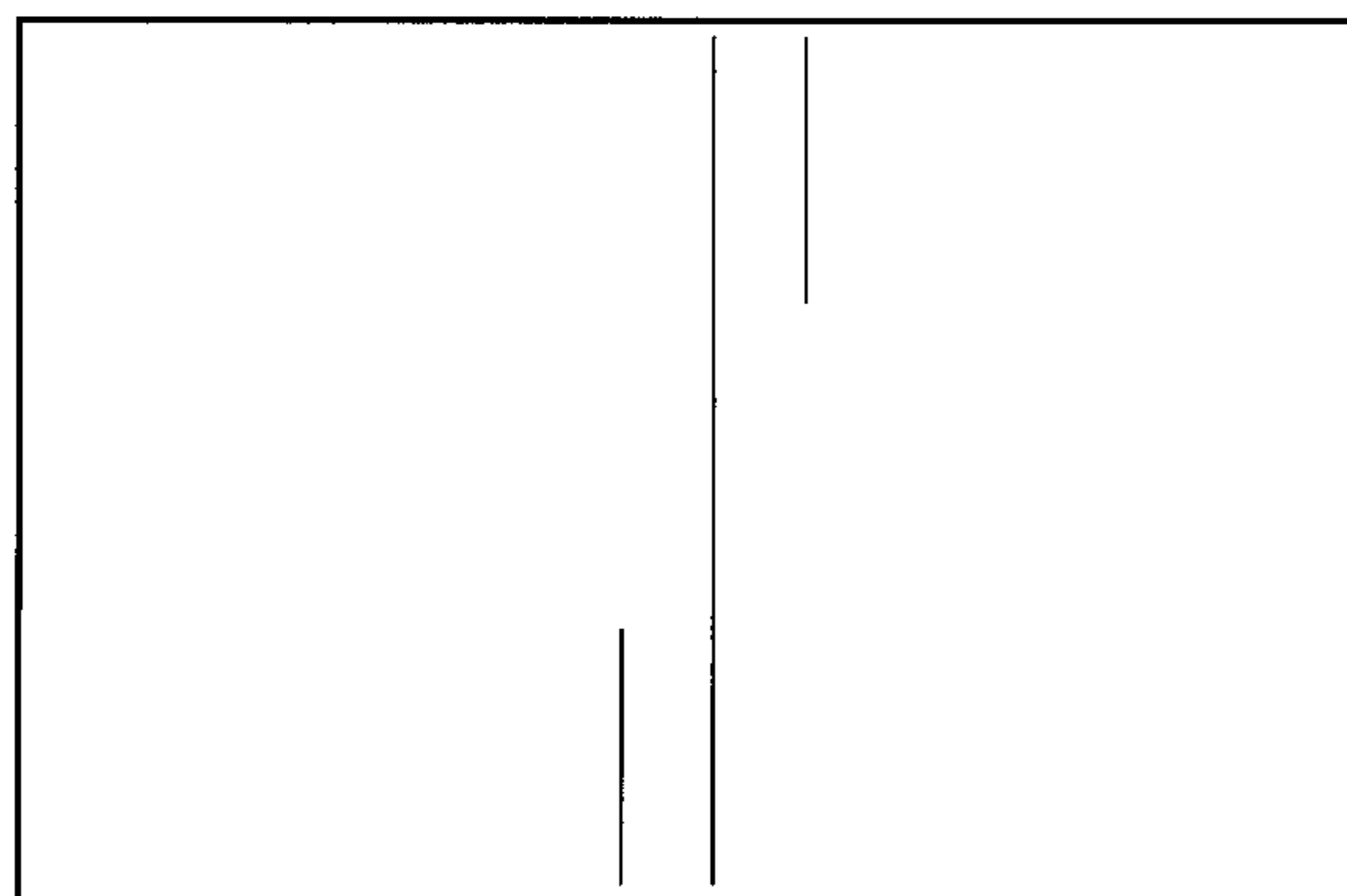
