FIG. 4 is a side view of the faucet of FIG. 1.

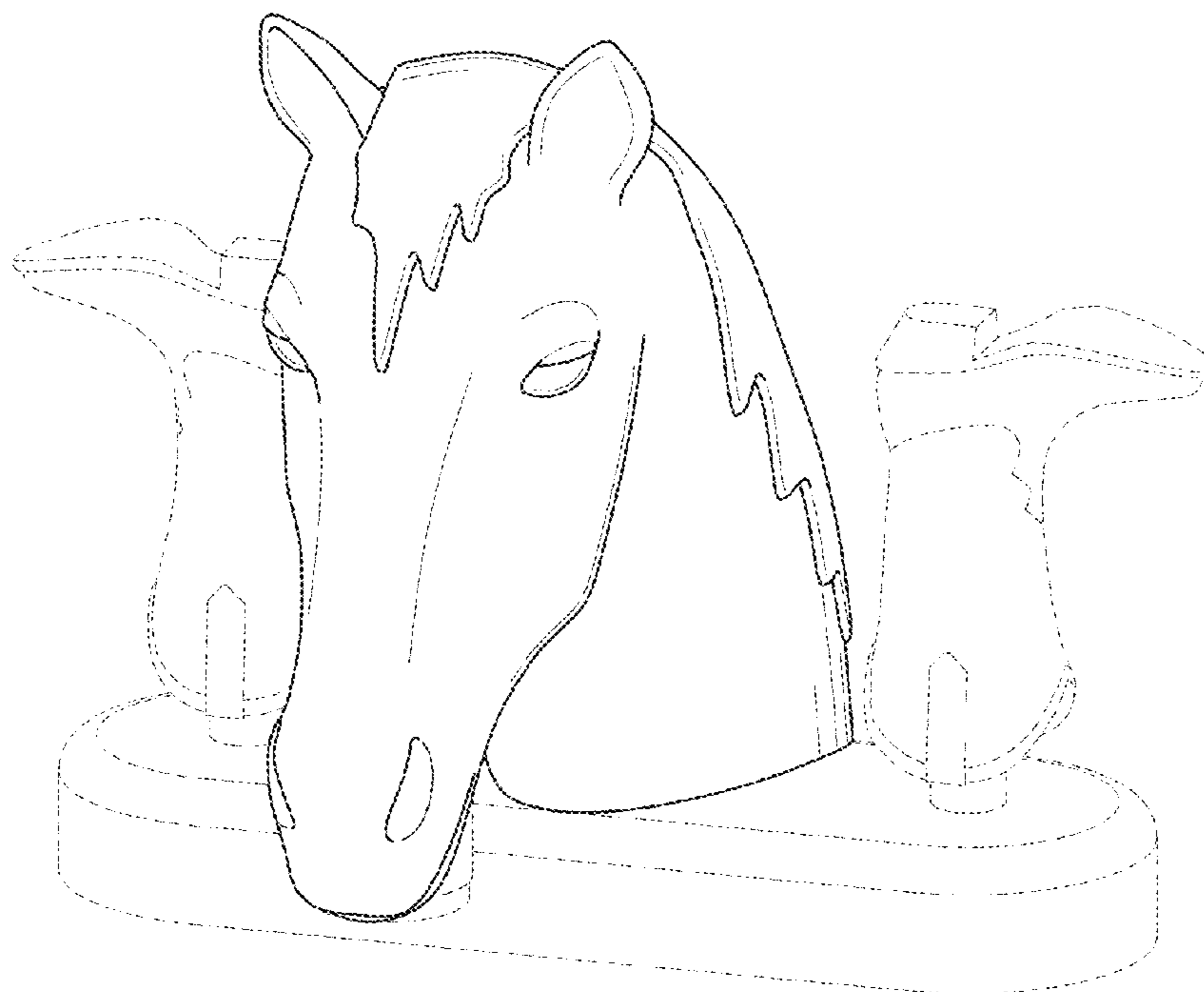
FIG. 5 is an opposite side view of the faucet of FIG. 1.

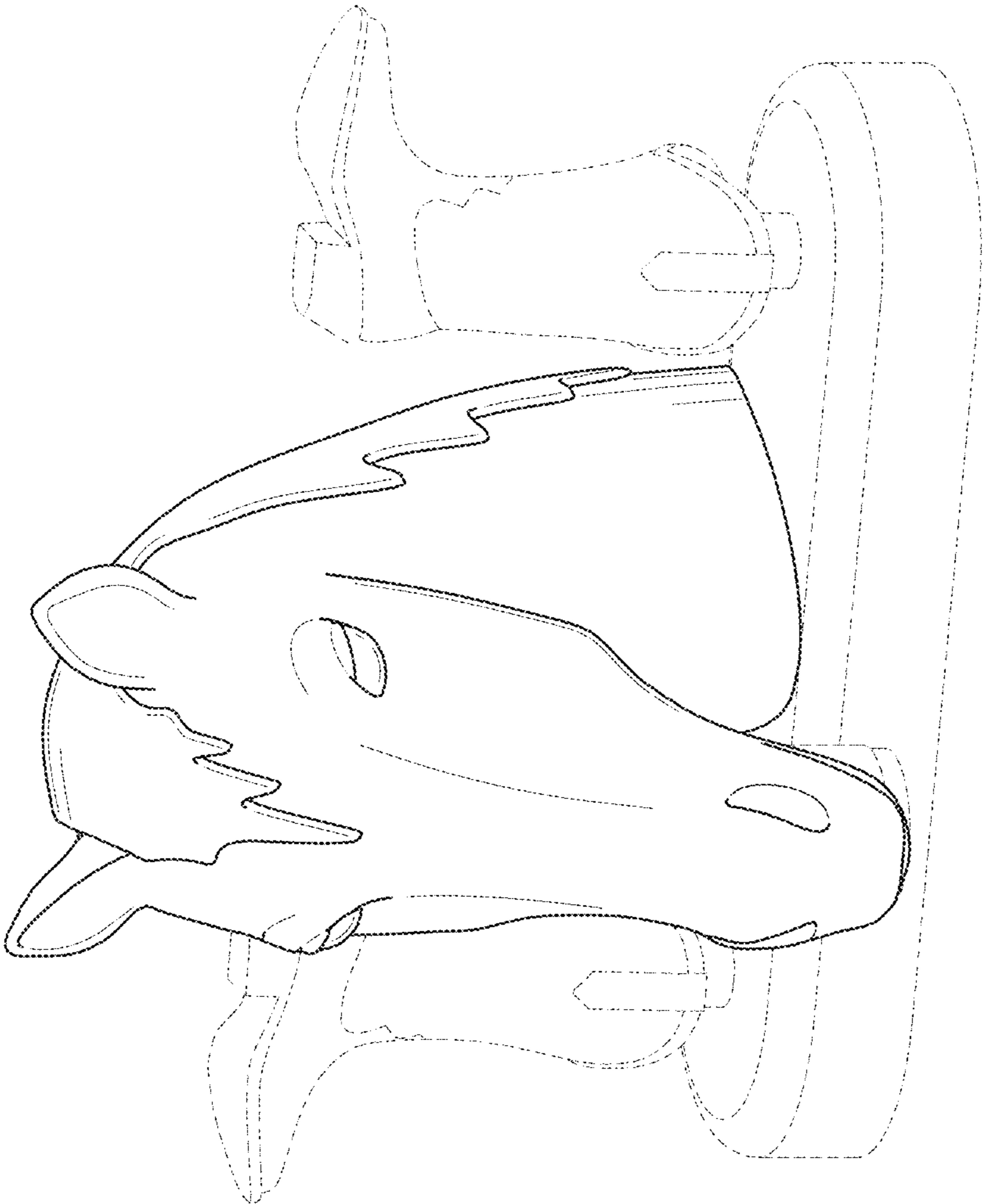

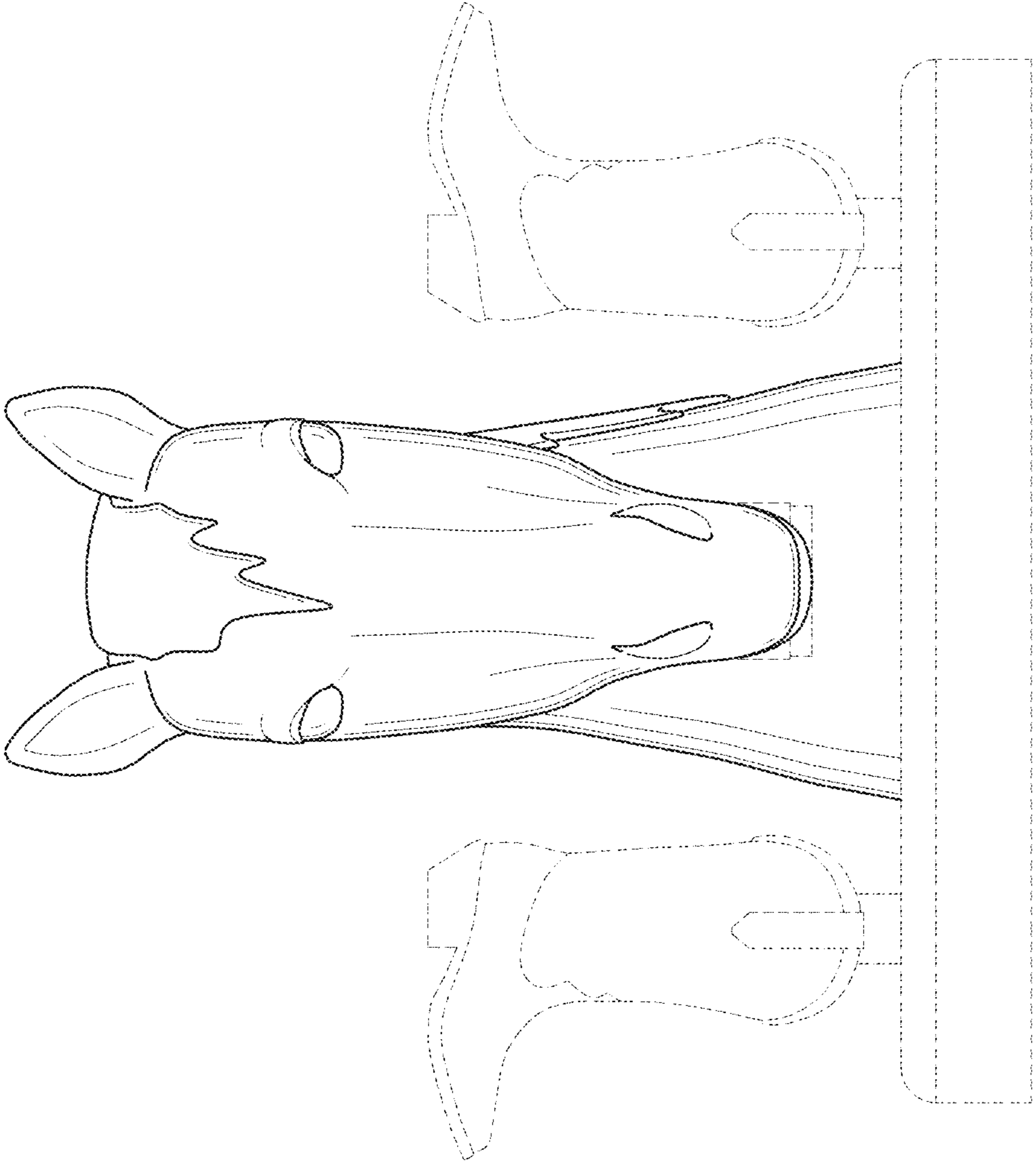

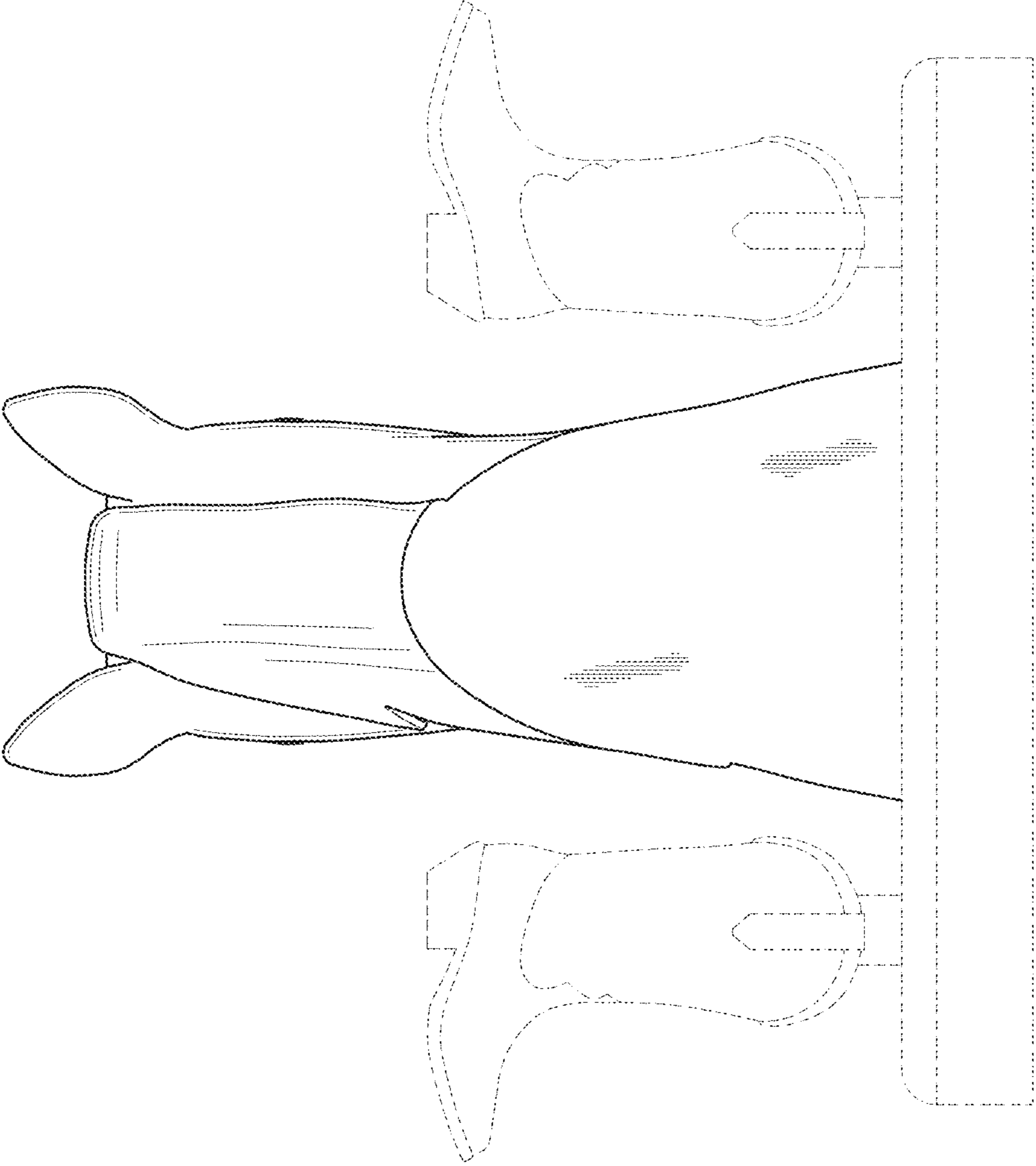

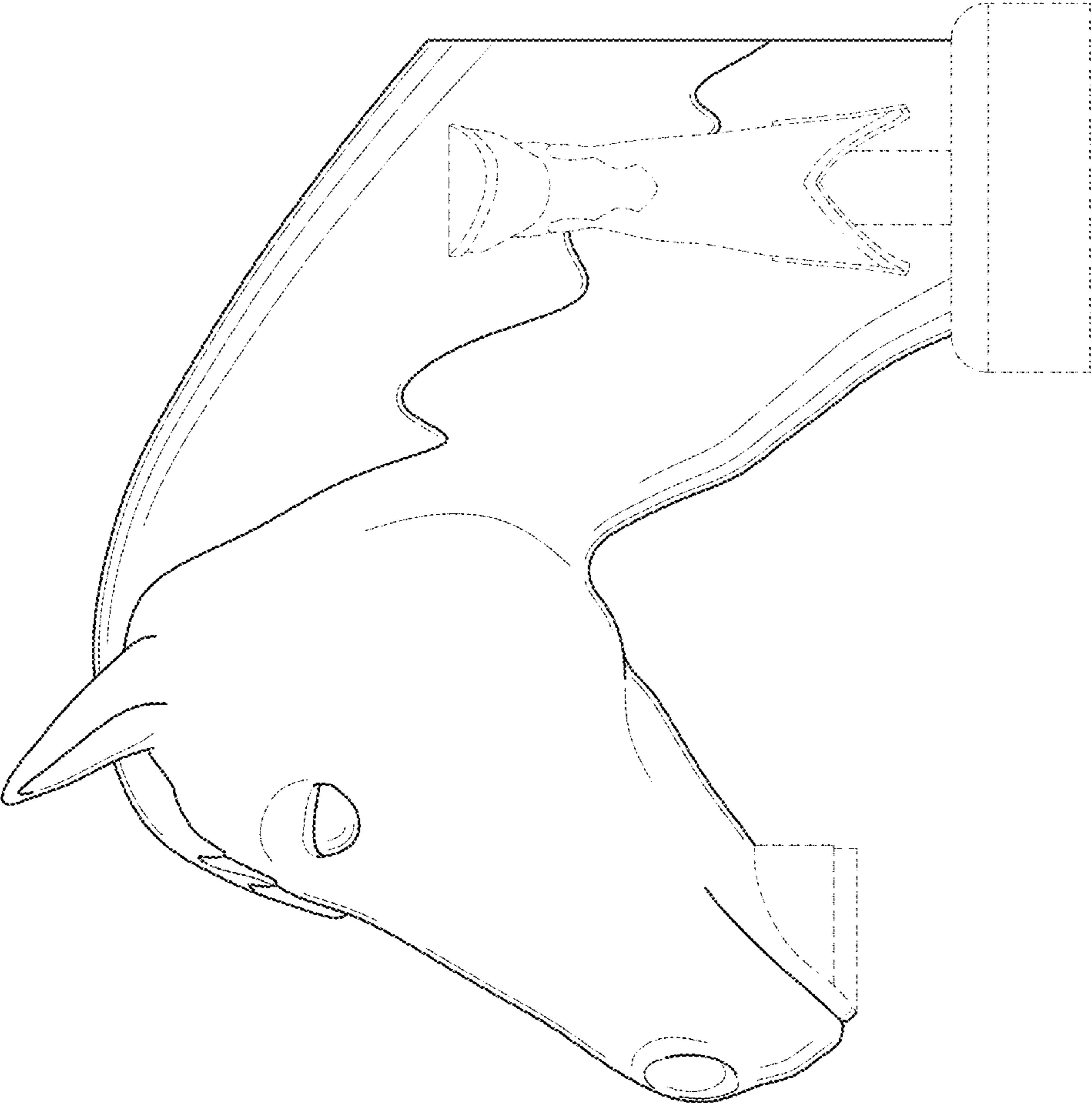

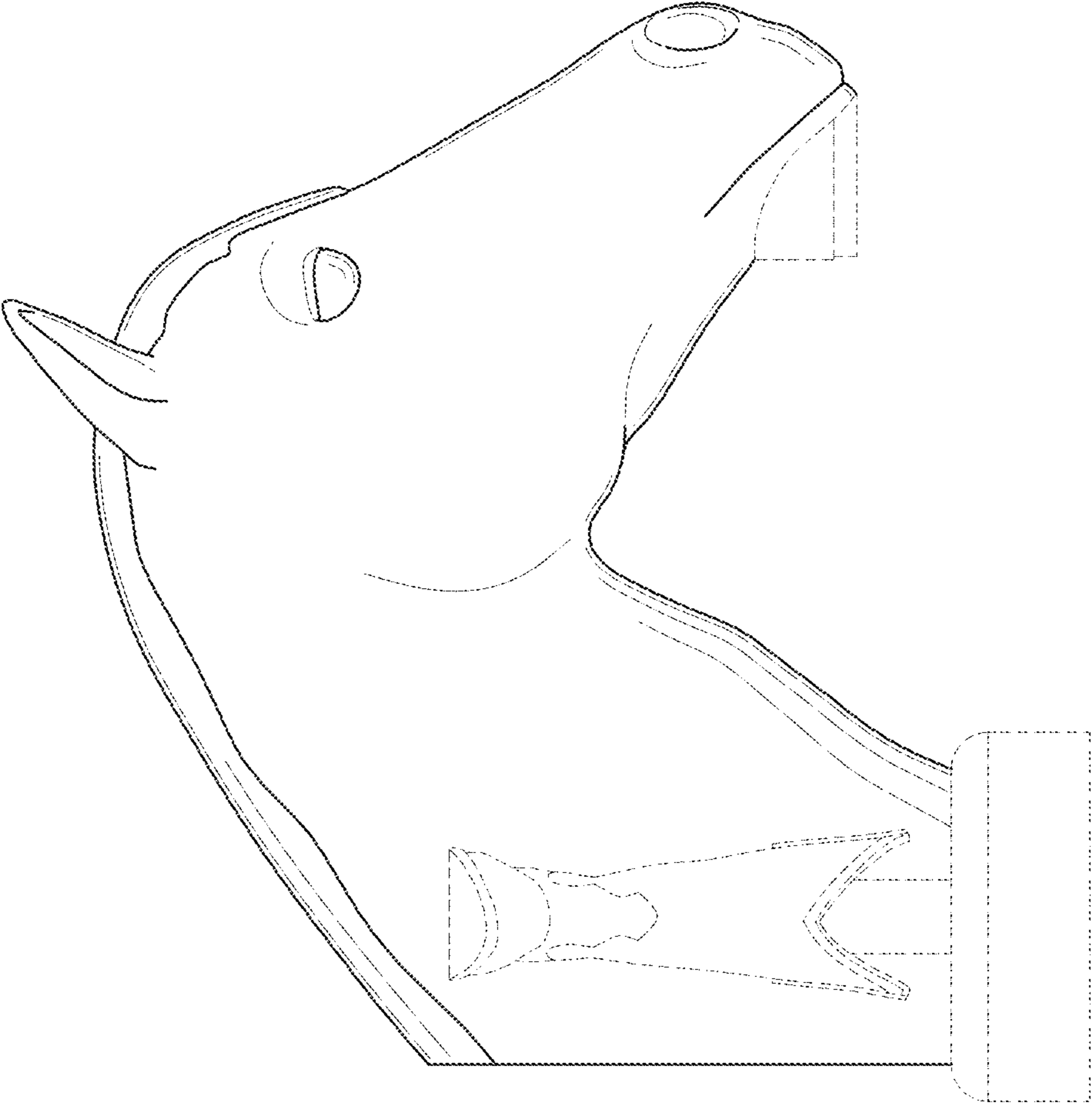

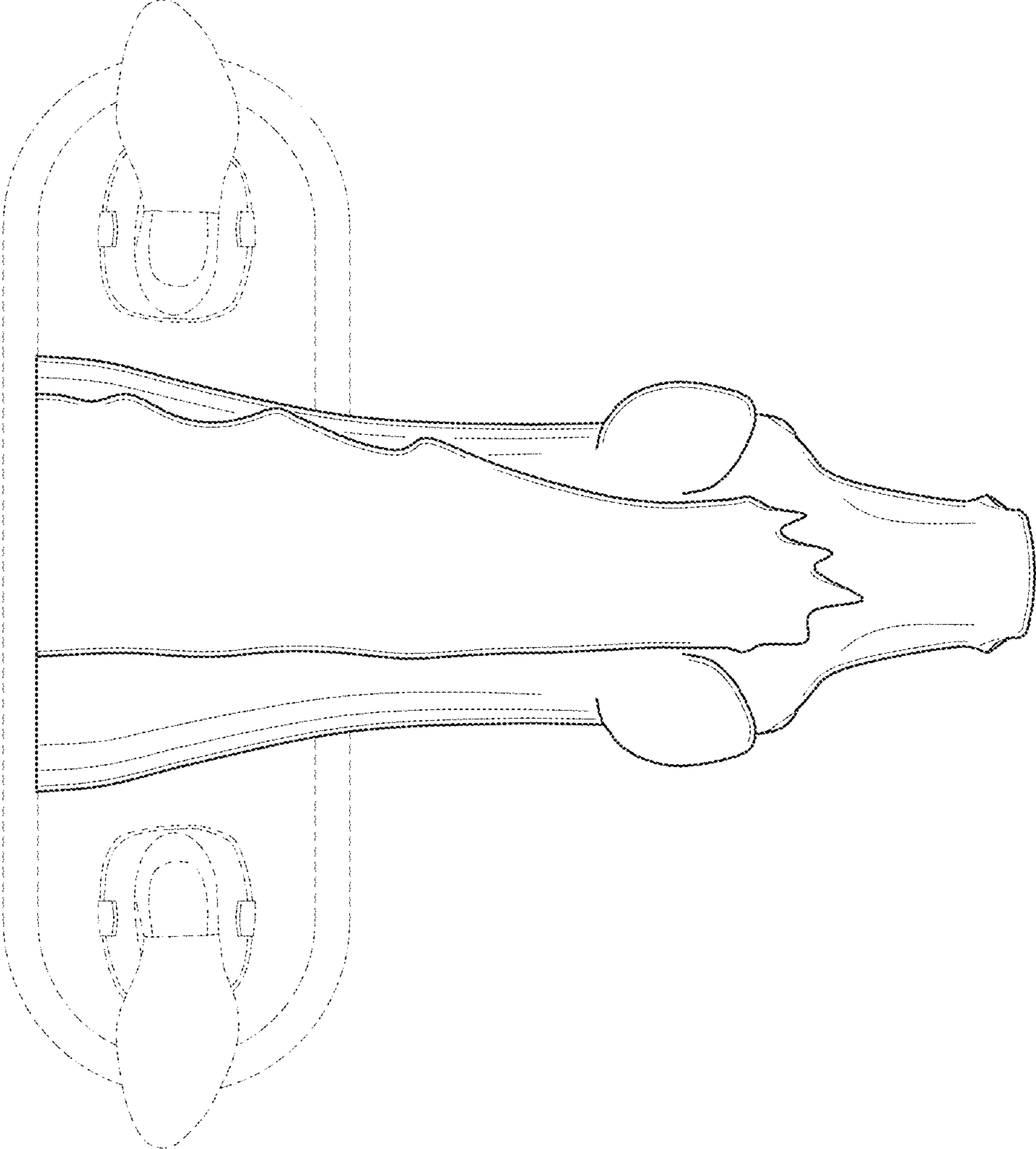

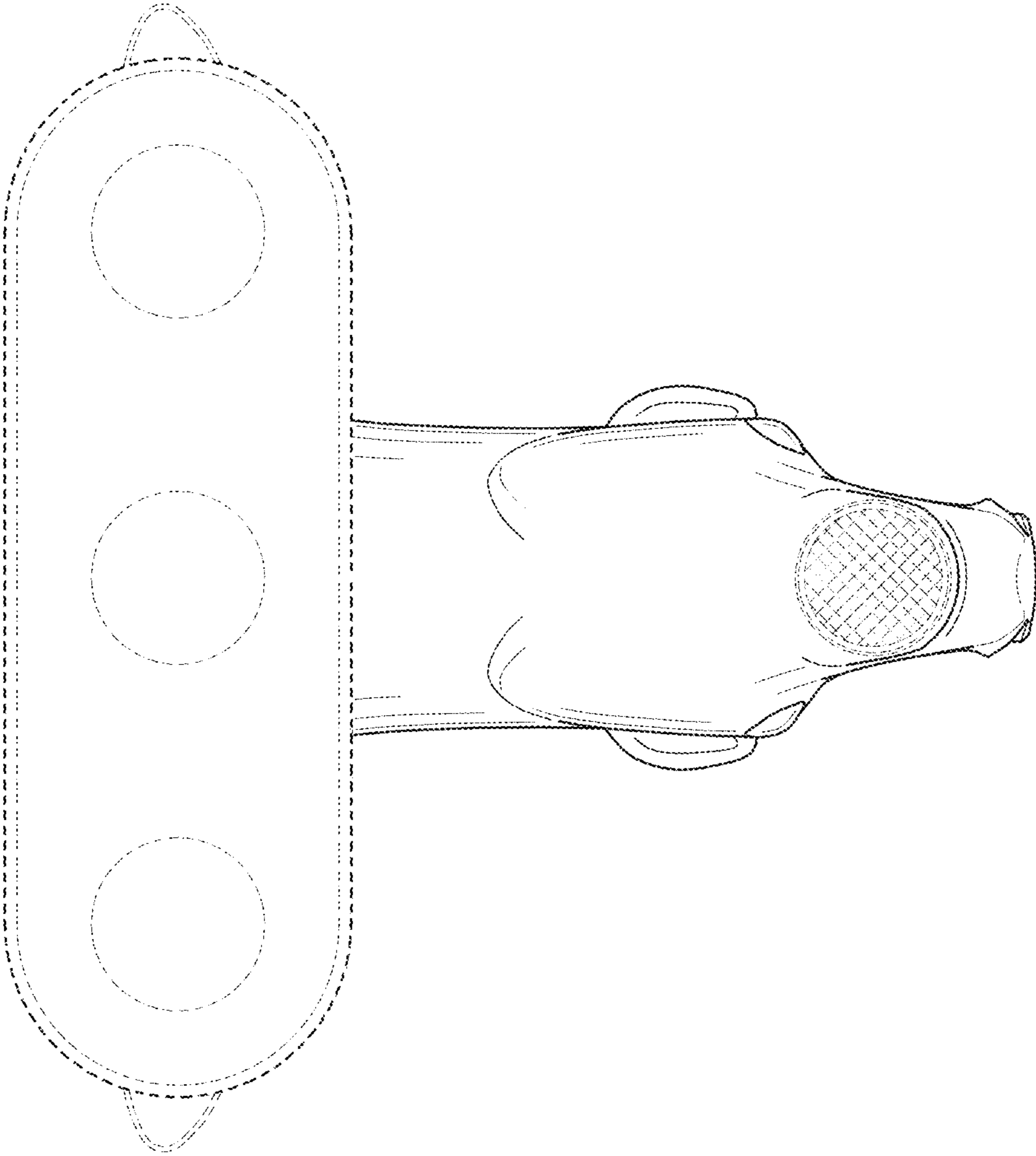
