FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of thereof;

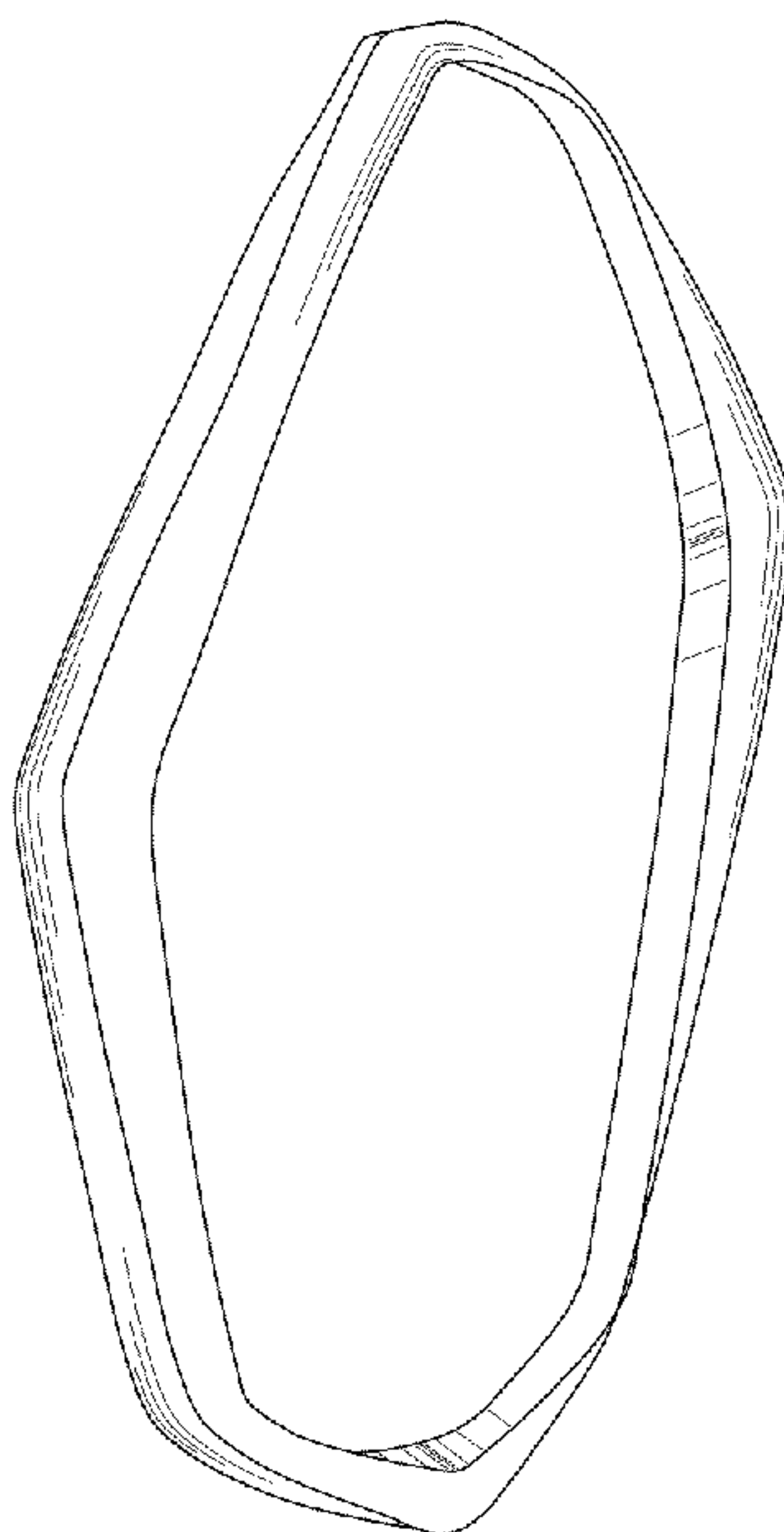
FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view thereof;

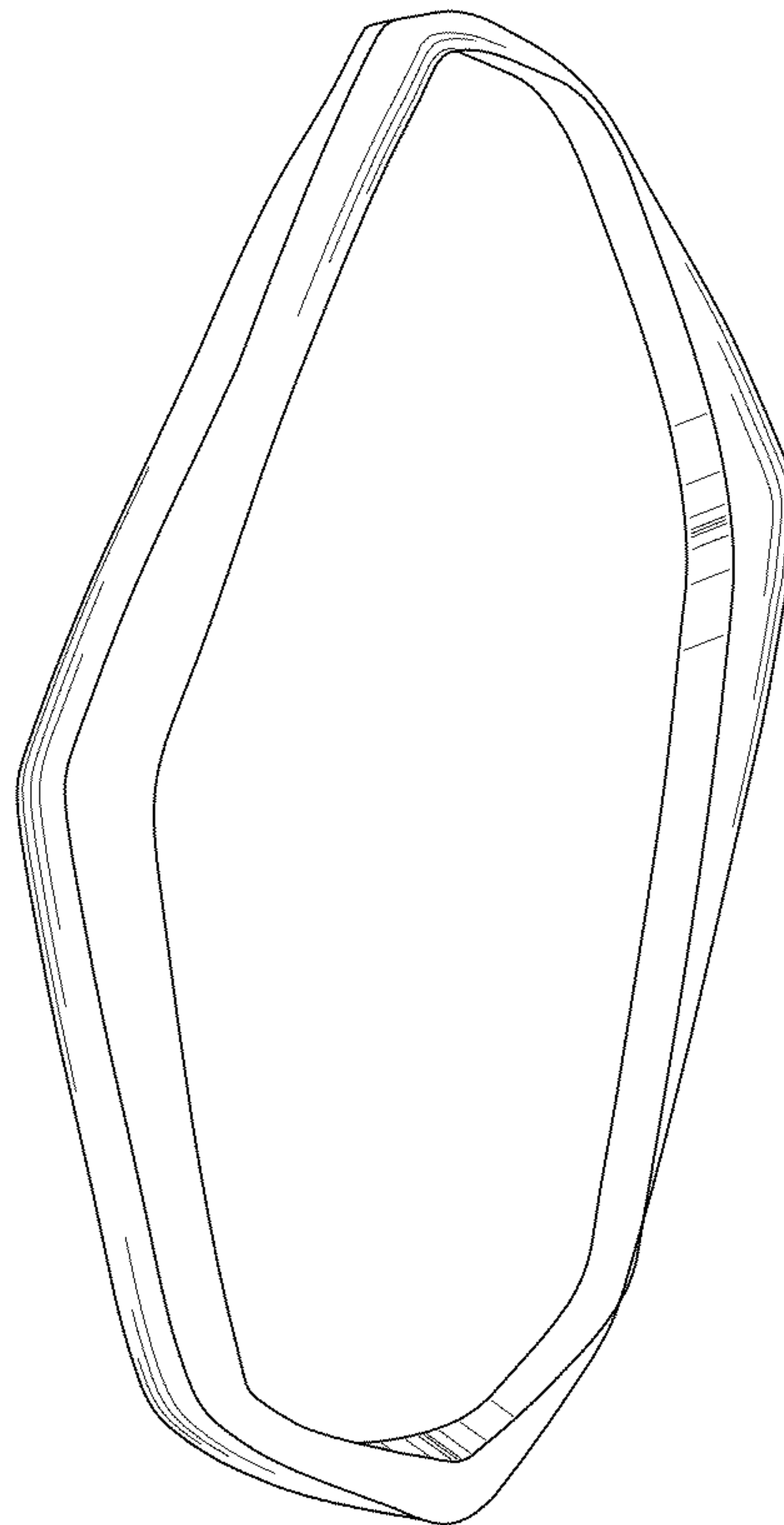

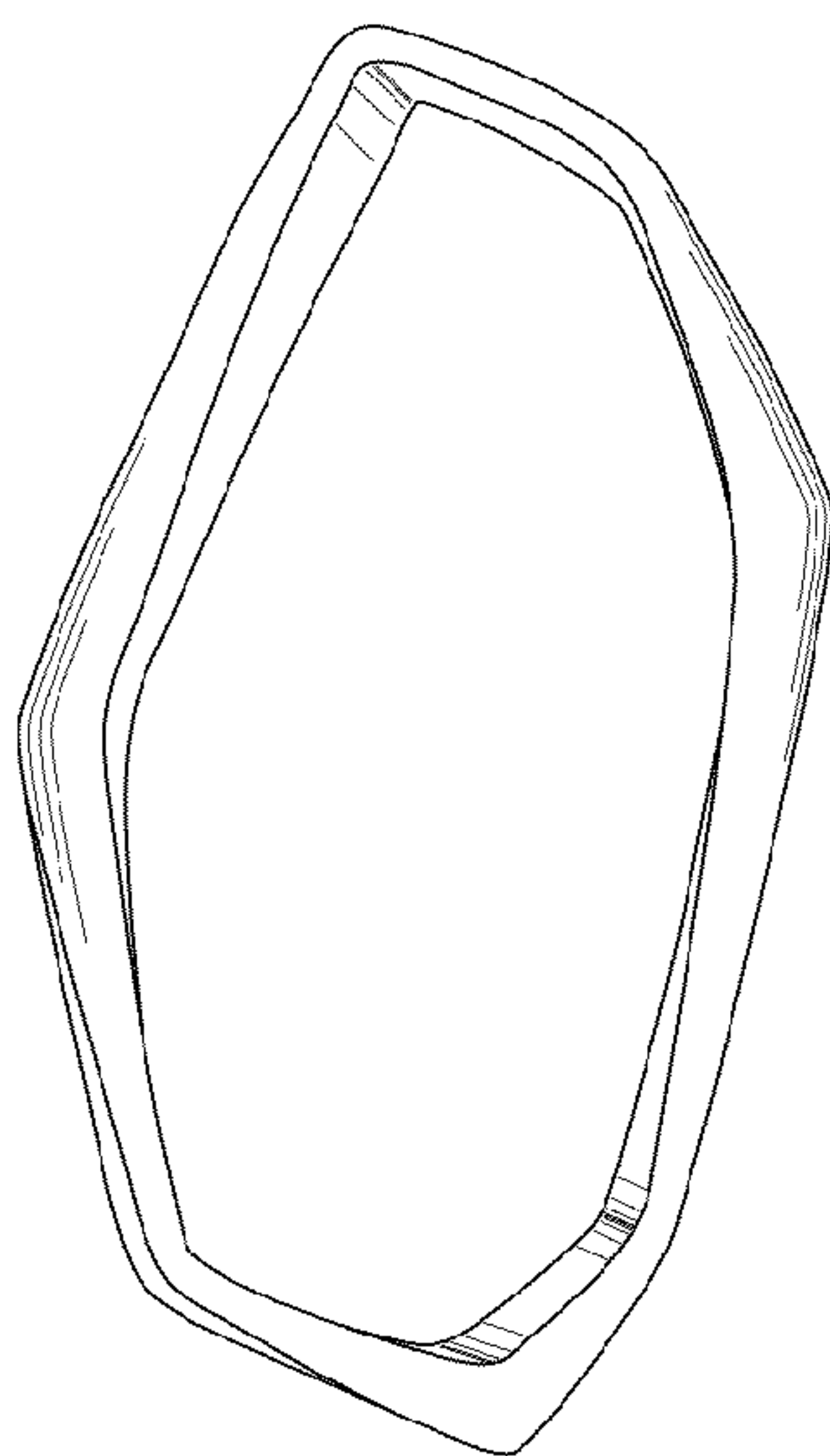

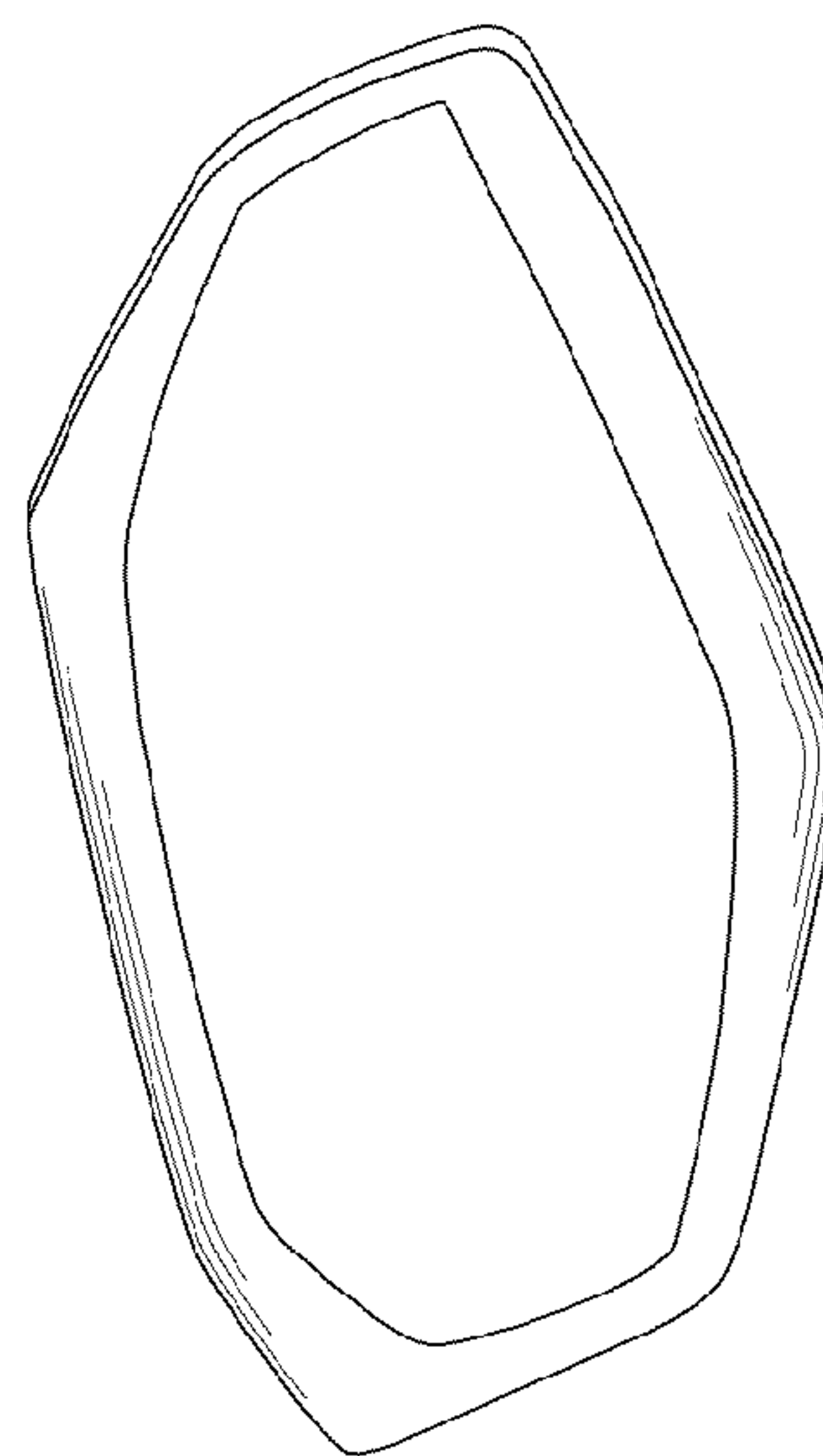

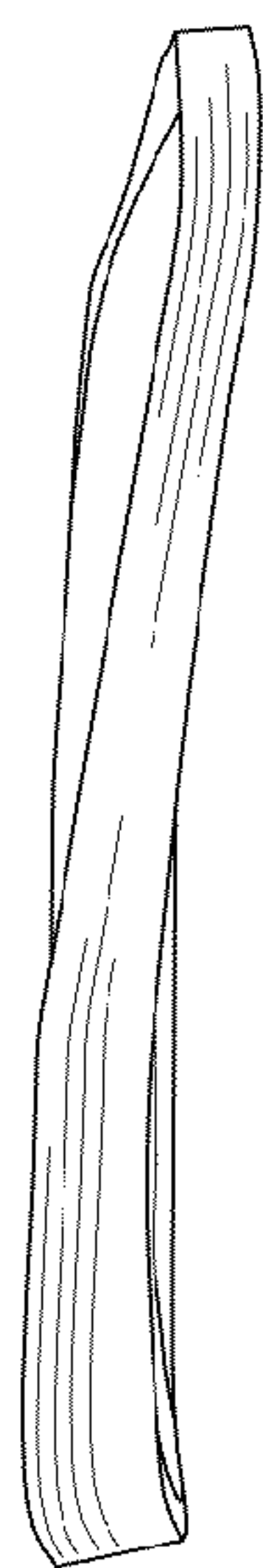

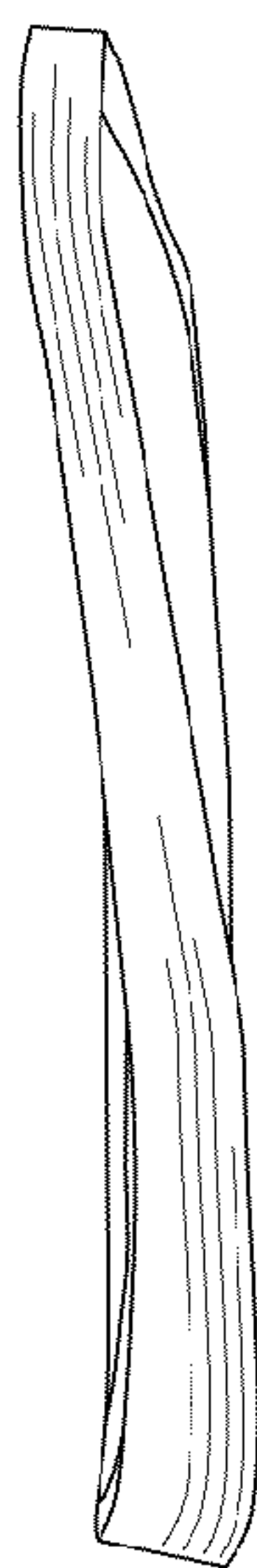

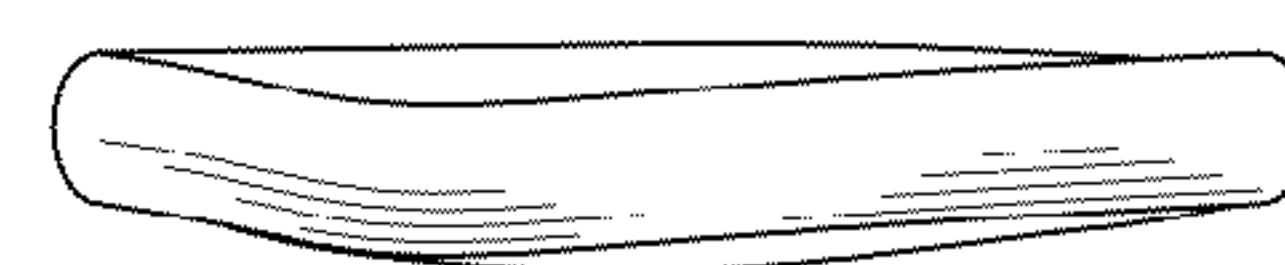

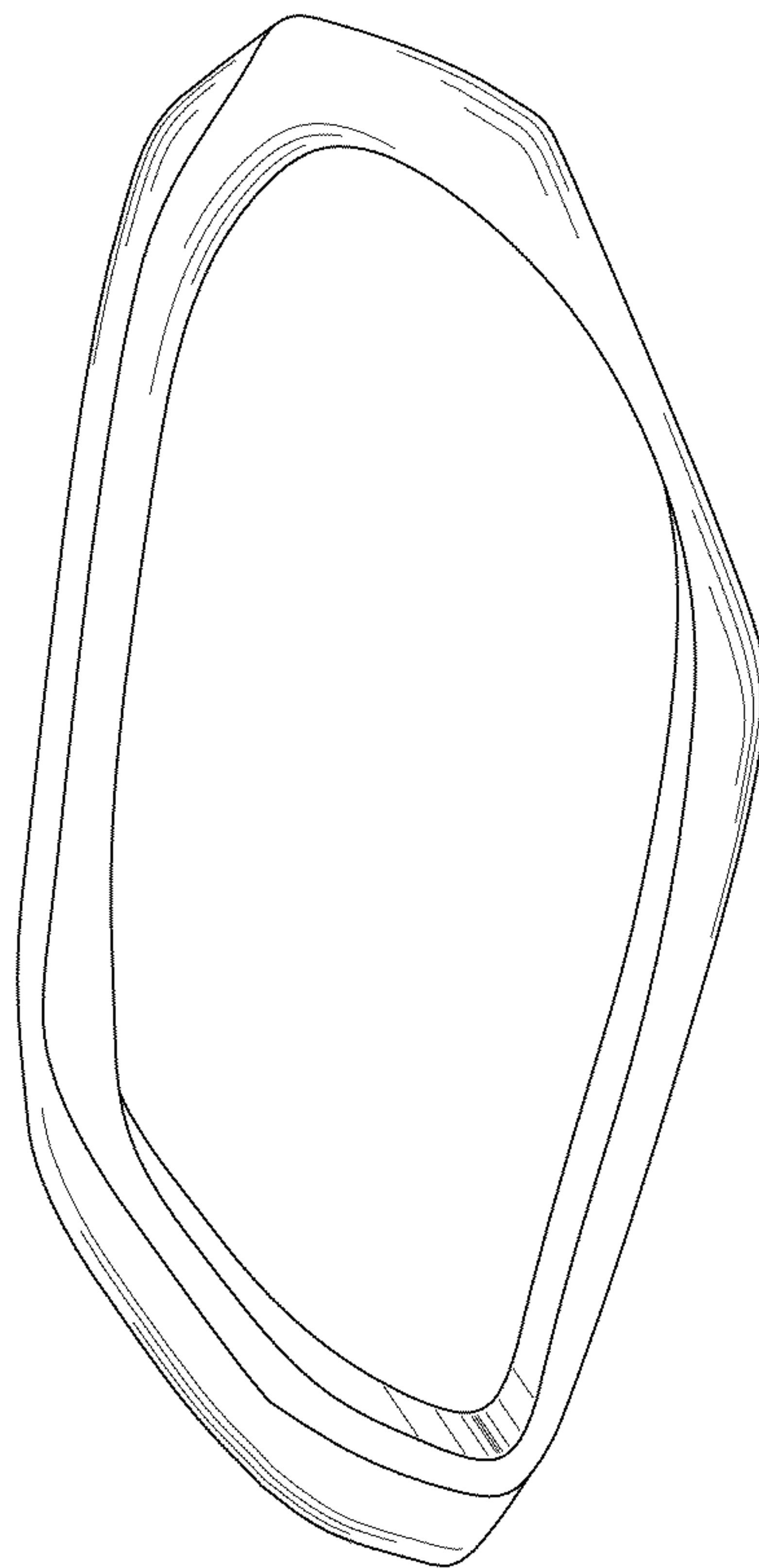

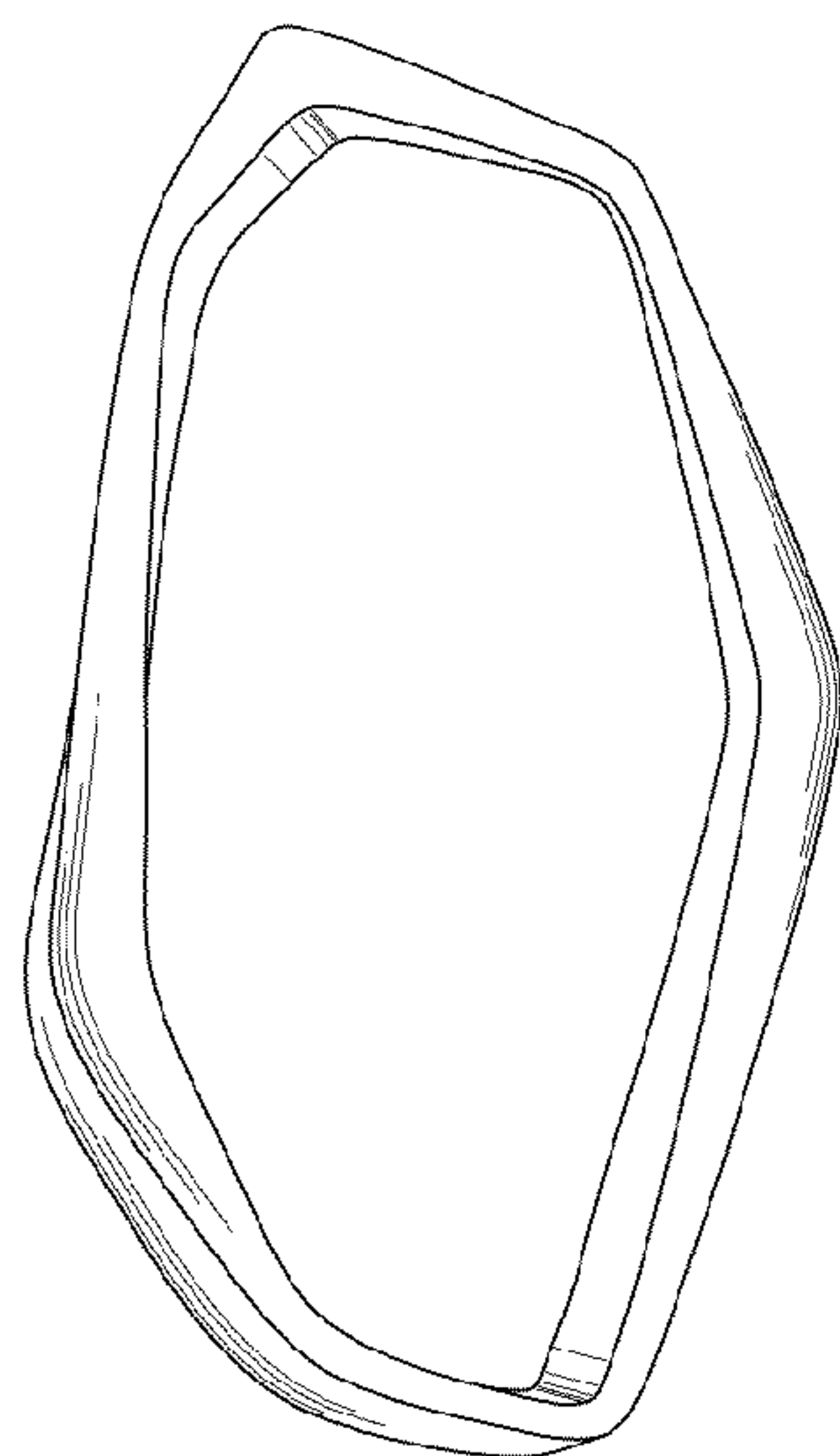

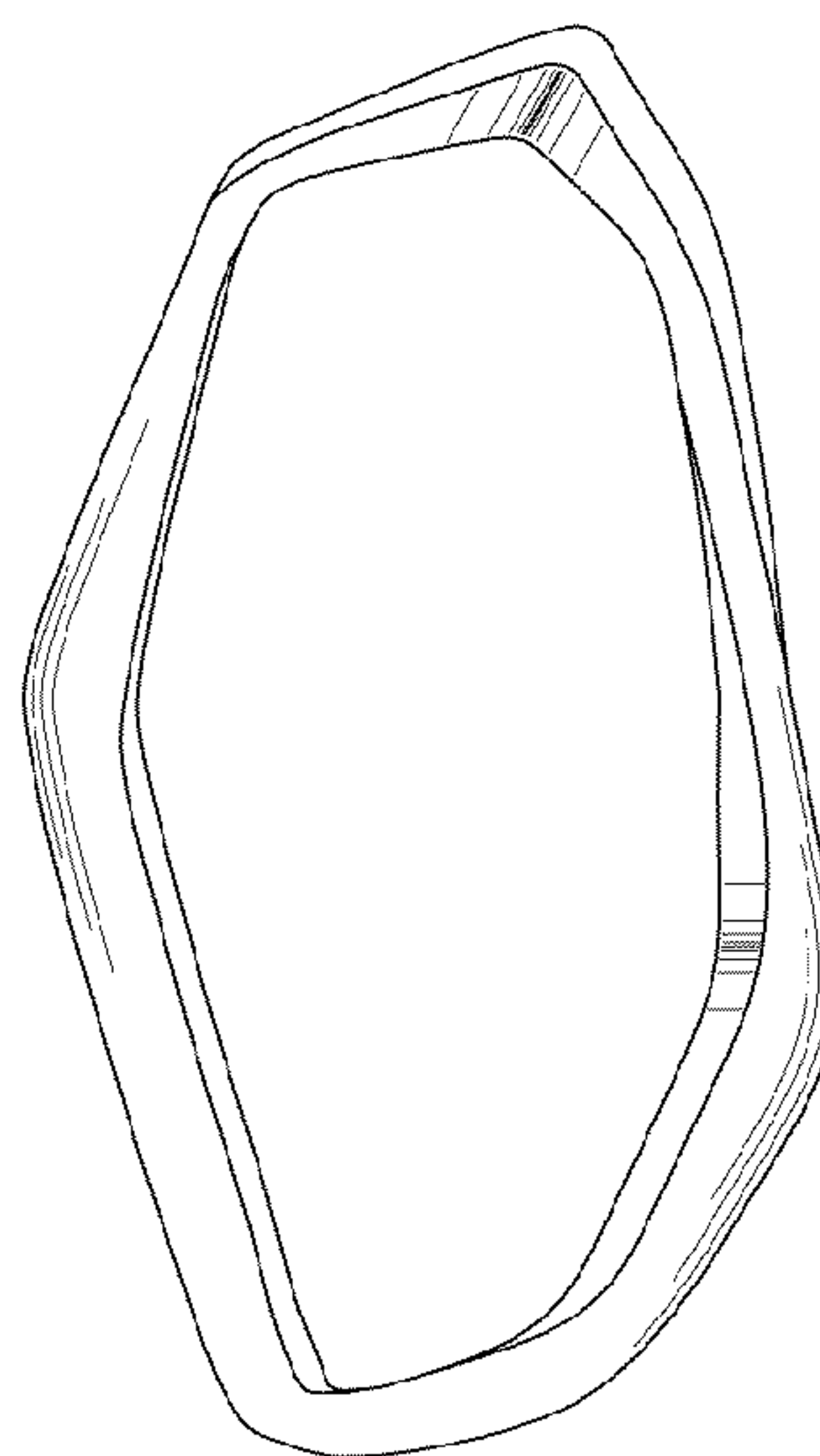

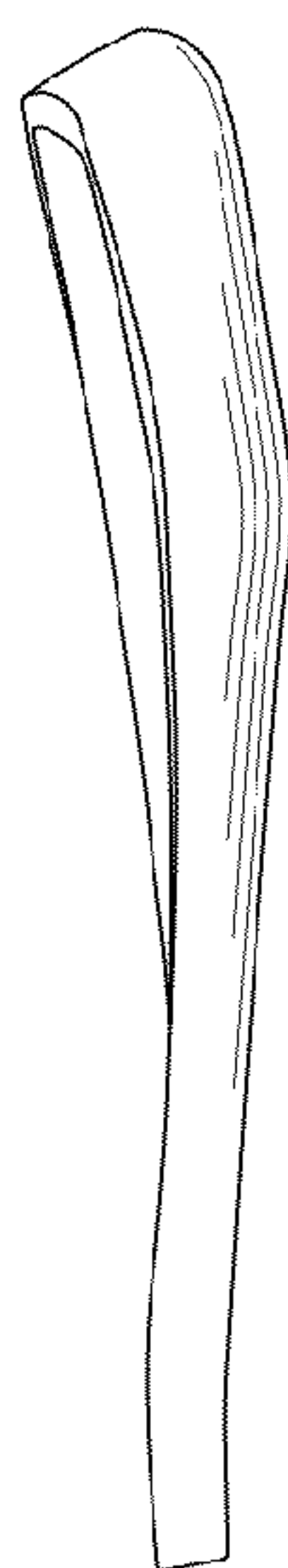

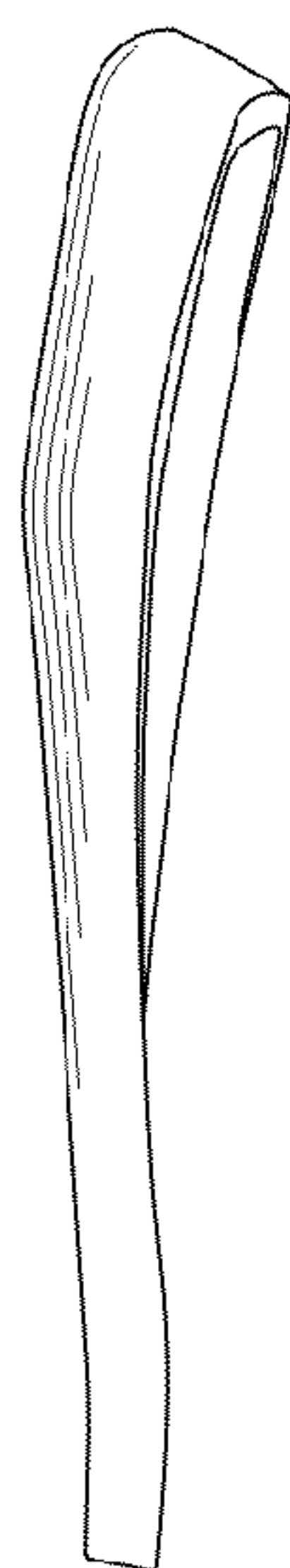

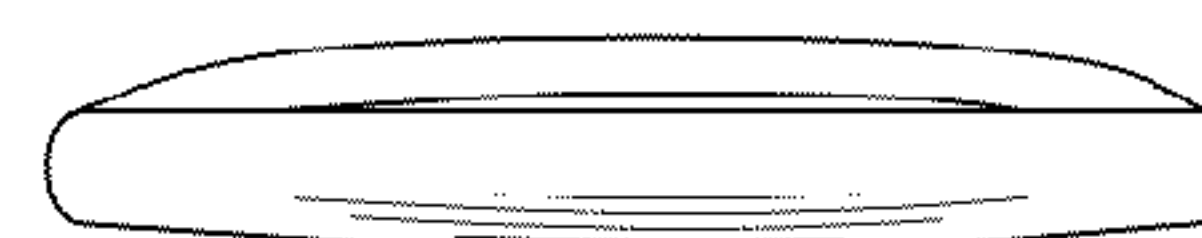

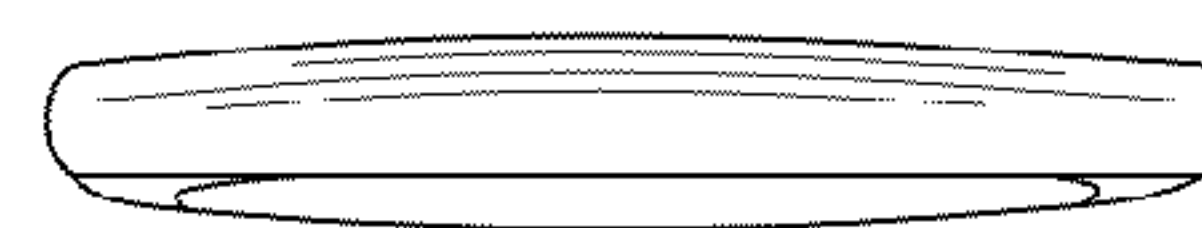
